Introduction

Tonight, I just want to share with us briefly what I have titled *The Protocol of Receiving the Supernatural*, because I have a burden. I want everybody to become a recipient of the supernatural.

We were created to walk in the supernatural. Although we were put in the natural world, we were created to operate in the natural world supernaturally, because our God is a supernatural God.

If you study your Bible, every dispensation of the dealings of God with men was characterized by the supernatural. In Genesis chapter 1 from verse 1, we saw that the very creation of the world was a supernatural enterprise.

The Bible said:

“In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.” — Genesis 1:1
(KJV)

He created everything without raw materials. This very realm is sitting on the supernatural.

The Bible said:

“And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.

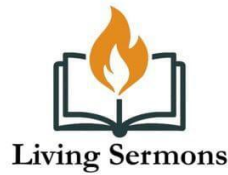
And God said, Let there be light: and there was light.” — Genesis 1:2–3
(KJV)

He created the earth. The earth was ruined by judgment, and He recreated it again. So, the supernatural is not a function of luck. It is a reality that, if understood, can be modelled and replicated at any time.

When you understand how it works, you can demonstrate it any day and at any time.

What God showed us in Genesis chapter 1 is that what He did the first time was not luck. There is a power and there is a protocol that occasions manifestation.

And it has been like that consistently.



A God of Wonders

In Genesis chapter 6, when evil overtook the earth and the earth was destroyed, God recreated the face of the earth again. That is how God functions. He has consistently dealt with humanity in that order.

In fact, when you read the Bible, God introduces Himself as a God of wonders. That is how God wants to be known. Those who walked with Him recognized Him in that fashion.

The challenge today is that many people claim to walk with God while choosing to function only in the natural realm, leaving God in the supernatural.

We are in a generation where there is now a debate about whether the supernatural is still real. Meanwhile, your God introduces Himself as a supernatural God.

He introduces you as a supernatural being.

And He expects your walk with Him to produce supernatural realities.

It is a contradiction in the spirit for a child of a supernatural God, who claims relationship with Him, to live naturally.

That is not how God designed it.

We have become masters in the natural realm. We have even begun advocating that the natural is the only reality.

So much so that when the supernatural is displayed, the first people who doubt it are Christians.

The unfortunate thing is this: the same Christians who doubt the supernatural in the realm of light do not doubt it in darkness.

When they see magic, they accept it.

When they see voodoo, they accept it.

When they see demonic manifestations, they accept it.

But the moment it is done in the name of the Lord, they say it is fake. Meanwhile, they claim their God is supernatural.

The God That Doeth Wonders

Write these scriptures down.

Exodus 15:11

“Who is like unto thee, O LORD, among the gods? who is like thee, glorious in holiness, fearful in praises, doing wonders?” — Exodus 15:11 (KJV)

Moses recognized Him as the God who does wonders. If the one you met does not do wonders, then you did not meet the living God. If you walk this earth without seeing wonders, then you need to investigate the god you claim to serve.

Those who encountered the living God described Him as:

- Glorious in holiness
- Fearful in praises
- Doing wonders

When last did you see your God do wonders in your life?

Something is wrong.

Exodus 34:10

“And he said, Behold, I make a covenant: before all thy people I will do marvels, such as have not been done in all the earth, nor in any nation...” — Exodus 34:10 (KJV)

God Himself declared that His covenant relationship with man was designed to showcase marvels.

He was not introducing dead religion.

He was introducing a relationship characterized by wonders.

Psalm 77:14

“Thou art the God that doest wonders: thou hast declared thy strength among the people.” — Psalm 77:14 (KJV)

Our God is a God of wonders.

And our relationship with Him is expected to produce wonders.

We Are Created for Signs and Wonders

Isaiah 8:18

“Behold, I and the children whom the LORD hath given me are for signs and for wonders in Israel...” — Isaiah 8:18 (KJV)

I do not know about others, but I and the children whom the Lord has given me are for signs and wonders.

And when we say “children,” we are not speaking only biologically.

Anything that comes forth from me is designed for wonders.

This ministry is a wonder. Nothing can kill it.

My business is a wonder. You may hate it, but you cannot stop it.

My career is a wonder. I keep rising because anything that emanates from me is designed for wonders.

Let these truths sink into your consciousness.

The supernatural should not surprise you. That is your realm. That is your reality.

You are the bridge that brings the supernatural into the natural.

Men Greatly Wondered At

Zechariah 3:8

“...for they are men wondered at...” — Zechariah 3:8 (KJV)

When people look at you, they should say:

“These are the people of wonders.”

How can everybody in your office be natural?

When confusion breaks out, nobody should need to wonder who can bring an answer from another dimension.

You and the people who sit with you should be men greatly wondered at.

These Signs Shall Follow

Mark 16:17

“And these signs shall follow them that believe...” — Mark 16:17 (KJV)

Jesus did not send His disciples out with doctrine alone. He sent them out with signs.

Your God is a God of wonders.

You are created for wonders.

Your relationship with Him should produce wonders. Therefore, your life should be filled with wonders.

But we have become too comfortable with the natural. We now have to be taught to believe in the supernatural because this environment has re-educated us. We have been colonized into thinking we are ordinary creatures.

But that is not true.

A New Creation Reality

The Bible says:

“Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature...” — 2 Corinthians 5:17 (KJV)

You are a being from another reality, hosting dimensions from another dispensation within this present world. Yet many believers think only a few selected people can host the supernatural. That is not how God thinks. The same life of God that is in an apostle is in you.

The same faith of Jesus is in you. Operating in wonders is not the privilege of a few.

This is our family heritage. We are children of wonders.

The Demonstration of the Spirit and of Power

Paul said:

“And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power.” — 1 Corinthians 2:4 (KJV)

That is the realm God wants you to live in. Imagine believers everywhere walking in supernatural realities. Imagine someone saying:

“Last night, a bird flew over my house and fell down dead.”

Imagine someone testifying:

“A tumour grew, and I commanded it to dry up. Three days later, it disappeared.”

Imagine someone saying: “My child was convulsing. I laid hands on him and rebuked the devil, and he stood up healed.”

That is a growing church. That is the church Jesus is returning for. Not a church of helpless infants depending entirely on one man.

Every Believer Should Carry Wonders

God gave some to be apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors, and teachers for the equipping of the saints. Yes, there are offices with greater dimensions because of divine assignments. But every believer should carry signs and wonders. In the early church, even ushers were city-takers. Stephen was appointed to serve tables, yet the Bible says mighty signs and wonders were done through him.

Imagine walking into church and an usher greets you, and depression lifts immediately. Imagine an usher shaking your hand and accurately speaking into your life by the Spirit. Nobody would need to beg people to attend church. Church would become home.

Ephesians 2:10 says:

“For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works...” —
Ephesians 2:10 (KJV)

The first man was created from dust. The new creation was created in Christ Jesus. The raw material for your existence is divinity. You were created for supernatural manifestations.

You are not ordinary.

God lives in you.

One Spirit With the Lord

1 Corinthians 6:17

“But he that is joined unto the Lord is one spirit.” — 1 Corinthians 6:17 (KJV)

It did not say you merely have the Lord.

It says you are one spirit with Him.

You are too deeply united with God for separation to be possible.

When people see you, they should see God.

That is the essence of your new creation reality.

Know Your Position in the New Testament

When reading the New Testament, stop seeing yourself as the helpless recipient.

You are not Bartimaeus crying for mercy. You are the carrier of mercy. You are not the woman with the issue of blood. You are the one through whom virtue flows. You are not the one searching for bread. You are the one multiplying bread.

You are not the one looking for a boat. You are the one walking on water. When you read about Bartimaeus, learn his persistence. When you read about the woman with the issue of blood, learn her courage. But understand your position.

1 John 4:17

“...as he is, so are we in this world.” — 1 John 4:17 (KJV)

Not in heaven.

Not after the rapture.

In this world.

All Things Are Yours

Jesus never prayed:

“Father, heal me.”

That prayer does not exist in that realm.

He never prayed:

“Father, deliver me from demons.”

That realm does not accommodate such realities.

The same way a man will never pray for God to open his womb because that reality does not exist in his order, many believers must awaken to the reality of who they are in Christ.

Health is yours.

Favor is yours.

Prosperity is yours.

Lifting is yours.

1 Corinthians 3:21

“...all things are yours.” — 1 Corinthians 3:21 (KJV)

When you enter a territory, the blessing of God has entered that territory. The forces in that land will recognize that a prince has arrived.

Entering Your Reality

A child may crawl for a season, but crawling is not his destiny. Eventually, the child stands, walks, and begins to run. In the same way, many believers are growing into the consciousness of their reality in Christ.

A day will come when sickness attempts to touch you and you will respond with holy indignation:

“How can this survive in me?”

You are a child of God.

You are His weapon of war.

You are an arrow in the quiver of the Almighty.

Do not allow your environment to mentor you into believing you are ordinary. You are not natural. God lives in you.

The fullness of the supernatural dwells within you. And tonight, God is awakening a new consciousness in you. With joy, you will draw waters out of the wells of salvation.

Something is already leaving bodies. Something is already shifting in destinies. You will stand up and discover that light has swallowed darkness.

Something has left you already.

You see, I am now in a valley of decision because this message has one dimension for church people and another dimension for ministers.

There is one for churchgoers, and there is another for carriers.

I am contemplating whether I should teach you the one for ministers.

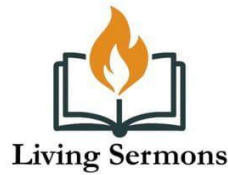
You know what I will do? I will list the protocols for those who receive the supernatural, and then I will list the protocols for those who give the supernatural.

Because when we speak about the supernatural, there are those who receive it, and there are those who administer it.

But I think many of you have shifted already into the realm of giving and not merely receiving.

You have gone higher than the message I originally came with.

So, I will list these things so that you can teach others also.



Protocol One: Discern the Crisis

The first protocol for receiving the supernatural is to discern the crisis. When you are walking in the supernatural, you do not deny facts. You simply refuse facts the right to dominate you.

Denying facts is not deliverance. In many cases, it prolongs suffering. When you recognize the reality of a situation, you position yourself to deal with it correctly.

Recognising the State of Affairs

In Matthew 14, after Jesus left the disciples to pray, the Bible says:

“But the ship was now in the midst of the sea, tossed with waves: for the wind was contrary.” — Matthew 14:24 (KJV)

The first thing they discerned was the reality of their condition.

The wind was contrary.

The sea was raging.

They were in trouble.

You cannot receive the supernatural while pretending problems do not exist.

Faith is not the denial of facts.

Faith is the refusal of facts to dominate you.

God Himself Did Not Ignore Crisis

Even God did not deny the presence of darkness in Genesis.

“And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep...” — Genesis 1:2 (KJV)

God acknowledged the condition, but His attention remained fixed on the solution. Some people deny problems to the point that they even deny satanic activity. That is why they never step into dominion.

Paul said:

“Lest Satan should get an advantage of us: for we are not ignorant of his devices.” — 2 Corinthians 2:11 (KJV)

And Peter warned:

“Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour.” — 1 Peter 5:8 (KJV)

The first protocol of the supernatural is accurate discernment.

Discern:

- Your state
- Your environment
- The crisis
- The limitations around you

If you do not understand where you are, you cannot ascend into where God wants to take you.

Crisis Reveals Your Need for God

The disciples knew they were in the middle of the sea. Swimming was not an option. They knew the wind was contrary. Human effort would not suffice. Their accurate discernment of the crisis revealed their need for God.

Paul described a similar situation:

“For we would not, brethren, have you ignorant of our trouble which came to us in Asia...” — 2 Corinthians 1:8 (KJV)

He said they were pressed beyond measure and despaired even of life.

Then he added:

“But we had the sentence of death in ourselves, that we should not trust in ourselves, but in God which raiseth the dead.” — 2 Corinthians 1:9 (KJV)

When you discern facts accurately, one thing becomes obvious: your urgent need for God.

Many people still trust their intelligence, connections, or natural abilities because they have not truly discerned the extent of their crisis.



Protocol Two: Discern the Presence and the Help of God

Once you discern the state of affairs, do not give up. Let your situation push you toward seeking God. And when God appears, discern His presence.

Many people are struggling because God has already come, yet they have not recognised Him.

Seeking Divine Intervention

The disciples discerned their crisis, and immediately they began looking for divine intervention.

The Bible says:

“And in the fourth watch of the night Jesus went unto them, walking on the sea.” — Matthew 14:25 (KJV)

The moment Jesus appeared, they became alert. Though they did not yet know it was Him, they sensed movement in the spirit.

They cried out:

“It is a spirit.” — Matthew 14:26 (KJV)

Then Jesus spoke:

“Be of good cheer; it is I; be not afraid.” — Matthew 14:27 (KJV)

The Proof That You Have Truly Discerned Your Crisis

The proof that you have discerned your crisis correctly is the intensity with which you seek God. A man who still trusts himself has not truly discerned the seriousness of his situation. But when a person comes to the point where only God can help him, his whole being gravitates toward God.

And when you seek Him with your whole heart, He cannot hide Himself from you.

Abraham and the Posture of Seeking

Abraham reached the point where he knew that unless God intervened, nothing would happen.

So every day he sat in expectation.

“And the LORD appeared unto him in the plains of Mamre...” — Genesis 18:1
(KJV)

The Bible says Abraham sat in the tent door in the heat of the day.

That was the posture of meditation and expectation.

When God appeared disguised as men, Abraham discerned immediately.

“And he lift up his eyes and looked, and, lo, three men stood by him...” —
Genesis 18:2 (KJV)

He ran toward them and bowed.

That was discernment.

He knew:

“My help has arrived.”

Restlessness Produces the Supernatural

Some people are too comfortable in bondage. They are relaxed in warfare. They are casual about affliction. That is why Isaac told Esau:

“...when thou shalt have the dominion, that thou shalt break his yoke from off thy neck.” — Genesis 27:40 (KJV)

The day you become restless, the hand of God will move. Many people have not seen the supernatural because they are comfortable in the natural.

They are coping with reproach.

Managing pain.

Adjusting to bondage.

But the supernatural responds to desperation.

Through Desire

The Bible says:

“Through desire a man, having separated himself, seeketh and intermeddleth with all wisdom.” — Proverbs 18:1 (KJV)

One of the greatest blessings that can happen to a man is divine agitation — the refusal to remain comfortable inside a problem.

There are moments in destiny where sleeping becomes dangerous.

Jesus experienced this in Gethsemane.

At the hour of destiny, the disciples slept.

Three times Jesus returned to wake them.

Finally, He stopped bothering them.

May you never arrive at the point where God no longer disturbs your comfort.

Wake Up in the Season of War

Do not sleep in warfare.

Do not become relaxed in crisis.

Your guard must remain up.

Many people only need a few days of intense pressing into God for an entire lineage to be delivered.

But they cannot sustain thirty minutes of prayer.

The supernatural hovers around them, yet they cannot connect to it.

Press until you discern His presence.

Press until you discern the help of God.



Protocol Three: Place Demand on the Help of God

When you discern the help of God, do not remain passive. Place demand on it. Many people press into prayer until God's presence appears, and then they become distracted. They begin enjoying the atmosphere without engaging the power available within it.

Some even pull out phones to record moments instead of receiving from God. Meanwhile, the supernatural is present and available.

Peter Walked on Water Because He Placed Demand

Jesus said: "Be of good cheer; it is I; be not afraid." — Matthew 14:27 (KJV)

Immediately Peter responded: "Lord, if it be thou, bid me come unto thee on the water." — Matthew 14:28 (KJV)

Peter placed a demand on the supernatural. The encounter was not for entertainment. It was not for emotional excitement. It was for manifestation. There were twelve disciples in that boat, but only one walked on water.

Why?

Only one placed demand.

The Difference Between Presence and Participation

Many people help open spiritual atmospheres but never benefit from them because they do not know how to engage what has opened.

There are dimensions available in meetings that only those who place demand will enter into. The supernatural does not automatically overwhelm everyone equally. Those who draw from it intentionally are the ones who experience it deeply.

The Majesty of His Presence

There is a generation today that talks about the presence of God casually. But in Scripture, whenever God manifested Himself, flesh collapsed.

Ezekiel said:

“...I fell upon my face...” — Ezekiel 1:28 (KJV)

John fell as one dead before Him.

When Solomon dedicated the temple and the glory filled the house, the priests could not stand to minister. The true presence of God destroys human pride and self-glory.

When He appears, flesh bows.

Tremble at His Presence

The Bible says:

“Tremble, thou earth, at the presence of the Lord...” — Psalm 114:7 (KJV)

When Israel came out of Egypt:

- The sea fled
- Jordan turned back
- Mountains skipped like rams

Creation itself responded to His presence. When Balaam attempted to curse Israel, he declared:

“Surely there is no enchantment against Jacob, neither is there any divination against Israel...” — Numbers 23:23 (KJV)

Why?

Because the shout of the King was among them. The government of God rested upon them.

Nothing Can Stand Before Him

When His majesty appears:

- Cancer cannot remain
- Reproach cannot remain
- Bondage cannot remain
- Darkness cannot remain

That is why you must place demand when His presence manifests.

Peter said:

“Lord, if it be thou, bid me come.”

And even water respected itself.

It could happen during worship.

It could happen during prayer.

It could happen during the preaching of the Word.

It could even happen during the benediction.

But whenever you discern His presence, place demand on it.

Nothing stands before Him.

Not Satan.

Not circumstances.

Not affliction.

The mountains skip at His presence.

That is why those who possess spiritual intelligence know how to engage the moment God manifests Himself.

“If it be Thou, bid me come.”

Peter understood something about the presence of God. He knew that if it was truly Jesus, then even the waters would have no choice but to obey.

The moment Abraham discerned that it was God standing before him, he knew his problem was over. He brought Him into his house and ministered to Him. Then the Lord said:

“At the time appointed I will return unto thee, according to the time of life, and Sarah shall have a son.” — Genesis 18:14 (KJV)

When God was leaving, He said He was going to judge Sodom and Gomorrah because the cry of their wickedness had ascended to heaven. Abraham immediately began to place a demand on the presence.

“Wilt thou also destroy the righteous with the wicked?” — Genesis 18:23 (KJV)

How can you come into God's presence and all you leave with is goosebumps? The moment His presence shows up, place a demand on it.

Scripture is full of examples.

In Mark 5, the woman with the issue of blood heard that Jesus was passing by. Jesus was not even going to her, yet she said within herself:

“If I may touch but his clothes, I shall be whole.” — Mark 5:28 (KJV)

Blind Bartimaeus also heard that Jesus was passing and immediately cried:

“Jesus, thou Son of David, have mercy on me.” — Mark 10:47 (KJV)

They understood how to place a demand on the presence.

Yet many people move in and out of God's presence every week without engaging it. You are struggling with sin, prayerlessness, sickness, business problems, career challenges, yet you never place a demand on the presence.

What are you doing with the presence of God?

Honour the Presence and Place a Demand

When you honour the presence, place a demand on it, and engage dominion, things begin to happen.

“Lord, revive me.”

“Lord, open doors for me.”

“Lord, empower me.”

“Lord, heal me.”

As worship rose in the atmosphere, prophetic declarations began to flow:

- That womb that was removed shall be recreated.
- Whatever has gone wrong with your organs receives divine replacement.
- Every resisting power is silenced in the name of Jesus.

Four: Engage Faith

The fourth protocol of the supernatural is faith.

Some people place demands on God's presence, and when He responds with an instruction, they begin to analyse instead of obeying.

In Matthew 14:28, Peter said:

“Lord, if it be thou, bid me come unto thee on the water.” — Matthew 14:28
(KJV)

Jesus answered with one word:

“Come.”

At that point, the response had been given. Whether Peter would experience the supernatural or not now depended on faith.

Peter stepped out of the boat and began to walk on water.

If he had remained inside the boat, he would never have walked on water. That was when he realised that the true trigger of the supernatural is faith expressed through action.

This is why Mary said at the wedding in Cana:

“Whatsoever he saith unto you, do it.” — John 2:5 (KJV)

It is not enough to hear. The supernatural manifests when you act.

I have seen people receive impossible healings because they heard an instruction and obeyed immediately. I have also seen others saturated in God's presence but still processing whether to obey or not—and they missed their moment.

Obedience Activates Power

I was preaching in Port Harcourt some years ago. A man was driving when he heard my voice from the crusade ground. He parked his car by the roadside while I was making declarations.

Right there in his car, he obeyed the prophetic instruction immediately and received healing instantly. He ran into the crusade ground testifying like a madman.

Meanwhile, there were people physically present in the crusade who heard the same message, participated in worship and prayers, yet remained unhealed because they never acted.

Whatever He tells you to do, do it.

That is where the power is activated.

When Peter saw the lame man at the Beautiful Gate, he declared:

“Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk.” — Acts 3:6 (KJV)

Nothing happened immediately.

Then Peter grabbed him by the hand and lifted him up. As the man attempted to stand, strength entered his ankles and he leaped.

The power was present all along, but it was activated in the doing.

Move When God Speaks

Some of you, God told you to relocate, but you are still waiting for certainty.

When I came to Abuja, I knew nobody influential. There was nobody who could suddenly hand me huge financial support. Yet from our very first meeting, millions were spent.

If I had remained in Makurdi waiting for help from familiar people, I would never have met the mighty kingdom labourers God had prepared in Abuja.

Today, there are people who pray with us daily with terrifying intensity. Lawyers, doctors, lecturers, businessmen—all gathered because I obeyed when God said “Come.”

Some of you are waiting for guarantees before obeying God.

But when Jesus says “Come,” do not walk—run. Even water can carry you when God speaks.

Your “Come” May Be Different

For one person, “Come” may be a scripture coming alive in your spirit.

You may suddenly hear:

“By whose stripes ye were healed.” — 1 Peter 2:24 (KJV)

That is your “Come.”

Another person may hear:

“Thou shalt be the head, and not the tail.” — Deuteronomy 28:13 (KJV)

That is your “Come.”

For someone else, it may be an instruction:

- Give to the orphanage.
- Wait on God for three days.
- Start the business.
- Serve faithfully.
- Shout “Hallelujah!”

It may not make sense naturally, but that is exactly how God brings men from the natural into the supernatural.

Understanding the Flow of the Spirit

I was preaching in Sydney, Australia, when a white woman came into the meeting with crutches.

Sometimes God moves through the anointing. Sometimes through revelation. Sometimes through gifts of the Spirit. Sometimes through faith.

As I ministered, I heard clearly:

“Go and collect the crutches.”

I hesitated because of the environment. In those countries, there are police officers monitoring large gatherings. But the instruction came again. I collected the crutches and told the woman to stand.

She took a step. Then another. Finally she said:

“I feel no pain.”

I knew she would feel no pain because I knew the One who sent me—Yeshua Hamashiach. The entire atmosphere erupted in celebration.

And tonight, God is still saying:

“Come.”

Five: Stay Focused

It is not enough to start walking in the miraculous. You must remain focused. Peter walked on water successfully until he became distracted.

“But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid.” — Matthew 14:30
(KJV)

The moment he shifted his eyes from Jesus to the storm, he began to sink. Many people receive miracles and then lose them because they become distracted. Satan often sends symptoms back to test whether you truly believe what God has done.

Do not focus on the symptom.

Focus on the Word.

If the symptom resurfaces, keep declaring:

“I am healed.”

Stay on the Word until the symptom disappears completely.

The symptom is temporary. The Word is eternal.

Do Not Lose Your Miracle

Some people receive healing during a meeting and feel symptoms return the next day. Immediately they conclude nothing happened.

No.

Stand your ground. If you walked before, keep walking. If you were healed before, keep declaring healing. Satan is trying to manipulate your mind. Do not surrender your miracle through unbelief.

Six: Return to Worship

The final protocol is worship. When Jesus entered the boat after rescuing Peter, the disciples bowed and worshipped Him.

“Of a truth thou art the Son of God.” — Matthew 14:33 (KJV)

Many people receive miracles but never return to give thanks. That is why the last miracle they experienced becomes the last miracle they ever receive. In Luke 17, ten lepers were healed, but only one returned to thank Jesus.

That one was made whole.

Gratitude sustains men in the supernatural.

The Truth Brings Liberty

Some people have already been healed simply because truth entered their spirits tonight.

“Ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.” — John 8:32
(KJV)

The truth carries an assignment: liberty.

Some chains have already broken.

Some demons have already fled.

Some burdens have already lifted.

The Lord is your healer.

He sent His Word, and His Word heals diseases.

That affliction is broken.

That infirmity is terminated.

That reproach is removed.

That tumour is leaving now in the name of Jesus Christ.

Everywhere Jesus went, He was doing good.

And even today, He is still doing good.

The Economy of the Supernatural

How many of you have noticed a touch already? Something has happened to you. You sensed a pain disappear. You sensed a growth vanish. Your ears opened, your eyes became clearer—something has happened in your body already. Wave your right hand if God has touched you.

Those of you waving your hands, come to the front. I want to show them something. We have not even prayed yet.

“Something happened, and now I know—He touched me and made me whole.”

Even those watching online, if you have received your healing already, indicate it wherever you are.

You know, I did not have the time to teach fully on the second protocol, but there are four things that undergird this operation of the supernatural.

Four Cardinal Principles of the Supernatural

1. Revelation

This is how the supernatural is released. The moment you catch revelation, access to the supernatural opens.

2. Consciousness

Revelation brings understanding, but you do not stop there. You saturate yourself in that revelation until it defines your consciousness, because your consciousness eventually becomes your reality.

3. Faith

Faith is like flipping the switch to the socket. It activates what revelation has already made available.

4. Virtue

When we worship, when we pray, and when we meditate, we are building virtue. This is how those of us on the Jesus side operate the supernatural:

- Revelation
- Consciousness
- Faith
- Virtue

That is the economy of power. When these four things are in place, the supernatural flows naturally. That is why I did not need to pray for many of them individually. Revelation was released into this atmosphere, it saturated their consciousness, faith was triggered naturally, and virtue was supplied. That is why healing began to happen. It is not by shouting. It is by the supply of the Spirit. These are the four cardinals that govern the operation of the supernatural.

The Release of Healing

Everybody lift your right hand.

Whatever affliction you came here with, I command it to leave your body now in the name of Jesus Christ.

Every circumstantial limitation around your life, I command it altered now. I release a verdict over you that brings victory and deliverance in the name of Jesus Christ.

The Bible says:

“Say ye to the righteous, that it shall be well with him...” — Isaiah 3:10 (KJV)

You are free from your calamities.

You are free from your crises.

Those in the main auditorium, in the overflow, and those watching online—you are free from every affliction in the name of Jesus.

Step into your victory.

Thank You, Father, in Jesus' name.

Prophetic Words and Healings

I am seeing somebody wearing something white or milk-coloured. You had a surgery or an affliction around your chest or heart region. The Lord is touching you now. That affliction is leaving you forever in the name of Jesus Christ.

Check your body—you will discover that issue is gone.

There is also someone with a kneecap condition caused by an accident. You have carried that pain for over a year. That bone condition has been corrected even now. You are free in Jesus' name.

Check your body. Something has happened to you already.

I also see somebody who has been having fluid discharge from the breast. That condition has stopped now in the name of Jesus.

That arthritis pain in your back has disappeared. Swing your body and discover that the pain is gone forever in Jesus' name.



Testimonies of Healing

Chest Pain Healed Instantly

A sister testified that she developed severe chest pain around 2 a.m. She could not lie down or bend her body. But the moment the declaration was made, the pain disappeared completely. She began bending freely and rejoicing in the power of God.

Thyroid Swelling Disappeared

Another woman had a visibly swollen neck due to thyroid complications and had already been scheduled for surgery. After attending the crusade and receiving the Word, she returned home only to discover that the swelling had disappeared completely.

Jesus did it for free.

Some afflictions go beyond physical pain—they destroy confidence and affect people psychologically. But tonight, whatever Satan planted in your body is uprooted in the name of Jesus Christ.

Eye Condition Healed

A man who had suffered itchy eyes and constant discharge for over a month testified that during the ministration, the itchiness and discharge stopped completely. That healing is permanent. Even in old age, your vision will remain clear in Jesus' mighty name.

Fifteen Years of Pain Gone

An air-conditioner technician who came only to fix equipment ended up sitting in the meeting. As he listened to the teaching, he caught revelation and suddenly felt a cold sensation all over his body. A pain he had carried for fifteen years disappeared instantly.

That is the power of revelation.

Shoulder Bone Restored

Another man testified that whenever he lifted his hand, the shoulder bone would pull out and he would have to push it back himself. But when instructed to raise his hands during the service, he discovered the bone remained intact.

For the first time in years, he could lift his hand freely without dislocation.

Only Jesus can do this.

Prophetic Declarations

I decree again over you: you are free from every infirmity in the name of Jesus Christ.

Every high blood pressure condition is crashing now. I command your blood pressure restored to normal range in Jesus' name.

Fibroids and every growth in the body—I command them to dematerialise now in the name of Jesus Christ.

Every prostate abnormality is healed permanently in Jesus' name.

The Lord spoke to me two days ago and said:

“Tell My people this month they will have peace.”

Therefore, I decree and declare over you:

Peace

February is your month of peace.

Every turbulence in your health—peace be still.

Every turbulence in your relationships—peace be still.

Every turbulence in your business and career—peace be still in the name of Jesus Christ.

Every wind of chaos around your life and family is terminated now.

Restoration

Whatever Satan stole from you—whether your health, joy, prosperity, or strategic relationships—I decree restoration now in the name of Jesus.

“If the thief be found, he shall restore sevenfold...” — Proverbs 6:31 (KJV)

The years that the cankerworm, caterpillar, and locust have eaten—receive sevenfold restoration in Jesus’ name.

We do not prophesy because we want to speak. We prophesy because we are commanded by God.

The Lord told Ezekiel:

“Prophesy upon these bones...” — Ezekiel 37:4 (KJV)

And when he spoke, dry bones rose again into a mighty army.

Every dry area of your life—every wasted season, every lost hope—I command life to return now in the name of Jesus Christ.

Let dry bones rise again!

Growth and Enlargement

Everything stunted in your life, I command it to grow.

Everything God has placed in your hands—let it increase, multiply, and expand in the name of Jesus Christ.

I banish lack from your life.

Step into a new dimension.

Step into a new heritage.

May your heavens be opened.

May the Lord grant you fresh encounters.

May those encounters produce transformation and revival in your life.

For your shame, receive double honour.

Every garment of reproach is burnt off your life. Be clothed with favour in this month in the name of Jesus Christ.

Protocols shall be suspended for you like they were suspended for Esther.

Rise into new dimensions.

Go from strength to strength.

From glory to glory.

From grace to grace.

From dimension to dimension.

- Uncommon restoration
