Introduction

The Lord asked me to tell you that He is here. And He said to me, *“I would not leave until it is over.”*

So I said, “What are You saying?”

He said, *“It is not visitation; it is habitation.”*

And He showed me the number of angels that are available here, all around this place. This struck me deeply when He began speaking to me about it. Then He took me to the Scriptures:

“For the Lord thy God walketh in the midst of thy camp, to deliver thee, and to give up thine enemies before thee...” (Deuteronomy 23:14, KJV)

God told Moses to make the people understand this because not everybody is spiritually sensitive. He told them that God is holy, and He is sensitive. The Lord walks in the midst of the camp. Camp meeting is meeting with God in a camp. It is a time of encounter. It is a kairos moment.

And He is in the camp to deliver you.

The Different Manifestations of His Presence

The manifestations of the glory of God and the presence of God are different. There is the Holy Spirit **in us**. There is the Holy Spirit **upon us** to do mighty works—the anointing that is upon me right now. But there is also the Spirit **with us**, when the glory comes and fills the temple. The presence of God in the midst of the camp.

And He explains why He comes:

To deliver you.

So maybe you are waiting for a healing service to begin. But this night is a night of glory. From now until the end, things will be happening everywhere. He is in the midst of the camp to deliver thee and to give up your enemies. Some of you are going to experience divine surgery.

All kinds of things will happen in you, for you, through you, and around you. If it is a situation around you, He will sort it out.

He will take care of your enemies and defeat them before you.

Therefore, your camp shall be holy. That is the key. When you host God, the environment must be different. Your personal life must be holy.

The camp must be holy so that He may not see any unclean thing in you and turn away from you. That is what happens in gatherings like this: Everybody is receiving, but some are not getting anything.

Why?

Because holiness matters.

When God came to visit Israel at Mount Sinai, He told Moses:

“Go unto the people, and sanctify them to day and to morrow, and let them wash their clothes.” (Exodus 19:10, KJV)

God is even interested in physical hygiene. That amazes me. I used to think that if your heart was clean, that was enough. But God cares about your environment too.

- He cares about your house.
- He cares about your space.

If you want habitation—not just visitation—keep your environment clean.

After cleansing their lives, He told them to wash their clothes too.

And then He said:

“And be ready against the third day: for the third day the Lord will come down in the sight of all the people...” (Exodus 19:11, KJV)

Personal Encounters With Jesus

The Lord told me He is going to appear to many people. He said it starts today. Some of you have never had a personal encounter. You have only heard other people talk about Him.

Watch out.

I will give opportunity when the time starts.

Not one. Not two. Not three.

Many people.

This Jesus you have been talking about—He is alive.

God Supplies the Ability

One thing about the type of ministry God gave me...

I am not naturally a public person. If not for ministry, nobody would know me. I would function quietly behind the scenes, supporting others. I told Him, *“I cannot talk. I am not a communicator.”*

And He said, *“Who made your mouth? I will touch your tongue.”*

There are people who are gifted communicators.

But me?

I cannot do ministry without the anointing. I am completely dependent on the Holy Spirit. I told Him I did not like the stage.

He said, *“Boldness—I will give it to you.”*

When God uses you, He is not depending on what you have. He is depending on your yieldedness. He supplies the ability. God does not call the equipped. He equips the called.

What He needs is the vessel.

He fills it.

Christ Living Through Us

When God calls you, He is not expecting you to do the work.

No.

He is the One who wants to do the work. But He needs a body. The way you wear your clothes is how God wants to wear you. *“Faithful is he that calleth you, who also will do it.”* (1 Thessalonians 5:24, KJV)

Since He is the One who gets the job done, our responsibility is to step out and let Him fill us. Do not be afraid of the Christian life. Do not be afraid of the work of God. Some of you are struggling in the flesh. That life was never designed to be lived in the flesh.

He wants to live His life through you. That is surrender. That is yieldedness. That is death to self. Paul said:

“I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me...”
(Galatians 2:20, KJV)

It is an exchanged life.

The Mystery of Christianity

I used to worry about what I could contribute. I thought I had nothing. I thought God had made a mistake. I worried about my imperfections. My lack of knowledge.

I said, *“I do not even know the Bible well enough.”*

Then I realised—Christianity is an exchange. People may praise you and call you “man of God”.

But it is not you.

It is Him.

Now I have confidence—not in myself—but in God. My faith is not in Pastor David. My faith is in God. I have a revelation of Christ in me. *“Christ in you, the hope of glory.”* (Colossians 1:27, KJV)

That is the mystery. That is the wealth of Christianity. That is the riches of Christianity. And I am learning: To the degree I yield, is to that degree He flows.

To the degree I die, is to that degree He works. And when He uses you, never forget—The glory belongs to Him.
