One more time, I welcome everyone to this service this morning in Jesus' Name.

Please do not let anybody disturb you or distract you. I want your attention to be, if possible, one hundred and eighty per cent.

Meanwhile, I bring you greetings from Accra, Ghana. We had a most explosive time in Ghana. On Friday alone, I preached four messages in four different places. The last one was a massive youth programme in Accra. God was awesome. The whole of Ghana was shaken in diverse ways, to the glory of the King of kings and the Lord of lords.

This week, we are back in Benin Republic, Cotonou, for another full-fledged crusade, and God is being glorified. The earth shall be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord, as the waters cover the seas.

A woman flew all the way from the United Kingdom to attend the Accra Ghana crusade, and she did not return disappointed. What a faithful God!

This morning, we are dealing with: **Dealing with Ancient Foundations and Hidden Unbroken Curses**

Our Objectives

- Our first objective is to understand the impact of evil foundations and hidden unbroken curses on lives and destinies.
- Our second objective is to understand what it takes to relay foundations and reverse hidden unbroken curses.

The Power of Foundations

God Lays Foundations

Isaiah 51:16 says:

“And I have put my words in thy mouth, and I have covered thee in the shadow of mine hand, that I may plant the heavens, and lay the foundations of the earth, and say unto Zion, Thou art my people.”

God’s Word in your mouth plants the heavens and lays foundations upon the earth.

Isaiah 54:11–13 says:

“O thou afflicted, tossed with tempest, and not comforted, behold, I will lay thy stones with fair colours, and lay thy foundations with sapphires.

And I will make thy windows of agates, and thy gates of carbuncles, and all thy borders of pleasant stones.

And all thy children shall be taught of the Lord; and great shall be the peace of thy children.”

You have been afflicted. You have been tossed with tempest. You have not been comforted. To change that situation, God said, “I will lay thy foundations.”

There are situations in life that persist because something is wrong in the foundation.

Galatians 3:13–14 says:

“Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree:

That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.”

What Foundations Mean

The Foundation Determines the Future

The foundation of every structure determines the future of the structure. The integrity and solidity of a foundation determine the destiny of a construction. A fault in the foundation equals failure or disaster in the construction—either immediately or eventually.

There are buildings where cracks appeared many years later on the twelfth floor, but the challenge was in the foundation. Many lives are like that. Suddenly, challenges begin to appear that were never there before, and people wonder where they came from. Most times, the issue is from the foundation.

Definition of Foundation

Origins and Underlying Principles

Foundation refers to the origins, beginnings, underlying basis, or principles of a thing or structure.

Forces That Determine Existence

Foundation also refers to the forces that determine the existence or future of a structure or system.

In a family context, foundation refers to the forces that determine:

- The future of the family
- The existence of the family
- The quality of life within the family

You may see a family where marriages fail consistently, or people rise to a certain level only to crash. You may see people who never live beyond a certain age.

The foundation is determining the quality of life in that family.

Negative Forces at Work

Evil foundations are evil or negative forces at the origins or beginnings of families that occasion negative events in the future life of that family.

These evil foundations are usually products of demonic covenants and transactions.

Today, by the mantle that is Apostolic and prophetic, I announce: every evil foundation of your life and family that has been negatively affecting your destiny shall collapse!

Say after me:

“Every evil foundation of my life and family is collapsing today!”

Understanding Curses

Negative Verdicts and Pronouncements

Curses are negative decrees, verdicts, or pronouncements that limit, disempower, or destroy the lives and destinies of their recipients.

When a curse is at work, it means there has been:

- A verdict
- A decree
- A pronouncement

These curses are often products of evil covenants and transactions.

Sometimes, however, they are spoken unintentionally by authority figures—fathers, spiritual leaders, or people in positions of influence.

But today, in the Name that is above every name, Jesus Christ the resurrected Lord, every negative verdict, decree, or pronouncement fighting your life and destiny shall crumble and collapse!

Adam and Eve: The Foundation of Doom

Adam's transaction with the devil established humanity on the foundation of gloom, doom, hardship, and death.

Genesis 2:16–17 says:

“And the Lord God commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat:

But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.”

Adam disobeyed God and entered into a transaction with the devil.

The outcome was catastrophic.

Genesis 3 records the curse that followed:

- Sorrow
- Pain
- Toil
- Sweat
- Hardship
- Death

Romans 3:23 confirms:

“For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God.”

But thank God for Jesus Christ, who came to crush the curse through the Cross of Calvary.

Shout Hallelujah!

The Lineage of Terah

A Foundation of Delay

There appeared to be a foundation in Terah's family that produced a hidden curse of delay.

Genesis 11:29–32 introduces the family of Terah.

The name "Terah" means delay.

Delay. Stagnation. Failure to achieve on time.

Terah himself was called to move to Canaan, but he stopped in Haran and remained there until he died. He never reached destiny.

Then came his sons.

Nahor: The Spirit of Slumber

Nahor's name suggests sleep or slumber.

Deep sleep is the mother of delay in life.

Haran: Death Before Destiny

Haran died before his father. His life ended prematurely.

Lot: Delay Fighting Destiny

Even Lot inherited the plague of delay.

When angels came to rescue him from Sodom, Genesis 19:15–16 says:

“And while he lingered, the men laid hold upon his hand...”

Delay almost destroyed him.

If not for mercy, Lot would have died in Sodom because of the foundation fighting him.

Many people are alive today only because of the mercy of God.

The reason why what is fighting you from your father’s house has not destroyed you is mercy.

But today, everything from your father’s house that will not let you rest shall be laid to rest!

Say it loudly:

“The delay is over!”

Delay Passed Through Generations

Barrenness and Delay in Abraham’s Line

The spirit of delay entered Abraham’s family line.

Sarah was barren.

Genesis 11:30 says:

“But Sarai was barren; she had no child.”

Isaac’s wife, Rebekah, was barren.

Genesis 25:21 says:

“And Isaac intreated the Lord for his wife, because she was barren...”

Jacob's wives also battled barrenness.

Genesis 29:31 says:

“...but Rachel was barren.”

There was a pattern.

A spell of delay said:

“You can achieve things, but not on time.”

Today, every spirit of delay following you from your father's house is broken!

Say:

“My delay is over!”

“The foundations of my father's house can no longer succeed against my destiny!”

The Curse of Death on Rachel and Her Offspring

This is a very touching example of hidden curses. When Jacob was leaving Laban's house, Rachel stole her father's images.

Genesis 31:19 says:

“And Rachel had stolen the images that were her father's.”

Laban pursued Jacob. In anger and ignorance, Jacob made a dangerous pronouncement. Genesis 31:32 says:

“With whomsoever thou findest thy gods, let him not live...”

Jacob did not know Rachel had taken the images. Rachel hid them beneath her and escaped discovery. But the pronouncement had already been made. Later, in Genesis 35:16–19, Rachel died while giving birth to Benjamin.

The curse had spoken.

Benjamin was initially named Benoni, meaning “son of my sorrow”. Though Jacob changed the name to Benjamin, the effects followed the tribe. Benjamin became the smallest tribe in Israel.

At one point, the tribe was almost wiped out completely. Judges 20 records how twenty-five thousand men of Benjamin were destroyed until only six hundred men remained. Israel wept and said:

“There is one tribe cut off from Israel this day.”

— Judges 21:3

A careless pronouncement had become a destructive force. But today, every negative pronouncement spoken knowingly or unknowingly over your life is broken in the Name of Jesus Christ!

The Curse on Benjamin

The curse almost wiped Benjamin out completely. The tribe had been reduced to only six hundred men, and they had to go to Jabesh-gilead to secure wives for the survivors.

Someone may ask, “Why did this affect only Benjamin when Rachel had two sons—Joseph and Benjamin?”

The answer is simple.

Joseph was born before the curse. Genesis 30 records Joseph’s birth, while the curse came in Genesis 31. Joseph escaped it narrowly because he had already been born before the pronouncement was made.

But from that moment onward, the curse touched everything that came out of Rachel. That is why we are here today. Every evil foundation and every evil curse that desires to take people prematurely in your family, community, or lineage shall expire today!

Lift your right hand and declare:

“I shall fulfil my days!

I cannot die like others died!

I shall fulfil my days!”

The Evil Foundation and Curse of Reuben

Moral Bankruptcy and Instability

Reuben had two major challenges:

- Moral bankruptcy
- Lack of firmness of purpose

He lacked moral integrity and stability in decision-making. Genesis 35:22 records how Reuben slept with his father’s concubine. His father did not react immediately, but the consequences followed Reuben and his descendants.

When Jacob blessed his sons in Genesis 49:3–4, he declared:

“Reuben, thou art my firstborn, my might, and the beginning of my strength,
the excellency of dignity, and the excellency of power:

Unstable as water, thou shalt not excel...”

That instability became a curse over his lineage.

Reuben's Weakness in Leadership

The Failure to Stand Firm

When Joseph's brothers conspired against him, Reuben failed to take a firm stand.

Instead of saying:

“No one touches Joseph while I am here,”

he vacillated.

Genesis 37:21–22 says:

“And Reuben heard it, and he delivered him out of their hands; and said, Let us not kill him.

And Reuben said unto them, Shed no blood, but cast him into this pit...”

They placed Joseph in the pit, and while Reuben was away, Joseph was sold into slavery.

When Reuben returned, he cried:

“The child is not; and I, whither shall I go?”

— Genesis 37:30

That unstable character followed his descendants.

The Reubenites in Battle

Great Searchings of Heart

In the days of Deborah, the tribe of Reuben still manifested indecision.

Judges 5:15–16 says:

“For the divisions of Reuben there were great thoughts of heart.

Why abodest thou among the sheepfolds, to hear the bleatings of the flocks?
For the divisions of Reuben there were great searchings of heart.”

While others went to battle, Reuben sat analysing and hesitating.

Because of this, Reuben lost the birthright.

First Chronicles 5:1 says:

“...forasmuch as he defiled his father's bed, his birthright was given unto the sons of Joseph...”

Reuben was the firstborn, yet he lost what belonged to him.

There are people today who are genuinely trying to live right, yet they are fighting inherited weaknesses from their bloodline.

But today, every evil pattern from your bloodline fighting your destiny is broken!

Declare:

“I shall not manifest the weaknesses of my bloodline!
I shall not inherit the liabilities of my father's house!”

The Evil Foundation and Curse of Judah

The Foundation of Immorality

Judah established a dangerous foundation in his lineage. Genesis 38 records the tragedy surrounding his family. Two of his sons died because of wickedness. Tamar, the widow of one of his sons, disguised herself as a harlot because Judah failed to fulfil his responsibility towards her.

Judah approached her, not knowing she was his daughter-in-law.

Genesis 38:16 says:

“And he turned unto her by the way, and said, Go to, I pray thee, let me come in unto thee...”

Judah entered into immorality and handed over symbols of authority as a pledge:

- His signet
- His bracelets
- His staff

Later, when Tamar was discovered to be pregnant, Judah ordered her execution.

But Tamar revealed the pledge and said the child belonged to the owner of those items.

Judah suddenly realised his shame.

The Generational Effect of Judah's Foundation

Judah established his lineage on a foundation of immorality and incest. That pattern continued through generations. David took another man's wife and arranged the man's death.

Amnon violated Tamar. Absalom publicly slept with his father's concubines. Solomon multiplied strange women. The foundation kept reproducing itself. There are people today who struggle with destructive behaviours they cannot explain.

They ask:

“Why am I behaving like this?
Why can't I control myself?”

Sometimes, those struggles are tied to foundations. But today, every evil foundation fighting your destiny—whether in character, behaviour, or lifestyle—collapses now in the Name of Jesus Christ!

Declare:

“Every evil foundation of my life, family, and destiny is ending today!”

Gideon and His Father's Altar

Judges 6:25–26 gives another example.

God told Gideon:

“Throw down the altar of Baal that thy father hath...”

Before Gideon could rise into destiny, something in his father's house had to come down. God was saying:

“There is something in your father’s house limiting your destiny.”

Today, everything in your father’s house fighting the plan of God for your life shall be set on fire!

Declare boldly:

“No altar from my father’s side, and no altar from my mother’s house, will stop my destiny!”

The Foundation of Jericho

A City Built on Blood

Jericho was laid on a bloody foundation.

First Kings 16:34 says:

“...he laid the foundation thereof in Abiram his firstborn, and set up the gates thereof in his youngest son Segub...”

Human sacrifice was used to establish the city. What future could such a city possibly have?

There are families and lineages built on bloody foundations. Some years ago, I heard the story of a family where every female child died before the age of thirty. When the matter was investigated, it was discovered that their ancestor was a powerful ruler. Upon his death, tradition demanded that someone accompany him into the grave.

His youngest wife was buried alive with him. As she was being buried, she cried out in agony and pronounced curses upon the family:

“No daughter in this lineage shall cross this age!”

And generation after generation, the curse repeated itself. There are lineages affected by:

- Bloodshed
- Slave trading
- Human sacrifices
- Wicked ancestral transactions

But the good news is this:

That is why the Cross of Calvary exists. Jesus came so that these things could be reversed. Today, every blood sacrifice at the foundation of your family and destiny is reversed and cancelled in the Name of Jesus!

Declare loudly:

“Today is my day!

I receive total freedom!”

God’s Answer to Evil Foundations

The Cross of Calvary

What is God’s answer to evil foundations and curses?

The Cross of Calvary. Galatians 3:13–14 says:

“Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us...

That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ...”

What Salvation Means

A New Creation

Second Corinthians 5:17 says:

“Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.”

To be saved is to become a new creation not connected to a previous life. When God created Adam, Adam inherited nothing from anyone. Through salvation, God begins something entirely new with you. You become the beginning of a new lineage.

Regenerated and Renewed

Titus 3:5 says:

“...according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost.”

To be regenerated means to be rewired.

It means the old spiritual gene carrying calamity has been replaced.

You have been redeemed, refurbished, rebranded, and rewired by Jesus Christ for victory.

Declare:

“I have been rewired through Jesus Christ to succeed in life!”

Redeemed from Futile Inheritance

First Peter 1:18–19 says:

“Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers;

But with the precious blood of Christ...”

The phrase “vain conversation” refers to an empty and profitless lifestyle inherited from forefathers. The blood of Jesus rescues people from inherited futility.

The New Living Translation says:

“For you know that God paid a ransom to save you from the empty life you inherited from your ancestors.”

Humanity was kidnapped by the devil through ancestral transactions, curses, and covenants. But Jesus came with a ransom—not silver or gold, but His precious Blood.

Lift your hand and declare:

“The ransom has been paid to rescue me from futility and calamity!
The Blood of Jesus has set me free!”

The Blood of Jesus sets free from shame, sorrow, bondage, and destruction. Today marks the terminal date of every evil foundation in your life.

Four: To Be Saved Is To Be Engrafted Into The Life Of Christ

To be saved is to be engrafted into the life of Christ—engrafted.

Anyone familiar with agriculture understands grafting. In Romans 11:17, Scripture says some branches were broken off, and you, being a wild olive tree, were grafted in among them, becoming partaker of the root and fatness of the olive tree.

Paul warns: do not boast against the natural branches. Then in verse 24, he continues the same thought—those who were cut out of the wild olive tree and grafted contrary to nature into a good olive tree now partake of its life.

This is the mystery: you came from a wild lineage, but salvation interrupts that lineage.

It breaks the root of destruction, curses, and inherited patterns. You have been removed from one system and planted into another.

So from the moment of salvation, you no longer draw life from your father's house. You no longer draw destiny from ancestral roots. You are sustained by a new root—Christ Himself.

What flows into you is no longer corruption, but divine life.

You are the same person physically, but spiritually, everything has changed. Your source has changed. Your root has changed. Your future has changed.

A change of fruit reveals a change of root.

Five: To Be Saved Is To Be Established On A New Foundation

To be saved is to be established on a new foundation—the foundation of Jesus Christ. In 1 Corinthians 3:11, Scripture declares that no other foundation can anyone lay than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ.

Salvation means stepping onto a new platform. If your previous foundation was weak or corrupted, it is replaced. Colossians 1:13 says He has delivered us from the power of darkness and translated us into the kingdom of His dear Son. That is relocation from one realm to another.

You are no longer standing on the ground of darkness. You are standing on a different ground entirely.

Jeremiah 31:29–30 makes it clear: the days of inherited blame are over. No longer shall it be said that the fathers ate sour grapes and the children's teeth are set on edge. Every man shall bear his own responsibility before God.

Through Christ, the chain of inherited condemnation is broken.

How To Walk In The Reality Of Your Liberty

How do you live out what redemption has provided?

First, understand this: provision is not the same as appropriation. Availability is not the same as activation. The existence of light does not guarantee freedom unless it is embraced. Truth must be applied before liberty is experienced.

So, how do you walk in this freedom?

1. Be Born Again

New life begins with Christ. This is the foundation of deliverance from inherited bondage.

2. Be Armed With Truth

Truth is light. Light dissolves darkness. John 8:32 declares that truth brings freedom.

3. Renew Your Mind

Transformation follows renewal. Romans 12:2 shows that a renewed mind produces a transformed life.

What you hear must become what you live. Let it sink deep until it reshapes your thinking.

4. Renounce Every Old Obligation

Consciously reject every connection to darkness and inherited bondage. Declare your separation through Christ.

5. Continually Declare Your Liberty

Your confession aligns your reality. What you repeatedly declare becomes what manifests.

6. Engage Fasting And Prayer

At times, spiritual resistance requires spiritual discipline. Fasting strengthens enforcement of truth.

7. Engage The Blood Of Jesus

Revelation 12:11 declares victory through the blood of the Lamb. The blood speaks redemption, freedom, and deliverance.

8. Engage The Power Of Praise

Praise is a weapon. In Acts 16, praise shook prison foundations and opened every gate.

9. Submit To Prophetic Instruction

God often uses prophetic direction as a channel of deliverance and preservation.

10. Engage Sacrificial Living

Sacrifice has spiritual weight. It enforces divine turnaround and invites divine remembrance.

When Noah offered sacrifice, God responded with covenant mercy. When Cornelius gave alms, heaven responded with intervention.

Sacrifice speaks where words cannot reach.

Closing Declaration

Every inherited limitation, every unseen chain, every foundational oppression is broken by the power of redemption.

Through Christ, the root has changed, the foundation has changed, and the future has changed.

This is liberty in its fullness.
