No Weapon Formed Shall Prosper

The subject is: **No Weapon Formed Shall Prosper.**

Foundational Scripture

“In righteousness shalt thou be established: thou shalt be far from oppression; for thou shalt not fear: and from terror; for it shall not come near thee.

Behold, they shall surely gather together, but not by me: whosoever shall gather together against thee shall fall for thy sake.

Behold, I have created the smith that bloweth the coals in the fire, and that bringeth forth an instrument for his work; and I have created the waster to destroy.

No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord, and their righteousness is of me, saith the Lord.”

— Isaiah 54:14–17 (KJV)

Somebody give the Lord a shout of victory!

No weapon formed shall prosper!

Our objective is to understand:

1. God's preservation provision for His people.
2. The conditions for divine preservation.

I want to start by saying that one of the greatest assets of the spiritual man or woman is called revelation — light, insight.

One of the greatest assets of the spiritual man or woman is not necessarily the frequency of church attendance. It is not necessarily the duration of being in church. It is not necessarily knowing the pastor.

It is the asset called revelation.

Revelation Brings Elevation

Revelation brings elevation. In Matthew 16:16–18, when Peter got to know who Jesus Christ is, he said:

“Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God.”

Jesus answered and said unto him:

“Blessed art thou, Simon Barjona: for flesh and blood hath not revealed it unto thee, but my Father which is in heaven.

And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter...”

I shift you from Simon. I upgrade you to Peter. Simon was grass. Peter was rock. Revelation brings elevation. It changes status. Paul the Apostle said in Galatians 2:2:

“And I went up by revelation.”

Isaiah 60:1 says:

“Arise, shine; for thy light is come...”

When light comes, people rise.

Revelation Brings Distinction

It causes you to stand out. What makes you stand apart from your mates is what you know that they do not know. Isaiah 60:1 says:

“Arise, shine; for thy light is come, and the glory of the Lord is risen upon thee.”

Paul stood apart from his contemporaries because of the things he knew that they did not know.

Revelation Brings Transformation

“But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory...”

— 2 Corinthians 3:18 (KJV)

There are things you know that change your behaviour on the spot.

There are things you know that change your character on the spot. It changes your mindset on the spot. It changes the way you look at things on the spot.

Revelation brings transformation.

All of a sudden, people begin to look at you and wonder what changed. It is just that you saw something.

You saw something, and character changed.

You saw something, and mindset changed.

You saw something, and everything changed.

That is going to happen to somebody here tonight!

Revelation Brings Direction

“Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.”

— Psalm 119:105 (KJV)

Your Word gives direction.

There are things God will show you out of Scripture that will show you the steps to take. It will show you the moves to make and the actions to proceed upon.

There are things you know that determine the kind of business you can enter and the kind you cannot enter because of something you saw out of Scripture.

Revelation Brings Preservation

For the sake of our study today.

Psalm 91:1 says:

“He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.”

Secrets bring shade.

The secrets you can access determine the shade you can experience. The secrets you have access to determine the safety you can experience. The possession of light is the aversion of destruction.

Nothing prevents destruction like light.

I remember when I was a young medical doctor in the teaching hospital. A young man was brought into the casualty on Christmas Day. He was riding a motorcycle at night without headlights and was drunk.

He ran into an oncoming Mercedes car and died on the spot.

He had no light.

But light can avert destruction.

Tonight, we are going to see the light in Isaiah 54 beyond what we have known before.

I am going to bring out seven lights from this passage that guarantee preservation.

Light Number One — Who Gathered Them?

“Behold, they shall surely gather together, but not by me...”

— Isaiah 54:15 (KJV)

Wizards, occultists, envious people, jealous people — they shall surely gather together.

But their gathering is not what is important.

What is important is this:

“It is not by Me.”

The Only Conspiracy That Can Succeed

The only conspiracy or gathering that can succeed against you is the one originated by God.

The only conspiracy of men or demons that can succeed against you is the one that originated from God.

He said the reason why their gathering means nothing is because it was not by Him.

For as long as a conspiracy is not from God, by God, or through God, it has no future against your life and destiny.

Look at your neighbour and say:

“The major issue is not the gathering. The issue is: who gathered them?”

Even if Lucifer himself gathered them, it is nothing to worry about.

If they gathered themselves, there is nothing to fear.

Anytime somebody tells you there is a gang-up against your life, the first question to ask is:

“Who gathered them?”

That revelation alone is enough to make you function as if the devil does not exist.

If God did not gather them, do not fear them.

Light Number Two — Their Rise Is Their Crash

“Whosoever shall gather together against thee shall fall for thy sake.”

— Isaiah 54:15 (KJV)

Their rise against you is their crash in life. Whatever made them rise is the signature for their downfall. As many as rise against you shall fall for your sake. There is an easy way to know who is about to crash: it is the one that rises against the righteous.

When a dog is about to die, it does not hear the whistle of the hunter. When a goat is about to die, it looks for food on the highway. Any witch that says you should not live is about to die. Every agent of wickedness and darkness that will not allow your family to rest is about to be laid to rest.

The rise of the wicked against the righteous is proof that the wicked is doomed to crash.

Light Number Three — God Did Not Create Weapons For You

“Behold, I have created the smith that bloweth the coals in the fire...”

— Isaiah 54:16 (KJV)

God said:

I created the manufacturer of weapons. The blacksmith manufactures knives, swords, spears, arrows, and instruments. But God is saying:

I did not create or license the manufacturers of weapons to manufacture anything against you. That was not the reason He created them. The one who can manufacture a weapon to waste you was not created for that purpose. The charm that can destroy you was not budgeted for in God’s creation plan concerning your life.

When you carry light like this, you move with springs under your feet. They may say somebody has killed one hundred people with charms, but you know the truth:

The one created to destroy you does not exist.

Light Number Four — No Weapon Shall Prosper

“No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper...”

— Isaiah 54:17 (KJV)

No weapon that can destroy you will ever be successfully constructed. No equipment, tool, or device that can finish your destiny shall prosper. And the one already formed against you is useless, powerless, and harmless against your life and destiny. Somebody shout, “Power!”

The weapon targeted at you is practically powerless and harmless. God’s preservation power is real.

Light Number Five — Every Evil Tongue Shall Be Condemned

“...Every tongue that shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn.”

— Isaiah 54:17 (KJV)

Every voice of accusation or confrontation raised against you is doomed for condemnation.

Judgment comes from accusation.

But God said:

“Thou shalt condemn.”

The voices of accusation and confrontation can never be stronger than your voice in condemnation and nullification.

Lift your voice and say:

“In the Name of Jesus, every voice of accusation and condemnation targeted against me, I silence you by the Blood of Jesus! I cancel you! I condemn you!”

Light Number Six — Preservation Is Your Heritage

“This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord...”

— Isaiah 54:17 (KJV)

It is the inheritance of God’s servants to be shielded and protected from conspiracies, weapons, and evil tongues. Anybody who serves the Lord is a servant of the Lord.

This means preservation is part of your service benefit. It is part of your covenant package. As you serve God wholeheartedly and dedicatedly, you are never at the mercy of conspiracies, weapons, or slander.

It is your inheritance for God to fight for you. It is your inheritance for God to neutralise the weapons targeted against your life. No devil and no agent of darkness shall rejoice over your life.

Light Number Seven — God Defends You With His Own Righteousness

“...And their righteousness is of me, saith the Lord.”

— Isaiah 54:17 (KJV)

God said:

“It is not your righteousness I use to defend you in the face of enemy confrontation. It is My righteousness.”

Their righteousness is of Me. That was the meaning of the song:

“By Your grace and mercy I was justified.
By Your grace and mercy I was sanctified.”

It was not because I was qualified. It was not because I deserved it. Lord, I do not place my faith in my own righteousness. I place my faith in Your mercy alone. God is saying:

“In case the devil says he deserves to be attacked because he failed somewhere, I will stand and defend him with My righteousness.”

What a merciful God!

What a preserving God!

What a faithful Father!

God Defends With His Own Righteousness

“Their righteousness is of Me.”

God is saying:

“I loan them My righteousness for this moment. Now fight Me if you can.”

Satan, I am the One to determine their standing — not you.

The Case Of Moses

How many of you remember the story of Moses?

God told Moses to speak to the rock, but Moses struck the rock instead, and water gushed out.

God was angry because of what Moses had done.

“Moses, you cannot enter the Promised Land.”

One, you disobeyed My voice.

Two, you refused to honour Me before the people.

Three, you took the glory for yourself:

“Must we fetch you water out of this rock?”

— Numbers 20:10 (KJV)

Moses died, and it appeared to be a transition point toward glory.

Then Satan stood in contention concerning Moses.

“Yet Michael the archangel, when contending with the devil he disputed about the body of Moses, durst not bring against him a railing accusation, but said, The Lord rebuke thee.”

— Jude 1:9 (KJV)

Satan appeared to be quoting legal grounds.

“I am the father of all disobedience, and this man disobeyed. If Moses was not qualified to enter the Promised Land on earth, what qualifies him to enter heaven?”

It looked as though Satan had a point.

Then the Lord seemed to whisper to Michael:

“Present My righteousness.”

And Michael said:

“The Lord rebuke thee.”

The battle was no longer between Moses and Satan.

It became a battle between the Lord and Satan.

And Satan backed off.

Mind you, Moses did not commit immorality.

Moses did not steal.

Moses did not run away with another man’s wife.

What happened was a moment of provocation, yet Satan held onto it.

But God said:

“Moses’ righteousness is of Me.”

That is what God is saying to somebody tonight.

When the enemy rises in accusation, God says:

“My righteousness will speak.”

The Righteousness Of God In Christ

“For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.”

— 2 Corinthians 5:21 (KJV)

The official title of Satan is:

“The accuser of the brethren.”

“And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down...”

— Revelation 12:10 (KJV)

In the face of accusations, God says:

“Their righteousness is of Me.”

God bears witness with the sincerity of your heart. You may have made mistakes under pressure, but God knows your motive. And He says:

“I surrender My righteousness for your defence.”

Lord, I do not place my faith in my own righteousness. Lord, I place my faith in Your mercy alone. For Your mercy is my lifeline throughout all eternity. God says:

“I use My righteousness to shield and defend you before the conspiracies and confrontations of the enemy.”

The enemy may say:

“His forefathers worshipped idols.”

But God replies:

“If any man be in Christ, he is a new creature...”

— 2 Corinthians 5:17 (KJV)

And Jesus said:

“The prince of this world cometh, and hath nothing in me.”

— John 14:30 (KJV)

Four Keys To Maintaining Divine Preservation

1. Be Established In Righteousness

“In righteousness shalt thou be established...”

— Isaiah 54:14 (KJV)

This does not give room for careless living while expecting God’s righteousness to cover you. Be established in uprightness. Hate evil the way Job hated evil. Stand in righteousness.

“And who is he that will harm you, if ye be followers of that which is good?”

— 1 Peter 3:13 (KJV)

Let nobody be in doubt of your stand.

2. Refuse To Fear

“...Thou shalt not fear...”

— Isaiah 54:14 (KJV)

Refuse fear in every form. Resist every attempt of the enemy to plant fear in your heart.

Job 3:25 says:

“For the thing which I greatly feared is come upon me...”

Many things you hear are designed to put your life under pressure.

Refuse to fear.

3. Condemn Every Evil Voice

“...Every tongue that shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn.”

— Isaiah 54:17 (KJV)

Not the pastor. Not your prayer partner. You shall condemn. Every voice of confrontation, hostility, jealousy, accusation, litigation, and opposition rising against your destiny — silence it.

Release the voice of the Blood of Jesus against the adversary. If you dream and hear evil pronouncements against your life, wake up and condemn them.

God has made you a judge over the litigation situations of your life. When the voice is condemned, the speaker is doomed.

4. Understand Your Heritage Of Divine Preservation

Understand that you are not easily wasted. Understand your covenant heritage.

“Nevertheless man being in honour abideth not: he is like the beasts that perish.”

— Psalm 49:12 (KJV)

People are wasted when they do not understand what belongs to them in Christ.

“The man that wandereth out of the way of understanding shall remain in the congregation of the dead.”

— Proverbs 21:16 (KJV)

You are not a disposable life.

You are not easily destroyable.

Understand your heritage.

5. Be Committed To Service

“This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord...”

— Isaiah 54:17 (KJV)

Be committed to Kingdom service. Serve in soul-winning. Serve in the house of God. Serve with your resources. This inheritance is for servants — not merely churchgoers, benchwarmers, or casual attendees. Until your service is confirmed, your safety is not fully established from God’s side.

Seven Revelational Lights From Isaiah 54

1. The Only Conspiracy That Can Succeed Is The One Originated By God

If God did not organise it, it is inconsequential.

2. Their Rise Against You Is Their Crash

They rose only to fall.

3. God Did Not License Weapon Manufacturers Against You

The Creator did not create weapons for your destruction.

4. No Weapon Formed Against You Shall Prosper

The weapon formed against you is useless, powerless, and harmless.

5. Every Evil Voice Is Doomed For Condemnation

You have authority to silence and condemn every evil tongue.

6. Preservation Is The Heritage Of God's Servants

God's servants are shielded from conspiracies, weapons, and evil tongues.

7. God Defends You With His Own Righteousness

It is not your righteousness that speaks for you. It is His righteousness. And no devil can stand against it.

Call To Salvation And Rededication

Place your right hand on your chest and pray this prayer: “Lord Jesus, I surrender my life to You. Forgive me my sins. Tonight, I have decided to follow You.

No turning back. From today, I go forward ever and backward never. Come into my life, Lord. Make me a new person. I receive the grace to live for You.

In Jesus’ Name, amen.”

Prophetic Declarations

I declare today that the hold of the enemy over your life is broken in Jesus’ Name. By the power of the Blood of Jesus, the revelations you received tonight shall produce transformation, direction, and preservation in your life.

Every gang-up of hell against your destiny is rendered inconsequential. Every unrepentant agent of darkness rising against your life shall crash now in Jesus’ Name. Every weapon manufactured against you backfires to sender!

Every voice of accusation, confrontation, litigation, slander, limitation, opposition, and hostility speaking against your destiny is silenced by the Blood of Jesus. Every altar from your father’s house, mother’s house, or ancestral foundation fighting your destiny is nullified by the Blood of Jesus.

Every spirit of backwardness is cancelled. Your giftings are released. Your preservation is confirmed. In the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost.

Amen.

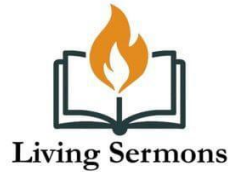
