## Introduction

Shiloh 2023 is themed “**Redeemed to Flourish in Hard Times.**”

This morning, by privilege, I will be touching on the subject: “**Unveiling the Mystery of Supernatural Supplies**”

It is important to begin by recognizing that no one can operate in the supernatural with a natural mentality. For as a man thinketh in his heart, so is he (Proverbs 23:7).

According to Scripture, the supernatural is expected to be the natural estate of the redeemed. John 3:8 says:

“He that is born of the Spirit is like the wind...”

You hear the sound of it, but cannot tell where it comes from or where it goes. That is God’s ordination for everyone born again. So we are born to live supernatural lives.

2 Corinthians 5:17 declares:

“If any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.”

The supernatural is therefore the natural lifestyle of every believer. But no one operates in this heritage without a supernatural mentality. The challenge is this: how do we migrate from the natural to the supernatural realm?

We were born through natural processes, raised in natural systems, trained in natural schools, and developed natural skills—yet we are ordained to live a supernatural life.

This means we must be retrained for the supernatural.

It takes a supernatural mindset to experience a supernatural lifestyle.

And this is why Shiloh becomes a mountain of encounter—where transformation from natural thinking to supernatural thinking takes place.

From today onward, I see a supernatural mindset being quickened afresh in your life, in the name of Jesus Christ.

If you believe it, say a loud amen!



# The Reality Of Hard Times And Supernatural Supply

---

We are living in prophetic times.

The Bible makes it clear that the last days will be hard times for the world. Malachi 4:1 describes days that will burn as an oven.

We are in days where shakings are affecting every corner of the earth. People are running from place to place seeking greener pastures, but without divine encounter, no pasture will remain green.

We are entering days where donor nations are becoming debt nations. Even previously developed nations are facing deep struggles.

These are prophetic realities.

But here is the truth:

For the world, it will be hard.

For the redeemed who are covenant-aligned, it will be sweet.

However, this requires a supernatural mentality.

Romans 12:2 says:

“Be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind...”

It takes a renewed mind to enjoy a new life. So while hardship is real, supernatural supply is also real.

## **Biblical Pictures Of Supernatural Supply**

Let us examine Scriptural examples:

### **1. Manna in the Wilderness (Exodus 16:8, 35)**

God fed Israel in the wilderness for forty years—morning and evening provision without fail.

Three million people were fed daily by heaven.

No harvest, no farming, yet divine supply never stopped.

God still supplies His people supernaturally.

No matter how dry the wilderness season may be, the God who rained manna will supply all your needs.

### **2. Elijah by the Brook and the Angelic Supply (1 Kings 17; 19:6–8)**

Elijah was fed by ravens morning and evening.

Later, an angel brought supernatural sustenance for his journey.

Heaven can supply from any source, in any form.

### **3. The Widow's Oil (2 Kings 4:1–7)**

A widow in deep debt was instructed to pour oil into vessels.

As long as vessels were available, the oil kept flowing.

Supernatural supply cancelled her debt and restored her dignity.

### **4. Feeding of the 5,000 (Matthew 14:13–21)**

Five loaves and two fishes fed thousands.

As they distributed, multiplication continued.

The supply increased in the act of obedience and giving.

### **5. Coin from the Fish (Matthew 17:24–27)**

A coin was found in the mouth of a fish to pay tax.

God can command resources from any channel.

Heaven is not limited by systems or economies.

## **Supernatural Supply In Our Generation**

Even in contemporary times, we see clear evidence. Major Kingdom projects testify of divine supply beyond natural explanation. There comes a point where even the beneficiaries become spectators of God's supply.

This shall be your experience in the name of Jesus.



## How Do We Access Supernatural Supplies?

---

### 1. THROUGH SERVICE

Service is a Kingdom access code.

Exodus 23:25:

“And ye shall serve the Lord your God, and he shall bless thy bread, and thy water...”

Service triggers supernatural supply.

Peter gave Jesus his boat, and after service came breakthrough (Luke 5:1–8).

Job also walked in service and became the greatest in the East (Job 1:1–3).

When service becomes lifestyle, lack becomes impossible.

## **2. THROUGH OBEDIENCE**

Mary said:

“Whatsoever he saith unto you, do it.” (John 2:5)

Obedience is a major key to supernatural supply.

Deuteronomy 28:1–2 shows that blessings overtake the obedient.

Heaven responds not merely to prayer—but to obedience.

Obedience is the trigger of divine supply.

I remember the testimony of a particular brother when I was privileged to be in our church in the UK.

It was a month of praise, and this brother had lost his job. There was no money anywhere. He had nothing to even give his children as food.

So he gathered the children together—himself and his wife—and said:

“The instruction for us is that we should praise.”

So they began to dance.

They danced and celebrated God.

They praised and praised and praised until they went to sleep.

The next morning, somebody came and brought all manner of food items.

The person said:

“The Lord just laid it on my heart to bring all of this.”

The individual had no idea what the family was going through.

They dropped the supplies with them, and the family began to dance again.

The next day, another person arrived with more food items.

Again, they danced.

Every day, supplies kept arriving until there was too much to keep. They began distributing to others in need. As they gave things away, more supplies arrived.

It continued like that until he eventually got a job.

Remember, the Bible says God caused manna to rain until they entered the border of Canaan.

The supply continued because obedience continued.

There is power in obedience.

That is why those who ignore scriptural and prophetic instructions become victims in hard times.

No one here will be a victim in these hard times, in the name of Jesus Christ!

Deuteronomy 11:18–21 gives us a clear picture.

God instructed His people to keep His Word continually before them—to teach it to their children, speak of it in the house, meditate on it daily, and engrave it into their lives.

Why?

“That your days may be multiplied... as the days of heaven upon the earth.”

There is a way to live a heavenly life on the earth, and that pathway is obedience.

Lift your right hand to heaven and say:

“Lord, give me grace to obey!”

The instructions of God come in various ways.

Sometimes during prayer, an instruction drops into your spirit.

Sometimes while hearing the Word, direction comes.

But as we engage with divine instructions, they position us for supernatural supplies.

I remember many years ago when God's servant came to dedicate a church facility while I was in one of our stations.

During the dedication, he gave a prophetic word:

“Many of you will build places like this and hand them over to the church as a seed.”

That word entered deeply into my spirit.

Later, after arriving in Canaanland on assignment, I came across a report from a particular zone. They had started building their zonal church facility but needed intervention to complete it.

Immediately, there was a witness in my spirit:

“This is your opportunity.”

I had some money saved and thought it would be enough to complete the project. But when the estimate came, it was far beyond what I had.

Then another instruction came:

“Your car.”

I sold the car and used the proceeds to complete the project.

From there, everything changed.

That one instruction became the trigger for the next chapter of my life.

By the grace and mercy of God, we have now seen several projects completed from start to finish.

Please hear this carefully:

### **Obedience may not be convenient.**

Many times, divine instructions oppose personal comfort.

But whatever will comfort your future may first discomfort your present.

That is why obedience must remain the watchword of anyone who intends to flourish in hard times.

We were told earlier that this is the best time to sow.

Genesis 26 tells us that Isaac sowed in famine, and in the same year he reaped a hundredfold.

What looked like a difficult season became a season of opportunities.

By the grace of obedience coming afresh upon your life, I see each one of us entering realms of unusual supplies, in the name of Jesus Christ.

### **3. THROUGH ENGAGEMENT ON THE HARVEST FIELD**

Another key to supernatural supplies is engagement in Kingdom advancement—especially in the pursuit of souls.

Luke 22:35 says:

“When I sent you without purse, and scrip, and shoes, lacked ye any thing?  
And they said, Nothing.”

Those committed to the advancement of God’s Kingdom become candidates for Heaven’s supply.

John 4:36 says:

“And he that reapeth receiveth wages...”

As you become sold out to seeing souls saved and established in the faith, Heaven's supplies begin to rush in your direction.

We are instructed in Scripture to follow the faith of those ahead of us.

We see our father in the faith tirelessly pursuing souls. That is one of the secrets behind ceaseless supply.

As you keep giving God what He requires, He keeps giving you what you desire.

#### **4. THROUGH TITHING**

Malachi 3:10–11 says:

“Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse... and prove me now herewith... if I will not open you the windows of heaven...”

Tithing is one of the covenant channels for supernatural supply.

The tithe is 10% of whatever God brings your way.

It belongs to God.

We do not merely give tithe—we return what belongs to Him.

The tithe secures your portion and preserves your harvest.

Hebrews 7:8 tells us:

“Here men that die receive tithes; but there he receiveth them...”

When tithe is paid on earth, it answers in heaven.

# **The Mystery Of The Cloud And The Rain**

In nature, rainfall follows a process:

- Evaporation
- Condensation
- Rainfall

Our givings are like vapour ascending upward. But tithe is the trigger that condenses the cloud into rain.

I remember seeing heavy clouds gathering one day. It looked as though rain would fall heavily. But suddenly the clouds began moving away until the darkness disappeared and the rain fell somewhere else.

The cloud was heavy, but it could not release rain over that ground. In the same way, tithe unlocks what your heavens are pregnant with. If you are not a tither, things will only become tighter.

## **A Childhood Lesson On Tithing**

As a child, tithing was taught to us practically. Whenever visitors gave us money, my mother had a system. We would record every amount and place it in a designated bag.

Why?

So that the tithe would be separated before the money was touched. This ingrained spiritual sensitivity into us from childhood. Before spending anything, God's portion came first. That discipline became natural.

Let us stop spiritual negotiations around tithe. Anything less than 10% is not tithe.

May God grant us grace and wisdom to remain faithful tithers, in the name of Jesus Christ.

## **5. ENGAGE THE FORCE OF FAITH**

Faith is a non-negotiable factor in commanding supernatural supplies.

Luke 1:45 says:

“Blessed is she that believed: for there shall be a performance...”

Yes, engage covenant practices.

Yes, engage obedience.

Yes, engage stewardship.

But also engage your faith. The covenant cannot fail. Everything in this Kingdom answers to faith. Where faith is absent, connection is broken.

Our connection to Heaven’s supplies is ultimately a product of faith. So keep your faith alive. Do not be overwhelmed by surrounding circumstances.

Remain connected to your covenant heritage. God’s servant once shared how, during the construction of the Tabernacle, there would be urgent financial needs. Yet instructions would go forth:

“Go ahead.”

And supplies would arrive.

Faith at high tension provoked unusual supplies.



## Closing Exhortation

---

My prayer for each one of us is this:

In these hard times for the world, this season will become your best times on the earth. God will turn your life into open wonders, in the name of Jesus Christ. Lift your hands before the Lord and pray:

“Lord, I receive grace to put Your Word to work.”

Ask for grace from the depth of your heart.

Grace to obey.

Grace to believe.

Grace to engage covenant practices.

Grace to walk in supernatural supplies.

Thank You, Father. In Jesus’ precious name we have prayed. By that grace, your life shall become a living wonder, in the name of Jesus Christ.

Give Jesus a big hand of praise!
