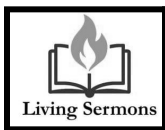

Opening Scripture

Genesis 1:26–28 (KJV)

And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.

And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth.

Somebody say, "Thank You, Jesus!"

I am sharing briefly on what I have titled: **Let Them Have Dominion.**

Somebody say, "Let them have dominion."

Say it again.

If you read verse 26, the Bible says:

"Let us make man... and let them have dominion."

Then He came back in verse 28 and said:

"Have dominion."

Dominion is the sole essence of your creation. Dominion is the ultimate agenda of God for mortality. God created man to be in charge. God created man to represent Him.

God created man to control and to rule.

The plan of God is that man should become a mini-god upon the earth.

That is why Psalm 82:5-7 says:

They know not, neither will they understand; they walk on in darkness: all the foundations of the earth are out of course.

I have said, Ye are gods; and all of you are children of the most High.

But ye shall die like men, and fall like one of the princes.

Why?

Because you do not know who you are.

In John 10:35, Jesus said:

“If he called them gods, unto whom the word of God came, and the scripture cannot be broken...”

The ultimate plan of God is for you to operate in dominion.

God created you in His image.

God created you in His likeness.

But He did not stop there.

He said:

“I am giving you something.”

Because being created in His image and likeness is not enough. There is something that powers that image. There is something that powers that likeness.

It is called **dominion**. Somebody say, “Dominion!”

What Is Dominion?

Dominion is complete and absolute authority. Dominion is mastery over mortality. You are a master over the creatures of God. Dominion is rulership over nature. You must understand what God said. You are not merely to dominate circumstances around you. You are called to exercise rulership over everything that creeps. That is dominion. In Genesis 27:40, after Jacob had subtly collected the blessing meant for Esau, Esau returned weeping bitterly. His father told him:

“When thou shalt have the dominion, that thou shalt break his yoke from off thy neck.”

In other words, there is only one way out. **Get dominion.**

When you have gotten dominion, you gain leverage. You gain advantage over what was taken from you. I know something may have been stolen from you. I know life may have treated you unfairly. But the way out is not crying. The way out is dominion. Dominion is your life advantage. Dominion is the platform for restoration. Dominion is the trigger for recovery. Somebody say, “Dominion!”

Dominion Is Your Divine Configuration

Psalm 8:4–6 asks:

What is man, that thou art mindful of him? and the son of man, that thou visitest him?

For thou hast made him to have dominion over the works of thy hands; thou hast put all things under his feet. Dominion is your configuration. You were made for it. You were wired for it. God created you for rulership. Shout, “Dominion!”

Dominion From Sea to Sea

Psalm 72:8 declares:

He shall have dominion also from sea to sea. The plan of God is for your dominion to be boundless.

Your dominion is limitless. Your dominion is not confined to a particular environment. It is not restricted to a geographical location. It is from sea to sea.

The God who made Africa made America. The God who made Europe made Asia. And that same God lives in you. Who made the world?

God.

Who lives in you?

God.

Therefore, wherever the sole of your foot shall tread, you possess.

Why?

Because the One who made it lives inside you. That is dominion from sea to sea. Your dominion is boundless. Your dominion is unrestricted.

Tell somebody: **“My dominion is from sea to sea.”**

Dominion From Generation to Generation

Daniel 4:3 says:

How great are his signs! and how mighty are his wonders! his kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and his dominion is from generation to generation.

Your dominion is not for a week. Your dominion is not for a month. As long as you have the revelation of Jesus Christ, your dominion is endless. You can transfer dominion to your children. You can transfer dominion to generations after you. Dominion is from generation to generation.

The Pathway to Dominion

If you study Genesis 1 carefully, you will discover something. In verse 26, God said:

“Let them have dominion.”

In verse 27, He created those who would have dominion. Male and female. This means dominion is not gender-based. Then in verse 28, God explained the process. He revealed the pathway.

Dominion is not a single element. It is a combination of several components. The first component is this:

Be Fruitful

God was revealing the pathway to dominion. In fact, among all the pathways to dominion, the hardest is fruitfulness. Your dominion mandate begins with fruitfulness.

What Is Fruitfulness?

Fruitfulness is converting potentials into tangibles. It is taking what is inside you and producing something visible outside you. Fruitfulness is bringing out what God deposited in you as raw material and transforming it into a finished product.

Fruitfulness means production. Fruitfulness means results. To be fruitful means to produce something.

Say:

“In the name of Jesus, I will produce.”

If you do not know what you were born for, you will die for anything. Understanding why you were born is the beginning of fruitfulness. Psalm 90:12 says:

So teach us to number our days, that we may apply our hearts unto wisdom.

You must ask yourself:

Why am I here?

What was I born to do?

What is my assignment?

Potential and Fruitfulness

The Bible says:

“And God blessed them.”

Before He spoke about dominion, He blessed them. That blessing is the inherent quality God deposited within you.

It is called **potential**.

Potential is an untapped resource residing inside you. Credential is what you have worked for. Potential is what you were born with. No employer asks you to submit your potential. They ask you to submit your credentials.

Why?

Because credentials are the manifestation of potential. Fruitfulness is the evidence that you have used what God gave you. Fruitfulness is your credential before God and before men.

You must ask yourself:

What am I good at?

What have I produced?

What am I known for?

You cannot wander through life aimlessly and expect dominion. At this point in your life, what have you produced?

Fruitlessness Attracts Judgment

Matthew 21:19 tells us that Jesus saw a fig tree.

He expected fruit.

Why?

Because He knew what had been deposited inside the tree.

When He found no fruit, He cursed it.

Why?

Because it was created to bless others. It was created to nourish others. It was created to be useful. Yet nobody could draw from it. Nobody could benefit from it. And Jesus said:

“Let no fruit grow on thee henceforward for ever.”

The lesson is simple. If you are fruitless to God, you become useless to men. Fruitlessness attracts divine judgment.

God expects production.

God expects results.

God expects manifestation.

Rooted to Produce Fruit

You must be rooted in God before you can produce fruit.

Isaiah 37:31 says:

“Take root downward, and bear fruit upward.”

A fruit-producing believer is a rooted believer.

And when you begin to produce fruit, God gives you greater grace.

Jesus said in John 15:2:

“Every branch in me that beareth fruit, he purgeth it, that it may bring forth more fruit.”

Keep producing.

Keep blessing lives.

Keep making yourself useful.

A fruit is not truly a fruit until someone can eat from it. A fruitful life is a life that blesses others. To become a medical doctor, you must take certain courses. You have to study specific subjects. When all of those requirements are completed, you become a medical doctor.

In the same way, God is showing us that dominion is not a single element. It is a combination of several components.

First, He said:

Be fruitful.

In the name of Jesus, your life will not be wasted. You will be fruitful. You will be fruitful. You will be fruitful.

Fruitfulness is transmitting the invisible into visibility.

Fruitfulness is converting ideas into tangible realities.

You take a dream, an idea, or a vision from the realm of the spirit and bring it into reality. Everyone who becomes great is someone who has converted raw materials into a finished product.

Fruitfulness is product.

Say it again:

Fruitfulness is product.

Then God said:

Multiply.

There is a difference between fruitfulness and multiplication. Fruitfulness is to produce. Multiplication is to reproduce. You have been fruitful; now make it happen again.

You succeeded once; repeat it. Perhaps 2024 was a wonderful year for you. You worked hard, exercised discipline, controlled your expenses, and made profit. That is fruitfulness. If in 2025 you intend to repeat the same success, that is multiplication.

Multiplication is increasing in number. It is easier to multiply when you have first been fruitful. For example, musicians know that composing a song is the difficult part. Once the song exists, reproducing it is easier. Authors know that writing a book is the challenge. Printing multiple copies is not the difficult part.

Fruitfulness creates the original product. Multiplication increases its reach. However, there is something important:

You must have a template for your fruitfulness if you want to multiply it. If 2024 was successful, ask yourself:

What did I do right?

That is why accidental success is dangerous. Accidental success cannot be replicated because it has no pathway. Whatever is not prototyped cannot be multiplied.

Every fruitfulness must have a recipe. Without a recipe, you cannot multiply. When God helps you obtain one shop, do not stop there.

Expand it into two.

Expand it into three.

Do not die with a single achievement. Multiplication is increase in number. Isaac understood this principle. He observed how Abraham prospered.

There was a pattern. There was a structure.

Abraham dug wells.

When Isaac encountered famine, he repeated what his father had done.

He dug wells.

When they were covered, he dug again.

Why?

Because Abraham's prosperity had a structure. Think about our fathers and grandfathers. Many of them cured diseases using herbs and natural remedies.

They understood the recipes. But when many of them died, the knowledge died with them because they never taught anyone else.

The produce could not be reproduced because there was no recipe. Many people leave this world carrying their greatness to the grave because they never created a structure for replication.

When you learn to cook, what do you need?

A recipe.

The recipe tells you what ingredients to use, how much to use, and how long to cook. Follow the recipe and you obtain the desired result. In the same way, if you want to multiply greatness, you must learn the recipe of greatness.

When you sit with successful people, ask questions.

How did they become successful?

How did they achieve what they achieved?

How did they build what they built?

Learn the process so you can reproduce the result.

Genesis 8:17 and Genesis 9:1 reveal God's desire for multiplication.

Leviticus 26:9 says:

“For I will have respect unto you, and make you fruitful, and multiply you...”

Multiplication is God's plan.

If you do not understand the process of fruitfulness, you cannot multiply.

Isaac became prosperous because he understood principles and patterns.

The blessing of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob was God's declaration.

But each generation had a responsibility to learn.

Isaac learned from Abraham.

Jacob learned from Isaac.

The tragedy of many of Jacob's sons was that they failed to replicate what their father had done.

The success stopped with the generation that understood the process.

Tell somebody:

“You will multiply.”

Do not stop at fruitfulness.

Increase the number.

If you have obtained one degree, pursue more knowledge.

Growth must never stop.

In this generation, learning must be continuous.

Every head without sense is a load to the neck.

A head filled with wisdom becomes a blessing to the neck.

Improve yourself. Develop yourself. Increase.

Tell somebody:

“Multiply.”

Have you built a house?

Thank God for it.

Recover for a season and begin planning the next level.

Increase.

You learned tailoring?

Learn hairdressing. You learned hairdressing?

Learn baking.

Keep expanding your capacity. Do not waste your time. Invest every season of your life in learning something new. Some people cannot perform even the most basic tasks.

Develop yourself. Grow.

Increase.

That is multiplication.

The Third Pathway to Dominion: Replenish

Then God said:

“Replenish the earth.”

When I studied that word, I was amazed.

Replenish means to expand.

It means to occupy.

It means to spread.

You cannot have a global destiny while maintaining a local mentality.

Spread.

The dream God gave you is not limited to your immediate environment.

Replenish the earth.

Do not die local.

Expand your thinking.

Carry your mind to the palace and your body will meet you there.

Think globally.

Think beyond your present location.

Think beyond your immediate surroundings.

Carry your mind to the palace.

Your body will meet you there.

You have been fruitful.

You have multiplied.

Now take that success beyond your current space.

Take it further.

Expand it.

A global mentality changes how you package yourself.

A global mentality changes how you present your gift.

The Bible says you are a sweet savour.

You are not meant to move through life carelessly.

Carry yourself with excellence.

Whatever we do, we must do it with a global mindset.

Global citizens understand their value.

Your mentality determines your locality.

Never forget that.

When influential people merely give you money, that is not the highest blessing.

Access is greater than money.

Reference is greater than money.

Introduction is greater than money.

A door opened through relationship can achieve more than a temporary financial gift.

Money is one of the lowest levels of wealth.

Access creates opportunities that money alone cannot create.

Say:

“I am global.”

My vision is global.

My mindset is global.

My gift is global.

What is inside me is global.

I am a global citizen.

This world will hear my voice.

Asia is waiting for me.

America is waiting for me.

The Fourth Pathway to Dominion: Subdue

Finally, God said:

Subdue.

This is where spiritual engagement becomes necessary.

To subdue means to take charge.

God's plan is for you to be fruitful.

God's plan is for you to multiply.

God's plan is for you to replenish.

But there are forces that will attempt to resist those purposes.

Subdue them.

There are powers that want to hinder your fruitfulness.

Subdue them.

There are forces that want to stop your multiplication.

Subdue them.

There are spirits that want to resist your expansion.

Subdue them.

This is where prayer becomes necessary.

This is where spiritual warfare becomes necessary.

God has already blessed you to be fruitful.

He has already blessed you to multiply.

He has already blessed you to replenish.

But opposition exists.

That is why Paul said in 1 Corinthians 16:9:

“For a great door and effectual is opened unto me, and there are many adversaries.”

Matthew 13:25 says:

“But while men slept, his enemy came and sowed tares among the wheat...”

God says:

Subdue.

Take authority.

Stand in prayer.

Declare:

“Lord, You blessed me to be fruitful.

You blessed me to multiply.

You blessed me to replenish the earth.

What is that force standing against my fruitfulness?

What is that power resisting my multiplication?

What is that spirit hindering my expansion?

I subdue it.

I take dominion over it.

I will be fruitful.

I will multiply.

I will replenish the earth.”

I was not born useless.

I was born to fulfil destiny.

I was created because I am needed.

Since I am needed, I cannot be wasted.

I am too important to be impotent.

Too expensive to be expended.

I am a child of the King.

You do not serve a dead God.

You serve the living God.

He is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

When God says yes, no man can say no.

When God lifts a man, no one can bring him down.

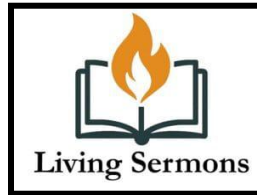
God is on your side.

“Let them have dominion!”

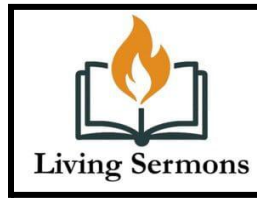

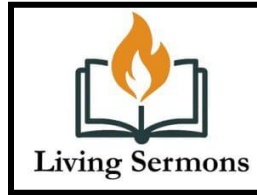
