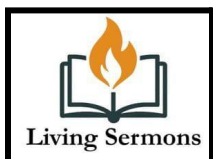

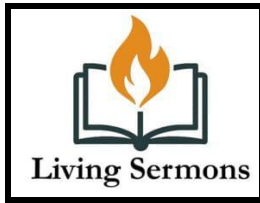

Called to Be World Changers

This morning, I will be sharing on:

Heralding the Emergence of World Changers.

From Scripture, we understand that believers are called to be world changers.

“Ye are the salt of the earth... Ye are the light of the world.” (Matthew 5:13–14, KJV)

We are not the salt of the church—we are the salt of the earth.

We are not the light of the church—we are the light of the world.

We are called to:

- Stop the earth from decadence
- Show the world the way to go
- Be pace setters, pathfinders, and trailblazers

Our steps should teach the world how to go.

We are the salt of the earth to sweeten a tasteless world and to preserve it from decay.

Jesus said if the salt loses its flavour, it is good for nothing. We lose value when we are not impacting our world.

Every child of God is either:

- **Adding value**, or
- **Losing value**

There is no neutral ground.

The Mandate of Light

“Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.” (Matthew 5:16, KJV)

Be the salt that you are.

Remain the light that you are.

Let that light keep shining brighter and brighter.

Every child of God is ordained a world changer.

The Power of Perspective

Redemption makes you a world changer—but you must think so.

“For as he thinketh in his heart, so is he.” (Proverbs 23:7, KJV)

We must think impact.

We must carry an impact perspective.

We are not here as consumers—we are here as **principal contributors**.

You are not a burden—you are ordained to be a blessing.

You must be adding something to the world, or you are losing everything you have.

The Law of Contribution

Every living thing stays alive by contribution.

Plants contribute oxygen.

Animals contribute carbon dioxide.

Both survive through continuous contribution.

So, when you are not contributing, you are not living.

Everything living contributes to stay alive.

The question is:

What am I adding as value to my world?

When you stop adding value, you begin to lose value.

Your Worth Is in What You Add

Your worth is not in what you have—it is in what you add.

Biographies are not written about what men possess, but about what they contributed.

What you have is secondary.

What you add is what defines your worth.

Think:

- Contribution, not possession
- Value addition, not value consumption

That is the pathway to becoming a world changer.

Revelation: The Foundation of Emergence

It takes revelation to emerge as a world changer.

“As far as thine eyes can see, to thee will I give it.” (Genesis 13:15, KJV)

What you cannot see, you cannot possess.

You must see it first.

Many believers only want to consume—but life thrives on contribution.

You Are a Global Citizen

Every child of God belongs to a global family.

“In thee shall all families of the earth be blessed.” (Genesis 12:3, KJV)

“If ye be Christ’s, then are ye Abraham’s seed, and heirs according to the promise.” (Galatians 3:29, KJV)

The Abrahamic family is not local—it is global.

Therefore:

Think global.

You are not a local citizen—you are a global citizen.

The Limits of Your Thinking

You cannot take beyond your thoughts.

Your thinking determines your taking.

We must think global before we can experience global impact.

The Anointing Empowers World Change

Every anointed believer is ordained a world changer.

“The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me... to appoint unto them that mourn in Zion... that they might be called trees of righteousness... and they shall build the old wastes.” (Isaiah 61:1–4, KJV)

The anointing is not just for speaking in tongues, singing or dancing. It is for **changing your world**. The anointing transforms you.

“God gave him another heart.” (1 Samuel 10:9, KJV)

If the anointing is not changing you, it is questionable.

It changes your:

- Person
- Perspective
- Spirit
- Entire being

And they shall build—not just speak.

Some people carry the anointing but do not understand its purpose.

Like a man who had a ship ticket that already covered feeding, yet lived on dry biscuits because he did not know.

The anointing is more than expression—it is for **impact**.

Rediscovering Your Identity

You must pick your picture from Scripture.

Like the lion raised among sheep, many believers have lost their identity.

But when he saw himself, he discovered who he truly was.

You are not a burden—you are a blessing.

Love: The Force Behind Impact

You cannot impact a world you do not love.

“For God so loved the world, that he gave...” (John 3:16, KJV)

Love empowers impact.

“Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: they shall prosper that love thee.” (Psalm 122:6, KJV)

You cannot prosper in a place you do not love.

Established as a World Changer

You are a world changer by:

- Redemption
- The Abrahamic covenant
- The Anointing

Therefore, you cannot live struggling for survival.

You are here to make others live.

From Good Word to Good Works

“That they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.” (Matthew 5:16, KJV)

The worth of a church is not in her message, but in her impact.

Good Word must produce good works.

“If I do not the works of my Father, believe me not.” (John 10:37, KJV)

Communities must feel the value we carry.

The Church: A Platform for Change

The Church is ordained as a platform for change in the world.

We are:

- The salt of the earth
- The light of the world

If the Church is not shining, it loses its value.

But when nations begin to call on the Church for solutions—that is value.

A Call to Awakening

As long as Christ is here, the Church must shine.

“I am the light of the world.” (John 9:5, KJV)

And we are His body.

Therefore, if we are not lighting the world, we have no value.

It is time for the Body of Christ to awake—and not watch problems close in on the world.

The Church Must Awake

Let us stop the problems—we can stop the problems.

Let us play our part according to the divisions given to each one of us. A little here and a little there, and we change the entire world.

The world today is at the mercy of the Church. Therefore, the Church must stay awake.

And the Church is not a building.

The Church is the people of God—the redeemed of the Lord. You and I are the Church of Christ. Colour, race, or background notwithstanding, we are one in Christ.

Every child of God is a member of that body and has a part to play.

The Worth of a Believer

The worth of a believer is not in his possession, but in his contribution.

“Charge them that are rich in this world, that they be not highminded... but in the living God... That they do good, that they be rich in good works, ready to distribute, willing to communicate.” (1 Timothy 6:17–18, KJV)

What you have is secondary.

What you distribute is what defines your worth.

God is not looking for those who hoard, but for those who distribute for the upliftment of others.

This is life—real life.

The Life of Distribution

I do not need anything; I only need what others may need.

That is life.

When I am privileged to push things out, I become excited—that is life.

Everyone is expected to give according to the level of God’s blessing upon his life.

If an elephant begins to release like a cow, it is on its way to the grave. You must release according to the level of your intake.

As God has blessed you, so you must give—so you can stay alive.

Many believers are dying while they yet live because they are keeping more than they are releasing.

Everything living must release to remain alive.

Think Contribution, Not Consumption

Think of avenues to add value—beginning from the household of faith.

“As we have therefore opportunity, let us do good unto all men, especially unto them who are of the household of faith.” (Galatians 6:10, KJV)

As you promote the Kingdom and the wellbeing of the saints, it overflows to the world around you.

Those who think contribution never lose value.

Those addicted to adding value see their value multiplied.

Covenant Opportunities for Impact

“I was an hungred, and ye gave me no meat... Inasmuch as ye did it not to one of the least of these, ye did it not to me.” (Matthew 25:42–45, KJV)

You must look around and take advantage of covenant opportunities to add value.

No one should be stranded when someone nearby has what they need.

That is value.

Faith: The Force of World Change

It takes faith to change your world.

“Who through faith subdued kingdoms...” (Hebrews 11:33, KJV)

It is by faith that kingdoms are changed.

Everyone feels what they have is not enough—but faith understands that when you release what you have, it multiplies.

“He that hath pity upon the poor lendeth unto the LORD; and that which he hath given will he pay him again.” (Proverbs 19:17, KJV)

“He that giveth unto the poor shall not lack.” (Proverbs 28:27, KJV)

Giving guarantees multiplied returns.

It takes faith to live for others.

It takes faith to pour your life out for others.

What Is Faith?

Faith is understanding the demands of your inheritance and going for it.

It is not just knowing the promise—it is knowing the conditions attached to the promise.

Many believe the promise but ignore the demands, and that leads to frustration.

There is no provision in Scripture without conditions attached.

Even salvation requires repentance.

In the same way, every provision—prosperity, growth, impact—has a process.

The Place of Obedience

“If thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the LORD thy God... the LORD thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the earth.”

(Deuteronomy 28:1, KJV)

There is a place for you on top—if you are interested.

But the pathway is obedience.

When you are tired of obeying, you are tired of rising.

As long as you remain obedient, your journey to the top cannot be stopped.

Key to Changing the World #1: Vision

Vision is a fundamental requirement for world changers.

World changers are **focused visionaries**.

They receive a word from the Lord and stay with it.

Many today are “hit-and-run” visionaries:

- They receive a vision
- When it does not work immediately, they abandon it
- Then move to another

But world changers are men of one thing.

“This one thing I do...” (Philippians 3:13, KJV)

You stay with what God has shown you until it speaks.

The Discipline of Staying Power

“To this end was I born, and for this cause came I into the world...” (John 18:37, KJV)

Jesus came for one purpose—and He stayed with it.

Even when they tried to make Him king, He refused because it was not part of His assignment.

“Let every man abide in the same calling wherein he was called.” (1 Corinthians 7:20, KJV)

Stay where God has called you.

Whether it looks like it is working or not—stay there.

Vision Speaks at the End

“For the vision is yet for an appointed time... at the end it shall speak.”
(Habakkuk 2:3, KJV)

No vision speaks at the beginning.

A child with a vision to become a doctor must pass through stages before fulfilment.

Vision is realised at the end—not at the start.

A Testimony of Vision

I received a vision from the Lord that at the base of this ministry would be a 50,000-seat auditorium.

That was April 10, 1982.

By December 1984, we were less than 150 people.

But at the end, it spoke.

In 1999, that vision became a reality, and today we run multiple services there.

The Danger of Instability

Hit-and-run visionaries have no future.

Many have moved from place to place for years without staying anywhere—and so they are nowhere today.

Stay where you belong.

That one thing is enough to impact your world.

The Power of Focus

Today, there are thousands of churches—because of staying power.

God is not a joker. He means what He says.

If you have heard from God, stay there—or you lose it.

Those who impact their world:

- Stay where they belong
- Remain committed
- Stay dedicated
- Remain dogged

The Single Eye of Vision

“If therefore thine eye be single, thy whole body shall be full of light.”

(Matthew 6:22, KJV)

The power of vision lies in focus.

A great army of world changers emerges when each person stays in his lane.

“They shall run every one in his way... and they shall not break their ranks.” (Joel 2:7–8, KJV)

That is the picture of world changers—each one maintaining his path.

When You Walk in Vision

When you walk according to God's plan:

- He goes before you
- He goes with you
- He works through you
- He works for you

“For it is God which worketh in you both to will and to do of his good pleasure.” (Philippians 2:13, KJV)

That is what makes a visionary a marvel—the hand of God.

Stay where you belong.

That is one sure way to impact your world continuously and forever.

Be a **focused visionary**.

Settle Into Your Assignment

It is time to settle down.

Do not do what everybody else is doing. Do what you are told to do.

You are not everybody—you are yourself. Your fingerprint is different from anyone else's.

Locate your place and settle there.

Do not mess up your life—you do not have a spare.

Let the Word change us.

Key to Changing the World #2: Revelation

The next demand on world changers is **the power of revelation**.

“In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.” (John 1:1, KJV)

Revelation has creative capacity.

When you encounter a word from the Lord, it carries dimensions:

1. The Creative Dimension

God’s Word creates solutions—it does not wait for them.

“And God said... and God saw...” (Genesis 1, KJV)

Whatever God says is as good as created.

2. The Prophetic Dimension

“So shall my word be... it shall not return unto me void.” (Isaiah 55:11, KJV)

God’s Word cannot fail.

Men of revelation are men of revolution—because revelation produces a dramatic turnaround.

3. The Seed Dimension

God’s Word is an incorruptible seed.

“Being born again... by the word of God.” (1 Peter 1:23, KJV)

When received, it must produce proof.

The Power of a Word from the Lord

A word from the Lord can transform your entire life.

Jacob was not a preacher, yet:

“The Lord sent a word into Jacob, and it hath lighted upon Israel.” (Isaiah 9:8, KJV)

Abraham was not a preacher—but one word gave him generational relevance.

What triggers transformation is **a word from the Lord**.

Testimony of Revelation

There was a time I was studying John chapter 5, where Jesus said:

“As the Father hath life in himself; so hath he given to the Son to have life in himself.” (John 5:26, KJV)

And I saw that there is life in my breath.

The following morning, a child with polio was brought.

I declared, “There is life in me, and I release that life into these legs.”

The next Sunday, the child was running.

That is the power of revelation.

Revelation Changes Perspective

A word from the Lord changed my understanding of finances.

From Hebrews 7, I saw that corporate tithing opens the heavens over organisations.

That revelation shifted everything.

I began to understand that what flows **out** of the Church determines what flows **into** the Church.

Personal Encounters Matter

What will change your life often comes privately.

God spoke to Abraham privately:

- Leave your country
- Circumcise yourself
- Offer your son

If you do not open up to God personally, you may remain at the same spot.

You must connect directly with Him.

You Are Meant for Greater Impact

Where you are is not your final destination—it is a stepping stone.

“The earth is the LORD’S, and the fulness thereof.” (Psalm 24:1, KJV)

You are called to share responsibility with God in changing the world.

Revelation Commands Attention

“Arise, shine; for thy light is come... and the Gentiles shall come to thy light.” (Isaiah 60:1–3, KJV)

Revelation attracts people to you for solutions.

Light commands attention.

“A little one shall become a thousand.” (Isaiah 60:22, KJV)

Revelation multiplies impact.

Accessing Light Through Others

“In thy light shall we see light.” (Psalm 36:9, KJV)

There are light bearers—anointed teachers through whom we can access light.

As you combine Scripture with revealed truth, your life explodes with insight.

Revelation Transforms You First

“But we all... beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed...” (2 Corinthians 3:18, KJV)

Revelation changes you before it makes you a changer.

You cannot give what you do not have.

Key to Changing the World #3: Faith

The third demand is **action-driven faith**.

Faith is not passive—it moves.

“Show me thy faith without thy works, and I will show thee my faith by my works.” (James 2:18, KJV)

Faith is understanding what your desire demands—and going for it.

Faith Must Produce Action

“By faith Noah... moved with fear, prepared an ark.” (Hebrews 11:7, KJV)

If faith is not moving you, it is dead.

“Faith without works is dead.” (James 2:26, KJV)

Faith always puts the believer on the move.

Prompt Obedience

Abraham is a model of action-driven faith.

When God spoke:

- He moved
- He obeyed
- He acted immediately

Delayed action is evidence of doubt.

The Power of Immediate Response

When God called me, I responded immediately.

Within the same month:

- The vision was shared
- A fellowship was started

God backs those who respond promptly.

Faith in Action Expands Impact

When God spoke about Africa, we acted immediately:

- Mission established
- Office set up
- Missionaries sent

That is how impact spreads.

The Urgency of Faith

At the pool of Bethesda, only those who stepped in first were healed.

You can be there for years—but without action, nothing changes.

When the Word comes—move.

Faith is a moving force.

When God speaks:

Act. Move. Obey.

That is the pathway to becoming a world changer.

Testimony of Faith

We were having a really nice time in Kaduna, in the northern part of Nigeria, and God said to me: “*Arise, go down to Lagos, raise Me your people.*” That was on the 19th of July, 1989.

On that same day, people were dispatched, and within two weeks we secured all the properties we needed. By September that year, we were ready to fly and open the church in Lagos. You see, you need the Abrahamic order of grace for prompt action—faith delivers maximally when paired with prompt action. You strike the iron when it is hottest; once it cools, you cannot shape it. Faith that guarantees proof is faith that is authenticated and validated by prompt action.

I remember clearly: the Lord spoke to me on the 17th of September, 1988, that the Tabernacle would be dedicated the following year. As an architect, it seemed impossible—the DRS were not prepared, and drawing the plans would normally take at least six months. Yet, because I heard from God, the following Monday, 18th of September 1988, we went to the site and started marking out the 50,000-seat auditorium. People thought it was crazy, but faith always answers to the impossible.

The dedication took place exactly on the 18th of September, 1999. The construction was an experiment—104 by 154 metres, executed entirely by local engineers with local technology. Multinational construction companies were astonished; they had never seen such a project done without foreign input. Like Noah, who was not a carpenter but built the first ark by God’s instruction, faith obeys God’s word and allows His creative power to manifest.

Faith is for the bold and the crazy in God’s eyes. For instance, when God said it was time to acquire an aircraft, I knew neither its price nor its brand. Yet, when God speaks, it is already created in the spirit realm. Faith takes delivery of what God has already established.

Key to Changing the World #4: Love

The power of love is transformative.

1 Corinthians 2:9 tells us,

“Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love Him.”

Every true lover of God becomes a world-changer.

You Cannot Love God Without Loving People

Love manifests as the desire for others to live, thrive, and succeed.

You cannot love God without loving people.

True change in the world comes from those who are die-hard lovers of humanity, willing to invest themselves for the benefit of others.

Romans 9:1 illustrates this:

“I could wish myself accursed from Christ for my brethren, my kinsmen according to the flesh.”

Nehemiah is a prime example. Though he lived in the comfort of the palace, his love for his people drove him to rebuild Jerusalem in just 52 days.

Love empowers insight that the world cannot provide.

The Spirit of God—power, love, and a sound mind (2 Timothy 1:6-7)—gives believers the capacity to act as lovers who transform communities.

The Holy Ghost: Master Custodian of Vision

Vision, revelation, faith, and love are all empowered principally by the Holy Ghost.

John 16:14 explains:

“He shall receive of mine, and shall show it unto you.”

The Holy Ghost is the custodian of visions, the master interpreter of truth. He takes believers from depth to depth, teaching, revealing, and energising faith.

God’s Word comes in various levels:

- Water
- Milk
- Strong meat
- Honey
- Wine

The Holy Ghost takes us from one level to the next, intoxicating us with insight and strengthening our faith.

The deeper the insight, the stronger the faith.

Everything waits for the church to come alive—the whole of creation is waiting for the manifestation of the sons of God.

Closing Charge

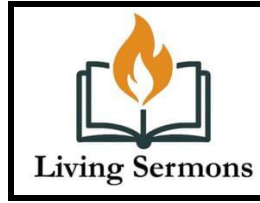
Do not waste your destiny.

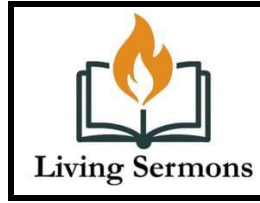

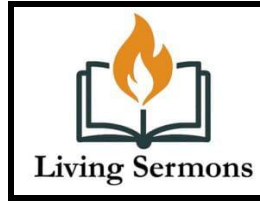

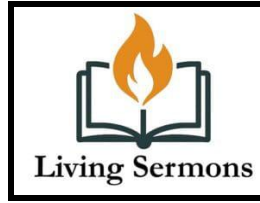
