## ***Introduction***

Very quickly tonight, we will deal on the subject of faith still, which is our subject for the month. I had thought that we would branch into the issues of Easter today, but we may look at that on Friday.

Tonight, it is: **Faith and Prayer**

Our objective tonight is to understand the connection between faith and prayer.

*“Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.”* — Mark 11:24 (KJV)

What things soever you desire, when you pray, believe.

Prayer and faith.

*“If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him. But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering...”* — James 1:5–6 (KJV)

## *We Serve a Prayer-Answering God*

I want to say by way of introduction that we serve a prayer-answering God.  
Prayer-answering God!

*“O thou that hearest prayer, unto thee shall all flesh come.”* — Psalm 65:2  
(KJV)

He does not only hear prayers; He answers prayers.

*“Call unto me, and I will answer thee, and shew thee great and mighty things, which thou knowest not.”* — Jeremiah 33:3 (KJV)

Call unto Me, and I will answer you, and I will show you great things, mighty things which you did not know before.

*“I will call upon the Lord, who is worthy to be praised: so shall I be saved from mine enemies.”* — Psalm 18:3 (KJV)

So we serve a prayer-answering God.

*“Hitherto have ye asked nothing in my name: ask, and ye shall receive, that your joy may be full.”* — John 16:24 (KJV)

Ask, and you shall receive, that your joy may be full.

*“Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you.”* — Matthew 7:7 (KJV)

*“Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.”* — Hebrews 4:16 (KJV)

Every scripture here shows that God is a prayer-answering God.

## *The Faith Component of Prayer*

But there is a second issue. As eager as God is to hear and answer prayers, not many people see answers to their prayers. God is eager to hear. God is eager to answer prayers. Yet many people do not see answers to their prayers.

Why?

Among other things, there is the challenge of faith — the faith component of prayer.

What has faith got to do with prayer?

That is where the message is tonight.

### **1. Faith Involves the Knowledge and Understanding of the Reality and Reliability of God**

Faith involves the knowledge and understanding of the reality and reliability of God.

That God is real and God is reliable.

*“But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.” — Hebrews 11:6 (KJV)*

So at the place of prayer, while you pray, it must be clear that God is real.

At the place of prayer, it must be clear that God is reliable.

God is real, and God is reliable.

## **2. Faith Involves the Revelation of the Word of God**

Faith involves the revelation of the Word of God — that is, understanding God’s dealings and operations in Bible days.

You are aware of what God has done before.

*“So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.” — Romans 10:17 (KJV)*

*“And what shall I more say? for the time would fail me to tell of Gedeon, and of Barak, and of Samson, and of Jephthae... who through faith subdued kingdoms, wrought righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions...” — Hebrews 11:32–33 (KJV)*

So at the place of prayer, when you pray in faith, you are aware that you are not dealing with a God who has not done it before.

A. A. Allen said:

*“We know what God can do because we know what He did.”*

If we are aware of what God did before, we can be convinced of what He will do now.

So faith involves an understanding of the reality and reliability of Almighty God. God is real. God is reliable.

Faith also involves the revelation of the Word of God — His dealings and operations in Bible days.

Somebody say aloud, Amen!

## *Healing and Deliverance Testimony*

Yesterday, I saw a young man who was brought into the service. Maybe the media crew will have the clip of that young man. A man and his mother held him while he could barely walk. They held him to come.

In the course of the healing service yesterday, the power of God touched him, and they did not need to hold him anymore. He could walk out by himself. That was the testimony he came out to testify about.

But my heart flamed, and I laid hands on him, and violently he stood up and ran up this altar and ran everywhere. I told somebody who was so shocked about that miracle, “That was an A. A. Allen operation.”

If you ever watched or heard about the healing revival, you would understand. Faith happens when you know what God has done before — in Bible days and in history — and you pray from the point of view that God has done this and that before, and He will do it again.

That was how that young man came whole. Paralysis disappeared, and he was able to walk by himself without support anymore. But faith said that was not enough. Faith said he needed to be complete.

Then the prayer was prayed for him. He was on the floor, and power rushed through his legs. He jumped up and moved. That was faith at work. Something is moving in your life tonight!

Something that was not moving shall move tonight!

Every paralytic condition in your life — business paralysis, marital paralysis, financial paralysis, destiny paralysis, career paralysis — is over tonight!

Shout the loudest amen!

Give the Lord a big clap of hands and tell somebody beside you:

“Something is moving in your life tonight!”

### **3. Faith Involves the Knowledge and Understanding of the Will of God**

Faith involves the knowledge and understanding of the will of God regarding particular situations. That is, you are praying and not guessing.

You know God wants you healed.

You know it is the will of God for you to be delivered.

*“And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us.” — 1 John 5:14 (KJV)*

The knowledge of the will of God brings confidence.

*“Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.” — 3 John 1:2 (KJV)*

So you are locating scriptures that show you what God wants for you. Your prayer is based not just on what you need, but on what God wills for your life. It is not just that you need it; it is that you know God wills it for your life.

God wants you to be well.

God wants you to be free.
