Introduction

Tonight, I just want to give us an outline on the word — the prophetic word the Lord has given us for this year. It is not really going to be a teaching. Rather, it is to give us perspective as to the major focus and emphasis that the Spirit would like us to dwell on as we carry out God's agenda for this year.

Sometimes people ask questions: *Why do churches always come up with new themes every year?* Some even say it is not correct. Others ask why the themes are different.

Glory to God.

God created this world to function in cycles and patterns. We are not the ones who decided that the earth would revolve around the sun once in 365 days. Neither are we the ones who established that the earth would revolve around its own orbit once in 24 hours. So long as there is night and day, and so long as there is the cycle of the year, you will know that God functions in seasons and cycles. He established this in Genesis 1:16–20.

The operations of God upon the earth function according to the laws of seasons and cycles. That is why, for every cycle, God gives prophetic words. These words help to form our focus and direction for that season. If we do not have prophetic words, we may become involved in too many things and end up ineffective in the enterprise of kingdom assignment.

So God gives us these words because:

1. The earth was created to function in cycles and seasons.
2. Prophetic words give us direction and focus so that we become effective and productive in our assignments.
3. Prophetic words become conduits through which the supply of grace is regulated.

As we obey the prophetic words that God gives us, we discover that more grace is apprehended.

Glory to God.

And for those asking why these words are different, they are different because God is doing many things upon the earth. Within the Body of Christ, we are separated into quadrants. There is no organised institution or system where everybody does the same thing. Every system operates with various parts carrying out unique responsibilities that eventually sum up into one corporate whole.

When you power your vehicle, what the tyre is doing is not what the engine is doing. What the engine is doing is not what the headlamp is doing. You cannot give all of them the same instruction; there will be crisis. Yet, at the end of the day, as they all perform their unique functions, they achieve one purpose.

Glory to God.

When you get to a company, it is not the same instruction you give to the gateman that you give to the marketer. It is also not the same instruction you give to those in the production unit. Every unit has specific directions and commands that contribute to achieving a corporate goal. So it is impossible for every church to have the same prophetic word. God gives different prophetic words because there are different things He is doing in packets that ultimately form one corporate whole in His divine agenda.

For us, and for a few like us, our focus by the Spirit is enlargement — supernatural enlargement.



The Year of Supernatural Enlargement

This year, for us, is the Year of Supernatural Enlargement.

My assignment tonight is to define the concept and show us its various components so that we can align ourselves correctly and maximise what God wants to do.

Hallelujah.

Let me use this opportunity to welcome everybody back. This is our first service for 2026. I hope you had a great time retreating and resting. This year, indeed, will be a year of supernatural enlargement for you.

Psalm 18:19 says:

“He brought me forth also into a large place; he delivered me, because he delighted in me.”

When God delights in a people, He naturally enlarges them. This man laboured and did all he needed to do as a human being, but in addition to all he did, it was God who supernaturally brought him into a large place.

God is in the business of enlarging His people. In fact, in Deuteronomy 12:20, the Bible says:

“When the LORD thy God shall enlarge thy border...”

If you understand this, you should actually have an expectation for enlargement.

If you know God enlarges, then you should expect enlargement. It is actually a command for the children of God. God does not only enlarge — He expects us to have an

expectation for enlargement. And in case we do not, He brings it to our consciousness because there are people who become relaxed and dormant and refuse to press for enlargement. When God finds such people, He mandates them to enlarge.

Isaiah 54:1–3 says:

“Sing, O barren, thou that didst not bear; break forth into singing, and cry aloud, thou that didst not travail with child...

Enlarge the place of thy tent, and let them stretch forth the curtains of thine habitations: spare not, lengthen thy cords, and strengthen thy stakes.”

You have a duty not to remain small. You have a duty not to be myopic. You have a duty to expect and press for enlargement. There is no glory in remaining small. Too much will be challenged if you remain the way you are. The Bible says:

“For thou shalt break forth on the right hand and on the left...”

Anybody who begins to press for enlargement will experience enlargement.

“And thy seed shall inherit the Gentiles, and make the desolate cities to be inhabited.”

Everybody connected to what God is doing here this year, I make bold to declare to you that you will be enlarged beyond your imagination. For thou shalt break forth on the right hand and on the left.

Thy seed shall inherit the Gentiles. I am no longer merely reading Scripture now — I am prophesying to you. Thou shalt make the desolate lands inhabited. This is your portion for 2026 and beyond.

This is what God does to His people. You cannot say you are blessed of the Lord and remain in one shallow place. That is not God’s plan.

Isaac: A Portrait of Enlargement

Please sit down for a moment. In Genesis 26:12–14, we see a portrait of an enlarged man. When God enlarges a man, nobody will mistake it. This is what He has always done. When He created Adam, He gave him the whole earth. When He entered covenant with Abraham, He gave him the whole earth. God is not a myopic God. He is a big God, and He is in the business of making His children big. The Bible says:

“Then Isaac sowed in that land, and received in the same year an hundredfold: and the LORD blessed him.”

The proof that a man is blessed is enlargement. This was the same land people were running away from. Isaac also attempted to run, but God said to him:

“Stay still in Gerar.”

It is not about the location; it is about the One powering you. See, where some of you are currently may look as though it is over for you. It may appear as though nothing can work there. Right there, God will break limits for you. Verse 13 says:

“And the man waxed great, and went forward, and grew until he became very great.”

He waxed great. He went forward. He became very great. Verse 14 says:

“For he had possession of flocks, and possession of herds, and great store of servants: and the Philistines envied him.”

A man became so great that an entire nation envied him. Can I talk to someone tonight?

This nation will not only recognise you — it will envy you. The nations of the earth will not only recognise you; they will envy you because this is your year of enlargement. Can somebody give the Lord a shout!

Hear this: you are not being enlarged to become small again. Proverbs 4:18 says:

“But the path of the just is as the shining light, that shineth more and more unto the perfect day.”

You are not rising in 2026 to fall in 2027. It is upward and forward only. I said it is upward and forward only, in the name of Jesus Christ.

Give the Lord a big hand.



What Is Supernatural Enlargement?

Supernatural enlargement refers to a divine act of God that results in the expansion of a person's:

- Capacity
- Territory
- Influence
- Authority
- Impact
- Fruitfulness

— beyond natural limits and without proportionate human explanation. Enlargement is not merely about money or assets. It begins with capacity. Some people, no matter how much God blesses them, still have a capacity of one. If you multiply anything by one, there is no geometric effect.

Others have a capacity of zero because they have not harnessed their potential. Even if the blessing is multiplied a billion times, once it connects to zero capacity, it still becomes zero. But when God enlarges a man, He first increases his capacity. Imagine if your capacity becomes a millionfold. Even one blessing becomes a million. Ten blessings become ten million.

So when God wants to enlarge you, He begins with your capacity. Then He moves to your territory — your jurisdiction. He gives you more territories to occupy, more territories to operate in, and more territories to function within. No matter how great you are, if your territory is limited, your enlargement is limited. Even in the world

system, the principle is understood. Somebody may be doing business in the United States, yet dominating Europe, Asia, and Africa.

The handset you are using today may have come from Japan, China, or America. The more your territories increase, the more your enlargement increases. If your territory is limited, no matter how great you are, you remain a local champion.

Enlargement of Territory

Some of you watching me now, what God has placed in your hands this year will break across demographics. Some years ago, no matter what I preached, only teenagers listened to me. They used to call me “the man of mysteries.” Every aspect of the sermon carried mysteries.

But only teenagers listened. I would go for meetings and preach with such intensity that it felt as though I wanted to rapture. There was a meeting I attended in Port Harcourt. While preaching, smoke literally began coming out of my chest. I called Pastor Victor and asked, “What is this? Where is this coming from?”

We checked everywhere. There was no fire. Yet, the whole meeting ended up reaching only campus people. Now imagine if I had remained there alone. Campus ministry is powerful because destinies are recovered there, but there are limitations if territory does not enlarge.

Then God began to enlarge me. Suddenly, adults began saying, “I heard you preach, and I was blessed.”

Territory had begun to enlarge. Soon, the demographics became mixed. You could no longer tell who exactly the messages were targeting. After a while, I began breaking into systems. Anglican bishops started inviting me to preach.

Pentecostal fathers invited me as well. People I once called mentors now stood on the same platforms with me — not merely to take opening prayers, but as an apostle.

Territory was enlarging. The demographics changed. I remember flying to Jos after travelling through Port Harcourt. While boarding, I noticed an elderly man struggling to walk, so I gave him my seat in business class and moved elsewhere.

A man later approached me and insisted on bringing me back to business class. As we talked, he said, "I am a senator."

I was shocked.

A senator left his seat to plead with me. The territory had changed. It was no longer campus alone. It had expanded across age groups and societal systems. Today, in this service, there are people above seventy years old seated here, and there are people as young as fifteen.

That is enlargement of territory.

At another time, all my invitations were from campuses within Nigeria. I moved from one campus to another. Then suddenly, nations opened. Now, when the year begins, more than fifty nations are already lined up, saying, "Please come and bless us."

Territory increased.

That is enlargement.

Some of you doing business have been sewing clothes in Mararaba for ten years. This year, you will have customers in Italy.

That is what I am saying.

Some of you have done ministry only in Kubwa and its surrounding streets. Even the birds know your voice there already. It is time for people to hear you in Saudi Arabia. It is time for people to hear you in Washington. It is time for people to hear you in Congo. It is time for people to hear you in Zambia. Give the Lord a shout!

Enlargement in Authority and Influence

And can I tell you something? The Lord will do a quick work. He will cut it short in righteousness. It may have taken some people twenty years, but some of you hearing me now — those jewellery businesses you have started — within three months, orders will begin to come from abroad.

Enlargement.

Capacity.

Territories.

Authority.

Please sit down.

There was a time when we would pray for four hours just to cast out one demon. We would shout:

“In the name of Jesus, come out! Come out! Come out!”

One demon would make you lose your voice. Sometimes, we would leave and come back the next day because of one demon. That demon would shut down our entire week.

But then God did something — authority levels changed. Now, you do not need to say “out” twice. You simply say, “Come out,” drop the microphone, and move on. There was a time when, if you wanted to impart or activate people, you would fast for two or three days. Then you would show up, preach for two hours, and after the atmosphere became charged, you would begin shouting:

“Lord, touch! Lord, activate!”

But no, sir.

How many places can you preach in one year like that?

When authority levels change, once you are done speaking, you simply say:

“Now God is about to touch some of you.”

Sometimes you even specify the number. You say:

“Thirty people will be touched in Jesus’ name.”

And it must happen because authority levels have changed. If demons are present, they will be cast out. If dormant gifts are present, they will be activated. Nowadays, I preach the same messages I preached seven or ten years ago. Back then, after preaching, I would shout for God to heal somebody. A few people would come out saying:

“Headache is gone.”

“Back pain is gone.”

And I would wonder:

Did I come here only to heal back pain?

But now authority levels have changed. I was in Jos yesterday. When I finished preaching, I told them:

“This message carries power. I will not pray for the sick.”

I simply made a declaration. Paralysis was healed. Eyes opened. That is normal. That is what God wants to do for you this year.

He will shift your authority. He will add influence to you both in the spirit and among men. That business you are doing will become a household name. Everybody will want it. You do not need to be operating a multi-million-dollar business before authority comes.

You can simply be selling puff-puff, yet authority rests upon it and an entire nation begins looking for it. You can be selling smoothies, but influence comes upon your work.

The things that stop other businesses will step aside when yours appears. I prophesy to someone tonight: God is giving you global influence.

This is what He is doing. Your capacity will enlarge this year. Your territories will enlarge this year. Your authority and influence will enlarge this year.

Influence That Opens Doors

There are people who carry brilliant ideas — ideas capable of transforming nations — yet they lack influence. I was speaking with a man recently. The things he shared with me, if even half were implemented, this nation would change. But every time the president gives him an appointment, certain people around prevent access.

Imagine the president wanting to see someone, yet those assigned to call him refuse to do so. Meanwhile, the solution to national transformation is with that man. When God gives you influence, doors open. When you speak, your words stand. Some people occupy good positions, yet they are only figureheads because you can be a king and still not reign.

The Bible speaks of kings who were crowned but did not truly reign until years later — because that was when authority and influence came. But hear this: From 2026, you will begin to reign.

It does not stop at influence and authority. God enlarges people by making them fruitful. This means whatever comes out of you does not die. It carries the potential to reproduce itself.

This is why disciples can be raised. This is why legacies can be established. Something comes out of you and gains the ability to replicate itself across generations. Not only that – it subdues time. That is enlargement.

You may leave the earth many years from now, yet your impact will still be speaking in 2026 and beyond. God will truly enlarge you.



Why God Enlarges People

Before we misunderstand enlargement, we must ask an important question:

Why does God enlarge people?

Myles Munroe once said:

“When the purpose of a thing is not known, abuse is inevitable.”

So let us consider why God enlarges people.

1. To Fulfil His Covenant Purpose

God enlarges people in order to fulfil His covenant purpose and agenda upon the earth.

Genesis 12:1–3 says:

“Now the LORD had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father’s house, unto a land that I will shew thee:

And I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing:

And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed.”

Why did God enlarge Abraham?

So that all the families of the earth could be blessed through him. Jesus said in John 15:8:

“Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be my disciples.”

Your enlargement advances God’s kingdom. When people see what God has done for you, they realise it is not by power or by might. The Bible says:

“By strength shall no man prevail.”

When they see certain accomplishments, certain records, and certain impacts, they recognise that an invisible hand is pushing you. Your life becomes a testimony that glorifies God.

And because you know God is the One who advanced you, you become an instrument for advancing His kingdom. Deuteronomy 8:18 says:

“But thou shalt remember the LORD thy God: for it is he that giveth thee power to get wealth, that he may establish his covenant...”

So God enlarges people for His glory and for the advancement of His kingdom.

2. Enlargement Demonstrates God’s Love

God also enlarges people as a demonstration of His love. Psalm 18:19 says:

“He brought me forth also into a large place... because he delighted in me.”

If God loves you, He blesses you. He does not love you and leave you in suffering, drought, and pain. His enlargement is proof that He is mindful of you. Jeremiah 29:11 says:

“For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end.”

When you see God doing certain things in your life, it should assure you that He loves you deeply. I told my friends many years ago that some of us have passed the realm of heartbreak.

Nothing can break my heart. Nothing can make me depressed. When I see what God is doing around me, I am persuaded that I am loved. Nobody leaves me and finds me lying down crying.

No, sir.

Why do you think the Bible says David encouraged himself in the Lord?

The goodness of God was too enormous. Is it because someone left that I will forget the speed, impact, and love of God surrounding my life?

What are we talking about?

Hear me tonight: Every channel Satan uses to torment you emotionally is broken from tonight in the name of Jesus.

Every month, heartbreak.

Every month, depression.

Come on — you are loved by the King. The affection of the King is towards you. And it is not empty affection. It is affection with proofs. Proofs of empowerment that make you the head and not the tail. Proofs of empowerment that continually increase you.

That is who you are.

The Grace Behind Enlargement

Most of the things God is doing with us were not earned. We did not merit them. We do not even have what it takes naturally. But He does them to remind us that He cares.

I remember travelling for a crusade one day. I was exhausted. I had not prayed properly and did not even have a word from God yet. To make matters worse, I did not organise the meeting myself. When people invite you, you must manifest.

They did not pay for your flight just for you to arrive and explain why nothing happened.

As they drove me to the venue, I kept praying:

“Lord, have mercy.”

I needed a word.

Sometimes all you need is one sentence or one scripture. Once it hits your spirit, God develops it. Suddenly, God dropped a scripture into my spirit.

I quickly grabbed my notepad because revelation can come with such speed that, if you do not write it down, you may lose it.

When I finished preaching, people were staring quietly. Sometimes, when people are excited during your sermon, you feel encouraged. But when they simply stare at you, you begin wondering whether your words are reaching them at all.

Then God dropped another scripture into my spirit. When I released it, miracles broke out everywhere. From that day, I became like Mount Zion that cannot be moved.

I realised something: Consecration is for my growth, but the miracles are manifestations of God's love and grace.

Galatians asks:

“He therefore that ministereth to you the Spirit, and worketh miracles among you, doeth he it by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?”

Everything God does with me and through me is a testimony of His love and grace.

God will enlarge you this year because He loves you.

3. God Enlarges People to Demonstrate His Strength

Psalm 75:6–7 says:

“For promotion cometh neither from the east, nor from the west, nor from the south.

But God is the judge: he putteth down one, and setteth up another.”

When God enlarges you, He is making a name for Himself through your life. That is why you must be careful to give Him all the glory. In this generation, many people want to take credit for every little thing God does.

Someone’s deaf ear opens, and immediately the person begins talking about how many mountains he climbed and how many months he fasted. God is showing mercy, yet man wants the glory.

Exercise your faith.

Obey God.

But when God shifts your possibilities, your first response should be:

“Thank You, Father.”

He made it happen.

1 Samuel 2:7–8 says:

“The LORD maketh poor, and maketh rich: he bringeth low, and lifteth up.

He raiseth up the poor out of the dust, and lifteth up the beggar from the dunghill, to set them among princes...”

When God begins to do extraordinary things in your life, remember: it is not merely your expertise. Your expertise matters, but God is using your life to reveal His power.

Do not rob Him of His glory.

4. Enlargement Prepares You for Greater Responsibility

God enlarges people in preparation for greater responsibility and stewardship. Luke 16:10–12 teaches that if you are faithful in little things, you will be faithful in much. Whenever God increases you, do not merely celebrate the blessings. Prepare your heart for responsibility. Those who are truly rising understand that higher levels carry heavier responsibilities.

When God increases your capacity, territory, and resources, it is because greater assignments are ahead. That is why many people never become truly great — they resist responsibility. You give them assignments, and they respond with excuses and complaints. But those God enlarges are people whose hearts are ready for greater stewardship. Do you think these crusades happen because we do not love rest?

At the level God has brought us, He expects millions of souls. There are people God may expect to win fifty souls in a year. But for some of us, if we win only fifty souls with the level of access, influence, and resources available to us, Heaven will ask questions.

Likewise, some people receive great financial resources from God, yet they give little and expect applause.

Meanwhile, God is asking:

Do you think the favour, strategies, influence, and opportunities I gave you were merely for luxury and comfort?

“Thou art my battle axe and weapons of war...”

God raises men for kingdom assignments. When God enlarges you, it is not merely so you can become comfortable. He enlarges you for greater responsibility and stewardship in His kingdom. That is why a widow can give two mites and Heaven celebrates her, while another person gives one million and Heaven asks:

“What is wrong with you?”

Because God measures giving and stewardship according to capacity and assignment. As we shout “enlargement” this year, you must remain mindful of this truth. Some of you cannot win the same number of souls you won last year.

Some of you cannot give the same amount you gave last year toward kingdom advancement. There are people seated here who are already positioned to buy land and donate it for church building projects. Some of you are already capable of sponsoring one crusade every month and saying:

“On my account, let this crusade happen.”

Others among you are positioned to adopt entire orphanages so that feeding children there no longer remains a prayer point. Yet many people still think enlargement is merely about increasing figures in their bank accounts.

“Last year I had ten million; this year I have two billion.”

No.

What you have may simply be paper without eternal value. The day breath leaves a man, he discovers that Heaven does not measure what was in his earthly bank account; Heaven measures what was stored in his heavenly account.

Enlargement means greater stewardship.

That is why God enlarges people.

5. Enlarged to Preserve a Generation

Another reason God enlarges men is to preserve generations. The opportunities, destinies, callings, and heritage of entire generations are often hidden inside the lives of men. Many generations would have been erased if certain individuals had not risen. So when God enlarges you, He is raising you to preserve a generation. Joseph understood this in Genesis 45:7–8 when he said:

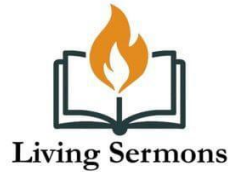
“God sent me before you to preserve you a posterity in the earth...”

There are nations that would never have become what they are today if certain men had not risen at critical moments in history. The possibilities available in many nations today are testimonies of individuals whom God raised. When God raises you, therefore, do not think only about yourself. When God enlarges you, He is using you as a vessel to preserve generations. You think influence came merely so you can become important. You think wealth came merely so you can become successful.

No.

God raised you to preserve a generation. There was a time in this nation when twins were killed. If somebody had not risen and said “No,” countless destinies would have been destroyed. Even today, there are nations where women still cannot drive or hold public office because nobody rose to preserve the opportunities and dignity of women in those societies. So whenever you enjoy possibilities in your generation, understand that men before you paid prices to preserve those possibilities.

And now that God is lifting you, do not leave the earth until you too have preserved opportunities, possibilities, and heritage for another generation. Your money is wasted if it does not preserve generations. Your influence is wasted if it does not preserve generations. Your name is wasted if it does not preserve generations. Jacob rose for a generation. Joseph rose for a generation. And you too are rising for a generation.



Areas Where God Enlarges People

Because of time, let me briefly outline specific areas where God enlarges men.

1. Enlargement of Territories

Genesis 13:14–17 says:

“Lift up now thine eyes, and look from the place where thou art northward, and southward, and eastward, and westward:

For all the land which thou seest, to thee will I give it...”

God enlarges people by giving them territories. Some of you listening to me this year, God will give you states within this nation. Any transaction you carry out there will prosper. Any campaign you undertake there will succeed. Some of you, God will give you nations.

You may remain physically in Nigeria while God grants you influence in Australia, Congo, or other nations of the earth. And somebody else may live abroad while God gives them influence in Nigeria.

Do not lose the nation God entrusts to you. There are people who lost nations because they failed to recognise divine entrustment when it came.

Joshua 1:3–5 says:

“Every place that the sole of your foot shall tread upon, that have I given unto you...”

Some of you may think you are travelling merely to visit someone or for tourism. Yet the moment your feet touch certain territories, Heaven signs documents concerning your inheritance.

Five years later, God may send you back there and say:

“This is your nation.”

Psalm 2:8 says:

“Ask of me, and I shall give thee the heathen for thine inheritance...”

God gives nations to men. That is enlargement.

2. Enlargement of Authority and Influence

Genesis 41:39–44 shows the story of Joseph. A houseboy and prisoner became prime minister of Egypt.

Some of you hearing me now may be occupying low positions in organisations today, but before this year ends, something dramatic will happen.

Someone may resign.

Systems may shift.

Unexpected opportunities may emerge. And suddenly they begin searching for the person with the highest level of experience. You may have served quietly for twelve years while others only served for three or five years.

Then suddenly, the same people who ignored you begin to recognise your value. Promotion does not come from the east or the west. Promotion comes from the Lord.

That is why your consciousness must change this year. The fact that you are trekking today does not mean you will still be trekking in December.

Every day you step out, position yourself for authority. Some of you cannot dress carelessly this year. Even if you currently work as a cleaner, dress with dignity because you may suddenly be recommended for a higher office. Some of you cannot speak carelessly anymore. Do not say:

“Nothing is working.”

“I am finished.”

“I am dying.”

Do not shut doors with your own mouth.

Anything is possible.

The Bible says:

“In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye...”

Even the rapture happens suddenly.

Whatever you do, do it with excellence and dignity because it may become the ladder to your next level.

Daniel is another example.

Daniel 6:3 says the king considered setting Daniel over the whole realm.

But how did Daniel begin?

He began as a eunuch — a servant.

Naturally speaking, eunuchs were disqualified from inheritance and dominion.

Yet the same person who was positioned for minor service became the highest authority in the kingdom.

Joseph was a forgotten prisoner and a foreign slave, yet he became prime minister.

So hear me:

In 2026, anything is possible. Anybody can become anybody. And by grace, you are rising into realms of authority. Prepare your heart. You may have just started a company or an NGO, but God can suddenly position you as an adviser to presidents and systems.

This is your year of influence and authority. Your words will carry weight. You will speak, and things will move.

3. Enlargement of Capacity

Ezekiel 36:26 says:

“A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you...”

God enlarges people by enlarging their internal capacity. There are people who seem overwhelmed by everything in life. Every day they rise tired, frustrated, and defeated.

But this year, God will transform capacities. Areas where you once looked weak and incapable will suddenly become areas of strength and excellence.

God will not merely improve you. He will re-engineer you. There is a difference between updating someone and upgrading someone. You update people by giving them new information. You upgrade people by changing the facility itself.

Some of you will experience divine upgrading this year. You will read one book and suddenly receive a thousand ideas and strategies from it. You will spend thirty minutes in prayer and receive visions, instructions, and strategies for implementation. By June, people will wonder what happened to you.

They will ask:

“How did you suddenly start five companies?”

“How are all of them succeeding?”

“Where did this inspiration come from?”

“How do you have the discipline to sustain all these things?”

That is capacity enlargement.

I know a senior friend who owns a bank in Nigeria and also pastors multiple thriving church services every Sunday, each filled with thousands of people. At the same time, he travels across nations for crusades and ministry assignments.

Everything is functioning effectively. That is not ordinary blessing. That is divine re-engineering. That is what God is bringing many of you into.

Vision increasing. Intimacy increasing. Finances increasing. Systems increasing.

People will look at you and wonder what happened. It will seem as though you became the host of a divine being.

So do not be intimidated.

Do not be lukewarm.

God is enlarging your capacity.

Some of you will receive ideas even while sleeping. Your dreams will become instructions. You will wake up in the middle of the night to write inspirations. You will park your car by the roadside because Heaven is downloading strategies into your spirit.

And as you execute these instructions, everything will begin to work simultaneously without confusion or conflict. Receive capacity enlargement now in the name of Jesus. People who once knew you as confused and directionless will suddenly become astonished at your transformation.

While others slept, God opened your spirit. Downloads are coming. Strategies are coming. Implementation grace is coming.

Prophetic Declaration

Before this year is over, some of you will start five companies, and all of them will prosper.

Some of you searched for jobs at the end of last year and found none because your season of working for others has ended.

You are about to build your own systems. You will establish structures upon which dynasties and legacies will stand — for individuals, churches, and nations. If God can turn slaves and eunuchs into rulers, then your case is not difficult for Him.

Write these things down.

Meditate upon them.

Some of you have run businesses or ministries for many years without visible results. The problem was not necessarily the business or ministry. The issue was capacity.

Once God revamps your inner capacity, what looked like failure for ten years can suddenly produce extraordinary results within three months.

4. Enlargement of Resources and Wealth

Deuteronomy 8:18 says:

“But thou shalt remember the LORD thy God: for it is he that giveth thee power to get wealth...”

There are many forces responsible for economic empowerment. One of the easiest is inheritance — being born into wealth. There are also natural principles that create wealth:

- Recognising opportunities
- Investments
- Relationships
- Discipline
- Integrity
- Moral values

All these contribute to wealth creation. But if you think that is all there is to increase, then you do not yet understand the ways of God.

The first man God created practised none of these systems, yet he was born into abundance.

That means God Himself empowers people.

“Thou shalt remember the Lord thy God: for it is he that giveth thee power to get wealth...” — *Deuteronomy 8:18 (KJV)*

God Gives Power to Get Wealth

Go and look at all the men God called. Abraham—God brought him into wealth. Now, Abraham was not really poor, but God gave him many times more than he had. And when Abraham was old, to show you that it was not merely his hard work, the Bible said in Genesis 24:1:

“And Abraham was old, and well stricken in age: and the Lord had blessed Abraham in all things.”

So Abraham was hardworking, but the Lord blessed him. Even Abraham himself said when they wanted to give him the spoils of war:

“I will not take from a thread even to a shoelatchet... lest thou shouldest say, I have made Abram rich.” — *Genesis 14:23 (KJV)*

Abraham knew where his increase came from. I know there are many doctrines today where people say God does not bless people materially. But God expects you to use what you labour for to advance His Kingdom.

If God does not bless people materially, then why does He bless them health-wise? If it is all about salvation, holiness, and making heaven, then why did the Bible say clearly:

“But thou shalt remember the Lord thy God: for it is he that giveth thee power to get wealth...” — *Deuteronomy 8:18 (KJV)*

The “power to get wealth” there is the same understanding Abraham carried when he said no man would claim credit for making him rich. Paul also spoke about this in 2 Corinthians 9. If you read from verse 6 to 8, he likened prosperity to the way a farmer sows and reaps:

“He which soweth sparingly shall reap also sparingly...” — *2 Corinthians 9:6 (KJV)*

He was referring to tangible things. Then in verse 8 he said:

“And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work.” — *2 Corinthians 9:8 (KJV)*

So there is a grace God gives people that causes them to abound in resources.

That grace gives inspiration.

That grace gives wisdom.

That grace gives strategy.

That grace gives favour.

You may not pick money up in your bedroom, but grace can open your understanding to opportunities. Grace can connect you with people whose hearts are open toward you.

Some people think wealth only comes through intelligence and strategic relationships. But even relationships require favour. You may meet the right people and still never gain access to them unless grace speaks for you.

In Esther 5:2, Esther broke protocol and entered the king’s court uninvited. According to the law, she should have died.

But the king said:

“What wilt thou, queen Esther? and what is thy request? it shall be even given thee to the half of the kingdom.” — *Esther 5:3 (KJV)*

Is that normal economic law? No. That is favour.

I am not saying you should be idle. Paul said:

“If any would not work, neither should he eat.” — *2 Thessalonians 3:10 (KJV)*

The Bible does not encourage laziness.

In fact, laziness negates enlargement.

But while you are diligent, you must understand that there are graces that lift men. And this year, that grace will come upon you because there is enlargement in the area of resources and wealth. When we speak of fruitfulness, we are talking about the ability to produce uncommon results—results that create legacies.

When God told Adam:

“Be fruitful, and multiply...” — *Genesis 1:28 (KJV)*

Adam already lived in a garden that had everything. So fruitfulness is not merely about money. It is about uncommon impact. In 2026, God will cause you to produce uncommon results. That is why Isaiah 54:1 says the barren shall sing and break forth with children. It is uncommon for a barren person not only to have a child but children.

Some of you in your field will rise from the back to the front. Some of you will overtake everybody. Some of you will rise from the bottom and become the head. They may envy you, but there is nothing they can do because it is your year of enlargement. People you once called mentors will begin calling you to ask how you are doing what you do. That is uncommon result. When people you once admired begin studying you secretly to learn from you, that is enlargement. Somebody said to me recently:

“You are doing ministry like someone who has done this for thirty years.”

I told him, “Please don’t hype me.”

But he continued: “Who does two crusades in one week without hiring equipment? Everything is already available.”

One camera alone costs thousands of pounds. Yet God keeps supplying. And I said to him: “The help of Yahweh.”

Paul said: “Having therefore obtained help of God, I continue unto this day...” — *Acts 26:22 (KJV)*

I am not smart. I am helped. And that is why I do everything with humility.

Declaration: You Will Generate Uncommon Results

I prophesy over you: you will generate uncommon results this year. Some of you will open five centres this year in different nations. Some of you will enter meetings and cripples will stand before you pray.

Some businesses will produce more turnover this year than they have produced in ten years combined.

It is called fruitfulness.

“Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it...” —
Genesis 1:28 (KJV)

You have done certain things for years with only family members encouraging you. But the results will change now.

“And the Gentiles shall come to thy light, and kings to the brightness of thy rising.” — *Isaiah 60:3 (KJV)*

You will generate uncommon results.

That building you struggled to complete for ten years—you will not only finish it, you may begin estate projects.

Believe it.



Enlargement in Intimacy with God

Finally, another area of enlargement is your walk with God. There are people who have not prayed alone for two hours in years. Their prayer lives are dead. Some cannot study one chapter of the Bible without sleeping.

Some have not heard God speak in years. But see what God will do with you this year:

Every day, you will hear God. Your passion for God will return. Your appetite for spiritual things will grow. In fact, if you are not enlarged in intimacy, every other enlargement is a mirage.

Jesus said:

“Abide in me, and I in you... He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit...” — *John 15:4-5 (KJV)*

So God will enlarge your intimacy. He will become your friend. You will no longer depend entirely on prophets to hear God for you. Every prophetic word will become a confirmation of what God has already told you personally.

That is enlargement.

Men Who Entered the Depths of God

Moses was so enlarged in intimacy that even when God hid Himself, Moses found Him.

“And Moses drew near unto the thick darkness where God was.” — *Exodus 20:21 (KJV)*

Moses understood the pathways of God. He knew the dimensions of prayer, fasting, brokenness, and consecration required to touch certain realms. When he came down from the mountain after forty days and forty nights, the Bible said:

“The skin of his face shone...” — *Exodus 34:29 (KJV)*

The glory of God had rubbed off on him. Enoch walked with God until it became unlawful for him to remain among men.

“And Enoch walked with God: and he was not; for God took him.” — *Genesis 5:24 (KJV)*

Samuel carried such presence that even Saul, while in rebellion, entered the circumference of that atmosphere and began to prophesy.

That is what intimacy can produce.

Some of you this year will step into dimensions in God. If you tell someone, “You are blessed,” the blessing will manifest. Not because it is a religious cliché, but because realms have been granted to you. Moses knew the ways of God. Abraham walked with God until God Himself called Abraham His friend. Some of us this year will enter realms where our appetite for God becomes insatiable.

You will seek Him and search for Him until something is entrusted to you for your generation. That is supernatural enlargement.

The Glory of Transformation

“But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed...” — *2 Corinthians 3:18 (KJV)*

Some of you will walk into your family and ancient curses will break simply because you arrived carrying divine presence. You will not need to announce yourself. You will come with dimensions of God. Patterns will break. Altars will collapse. Bondages will end.

I read my Bible and saw fornicators become carriers of deity. I saw murderers become apostles. I saw fearful men become veterans in the Spirit.

Why?

Because dimensions opened to them. Some of you this year will become embodiments of realms. You will enter places and atmospheres will change. Fire will enter markets because you entered there. Light will invade systems because you appeared there.

There are inheritances waiting in the realms of light. There are garments waiting for you. There are dimensions waiting for you.

Job said:

“When the secret of God was upon my tabernacle... By his light I walked through darkness.” — *Job 29:4-3 (KJV)*

A generation is rising that will carry dimensions in God. Your voice will become like rain to your generation. Some of you will be perfumed with the fragrances of heaven. Some will carry fresh oil. Some will become custodians of divine oracles. Your voice will become liberation to a generation.

This is the year of supernatural enlargement.

“Lift your hands toward heaven. The heavens over you are open. The garment of heaviness is destroyed. Step into dimensions that are immortal and begin to extract from those realms until your appearance is likened to the similitude of those dimensions. Receive that grace now.”

The preacher declared that some people were being clothed with authority — authority to take over sectors, systems, governance, academics, real estate, and economic structures. He spoke prophetically of divine influence and unusual speed.

“There is a grace for speed, a grace for influence. You will overrun your enemies. You will go ahead of your generation.”

He proclaimed the breaking of limitations, reproach, and stagnation.

“Somebody that has been tied to one spot for ten years, they are breaking now. Doors of opportunities, doors to new dimensions — receive it now in the name of Jesus.”

The declaration continued:

“In this year, God will enlarge you on every side. Your mouth is enlarged over your enemies. He has broken the bow of the mighty. He has caused the strong to stumble. By the Spirit of the Lord, He has lifted the beggar from the dust and the poor from the dunghill to sit among princes and to inherit thrones.”



Forces That Hinder Enlargement

The preacher then outlined major hindrances to enlargement.

1. Smallness of Vision and Mentality

In Numbers 13:31–33, Israel saw themselves as grasshoppers before giants. Because of this mentality, they could not enter their inheritance.

“Grasshoppers cannot take over the heritage of giants.”

God had to raise another generation with a renewed mindset. He referenced Abraham, whom God took outside to look at the stars in Genesis 15:5–6 in order to enlarge his mentality. “If your mentality is myopic, you cannot be enlarged.”

2. Pride and Self-Sufficiency

James 4:6 declares that God resists the proud but gives grace to the humble. “If you want to be enlarged this year, you must pay the price to attain brokenness by the help of God.”

The preacher warned against arrogance and self-exaltation. “All this putting up your shoulder like a peacock — you will go nowhere. Let your impact speak for you.”

3. Disobedience and Compromise

Isaiah 1:19 teaches that willingness and obedience are prerequisites for enjoying the good of the land. The preacher referenced 1 Samuel 15:22–23, where rebellion is likened to witchcraft.

“Every rebellious person, the Bible says, dwells in a desolate land.”

4. Spiritual Laziness and Inconsistency

“You don’t get enlarged by sleeping. You get enlarged by working with your hands.” The preacher lamented the laziness of a generation seeking quick results without discipline or labour.

“In the days of the fathers, they knew the place of hard work and gave themselves to it. We are a generation on a speed lane.”

5. Unresolved Sin and Defilement

Using Achan as an example from Joshua 7, he explained that one man’s sin brought reproach upon an entire nation.

“When a man lives in sin, he does not only limit himself — he limits the company he is part of.”

Isaiah 59:1–2 was cited to show that sin separates men from God and blocks divine help. “If you want God to truly lift you this year, do away with secret sin.”

6. Wrong Associations and Counsel

The preacher referenced Psalm 1:1–3 and 1 Corinthians 15:33.

“Anybody who sincerely wants to be enlarged this year must do away with defilement, secret sins, and wrong associations.”

Precursors to Enlargement

1. Divine Instructions

Before God promised Abraham greatness, He first gave him instructions. “Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father’s house.”

The preacher explained that enlargement follows obedience. “The moment you obey, then there is possibility for enlargement.”

2. Prayer, Travail, and Intercession

Jabez was highlighted as a man who travailed in prayer for enlargement. “Jabez became so great that the elders of Israel gathered themselves and said, ‘Come and lead us.’”

Isaiah 66:8 was quoted:

“As soon as Zion travailed, she brought forth her children.”

The preacher declared:

“You want to be big this year? Let your altar come alive. That is where inspiration comes from. That is where empowerment comes from.”

3. Faithfulness in Little Things

“If you are not faithful in little, you cannot be faithful in much.”

The preacher rebuked carelessness, dishonesty, and irresponsibility. “You are an apprentice and you want to steal your boss’s money. Is that your way to enlargement?”

He stressed that preparation and faithfulness are non-negotiable.

4. Separation and Consecration

2 Timothy 2:19–20 was referenced to show that vessels prepared for honour must purify themselves. “If you want God to enlarge you, it must be clear that you belong to God.”

The preacher warned against living for validation and attention. “Don’t be everywhere this year. Go where you are needed.”

5. Hunger and Desire

“Through desire, a man, having separated himself, seeketh and intermeddleth with all wisdom.”

The preacher emphasised spiritual hunger and pursuit. “The things that make for enlargement are not in the public; they are in the secret place.”

6. Discernment of Times and Seasons

Everything in life has timing. “There is a time to pray. There is a time to fast. There is a time to invest. There is a time to serve.”

The preacher referenced the sons of Issachar who understood the times and knew what Israel ought to do. “You cannot be enlarged if you miss timing.”

Principles of Enlargement

Hard Work

“Even God said He will bless the work of your hands.”

The preacher stressed diligence and responsibility.

“If you have nothing doing, there is nothing to enlarge.”

Death to Self

“Except a grain of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it abides alone.”

He taught on self-denial, delayed gratification, and dying to fleshly desires.

“Some of you will die to applause. Some of you will die to sexual pleasure. Some of you will die to the things inconsistent with God’s purpose for your life.”

Integrity in Relationships

The preacher warned against being parasitic in relationships.

“Relationships do not work like that. You must bring value to the table.”

He taught that enlargement requires sincerity, honour, loyalty, and integrity.

The Seven Relationships of Destiny

The preacher briefly revisited teachings on destiny relationships.

Midwives

“Those are the people who discern your vision and help birth it.”

Burden Bearers

“They may not be seen, but they are carrying the weight of what you are doing.”

Divine Connectors

He referenced the servant girl who connected Naaman to Elisha.

“They may not look influential, but they connect you to gatekeepers.”

Gatekeepers

“Nehemiah had Artaxerxes. Esther had Ahasuerus. Joseph had Pharaoh.”

These are people who can change your story with one statement.

Destiny Challengers

“These are people who oppose you or inspire you.”

Some challenge you through resistance; others through inspiration.

Prophetic Coverings

“There are people who may not give you money, but they are the reason devourers and attacks do not come near you.”

The preacher warned against pride and dishonouring spiritual authorities.

Closing Charge

“Be focused. Be committed. Don’t take these things for granted.”

“There is something God wants to use your life to prove this year, and it will take your commitment and connection to make it happen.”
