Introduction

The second class in the school of process is the class of instructions.

It is not given to man to order his steps. They have X-rayed man in the studios of eternity, and they have checked that even though he has a brain, his brain is not enough to define his destiny.

Because you can be preparing for a job interview, and the principalities have scheduled an accident. There is no way you can see the accident. You can know all the questions that will be asked in the job interview. You can be qualified for that job interview, but there is no way you can understand how that accident will come.

So, in addition to your capacity-building exercise, you will need a Spirit to instruct you. You will need men empowered by God to instruct you.

That's why when Jesus was resurrected, He didn't go to heaven just trusting on the Holy Spirit. He said, "I will go to the Father, and I will pray the Father, and He will send you the Holy Ghost." But He knew the Holy Ghost alone was not enough, so He left instructors.

Many people cannot relate with the Holy Spirit. They will need somebody to help them get to the Holy Spirit. Their men in themselves are nothing; it's the same Holy Ghost that is walking through them. But God knows that they need human instructors to help them.

Don't just jump out and say, "I've had an encounter with God. I'm going to take my word."

There is a season of your life where you need to be taught the oracles of God.

Samuel had an encounter as a little boy. He was still with Eli. Eli was no longer hearing God. The Bible said, "In those days the word of the LORD was precious; there was no open vision" (1 Samuel 3:1).

But there was an experience of walking with God that Eli had. So even though Samuel was the one God was talking to, someone had to be there to instruct him.

That's why in Ephesians 4:11, he said:

"And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers."

Every saint needs to be equipped with instruction.

I know God has encountered you to bring wealth, but you need to be guided on how to handle money.

I know God has encountered you to work in power, but you need to be guided on how to walk with power.

I know God has encountered you and equipped you to be able to prophesy. You see, sometimes your instructor may not even be a seer, but he will teach you the character requirement for you to be able to host the prophetic anointing, else you go with the prophetic anointing and bring ridicule to the name of God.

CHAPTER ONE

Instructors Are the Insurance Policy

Instructors are the insurance policy that God puts around men that have encounters. The Bible said concerning Joshua, that Joshua was the servant of Moses. It said concerning Elisha, the man that poured water in the hands of Elijah.

There is nobody that becomes anything without being instructed in the phase of his life. What does instruction do to you?

Instruction Guides You Into Accuracy

Number one, it guides you into accuracy.

Without instruction, you will fail.

He said, "In the multitude of counsellors there is safety" (Proverbs 11:14).

I know an angel comes to your room every night. I know God appears to you through the Word, but you still need a pastor. You still need a mentor.

Don't jump up and say, "I know what to do to get money."

The people of the world understand this. You see a boy go and serve somebody for seven years. He's an apprentice. He has understood everything about the business, but he needs to be guided because there are many errors that only instruction will save him from.

We have a generation where nobody wants to serve anybody. Everybody just wants to jump up and begin to talk about what you have seen.

What you have seen is not enough. You need to be instructed.

Because this God you are following, some people have followed Him for thirty years. This God you are following, some people have followed Him for forty years.

That business you want to do, you are not the first.

It could be a download business. It could be car business. You want to sell cars. Have you heard of—let me not call anybody's name—there are people that have sold cars for forty years.

They have seen different trends, different errors in car business.

So even though you see the God that will train you by prophecy, you still need to wait under the man that has sold cars for many years. He will guide you. If not, you can't go far.

I know you started laying hands on the dead and they woke up at the age of ten. You still need to be guided. Hope you know Jesus, the Word of Life, could not manifest until He was thirty.

There were many times they sat with doctors of the law in the temple, engaging them. They were learning with them, asking questions, answering questions.

Because people must be instructed. Did you think Jesus was just living?

He was called the carpenter because even Joseph, the human being, they got Jesus submitted to Joseph, and Joseph taught Him carpentry. There were many things He learned from carpentry.

That is the Son of the living God. If you don't have instructions, you can't go far.

After an Encounter, God Will Still Lead You to Be Instructed

So when God grants you an encounter, God will still lead you to be instructed.

That was why Jesus appeared to Paul—Saul—on his way to Damascus, and He sent Saul to go and meet Ananias. And He said he will tell you what you must do. How can Jesus encounter a man and send him to another man?

Acts 9:4–6 says:

"And he fell to the earth, and heard a voice saying unto him, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me?

And he said, Who art thou, Lord? And the Lord said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest: it is hard for thee to kick against the pricks.

And he trembling and astonished said, Lord, what wilt thou have me to do? And the Lord said unto him, Arise, and go into the city, and it shall be told thee what thou must do."

Again, in Acts 9:11–12, the Lord instructed Ananias concerning Saul.

Go into the city, and you will be told what you must do.

If you have an encounter and you jump from encounter to manifestation, not too long, it will collapse.

When you have had encounters, somebody will have to instruct you.
