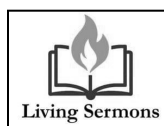

Introduction

Provoking supernatural supplies simply means God providing help. It is God providing help, resources, wisdom, and solutions in ways that exceed human ability and natural limitations.

Our key Scripture in this first service is taken from **1 Kings 17:2–16**, the story of Elijah, the brook Cherith, and the widow of Zarephath.

From this account, we see clearly that supernatural supplies are real. God supplied supernaturally for Elijah, and what He has done for one, He can do for another. Nobody can doubt the reality of supernatural supplies when they look at the Scriptures.

God first supplied Elijah through the brook. When the brook dried up, He supplied him again through the widow of Zarephath. This shows that every time one channel closes, God is able to open another. He remains the God of supernatural provision.

Walk by Divine Direction

If you want to enjoy supernatural supplies, the first requirement is to **walk by divine direction**.

In **1 Kings 17:2–3**, the Word of the Lord came to Elijah, saying:

“Get thee hence, and turn thee eastward, and hide thyself by the brook Cherith, that is before Jordan.”

God told him where to go because He had already commanded the ravens to feed him there.

Again, in **1 Kings 17:9**, God said:

“Arise, get thee to Zarephath... behold, I have commanded a widow woman there to sustain thee.”

Every time Elijah came to a crossroads, God instructed him to move. At every stage, there was already a provision prepared for him.

If you want to enjoy supernatural supplies, divine direction is the secret behind distinction.

Learn to remain in the place where God has asked you to be.

The Bible says:

“The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want.” (Psalm 23:1)

A sheep does not search for grass. The shepherd knows where the grass is and leads the sheep there.

When you follow God’s leading, He knows where your prosperity is. He knows where your supply is. He knows where your next level is.

Many times, people follow their feelings or the opinions of others, and that is why they miss their provision.

Supplies will only be found where God has directed you to be.

If you are in want, then be sure you are not following the leading of the Shepherd.

When you are in God’s place, you cannot be displaced.

Never go where God has not sent you.

Lack Is Often a Direction Problem

Jesus asked His disciples:

“When I sent you without purse, and scrip, and shoes, lacked ye any thing?
And they said, Nothing.” (Luke 22:35)

Lack is often a function of being outside the place God has assigned to you.

Isaiah declares:

“I am the Lord thy God which teacheth thee to profit, which leadeth thee by
the way that thou shouldest go.” (Isaiah 48:17)

God teaches profit, but He does so through divine leading.

The same chapter shows that when God led Israel through difficult places, they still did not thirst because He made water flow from the rock for them.

No matter how difficult the environment may be, if you are following God’s leading, you will prosper.

One of the greatest challenges in life is not a lack of money, opportunities, or connections. One of the greatest challenges in life is a lack of divine direction.

Stop focusing on what people are saying.

Stop focusing on the economy.

Start focusing on what God is saying.

Do not force your way through doors that God has not opened.

Pray before you move.

Success Comes from Being Where God Wants You

Many people do not know why I am succeeding. It is not because I am the most powerful pastor. I am where God asked me to be. Everyone has a place prepared by God. When you are where God wants you to be, you will not struggle. I pray today that you will hear God clearly in the Name of Jesus.

Ways God Leads Us

Many people are not being led by God. The world may be moving in a particular direction, but that does not mean God is leading you that way. I once spoke to a businessman who had been running losses continually. I advised him to shift because the business climate had changed.

He replied, “I have not heard God.”

I became concerned because if something is continually producing losses, it is important to seek divine direction. God will not speak to someone who is unwilling to hear. When your heart is open, hearing from God is not difficult. Many people have already made up their minds before they pray, so even when God wants to speak, they reject what He is saying. I loved Lagos very much. I did not want to leave. I kept praying, “God, speak.”

But God remained silent because He knew that deep within my heart I did not want to leave. The moment I surrendered and became willing to obey, He spoke. Sometimes people pray, “God, speak to me,” while already determined to do what they want. God knows the heart. He knows what you are willing to accept and what you are unwilling to accept.

Check your heart.

Many times, God is not silent because He cannot speak. He is silent because we have refused previous instructions.

God Leads Through His Word

One of the primary ways God leads us is through His Word. The Bible says:

“Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.” (Psalm 119:105)

Every time you read the Bible, God is able to guide you through His Word.

God Leads Through Prayer of Inquiry

God also leads through prayer of inquiry.

In **2 Samuel 5**, David repeatedly inquired of the Lord before going to battle.

On one occasion, God told him to go and fight.

On another occasion, God told him not to move until he heard the sound in the tops of the mulberry trees.

This teaches us that yesterday’s instruction is not necessarily today’s instruction.

You must continually ask God for fresh direction.

The Bible says:

“Call unto me, and I will answer thee, and shew thee great and mighty things, which thou knowest not.” (Jeremiah 33:3)

Many believers spend all their prayer time saying, “God, do this for me.”

But there is another important prayer:

“Lord, show me what I should do.”

That is called the prayer of inquiry.

God Leads Through the Holy Spirit

The Holy Spirit is already within every believer.

Jesus said:

“Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth... and he will shew you things to come.” (John 16:13)

The Holy Spirit guides, directs, and reveals. He can show you what to stop doing and what to start doing. He can reveal the path that will produce results. Hearing God is not difficult for a child of God.

Just as you recognize your mother's voice, you should learn to recognize the voice of God.

God Leads Through His Voice

Another way God leads is through His voice.

Jesus said:

“My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me.” (John 10:27)

God's children have access to His voice.

As you grow in fellowship with Him, you become familiar with how He speaks.

God spoke to Abraham:

“Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house...” (Genesis 12:1)

Abraham heard and obeyed.

The voice of God is powerful.

Every time you read Scripture, there is a voice behind the written Word.

Just as a wife can read a text message from her husband and hear his voice behind the words, believers can learn to hear God's voice behind the Scriptures.

When you become familiar with His voice, doubt disappears.

The Danger of Spiritual Deafness

Isaiah 42:18–20 speaks about people who have ears but do not hear and eyes but do not see.

Many Christians are spiritually deaf and spiritually blind.

God is speaking, but they are not hearing.

That is one of the worst things that can happen to a believer.

Today marks the end of every spiritual deafness in your life.

In the Name of Jesus, every deaf ear is opened.

Every spiritual blindness is removed.

From today, you will hear.

From today, you will see.

You will hear the voice of God clearly and follow His leading.

In Jesus' Name. Amen.

Walk by Faith

If you want to enjoy supernatural supplies, you must walk by faith.

When Elijah spoke to the widow, he said:

“Fear not; go and do as thou hast said: but make me thereof a little cake first...” (1 Kings 17:13)

The woman was in a desperate situation. By her own confession, she was preparing her last meal before death. Yet Elijah instructed her to act contrary to what her circumstances suggested.

That is faith.

Faith is acting on God's Word before seeing the result.

Faith is standing on the integrity of God's Word.

The Bible says:

“Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.” (Hebrews 11:1)

The widow had not yet seen the miracle, but she believed the Word that came from God. The kingdom of God operates on the currency of faith. Faith is accepted everywhere in the kingdom. The widow acted in faith because she believed that what God said would surely come to pass. The Scripture declares:

“Blessed is she that believed: for there shall be a performance of those things which were told her from the Lord.” (Luke 1:45)

Any instruction mixed with faith guarantees supernatural supplies. Many believers are not experiencing supernatural supplies because they doubt even after God has spoken.

The Bible says:

“For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them: but the word preached did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in them that heard it.” (Hebrews 4:2)

When God speaks, do not doubt.

Believe. Trust. Act.

You can never prosper without faith. Even giving requires faith. You release what is in your hand before seeing what God will place in your future. Faith says, “God cannot lie.”

Faith says, “If God has spoken, He is committed to bringing His Word to pass.”

Obedience: The Master Key to Supernatural Supplies

The Bible says:

“And she went and did according to the saying of Elijah...” (1 Kings 17:15)

The widow's miracle was not produced merely by hearing the instruction; it was produced by obeying it.

Obedience is the master key to supernatural supplies.

You may hear powerful teachings every week, but if you do not obey, there will be no results.

The Scripture says:

“If ye be willing and obedient, ye shall eat the good of the land.” (Isaiah 1:19)

Many people know the truth but refuse to obey it.

They hear God's Word but resist God's instructions.

Yet they still desire supernatural prosperity.

It does not work that way.

Whenever truth makes you uncomfortable, do not reject it. Instead, examine yourself.

Often, the area that provokes resistance is the very area God wants to correct.

The purpose of God's Word is not to condemn us but to transform us.

When God points out an area of weakness, His intention is restoration, growth, and breakthrough.

Do not fight correction.

Embrace it.

Obedience always leads to increase.

Giving: A Covenant Key to Supernatural Supplies

Another key to supernatural supplies is giving. In the story of the widow, Elijah repeatedly instructed her:

“Make for me first.”

She was preparing her last meal, yet God required her to release what she had before receiving what she needed. This reveals an unchanging kingdom principle:

If there is no release from your hand, there will be no release from heaven. Giving is not merely a financial activity; it is a covenant principle established by God Himself. God demonstrated this principle when He gave His Son.

The Bible says:

“For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son...” (John 3:16)

If God had not given Jesus, humanity could not have been redeemed. Giving precedes receiving. The law of seedtime and harvest remains in force. The Scripture declares:

“While the earth remaineth, seedtime and harvest... shall not cease.”
(Genesis 8:22)

Everything reproduces after its kind. If you desire financial increase, you must understand the principle of financial seed. Giving is living. Giving is kingdom culture. Stinginess is contrary to the nature of God. The Bible says:

“There is that scattereth, and yet increaseth...” (Proverbs 11:24)

And Jesus said:

“Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over...” (Luke 6:38)

If you are not experiencing a harvest, examine your seed. Life is built on giving. Stop being stingy. Learn to release what God places in your hands.

Follow Proven Kingdom Principles

If you faithfully follow God's principles, your life cannot remain the same.

The Word of God works.

Kingdom principles produce kingdom results.

Growth may be gradual, but progress is inevitable when biblical principles are consistently applied.

Truth may sound hard at times, but it is better to embrace truth and prosper than reject truth and remain in struggle.

God's Word never fails.

Believe in the Fulfilment of God's Word

The fifth key to supernatural supplies is believing in the fulfilment of God's Word. The widow experienced supernatural provision because God's Word came to pass exactly as He had spoken. The Bible says:

“And the barrel of meal wasted not, neither did the cruse of oil fail, according to the word of the Lord...” (1 Kings 17:16)

God's Word is dependable. Heaven and earth may pass away, but His Word remains forever. Jesus said:

“Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away.”
(Matthew 24:35)

Believe God's Word. Stand upon God's promises. Trust His integrity.

As you obey His instructions, no hardship in the land will prevail against you.

God will always honour His Word.

Prayer for Divine Guidance

Lift your heart before the Lord and declare:

“Father, I will never remain spiritually deaf. I will never remain spiritually blind. From this day forward, I will walk by Your guidance. Instruct me concerning what next to do.

I receive grace to obey Your voice.”

Hearing God is not difficult for His children. The more you walk with Him, the clearer His voice becomes.

There are places God has ordained for you, opportunities prepared for you, and supplies reserved for you. Your responsibility is to hear and obey. Life is not as difficult as many people think. Many struggles are simply the result of being in the wrong place. As you hear God's voice, He will position you in the right place at the right time.

Prayer for Your Wealthy Place

The Scripture says:

“Thou broughtest us out into a wealthy place.” (Psalm 66:12)

Notice that God does not merely bring His people out; He brings them into. He brings them out of limitation and into abundance. Out of stagnation and into advancement. Out of frustration and into fulfilment.

Pray:

“Lord, bring me out of every pit of stagnation.

Bring me out of every pit of frustration.

Bring me out of every limitation.

Move me into my wealthy place.

Position me where Your purpose for my life will be fulfilled.”

God knows how to connect people with their ordained opportunities.

One divine connection can change an entire destiny. One instruction can alter the course of a lifetime. May God position you in your wealthy place.

In Jesus' Name.

Amen.

Prophetic Declaration
