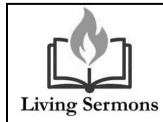

# ***Main Message***

*Begins Here*



---

## *Introduction*

---

Let us talk about the supernatural ministry—the ministry of signs and wonders, healings, and miracles. Nothing grows a church like the supernatural. The Bible says:

*“Now when he was in Jerusalem at the passover, in the feast day, many believed in his name, when they saw the miracles which he did.”*

—John 2:23 (KJV)

Again:

*“And a great multitude followed him, because they saw his miracles which he did on them that were diseased.”*

—John 6:2 (KJV)

Nothing grows a church like the miraculous. Notice the emphasis: **they saw**.

Do not just do it—make sure people see it. A miracle may happen in private, but it must not remain private. It must be publicised. That is what testimonies are for. If the miraculous is happening and it is not backed by testimonies, you may not see the growth you intend.

The Psalmist said:

*“Declare his glory among the heathen, his wonders among all people.”*

—Psalm 96:3 (KJV)

When God does something, publicise it. Let the whole world hear it. Let the whole community hear it. Do not let it stay within the church. Declare His glory among the heathen. When God does something, do not hide it. His wonders must be known among all people. And then the Bible says:

*“For the LORD is great, and greatly to be praised: he is to be feared above all gods.”* —Psalm 96:4 (KJV)

In some communities, even the church is insulted. Christianity is mocked. The name of the Lord is not respected. But here is the key:

Declare His glory among the nations, and His wonders among all people. For all the gods of the nations are idols, but the Lord made the heavens.

# *The Power of Testimonies*

---

If you start a movement of miracles and let people know what God is doing, the finances of the church will rise. According to Psalm 110:

*“Thy people shall be willing in the day of thy power...”*

—Psalm 110:3 (KJV)

People respond to power. Not mobilisation. Not activism. People respond to the supernatural. That is why testimony sessions should always come before offerings. Church growth is not just numerical growth. There are three dimensions:

## **1. Numerical Growth**

Growth in numbers.

## **2. Spiritual Growth**

People becoming more like Jesus. Maturing. Becoming stronger.

### **3. Financial Growth**

Increase in kingdom resources. If you are doing everything right, it must lead to increase in income. Offerings should be taken after people hear the Word. By that time, their faith is stirred. Offerings should also come after testimonies.

Why?

Because people are willing in the day of His power. When God is moving, resistance breaks. It becomes easier to call people into service, departments, and kingdom commitment. The anointing breaks resistance.

### ***Motivate Through Benefits***

If your church order requires taking offerings before the message, then assign someone to exhort the people for five minutes with the Word. Because human nature resists giving.

People are naturally defensive. Do not harass people to give. Show them the benefits. God never commands anything without attaching incentives to it.

Show people what is in it. When people see the benefit, they move. That is human nature. Even as a preacher, there are times I hear a powerful exhortation and I triple what I had planned to give. There are times I have had to write a pledge because what was in my pocket was not enough.

That is how we are wired.

## ***Weekly Miracle Services***

The miraculous creates movement. Here is my recommendation: For these ninety days, introduce weekly miracle services. When William Kumuyi was growing a mega church in Lagos, he started weekly miracle services every Friday.

That was part of the explosion. If you want breakthrough, understand the principle of concentration of power. An aircraft does not spend all its fuel just overcoming gravity. It rises fast so it can travel.

Some of you have wasted too much time because gravity is still holding you down. Weekly miracle services help break that. For mega churches, monthly may be enough. But if you are trying to break through, do it weekly. It can be your Sunday. It can be your Friday. It can be Thursday.

Use it to create expectation, Healings, Deliverance, Miracles, Breakthroughs, and breakthrough is not just healing. People want marriages, Career advancement, Business breakthroughs.

Pray into those areas. Things will happen.

## ***Point of Contact and the Release of Faith***

Use points of contact. Deploy them. Communion services. Anointing services. Feet-washing services. These are channels for transmitting faith.

A point of contact is like a socket. It helps connect divine power to human consciousness. Some people struggle with abstract spiritual realities. But when they touch something tangible, faith rises. Use it.

Anoint with oil. Serve communion. Release miracle handkerchiefs. People will be healed. And if you do not feel gifted strongly in healing, work with a team.

There are diversities of gifts. You are not the only one carrying grace. Gather those with faith. Work together.

There will be testimonies. And the church will grow. It will explode. Because needs are being met. Use the authority in the Name of Jesus.

Be bold.

It works.

## ***The Secret To Multitudes***

---

The ministry of Jesus was marked by fame. His fame spread abroad. And great multitudes followed Him.

Why?

Because testimonies spread. When people get healed, they carry the news. And the result is multitude. A church that draws multitudes is a church that believes in the supernatural.

## **Aggressive Evangelism**

This is another critical key. Aggressive evangelism. For the next three months, make room for supernatural manifestations in your services. Towards the end, reduce your preaching time. Fifteen minutes may be enough.

Pray for people.

Minister to people.

Get more hands to help.

Introduce miracle meetings. If you are a teacher and not particularly prophetic, use the people around you. There are graces in your church. Bring them forward. Let them minister. Sit there and listen. Take notes.

That is how you build confidence in leaders. When you honour them publicly, the people will honour them too. That is leadership. You are the one creating stars.

You can raise people. And if one becomes proud, God always has replacements.

God never runs out of vessels.

## **The Great Supper**

Jesus said:

*“A certain man made a great supper, and bade many.”*

—Luke 14:16 (KJV)

And when it was time, he sent for them. This is the principle: Do not invite people where there is no food. Make sure your services are loaded.

- Loaded with the Word.
- Loaded with power.
- Loaded with answers.

When people come, their lives must change. Restaurants do not invite people when there is no food.

Churches must learn this.

# Reaching the Rich

Many pastors want to start by reaching the rich. That can frustrate you.

Reach the masses first. When the rich see what God is doing, they will come. When they see order, results, and honour, they will respect what is happening.

David did not start with kings. He started with distressed men. Discontented men. Broken men. But he turned them into mighty men. That is how ministry works. God does not usually start you with finished products.

He gives you raw materials.

- You build them.
- You teach them.
- You disciple them.

And over time, they become mighty. That is church growth.

The master said:

*“Go out quickly into the streets and lanes of the city, and bring in hither the poor, and the maimed, and the halt, and the blind.”*

—Luke 14:21 (KJV)

Start this week.

Do not waste time.

Go quickly.

Find hungry people.

Find needy people.

Stop trying to force the gospel on people who are not hungry. Find those who know they need God. That is where the harvest is. The servant said:

*“Lord, it is done as thou hast commanded, and yet there is room.”*

—Luke 14:22 (KJV)

God has zero tolerance for empty chairs. If there is still room, there is still work to do.

## **Compel Them to Come**

*“Go out into the highways and hedges, and compel them to come in, that my house may be filled.”*

—Luke 14:23 (KJV)

Aggressive evangelism. We grew a church from twenty-four people to three thousand in six weeks.

How?

We deployed everybody.

In pairs.

Write that down.

Do not send people alone. Send them in twos or small groups. One can chase a thousand. Two can put ten thousand to flight.

There is courage in numbers. There is boldness in groups. There is greater productivity. The best form of evangelism is social evangelism.

Relationship evangelism. Give people handbills. Digital flyers. Physical flyers. Let them go into their workplaces. Their families. Their neighbourhoods. Mobilise people. Transport people. Follow up on Sunday. Call them.

Check on them. That is how growth happens. And remember this: To retain one thousand, you may need to reach ten thousand. To retain two thousand, you may need to reach twenty thousand. That is the law of harvest. Reach wide. Gather many. And the house will be filled.

## *Jesus Sent Seventy*

Let us look at Luke chapter 10:

*“After these things the Lord appointed other seventy also, and sent them two and two before his face into every city and place, whither he himself would come.”*

—Luke 10:1 (KJV)

This makes the principle clear. Jesus deployed seventy people, and He sent them **two by two**. That is how to do it. God does not usually send people alone. When God sent Jesus, He sent John the Baptist ahead of Him. When He sent Moses, He gave him Aaron. When you study Scripture carefully, you will see a recurring pattern—partnership.

You see Peter and John. You see Paul and Barnabas.

In Acts chapter 13, the Holy Ghost said: *“Separate me Barnabas and Saul for the work whereunto I have called them.”*

—Acts 13:2 (KJV)

Not one. But Two.

God sends in pairs. If you are a Joshua, find your Caleb. That is how kingdom advancement works.

## *Destiny Partnerships*

When God was raising Mary to carry Jesus, He also raised Elizabeth. Mary and Elizabeth became destiny partners. Find someone you can team up with. Exponential growth requires partnership. Do not deploy your people as isolated individuals. Even in prayer, fire burns stronger together.

One piece of wood on fire can quickly die out. But when woods burn together, the fire is sustained. You have been setting individuals on fire. Now set them in pairs.

Set them in groups. The fire will be sustainable. The gospel spreads through relationships. The gospel spreads through networks. When Jesus entered Samaria, He met the woman at the well. He touched her life, and immediately she became a messenger to her city. She went and called the men. That is wisdom. Anyone you reach should become a bridge into their network. Do not just extract the person and stop there. Deploy them. Social networks begin with family: Brother. Sister. Mother. Father. Neighbours. Friends.

This is how the gospel grows.

When Rahab was reached, her whole household was preserved. When Zacchaeus encountered Jesus, the Lord said:

*“This day is salvation come to this house...”*

—Luke 19:9 (KJV)

Notice: **house**, not just life. God thinks in households. The redemption plan is a family plan.

# *The Family Plan of Redemption*

God does not just save individuals. He saves families. He saves communities. Look at Cornelius. When Cornelius sent for Peter, he gathered his relatives, friends, and neighbours. By the time Peter arrived, the house was full.

That is how the gospel spreads.

It moves through family systems.

It moves through communities.

The Bible says:

*“Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house.”*

—Acts 16:31 (KJV)

When the Philippian jailer encountered Paul and Silas, salvation did not stop with him. His entire household was baptised that very night. God’s plan has always been covenantal. He told Abraham:

My covenant is with you and your seed. So every person in your church already carries a network. Teach them to recognise it.

- Their family network.
- Their friendship network.
- Their career network.
- Their professional network.
- Their customer network.

There are many people waiting to be reached. And those people are already connected to your members. That is kingdom intelligence. That is strategic evangelism.

# *Media and Technology*

Now let me give you another secret to explosion: Technology. Media. Technology multiplies speed. Trying to reach your city without technology is like trying to walk to the United Kingdom instead of flying.

Technology adds speed. Technology adds scale. Technology creates exponential movement. Imagine travelling from Northern Nigeria to Lagos by foot.

Or travelling from Nigeria to Accra by road when a plane is available. One person arrives in less than an hour. The other spends days or weeks. That is what technology does. It shortens distance. It multiplies reach.

In the past, mass communication was expensive. Only churches with large resources could sustain it.

But now social media has made it accessible to everybody. Use it.

- Use WhatsApp broadcasts.
- Gather contacts.
- Build communication systems.
- Reach your city.
- Reach your community.

The smaller pattern is simple: Broadcast. But the exponential pattern is deeper. If one thousand people are in a service, and every one of them shares an invitation with their contacts, your reach multiplies instantly.

Every member's phone is a broadcasting station.

That is power.

Use it.

Every Sunday, create materials:

- Digital handbills.
- Physical handbills.
- Graphics.
- Invitations.

Let members send them to friends, customers, relatives, and colleagues. People transact business every day. They market products every day. Why not market the kingdom?

Banks go aggressively after customers. They simplify the process. They bring the service to the people.

That is what ministry must do. Take ministry to the people. Make access easy. Bring the gospel to where they are. And when testimonies happen, upload them.

Do not let testimonies remain inside the church walls. Publish them. Spread them. Let more people see what God is doing.

## **The Need for Structure**

If you are going to engage in aggressive evangelism, prepare your structure. Because people will come. And structure is the container. If there is no container, the harvest leaks.

- Double your structure.
- Double your cells.
- Double your fellowships.
- Double your systems.
- Women's fellowship.
- Men's fellowship.

- Youth fellowship.
- Campus fellowship.
- Satellite centres.

Expand.

Even if you currently have one hundred cells, divide them and make them two hundred.

Why?

Because growth needs vessels. The prophet said:

*“Borrow thee vessels abroad of all thy neighbours, even empty vessels; borrow not a few.”*

—2 Kings 4:3 (KJV)

The moment there were no more vessels, the oil stopped. That is the law. Structure determines capacity.

Growth requires expansion.

Just like clothes.

A child cannot remain in one size forever. As growth happens, larger garments are needed. The same is true for church growth. As the church grows, the structure must keep growing.

- Keep enlarging.
- Keep stretching.
- Keep preparing.

Because God fills prepared vessels. That is how it is with a church. As people are coming, you must keep expanding.

- Grow more cells.
- Deploy more cell leaders.
- Double up your systems.
- Grow more workers.
- Grow everything.
- Do it now.
- Do it this week.

And you will see growth.

If you have one hundred and twenty satellite centres holding midweek meetings and gatherings during the week, increase them.

Make it three hundred.

Deploy more. Because with the expansion of structure comes another principle:

### **Deploy more leaders.**

You saw Jesus do it. First, He deployed twelve. Next, He deployed seventy. That is the pattern. If you have three hundred people, deploy half of them. Put them in pairs. If you deploy one hundred and fifty in pairs, that gives you seventy-five cells. If you deploy two hundred in pairs, that gives you one hundred cells.

And these structures come in different forms:

- Cell structures.
- Satellite structures.
- Women's fellowships.
- Men's fellowships.
- Youth fellowships.
- Singles fellowships.

Every one of them should be planting and multiplying. Every group must be part of multiplication. Even the choir. Double the size of the choir.

Create cells within the choir. Let them meet, practise, disciple one another, and grow. It should not just be about singing. It should be about discipleship. The choir should be raising disciples and reaching more people.

The ushers too. Every department. All departmental structures must multiply. Double the departments.

Give them targets.

Give them goals.

Because if you do not expand your structures, you may attract people, but you will not retain them. Growth must have containers.

Without containers, growth leaks.

## ***The Tool of Social Services***

There is one more tool that works powerfully: Social services. Good works.

Jesus said:

*“Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.”*

—Matthew 5:16 (KJV)

Good works are evangelistic tools. They open hearts. They create access. They create visibility. And they attract people to the kingdom.

# The Power of Food

In John chapter 6, Jesus multiplied bread and fed five thousand.

That day, they wanted to make Him king by force. He healed the sick many times. He worked miracles. But there was something unique about feeding them.

Food has power.

When we grew that church from twenty-four to three thousand in six weeks, one of the strategies was food.

Every Sunday, Free food.

We were not just doing evangelism. We were attracting the poor, the needy, the hungry—just as Jesus described in Luke 14.

One service ends, and food is served. When the community heard that there was a church giving food every Sunday, they came.

Not alone.

They brought father, mother, children, grandchildren, and neighbours. Some even came carrying their own plates. That means once they were in service, there was hope they would eat. And we made it good.

Sweet jollof rice, Chicken, Fried meat, Good meals. Not leftovers.

It was done with excellence. Like a wedding feast. By the end of six weeks, the place was filled. Then they asked if they should stop.

I said no.

Continue another six weeks. Then gradually replace the food with the Word. That is wisdom. Use the food to bring them. Use the Word to keep them.

# Foundation School

This is another critical point. If people are coming in, you must disciple them. Foundation School is non-negotiable.

The food will bring them. Miracles will bring them. But it is the Word that will keep them. If you do not give them the Word, they will eat your food and disappear. If you do not disciple them, they will receive healing and vanish.

So we ran Foundation School aggressively. Saturday mornings and Monday evenings Different centres. Closer to where the people lived.

We also held encounter retreats, Monthly.

Every four weeks.

Consistently.

- People came to Christ.
- Went through Foundation School.
- Went through encounters.
- And entered discipleship.
- That is how retention works.

# Community-Based Social Services

There are many ways to serve your community. Think about what your community needs. Vocational training. Career development programmes.

- JAMB classes.
- GCE coaching.
- Educational support.

- Enterprise development.
- Professional mentoring.

Use your church facility, turn it into a centre of impact from Monday to Friday. Let professionals in your church teach. Let bank managers train people. Let experts equip people. Help them improve their careers. Help them get jobs. Help them build businesses.

And in every programme, insert spiritual content. So they are growing professionally and spiritually. That is kingdom strategy.

## **Sports Outreach**

Sports programmes work. Create football competitions. Invite the youth. Create prizes. Use sports as a gathering point. Bring them in. And from there, lead them into church. Simple. Effective. Powerful.

## **Talent Development Programmes**

One of our ministries created a talent development project. It became so effective that it attracted more people than the church itself. People came for acting.

- Film training.
- Creative coaching.
- Industry mentorship.

Sometimes there were two thousand people. Sometimes four thousand. That became a harvest field. From there, they recruited the best, developed them. Created kingdom projects.

That is strategy. You can take your community through talent development.

# *Relationship Programmes*

Another powerful growth tool: Relationship programmes. Singles programmes. Not just teaching on marriage. Not just teaching on dating. But creating healthy environments for connection. After all, what is the use of learning if there is no practical pathway?

People are looking for relationships. People are lonely. Create spaces for them. Question-and-answer sessions. Practical discussions. Real-life issues. Not just spiritual hype. Address realities. Come down from the mountain. Meet people where they are.

- Talk about pregnancy.
- Talk about heartbreak.
- Talk about emotions.
- Talk about wisdom.
- Talk about relationships.

And if you are not equipped for it, bring people who are. If you are talking to singles, be relatable.

- Be presentable.
- Be practical.
- Do not create distance.
- Create connection.

There should also be programmes for: Couples, Single mothers and Older singles.

Different structures for different realities. That is how people feel at home. That is how church becomes family.

## *Prophetic Release and Benediction*

---

There is so much more to say. But for these next three months, I decree explosion in your ministry.

Explosion in your life.

In the Name of Jesus Christ.

Where you used to count hundreds, you will count thousands. Where you used to count thousands, you will count tens of thousands. Some of you need to reduce the length of your preaching.

Thirty-five minutes.

Forty minutes.

So that you can run multiple services.

First service.

Second service.

Third service.

I release the angels of God to work alongside you.

To supply miracles.

Miracles of all kinds.

Every time you pray for people, God will confirm your words with signs and wonders. God will not allow your words to fall to the ground. I declare abundant testimonies in your services. I declare explosion in your churches.

Explosion in your fellowships. Explosion in your cells. In the Name of Jesus.

As growth comes, financial explosion shall also come.

I bless the works of your hands.

Your businesses.

Your careers.

As you pour out your life in God's service, every other aspect of your life will blossom.

Satan, I rebuke you.

Take your hands off their lives.

Take your hands off their ministries.

Take your hands off their families.

Take your hands off their businesses.

Take your hands off their careers.

We break your power.

We open the floodgates of multiplication.

We open the floodgates of heaven.

Let revival come.

Let there be an outpouring of the Holy Spirit on every life, every church, every ministry, and every cell.

You will return with testimonies.

Your joy shall be full.

And the name of the Lord shall be glorified in your life.

In Jesus' mighty name.

Amen.
