## *Introduction*

---

The wisdom of God is never without proof. Everywhere wisdom is at work, results become undeniable. Throughout Scripture, men who walked in wisdom rose into relevance, authority, preservation, and divine presence.

Daniel interpreted the nightmare of Nebuchadnezzar by the wisdom of God, and the king promoted him. Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego escaped disaster in Babylon by divine wisdom, and they too were promoted in the province of Babylon.

In 1 Samuel 18:5, we also saw the promotion of David:

“And David went out whithersoever Saul sent him, and behaved himself wisely...” — 1 Samuel 18:5 (KJV)

By wise behaviour, David was set over the men of war.

Wisdom brings lifting.

## *Wisdom in the Workplace*

One of our members decided to apply the wisdom principles taught concerning career and workplace excellence. As a result, she gained promotions, recognition, and international opportunities through wisdom.

A young lady in America heard that message and approached her boss with three questions:

1. “Is there any burden in this workplace that I can help relieve for you?”
2. “Is there anything I am doing that you are not happy with?”
3. “Is there anything you would want me to do that I am not yet aware of?”

The man looked at her in amazement and replied:

“All your three questions are no. There is nothing I need you to relieve, there is nothing you are doing wrongly, and I am happy with everything you are doing.”

That was wisdom speaking.

Wisdom says:

“I am not just here to secure my own interest, but also the interest of my employer.”

That kind of wisdom produces promotion.

## *Wisdom in Marriage*

A woman who walks in wisdom in marriage will keep rising. Every genuine and responsible man should place his wife on allowance. It is not about the amount; it is about the thoughtfulness behind it.

Food money is not allowance. Kitchen money is separate.

Many women end up writing exaggerated market lists because they have no personal allowance. If they need fifty thousand naira, they may write one hundred thousand naira into the list because there is no other provision for personal needs.

A wise man says:

“This is kitchen money, and this is your own personal money.”

A woman has responsibilities too. Family members may call. Someone stranded may need help. She should not always have to explain every need before she can help somebody.

I placed my wife on allowance, and once in a while I would say:

“Because of your goodness of girlness, your allowance has increased.”

If she were quarrelsome, perhaps the allowance would reduce until suspension.

But understand this clearly: it is not about the amount. Even if it is small, the joy is that it came from the husband.

Men are rugged, but women are emotionally fragile. Scripture refers to them as the weaker vessel—not weak in destiny, but tender emotionally.

That wisdom preserves homes.

## *Wisdom Produces Power and Authority*

Another dividend of wisdom is power, authority, and rulership. In Proverbs 8:14–15, wisdom declares:

“Counsel is mine, and sound wisdom: I am understanding; I have strength.  
By me kings reign, and princes decree justice.” — Proverbs 8:14–15 (KJV)

Wisdom positions people for rulership. Joseph became ruler in Egypt because of wisdom. Pharaoh said to him:

“Forasmuch as God hath shewed thee all this, there is none so discreet and wise as thou art.” — Genesis 41:39 (KJV)

Then Pharaoh continued:

“Thou shalt be over my house, and according unto thy word shall all my people be ruled...” — Genesis 41:40 (KJV)

Wisdom is the way of stardom. Wisdom is the pathway to dominion. You cannot be genuinely wise and remain without territory. Wisdom creates domains of influence.

God is positioning somebody into authority.

## *The Presence of God and Wisdom*

Another dividend of wisdom is the presence of God.

“And David behaved himself wisely in all his ways; and the LORD was with him.” — 1 Samuel 18:14 (KJV)

As long as David behaved wisely, the Lord remained with him. Joseph also walked in wisdom, and the Lord was with him.

Why?

Because God is the only wise God. Amos 3:3 says:

“Can two walk together, except they be agreed?” — Amos 3:3 (KJV)

If God is wise, and you walk in wisdom, you naturally walk with Him. God is close to wisdom and far from foolishness. Where things are done wisely, orderly, and excellently, the presence of God is evident. Where there is confusion, disorder, and carelessness, the atmosphere resists divine presence.

How can somebody pray effectively in a room full of disorder? Shoes on the bed, dirty plates everywhere, flies flying around, and yet the person says:

“Lord, I lift Your Name on high.”

Order attracts divine manifestation. Jesus instructed the people to sit in companies before the miracle of multiplication occurred. The temple was arranged according to divine order before God showed up. Wisdom creates the climate for God's presence.

## *Pursue the Wisdom of God*

There are many more dividends of wisdom, but if these manifest in your life, no devil can stop you.

### **1. Determine to Pursue Wisdom**

“And I gave my heart to seek and search out by wisdom...” — Ecclesiastes 1:13 (KJV)

Every area of pressure, crisis, confusion, or lack of progress is a signal that wisdom is needed.

Ask God:

“What am I meant to do in this situation?”

Pursue wisdom intentionally.

### **2. Receive the Instruction of the Wise**

“A wise man will hear, and will increase learning...” — Proverbs 1:5 (KJV)

School may stop, but learning must never stop.

Learning is for life.

Everything around you is teaching something. Keep learning.

There were times while driving long distances, inspiration and instruction would begin to flow so strongly that I had to stop and write. Because of that, I kept pen and paper close to me everywhere.

A wise person remains teachable.

### *Prayer for Divine Direction*

“Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding.

In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.” — Proverbs 3:5–6 (KJV)

Lift your voice and pray:

“Father, direct my path into Your plan, Your purpose, Your agenda, and Your wisdom for my life in this season.”

### *Deliver Me from Wrong Decisions*

“There is a way which seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death.” — Proverbs 14:12 (KJV)

The same warning appears again in Proverbs 16:25.

Many people entered wrong paths fully convinced they were right. Some travelled abroad without divine direction and later discovered they were never meant to leave home. Yet pride kept them there for decades.

But God created room for U-turns. There is reverse gear in destiny.

Pray:

“Father, deliver me from wrong decisions, from the path of danger, destruction, and disaster.”

May Jehovah interrupt every wrong journey in your life. Sometimes delays are deliverance. Sometimes interruptions are protection. A vehicle may stop unexpectedly because God is preserving somebody from danger ahead. May God interfere mercifully whenever you are on the wrong path.

### ***Mercy for Previous Wrong Decisions***

Psalm 136 repeatedly declares:

“For his mercy endureth for ever.” — Psalm 136 (KJV)

Solomon was never naturally positioned for the throne considering the circumstances surrounding his birth. Yet mercy spoke for him.

Mercy does not always make human sense.

Pray:

“Lord, let Your mercy rescue me from the consequences of previous wrong decisions.”

May mercy reduce the effects of every wrong move and every wrong step.

## *Deliverance from Every Conspiracy*

“No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper...” — Isaiah 54:17  
(KJV)

Declare boldly:

“No weapon formed against me shall prosper, and every tongue that rises against me in judgment I condemn.”

Pray for deliverance from every gang-up, conspiracy, orchestration, and condemnation against your life, your family, your destiny, the Church, and the nation.

Every voice of accusation is silenced in Jesus' Name.

## *Closing Charge*

The entrance of God's Word brings light.

“The entrance of thy words giveth light; it giveth understanding unto the simple.” — Psalm 119:130 (KJV)

Walk in the light of the wisdom you have received.

Pursue wisdom.

Value instruction.

Remain teachable.

And may the Lord direct your steps continually into His perfect will.
