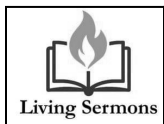

Introduction

The message for tonight is **Faith for All Round Possibilities**.

Faith is the foundation of Christianity. Faith believes that God will do what He says He will do. Faith is the life-wire of Christianity. Christianity is worthless without faith. Take away faith, and there will be no Christianity. Everything about your life is controlled by faith. In **Mark 10:27**, the Bible declares:

"And Jesus looking upon them saith, With men it is impossible, but not with God: for with God all things are possible." (KJV)

If everything is possible with God, many of us say, "I know God can do it." Have you ever said that before?

But hear what God said in **Mark 9:23**: *"Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth."* (KJV)

Yes, with God it is possible. But if I also believe what God says, then whatever God has said in this world, if I believe it and stand on the integrity of it, I commit God to make it happen exactly as He has said. So, for a man of faith, there is no impossibility. Every impossibility is simply a lack of faith. If I exercise my faith and stand on God's Word, then I commit God to do whatever He says He will do.

Shout hallelujah!

Faith Gives You a Place on the Earth

Faith is what gives you a place on the earth. Faith gives you the assurance that what God has promised must come to pass irrespective of contradictory circumstances.

Faith and God's Word cannot be separated, because faith stands on the integrity of God's Word to commit Him to perform whatever He has said.

Faith is the supernatural force that turns impossibilities into possibilities. It thinks the unthinkable and speaks the unspeakable. It enables the impossible and does the incredible.

That is faith. What faith does is connect you with the supernatural power of God for divine intervention. Faith is the hand stretched forth to take whatever belongs to you.

If someone says, "Take," you stretch your hand to collect it. In the same way, whatever God has promised you in His Word, it is by faith that you take delivery of it.

You cannot take delivery of any promise of God without faith. But if faith is that important, how do I activate faith for all-round possibilities?

If all things are possible with God, and all things are possible to him that believes, then I must do something to activate that faith.

1. Depend on God's Ability

Have absolute confidence in God's ability. When human responsibility mixes with God's ability, a miracle must be born.

Look at Abraham. He believed God's Word—that was man's responsibility. God gave him Isaac in old age—that was God's ability.

Faith is sharing responsibility with God.

Moses pointed the rod—that was his responsibility. God parted the Red Sea—that was His ability.

David carried the stone—that was his responsibility. God ensured Goliath came down.

Noah built the ark—that was his responsibility. God brought the rain.

Joshua marched around Jericho—that was his responsibility. God brought the walls down.

Mary stood on the integrity of God's Word—that was her responsibility. God gave her a child without a man—that was His ability.

So if God speaks, all I need to do is my part.

If God says give, I give. It is God's responsibility to bring it back.

Luke 6:38 says:

"Give, and it shall be given unto you..." (KJV)

My responsibility is to give. God's responsibility is to bring it from any source.

Just do your own part and leave the rest to God.

There shall be nothing called impossibility to you if you can accept your responsibility.

Do you want God to do something? Then do your part.

Do not ever try to figure out how God will do His part. That is where many miss it.

It is not your business.

Accept your responsibility and depend on God's ability to perform whatever He has said.

Faith is simply accepting responsibility to activate God's ability.

That is all.

2. Stand on the Integrity of His Word

Stand on the integrity of God's Word.

In **Numbers 23:19**, the Bible says:

"God is not a man, that he should lie; neither the son of man, that he should repent..."
(KJV)

If God has said anything in this Book, do not doubt it.

Stand on it.

You commit His integrity to perform it.

Everything can fail, but not the Word of God.

Jesus said in **Luke 21:33**:

"Heaven and earth shall pass away: but my words shall not pass away." (KJV)

God speaks according to His ability, capability, and capacity to perform.

So when God speaks, stand on the integrity of His Word without shaking.

His Word is the final authority over every issue of life.

In **Isaiah 26:3**, the Bible says:

"Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee." (KJV)

When your mind is stayed on God, you don't shake inside.

You say, "God, this is what You said. I am standing on it."

And things will work in your favour.

But hear this carefully:

You cannot stand on the Word if you do not know it.

How do you stand on a scripture you do not know?

That is why many have problems. When challenges come, they cannot stand because they do not know the Word.

Romans 10:17 says:

"So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God." (KJV)

You cannot use yesterday's faith, because yesterday's diet cannot sustain you today.

If you want to sustain your life, you must eat fresh food.

That is why you must keep hearing and hearing and hearing.

You do not say, "I heard that scripture last year."

No.

Faith comes by hearing.

What you heard yesterday cannot sustain you today.

The manna of yesterday cannot sustain today.

And having a Bible does not mean you have faith.

The Word must be in you.

If you have medicine on your shelf, can it heal you?

No.

You must take it.

In the same way, faith will not work because you own a Bible. Faith will work when you have taken the Word.

Until the Word enters you, it will not produce.

Faith begins where the will of God—which is the Word of God—is known.

That is where faith begins.

You must know the Word of God.

Faith Does Not Deny Reality

Faith does not deny the obvious.

Faith does not deny sickness.

Faith does not deny hardship.

Faith does not deny challenges.

But faith uses God's Word as a superior authority to overcome the challenges.

If a man is sick, faith does not deny it.

But faith declares:

"By whose stripes ye were healed." (**1 Peter 2:24**, KJV)

And:

"Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses." (**Matthew 8:17**, KJV)

That Word now overcomes the sickness.

If a man is broke, faith does not deny it.

But faith says:

"But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus." (**Philippians 4:19**, KJV)

Faith stands on the integrity of the Word irrespective of what is seen.

Whether it is your health, finances, barrenness, stagnation, academic struggles, or marital delay—faith is the currency of heaven for miracles.

Faith has the same purchasing power everywhere in the world.

The faith that works in Nigeria will work in Ghana.

The faith that works in Ghana will work in China.

The faith that works in China will work in America.

Faith is a universal currency.

It works anywhere.

It has universal purchasing power.

The Word of God works anywhere in the world.

There is no dry land in the Kingdom.

Wherever men have problems, the Word has answers.

And faith remains the bridge between God's promise and your manifestation.

3. Speak What You Believe

An old man once went to the United States. When he returned, he said, “Papa, I am not going there again.”

I asked him, “Mama, why?”

He said, “How can I stay in a place where my daughter and her husband go out in the morning and come back at night, and no neighbour greets me? I come outside, and everybody just enters their houses. Nobody talks.”

He said, “I cannot stay there again.”

At least here in Africa, you have neighbours. In fact, you have excess neighbours.

That is one thing I love about Africa. When you wake up, someone says, “Ah, brother, how now?”

Shout hallelujah!

Now finally, number three:

Speak what you believe.

If you want impossibilities to become possibilities, speak what you believe.

In **Mark 11:23**, Jesus said:

"For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith." (KJV)

Take note of that scripture.

The word **believe** appears once, but the word **say** appears three times.

That means whatever you believe, you should speak as many times as possible.

Let me say this clearly:

No situation can change without positive declaration.

If there is no confession, there will be no possession.

If you close your mouth, God will never act.

There will be no possibility with a closed mouth.

In **2 Corinthians 4:13**, the Bible says:

"We having the same spirit of faith..." (KJV)

Take note—it says **the same spirit of faith**.

That means the same spirit that works in one believer works in another. It is not that some have a higher spirit than others.

The same Holy Ghost is in every believer.

The difference is in how you use it.

According as it is written, *"I believed, and therefore have I spoken."*

Whatever is written, believe it.

But anything you believe and do not speak will not produce. Faith in the heart cannot affect the earth until it reaches the mouth. It is faith in the heart expressed through the mouth that produces results on the earth.

That is why the Scripture says:

"We also believe, and therefore speak." (KJV)

What you believe must be declared.

Your Mouth Activates Redemption

In **Romans 10:9–10**, we often use it for altar calls:

"That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved." (KJV)

But verse 10 is the key:

"For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation." (KJV)

Salvation is not just about being born again. Salvation includes everything redemption offers. So whatever redemption has made available, your mouth must declare it. Anything you want to possess in life, your mouth has to say it.

Some ask, "What if I talk and it does not happen?"

Talk!

Because if you do not talk, it will never happen. If God had kept quiet in **Genesis 1**, creation would not have happened. The Bible says:

"And God said, Let there be light: and there was light." (Genesis 1:3, KJV)

It did not say *light came*.

It said *there was light*.

That means the light already existed. Your miracle already exists. Your breakthrough has already been provided. What remains is for your mouth to bring it into manifestation. You are not trying to get the breakthrough.

The breakthrough has already been given. Now you must speak it into existence.

Hold Fast Your Confession

This is where many believers miss it. In **Hebrews 10:23**, the Bible says:

"Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;)" (KJV)

Hold fast your profession. That word **profession** means confession. Hold tightly to what you are declaring from God's Word and do not shake. Because your mind will fight your heart. You will declare, "By His stripes I am healed," and your mind will tell you, "But the pain is still there."

Your mouth says, "I am healed."

Your mind says, "No, you are still in pain."

But God says, **do not waver**. James says a wavering man cannot receive. Stand on the integrity of the Word and do not shake.

Why?

Because **He is faithful that promised**.

God is too faithful to fail.

So when you declare the Word, keep saying it.

If symptoms arise again, say:

"I am made whole."

If fear comes, say:

"I am healed."

If lack comes, say:

“I am blessed.”

Even when everything around you suggests otherwise, do not change your language.

That is where many miss it.

When challenges come, their language changes.

They begin to say, “I have tried.”

No.

Keep saying what God said.

I have seen situations that looked impossible, but I kept declaring.

And at the end, God proved faithful.

He is ever faithful to His Word.

Summary of Faith for All-Round Possibilities

What have I said in summary?

Depend on God’s ability.

Do your part and leave the rest to Him.

Stand on the integrity of His Word.

Know the Word and stand on it.

Speak what you believe.

Declare it consistently and without wavering. And all things that look impossible will end up becoming possible.

Shout hallelujah!

Prophetic Declaration

Look at your life and identify that area where it seems the Word has not yet manifested. Declare it again. And do not shake. This is not prayer. This is declaration.

If it is healing, declare:

"By His stripes I am healed."

If it is marriage, declare:

"He maketh the barren woman to keep house, and to be a joyful mother of children."
(**Psalm 113:9**, KJV)

If it is promotion, declare:

"But God is the judge: he putteth down one, and setteth up another." (**Psalm 75:7**, KJV)

No matter the opposition, one with God is majority. Take your responsibility, and God's ability will make it happen. Speak over that situation with authority.

And do not doubt it.

Closing Blessing
