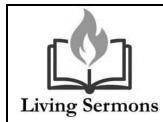

Introduction

The problems of life do not give notice. They come on a daily basis—almost every minute of your life. They do not come like the usual examinations you do in school; otherwise, there would be long enough notice, and you would be able to prepare not to fail.

The interesting thing is that these problems exempt no one. Whether you are expecting them or not, whether you like it or not, they keep coming.

There is no prayer you can pray to get problems away. Praying that you will not have problems is like praying that you should die—and nobody prays that they should die. Everybody wants to live.

Even those who have prayed to die still struggle to live. Even those who hang themselves still struggle to survive. You will never see anybody willingly submit to death. Every natural man wants to survive.

Problems of life do not give notice, and if you do not act fast, you may end as an object of shame and reproach.

This is why solutions to the problems of life must be spontaneous. What wisdom does is help us to solve problems. Problems are not to be prayed away; they are to be solved. The ability of life is in the ability to solve problems. The honour of life is in the ability to quickly respond to problems by solving them.

You are leaving this place this morning as a problem solver. Did I hear an amen from someone this morning?

Inspiration: The Vital Force of Wisdom

I want to show you this morning one very vital force of wisdom that helps you discharge every problem as they come your way in such quick succession that problems will not be able to stick to you.

You will be living as if problems do not exist. There is this dimension of wisdom that we call **inspiration**. It is the vital force of wisdom. If you lack inspiration, you will suffer expiration. People expire simply because they are no longer inspired.

For as long as you are inspired, you will never expire. Without inspiration, there will be continuous failure in the battles of life. Inspiration is the gateway in the school of wisdom. Inspiration is the catalyst in the compound of wisdom.

It is the major element required for you to operate in the wisdom of God. It is the capital requirement in the operation of wisdom.

Jesus and the Power of Inspiration

Checking through the Gospel, you will see how Jesus largely operated by inspiration. He was faced with problems on a daily basis, but the force of inspiration bailed Him out. They came to Him one day without notice and brought a woman caught in adultery. According to their report, they said: "*Master, this woman was taken in adultery, in the very act.*" (John 8:4)

They said to Jesus, "Tell us what to do with her. We just caught her red-handed." Jesus asked, "What does the law say?"

They replied, "The law of Moses says she should be stoned to death." Jesus looked up and down. That kind of situation—you cannot say, "*Let me go and study and come back with an answer.*"

There are situations you cannot wait to study before answering. Here were people with stones in their hands. If He said, "Stone her," they would say, "*You are a murderer.*"

If He said, “Do not stone her,” they would accuse Him. And suddenly—there was inspiration. Say with me: **Inspiration!**

And He said: “*He that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her.*” (John 8:7)

And everybody’s conscience came alive. One after another, they withdrew.

And there was solution.

The Same Hour

How many of you have ever faced sudden situations like that?

You did not prepare before somebody came to ask you a question. Or you were faced with a challenge at your workplace. Or face to face with temptation. You did not know what to do. You turned right and left, and everywhere you were trapped.

And suddenly, something told you what to do. You will be living under such open heavens from today, in the name of Jesus.

Daily Living Under Inspiration

Jesus largely used inspiration to sort out the problems of life. Many times, they came to Him with different questions because they wanted to ensnare Him with the words of His mouth. Several times Jesus would look at them and say:

“Why do ye about to kill me?” (John 7:19)

He was able to know what they were thinking. He was able to detect what they were planning because of the power of inspiration. Look—life is too short.

You do not have time to study for everything, yet you have to succeed. And Jesus, knowing that we would be faced with such situations, told us ahead of time:

“And when they bring you unto the synagogues, and unto magistrates, and powers, take ye no thought how or what thing ye shall answer, or what ye shall say: For the Holy Ghost shall teach you in the same hour what ye ought to say.”

—Luke 12:11–12

Say with me: **The same hour.**

That means you do not have time. In the same hour, the Holy Ghost shall teach you. So inspiration is the gift of God that enables you to answer instantaneously for every issue of life that comes your way.

The same hour.

That means there are hourly problems that you must solve. You cannot always have time to study your way out.

Inspiration Versus Reasoning

By comparison, inspiration is superior to reasoning. Reasoning is a process of mental exertion. It has to do with grinding information. You collect information here and there, connect facts, and weigh the pros and cons. That is what reasoning does.

It puts you under mental exertion. But what inspiration does is take care of the process and deliver to you the product. Inspiration does not task your brain. That is not to say thinking is unnecessary.

But there are certain things you cannot think through. All you require at such moments is inspiration from heaven.

A divine idea. Something suddenly bursting forth in your soul. In your career. In your family. In your relationships. At your place of work. Something just bursts through your soul. Sometimes through your mouth. You will say something you could never have imagined would come from your mind— and then you are credited for it.

Solomon: A Man of Inspiration

Solomon largely lived under inspiration. The Bible says: *“And God gave Solomon wisdom and understanding exceeding much, and largeness of heart...”*

—1 Kings 4:29

Two women brought a living child before Solomon, and each laid claim to the child. That was not the time to go and study law. That was not the time to begin an investigation. But under inspiration, Solomon said: “Bring me a sword. Divide the child into two.” And immediately, the true mother cried out: “No! Leave the child alive!”

And by that inspiration, truth was revealed. The Bible says all men feared Solomon. People respect you for your inspiration. When you operate under inspiration, you look like a superstar. People think you went to school to learn intelligence. But inspiration is superior to intelligence. This day, I decree that your mental faculty will be connected to heaven for divine illumination and inspiration in the name of Jesus.

The Same Spirit of Christ at Work in You

The same Spirit that guided Christ, that taught Christ on a daily basis, will teach you wisdom by inspiration in the name of Jesus. Would somebody be ready to receive that this morning?

Lift up your hand and say: **“Lord, I am ready for it!”**

It is inspiration that makes you ten times smarter than all your teachers. Inspiration—the spirit of quick understanding. If you live under inspiration, most problems of your life will be cheaply solved.

Whether at home, at work, or in your extended family, by the power of inspiration, I see God taking you to a new level in the name of Jesus.

What Is Inspiration?

What then is this thing we call inspiration?

Let me quickly summarise and put the definitions together for you in three different perspectives.

1. Inspiration Is the Movement of the Holy Spirit

Inspiration is the movement of the Holy Spirit upon the mental faculty of man.

Job 32:8 says:

“But there is a spirit in man: and the inspiration of the Almighty giveth them understanding.”

There is an object in man which looks ordinary, but when the inspiration of the Lord comes upon it, it turns it into an extraordinary force.

Peter was a local fisherman, but on the day of Pentecost, when the Holy Ghost came upon him, his mind became ignited. After he spoke, the learned men came to him and said: *“Men and brethren, what shall we do?”* (Acts 2:37)

Their hearts were pricked.

Stephen never went to school, yet when they asked him what he had to say in his defence, he gave a long speech—from Abraham all the way to Jesus Christ. And the people marvelled at the wisdom with which he spoke. Inspiration is the movement of the Holy Spirit. It is the spirit of accuracy.

The spirit of knowledge.

The spirit that knows the past, the present, and the future.

When that Spirit moves upon your mind, inspiration is born.

Paul prayed in Ephesians 1:17:

“That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him.”

It is the special influence of divinity upon the mind of man. It is the breath of the Lord. Daniel operated by this spirit. They said of him that he had *“the spirit of the holy gods”* (Daniel 4:8). Behind every inspiration is the Spirit of the holy God. I see you partaking of that Spirit today in the name of Jesus.

2. Inspiration Is the Release of Supernatural Intelligence

Inspiration is the release of supernatural intelligence. Please note: inspiration is not something you learn. Neither is it something you reason out. Inspiration is what you receive. It is received by man as revealed by God. There is no school of inspiration.

In the days of Daniel, there were schools of magicians, astrologers, and soothsayers. That was the kind of wisdom that existed in the days of Nebuchadnezzar. But when the king had a problem, all of them failed. Then Daniel stood and said:

“This wisdom you seek cannot be found among men.” And he pointed them to the God who reveals secrets. There is no school of inspiration. It can only be delivered by God.

And thank God you are serving that Living God. This morning, you are receiving that gift in the name of Jesus. There is nowhere they issue certificates for inspiration. It is a gift from the Lord. And I believe that today, as you partake of this communion, the blood of Jesus will release upon you the spirit of supernatural intelligence.

Somebody who believes, say loud amen.

Intellectualism is all about the study of the various things of life. It cannot compare with inspiration. When you are inspired, the level of your understanding changes.

You become superior in understanding to all men. I believe that God is releasing that to you today in the name of Jesus.

3. Inspiration Is Spontaneous Light

Inspiration is spontaneous light. Spontaneous knowledge. A spontaneous idea.

We saw this in Jesus. One day He sat among five thousand men and women who needed food. While the disciples were busy calculating how much food would be required and how much money it would cost, the Bible says:

“For he himself knew what he would do.” (John 6:6)

Say with me:

Inspiration!

From today, in every situation, you will know what to do.

That is my endless prayer for you—that in every circumstance of life, you will know what to do.

That is inspiration: Spontaneous knowledge of what to do.

Knowing What to Say, Knowing What to Do

Daniel had no prior notice.

The king said: “If you do not interpret this dream, I will kill all of you.”

Daniel went back home and sought the face of the Lord. And in the night, the Lord inspired him. On speaking what God revealed, the problem of the king was solved.

And that inspiration elevated him and changed his position. Inspiration is spontaneous light.

- Spontaneous knowledge of what to say.
- Spontaneous knowledge of what to do.

In the New Testament, this is what we call the **gift of the word of knowledge** (1 Corinthians 12).

- Knowing what to say per time.
- Knowing what to do per time.
- Having a clear sense of judgment.

That is inspiration.

As it was in the case of Solomon.

And I know today, by the mighty hand of God, your mental faculty shall be thoroughly connected to heaven's inspiration in the name of Jesus.

How to Make Inspiration Work

1. Have Respect for the Holy Spirit

Have respect for the Holy Spirit because He is the source of inspiration.

Jesus said:

“For the Holy Ghost shall teach you in the same hour what ye ought to say.” (Luke 12:12)

In every case of inspiration, the Holy Spirit is the fountain.

Every move of the Spirit culminates in supernatural intelligence.

When the Spirit moved upon Peter, he became intelligent.

When the Spirit moved upon Christ, He operated with divine intelligence.

They all lived under inspiration.

So you must have respect for the Holy Spirit.

Make Him your daily companion.

Do not take steps that will offend Him.

2. Live an Anxiety-Free Life

Relax yourself.

Be positive about the issues of life.

Jesus said not to be anxious about what to say.

For in that same hour, the Holy Spirit will teach you.

You are going for an interview?

Relax yourself.

Let the interview come first.

By the time you get there, the Holy Spirit will put the right question in the mouth of your interviewers and the right answer in your mouth.

Be anxiety-free.

Charge your environment with praise and worship.

Remain connected to the Holy Spirit.

Daniel had only twenty-four hours to live, yet he remained calm.

He went back home and sought God.

The three Hebrew boys stood before the king and said:

“Our God whom we serve is able to deliver us...” (Daniel 3:17)

They were relaxed.

Anxiety destroys mental ability.

Many people fail not because they cannot perform, but because anxiety steals control from them.

Relax.

There is money to pay for that business tomorrow—relax.

Let tomorrow come.

The Holy Spirit will inspire you.

He will show you what to say.

He will show you where to go.

He will show you how to get it.

The Power of Inspiration Is Working for You

From today, nothing will disconnect you from the inspiration of heaven. Beginning with every step you take this week, I see the mighty hand of God guiding you to obtain results in the name of Jesus.

Say with me: **Inspiration is working for me!**

Today again, I open up to be connected to the power of inspiration. I will no longer be stranded. I am walking under open heavens in the name of Jesus.

Prayer for Open Heavens

Lift up those hands and give thanks to the Lord because the power of inspiration is working for you.

The power of inspiration is working for you.

Thank You, Lord.

In Jesus' wonderful name.

How many of you want your heavens open today for divine inspiration?

Pray:

Lord, I lift up my eyes to the hills. Let Your heavens open over me. Let there be daily inspiration for me. From this moment, I live under open heavens. I live under inspiration. No more dry moments for me. No more dry seasons for me. Holy Spirit of God, inspire me from today—in my career, in my family matters, and in everything that I do.

Thank You, Lord.

In Jesus' wonderful name, we have prayed.
