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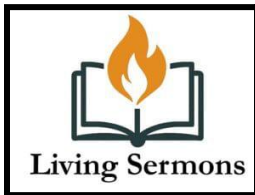

The Encounter

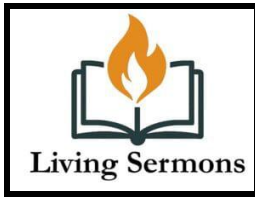
Hallelujah. Praise the Lord.

Your hour has finally come. No one is leaving here with any trace of oppression of the wicked, in the name of Jesus. There are no group encounters with God. Encounters with God are on an individual basis. There is no group success in an exam—success is on an individual basis.

“Look unto Abraham your father... for I called him alone” (Isaiah 51:2).

“Go ye rather to them that sell, and buy for yourselves” (Matthew 25:9).

Refuse to be lost in the crowd. It is your personal encounter that opens new chapters to your life. May you secure a personal encounter today that will open new chapters to your life.



Get Serious with God

While writing my note when I turned fifty-five in the faith, the first thing I saw was this: being serious with God is what guarantees a glorious future.

Get serious with prayer. Please, get serious. Get serious with God. Don't be casual—get serious with God. Your next chapters are not in view without your personal encounters. Get serious with God, sir.

I went for an all-night prayer on Psalm 1:1–3, saying:

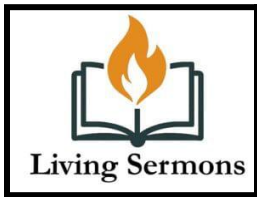
“Lord, connect me only with those who are going forward. Disconnect me from those who are going backward. Make my ears deaf to things that do not edify. Make my eyes blind to things that do not build up.”

I was praying my way into securing my destiny by keeping godly associations.

Get serious with God.

“Lord, what is the secret of Kingdom prosperity?” I was on a three-day fast—reading, searching, and praying. Get serious with God. Forty-four years after, I'm still flowing in it. Get serious with God. Cry, “God, let me see revival before I go to heaven!”

We are too casual for the things we are looking for. “Seest thou a man diligent in his business?” (Proverbs 22:29). Our core business is Kingdom business. “Wist ye not that I must be about my Father's business?” (Luke 2:49). Your spiritual life is your core life. Get serious with God. My personal encounters have been counting in my favour till now.



The Power of Personal Encounters

A jeep climbed over a small boy—first tyre, second tyre—and there was no broken bone. The boy went to the table, took the anointing oil, and gave it to his father: “Anoint me.”

Get serious with God. The faith of the parents will edify the children. This is another open encounter platform. May you catch your own. Why is this church not growing? I went on a three-day prayer and fasting with two others. On the third day, help came down—see the result.

If that encounter never happened, the chapter would not open. Get serious with God. Don't carry things that are not part of your destiny. “Whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely” (Revelation 22:17). There is life on this ground this morning. Everyone whose heart is genuinely panting—you will partake of your portion.

New chapters must open to everyone's life from this service, in the name of Jesus.

Acknowledging the Manifold Grace of God

Father, thank You for Your undeniable grace that has brought us thus far. To You alone be all the glory. May I congratulate all members of this family—nuclear and extended—on this 45th anniversary celebration.

I was still in that vision 45 years ago. God was taking me through an agenda I was least qualified for—but for the grace of election, and to Him alone be all the glory. We are looking at acknowledging the manifold grace of God upon this church. “As every man hath received the gift, even so minister the same one to another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God... that God in all things may be glorified through Jesus Christ” (1 Peter 4:10–11).

What is Grace?

Grace is a most abused word today. Please listen with all intent and purpose. Grace, by biblical definition, can be described as:

1. Divine Endowment

Grace is a divine endowment—it implies divine enabling, getting us into things beyond our natural limitations. “I am what I am by the grace of God... yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me” (1 Corinthians 15:10).

2. Divine Orchestration

Grace is what God makes happen on His own. “The gospel... was not after man... but by the revelation of Jesus Christ” (Galatians 1:11–12).

3. Divine Help

“Having therefore obtained help of God, I continue unto this day” (Acts 26:22). “Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace... to find grace to help in time of need” (Hebrews 4:16).

Grace helps us beyond our limits. “My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness” (2 Corinthians 12:9). Grace is divine help.

Grace helps you to do—it does not do it for you. Grace helps you to do. The grace being preached today across the nations is questionable. Nothing empowers grace like the truth you engage with.

“And the child grew... and the grace of God was upon him” (Luke 2:40).

“Full of grace and truth” (John 1:14). Of His fullness have we all received—grace for grace (John 1:16). Christ is the author of grace. He exemplifies what grace represents.

Grace Upon Churches

Every church or ministry carries specific grace. The church in Judea carried the grace to weather persecution triumphantly (1 Thessalonians 2:14). The Macedonian church carried unusual giving grace:

“How that in a great trial of affliction... their deep poverty abounded unto the riches of their liberality” (2 Corinthians 8:2).

They gave beyond their power. They first gave themselves to God. They gave their way out of poverty into plenty. Maybe that is the story of our church. We are not a church of rich people—we are a church of poor people made rich. You are the next to be made rich.

Testimonies are simply acknowledgments of the grace of God at work—they are not a show of strength. “I will speak of thy testimonies also before kings, and will not be ashamed” (Psalm 119:46).

Impact in ministry is simply a manifestation of the manifold grace of God. “For by strength shall no man prevail” (1 Samuel 2:9).

Spiritual environment can be very contagious when your heart is connected. Saul found himself among the prophets—and he began to prophesy (1 Samuel 10:10). What are the manifestations of His grace in this ministry?

Forty-five years of peace that passes all understanding—with no crisis to manage. “The Lord shall fight for you, and ye shall hold your peace” (Exodus 14:14). That is the covenant platform that makes God fight our battles.

1. Peace as a Covenant Right

I have never heard, and nobody has ever met me here, when an announcement is made that creates tension or apprehension—“See what they are doing against us.” No.

We just watch our victories on the screen like anybody else. From today, that becomes your testimony—because the peace of God is your birthright in redemption. Among the proofs of redemption are love, joy, and peace.

“And Christ said, *My peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you*” (John 14:27). You have struggled enough. Let God take over your fight by holding your peace. Let God take over your fight by holding your peace. I have never had one sleepless night over this ministry in forty-five years—one.

When they say, “People are fighting you”—it is not a fight when there are not two parties involved. If you are the only one fighting, then you have a problem. “There remaineth therefore a rest to the people of God” (Hebrews 4:9).

May you catch it today.

2. Joy Unspeakable, Full of Glory

Forty-five years of joy unspeakable, full of glory—which secures divine presence that always makes the difference. Joy and rejoicing are the atmosphere of heaven.

“In thy presence is fulness of joy; at thy right hand there are pleasures for evermore” (Psalm 16:11).

This is a joyful family.

Someone asked me years ago, “Do you ever have problems?” I said, “Maybe they came, I didn’t know.”

May the overwhelming joy of salvation come upon you today. Now listen:

- Joy gives access to strength. “The joy of the Lord is your strength” (Nehemiah 8:10).
- Joy procures health. “A merry heart doeth good like a medicine” (Proverbs 17:22).
- Joy secures access to the voice of God. “Blessed is the people that know the joyful sound” (Psalm 89:15).

When you operate in this realm of joy unspeakable, full of glory:

- Your strength is renewed
- Your health is revitalised
- Your access to divine direction becomes clear

The grace of joy and rejoicing is among the manifold grace of God upon this commission. You see us rejoicing—you think we are in a glass house. No. It is joy unspeakable, full of glory. One soul saved is enough to turn me crazy.

Stop murmuring and complaining—it complicates your case. Nobody moves forward complaining in the Kingdom. Today, you are leaving with the grace of joy and rejoicing. It belongs to you as a member of this family, and it shall be yours for life.

Three channels of this grace include:

- **The joy of salvation**
- **The joy of revelation** — “Thy words were found, and I did eat them; and thy word was unto me the joy and rejoicing of mine heart” (Jeremiah 15:16)
- **Joy in the Holy Ghost** — “For the kingdom of God is... righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost” (Romans 14:17)

You are an embodiment of joy. Depression has no place around your life. Today marks the end of every trace of depression in your life.

3. Ever-Burning Love for God

Forty-five years of ever-burning love for God, which keeps all things working together for our good. This is a church of great lovers of God. You find people cleaning the church—smiling. Cleaning the gutters—smiling. Controlling traffic—smiling. Serving everywhere with joy and rejoicing.

“And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God” (Romans 8:28). As you keep your love for God alive and growing, all things will keep working together for your good. Keep your love for God alive. Stop religiosity. Enter into the realm of redemptive realities.

Ask yourself: when last did you ask God for something?

“Lord, give me a house, give me a car...” No. Seek His Kingdom—and all these things will be added. When last did this church pray for money? Never. We pray: “Lord, go before us, go with us, save the lost, establish them.”

And the doors keep opening. Keep your love for God alive and growing. This service will mark the end of every concern in your life. “For eye hath not seen, nor ear heard... the things which God hath prepared for them that love him” (1 Corinthians 2:9).

4. Continuous Growth and Expansion

Forty-five years of continuous growth and expansion. “Except the Lord build the house, they labour in vain that build it” (Psalm 127:1). Every house is built by someone, but He that built all things is God (Hebrews 3:4). This is nothing but the hand of God at work.

5. Kingdom-Advancement Prayer Lifestyle

Forty-five years of praying Kingdom-advancement prayers leading to open rewards on every side. “Seek ye first the kingdom of God... and all these things shall be added unto you” (Matthew 6:33).

Your engagement in secret brings open rewards.

6. Fearful Favour

Forty-five years of fearful favour. “Thou shalt arise, and have mercy upon Zion: for the time to favour her, yea, the set time, is come” (Psalm 102:13). For those who take pleasure in the affairs of the Kingdom, favour answers. Wherever your name is mentioned, favour will answer.

7. Continuous Guidance of the Holy Spirit

Forty-five years of continuous guidance of the Holy Spirit. “The Lord shall guide thee continually” (Isaiah 58:11). When God is guiding, there is no crisis. When God is guiding, there is no lack.

“They thirsted not when he led them” (Isaiah 48:21). Welcome to the gushing realm of your life. Your dry seasons are over. “As many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God” (Romans 8:14).

8. All-Round Rest

Forty-five years of all-round rest. Rest at home. Rest at work. Rest in your journey. Rest in your health. Rest in your mind. “They entered into a covenant... and the Lord gave them rest round about” (2 Chronicles 15:12–15). This church has enjoyed roundabout rest for forty-five years. In the name of Jesus, the days of unrest are over in your life.

There is a war-free zone in life. A time comes when you don’t know war—you don’t see it—it is not near you. That is your new realm. Redemption has empowered you to dominate what once dominated you.

Can darkness disturb light?

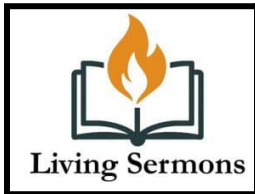
Take responsibility. You are far above the forces you fear. Redemption has positioned you for dominion. From today, every devil will stay clear of your environment.

9. Access to Heavenly Riches

Forty-five years of access to His riches in glory.

“My God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus” (Philippians 4:19). Access to heavenly resources empowers you to live above the economic climate of the world. No economic situation has affected this commission in forty-five years. Access to His riches is by covenant.

“But thou shalt remember the Lord thy God: for it is he that giveth thee power to get wealth” (Deuteronomy 8:18). His covenant is stronger than any economy. No matter how harsh the economy becomes, your case will be different. There is nothing new under the sun.



Covenant Advantage in Hard Times

Now listen—there was a grievous famine in the days of Joseph. People were offering themselves for sale as slaves. You would go to the market not with goods, but with yourself, just to have food to eat.

But at the same time, covenant people dwelt in the same land, and they had possessions, and grew, and multiplied exceedingly. “The children of Israel dwelt in the land of Egypt... and they had possessions therein, and grew, and multiplied exceedingly” (Genesis 47:27). In the same land, under the same economic climate, the same environment—two different outcomes.

Those who do wickedly against the covenant shall fall, but “the people that do know their God shall be strong, and do exploits” (Daniel 11:32). Please cherish your place in the covenant. Cherish your stand in the covenant.

I plugged into it in 1982. This is 2026—forty-four years ago. I am not surprised I am flowing in affluence. I knew from that encounter. May you have your own encounter today.

The Reality of Covenant Supply

I have never sent anyone to any man in forty-five years to ask for help. I have never opened my mouth to any man under heaven to ask for help.

I am heavily supplied by the covenant. I gain natural access to His riches in glory. Let somebody pray over me? Wake up! Prayer over you will not make you pass an exam—you study. The same access this church has to riches in glory is your right. Therefore, grace to engage with your place in the covenant—receive it now.

Until the giving grace is in place, it is impossible.

Forty-five years of increasing relevance of this commission across the nations. Abraham was old and stricken in age, yet he never lost relevance—God blessed him in all things (Genesis 24:1).

Even in old age, they shall still bring forth fruit (Psalm 92:14). Your life will never lose relevance. Over forty years of publishing impact—transforming individuals and nations through the printed page. Every work committed into your hand shall not lack impact.

A Legacy of Spiritual Impact

Forty years of training believers for exploits. Many under the sound of my voice today are direct beneficiaries of this impact. Twenty-seven years of Shiloh—where God distributes our inheritance. Whatever God commands, He backs up. May you gain access to what He commands.

Grace is not hidden—it can be perceived. “When James, Cephas, and John... perceived the grace that was given unto me...” (Galatians 2:9). From this service onward, people will see the grace of God at work in your life. Expect an end to every shame and reproach.

As you stay connected to this vine, you are entitled to partake of the root and the fatness. You will not be denied.

No one boards a flight and is denied what is served. In the same way, no one can be on board a spiritual flight like this and not partake of the manifold grace available here.

It is your right.

“Blessed is the man whom thou choosest... that he may dwell in thy courts: we shall be satisfied with the goodness of thy house” (Psalm 65:4). Every house of God carries the deposit of His goodness. Whatever is deposited here is your right.

The Evidence of Connection

“When they saw the boldness of Peter and John... they took knowledge of them, that they had been with Jesus” (Acts 4:13). People will take knowledge of you—that you belong here. Whatever works here will begin to work in your life.

Replication of Grace

When Saul came among the prophets, he began to prophesy. The grace upon this commission shall be replicated in your life. From this impartation service, every one of us shall begin to bear fruit after our root—reflecting the manifold grace of God in our lives, families, and endeavours. Many shall be drawn to Christ through your testimonies.

If you are on board, declare it: “Lord, I am on board this spiritual flight. I am entitled to whatever is served here. I tap into this manifold grace.”

The Call to Meekness and Impartation

We have come to a point where your meekness will be tested. God gives grace as He wills. There are many grace carriers. My heart cry is that every grace endowed upon me by God will be freely transmitted to you. Forty-five years—no games, no gimmicks, no manipulation. Open accountability.

Imagine the level of love for God being imparted into your life. All things have been working together for my good—this is truth. You are stepping into that same realm.

There Is No Self-Made Man

There is no self-made man. Men are made by inflows from others. I am a beneficiary of grace from others. Now it is your turn—to replicate the grace available on this altar.

Grace is in degrees. Grace grows. Grace multiplies. “Grow in grace” (2 Peter 3:18).
“Grace and peace be multiplied unto you” (2 Peter 1:2).

Levels of Grace

There are five levels of grace revealed in Scripture:

1. **Saving Grace** — “The grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men” (Titus 2:11)
2. **Great Grace** — “Great grace was upon them all” (Acts 4:33)
3. **Exceeding Grace** — (2 Corinthians 9:14)
4. **Indescribable Grace** — “Thanks be unto God for his unspeakable gift” (2 Corinthians 9:15)
5. **Manifold Grace** — (1 Peter 4:10)

Grace is in degrees—your level is changing.

Channels of Access to Grace

There are five biblical channels of access to grace:

1. **By Divine Will** — God gives as He wills (1 Corinthians 12:11)
2. **Through Prayer** — “Find grace to help in time of need” (Hebrews 4:16)
3. **Through Revelation** — Grace multiplies through knowledge (2 Peter 1:2)
4. **Through Spiritual Environment** — Grace is contagious
5. **Through Impartation** — “Ye all are partakers of my grace” (Philippians 1:7)

Grace is transmissible.

“I long to see you, that I may impart unto you some spiritual gift” (Romans 1:11).

The Beginning of Manifestation

Upon my salvation, unusual grace began to manifest in my life. My passion for God came alive. Everything about God became my natural delight.

A Heart for God Produces Visible Marks

Don't ever think you know my secret or have discovered my heartbeat for God. You cannot have a genuine heart for God and not make strange marks on the earth. I am talking about 1969. I was not a pastor, I had no idea of any calling—but a heart for God will always produce evidence on the earth.

“For eye hath not seen, nor ear heard... the things which God hath prepared for them that love him” (1 Corinthians 2:9). Your passion for God must come alive.

I love Jesus more than I love you. I love Jesus more than I love my wife. And she knows it. My children know it. May your passion for Jesus come alive today. I would rather sink with God than shine without Him.

That is the stand. That is the covenant posture.

When God led us into this land, I said: I would rather sink with God than shine without Him. You must come to that place—where it is God or nothing.

This is strong man's gospel. Not a petty gospel. You are either in it or not in it. May you find your way into it today. “They that seek the Lord shall not want any good thing” (Psalm 34:10). May your passion for the Word come alive.

Passion for the Word of God

Without anyone coercing me, my passion for the Word came alive long before modern tools existed. I went through multiple books of the Bible—marking, studying, engaging, and returning again and again. It is not casual reading. It is engagement.

Even as a young believer, I discovered truths that shaped my life—such as being made a king and a priest unto God (Revelation 1:6). My craving for the Word drove me into revelation. “Whatsoever he saith unto you, do it” (John 2:5).

May your passion for the Word come alive.

Distaste for Wrong Living

At twenty years old, I encountered Jeremiah 17:11, and it changed my outlook:

“As the partridge sitteth on eggs, and hatcheth them not; so he that getteth riches, and not by right, shall leave them in the midst of his days.”

Immediately, a gross distaste for anything not right was born in me. That encounter shaped integrity. Today, not a dime of church money is in my private pocket. Not one.

God does not bless crookedness.

It is not just study—it is study and engagement. Over decades, the Word has continued to intoxicate my spirit. Seek knowledge. Engage revelation. Let truth become life.

Passion for the Word Produces Transformation

From early years, the Word shaped decisions, direction, and lifestyle. What you feed on determines what you become. May your passion for the Word come alive.

Passion for Communion with God

You cannot be in love with God and not love His presence. David said, “Seven times a day do I praise thee” (Psalm 119:164). “Three times a day will I pray” (Daniel 6:10). His presence becomes your longing. May your prayer life take a new turn.

Passion for Fellowship

Fellowship is not optional—it is a recharge centre. “Those who appear before God go from strength to strength” (Psalm 84:7). If your spiritual life is not charged, your strength will fail. Embrace fellowship as lifestyle.

Passion for Knowledge Through Books

“Daniel understood by books” (Daniel 9:2).

Study to show yourself approved (2 Timothy 2:15).

Anointed books expand understanding. Knowledge prevents shame and stagnation.

Faith becomes natural when truth is understood and engaged. Commit to study. Commit to learning. Commit to growth.

This is a lifelong journey. “I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God” (Philippians 3:14).

It is a press—continuous, intentional, lifelong. Do not settle. Do not slow down. Keep pressing. Do not live on past experiences. God is not the God of yesterday alone. Stay current with God. It is dangerous to settle spiritually.

Endurance to the End

“He that endureth to the end shall be saved” (Matthew 24:13). Do not be distracted by temporary success. Stay faithful. Stay focused. People’s commendation is not your destination. Only God’s “Well done” secures eternity.

In the name of Jesus, we shall all make it. Say it with conviction:

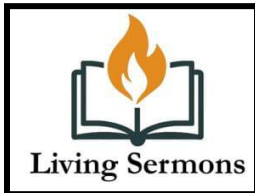
I must make it. I must make it. I must make it.

There is no other safe ground.

Thank You, Jesus.

May the same passion for souls that God endowed me with become your portion. And the resultant effect is this: all these things that others are dying to get shall be added unto you.

You will not struggle for change of level; it will be changing your level at a single deal.



Passion For The Afflicted

Now listen carefully—this is a very prosperous people. Please, have a place for the afflicted in your abundance before the evil days come, where you can only draw from heaven. Have a place for the afflicted with your abundance.

“Charge them that are rich... that they be willing to distribute...” (1 Timothy 6:17–19)

Do not be high-minded, nor trust in uncertain riches, but in the living God who gives us all things richly to enjoy. Be willing to distribute. Be ready to communicate. In doing so, you are laying up treasures for yourself against the time to come—resources from above, riches from His glory. When everything here dries up, your access will still speak.

Do not wait for the rainy day. Be awake at your level. Everybody begins from somewhere. Have a place for the afflicted. Be willing to put a smile on somebody’s face. Commit yourself to making others fulfil their destiny. He that giveth to the poor shall not lack; but he that hides his face shall have many a cause. You shall not have a cause.

Living With The Afflicted In View

Do not look away from the afflicted in your service, especially when it is within your power to help. Have the afflicted on your budget. Have them in your passion. Passion for the afflicted will always rescue you from affliction. Somebody is freed today. You will never know affliction.

Passion For The Church Of Christ

Please honour the Body of Christ. Reverence the Church. Do not speak against the Church. That is not your assignment. We are one Body. The Body of Christ is sacred. Do not be part of any talk against the Church. It can be very costly. In the name of Jesus, you will live free.

Grace for prompt response to divine encounters—receive it now. Like Abraham, you respond immediately to God’s instruction.

“As Abraham rose early...” (Genesis references)

Every word from God receives immediate obedience. May that Abrahamic grace of prompt obedience rest upon you.

Grace For Unreserved Dedication

Finally, grace for unreserved dedication to God is the covenant guarantee for a great future.

“Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground...” (John 12:24)

Unreserved dedication produces fruitfulness. When you are fully yielded, you stand out tomorrow. You cannot be sold out to God and remain ordinary.

All this “one leg in, one leg out” Christianity will not produce results. You must love the Lord with all your heart, all your soul, and all your strength. This is not strength of skill—it is grace that makes great in the Kingdom.

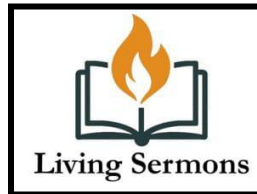
The Life Of The Sold-Out Believer

I am sold out to God. That has not changed since 1984. A true disciple does not shift with convenience. You are not a master—you are a disciple. Seek the commendation of God, not the approval of men. Only “well done, thou good and faithful servant” secures eternity.

If you are wise, you will embrace this. If you refuse, only you will bear the consequence. We must make it. We must endure. We must finish well.

May grace for unreserved dedication that guarantees a great tomorrow come upon you today. May you be strengthened to stand wholly for God.

Forgive me all my sins and wash me with Your blood.

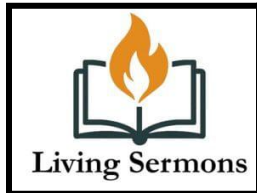
I believe You died for me.

May the same passion for souls that God endowed me with become your portion. And the resultant effect is that all these things others are dying to get shall be added unto you.

You will not struggle for change of level; it will come as one divine deal.



Passion For The Afflicted

Now listen—this is a very prosperous people.

Please, please, have a place for the afflicted in your abundance before the evil days come, when you can only draw from heaven. Have a place for the afflicted within your abundance.

“Charge them that are rich in this world, that they be not high-minded, nor trust in uncertain riches, but in the living God, who giveth us richly all things to enjoy; that they do good, that they be rich in good works, ready to distribute, willing to communicate; laying up in store for themselves a good foundation against the time to come...” (1 Timothy 6:17–19)

Have a place for the afflicted within your abundance. Don't wait for the rainy day. Be awake at your level. Everybody begins from his beginning. Be willing to put a smile on somebody's face. Be committed to making others fulfil their destiny. Have the afflicted in your budget. Have the afflicted in your passion.

Passion for the afflicted will always rescue you from affliction. If that is you, let your loudest amen show it. You will never know affliction. You will never know affliction. You will never know affliction.

Passion For The Church Of Christ

Please honour the Body of Christ. Reverence the Body. I have never preached against any church; I will not start till I go to heaven. We are one Body—the Body of Christ. I am not called to judge; I am called to build. Please value the Church of Christ. Do nothing against the Church—it is costly. Touch not Zion. Do not come against it. Please do not participate in anything that speaks against the Church. That is not your assignment.

Walk in peace, and live free in the name of Jesus.

Grace For Prompt Response

Grace for prompt response to divine encounters—receive it. Like Abraham, when God speaks, he moved immediately.

“As Abraham departed...” (*Genesis 12:4*)

“As soon as God finished speaking...” (*Genesis 17:23*)

“Abraham rose early in the morning...” (*Genesis 22:3*)

Receive grace for immediate obedience to divine instructions. Somebody is blessed.

Grace For Unreserved Dedication

Grace for unreserved dedication to God is the covenant guarantee for a great future.

“The kingdom of God is like a grain of mustard seed...” (*Mark 4:30–32*)

A tiny seed becomes a great tree when fully yielded. “Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die...” (*John 12:24*)

Unreserved dedication produces a great future. In 1984, in Kaduna, I declared: *I am sold out to God*. That declaration has not changed. You cannot be truly sold out to God and remain ordinary tomorrow. It is a lifelong press.

The Call To Press On

This is not a season to settle. Press on.

Do not rely on past victories. God is not moved by yesterday's righteousness. It is a continual pursuit. "I press toward the mark..." (*Philippians 3:14*)

This is the call of the believer—pressing forward. Not settling. Not retiring spiritually.

Press on.

Love That Casts Out Fear

When love for God becomes alive, fear dies. Perfect love casts out fear. Fear makes victims; love makes victors. Every grip of fear over your life is broken now in the name of Jesus. You shall not know fear again. You shall not know fear again. You shall not know fear again.

Divine Protection & Covering

You shall not die prematurely. No burial of your children. No tragedy in your lineage. No kidnapping. No road accidents. No evil report. You are preserved in the name of Jesus. Every hostage of the enemy is released now.

So shall it be.

Now receive grace impartation. What I carry in grace is released upon you. Whatever you touch shall respond as though I touched it.

Holy Anointing Declaration

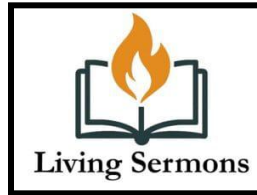

By this anointing:

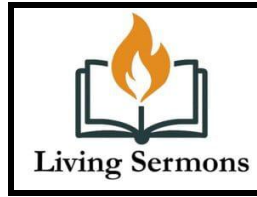

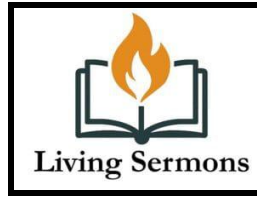
