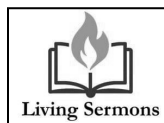

Introduction

The message today is a secret to impactful living.

The secret is speaking the right words.

The message is simple yet powerful: **Speak the right words.**

That is the message.

Speak the right words.

Your life is controlled by your words.

Your words control your life. Everything about your life is controlled by the words you speak.

The Invisible Power Of Words

In John 3:8, *“The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit.”*

If you are born again, God is saying anything you say has power to manifest. That which is born of the Spirit is spirit; that which is born of the flesh is flesh. So every born again person controls his life from invisible things that come forth. The words you speak are not visible. Nobody can see the words you speak. But do not think the words you speak do not have power. Can you see what I am speaking now? No. But the effect is there.

Just like the wind—you cannot see it, but you see its effect. So also, the words you speak are not visible, but their effects are visible in your life.

The sounds you make determine the signs you see.

Your Mouth: A Weapon Of Authority

Your mouth is a weapon of authority that has dominion on the earth.

In Luke 21:15: *“For I will give you a mouth and wisdom, which all your adversaries shall not be able to gainsay nor resist.”*

God is saying no devil can resist what you say. No witch can override what you declare. Many have faith but do not speak. In 2 Corinthians 4:13: *“We having the same spirit of faith... I believed, and therefore have I spoken.”*

Yes, many believe God’s Word, but stop at believing. If all you do is believe, there will be no manifestation. *“I believed and therefore have I spoken.”*

Faith is not complete until it is spoken.

Faith Must Be Declared

We also believe, and therefore we speak. No faith produces manifestation without declaration. You may believe you will prosper, but if you do not say it, it will not manifest.

“I am rich.”

“I am blessed.”

“I cannot be poor.”

If you do not speak it, you may never walk in it. Faith is not finished until it is spoken. God Himself followed this principle. In Genesis chapter 1, God said... God said... God said... and God saw.

May you see what you have said in Jesus name. Amen.

Life And Death In The Tongue

When you speak the Word of God, it delivers from trouble. In Proverbs 12:6, *“The mouth of the upright shall deliver them.”*

When there is crisis, declare your victory in advance. “I am coming out with a testimony.”

And it shall be so in Jesus name. Health and healing also come through bold declaration of God’s Word. Even when you know “by His stripes I am healed,” if you do not say it, it may not manifest.

In Proverbs 12:18: *“The tongue of the wise is health.”*

Your health is in your mouth. Many are not careful with their words. “I am very sick...”—words like that open doors to manifestation of sickness.

Be careful what you say.

Say: **“I am healed. I live in sound health.”**

Words Open Doors

Words can give access to important people and high places.

Proverbs 16:13 shows that righteous lips are the delight of kings.

Right words open doors to authority and influence.

The Power Of Proverbs And Daily Living

The book of Proverbs is a manual for daily living. It teaches how to deal with people, relationships, wisdom, and even difficult situations. Everything about human behaviour is addressed in Proverbs.

Proverbs 13:3: *“He that keepeth his mouth keepeth his life.”*

Some people destroy their lives with their own words. Anger-filled declarations can set destructive things in motion. Be careful not to speak in moments of emotion. Cancel every careless word spoken in anger by the blood of Jesus. Your life moves in the direction of what you keep saying. Words are seeds. Genesis 8:22 confirms seedtime and harvest. Luke 8 shows the seed is the Word of God. What you keep saying is what you will keep seeing.

Speak well, and it shall be well with you. You cannot reach a great destiny speaking small. In the world it may look like pride, but in the kingdom, it is how life works. You must learn to speak according to your destiny.

Do not speak poverty. Do not speak limitation. You are blessed. You are rich in God. Your life is not defined by your current condition but by your covenant identity. Even if conditions look small, your confession must remain large.

The Report Of The Spies (Numbers 13)

In Numbers 13, the spies saw the land and confirmed it was good. But they also spoke fear, limitation, and defeat. Only Caleb declared, “We are well able.”

Words determine outcomes. The people saw themselves as grasshoppers, and so it became their reality. How you see yourself is how you will speak—and how you speak shapes your future.

Change Your Words, Change Your Future

Your words shape nations, families, and destinies. Negative declarations produce negative outcomes. But faith-filled words produce victory.

A 21-Day Practice Of Declaration

For the next 21 days, speak intentionally in the direction of your destiny.

Every morning, declare what you want to see.

Speak the Word. Speak life. Speak progress.

If you do this consistently, your life will shift in that direction.

Believe And Speak

Mark 11:23 shows the principle: believe and speak. Believing is not enough—speaking completes faith. Keep saying what you believe. Acts 14:3 shows that bold speaking brings divine confirmation. Your testimony is tied to your bold declarations in God.

Right words can stop the devil and his agents. Luke 21:15 confirms that God gives you a mouth no adversary can resist. David defeated Goliath with words before the stone was ever released. Your victory begins from your mouth.

Open your mouth. Declare life. Declare victory. Declare destiny. Speak the right words consistently. Your future responds to your words. And it shall be so in Jesus' name.

Amen.

Every devil against my life is defeated. Every force of darkness assigned against my destiny is judged. From today, whatever you declare is what will happen in your life.

Shout Amen!

Now declare boldly in the name of Jesus—declare it!

Open your mouth and speak it!

Every devil against your life... every demon against your destiny... speak it out!

No agent of darkness will escape the judgment of God. Whatever is assigned against your life is terminated in the name of Jesus.

The Principle Of Seed Time And Harvest

Right words are seeds. Many only understand seed in terms of giving, but every word spoken is also a seed.

In Luke 8:11, *“The seed is the word of God.”*

Ecclesiastes affirms that seed time and harvest shall not cease. Every word you speak—good or bad—is a seed. You are sowing with your mouth. If you want a better tomorrow, sow the right words today. **Isaiah 55:11 — The Word That Cannot Return Void**

“So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth...” (Isaiah 55:11)

The Word of God does not return void. But there is a divine order: **you are the one who gives voice to His Word.** When God speaks, it is finished. But it is your responsibility to release that Word in declaration.

For example:

- “By His stripes I am healed” becomes powerful when you speak it.
- “No weapon formed against me shall prosper” becomes active when declared.

You give voice to the written Word so it can manifest.

The Ministry Of The Spoken Word

When Jesus was tempted, He said, *“It is written...”*

He was not arguing—He was activating what had already been written. Every situation must be addressed with the appropriate Word of God. Speak it, and it will not return void. You have sown a seed; you must receive a harvest.

1 Peter 1:23 shows that the Word of God is incorruptible seed.

No devil can corrupt the Word you declare in faith. No opposition can stop it. But doubt can cancel it. The issue is not God’s ability—it is your consistency in speaking without doubt.

Do not ask how God will do it. Your responsibility is to declare the Word in faith.

God handles the manifestation.

Say it. Believe it. Speak it.

Angels are ministering spirits sent to serve those who are heirs of salvation (Hebrews 1:14).

Psalms 103:20 confirms:

“Bless the Lord, ye his angels, that excel in strength, that do his commandments, hearkening unto the voice of his word.”

Angels respond to the voice of His Word in your mouth.

They carry out what you declare.

Be careful what you say—even in jokes.

Words are spiritual commands.

Be Careful With Casual Words

Some words are not jokes in the spirit. Do not speak death, failure, or destruction casually. Your mouth is too powerful for careless speech. Even in frustration, guard your declarations.

The same principle works in real life: what you say shapes what you experience. Words carry authority. What you consistently declare begins to manifest.

Words Create Reality

Genesis shows us that God created everything through words. “Let there be light”—and there was light. God did not wait for light before speaking it into existence.

Words are creative forces.

Hebrews 11:3 shows that the worlds were framed by the Word of God. Reality responds to divine speech. There are realms of prosperity, protection, and deliverance—framed by words. To enter them, you must speak into them.

Your Financial Reality And Confession

Every believer has a spiritual account. But withdrawal is not only through giving—it is also through confession. After you give, you must speak:

“I am blessed.”

“I cannot be poor.”

“I walk in supernatural supply.”

Without confession, breakthrough is hindered. As you speak rightly, favour follows you. Wherever you go, divine favour will speak for you. From today, favour will surround your life in Jesus’ name.

Prophecy Is Released Through Speech

Ezekiel 37 shows that dry bones lived when the Word was spoken. God said, “Prophecy.”

Your responsibility is to speak. You are not to ask how—it is to declare. Silence is dangerous in the spirit. Closed mouths cannot enforce destiny. Open your mouth and declare life. Anything contrary to your destiny must respond to your declaration. Speak, and situations shift. Declare, and environments change.

Never allow negative words to remain unchecked. Replace them immediately with God’s Word.

Speak life. Speak healing. Speak victory. Speak destiny.

“Lord Jesus, come into my life.

I accept You as my personal Lord and Saviour.

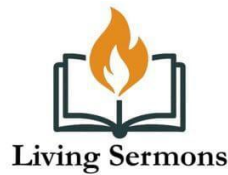
I believe You died and rose again to save me.
