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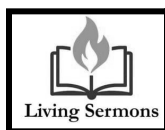
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# Foreword

# ***Main Message***

*Begins Here*



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## **The Holy Spirit: The Fifth Platform for Wealth**

We started something three Sundays ago. What has been the topic of our message? Power.

Our anchor scripture has been:

*“But thou shalt remember the LORD thy God: for it is he that giveth thee power to get wealth, that he may establish his covenant which he sware unto thy fathers, as it is this day.” — Deuteronomy 8:18 (KJV)*

The fifth platform for wealth is the Holy Spirit. This is a very important truth that you need to understand. There are three kinds of people living on the face of the earth.

The first category consists of those who live for survival. If people do not give to them, they do not eat. If people do not give to them, they do not have. If people do not give to them, they do not own.

The children of Israel, while they were in Egypt, lived that kind of life. There are people living a survival life who have become so used to it that they are comfortable with it. They have adjusted themselves to that condition. When God brought the children of Israel into the wilderness and they began to go through a process, they said to Moses:

“Take us back to Egypt where we had cucumbers.”

In other words, take us back to where people fed us. Take us back to where we depended on others. For a man to be willing to return to that kind of life means he has become accustomed to it. There are people whose lives operate entirely on survival.

## **Need Before Supply**

The second category of people live in what I call *need before supply*. They must first encounter pressure before provision appears. School fees become due, then they begin running around to gather money. Rent becomes due, then they begin searching for funds. Food becomes scarce, then they begin looking for resources.

Everything in their lives follows the pattern of need before supply.

## **The Realm of Flow**

But there is a third category.

It is called **flow**.

Somebody say, “Flow.”

That is why God said:

*“A land flowing with milk and honey.”*

In this realm, before the need comes, the supply is already waiting. Before the demand arises, provision is available. I make a declaration:

You will not go through survival. You will not go through need before supply. You will enter the realm of flow. Tell somebody, “Flow.”

## **Life Is Not Wired to Favour You**

Say, “The Holy Spirit.”

Let me give you some hard truths. You may not like them, but they are truths. Life is not wired to favour you. Life is actually wired to work against you.

Gravity itself proves it. When you jump up, what happens?

You come down. Life is not designed to keep you up. As you age, your organs become weaker. When people reach certain ages, restrictions increase:

“Do not eat this.”

“Avoid red meat.”

“Do not do that.”

Why?

Because the body weakens with age. Life is not naturally designed to favour you. For life to favour you, you must involve spirits. For life to favour you, you must engage the spirit realm.

That is why some people, in pursuit of wealth, go beyond hard work and enter cults.

Why?

Because they understand that to move beyond the ordinary, spirit forces must be involved.

But for the believer, the answer is not dark spirits. The answer is the Holy Ghost. To move beyond the ordinary, the Holy Ghost must be involved.

Spirits must be engaged.

Spirits must be activated.

## **What Is Following You?**

Can I say this to you?

It is what follows you that determines your outcome.

It is the sign attached to a man that determines what that man becomes.

In basic mathematics:

$5 + 2$  produces one result.

$5 - 2$  produces another.

$5 \div 2$  produces another.

The outcome is determined by the sign.

That is why the Bible says:

*“And these signs shall follow them that believe...”* — Mark 16:17 (KJV)

There are people followed by subtraction.

There are people followed by division.

There are people followed by addition.

And there are people followed by multiplication.

The question is:

## **What is following you?**

I came to prophesy by the mandate of God.

As you hear the sound of my voice, the Holy Ghost shall follow you.

Power shall follow you.

Grace shall follow you.

If your amen is louder, take the blessing.

Ask somebody:

“What is following you?”

The Bible says:

*“But truly I am full of power by the spirit of the LORD...”* — Micah 3:8 (KJV)

Jesus said:

*“But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you...”*  
— Acts 1:8 (KJV)

The Bible says:

*“How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power...”* — Acts 10:38 (KJV)

Everywhere you see the Holy Ghost, you see power. The Holy Ghost is the key to changing times and seasons. If you are tired of one season and desire another, engage the Holy Ghost. If you are tired of remaining on one spot, engage the Holy Ghost.

In Acts chapter 1, the disciples asked Jesus: “When will the kingdom be restored?”

“When will everything stolen be restored?”

“When will all that the enemy has taken be restored?”

Jesus answered:

*“It is not for you to know the times or the seasons...” — Acts 1:7 (KJV)*

But then He gave them the secret:

*“But ye shall receive power...” — Acts 1:8 (KJV)*

In other words, restoration operates on the platform of power.

And that power is triggered by the Holy Ghost.

## **The Holy Spirit Is a Person**

Many people do not know the Holy Spirit. They know theology.

They know explanation.

They know doctrine.

But they do not know the Holy Ghost. The Holy Ghost is a person.

Jesus said:

*“Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away...  
but if I depart, I will send him unto you.” — John 16:7 (KJV)*

Notice He said **Him**, not “it.”

The Holy Spirit is a person.

There is a difference between a human being and a person.

A human being possesses a physical body.

A person possesses personality.

Personality is defined by three things:

- Will
- Mind
- Emotion

The Holy Spirit possesses all three.

The Bible says:

*“And grieve not the holy Spirit of God...”* — Ephesians 4:30 (KJV)

That means He can be grieved.

He has emotions.

The Bible says:

*“But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as he will.”* — 1 Corinthians 12:11 (KJV)

He has a will.

Romans 8:27 speaks of:

*“The mind of the Spirit.”*

He has a mind.

He has emotion.

He has a will.

He has a mind.

Therefore, you cannot impose your desires on Him.

# Knowing the Letter but Missing the Spirit

There are people who know the Bible but do not know the Holy Spirit. You can explain Scripture perfectly and still miss the Spirit behind it. For example, I may see someone begging and immediately think, “The Bible says help him.”

That is true.

But the Holy Spirit may say, “Do not help him.”

Why?

Because the Holy Spirit knows what you do not know.

That is why the Bible says:

*“The letter killeth, but the spirit giveth life.”* — 2 Corinthians 3:6 (KJV)

Without the Spirit, people become critical, judgmental, and harsh. But once you know Him, compassion overwhelms you. For over thirty years, whenever I see people doing wrong, the Holy Spirit never tells me, “Attack them.”

He says:

“Pray for them.”

“Love them.”

That is His character.

You can have gifts.

But we do not judge men by gifts.

We judge men by fruit.

My wife and I discuss everything. We joke together. She can tap me; she can even tap my head. Yet there is honour in our home.

There are conversations we do not have. Not because they are secrets, but out of respect.

We are open with each other and can discuss many things, but there are certain areas where friendship does not enter.

A woman should know where friendship should not enter. A man should know what not to say to his wife that would demoralise her. Even when food is not prepared well, there is a way to communicate it. There is a way to package your words.

When you have the Holy Spirit, there are things He will tell you not to say. He guards your utterance.

That is intimacy.

Intimacy produces a consciousness of purity.

There are things you refuse to do and things you refuse to say because you do not want to offend God.

Say:

“Holy Spirit, I need You.”

## **The Holy Spirit Announces Men**

When you have the Holy Spirit, the third thing He does is announce you.

The first proof is brokenness.

The second proof is intimacy. The third proof is announcement.

“And Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit into Galilee: and there went out a fame of him through all the region round about.” — Luke 4:14 (KJV)

When the Holy Spirit takes hold of your life, He brings you from the backside to the front side.

Show me any man who has impacted his generation, and I will show you a man helped by the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit can pick up a young girl from a forgotten village and place her on the world stage.

He can pick up a young man from obscurity and place him before nations. He is the lifter of men. He is the announcer of men.

He advertises men.

He picked David from tending sheep and made him king. He picked Joseph from prison and made him Prime Minister in Egypt. He picked Esther, an orphan girl, and made her a queen. It does not matter how rejected, abandoned, or overlooked you may be.

If you connect to the Holy Ghost, He can lift you. Papa Adeboye was working in a university as a lecturer and professor of mathematics. Today, the Redeemed Christian Church of God is established in nations across the world.

Why?

A man yielded himself to the Holy Ghost. Kathryn Kuhlman experienced personal disappointments, yet she surrendered herself to the Holy Spirit. Presidents, professors, and influential people sat under her ministry.

Why?

The Holy Ghost. When you build friendship, intimacy, relationship, alignment, and communion with the Holy Spirit, He sets your life on a global platform.

Say:

“Holy Ghost, drive me to Your presence.”

## **Beyond Logic and Human Calculation**

I am talking about a relationship with the Holy Spirit that goes beyond mere reading and intellectual explanation. Some people use human logic to explain spiritual realities.

Everything becomes calculation, reasoning, and debate. But the Holy Spirit is beyond human permutations. Four or five years ago, there were things that would provoke me easily. Now, the Holy Spirit has worked on me.

There are things I see today, and I simply smile. There are situations where I choose silence because the Holy Spirit has taken over. When you genuinely encounter God, one of the strongest proofs is overwhelming love.

A palpable love.

Children ran to Jesus because they felt safe around Him. For children to run to you, there must be something welcoming about your countenance.

That shows how approachable Jesus was. You cannot claim to build holiness while destroying compassion. Compassion is one of the highest expressions of holiness.

You cannot claim to work for God while operating through the flesh.

Somebody say, "The Holy Spirit."

## **The Spirit of Love and Reconciliation**

When two people are keeping malice, they do not know the Holy Spirit. He will not permit it. One of our leaders once said to me concerning someone who had done wrong:

“Leave him. Even if we deal with him, Papa will still call him back and calm everything down.”

I replied, “It is not about me.”

I cannot sleep comfortably when there is unresolved conflict because the Holy Spirit keeps speaking.

He says:

“Draw that person closer.”

How do you live in the same house and stop talking to one another?

How do you do that and still claim to know the Holy Spirit?

How do choir members refuse to speak to one another and still stand together to sing about the love of God?

We have a great work to do. Knowing the Holy Spirit is not memorising Bible verses. Knowing God is not merely quoting Scriptures. There are people who know many verses but lack spiritual reality. The Holy Spirit is what makes the difference.

## **Prayer: The Sixth Platform for Wealth**

The sixth platform for wealth is prayer. The disciples said:

“Lord, teach us to pray...” — Luke 11:1 (KJV)

Prayer is powerful.

Jesus said:

“For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.” — Mark 11:23 (KJV)

This Scripture reveals the dynamics of prayer. Before effective prayer, there must first be a picture.

## **See Before You Say**

What are you seeing?

What picture exists in your mind?

When you have a clear picture of the future you expect, nobody needs to force you to pray. Vision naturally creates intercession. That was what happened with Hannah.

She saw a child before she held a child.

Even after everyone left the temple, she remained praying.

Vision makes intercession natural.

Vision makes prayer easy.

God continually asked His servants:

“What seest thou?” — Jeremiah 1:11 (KJV)

“What seest thou?” — Amos 7:8 (KJV)

“What seest thou?” — Zechariah 4:2 (KJV)

God works with what you can see.

As Bishop David Oyedepo often says:

“Your mental picture is your actual future.”

What do you see?

The wrong picture has destroyed many lives.

The picture before your mind determines the direction of your life.

When challenges come, what do you see?

When others see disaster, can you still see possibility?

When others see failure, can you still see victory?

Nothing can be restrained from a people who imagine correctly.

“...and now nothing will be restrained from them, which they have imagined to do.” — Genesis 11:6 (KJV)

## **The Power of Positive Expectation**

What made Jesus outstanding was not only His divine nature. He possessed the right mindset. Positive thinking affects your health. Negative thoughts transmit weakness into the body. That is why doctors often recommend rest.

True rest is not merely lying down.

You can be on a bed and still be restless.

Rest involves quieting your mind.

Before prayer, there must be a picture.

# **The Second Dynamic of Prayer: Say**

Number one: See.

Number two: Say.

What are you seeing?

What are you saying?

You do not speak your condition.

You speak your expectation.

There are two dimensions of speaking:

## **Declaration**

Declaration is speaking what you expect.

## **Affirmation**

Affirmation is speaking what God has already said concerning you.

You wake up in the morning and declare:

“I am the righteousness of God.”

“By His stripes I am healed.”

“I walk in divine health.”

That is affirmation.

You are agreeing with God's verdict concerning your life.

That is prayer.

# Speak Life Over Your Family

Husbands and wives should learn to speak blessings over each other. Hold hands. Pray together. Declare God's purpose over one another.

Say:

“My husband is a blessed man.”

“My wife is a virtuous woman.”

“You are a crown to me.”

“You are a royal excellency.”

“You are a joy.”

Speak life.

Speak destiny.

Speak purpose.

Prayer is not only what happens in church. Prayer includes declarations and affirmations made in faith. Speak over your children.

Declare:

“You are the righteousness of God.”

“You are the head and not the tail.”

“God will use you.”

“All my children are taught of the Lord, and great is their peace.”

Speak progress.

Speak provision.

Speak enlargement.

Speak health.

Speak excellence.

Do not speak evil over your family.

Negative declarations are also prayers.

Calling your husband a failure is a form of prayer. Calling your child useless is a form of prayer. Words carry creative power. Therefore, call forth those things which be not as though they were.

## **Thy Words Were Heard**

The angel said to Daniel:

“Fear not, Daniel: for from the first day that thou didst set thine heart to understand, and to chasten thyself before thy God, thy words were heard...”

— Daniel 10:12 (KJV)

Thy words were heard. Your words matter. A word not declared cannot be confirmed.

“And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following...” — Mark 16:20 (KJV)

Let the weak say, “I am strong.”

Let the poor say, “I am rich.”

Declare what God has promised.

# Future Begins Today

Many people think the future is a special arrangement waiting ahead of them.

No.

The future is your today carried into tomorrow. If you carry failure today, you will meet failure tomorrow. If you carry negative confessions today, they will shape tomorrow.

Instead, declare:

“In the name of Jesus, I and my children are for signs and wonders.”

“I declare greatness.”

“I affirm preservation.”

“I declare increase.”

“I affirm protection.”

“I declare expansion.”

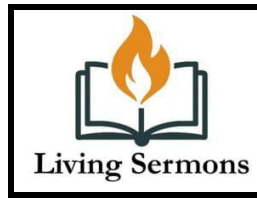
“I affirm sound health.”

“I affirm preservation.”

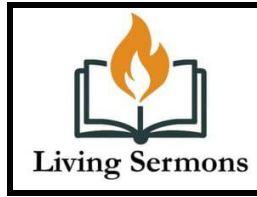

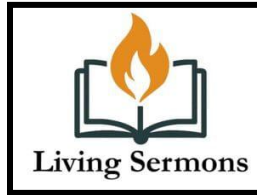
