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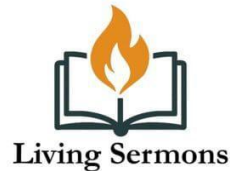

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## *Introduction*

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Tonight, I want to teach again on something that has to do with enlargement, and the Lord has quickened my spirit to talk to us about the necessity of soul winning.

What a way to start the year.

You know I began teaching us last week, and I told us the meaning of enlargement. I showed us the areas where God will enlarge us, and I also showed us the principles that provoke enlargement. There are principles that provoke enlargement, and I believe some of us are already engaging them. Hallelujah.

We took our anchor scripture from Psalm 18:19:

“He brought me forth also into a large place; he delivered me, because he delighted in me.” — Psalm 18:19 (KJV)

That means He has brought me into enlargement.

I told us on Sunday that God is the One who enlarges. It is His desire for you to be enlarged. There is no glory in being small. You cannot help humanity as much. You cannot do much for God. You cannot even do much for yourself.

So, one of the many things God does is that He empowers you for enlargement.

And in case you are not catching it, He went further and encouraged you to expect it. So, do not just be inactive—expect it.

As we saw in Deuteronomy 12:20:

“When the LORD thy God shall enlarge thy border...” — Deuteronomy 12:20  
(KJV)

So, they were looking forward to it.

Do not relax. If you have not seen it, expect it. God enlarges. He wants to enlarge you, and He mandates you to expect it.

And then, in case that has not gotten to you, He now made it a law that you should be enlarged.

Isaiah 54:1–3 says:

“Sing, O barren, thou that didst not bear; break forth into singing, and cry aloud...” — Isaiah 54:1 (KJV)

Then verse two says:

“Enlarge the place of thy tent, and let them stretch forth the curtains of thine habitations: spare not, lengthen thy cords, and strengthen thy stakes.” —  
Isaiah 54:2 (KJV)

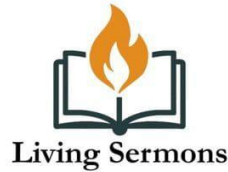
God is saying, “I enlarge, and I expect you to expect Me to enlarge you.”

Many things God wants to do depend on your enlargement.

Deuteronomy 8:18 says:

“But thou shalt remember the LORD thy God: for it is he that giveth thee power to get wealth...” — Deuteronomy 8:18 (KJV)

So, when God enlarges you, a lot depends on it.



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## *Enlargement Beyond Personal Ambition*

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I remember ten years ago, we had so much passion to win souls. But sometimes, in a whole year, if we had done so much, we would have won ten thousand souls. This came with many weeks and months of fasting, many strategies, visitations, street evangelism—all the things you know to do. We did them and ended with ten thousand souls.

Today, we win hundreds of thousands in a year because the bigger you become, the more impactful you are. Some of you seated here, there is so much you want to do for God. There is so much you want to do for humanity. There are people seated here this evening whose ambition is to build orphanages or sponsor orphans, but as we speak, they cannot even feed themselves. So, it remains a desire without manifestation.

When God says, “I want to enlarge you,” it is an empowerment beyond personal ambition. He wants to use you as His battle axe, as His weapon of war.

And so, everyone connected to this movement in 2026 must make up their minds to be enlarged. It is not something you are merely thinking about. You are implicated for enlargement. And I prophesy to you that at this moment, a grace comes upon you for enlargement.

This is not ambition.

This is not a quest for materialism or fame. The Bible says if you have food to eat, clothes to wear, and a place to lay your head, you should be content.

What we are talking about here is empowerment to glorify God on a larger scale. It is empowerment to help humanity. It is empowerment to bring transformation to people, territories, systems, and nations. Because you cannot leave this world merely as an individual.

You are permitted to come as an individual, but when you leave here, the least you are permitted to leave as is a city.

Jesus said:

“Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid.” —  
Matthew 5:14 (KJV)

But some of us will leave as nations.

God said to Abraham:

“In thee shall all nations be blessed.” — Genesis 18:18 (KJV)

So, if you do not leave as a nation, at least leave as a city. Within you are chambers of blessings of various kinds—supernatural blessings, material blessings, mental and intellectual blessings.

In the name of Jesus Christ, let the grace that empowers rest upon you now.

Who says you cannot build hospitals?

Who says you cannot build schools?

Who says you cannot establish investments that will employ many people?

Who says that on account of your walk with God, many should not encounter destiny?

By the power that created all things, let there be a re-engineering for greatness.

Nobody in your lineage may have amounted to anything before now. First generation. Second generation. Third generation. Fourth generation.

But a new generation is about to be born. I sense an anointing right now as I speak. There is a fire coming upon someone.

One is for wisdom.

One is for open doors.

Another is for speed.

Whatever has stopped people in your bloodline, I stand here as a priest and decree their cancellation.

Let that fire come upon you from the crown of your head to the soles of your feet. I break limitations. The chains that held you back are destroyed now. Every utterance against you, every curse against you, every ordinance against you—I overturn them by the Spirit.

Come out from the pit. It is a new beginning for someone. Go and write it down: this is your birthday into a new season. New dimensions.

New graces.

New possibilities.



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## *Six Areas of Enlargement*

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### **1. Territorial Enlargement**

One of the major areas of enlargement is your territory. Every context in which your life should be consequential, God amplifies it. For some of you, it will be demographic territory. Something will happen to you, and suddenly your life will begin to affect people of all ages, classes, and backgrounds.

For some, it will be physical geography. From that one spot where you have remained for years, God will amplify you. What you are doing will break out of Africa, break into Europe, and break into the Americas. When you travel, you will not travel as a tourist. You will go as a significant entity carrying influence.

People's decisions, philosophies, and ideologies will be altered because capacity has been enlarged.

Genesis 13:14–15 says:

“Lift up now thine eyes... for all the land which thou seest, to thee will I give it.” — Genesis 13:14–15 (KJV)

And Genesis 12:2–3 says:

“In thee shall all families of the earth be blessed.” — Genesis 12:3 (KJV)

I speak over someone: in thee shall nations be blessed. This is not a lecture theatre. This is the Ecclesia. This is a spiritual gate where legislations and spiritual administrations take place. And I stand here as a priest and bring you the administration of the blessings of the Lord.

Let your territories be enlarged now. Not by power, nor by might, but by the Spirit of God. The season of remaining confined to one locality is over.

Acts 1:8 says:

“Ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.” — Acts 1:8 (KJV)

I speak to your territories.

I speak to your borders.

I command your limitations to fade away.

Let your territories enlarge.

## **2. Enlargement in Influence and Authority**

Influence is not popularity. You can be popular and still not be influential. Influence is having a voice that can compel leadership. It is credibility upon which transactions happen. When your name is mentioned, doors open.

When your name is mentioned, things change. Not just among men, but even among spirits. Influence is the ability to command leadership such that a generation can say, “In your light, we have seen light.”

When God enlarges you, He adds influence to your life. Your voice no longer echoes; your voice becomes a force. When you speak, systems change. When you speak, doors open. When you speak, decisions are altered.

Daniel 6:3 says:

“Then this Daniel was preferred above the presidents and princes...” —  
Daniel 6:3 (KJV)

Daniel carried influence so powerful that kingdoms depended on him. When mysterious writings appeared on the wall and nobody understood them, Daniel came from the secret place and interpreted mysteries.

He judged kings by the wisdom of God. Some of you will speak, and curses that have existed in your families for decades will break. Some of you will speak, and limitations over systems and territories will collapse. I see horns being exalted by the anointing.

“My horn shalt thou exalt like the horn of an unicorn...” — Psalm 92:10  
(KJV)

Receive that oil now.

### **3. Enlargement in Capacity**

The third area where God enlarges you is in capacity.

Spiritual capacity.

Mental capacity.

Visionary capacity.

Some of us have minds that are too narrow.

Everything is “me, myself, and I.”

But God wants a nation.

Hannah thought she was praying for a son because of her contention with Peninnah, but God was looking for a prophet.

Your limited capacity can limit God.

Ephesians 3:20 says:

“Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us.” — Ephesians 3:20 (KJV)

So, when God wants to increase you, He enlarges your capacity.

Ezekiel 36:26 says:

“A new heart also will I give you...” — Ezekiel 36:26 (KJV)

God is about to break limited mindsets.

Some of you grew up where scarcity was normal, and so you unconsciously accepted limitation as a lifestyle.

But God is about to show you that from one location, you can affect nations. There is a realm of abundance where you do not need to hoard for survival. The liberal soul shall be made fat. There is a realm where God makes you a blessing to territories and nations.

## *The Supernatural Dimension of Enlargement*

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Some of you were not raised in environments where miracles happened. So, when these things are spoken, your mind struggles to process them. But hear the answer:

“The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee...” — Luke 1:35 (KJV)

If a virgin can conceive, then no limitation is final.

Ten or eleven years ago, I was the Head of Department of Chemistry in a secondary school. My idea of revival was gathering students during break periods and ministering to them. Then one day, while fasting in the laboratory, I entered into a trance.

I saw an eagle bigger than a building. It flapped its wings and entered nations. Within seventeen days, invitations came from over ten nations of the earth. What changed?

The Holy Ghost came upon me. It happens by the Spirit. Tonight, somebody is changing gears—from the natural into the supernatural.

## **4. Enlargement in Resources**

Another area where God enlarges you is in resources. Job 22:24 says:

“Then shalt thou lay up gold as dust...” — Job 22:24 (KJV)

There is a realm where wealth becomes like dust. Not because money magically appears, but because God gives strategy, wisdom, favour, ideas, and divine opportunities.

Deuteronomy 8:18 says:

“For it is he that giveth thee power to get wealth...” — Deuteronomy 8:18  
(KJV)

That power is wisdom.

That power is inspiration.

That power is favour.

That power is supernatural energy.

Suddenly, God gives you ideas others cannot see.

You enter a field and become indispensable.

Why?

Because there is a Kingdom to be advanced, and God advances it through empowered men.

Paul said:

“But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.” — Philippians 4:19 (KJV)

I speak over someone: your life is changing, and the difference will be like night and day.

## **5. Enlargement in Fruitfulness**

Fruitfulness is not merely having material things.

When God told Adam to be fruitful, Adam was already in Eden.

Genesis 1:28 says:

“Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it...” —  
Genesis 1:28 (KJV)

Fruitfulness is undeniable impact.

It is getting to the point where your life becomes so consequential that your absence will be felt.

You are no longer part of the number they count.

You become a significant entity.

Not only in church, but in the world.

There are people today whose absence from certain nations would affect the economy of those nations because they are that consequential.

That is the dimension of fruitfulness God wants to bring you into.

There are people that if you remove them from a nation today, the spiritual atmosphere of that nation will suffer a setback. It will be like a vacuum.

Isaiah 56:10 says:

“His watchmen are blind: they are all ignorant...” — Isaiah 56:10 (KJV)

If a watchman departs and another watchman does not arise, there will be spiritual implications.

So, when God wants to enlarge you, He gives you capacity for fruitfulness. You become so impactful that your absence is not something anyone wants to imagine.

The economy will suffer.

The government will suffer.

The church will suffer because you are withdrawn.

It may take years for the void your absence creates to be filled.

That is how to live your life.

Paul said:

“For to me to live is Christ...” — Philippians 1:21 (KJV)

He said he was caught between two desires: to depart and be with Christ, which was far better for him personally, or to remain for the sake of the believers.

That is a man whose life had become consequential.

Paul told the Ephesian church in Acts 20:29–30:

“For I know this, that after my departing shall grievous wolves enter in among you...” — Acts 20:29 (KJV)

In other words, his presence restrained darkness.

You will not merely be a church member.

You will become an indispensable kingdom entity.

Not only in the church, but in the nation where you are planted.

This is what God means when He says He will enlarge you.

## *Enlargement That Swallows Limitations*

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Some of you have fought battles all your lives. You go for a job interview, opposition follows you there. You sleep, and oppression follows you into your dreams. You want to marry, resistance rises. You start a business, warfare begins.

But something is about to erupt from within you that will drown every opposition. You will stand and say:

“I was minding my business. You were the one calling my name in strange places. But now the forest has caught fire.”

There is a dimension of power that swallows every contention. Some of you came into this service discouraged and almost empty. But you are leaving fully charged. You came worried about rent; now you are speaking about building houses.

That is prophecy.

And when prophecy goes forth, even dry bones rise again.

Joshua 6:20 says:

“So the people shouted... and the wall fell down flat...” — Joshua 6:20 (KJV)

Every wall blocking your advancement is sinking right now by the Spirit. You are enlarged in the name of Jesus. By March, some of you will look at your lives and wonder what happened. Suddenly, ministry has fifty branches.

Suddenly, your income multiplies. Suddenly, influence increases.

Why?

Because something happened inside you. You were enlarged. You entered as an individual, but you are leaving as a system. You are leaving as a city. You are leaving as a nation.

## **6. Enlargement in Intimacy**

The sixth area of enlargement is intimacy. God will open you up to encounters. Things you once only heard about or read in books will become your reality. Moses ascended Mount Sinai and entered dimensions where mortality itself seemed suspended.

There are places in God where natural limitations lose their hold. You may enter your room to pray and emerge hours—or even days—later without realizing how much time has passed.

Exodus 34:29 says:

“Moses wist not that the skin of his face shone...” — Exodus 34:29 (KJV)

He had become a carrier of divine glory. That is intimacy. God will give you appetites for Him and for His realm. There are dimensions in God where, the moment you close your eyes, heaven opens.

God will begin to reveal things before they happen. He will show you the future of territories and nations. This is not rebellion against spiritual authority—it is kingdom partnership.

The body grows stronger when many believers carry divine burdens. Imagine a church where prophets, intercessors, worshippers, kingdom financiers, and reformers all operate from deep intimacy with God.

That is apostolic Christianity. When the choir ministers, wells of inspiration open. The businessman receives strategies. The sick are healed at the door. Depression disappears during greetings. That was the reality of the early church. Acts 6 and Acts 8 reveal that even deacons became carriers of power. Philip, who began as one assigned to serve tables, entered Samaria and shook an entire city.

Why?

Because everybody had a deep relationship with God.

The time has come when fasting will not only happen because the church announced it. There are dimensions of God that will compel you into deeper consecration. You may fast because God is preparing you for governmental authority. You may pray because heaven is clothing you for future battles.

2 Corinthians 3:18 says:

“But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image...” — 2 Corinthians 3:18 (KJV)

The word “changed” speaks of metamorphosis. An egg becomes a winged creature. A crawling caterpillar becomes a butterfly. What happened?

Transformation through process. There are dimensions asleep within you that only intimacy can awaken. Isaiah 40:31 says:

“But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles...” — Isaiah 40:31 (KJV)

You have wings, but they are dormant. You have dimensions, but they are unopened. As you stay with God, those dimensions begin to unfold. You will begin to walk in precision and supernatural accuracy.

You will know what to do, who to speak to, where to go, and when to move. You will carry intelligence from another realm. But this kind of life requires spiritual hunger. You cannot remain in shallow Christianity and experience enlargement. When God wants to enlarge you, He begins to draw you deeper.

There is a place where men are forged in the furnaces of the Spirit. There are mysteries that are not taught intellectually—they are caught through pursuit.

Psalm 80:18 says:

“Quicken us, and we will call upon thy name.” — Psalm 80:18 (KJV)

There is something God will awaken in you this year. Seeking Him will become sweeter than worldly pleasure. Song of Solomon 1:2 says:

“Let him kiss me with the kisses of his mouth: for thy love is better than wine.” — Song of Solomon 1:2 (KJV)

God will introduce you to the sweetness of His presence. He will give you access to the perfumes of the Spirit. Exodus 20:21 says:

“And Moses drew near unto the thick darkness where God was.” — Exodus 20:21 (KJV)

There are men who follow God even into hidden places. This year, your greatest asset will be the presence of God.

## *Enlargement in the Work of God*

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Finally, God enlarges you in His work. Jesus spoke about a rich man and called him a fool because he was rich toward men but not toward God. When God enlarges you, He enlarges your participation in His agenda.

Do not become big in the world and tiny in the Kingdom. Those who are great in worldly pursuits but insignificant in Kingdom labour have misunderstood priorities.

There are two major works God is doing on the earth:

1. Saving souls
2. Transforming lives

God saves lost souls, then transforms them into mature believers who enforce His Kingdom on the earth.

Matthew 6:10 says:

“Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.” —  
Matthew 6:10 (KJV)

If you will be great in the works of God, you must be involved in soul winning.

Proverbs 11:30 says:

“He that winneth souls is wise.” — Proverbs 11:30 (KJV)

Matthew 6:33 says:

“But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness...” — Matthew  
6:33 (KJV)

Many people pursue additions instead of priorities.

But God's primary business is building men and building His church. Acts 20:32 says:

“I commend you to God, and to the word of his grace, which is able to build you up...” — Acts 20:32 (KJV)

Jesus also said:

“I will build my church...” — Matthew 16:18 (KJV)

The church is not merely structures. The church is a spiritual congregation of men enforcing the will and wisdom of God over territories. Anyone who is not aggressively involved in this work has not yet understood true enlargement.

Matthew 5:16 says:

“Let your light so shine before men...” — Matthew 5:16 (KJV)

Every believer must become a participant in the enterprise of soul winning.



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## *Why the Soul Matters to God*

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### **1. A Soul Is Worth More Than the Whole World**

Mark 8:36–37 says:

“For what shall it profit a man, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul?” — Mark 8:36 (KJV)

A soul is worth more to God than the entire world. When God values something above all creation, wisdom demands that we value it too.

### **2. The Soul Bears the Image of God**

Genesis 1:26 says:

“Let us make man in our image...” — Genesis 1:26 (KJV)

Every soul carries the image of divinity. When you win souls, you are rescuing image-bearers from eternal destruction.

### **3. God Paid for Souls With His Own Life**

John 3:16 says:

“For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son...” — John 3:16 (KJV)

The value God places on a soul is equal to the value of His Son. We were not purchased with silver or gold, but with the precious blood of Jesus Christ. If God values souls this much, how can we ignore them?

How can we claim to love God while neglecting what He values most?

## **4. Every Soul Belongs to God**

Ezekiel 18:4 says:

“Behold, all souls are mine...” — Ezekiel 18:4 (KJV)

Every soul belongs to God.

So, when you preserve and disciple souls, you are stewarding God’s possession.

## **5. One Soul Can Trigger Joy in Heaven**

Luke 15:7 says:

“There is joy in heaven over one sinner that repenteth...” — Luke 15:7 (KJV)

One soul can cause celebration in heaven.

Not ten souls.

One soul.

That is how valuable a soul is before God.

## *The Responsibility of Every Believer*

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Paul said after preaching the Gospel:

“I am pure from the blood of all men.” — Acts 20:26 (KJV)

Ezekiel 3:18 warns that if we fail to warn the wicked, their blood can be required at our hands. Soul winning is not only for evangelists. Mark 16:15–16 commands every believer to preach the Gospel.

Now that you are saved, you are expected to become an instrument of salvation to others. We live in a generation where many believers clap for soul winners instead of becoming soul winners themselves.

But Kingdom responsibility belongs to every believer.

## *Why You Must Win Souls*

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### **Do Not Make the Death of Jesus Meaningless**

Jesus died to reconcile humanity back to the Father. 2 Corinthians 5:19 says:

“God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself...” — 2 Corinthians 5:19 (KJV)

Then He committed to us the ministry of reconciliation. In essence, Jesus is saying: “I died for them. Now take the message to them.”

After Jesus resurrected, Peter returned to fishing. Jesus had to appear to him again because Peter was abandoning Kingdom priority. Jesus was not against career or business. But career must become a platform for Kingdom advancement.

The death of Jesus must not become inconsequential through our indifference. Christ paid for souls with His blood. Our responsibility is to ensure that those He paid for are reached with the Gospel. That is the necessity of soul winning.

Jesus paid the ultimate price of death to save souls from destruction. Soul winning is not optional for the believer; it is a divine responsibility.

### **1. The Value of a Soul**

Souls matter deeply to God. Christ died so that men would not perish. We cannot allow the sacrifice of Jesus to be in vain.

### **2. We Do Not Want the Death of Jesus to Be Wasted**

Every soul rescued from darkness validates the labour of Calvary. We preach because His sacrifice must bear fruit in men's lives.

### **3. Soul Winning Is a Command**

*“Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.”* — Mark 16:15 (KJV)

The early Church called it the Great Commission because it was not a suggestion. It was a command.

Paul said:

*“Necessity is laid upon me; yea, woe is unto me, if I preach not the gospel!”*  
— 1 Corinthians 9:16 (KJV)

To refuse soul winning is rebellion against God.

## 4. Soul Winning Activates Wisdom

*“He that winneth souls is wise.”* — Proverbs 11:30 (KJV)

Soul winners carry unusual wisdom. God preserves fruitful branches because He desires more fruit from them. Wisdom is not merely possessing information. Wisdom is the productive application of knowledge. It is the capacity to execute truth effectively and obtain results.

*“By me kings reign...”* — Proverbs 8:15 (KJV)

When you win souls:

- You reign in life.
- You dominate by wisdom.
- You become productive.
- You walk in divine guidance.
- You carry dominion.

No genuine soul winner lives a wasted life.

## 5. Soul Winning Is for Every Believer

Soul winning is not only for pastors, evangelists, or the poor. It is for every child of God. If you desire enlargement in life, become committed to bringing souls into the Kingdom. There are different dimensions of soul winning:

- Some win souls through prayer.
- Some through going out to preach.
- Some through giving and sponsoring Kingdom projects.

Even Jesus’ ministry was supported by people’s resources.

*“And certain women... ministered unto him of their substance.”* — Luke 8:3 (KJV). One way or another, every believer must participate.

## *The Sacrifice of Soul Winning*

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Soul winning is not always convenient. There are villages where internet access is nearly impossible. There are difficult roads, dangerous territories, mosquitoes, darkness, and uncertainty.

Yet men still go because souls matter to God. The consolation is this: if a man dies in the field of Kingdom labour, he died serving eternal purpose.

### **Eternal Rewards Await Soul Winners**

*“And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever.”* — Daniel 12:3 (KJV)

Soul winners do not merely hope to enter Heaven; they carry eternal reward. Paul declared confidently:

*“I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith.”* — 2 Timothy 4:7 (KJV)

There is a crown reserved for faithful labourers in the Kingdom. A man who has spent his life bringing multitudes into the Kingdom will not enter eternity unnoticed.

### **Soul Winning Releases Supplies**

*“Through prosperity shall my cities yet be spread abroad...”* — Zechariah 1:17 (KJV)

God supplies those committed to His Kingdom. Resources can come through:

- Business opportunities
- Divine favour
- Open doors
- Strategic relationships
- Wealth-creating ideas
- Supernatural inspiration

Soul winning provokes favour. There are contracts, opportunities, and doors that open because God backs those who labour for Him. Education is valuable, but there are spiritual forces that influence outcomes in life. Soul winning positions a believer ahead of his peers through divine favour and wisdom.

## **The Presence of God Accompanies Soul Winners**

*“And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them...”* — Mark 16:20 (KJV)

One of the guarantees of divine presence is obedience to the Great Commission. When God is with a man:

- Signs and wonders become natural.
- Wisdom flows freely.
- Preservation becomes evident.
- Dominion manifests.

The power of God can manifest in ministry, business, academics, medicine, leadership, and every sphere of life.

## **Soul Winning Produces Maturity**

*“My little children, of whom I travail in birth again until Christ be formed in you.”* — Galatians 4:19 (KJV)

When you begin winning souls, you become a spiritual parent. Maturity is not merely spiritual age. Maturity means God can entrust responsibilities, graces, authority, and Kingdom assignments to you. Soul winning accelerates spiritual growth.

## *The Scope of Soul Winning*

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There are two dimensions of soul winning:

1. **Horizontal Scope** — magnitude of impact.
2. **Vertical Scope** — depth of transformation.

### **Horizontal Scope**

Every relationship is a platform for evangelism.

## **2. Systems and Territories**

*“This gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world...”* — Matthew 24:14 (KJV)

God empowers believers to influence systems, institutions, territories, and nations.

## **3. Global Impact**

*“Go ye into all the world...”* — Mark 16:15 (KJV)

Some believers carry a global mandate that affects the nations of the earth.

## **4. Generational Impact**

*“I will make thee an eternal excellency, a joy of many generations.”* — Isaiah 60:15 (KJV)

A true Kingdom life continues influencing souls even after physical death. The preacher referenced Reinhard Bonnke as an example of generational impact, noting that millions of souls were won through his ministry.

## *The Depth of Soul Winning*

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Soul winning is not complete until believers are disciplined and empowered to disciple others. The process includes:

1. Making the Gospel understandable.
2. Bringing people into faith.
3. Discipling them in the ways of Christ.
4. Sending them out as witnesses.

This is the pattern:

**Win. Build. Send.**

An apostolic Church is not merely a gathering Church; it is a sending Church.

Believers are sent into:

- Ministry
- Business
- Academia
- Media
- Government
- Culture

Every believer must become a witness.

## *Living for Eternity*

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The preacher described the glorious departure of saints who fulfilled their assignment on earth.

Those who serve God faithfully do not leave the earth carelessly. They finish their mission with honour, fulfilment, and eternal reward.

*“Well done, thou good and faithful servant...”* — Matthew 25:21 (KJV)

## *Prophetic Declarations*

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The following declarations were released during the meeting:

- Grace for soul winning
- Wealth for Kingdom advancement
- Divine favour and open doors
- Restoration of health
- Supernatural wisdom
- Speed and acceleration
- Deliverance from family patterns and reproach

The congregation was charged to become witnesses in their generation and to give themselves wholeheartedly to the advancement of God’s Kingdom.

## *Salvation Call*

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The meeting concluded with an invitation to surrender to Jesus Christ.

The Gospel was clearly presented:

- Jesus is the Son of God.
- He died for the sins of humanity.
- He rose again on the third day.
- Eternal life is received through faith in Him.

Many responded publicly and were led in the prayer of salvation.

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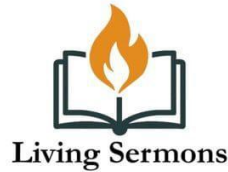
