Introduction

Provoking supernatural supplies refers to provisions, help, and resources that come from God in ways beyond human ability. It is God providing beyond human means.

Ephesians 1:3 says:

"Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ."

Supernatural supplies are real.

God gave manna in the wilderness to the children of Israel (Exodus 16). He brought money from the mouth of a fish to pay tax (Matthew 17:24–27).

Our key scripture for this service is taken from 2 Kings 7. The story revolves around the four lepers.

There was a severe famine in Israel. Hardship filled the land. Then Elisha arose and declared:

"By this time tomorrow shall a measure of fine flour be sold for a shekel, and two measures of barley for a shekel..." (2 Kings 7:1).

One of the king's officers doubted the prophecy. In today's terms, we could call him an economic adviser. He looked at the situation through natural reasoning and concluded that what Elisha declared was impossible.

Elisha responded with holy indignation and said:

"Behold, thou shalt see it with thine eyes, but shalt not eat thereof." (2 Kings 7:2)

Exactly as God had spoken through His servant, the prophecy came to pass. Food became abundant the next day, but the officer who doubted was trampled at the gate and died.

The four lepers entered the camp of the Syrians and discovered that God had already gone ahead of them. The enemy had fled, leaving behind an abundance of supplies.

I decree that whatever God has said in His Word shall come to pass in your life.

Amen.

How to Provoke Supernatural Supplies

1. Believe the Prophet Sent to You by God

In 2 Kings 7:1–2, Elisha declared God's mind concerning the situation.

A prophet is a messenger chosen by God, sent to reveal His will, speak His mind, and guide His people.

2 Chronicles 20:20 says:

"...Believe in the LORD your God, so shall ye be established; believe his prophets, so shall ye prosper."

Supernatural supply came because some people believed the word that came through Elisha.

I decree that no matter the hardship in the land, God will give you breakthroughs.

God speaks through His servants. Hold on to the word God gives through them and give it the attention it deserves.

2. Refuse to Doubt

The officer in 2 Kings 7:2 said what God declared could not happen. Elisha challenged that unbelief because doubt is the enemy of faith.

Mark 9:23 says:

"Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth."

When God speaks through a true messenger, do not doubt His Word. If you want to doubt something, doubt yourself—but never doubt God. The doubting officer saw the miracle, but he never partook of it. Never doubt God's Word. Just believe it. I remember while meditating on the cathedral project, God spoke clearly to me:

"David, you are not the builder. I am the One building it."

He reminded me:

"I will build my church..." (Matthew 16:18)

He did not say David would build it. He did not say David and I would build it. He said, "I will."

The architect does not worry about where the money will come from. The owner of the project supplies the resources. The cathedral is His project. Therefore, the resources are His responsibility. I depend absolutely on Him by faith. Never doubt the Word of God in any area of your life. If you want supernatural supplies, stand on the integrity of this Book.

Sometimes circumstances will appear contrary to God's promises. Everything around you may suggest that God's Word cannot come to pass. But refuse to doubt.

I remember a young man in this church who contested an election. His opponent had enormous financial backing and powerful political sponsors.

People told him he could never win.

I looked at him and said:

"I command them to bow."

Those who came intending to support his opponent eventually voted for him.

Why?

Because the Word had gone forth. Anyone competing with you shall bow in the name of Jesus. Whether in politics, business, career, or ministry, God will put down your competitors and lift you up.

Psalm 75:6–7 says:

"For promotion cometh neither from the east, nor from the west, nor from the south.

But God is the judge: he putteth down one, and setteth up another."

God will put down your competitors and lift you up.

Shout a loud Amen!

3. Be Courageous

In 2 Kings 7:3–5, the four lepers asked themselves:

"Why sit we here until we die?"

They realised that remaining where they were guaranteed destruction. So they decided to move. And when they moved, God moved. You cannot enjoy supernatural supplies while living like a weakling. The lepers stepped out with courage. You cannot have a lion's share if you do not possess a lion's heart. Joshua was given great promises by God.

Yet repeatedly God told him:

"Be strong and of a good courage." (Joshua 1:6)

All the promises of God minus courage equal nothing. After God gives you a promise, you must possess the courage to act upon it. You cannot fold your arms and expect God to act on your behalf. Supernatural supplies require courageous steps.

Courage is the quality of mind that enables a person to face challenges without fear. The lepers did not merely discuss possibilities; they acted. Until you become courageous, you cannot attain the next level in life, business, ministry, or career.

Some people spend their lives asking:

"Should I go? Should I not go?"

God has already told you to go.

Move!

You may not know anyone there. You may not have all the answers. But move. Until you move, you cannot become a mover. God has given many of you ideas, visions, and dreams. Yet you are still praying about what God has already instructed you to do.

Get up and put your faith into action.

No one can enjoy supernatural supplies without courage. Courageous people are never intimidated by circumstances. Courage turns obstacles into opportunities and challenges into victories. A courageous heart accomplishes what a fearful heart considers impossible.

It took courage for this church to accomplish many of the things we are doing today. I was the first minister in this city to organise a major crusade without inviting a famous guest minister. In those days, every large programme featured recognised national ministers.

Then God told me:

"Step out."

In 2003, I carried the pulpit outside and held the crusade. Many pastors criticised the idea. My face alone appeared on the posters. They called it foolishness.

They expected me to fail. But whenever people think you cannot make it, that is exactly when you should challenge yourself to succeed. When people despise you, let it inspire you. When people call you a failure, let it motivate you to prove them wrong.

The first day, the venue overflowed. The second day, there was no space available. Later, one of those critics confessed:

"We were waiting for you to fail."

Many people may be expecting you to fail.

You will not fail.

Just have courage.

The size of your breakthrough is often determined by the size of your courage.

Move forward.

You have talked long enough.

You have dreamed long enough.

Now put the dream to work.

There is one thing God will never do for you, regardless of how much you pray:

He will not provide your courage.

He told Joshua:

"Be strong and of a good courage."

In other words, build your heart.

Step out.

It takes courage.

Many of you have prayed enough. You have fasted enough.

Now take bold steps.

Nigeria may be hard, but God remains God.

If you wait for perfect conditions, you may never start.

Business requires courage.

Ministry requires courage.

Success requires courage.

Many people's problem is not the devil—it is fear. They blame witches, wizards, and family limitations. But God has already prepared a table before you in the presence of your enemies. Your enemies are not the issue.

Step out.

When David pursued the lion, the lion fled. The thing you fear is often afraid of you. I command every devil resisting your progress to bow in the name of Jesus. David confronted Goliath because he possessed courage. While others saw a giant, David saw an uncircumcised Philistine. God has already given you everything you need.

What remains is courage.

All the principles you know, all the fasting you have done, all the prayers you have prayed—without courage, they produce little result. Faith requires action.

Miracles require action. Breakthroughs require action. It takes courage to step out and believe God. It takes courage to obey His instructions. And it takes courage to possess your inheritance. Most times, opportunity will come in a disguised form.

My wife saw me and said the day she saw me, she knew within her heart, *“This is the kind of man I want to marry.”* She saw me in a blue suit while I was working. I have always been a smart person.

She saw me coming to church and simply said, *“This is the kind of man of God I like.”*

God answers the desires of the heart. And without me knowing, God was already answering her prayer. Without me even knowing it, God was already working things out.

Then I proposed to her.

May God answer your prayers.

So do not keep saying, “How will it happen?” Forget it. It is not you that will chase the right connection; God will bring it.

I was the one who went to ask her to marry me because she was extremely dedicated to God. As a pastor, I needed someone who was deeply committed to prayer, because if I go for the wrong person, it can take me out of ministry.

My wife loves prayer. She prays intensely, at least two nights every week—Wednesdays and Fridays.

If you marry a pastor’s wife who does not pray, you are in trouble. My wife prays until morning. She is a good woman. May God give you a good wife. Some people even pray wrongly, saying, *“Let my husband die so I can collect property.”* That is evil.

Marriage is not a place of manipulation; it is covenant.

4. Supernatural Supply Through Giving

Now number four.

The fourth way to provoke supernatural supply is through giving.

Through what? Giving.

In 2 Kings 7:9–10, the lepers said:

“We do not well: this day is a day of good tidings, and we hold our peace...”

They did not eat alone.

They were willing to share what they had received.

Be a covenant practitioner.

Do not live for yourself. Live to bless the kingdom and humanity.

You cannot enjoy supernatural supplies if you live only for yourself.

Be a promoter of the kingdom.

Be a blessing to people.

Never live a self-centred life.

Be free-handed.

Bless the kingdom of God.

Promote the kingdom of God.

Pay your tithe faithfully. Do not compromise it.

Malachi 3:10 teaches us the principle of tithing.

Be free-handed in giving.

Giving is living.

“Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over...” (Luke 6:38)

Genesis 8:22, Proverbs 11:24, and other scriptures confirm the principle of sowing and reaping.

Give God your substance, not your leftovers.

You cannot give God trash and expect treasures.

David gave God treasure (1 Chronicles 29:3–5).

Solomon gave treasure (1 Kings 3:3–5, 12–13).

Even God gave treasure—He gave His Son (John 3:16).

If God gave treasure, then you cannot be found giving Him trash. The more you give, the more you receive. Anyone who says giving is foolish must first become a giver before they understand. The day you die to money is the day you become truly free.

Money wants to be worshipped, but you cannot serve God and mammon. When a man dies to money, he conquers greed. Man is naturally selfish. You must kill selfishness. If you struggle to give, it is because selfishness is still alive. You must come to a place where money loses control over your heart.

The Mystery of Giving and Impartation

Recently, I received a deep revelation while listening to a testimony about a wristwatch. I began to reflect deeply on what I give and what I release. And I began to understand that whatever I give carries movement.

So I began to see watches differently.

When I give someone a watch, I am not just giving an item—I am releasing motion, progress, and shift. I do not just give watches randomly. I am led.

When I see someone stagnant, I may release a watch and say, *“Let your life move.”*

I have given hundreds of watches—many, many watches. Even people around me have received two, three, or four watches each. Anything you give, you do not lack.

I do not give because people ask. I give because I am led. There are moments I simply pick watches and release them as God directs. Because when you give, something is released in motion. A man of God once shared how he received a watch and began to experience movement in his life. So I began to understand that impartation can be carried through giving.

Honour in Receiving

There are times I test honour.

Someone may be offered something and refuse it. But when something carries grace, you do not reject it casually.

Sometimes proximity does not mean connection.

There are people far away who carry more grace than those physically close.

Do not despise what God sends to you.

Even clothes given in honour carry value beyond material worth.

When an anointed man gives you something, it is not ordinary.

Demonstration of the Anointing

Let me demonstrate something.

Whatever comes from the anointed carries the anointing.

Whatever is connected to grace carries grace.

There was a man with pain in his leg for over ten years.

When his foot touched what had been released under anointing, the power of God healed him instantly.

Do not become too familiar with the anointing, or you may lose sensitivity to it.

Even in Scripture, the bones of Elisha raised the dead (2 Kings 13:21).

The anointing does not die.

It is a spiritual force that remains active.

The Power of Honour and Obedience

Do not despise what God sends your way. Some people were given opportunities but did not recognize them. Opportunity must be discerned. When honour is absent, access is lost. When pride is present, blessing is resisted. Even when something is small in human eyes, it may carry divine weight.

Do not miss your moment.

David gave treasure, Solomon gave treasure, and God gave His greatest treasure—His Son.

Therefore, do not give God anything less than honour.

Give God your best.

The more you give, the more you rise.

I receive grace for obedience.

I receive grace to act on what I have heard.

I receive grace to walk in kingdom principles.

Prophetic Declaration

As I speak, I hear the Spirit of God say:

Rise and shine.

No force will stop your lifting.

No opposition will hinder your destiny.

What God has ordained for you shall manifest.

Those you once depended on will begin to depend on you.

Before three months, testimonies shall erupt in your life.

In the name of Jesus Christ, it is done.
