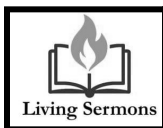

THE WORD OF FOUNDATIONAL TRUTH

Deuteronomy 8:18:

“But thou shalt remember the Lord thy God: for it is he that giveth thee power to get wealth, that he may establish his covenant which he sware unto thy fathers, as it is this day.”

This is *Power to Get Wealth, Part Four*.

And in this teaching, we begin to examine the last three elements of wealth.

THE SYSTEM OF HONOUR

Number seven is the honour system.

A man who wants to access wealth must understand the system of honour.

1 Timothy 5:17:

“Let the elders that rule well be counted worthy of double honour, especially they who labour in the word and doctrine.”

You cannot access wealth if you do not understand honour.

Anytime God wants to elevate a man, He orchestrates a situation that demands honour. Through that honour, grace is released from custodians of divine assignment.

Even Jesus walked under this system.

From the age of twelve, He was already conscious of His calling, speaking with teachers and doctors of the law.

Yet He did not begin public ministry until He came under John the Baptist.

John had to baptise Him.

Jesus submitted to that order so that righteousness would be fulfilled.

Until that honour structure was activated, heaven did not open.

MOSES AND DIVINE INSTRUCTION

Moses had encounters with God:

- The burning bush that was not consumed
- The rod that turned into a serpent
- The hand that became leprous and restored

Yet even after such encounters, Moses still needed honour and instruction before Pharaoh.

There is a system God uses to release men into manifestation.

THE WIDOW OF SHUNEM AND THE PROPHET

In 2 Kings 4, a woman perceived that Elisha was a holy man of God. She was spiritually sensitive, yet she had no child. Her spiritual perception was not enough to produce her miracle.

But when she honoured the man of God, a prophetic word came:

“By this time next year...”

Honour activated what prayer alone had not delivered.

SUBMISSION AND SPIRITUAL COVERING

Hebrews 13:17:

“Obey them that have the rule over you, and submit yourselves: for they watch for your souls, as they that must give account...”

Spiritual leadership carries responsibility before God.

When believers dishonour spiritual authority, they hinder the flow of grace over their lives.

Submission is not bondage—it is alignment for divine covering.

GIVING AS A SPIRITUAL LANGUAGE

Philippians 4:15–17 shows that giving is communication.

“Not because I desire a gift: but I desire fruit that may abound to your account.”

Every offering speaks.

Every act of giving is a spiritual transaction that produces eternal fruit.

Honour is not for the man—it is for your benefit.

When honour is broken, access is restricted.

Many do not understand that spiritual covering is real, and it must be treated with reverence.

Even in generations today, dishonour has become common, but it weakens spiritual protection.

PERSONAL LESSON OF HONOUR

The preacher reflects on learning honour early in ministry—how a simple correction from a father in the faith shaped his lifestyle and appearance. What others may ignore, the wise receive as instruction. Honour transforms perception, posture, and destiny.

When leadership is burdened, spiritual flow is affected.

Scripture warns that such behaviour is not profitable.

Honour ensures continuity of grace.

David is presented as a key example of honour.

Despite multiple opportunities, David refused to touch Saul, saying:

“The Lord forbid that I should do this thing unto my master, the Lord’s anointed...”

Even when Saul was vulnerable, David restrained himself.

He understood that honour preserves destiny. When Saul eventually died, David still honoured the principle. He rejected anyone who claimed to have killed the Lord’s anointed. This shows the seriousness of spiritual honour in Scripture.

THE CHURCH AND PRAYER THAT WORKS

Acts 12 shows Peter in prison.

But the church did not just pray—they aligned with divine words already spoken:

“I have prayed for thee...”

They stood on existing intercession, and heaven responded. An angel was sent, chains fell off, and Peter walked free.

Honour produces release. Chains fall when divine order is respected. What binds men cannot stand where honour is properly applied.

Abraham waited many years for promise. But through structured divine encounters—such as his interaction with Melchizedek—access was established. When honour was demonstrated, covenant access opened. Honour is not optional in the kingdom.

It is a system that governs wealth, access, covering, and manifestation. Those who understand it do not struggle for release.

They step into alignment—and doors open.

God also occasions platforms where honour is activated.

Abraham and the Three Visitors

In Genesis 18, three men appeared.

“And he lift up his eyes and looked, and, lo, three men stood by him...”

(Genesis 18:2)

As they passed by, Abraham ran to meet them and invited them into his house.

Sarah prepared a meal for them.

As they ate, they asked, “*Where is your wife?*”

A prophecy that had no date suddenly began to find timing.

Because honour had opened the door for visitation.

THE LOST CULTURE OF HONOUR

Any generation that understands honour experiences stability and order. Even in natural families, honour produces structure.

Where children respect their parents, discipline is accepted, correction is received, and alignment is maintained.

But where honour is missing, disorder increases.

A GENERATIONAL SHIFT

There is a contrast between past and present cultures.

Earlier generations operated under strong honour systems:

- Correction was accepted
- Instruction was respected
- Waiting was normal

But today, impatience, rebellion, and disregard for structure have weakened that fabric.

The result is instability in many areas of life and society.

THE POWER OF HONOUR IN SPIRITUAL COVERING

Honour is not just emotional—it is spiritual protection. When spiritual coverings are dishonoured, access to grace is affected.

Believers are therefore instructed to guard how they respond to those God has placed over them.

Even when misunderstanding arises, discernment is required.

DEDICATED SERVICE IN THE HOUSE OF GOD

Now number eight: dedicated service in the house of God.

A believer must be committed, consistent, and planted.

Jesus as Example

“And he came to Nazareth... and, as his custom was, he went into the synagogue on the sabbath day...” (Luke 4:16)

It was His custom. If Jesus were physically on earth today, He would not treat gathering with indifference. Consistency in God’s house is part of spiritual alignment.

THE PATTERN OF ASSEMBLY

Hebrews 10:25:

“Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together...”

There is a divine pattern for gathering.

Believers are not only called to attend but to remain connected, expectant, and engaged.

The gathering of believers is not ordinary—it is a spiritual system.

THE HEAVENLY REALITY OF CHURCH GATHERING

Hebrews 12:22–24 reveals what happens spiritually when believers gather:

- Mount Zion
- The city of the living God
- An innumerable company of angels
- The spirits of just men made perfect
- Jesus, the Mediator of the new covenant
- The blood of sprinkling

When the church gathers, heaven is present.

It is not just a physical meeting—it is a spiritual assembly.

THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF HEAVEN

This gathering is described as a “general assembly.”

It reflects divine order:

- God as Judge (Judiciary)
- God as Lawgiver (Legislator)
- God as King (Executive)

In this assembly, spiritual authority is active.

Believers are not passive observers—they participate in spiritual declarations and alignment.

When believers agree, heaven responds.

Words spoken in alignment carry authority.

Declarations made in faith are not empty—they are spiritual legislation.

Angels are present in multitudes.

The atmosphere of church gathering is filled with divine activity beyond human sight.

What is seen physically is only a fraction of what is happening spiritually.

THE BLOOD THAT SPEAKS

Hebrews 12:24:

“And to Jesus the mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling, that speaketh better things...”

The blood of Jesus speaks.

Even in silence, there is spiritual communication happening.

The blood speaks:

- Peace
- Health
- Restoration
- Advancement
- Grace
- Fruitfulness

THE VOICE OF GOD – NUMBER NINE ELEMENT OF WEALTH

Now number nine: the voice of God.

The voice of God is a critical key in the system of wealth. David consistently won battles because he inquired of the Lord before action. He did not rely on assumption or strategy alone.

He sought divine instruction first. Even when others relied on one prophetic voice, David sought multiple confirmations—prophet, priest, and seer—ensuring clarity.

DIVINE STRATEGY IN BATTLE

God often gives unusual instructions:

- Worship before warfare
- Praise before battle
- Choir before soldiers

Yet these instructions produce victory. Because when God speaks, strategy is already secured.

When God speaks, confusion becomes clarity. Even enemies can be defeated through divine sound amplified by heaven. The voice of God carries authority beyond human understanding.

THE VOICE THAT WALKS

Genesis 3:8:

“And they heard the voice of the Lord God walking in the garden...”

The voice of God is not static—it moves. This reveals a spiritual principle: the voice of God produces motion.

THE VOICE OF GOD PRODUCES MOVEMENT

Anyone who hears God cannot remain stagnant. The voice of God produces:

- Motion
- Direction
- Acceleration
- Elevation

A life without divine instruction becomes stagnant. The believer must remain sensitive daily. What God said yesterday may not be the instruction for today. Even Abraham had to listen again at Mount Moriah to receive updated instruction.

God’s instructions are progressive. While His purpose does not change, His methods may shift. Those who stay sensitive experience accurate alignment and timely breakthroughs.

Revelation 11:12:

“Come up hither...”

The voice of God produces lifting. Those who hear Him rise above limitations.

FINAL DECLARATION

The voice of God brings:

- Ascension
- Progress
- Elevation
- Advancement

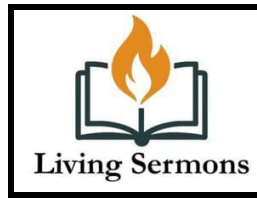
A life guided by God's voice cannot remain on the same level.

Because divine motion is sustained by divine voice.

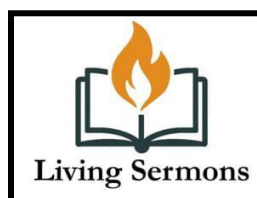

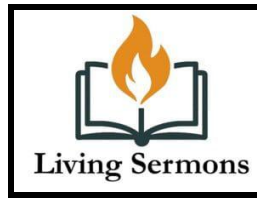
