Give that hand to Jesus. Give that hand. Hallelujah. Give that hand to Jesus Christ. If you are clapping, give it to the King of all kings. Give that hand to the One we have come to celebrate.

In Jesus' mighty name.

I deeply appreciate God for this privilege. I appreciate my father and my mother for that powerful word. I want to say to every one of us: you cannot be here and remain the same.

Heavenly Father, speak to us through Your Word. Breathe Your breath, Holy Spirit, upon the Word of life. Encapsulate every word that will come out of my mouth, and I vow to give You all the glory. Thank You, Father. In Jesus' mighty name.

You may be seated with a big hand to Jesus.

Engaging the Power of the Tongue and Commanding the Supernatural The message given to me is: Engaging the Power of the Tongue and Commanding the Supernatural.

In 1996, when my father preached a message titled "*The Tongue: Trigger for Signs and Wonders*," I listened to it until I could recite it offhand. When he gave me this topic, I smiled. He had already given me the blueprint.

Now hear this:

The transformation of any man's life is found one inch below his nose — which is his mouth. The louder you declare the Word, the better your destiny becomes. Every child of God is born a sign to his world.

Born Again: A Candidate for the Supernatural

John 3:8 (KJV)

"The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit."

If you are born again, you are a candidate for signs and wonders. Being born again grants access to the supernatural, but it takes an open mouth to flow in the supernatural. Your destiny will never be closed.

Psalm 81:10–14 (KJV)

“I am the Lord thy God, which brought thee out of the land of Egypt: open thy mouth wide, and I will fill it...”

It takes sound to produce signs.

No sound, no sign.

God Said Before God Saw

In Genesis 1, the Bible says repeatedly:

“And God said...”

Before God saw, God said.

If God never said it, He would not have seen it. Words are so important to God that He called Himself the Word. Words create worlds — and it is your words that will create your world.

Hebrews 11:3 (KJV)

“Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God...”

There is the financial world.

The world of protection.

The world of deliverance.

The world of healing.

Without the Word of God in your mouth, you cannot create your world. A closed mouth will hinder the flow of the supernatural. But from today, I see you opening your mouth wide.

God Confirms What You Declare

Isaiah 44:26 (KJV)

“That confirmeth the word of his servant...”

Mark 16:20 (KJV)

“...the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following.”

God confirms what you declare. If you say nothing, God has nothing to confirm. Faith is voice-activated.

2 Corinthians 4:13 (KJV)

“...we also believe, and therefore speak.”

Belief is not enough. You must say what you believe.

The Power of Bold Declarations

No matter how anointed you are, a closed mouth will shut down the supernatural.

Acts 14:3 (KJV)

“...speaking boldly in the Lord... and granted signs and wonders to be done by their hands.”

Bold declaration empowers you to walk in the supernatural.

Acts 4:29–30 (KJV)

“...grant unto thy servants, that with all boldness they may speak thy word... that signs and wonders may be done...”

There is power in my tongue.

Say it: There is power in my tongue to stop every adversary against my life.

Jesus Spoke — and It Happened. At the tomb of Lazarus:

John 11:43 (KJV)

“...he cried with a loud voice, Lazarus, come forth.”

If He had kept quiet, Lazarus would not have come out. Every death situation in your life turns now, in the name of Jesus. In Mark 11:14, Jesus spoke to the fig tree — and it withered. The disciples heard Him.

He did not just look at it. He spoke.

In Mark 4:39 (KJV):

“Peace, be still.”

And the wind ceased.

He commanded the wind and the sea — and they obeyed His voice. Many believers cannot declare boldly because there is no Word in their heart.

Matthew 12:34 (KJV)

“...out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh.”

You cannot withdraw from an account where there is no deposit.

Store the Word in your heart — then declare it with authority.

What Your Words Can Do

1. Your Words Commit God to Perform

Numbers 14:28 (KJV)

“...as ye have spoken in mine ears, so will I do to you.”

When you speak in line with God’s Word, you commit Him to perform.

2. Your Words Stop the Devil

Luke 21:15 (KJV)

“For I will give you a mouth and wisdom, which all your adversaries shall not be able to gainsay nor resist.”

When Goliath spoke, David spoke back.

When Satan spoke, Jesus replied:

“It is written.”

Never allow the enemy to have the final say. Make sure the word ends in your mouth — not in the mouth of your adversary.

3. Your Words Are Seeds

Luke 8:11 (KJV)

“The seed is the word of God.”

Every time you speak God’s Word, you are sowing seed. Where you are today is a product of what you said yesterday. Seedtime and harvest shall not cease.

Mind what you say.

You are not broke because money is not in your pocket. That money is not in your pocket does not mean you are broke.

You shall have whatsoever you say.

4. Your Words Commit Angels to Act

Hebrews 1:14 (KJV)

“Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?”

Psalms 103:20 (KJV)

“...that do his commandments, hearkening unto the voice of his word.”

Angels hearken to the voice of His Word — when you give it voice.

There is no idle talk in the Kingdom. Speak carefully.

5. Your Words Are Creative

Proverbs 18:21 (KJV)

“Death and life are in the power of the tongue...”

In Genesis 1, God said — and God saw. May you speak life from today.

Keep Saying It Until You See It

Mark 11:23 (KJV)

Notice:

“Shall say...” — repeated three times.

“Believe...” — once.

If you believe, do not stop saying it until you see it.

Say it.

Say it again.

Like the rudder of a ship, you keep turning it until the ship changes direction. Do not change your language because of challenges.

Keep saying:

“By His stripes I am healed.”

“My body, hear the Word of the Lord.”

Keep speaking until you see it.

The Final Trigger

Romans 10:9–10 (KJV)

“...with the heart man believeth... and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.”

Without the mouth, salvation itself is not completed. Whatever you believe, begin to declare it.

Trigger signs and wonders. The things you want to see tomorrow — say them now.

And you will command the supernatural.

Rise to your feet.
