Introduction

Welcome, everybody.

I bring you greetings from Ibadan, where we had the most explosive Healing and Deliverance Crusade. We will show you clips of it shortly, but this morning we are going straight into the subject we discussed before we came here: **Faith For Supernatural Finance (Supplies)**

“I had fainted, unless I had believed to see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living.” — Psalm 27:13

Our objective this morning is to understand the pathway to supernatural finance or supernatural supplies.

I want to mention three things by way of introduction.

God Is The God Of Supernatural Supplies

God is the God of supernatural supplies. He is the God of supplies beyond the natural—beyond normal human provision.

We saw His supply for Elijah in:

1 Kings 17:3–6

God directed Elijah to the brook Cherith and fed him through ravens. That was not normal supply; that was supernatural supply.

Another example is the miraculous sustenance of the widow of Zarephath.

1 Kings 17:13–16

There was famine in the land, yet Elijah declared:

“The barrel of meal shall not waste, neither shall the cruse of oil fail, until the day that the LORD sendeth rain upon the earth.”

And the food did not finish. That was supernatural supply. Another example was the supply for Peter and the Master at the lake.

Matthew 17:27

When it was time to pay tax, Jesus sent Peter to cast a hook into the sea, and the first fish he caught had money in its mouth. That was not normal supply. That was supernatural supply.

We also saw the miraculous catch of fish.

Luke 5:4–6

Peter said:

“Master, we have toiled all the night, and have taken nothing: nevertheless at thy word I will let down the net.”

And they enclosed a great multitude of fishes, and their net brake. That was supernatural supply.

Then there was the wedding at Cana of Galilee.

John 2:5–11

The wine finished, and Jesus released supernatural supply by turning water into wine.

Let it be made clear: we serve the God of supernatural supplies.

Faith Is Key To Seeing God's Supplies

Faith in God is key to seeing the goodness, the goodies, and the supplies of God.

"I had fainted, unless I had believed to see..." — Psalm 27:13

To believe is to see.

"But without faith it is impossible to please him..." — Hebrews 11:6

Faith in God is the key to our rewards in God. Faith in God is the key to our supplies in God.

Obedience Is Key To Accessing Divine Supplies

Obedience to scriptural instructions and injunctions is key to accessing supernatural supplies.

The faith that brings supplies is obedience-driven faith.

Deuteronomy 28:1–2

"And it shall come to pass, if thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the LORD thy God... that all these blessings shall come on thee, and overtake thee..."

You hearken to the voice of the Lord your God, and you open the way for blessings that overtake.

Job 36:11

“If they obey and serve him, they shall spend their days in prosperity, and their years in pleasures.”

There is a connection between obedience and abundance.

Isaiah 1:19

“If ye be willing and obedient, ye shall eat the good of the land.”

There is good in the land, but it is for the willing and for the obedient.

Right now, I prophesy to someone here: your obedience to what you will hear this morning will usher you into a realm of resources that will amaze you.

The End Time Is A Season Of Revival And Resources Explosion

The end time is a season for both spiritual revival and resources explosion.

Joel 2:23–26

“Be glad then, ye children of Zion, and rejoice in the LORD your God...”

The former rain and the latter rain speak of revival.

Then He says:

“And the floors shall be full of wheat, and the fats shall overflow with wine and oil.”

That is resources explosion.

“And ye shall eat in plenty, and be satisfied...”

This is the season where the fire of prayer, the fire of the Word, the fire of fasting, and the fire of evangelism are producing dimensions of miracles we have never seen before.

The kind of things eyes have not seen and ears have not heard are happening.

And in the midst of that revival, there shall also be unprecedented resources for the advancement of the Gospel, because this Gospel must be pushed out in a hurry.

Zechariah 1:17

“My cities through prosperity shall yet be spread abroad...”

Haggai 2:6–9

God said:

“The silver is mine, and the gold is mine...”

And He will use that silver and gold to ensure that the glory of the latter house is greater than the former.

God Is Looking For Vessels To Entrust With End-Time Wealth

God is in search of vessels to entrust with end-time wealth.

2 Chronicles 16:9

“For the eyes of the LORD run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to shew himself strong in the behalf of them whose heart is perfect toward him.”

God is looking for men and women He can trust.

Let me shock you: if God cannot find believers who will be relevant to His purpose on the earth, He will locate unbelievers who will be faithful to assignment.

That was what He did with Cyrus.

Isaiah 45:1

“Thus saith the LORD to his anointed, to Cyrus...”

Cyrus was a heathen king, yet God called him His anointed because he understood kingdom assignment.

Isaiah 45:13

“He shall build my city, and he shall let go my captives...”

Cyrus empowered Nehemiah for the rebuilding of Jerusalem and empowered Ezra for the rebuilding of the temple.

That is what the Bible means when it says:

“If these should hold their peace, the stones would immediately cry out.” —

Luke 19:40

God is saying:

“If I cannot find those inside the church who understand kingdom assignment, I will find those outside who will do what I ask them to do.”

But I believe there are people here today whom God is saying: “You are the one I am looking for.”

Lift your hands and say: “Here am I, Lord. Use me. I will not allow another person to take my place in destiny.”

The Pillars Of Obedience For Supernatural Supplies

What are the pillars of obedience for supernatural supplies?

What must we do in order to experience supernatural supplies?

The Revelation Of The Word

The first pillar is the revelation of the Word of God for supernatural supplies. You need to know what is in the Word for you, and what the Word says concerning you.

Psalm 35:27

“Let the LORD be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of his servant.”

3 John 1:2

“Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.”

Revelation does three things:

1. Revelation brings possession.
2. Revelation precedes releases.
3. Revelation determines manifestation.

If you want to manifest in any realm, you must possess revelation in that realm. If you want to manifest in the realm of finances, you must have revelation in the realm of supplies.

The Conviction Of The Heart

The second pillar is the conviction of the heart for supernatural supplies.

“I had fainted, unless I had believed to see...” — Psalm 27:13

What you believe determines what you see.

Those who believe they will struggle like their fathers struggled will continue to see struggles.

What you believe determines what you receive.

John 1:12

“But as many as received him, to them gave he power...”

What you believe also determines how you behave, and how you behave determines what you become.

Proverbs 23:7

“For as he thinketh in his heart, so is he.”

If you believe scarcity is not your portion, you will not behave like scarcity is your portion.

Years ago in Deeper Life, we used to sing:

“I’m a millionaire,
My Father is rich in houses and lands,
And I am His heir...”

Even when people had nothing materially, they still believed the covenant.

These are the kinds of mentalities that must occupy our minds.

We do not look inferior to anybody under heaven. We do not look beggarly or pitiable.

The Understanding Of The Covenant Of Supernatural Supplies

The third pillar is understanding the covenant of supernatural supplies.

Genesis 8:22

“While the earth remaineth, seedtime and harvest... shall not cease.”

2 Corinthians 9:6–7

“He which soweth sparingly shall reap also sparingly...”

Supernatural supply is not merely a promise to claim; it is a covenant to walk in.

It is not enough to say: “God will supply all my needs.”

There is something to do. God is obligated only when man is committed. The commitment of man provokes the response of God. Everything done to bring about harvest is futile until seed enters the ground.

The Practice Of The Covenant

The fourth pillar is the practice of the covenant of supernatural supply.

Until seed leaves your hand, harvest does not move in your direction.

Genesis 8:20

Noah built an altar unto the Lord and offered burnt offerings unto God. Then God enacted the covenant.

Listen carefully:

What you know is not what changes your life; it is what you do that changes your life.

What you know may make you intelligent. What you do makes you wise. Information brings intelligence; action confirms wisdom. There are many intelligent fools in the world. A consultant pathologist who knows alcohol destroys the liver yet remains a drunkard is an intelligent fool.

A cardiologist who understands the dangers of smoking yet remains a chain smoker is an intelligent fool. And there are many like that in church. Your information made you intelligent, but your lack of action made you foolish.

Today, I see people of action stepping out from here.

When you give—whether tithes, seeds, or sacrifices—let revelation fuel the action.

Isaiah 32:20

“Blessed are ye that sow beside all waters...”

Water represents the Word.

Ephesians 5:26

“...the washing of water by the word.”

Your sowing is blessed when it is done beside the waters—when revelation backs your action. Some people give merely as religious duty without expectation or understanding. But revelation-backed giving produces results.

Give relentlessly and tirelessly.

Galatians 6:7–9

“Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.”

“And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.”

Ecclesiastes 11:4–6

“He that observeth the wind shall not sow...”

If you wait for perfect conditions, nothing gets done.

“In the morning sow thy seed, and in the evening withhold not thine hand...”

You do not know which seed will produce the explosion—whether the one in the morning, the one in the evening, or both together.

So continue sowing.

Continue acting.

Continue believing.

The revelation of the Word, the conviction of the heart, the understanding of the covenant, and the practice of the covenant are pathways into supernatural supplies.

Anybody here who is receiving something so far, say loud Amen!

Anybody whose life is about to be totally disconnected from poverty forever, shout the loudest Amen!

Anybody saying, “No Cyrus can take my place,” shout the loudest Amen!

Lift your hands and say:

“In the Name of Jesus, no Cyrus can take my place. It is my season, and I must play it well.”

Give the Lord a praise as you take your seat.

The Possession Of The Picture And Mindset Of Abundance

The fifth pillar is the possession of the picture and mindset of abundance.

Proverbs 23:7

“For as he thinketh in his heart, so is he.”

Genesis 13:15

“For all the land which thou seest, to thee will I give it, and to thy seed for ever.”

The possession of the picture and mindset of abundance is critical.

Proverbs 21:5

“The thoughts of the diligent tend only to plenteousness...”

When you open the mind of a diligent man, it is filled with pictures of plenty.

Take note of these truths:

1. Mental picture determines actual future.

2. What is not your picture can never be your future.
3. What goes through your mind eventually overflows into your life.

Criminals commit crimes because those thoughts have filled their minds until they overflow into action.

And thirdly: What you imagine eventually images.

Ephesians 3:20

“Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think...”

God responds to our thinking the same way He responds to our asking. Do not allow negative thoughts from your upbringing to overwhelm your mind.

One of the greatest things my father did for me was to remove the mentality of scarcity from my thinking. The thought of lack did not exist around him.

There was abundance around him. Money was not presented as something impossible.

Some of you tell your children:

“Do you pluck money from trees?”

Stop speaking scarcity into their minds.

You are planting negative pictures of hardship and limitation.

Even if your own upbringing was not like that, you can create a new picture for your generation. If necessary, surround yourself with pictures of possibilities. What goes through the possibilities of your mind affects the realities of your life.

I announce today, in the Name above every name, Jesus Christ the resurrected Lord: I see unusual possibilities opening for somebody here. I like you to see yourself paying for an aircraft—or owning one—for evangelism to South America, Russia, China, and Japan.

Let your mind be filled with unbelievable possibilities.

If the earth is the Lord's and the fulness thereof, and your Father owns the earth, then anything is possible. Papa went for a programme one day, and they met a man with a private jet. He sent one of the pastors to tell the man:

“We want you to give us a lift until our own arrives.”

The man laughed.

But Papa said it because he could see it in his spirit. Today, he has been flying aircraft for decades. If it cannot cross your mind, it will not mistakenly cross your life. Today, every closed mentality and every closed mindset is opening now in Jesus' Name.

The Maintenance Of The Right Utterance

The sixth pillar is the maintenance of the right utterance. Your words matter.

Proverbs 18:20–21

“A man's belly shall be satisfied with the fruit of his mouth...”

“Death and life are in the power of the tongue...”

Take note of this carefully:

The heart, the hand, and the mouth must cooperate to produce supernatural results.

The heart believes.

The hand releases.

The mouth declares.

Then Heaven delivers.

The heart believes that God is a covenant-keeping God and a supernatural Supplier.

The hand releases according to covenant principles. Then the mouth declares:

“I cannot be stranded. I cannot be a beggar. My God supplies all my needs according to His riches in glory.”

Even when things are difficult around you, your utterance must remain in agreement with God.

While others are saying:

“There is a casting down,”

you are saying:

“There is a lifting up.”

Never allow your mouth to speak against your covenant.

When belief is right, and giving is right, but speech is wrong, the outcome can still be wrong.

Somebody asks:

“How are you?”

And you answer:

“We are managing.”

When did you become a manager?

Others say:

“We are patching.”

No.

We do not speak failure.

Numbers 14:28

“As truly as I live, saith the LORD, as ye have spoken in mine ears, so will I do to you.”

Ecclesiastes 5:6

“Suffer not thy mouth to cause thy flesh to sin...”

Do not say before the angel: “It was a joke.”

Words are not empty in the realm of the spirit.

People say casually: “I am dying.”

And they expect you to agree with them.

No.

Your mouth can destroy the works of your hands if you speak wrongly. That is why we do not play with words. When somebody asks: “Are you going down?”

You answer: “I can never go down.”

When somebody says: “Food has finished,”

we say: “No food finishes here. Things only need replacement.”

And because we speak replacement, things are always replaced.

Take your words seriously.

You need a serious approach to life in order to have a glorious destiny.

Lift your right hand and declare:

“I am doing well. Everything is working fine. All things are working together for my good. Things shall end well in my life.”

The words of your mouth ultimately bring home your harvest.

Proverbs 18:20

“With the increase of his lips shall he be filled.”

Your words bring home your harvest.

The Maintenance Of Joy And Praise

The seventh pillar is the maintenance of joy and praise.

Psalm 126:5

“They that sow in tears shall reap in joy.”

Isaiah 12:3

“Therefore with joy shall ye draw water out of the wells of salvation.”

Jeremiah 30:19

“Out of them shall proceed thanksgiving, and the voice of them that make merry...”

Take note of these truths:

1. Joy and praise are the irrigation and fertilisation of the seed.
2. Joy and praise are sickles for harvest.

Joy waters your seed. Joy fertilises your seed.

Joel 1:11–12

The harvest perished because joy withered away from the sons of men.

You reap with joy.

Many people have ripe harvests, but they cannot bring them home because joy is absent.

Murmuring and grumbling only produce dryness and destruction.

Joy is not a gift; joy is a choice.

You can choose excitement, and you can choose depression.

But if you understand how many things are connected to joy, nobody will beg you to rejoice.

The joy of the Lord is your strength.

If you want to remain weak, stay depressed.

Some people are tithers and givers, yet they remain permanently depressed.

They say:

“I have given. I have tithed. God, over to You.”

No.

That is not covenant mentality.

This is one of the churches where nobody begs people to give.

Sometimes offerings are almost forgotten because offerings are not the focus.

Look at your neighbour and say:

“I refuse to be depressed.”

Say it louder:

“I reject depression.”

When you see anybody trying to transfer depression into your atmosphere, excuse yourself and protect your spirit.

Joy is critical to destiny.

The Avoidance Of Anti-Covenant Practices

The eighth pillar is the avoidance of anti-covenant practices.

This mainly refers to borrowing and waste.

Borrowing and waste are enemies of supernatural supply.

We live in a generation where borrowing has become rampant.

People borrow online and become trapped in unbearable pressure and shame.

I receive messages constantly from people saying:

“I borrowed money, and now they are threatening me.”

Some even say they want to take their own lives because of debt pressure.

Beloved, escape borrowing.

Borrowing takes a man out of covenant dependence and into self-help.

Deuteronomy 15:6

“Thou shalt lend unto many nations, but thou shalt not borrow...”

Borrowing is functioning contrary to covenant.

Borrowing is also disobedience against divine instruction, and rebellion brings dryness.

Psalms 68:6

“...the rebellious dwell in a dry land.”

Romans 13:8

“Owe no man any thing, but to love one another...”

Borrowing empties tomorrow into today, so that when tomorrow arrives, it arrives empty.

Avoid borrowing wherever possible.

Trust God for wisdom, direction, and strategy.

There is a way God can guide a person to live without borrowing and without begging.

Lift your right hand.

I break the plague of debt over anyone here today.

Anyone already trapped in debt, I decree that help to come out of it is released upon you now in Jesus' Name.

Waste destroys potential wealth.

John 6:11–13

Do not waste resources carelessly.

Avoid Dependence On Man

The ninth pillar is the avoidance of dependence on man. Do not make any human being your source.

Jeremiah 17:5–8

“Cursed be the man that trusteth in man...”

Psalm 34:5

“They looked unto him, and were lightened: and their faces were not ashamed.”

Take note of these truths:

1. Looking up to man is looking away from God.
2. Looking away from God is looking away from good.
3. Looking up to man eventually leads to shame.

Refuse to make any human being your god or your source.

If we depended only on the offerings coming into this church every Sunday, this building would never have been completed.

At certain stages of construction, one month's work exceeded the income of many months combined.

But God remained the Source.

And He supplied.

Those heavy, heavy columns there, iron—when they give you iron rods, iron, iron, iron rods... bill, that is iron rod; ninety-something million, one hundred million rods that will enter the building and disappear.

And if that is how much is in the offering, God will show you help and mercy. If you are saying Amen, say a louder Amen. If you are saying Amen, say louder Amen.

If we were looking up to one man for this building, the man would have been mixed with the concrete, because he himself would have been so depleted that he would say, "Just mix me with the concrete, I have nothing to bring anymore."

That is what happens to people who look up to man. When men dry up, they dry up. Look at your neighbour and say: your destiny is big. No man's pocket is big enough to sponsor your big destiny. Did you hear what I said?

Look at somebody and say: your destiny is big. No man's pocket is big enough to handle your destiny. Only God has enough pocket.

When you hear people talk, you hear it in their voice: “My uncle is the only supporter of our family... my only help is this senator... my only help is this governor...”

You hear it in people’s mouth.

For out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks. God, who is a jealous God, says: Is it a human being you are talking about like this? Let Me leave you and the person, and I will watch how you handle each other. I release a blessing upon you in the name of Jesus Christ.

You know many things out there—you have to do it credit-wise, but it is possible to do it cash or without going that route. Somebody say a loud Amen.

Lift up your hands and say: God is my source.

Louder: God is my source.

Say Amen.

Man may be a channel, but God remains my source.

Shout the loudest Amen.

Number 10: openness to divine direction.

Lord, what business do You want me to get into?

Lord, what is the right investment?

Lord, where is my harvest?

Your portion is not everywhere. There is a particular position for your portion.

Psalm 23:1–2: *“The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters.”*

If God is the One leading, it will be green pastures—not dry pastures.

It will be still waters—not troubled waters.

Isaiah 48:21: *“They thirsted not when he led them through the deserts...”*

Isaiah 49:10: *“They shall not hunger nor thirst...”*

Why? Because He that has mercy on them shall lead them, even by the springs of water shall He guide them.

They shall not hunger nor thirst.

You are permitted to hunger if you lead yourself.

You are permitted to thirst if you are disconnected from His voice.

Church, let us stop struggling and start resting in His leading.

There is a business where your money is waiting for you. There is an investment that is for you. There is a career, a partnership.

Divine provision and divine direction are connected.

You are not permitted to hunger or thirst if He is allowed to lead you.

To Elijah: go to the brook Cherith.

Not any brook.

To Elijah: go to the widow of Zarephath.

Not any widow.

To Peter: go to the sea of Tiberias.

Not any sea.

You don't just move anywhere and say, "Let me just go to any sea."

You may catch the wrong thing.

When a man feels the call of God, he seeks direction.

In the same manner, if you are a Christian businessman, don't just jump into business.

Separate yourself and ask: Lord, where am I going? What am I doing?

Submission To Prophetic Instruction

Number 11: submission to prophetic instruction and impartation.

2 Chronicles 20:20: *“Believe in the Lord your God, so shall ye be established; believe His prophets, so shall ye prosper.”*

The prosperity of the people is tied to the mantle of their prophet. Prophetic instruction is connected to supernatural provision. Elisha declared at the gate of Samaria. Peter obeyed at the lake of Gennesaret.

John 2:5: *“Whatsoever He saith unto you, do it.”*

Virtue is drawn by value. Virtue is what you value that you draw.

There are people who think they know the person they are close to. Mary thought she knew Jesus until He said, “I must be about My Father’s business.”

Value spiritual grace. If your child is anointed, value the unction. At the National Stadium in 2007, there was healing and deliverance. I stand on the prophetic mantle and declare: your days of scarcity are over forever.

Say Amen like a believer.

Thanksgiving And Appreciation

Number 12: habitual thanksgiving and appreciation. Appreciate every favour you see. Appreciation stabilizes what God has done. Malachi 2:2 shows the danger of not laying things to heart. If you do not give thanks, what you call blessing can be turned.

The children of Israel said, “What is this?” instead of thanksgiving. They ate manna for forty years. But thanksgiving multiplies blessing. Jesus took five loaves and two fishes and gave thanks—and it increased.

Anything you appreciate multiplies.

I see young people under thirty empowered supernaturally.

I see men and women lifted by the God of a second chance.

Lift your hands.

Something is shifting.

A wealth mantle is being released.

A Cyrus mantle is being released.
