Every Kingdom Secret Is an Open Secret

Hallelujah.

Praise the Lord.

Every Kingdom secret is an open secret.

“What I tell you in darkness, that speak ye in light: and what ye hear in the ear, that preach ye upon the housetops” (Matthew 10:27).

As Jesus tarries between now and next Shiloh, you are a new you in the precious name of Jesus. If those I learned from had kept from me what I learned from them, I would not have been able to access it. You don't lack what you give; you only lack what you keep.

Every act of God is ordained to become an open testimony. If it is the act of God, it must speak. My prayer is that the light that has come our way will keep speaking for life.

“I know that, whatsoever God doeth, it shall be for ever” (Ecclesiastes 3:14).

May your experience here last each one of us a lifetime, in the name of Jesus. We have emphasized for a long time the need for knowledge—the knowledge of the truth that sets free. But it is not enough to engage in a search. Engage in a search **until you find**.

Our text is **Proverbs 24:13–14**:

“My son, eat thou honey, because it is good; and the honeycomb, which is sweet to thy taste:

So shall the knowledge of wisdom be unto thy soul: when thou hast found it, then there shall be a reward, and thy expectation shall not be cut off.”

Not when you have searched it—when you have **found** it. It is what you find that defines you. We have settled with the need to search. But searching without finding produces no proofs. When thou hast found it, there shall be a reward. Expectations will turn to manifestations when you have found it.

Search Until You Find

I read books on prosperity repeatedly. I could quote them. I could preach them. But I had not found it. So I went back to God. I fasted. I prayed. I searched. Then I found it. When I found it, I knew. I screamed, “I can never be poor.”

“Thy words were found, and I did eat them; and thy word was unto me the joy and rejoicing of mine heart” (Jeremiah 15:16).

Embark on a search until you find. Jesus said:

“Come unto me... Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me... and ye shall find rest unto your souls” (Matthew 11:28–29).

Learn until you find. Seek until you find.

“Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you” (Matthew 7:7–8).

He that seeketh finds.

Don’t let anyone make you feel good just because you are searching. Search until you find. Put what you find to work until it commands proofs. Knock until the door opens. Not a casual knock—but a determined knock. If your hand is hurting, use another finger. I must enter.

Leave Shiloh with a sense of responsibility: I am absolutely responsible for the outcome of my life. There are no private testimonies in the Kingdom.

“Thy testimonies have I taken as an heritage for ever: for they are the rejoicing of my heart” (Psalm 119:111).

What You Find Redefines You

When the secret was revealed to Daniel, it redefined his destiny (Daniel 2:19). When Joseph found the key to the impending crisis, God redefined his destiny (Genesis 41).

Job said:

“When the secret of God was upon my tabernacle” (Job 29:4).

It turned him into the greatest businessman of his time—by access to what others did not know. It is what we find that defines us.

Some speak lightly about the covenant of prosperity. They have never found it. When I found from Scripture that if you are not a tither, no matter what you preach, you will beg at the end, it settled it for me.

“The same Lord over all is rich unto all that call upon him” (Romans 10:12).

There is no discrimination in the gospel.

“For God so loved the world...” (John 3:16).

Black is not synonymous with lack. White is not synonymous with worth. It is not the nation—it is the individual. When I found my place in the covenant, I knew poverty was not part of that package.

You are free. Between now and next Shiloh, you will sing a new song.

What God Shows You Is What Shows You to Your World

Jesus said:

“The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do” (John 5:19).

What He shows you will make the world marvel at you. Nobody can see for you.

“Lift up now thine eyes... for all the land which thou seest, to thee will I give it”
(Genesis 13:14–15).

Your eyes must see it before God can give it.

Carnality cannot secure access to truth.

“I, brethren, could not speak unto you as unto spiritual, but as unto carnal...” (1
Corinthians 3:1–2).

*“For every one that useth milk is unskilful in the word of righteousness: for he is a
babe”* (Hebrews 5:13).

An heir, as long as he is a child, differs nothing from a servant (Galatians 4:1–4). The natural man cannot receive the things of the Spirit of God (1 Corinthians 2:14). No matter how hard a carnal man searches, he cannot find.

Please, grow up spiritually.

Light Your Candle

In **Luke 15:8–10**, the woman who lost one piece of silver lit a candle and swept diligently until she found it.

“The spirit of man is the candle of the LORD” (Proverbs 20:27).

Light your candle if you want to find. Set your spirit on its feet in a search. It is not an intellectual resource; it is a spiritual resource. Set your spiritual antenna in place.

Finding becomes natural.

There is no end to finding. There is no end to finding. There is no end to finding. It is your turn. What you don't seek, you can't find. Seeking without finding is a waste of time. Go for it until

you find it. When you find it, there shall be a reward. There shall be proofs that cannot be doubted. That is your new realm.

In the name of Jesus, you shall not know a fall. Circumstances will no longer rule your life. The covenant will put you in command forever.

If You Must Find

“With my soul have I desired thee in the night; yea, with my spirit within me will I seek thee”
(Isaiah 26:9).

If you must find, you must seek with your spirit. Searching with your head, you cannot find God. “With my spirit within me will I seek thee.”

When I go after You with my spirit, I will find. If there is anything in me today, it is that every grace I have ever touched in my life, I will be alive to see you flowing in it on the same frequency and higher—if you will care to do what the Bible says to do.

We are still learning. There is no graduate in this school. You are either a senior student or a new student. Everybody is a student. Settle down. Ignorance is the greatest torment of a believer. Do not subscribe to it.

Spiritual Disposition Is Non-Negotiable

The system is being corrupted. People are busy quoting unbelievers to teach truth. How can the living be envious of the dead?

You will not find me making reference to unbelievers to define my destiny. The little I know—if you will do the little I know—you will see results. I am still learning. It is not grammar; it is power.

“The secret of the LORD is with them that fear him; and he will shew them his covenant” (Psalm 25:14).

The secret things belong to God. Only what He reveals can belong to us. You must position yourself among those to whom He will reveal things.

You Are Precious in His Sight

“Since thou wast precious in my sight, thou hast been honourable, and I have loved thee: therefore will I give men for thee, and people for thy life” (Isaiah 43:4).

Any agent of the devil that tries to stop your way after this event will go down for you. You are precious in His sight.

“Let my son go... if thou refuse... I will slay thy son” (Exodus 4:22–23). Whatever will not let you go, God will clear out of the way. Search with your spirit and you shall find. Light your candle.

“The spirit of man is the candle of the LORD” (Proverbs 20:27).

The Wisdom of Mighty Works

God’s Word is the treasure chest of wisdom because Jesus, the Living Word, is the wisdom and the power of God. This is not theoretical wisdom. It is the wisdom of mighty works.

“From whence hath this man this wisdom, and these mighty works?” (Matthew 13:54).

Not mighty grammar—mighty works.

“The LORD by wisdom hath founded the earth” (Proverbs 3:19).

“O LORD, how manifold are thy works! in wisdom hast thou made them all” (Psalm 104:24).

I release you into the realm of mighty works. Welcome to your era of mighty works. Everything He leads you into will turn mighty in your hands.

The Word Makes Wise

God's Word is God's wisdom bank.

"The law of the LORD is perfect... the commandment of the LORD is pure... making wise the simple" (Psalm 19:7–8).

"Thou through thy commandments hast made me wiser than mine enemies" (Psalm 119:98).
David behaved himself wisely (1 Samuel 18:14). Wisdom and knowledge shall be the stability of thy times (Isaiah 33:6). Operating by the wisdom of Scripture makes you unshakably stable—an all-weather believer.

Nothing will go down in your life.

Nothing will go down in your family.

Nothing will go down in your business.

Nothing will go down in your career.

Nothing will go down in your ministry.

"If thou be wise, thou shalt be wise for thyself: but if thou scornest, thou alone shalt bear it" (Proverbs 9:12).

Register in This School of Lifelong Learning

"Give instruction to a wise man, and he will be yet wiser" (Proverbs 9:9).

Register in this school of lifelong learning. It will make you wiser by the day and wiser than your enemies. There is no end to finding. It is your turn.

You Cannot Find a Treasure and Hold Back

“The kingdom of heaven is like unto treasure hid in a field; the which when a man hath found, he hideth, and for joy thereof goeth and selleth all that he hath, and buyeth that field” (Matthew 13:44).

When you truly find, you go all the way. If a man drags himself to church, he has not found the treasure in fellowship. When he finds it, nothing will keep him away.

“Buy the truth, and sell it not; also wisdom, and instruction, and understanding” (Proverbs 23:23).

Whatever you are sluggish to buy into, you have not found. I found treasure in soul winning. I bought into it wholeheartedly. And I am enjoying it with utmost delight. Protection from evil. Favour money cannot buy. Access no human connection can deliver. If you find the treasure in giving, it becomes stress-free engagement. Grace to search till you find. Grace to knock until the door is opened. Receive it in the name of Jesus.

By What He Found

A man read *Keys to Divine Health* in 1986. On page 20 he found light. He discovered that Satan is not a gentleman. He discharged himself from hospital against medical expectation. Ten years later, he was still standing—by what he found. If he had not found it, who knows the outcome?

By what he found. There is an answer waiting, no matter the question. One woman faced a strange affliction in her home. She began searching Scripture from Genesis. She reached Jeremiah before she found the answer. When the Word came, the siege was over.

There is an answer waiting.

No matter the question, there is an answer waiting.

And you will find it.

Settle down for an adventure in searching to find. Between now and next Shiloh, your findings will keep refining your destiny. You will move from one realm of glory to another. If there is crisis in your business, search for light on business breakthrough. If there is challenge in your health, search for light on healing and wholeness.
