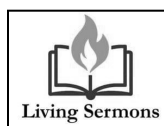

Introduction

Supernatural supplies mean causing the release of provisions by means beyond natural laws or phenomena. These provisions do not come by killing, stealing, or defrauding people or systems. They come by the supernatural hand of God.

Supernatural supplies are the heritage of the children of God. They belong to us. The Bible says:

“But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.”

— Philippians 4:19 (KJV)

Again, Scripture declares:

“But in the living God, who giveth us richly all things to enjoy.”

— 1 Timothy 6:17 (KJV)

God is never in lack, and He does not want His children to live in lack.

Jesus said:

“I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.”

— John 10:10 (KJV)

The Bible further says:

“The young lions do lack, and suffer hunger: but they that seek the LORD shall not want any good thing.”

— Psalm 34:10 (KJV)

Also:

“The earth is the LORD'S, and the fulness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein.”

— Psalm 24:1 (KJV)

And God declares:

“The silver is mine, and the gold is mine, saith the LORD of hosts.”

— Haggai 2:8 (KJV)

David said:

“The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.”

— Psalm 23:1 (KJV)

Everywhere in Scripture, God is telling us that we are not ordained to live in want.

May lack and want come to an end in your life.

However, your attitude towards the covenant determines the flow of supernatural supplies.

God has already blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ Jesus. Therefore, supernatural supplies are real.

Say with me, “Supernatural supplies are real.”

Biblical Examples of Supernatural Supplies

The Bible is filled with examples of God's supernatural provision.

Manna in the Wilderness

God provided manna for the children of Israel in the wilderness.

Exodus 16

Elijah and the Ravens

God provided for Elijah through ravens and later through the widow of Zarephath.

1 Kings 17:2–16

Money from the Mouth of a Fish

God caused money to appear in the mouth of a fish.

Matthew 17:27

Feeding Five Thousand Men

Jesus fed five thousand men, besides women and children, in the wilderness.

John 6:1–13

The Cathedral Project

The building of the Salvation Ministries Cathedral is also a testimony of supernatural supply.

You cannot naturally explain how such supplies come.

God has already given me the date for the dedication this year. I will announce it very soon.

This is not guesswork.

When I hear God, I do not doubt Him.

I was sleeping when He woke me and said, "Write the date." He mentioned the date and instructed me to dedicate it on that day.

For God to give a date means He already knows everything required for its accomplishment.

It is by supernatural supply.

The Bible says:

"If ye be willing and obedient, ye shall eat the good of the land."

— Isaiah 1:19 (KJV)

Supernatural supplies are available, but they are accessible only to those who fulfil God's demands.

How to Provoke Supernatural Supplies

You do not sit down and wait for supplies. You provoke supernatural supplies.

1. Follow Divine Direction

Follow divine guidance.

Follow God's leading.

In the Kingdom of God, obedience to divine direction is a key to enjoying supernatural supplies.

The Bible says:

“And the LORD shall guide thee continually, and satisfy thy soul in drought,
and make fat thy bones...”

— Isaiah 58:11 (KJV)

Notice the phrase: *“The Lord shall guide thee continually.”*

When there is famine, hardship, or drought, God guides His people to where provision exists. No matter the hardship around you, God can guide you into abundance. Divine direction is the heritage of every child of God.

“For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.”

— Romans 8:14 (KJV)

God is always willing to lead, guide, and direct us. However, we have the responsibility to follow His leading. A shepherd may lead sheep to green pastures, but if a sheep insists on going its own way, it will miss the grass.

God has no problem leading you. The question is: are you willing to follow?

Shout hallelujah!

As long as the children of Israel followed God's leading, they never lacked His supplies.

He provided for them in the most unlikely places.

The Bible says:

“And they thirsted not when he led them through the deserts...”

— Isaiah 48:21 (KJV)

Notice what it says:

They thirsted not **when He led them**. It does not say they thirsted not when they led themselves. Many believers today are leading themselves. The children of Israel did not thirst because God led them through the wilderness. Even in the desert, He brought water out of a rock.

There is no impossibility with God. If you follow God's leading, things will work where others say nothing works. I came here by the leading of God. Before I came, nobody considered this place a prosperous city. Everybody talked about Lagos and Abuja.

But God sent me here.

Today, we can all see the result.

May you be where God has sent you.

If you allow God to lead you in your business, career, ministry, projects, or any area of life, you will not lack His supplies.

Go Where God Sends You

Many people suffer because they insist on going where they like instead of where God wants them to be. Jesus asked His disciples:

“When I sent you without purse, and scrip, and shoes, lacked ye any thing?
And they said, Nothing.”

— Luke 22:35 (KJV)

Many people today are where God never sent them.

Lift your right hand and pray:

“Holy Spirit, lead me to where You have prepared for me.”

Every child of God has a place in destiny.

Never go where God has not led you.

I was teaching one day when a man of God approached me and said, “Pastor, it is as though you were speaking directly to me.”

He lived in Germany and held a German passport.

Yet many people spend thirty or forty years abroad and have nothing substantial to show for it except citizenship and a mortgaged house. A child of destiny should not live like a destitute. Therefore, I curse every form of misdirection. And if you have made mistakes in the past, pray:

“Lord, redirect me. I am willing to obey You.”

When God tells you to move, refusing to move is pride. Even if you have gone far in the wrong direction, humility demands that you make a U-turn.

It is never too late.

Abraham changed direction at seventy-five. Moses changed direction at eighty. God told Abraham:

“Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house...”

— Genesis 12:1 (KJV)

Everyone has a place in destiny. Every child of God is designed to flourish in a specific place prepared by God. May you not miss your place.

Amen.

Examples of Supernatural Supplies Through Divine Direction

Elijah

God led Elijah to the brook and supplied his needs through ravens.

1 Kings 17:2–8

When the brook dried up, God instructed him to move to the widow of Zarephath.

Divine direction is continuous.

God can tell you to move from one phase to another. Not every open door is God's door. Some free opportunities can become expensive mistakes.

May you hear when God says, “Move.”

Peter

Peter was a professional fisherman, yet he caught nothing.

Then Jesus instructed him:

“Launch out into the deep...”

— Luke 5:4 (KJV)

Later, Jesus instructed him again:

“Cast the net on the right side of the ship...”

— John 21:6 (KJV)

Many people are working hard on the wrong side.

May you find the right side.

Shout a louder Amen!

Even Your Church Can Be a Matter of Divine Direction

When I wanted to attend Bible school, there was one close to where I lived in Victoria Island. But God said no. He instructed me to travel to another location where He had prepared someone to train me. Something being close does not mean it is your place.

Some people remain where God has not assigned them and wonder why progress is absent. Everyone has a God-ordained place. When you meet your pastor, you will know.

God said:

“And I will give you pastors according to mine heart...”

— Jeremiah 3:15 (KJV)

God gives people pastors, not merely church buildings.

The Miracle of Wine at Cana

Another example of supernatural supply is found at the marriage feast in Cana. There was no wine. Then Jesus gave a simple instruction:

“Fill the waterpots with water.”

They obeyed. The water became wine. **John 2:1–10**

Supernatural supplies are real.

A Personal Testimony of Divine Supply

When my wife and I were preparing to marry, we had only twenty-three thousand naira.

Then God instructed me: “Give Me twenty thousand.”

I obeyed. Heaven opened. God supplied everything required for the wedding without begging any man. That is Kingdom Christianity.

The same God has continually supplied Salvation Ministries through divine direction and supernatural provision.

How to Receive Divine Direction for Supernatural Supplies

If divine direction is so important, how do we receive it?

Seek Through Prayer of Inquiry

This is different from ordinary prayer.

It is called **prayer of inquiry**.

Instead of asking God merely to do something for you, ask Him what you should do.

Ask questions such as:

“Lord, what shall I do to experience Your supply in this business?”

“What should I do concerning this project?”

“What step should I take regarding this family matter?”

The Bible says:

“Call unto me, and I will answer thee, and shew thee great and mighty things, which thou knowest not.”

— Jeremiah 33:3 (KJV)

You are not simply praying for provision.

You are praying for instruction.

And instruction produces provision.

When we bought the land for the Cathedral, the sellers suddenly demanded payment within two months or they would reclaim the land.

I asked the Lord:

“Lord, what do we do?”

He instructed me to sow one hundred million naira into the ministry I was connected to.

I obeyed.

Heaven opened.

Before the deadline arrived, God supernaturally supplied the resources needed.

Without divine instruction, I might have gone to the bank for a loan.

But God had a better way.

Pray Through the Holy Ghost

The Holy Spirit is the Guide of believers.

Jesus said:

“Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth...”

— John 16:13 (KJV)

To enjoy supernatural supplies, you must follow His voice.

To continue enjoying supernatural supplies, you must continue following His voice.

God still speaks today.

The Holy Spirit still guides today.

The question is: are you listening?

Hearing God's Voice Is Not Difficult

Listen, read those two books:

- *How to Hear from God*
- *Following Divine Guidance*

I cannot teach everything today, but those books will help you greatly.

Hearing God is not difficult.

When you hear God, life becomes sweet.

In any area of your life, if the whole world gangs up against you but you have heard from God, you already know how to overcome.

A young man in this church wanted to contest for a political position. He came and said:

“Sir, I don't have money. The opposition is heavily funded.”

As he stood before me, the Holy Spirit gave me a scripture:

“And he putteth down one, and setteth up another.”

— Psalm 75:7 (KJV)

I simply declared:

“Whoever is competing against you shall be put down.”

The young man had no financial backing.

The other candidate had influential politicians supporting him.

Yet, God intervened.

Those who were supposed to support the other candidate suddenly withdrew their support and stood behind this young man.

Eventually, the heavily funded opponent was disqualified, and the young man emerged victorious.

Why?

Divine direction.

I did not pray a long prayer.

I simply spoke what God had said.

When God speaks, situations bow.

There was a time people rose against me.

The Lord brought a scripture to my heart:

“Thy hand shall be in the neck of thine enemies...”

— Genesis 49:8 (KJV)

I simply prayed:

“Lord, put Your hand upon the neck of my enemies.”

And God intervened.

May you hear God today in the name of Jesus.

A Prayer Against Spiritual Deafness and Blindness

Put your hands on your ears.

I command every form of spiritual deafness to be destroyed in the name of Jesus.

From this day, hear distinctly from God in the name of Jesus.

Now place your hands upon your eyes.

Every form of spiritual blindness is terminated in the name of Jesus.

Receive spiritual sight.

See clearly in the name of Jesus.

Declare:

“I will see.”

“I will hear.”

“I will hear God's voice.”

The day you begin to hear God, Christianity becomes sweet.

Jesus said:

“My sheep hear my voice...”

— John 10:27 (KJV)

As His sheep, you are meant to hear His voice.

Whenever things are not working, learn to ask:

“Lord, what must I do?”

Giving

How do you provoke supernatural supplies?

Number one: Divine guidance.

Number two: Giving.

To provoke supernatural supplies, you must understand the covenant of seedtime and harvest.

A covenant is an agreement between God and man.

The Bible says:

“While the earth remaineth, seedtime and harvest... shall not cease.”

— Genesis 8:22 (KJV)

As long as the earth remains, the covenant remains.

Therefore, every believer must become a faithful practitioner of giving and receiving.

However, it is not merely giving that produces harvest.

It is giving in faith and in love.

Give First, Then Receive

The greatest example is God Himself.

“For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son...”

— John 3:16 (KJV)

God gave before He received sons and daughters.

He did not receive first and then give.

He gave first.

The Kingdom principle is simple:

You do not get in order to give.

You give in order to receive.

Whatever you desire determines the seed you sow.

You release what is available in order to obtain what is desirable.

Many people pray:

“Lord, if You give me, I will give.”

That is not Kingdom order.

Kingdom order says:

Give first.

Then receive.

I gave fifteen naira before I received two thousand.

From two thousand, I gave again and received more.

From 1997 until today, I have continued giving.

Where giving stops, harvest stops.

What you love to give will never finish.

Whatever you give in love, you will never lack.

Every Seed Produces After Its Kind

The Bible says:

“And the earth brought forth grass, and herb yielding seed after his kind...”

— Genesis 1:12 (KJV)

Every seed produces after its kind.

When God wanted sons and daughters, He sowed His Son.

If you want money, sow money.

Do not deceive yourself.

You cannot sow preaching and expect financial harvest simply because you are a preacher.

Even as a pastor, if I desire financial increase, I must sow financial seed.

There is no spiritual abracadabra.

The principle remains the same for everyone.

David and Solomon Understood This Principle

David loved the Lord.

Because of his affection for God's house, he gave generously.

1 Chronicles 29:3–4

Solomon also loved the Lord and offered great sacrifices.

1 Kings 3:3–4

The result was supernatural abundance.

If you want financial increase, understand the covenant of giving.

Love Is Proven by Giving

In 2012, I shared a testimony that some people became uncomfortable hearing.

But testimonies are meant to inspire faith.

At that time, I gave one million dollars in a service.

No offering was raised.

Nobody pressured me.

My wife did not even know beforehand.

I simply wanted to demonstrate my love for God.

Love is always tested.

Many people struggle to release even a small offering and complain continuously.

Yet they spend freely on personal pleasures without hesitation.

The truth is this:

The money you are protecting today cannot follow you beyond the grave.

Therefore, do not allow money to become your master.

Be dead to money.

Be alive unto God.

Whatever Challenges You Is What God Wants to Correct

Sometimes people complain:

“Why does the church always talk about tithing?”

Others complain when purity, integrity, truthfulness, or relationships are addressed.

But consider this carefully:

Whatever challenges you most is often the area God wants to correct. If teaching on giving irritates you, God may be working on your attitude towards giving. If teaching on truthfulness irritates you, God may be dealing with dishonesty.

God corrects what He intends to transform. Every believer must submit to divine correction.

Never Give Trash and Expect Treasures

Never give trash and expect treasures. If you desire God's best, honour Him with your best. There was a time God instructed me to release money that had been secured in a fixed deposit. The amount was substantial.

Yet I obeyed.

At that point, God revealed certain things to me and brought supernatural intervention. Many battles can be won through obedience and sacrificial giving.

If Money Controls You, It Has Become Your God

If you cannot use money to serve God, then money has become your god.

And God hates idolatry.

Many people claim to worship God while secretly serving money. The evidence appears whenever giving is mentioned. A believer should never be controlled by money. Rather, money should be a tool for Kingdom advancement. Never become dependent on people.

Depend on God.

If people choose to help you, thank God.

If they do not, trust God.

Your source is not man.

Your source is God.

Every stingy person eventually reaches a limit in the Kingdom.

You can never rise beyond certain levels while holding tightly to what God asks you to release.

Grace to Practise What You Have Heard

Lift your voice and pray:

“Lord, I receive grace to practise everything I have heard today.”

“Give me grace to obey Your instructions.”

“Give me grace to walk in divine guidance.”

“Give me grace to become a faithful giver.”

In Jesus' mighty name.

Amen.

I have never built my life around dependence on men.

Challenges come to everyone.

Even today, challenges still arise.

But I give my way out of them.

Why should a believer depend entirely upon mortal men?

The Bible says:

“Thus saith the LORD; Cursed be the man that trusteth in man...”

— Jeremiah 17:5 (KJV)

Man can be arrogant.

Positions can change.

Influence can disappear overnight.

Joseph was once a prisoner and later became Prime Minister.

God can lift anyone at any time.

Therefore, when God elevates you, remain humble.

Do not become arrogant.

Many who were once prominent are now forgotten.

Many who were once overlooked are now celebrated.

God can change any situation.

Prophetic Prayer for Release

The Bible says:

“This is the portion of a wicked man with God, and the heritage of oppressors...”

— Job 27:13 (KJV)

And again:

“Though he heap up silver as the dust, and prepare raiment as the clay; He may prepare it, but the just shall put it on...”

— Job 27:16–17 (KJV)

The wealth may be prepared elsewhere, but Scripture declares that the just shall possess it.

The Bible also says:

“...the wealth of the Gentiles shall come unto thee.”

— Isaiah 60:5 (KJV)

Therefore, declare:

“In the name of Jesus, everything prepared for my destiny be released to me now.”

“Every blessing held back from me, be released.”

“Every opportunity assigned to me, be released.”

“Every contract, promotion, favour, and breakthrough ordained for my life, be released.”

In the mighty name of Jesus.

Amen.

Take Possession

Now declare:

“I take possession of everything God has released to me.”

“I receive my blessings.”

“I receive my breakthroughs.”

“I receive all that belongs to me in Christ.”

Blessed be God forever.

In Jesus' mighty name.

Amen.

Closing Exhortation

Go and enjoy what has been released.

Return with testimonies.

In Jesus' name.

Amen.

Salvation Prayer

If you are not born again, pray this prayer:

“Lord Jesus, come into my life.

I accept You as my personal Lord and Saviour.

I believe in my heart that You died and rose again to save me.

Today, I confess You as Lord over my life.

Thank You, Father, for saving me.

In Jesus' name.

Amen.”

If you prayed that prayer sincerely, welcome to the family of God.
