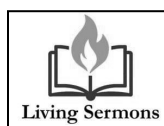

Introduction

Can we stand for the reading of the Word?

Exodus 2:1–10

And there went a man of the house of Levi, and took to wife a daughter of Levi.

And the woman conceived, and bare a son: and when she saw him that he was a goodly child, she hid him three months.

And when she could not longer hide him, she took for him an ark of bulrushes, and daubed it with slime and with pitch, and put the child therein; and she laid it in the flags by the river's brink.

And his sister stood afar off, to wit what would be done to him.

And the daughter of Pharaoh came down to wash herself at the river; and her maidens walked along by the river's side; and when she saw the ark among the flags, she sent her maid to fetch it.

And when she had opened it, she saw the child: and, behold, the babe wept. And she had compassion on him, and said, This is one of the Hebrews' children.

Then said his sister to Pharaoh's daughter, Shall I go and call to thee a nurse of the Hebrew women, that she may nurse the child for thee?

And Pharaoh's daughter said to her, Go. And the maid went and called the child's mother.

And Pharaoh's daughter said unto her, Take this child away, and nurse it for me, and I will give thee thy wages. And the woman took the child, and nursed it.

And the child grew, and she brought him unto Pharaoh's daughter, and he became her son. And she called his name Moses: and she said, Because I drew him out of the water.

May the Lord bless His holy Word. Biblical stories are not merely narratives. They are designed to reveal deep mysteries. There are five "P's" you must understand:

- **Pattern**
- **Principles**
- **Promises**
- **Processes**
- **Prophecy** (which ultimately points to destiny and future fulfilment)

Anytime you study the Bible, look out for patterns. A pattern is a consistent sequence of events revealed in Scripture. You recognise it because it repeats itself—again and again.

You see it in David.

You see it in Joseph.

You see it in Moses.

It is not a pattern if it happens once and never repeats.

The text we read is about Moses, but the same message could be drawn from David, Joseph, or Esther—because Scripture operates in patterns.

Patterns And Principles: The Hidden Laws Of Scripture

Biblical stories are case studies revealing principles. A principle is a fundamental law—unchanging, immutable, and producing predictable outcomes.

This is what Scripture calls the wisdom of God. When you pray, “Lord, give me wisdom like Solomon,” what God is actually doing is opening your eyes to understand principles and precepts. There are laws governing everything:

- Health
- Relationships
- Success
- Financial productivity
- Spiritual life

These are spiritual and natural laws. And Scripture says, “*the Scripture cannot be broken.*” These laws are immutable.

The Pattern In Moses: God's Strategy For A Generation

Whenever God has a problem, whenever He wants to shift a generation or solve a societal crisis, He places a child in the womb of a woman. This is why every life carries meaning. You are not an accident. You are a message sent from heaven.

From the beginning, God declared that the salvation of the world would come through *the seed of a woman*. Adam failed, but God already had a solution.

Even what men call “illegitimate” does not cancel destiny. There is no such thing as an illegitimate child—only misguided understanding of purpose and timing. The issue is not how someone was born, but why they were born.

The Mystery Of The Virgin Birth And Divine Intervention

God demonstrated His final solution through prophecy:

“Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call His name Emmanuel.”
(Isaiah 7:14)

God was saying:

“I will enter into history Myself.”

Animal sacrifice could not solve it. Prophets could not resolve it. So God came into the earth system to redeem humanity.

Human Beings As Spiritual Carriers On Earth

Women are gates of entry for spirits into the earth realm. A spirit requires legal entry into the physical world, and that entry is through a human body.

Your body is your legal passport on earth. Do not misuse it. Do not neglect it. It is part of your assignment here. You are not here for leisure—you are here on assignment.

Many children carry a sense of destiny from birth. But as they grow, environment, education, and peer influence begin to distort that awareness.

Yet every human being is a mixture of:

- Nature (what is built within)
- Nurture (what is added from outside)

Like a computer system, you already came with an operating system installed.

Certain abilities, gifts, and inclinations are already embedded within your spirit. You struggle in life when you deviate from that internal design. Nobody succeeds by becoming someone else.

The Case Of John The Baptist: Divine Assignment Cannot Be Altered

Even John the Baptist carried a defined assignment before birth. Human opinion suggested one name, but heaven had already spoken. An angel declared his identity and mission long before public understanding could define him.

Every destiny has a divine blueprint.

The spirit of Elijah is a restorative grace.

It turns hearts:

- Fathers back to children
- Children back to fathers

This is reconciliation.

True spiritual leadership understands both sides of a generation and brings them together.

Christ As Mediator: God Entering Human Experience

Jesus is the ultimate mediator. He did not remain distant from human experience. He entered it fully:

- He experienced temptation
- He experienced pain
- He experienced rejection
- He experienced suffering

Because of this, He understands humanity completely. His victory becomes our victory. His righteousness becomes our gift.

The Purpose Of Process And Pain

There are processes attached to destiny. Some of them are painful, but they are not wasted. They are designed to:

- Shape your understanding
- Refine your assignment
- Prepare you to carry the burdens of others

Moses could not become a deliverer without understanding the pain of his people. Even his upbringing in Pharaoh's house was part of divine preparation.

You are a Moses in your generation. What you go through is not random—it is preparation. Your perception of pain must change. Until you see differently, you are not ready to deliver others.

A deliverer is not made in comfort, but in process. Joseph had to come to a place where he could say to his brothers:

“You meant it for evil, but God meant it for good.”

It is true, you sold me into slavery—but that is how I became prime minister. I could not have become prime minister sitting with you, looking after sheep.

You were actually the ones who bought me the visa that sent me to my destination. You meant it for evil, but it was God who sent me ahead of you to preserve your lives. At that point, Joseph had not only converted his pain into power—he had discovered purpose in his pain.

So he was no longer a wounded man. That is what makes him a saviour. He loved them and took care of them, because he understood that if God had not intervened, that family would have been wiped out.

When Bitterness Blocks Destiny

As long as you are walking in bitterness, you are not yet healed. And if you are not healed, you cannot begin your assignment. Your assignment is often revealed inside your pain. Some of you, your assignment is connected to:

- Single mothers
- Rape survivors
- Broken families
- Young people
- Girls
- Marriage restoration
- Children
- Politics and justice

Some of you have been exposed to the pain of your nation so you can carry a burden for it. You begin to see corruption, injustice, and oppression—and something rises inside you. That is not ordinary anger. That is divine assignment being formed.

Impact, Media, And The Power Of Story

Even in the world, powerful stories shape generations. Many blockbuster stories are already in the Bible, yet the world repackages them.

A film like *The Passion of the Christ* shows how powerful biblical storytelling can be. It became one of the most successful films in history because it carried truth, pain, and sacrifice.

But even that production came through suffering, rejection, and personal cost. When God wants to reveal something powerful through you, He may first take you through what it means to carry it.

There are people who are called to carry burdens others avoid. The reason you feel deep concern for certain issues is because: That is where your assignment lies.

Some are drawn to:

- Youth ministry
- Social justice
- Political transformation
- Media and influence
- Cultural reform

God will even expose you to systems so you understand how they operate. You cannot change what you do not understand.

Media, Technology, And Kingdom Influence

There are multiple vehicles for preaching the Gospel:

- Word of mouth
- Movies
- Music
- Books and publications
- Technology and digital platforms

Some of the most powerful influences in the world today are not pulpits—but media. Books have travelled into villages where there is no electricity. Christian literature has shaped generations of leaders. This generation has been given access to technology to bring biblical truth into visible expression.

There are stories yet to be told properly. Many biblical realities have been misrepresented or simplified. But this generation has the tools to tell them with clarity and power. There are depths of Scripture that must be expressed in new formats:

- The Exodus
- The burning bush
- Spiritual encounters
- The unseen realm

These are not myths—they are realities waiting to be properly revealed.

The Unseen Realm And God's Moving Throne

God is not static. He is a moving God. Scripture describes His throne as having movement and living creatures around it. There are realities in the spirit realm that are beyond human imagination. Yet heaven governs everything.

The same God who governs galaxies and light years is also present in your daily life.

Nothing escapes His control.

The Generation God Is Raising

This is a generation God is raising with capacity to do greater works. The church age is not ending in weakness—but in greater manifestation. What previous generations carried in limitation, this generation will carry in expansion.

But it requires:

- Guidance
- Discipline
- Discovery of purpose
- Alignment with divine assignment

The love of parents is important, but the greater love is the love of the Father in heaven. That love heals identity wounds. Even David said:

“When my father and my mother forsake me, then the Lord will take me up.” (Psalm 27:10)

Rejection does not cancel destiny. God uses what others overlook.

David: The One Left In The Field

When Samuel came to anoint a king, David was not even considered. Seven sons were presented, but David was left in the field. Yet God said:

“We will not sit down until he comes.”

Men may forget you, but God remembers you.

There is no illegitimate child in destiny. There may be flawed systems of entry, but there is no flawed purpose in God. What matters is not how you entered the world—but why you are here. Even broken experiences do not cancel divine purpose. In fact, God often uses the broken things, the rejected things, and the overlooked things.

The Pattern Of Divine Selection

When you study Scripture carefully, you see a pattern:

Whenever God wants to change a system, He starts with a young person.

- Jesus: began early
- Moses: prepared early
- David: called young
- Esther: positioned young
- Joseph: dream given young

It is a consistent pattern. Two or three witnesses confirm truth. That is how Scripture establishes principle.

Conclusion: discovering the ways of god

When you recognise repeated patterns in Scripture, you are discovering the wisdom of God. You are learning how God gets results.

That is what Scripture calls:

- The ways of God
- The wisdom of God
- The secrets of God

And once you understand it, you become a custodian of divine wisdom.
