Chapter One

The Foundation of Dominion

The theme of this convention is *Walking in Total Dominion*. I have been asked to speak to that tonight.

The anchor scripture is **Genesis 1:26**:

“And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion...”

Purpose defined: *Let them have dominion*.

God made man, and man had dominion—but lost it to the subtlety of the devil. Jesus came and brought it back for us. So dominion is restored. Every child of God is redeemed to walk in dominion.

We live in a world of darkness, and we are redeemed as the light of the world. The dominion of light over darkness is instant and unquestionable. Whenever light breaks forth, darkness backs out. Wherever light breaks forth, darkness packs out.

Beginning from tonight, every work of darkness will start clearing the way at your instance. When Jesus, the Light of the world, came down here, demons were screaming:

“Art thou come hither to torment us before the time?” (Matthew 8:29)

Darkness cannot stand the authority of light. In the same vein, no gang-up of hell will ever stop the way forward for you.

The Scripture says:

“For ye were sometimes darkness, but now are ye light in the Lord: walk as children of light.” (Ephesians 5:8)

Redemption makes us light in a world of darkness. That means darkness is under our authority. It does not dictate happenings in our lives. Therefore tonight, every work of darkness harassing your life, tormenting any aspect of your destiny, in the Name of Jesus, I rebuke them and cast them out.

Passion for God — Our Battle Axe for Dominion

Hear this story, and hear it well: **Passion for God is our battle axe for dominion.**

Jeremiah 51:20:

“Thou art my battle axe and weapons of war: for with thee will I break in pieces the nations, and with thee will I destroy kingdoms.”

Dominion is a function of genuine passion for God. Follow closely tonight. I believe this is the missing axe head of many believers today. Passion for God is missing and lacking.

In **2 Kings 6:5**, the sons of the prophets were cutting wood when the axe head fell into the water. They cried, “Alas, master! for it was borrowed.”

Without an axe head, you cannot build anything. If your axe head is missing, the handle can do nothing. You will be exerting energy without results.

What we have in most places today among believers is passion for possession, passion for recognition, passion for position, passion for influence—not passion for God. So it is important to define what passion is. Because you are leaving here tonight on fire for God.

Chapter Two

What Is Passion?

In our context, passion is the spiritual fuel that keeps a believer going after God and the interests of His Kingdom—in season and out of season.

Jeremiah 20:9:

“Then I said, I will not make mention of him, nor speak any more in his name.
But his word was in mine heart as a burning fire shut up in my bones... and I
could not stay.”

Too many seasonal believers. God is only God to them when there is hallelujah to sing. Once there is a challenge, they begin to doubt. Passion is a product of one’s decision, based on personal conviction, in the pursuit of God.

We saw this in King Asa (2 Chronicles 15:3–15). After the prophetic word came, he removed his own mother from being queen and cleared all abominable things out of Judah. That is conviction-driven passion.

Paul said:

“For though I preach the gospel, I have nothing to glory of: for necessity is laid upon me; yea, woe is unto me, if I preach not the gospel!” (1 Corinthians 9:16)

Conviction leads to an avowed decision.

Passion Is Stronger Than Anointing

What fuel is to a vehicle is what passion is to a believer in the pursuit of God. You cannot push a car to start without fuel. No anointing can help a docile Christian to be dedicated.

Passion is stronger than unction. Consider this: every vehicle has engine oil to keep the engine healthy. But engine oil cannot drive the car. The anointing is the engine oil—it keeps you in shape. Passion is the fuel—it keeps you on the go.

A Personal Encounter with Passion

At the age of nineteen, I found myself in a village for seventy-two days as a relief teacher. I asked, “What church is in town?” They said, “None.”

I knelt down and said, “Jesus, I must not leave this village the way I met it. Your Name must be planted here.”

Was I a pastor? No.

Was I planning to be a pastor? No.

Was I baptised in the Holy Ghost? I did not even believe in it. But I was born again.

I said, “Lord, how do I go about it?” He showed me the way. By the next Sunday, people had started gathering through house-to-house early morning prayer. In forty days, a church was built. Grass roofing and all. On my last day, they gave me a gift—a lantern—and said, “The light you have brought to our village, let it shine around the world.”

That is passion.

When civil war was about to break out and American citizens were asked to leave, someone said, “What will I tell Jesus?”

Passion.

You must recover this axe head tonight. Your dominion is not in view without passion.

The Zeal That Consumes

Jesus, our passionate Master, entered the temple and drove out those buying and selling.

John 2:17:

“The zeal of thine house hath eaten me up.”

In John 4, when they brought Him food, He said:

“My meat is to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work.” (John 4:34)

Passion drives you beyond yourself in your pursuit of God.

In 2 Kings 10:16:

“Come with me, and see my zeal for the Lord.”

Passion that cannot be seen is fake.

Passion Repositions for Dominion

To be passionless is to be fuel-less.

To be fuel-less is to be motionless.

To be motionless is to be stagnated.

“You have compassed this mountain long enough: turn you northward.” (Deuteronomy 2:3)

Dominion means dominating your territory for Jesus.

Be the carpenter.

Be the fashion designer.

Be the consultant in your field.

The more passionate a believer is for God, the greater the resources he commands. The craving for things has replaced the craving for God. So we chase goodness and mercy—when they are meant to chase us.

“Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me...” (Psalm 23:6)

Chase God, and goodness and mercy will chase you.

The Jackpot of Life

In 1976, at twenty-two years old, I encountered what I call the jackpot of life: Matthew 6:33.

“But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.”

I did not read it in a book. I was in a bookshop when the Holy Ghost spoke to me from that Scripture. There is nothing of value in my life today that I cried for.

It was added. When God becomes the constant in the equation of your life, you never lack solutions.

“But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard... the things which God hath prepared for them that love him. But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit.” (1 Corinthians 2:9–10)

Let God Be the Constant

Whatever God cannot do, let it remain undone.

Whatever God cannot give me, may I never have it.

Whatever God cannot take me to, may I never get there.

Let God be true. This God has never offended me. He has only added to me. If anything went wrong, I went wrong—not God. Accusing God will not change your story. My verdict

has always been: God is always right. God is never to blame. If anything went wrong, I am responsible.

Preacher's Charge

The pursuit of God is what repositions the end-time Church for dominion.

It is finally your turn to exercise dominion.

You are changing level.

In the Name of Jesus.

Chapter Three

All Things Work Together for Good

“And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.” (Romans 8:28)

Not all believers — He qualifies it.

To them that love God.

To them who are called according to His purpose.

To them who are in the place God called them to be.

To them who are doing what God has called them to do.

“We know that all things work together for good.”

Imagine me travelling to 143 nations because we are ordaining pastors. I would kill myself.

But in two hours and fifteen minutes, it is done.

Stay where you are — where He has called you to be. Keep doing what He has called you to do with absolute trust in Him. What an awesome God we serve. This convention is called for you because you are long overdue to exercise dominion. And it is starting from now.

Examine Yourself

Interestingly, you cannot be passionate for God and not know. You may suppose you are, but inside you know whether it is God you are pursuing or other things.

“Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith...” (2 Corinthians 13:5)

You do not need a laboratory. You are the laboratory.

“For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him?” (1 Corinthians 2:11)

Your spirit knows where you stand. Am I really passionate for God, or passionate for things?

Your childhood friend builds an estate, and you cannot sleep again. Your colleague buys a flashy car, and peace leaves you.

“How long will I be riding this car?” Then you say it is God’s fault.

Who gave you the car?

Wake up.

The Mystery Behind Dominion

The pursuit of God is the mystery behind the believer’s dominion. Do not miss that tonight.

In **1 Kings 19:10**, Elijah said:

“I have been very jealous for the Lord God of hosts...”

Again in verse 14, he repeated it: “I have been very jealous.” You cannot be passionate for Jesus and not know. If I were looking for things, I would go and sleep. But I am pursuing after God — and it has no end until the end comes.

“Occupy till I come.” (Luke 19:13)

You are looking for a car. When you get it, your passion dies.

You want to be married. When you are married, your passion dies.

You want to build a house. When you build it, your passion dies.

But this God — His ways are everlasting. His mercies are new every morning. The pursuit is endless. In 1977, from the book *The Pursuit of God*, I caught a Scripture:

“My soul followeth hard after thee: thy right hand upholdeth me.” (Psalm 63:8)

The Holy Ghost said to me, “My son, the harder you follow Me, the higher you fly.”

The harder you follow Me, the higher you fly.

There are no private revelations in Scripture. What He says to one, He says to all.

The pursuit of God is not a gift. It is a choice. It is not a talent. It is a choice. May that choice be made tonight.

Who Is on the Lord’s Side?

“How long halt ye between two opinions? if the Lord be God, follow him...” (1 Kings 18:21)

How long will you keep hopping between two opinions?

Moses said:

“Who is on the Lord’s side? let him come unto me.” (Exodus 32:26)

Three thousand perished because they would not respond. They were praying, but they were not on God’s side.

You can tell which side you are on — any day, any time.

My wife was under attack, and God said to me, “Go to the foreign nations.” I went to twenty-seven nations that year. I had a dying wife at home. I was following hard after Jesus, preaching deliverance and healing.

She is alive.

Until God is number one — and number one — and number one — you are not there.

Passion implies God first. Every other thing next.

Jesus said:

“If any man come to me, and hate not his father, and mother, and wife, and children, and brethren, and sisters, yea, and his own life also, he cannot be my disciple.” (Luke 14:26)

It is not hatred in the negative sense. It is relative priority. The moment you step back, God takes over. And you cannot lose a battle when God takes over. The last battle you lost is the last you will ever lose.

As you step back, God takes over.

As God takes over, the battle is won.

Things beyond your widest imagination will begin to pursue you.

Chapter Four

Proofs of Genuine Passion

As mentioned earlier, passion that cannot be seen is fake. They saw the passion of Jesus when He cleansed the temple. They saw His compassion when:

“Jesus wept.” (John 11:35)

The Three Hebrew Boys

They said, We will not bow.

“Our God whom we serve is able to deliver us... But if not... we will not serve thy gods.” (Daniel 3:17–18)

Passion is stronger than death. The consuming fire went ahead of them and turned the furnace into a cool chamber. There was no smell of fire upon them.

Daniel

Just bow once — the king has favoured you. He opened his window and prayed.

“My God hath sent his angel, and hath shut the lions’ mouths...” (Daniel 6:22)

He commanded dominion for sixty-five running years in Babylon.

From Mockery to Envy

No one ever fails with genuine passion for God — except the Bible is not true. The journey may start with mockery. It will end with envy. Jesus came as a carpenter. His brethren did not believe in Him.

“For neither did his brethren believe in him.” (John 7:5)

They spat on Him. But today He reigns eternally. Never mind where you are beginning from. Every giant today was once a baby.

“Though thy beginning was small, yet thy latter end should greatly increase.”
(Job 8:7)

People do not want the mockery, but they want the envy. It is the mockery that leads to the envy.

“Let us go forth therefore unto him without the camp, bearing his reproach.”
(Hebrews 13:13)

Passion Commands Extraordinary Returns

When one is consumed with passion for God, he commands extraordinary returns.

Paul said:

“For to me to live is Christ, and to die is gain.” (Philippians 1:21)

“I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me...” (Galatians 2:20)

They exclaimed:

“The gods are come down to us in the likeness of men.” (Acts 14:11)

He reached all Asia in two years. He wrote half of the New Testament.

“Jesus I know, and Paul I know.” (Acts 19:15)

That was his rank. Every passionate man is ever self-motivated. You cannot push him. He is always on the move.

Passion-Made Giants

Noah

It had never rained. Yet he built the ark according to divine instruction. Passion drove him. And he rescued a generation.

Abraham

“Go to a land I will show you.”

Where are you going?

God will show me.

Circumcise every male in your house. He began with himself.

Prompt response is a hallmark of passion.

“And Abraham was old, and well stricken in age: and the Lord had blessed Abraham in all things.” (Genesis 24:1)

Dominion.

Moses

Comfortable in the palace — yet he could not stand oppression.

Even after forty years in exile, the passion still burned.

“And there arose not a prophet since in Israel like unto Moses, whom the Lord knew face to face.” (Deuteronomy 34:10)

God buried him.

Gideon

“Where be all his miracles?” (Judges 6:13)

Passion provoked deliverance.

Nehemiah

A cupbearer — restless over Jerusalem’s reproach. Passion moved the king’s heart. He became governor.

Passion Overflows to Men

“And this commandment have we from him, That he who loveth God love his brother also.” (1 John 4:21)

Genuine passion for God overflows to those around you. Peter — the most passionate disciple — stayed to the end. And he stood as a rock.

Trials Reveal Passion

Gideon announced: Whoever is afraid, let him go back. Twenty-two thousand left. They were pretenders. Trials separate the passionate from the fearful.

“I lost my job — where was God?”

“I was sick — and I am always in church.”

You are among the fearful.

“Knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience.” (James 1:3)

Preacher's Declaration

Who is on the Lord's side tonight?

When passion comes alive, dominion becomes natural.

You are changing levels.

In the Name of Jesus.

Chapter Five

Every Champion Is Made of Challenges

Every champion is made of challenges. You cannot graduate from school without writing examinations. When you find a student crying because there is an exam, he has a problem. You went to school knowing that after lectures must come examinations.

Every champion has stories of challenges to tell.

I have tried putting some things down in my biography. There are places where you will cry. There are places where you will laugh. They are part of the journey. There were times we were going to an apartment and bombs were going off. That was part of the journey. When you say, “Remove the bomb,” it is to save lives.

Your tomorrow is great.

A Craving to Please God

As we conclude, passion for God will always provoke a craving and yearning to please Him — a craving to please God.

Enoch walked with God:

“And Enoch walked with God: and he was not; for God took him.” (Genesis 5:24)

“Before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased God.” (Hebrews 11:5)

You are taken to heights beyond imagination when your passion moves you into a lifestyle of pleasing God. When people hurt you, ask yourself: *How would Jesus respond?*

There were days when some boys would mock me on my way to the office. The first day I was upset. The next day I waved at them. They laughed harder.

How would Jesus respond?

“He answered him to never a word.” (Matthew 27:14)

A craving to please God — like Joseph.

“How then can I do this great wickedness, and sin against God?” (Genesis 39:9)

And you saw how he commanded dominion.

Jesus said:

“He that sent me is with me: the Father hath not left me alone; for I do always those things that please him.” (John 8:29)

May you leave here with a burning passion to please God in all your ways.

You may look like a slave today. You may even be in a prison. But you will soon arrive in the palace.

Divine Backing

Passion for God secures divine backing. There are no great men in the Kingdom — only ordinary men backed by a great God. Moses could not be arrested. Pharaoh stood helpless.

God said:

“My presence shall go with thee, and I will give thee rest.” (Exodus 33:14)

Moses replied:

“If thy presence go not with me, carry us not up hence.” (Exodus 33:15)

That is divine backing. God’s backing will speak strongly in your life. Passion also secures divine presence. You will not lack it.

Passion is not a calling.

Passion is not a gift.

Passion is a choice based on conviction from Scripture. This is your opportunity to have your dominion restored.

Your dominion level is changing.

You came here at one level — you are changing levels.

Before this convention is over, your level will keep changing.

Intimacy and Divine Secrets

Many people struggle with hearing from God. Your intimacy with God entitles you to His confidentialities. Abraham was called the friend of God.

“Shall I hide from Abraham that thing which I do?” (Genesis 18:17)

God began to discuss Sodom with him. Abraham negotiated from fifty down to ten. That was rich communication — born of intimacy. When there is no relationship, there is no access to information. You must settle down and come to a frequency where you have access to divine secrets — the mystery behind the making of stars.

Somebody is going places.

Thanksgiving and Dedication

Lift up your right hand and give God thanks.

Thank Him for restoring your dominion.

Thank Him for changing your level.

Thank Him for showing you the way forward.

Thank Him for bringing you to this convention.

Thank Him for an undying craving to please Him.

Thank Him for understanding the place of passion in exercising your heritage of dominion.

In Jesus' precious Name.
