Very quickly this morning, the subject is an impartation.

Before we go, I felt directed and led to, one more time, show us the clip of the documentary as we get into an impartation this morning.

Occupy Till I Come

The message this morning is **“Occupy Till I Come.”** This will be part six:

The Way of the Eagle.

Occupy till I come—the way of the eagle.

Our objective is to understand what makes the eagle the king of the air.

What makes the eagle occupy the air, to take charge of the air, to be the king of all that fly?

And it's important for us to know because the Bible likens us to the eagle.

They that wait on the Lord, they are like the eagles.

Concerning the children of Israel coming out of the land of Egypt, God likened them again to the eagle. He likened Himself to the eagle, as the eagle fluttereth over her young and stirreth the nest.

So, if God is Mother Eagle and we are eagles, then it is important for us to understand the way of the eagle.

What makes the eagle the eagle?

The Psalmist said at one point that there are three things that are too wonderful for him to understand. That is Solomon in Proverbs chapter 30 and verse 19.

And he said the first among these is **the way of the eagle in the air.**

What makes the eagle?

So, understanding the eagle will make us understand the wonders of the eagle. It will also make us understand how to function, how to live, and how to operate in order to dominate our realms.

Somebody say a loud amen.

Somebody shout the loudest amen.

Strange Strength

Without any doubt, the eagle is king in the sky.

I have watched the eagle with aggression. I have watched the eagle with mastery in the sky.

I have watched the eagle deal brutally with snakes and serpents. I've watched the eagle deal with hyenas.

I saw one day in a clip where an eagle came after a hyena, landed on its back, and began to eat it alive.

I've seen it pull out intestines. I've seen the audacity of the eagle.

The question is, **what makes the eagle the eagle?**

If you are a pastor or a minister of God here, and you are going to dominate your realm, your realm of influence, and you are going to take charge, what makes the eagle?

The eagle, number one, is **strange strength**.

There is a strange dimension of strength.

The Bible says the eagle dwelleth on the crag of the rock.

Isaiah 40:31:

“But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength, and mount up with wings as eagles.”

There is strange strength.

The eagle is said to have very large claws with which it attacks prey and punctures its prey.

It has powerful muscles, muscles of the leg and the feet, with which it maintains a very strong grip and carries weights that are three times its size, flying great distances.

Strength.

Are you trusting God to dominate your territory? Are you trusting God to occupy your domain of influence?

You can't do it in weakness.

The people that do know their God, they shall be strong and do exploits.

Exploits don't belong to the weak. Exploits don't belong to the timid. Exploits don't belong to the frail.

Exploits belong to the strong.

Many of us are too weak for territorial principalities. We are too weak for ancestral powers.

We are too weak for enemy confrontations in the lands where we are.

The way of the eagle is the way of **strange strength**.

If you are going to live here today, I will ask you to go and build strength.

Go and build strength.

Build strength at the place of waiting on the Lord.

Build strength at the place of feasting on light.

“Say, I have written unto you, young men, because ye are strong.”

And why are you strong?

The Word of God dwelleth in you. The Word of God dwelleth in you.

The Word of God dwelleth in you because you are strong, and the Word of God abideth in you.

I am not talking of the Word you take to preach. I am talking about the Word you feast on, you feed on, that builds in you strange strength.

Samson was a man of very strange strength until they asked themselves, **“Wherein lieth the strength of this man?”**

And with that strength, he was able to dominate the land of the Philistines. He plundered the nation by strength.

Sharp Sight

Strange strength, number two, is **sharp sight**.

Sharp sight.

The Bible says from the crag of the rock the eagle beholdeth his prey. From that strong place, she seeketh the prey, and her eyes behold afar off.

“From thence she seeketh the prey, and her eyes behold afar off.”

Her eyes behold afar off.

The eagle can detect prey from long distances. Its eyes are large, with a high density of light-sensitive cells. I read some time ago that the pigment cells on the retina of the eagle's eye are about eight times more concentrated than that of the human eye.

So, the eagle has a range of vision. He can see wide, look like this and see very, very wide around, and he also has distance of vision—sharpness of sight.

It is said that the eagle's eye is so sharp that he can detect ultraviolet light in certain cases, to be able to detect certain traces about some prey.

How Far Can You See?

How far can you see?

There are pastors and ministers who don't see beyond today.

There are people who don't see beyond what to eat.

There are people who don't see beyond what to wear.

There are people who don't see. They lack the capacity to see far.

And until you see far, you can't go far.

The Bible says:

“Write the vision, and make it plain upon tables, that he may run that readeth it.”

It is vision that makes runners.

Vision is key to motion. Vision is key to acceleration.

Show me a man of vision, and I will show you a man in motion.

Show me a man of vision, and I will show you a man with high acceleration.

The vision of a man is directly proportional to his acceleration.

The vision of a man is directly proportional to his motion.

How can you talk about 43 crusades by this time of the year in one year?

What is the reason for such a speed?

There is such sharp and very deliberate vision of what must be by this kind of time.

Hallelujah.

Forty-one all through last year and this year already. And there are meetings we have not counted. There are meetings that we have not included in this. In-between meetings we have not included in this.

Are you hearing what I'm saying here today?

If the only prayer you are going to pray today is, “**Lord, touch my eyes,**” then pray it.

The way we have shortsightedness in the physical, there are people who are spiritually shortsighted, and there are those who are actually spiritually blinded.

They see in the physical, but they can't see in the spirit.

A Man of Vision Is a Man of Focus

I was talking to a pastor yesterday.

He has invitation. He has invitation there. He has a church.

He sent me a picture the other day where he had a meeting in a particular church—miracles, signs, and wonders. And I said to him, “Very, very strange.”

I said to him, “**What you have shown me is accurate, is good, but I want your first vision to be your home base.**”

This miracles and things you have shown there, what that dwells in Kapano, do out here. There is a focused dimension of vision. **A man of vision is a man of focus.**

He doesn't scatter his punches. It's a man of focus. So, I told him, I said, “I like you to function where your base is until there is such an undeniable explosion, until you have shifted to this level.”

Then you have the authority to take what you have seen at home to the world.

From Jerusalem to the Uttermost

Part

“You shall be witnesses of Me in Samaria.”

Is that what He said?

“You shall be witnesses of Me in Judea.”

Is that what He said?

“You shall be witnesses of Me in the uttermost part of the world.”

Where is He starting from?

You shall be witnesses of Me first.

Conquer Jerusalem. Dominate Jerusalem. Overwhelm Jerusalem. Overrun Jerusalem.

Then you go to Judea. Overrun Judea.

Then you go to Samaria. Overrun Samaria.

Then you go to the uttermost part of the world.

So that when they see you at the uttermost part of the world, nobody will say, “Where is he coming from?”

So that if they reach back to Jerusalem, people of Jerusalem will say, “We know him.”

He conquered and dominated the demons here.

Am I communicating at all?

Is the prayer you are going to pray, **“Lord, touch my eyes. Lord, touch my eyes.”**

Vision Does Not Happen by Chance

When we were in Area One Church before we moved here, I already did the time schedule for seven services on Sunday morning.

We did six services on Sunday morning before we moved here.

Six services started by 6:00 a.m.

We did the six powerful, impactful services with overflows before we stepped up.

Actually, we did first service, second service, third service, and then we jumped from three to five services by divine instruction.

Then from five to six services every Sunday morning for the sake of the crowd.

And then I had scheduled first service, second service, third service, fourth service, fifth service, sixth service, seventh service schedule before we moved here.

Many people want things to happen by chance.

It doesn't work by chance.

It happens by **vision**.

The things that happen by chance disappear by chance.

What happens by vision has a destination.

Are you hearing what I'm saying here today?

If it manifested by accident, it disappears by accident.

If it happens deliberately by vision, it will have a destination.

Next year, I'm sure, I think, is concluded. We are talking of the other year right now, probably another year and other years.

There are things on our mind for the next seven years. If you don't know where you are going, you may not like where you will end. If you don't know what you are looking for, you will not recognize it when you find it.

It's very, very important.

Open My Eyes, Lord

The way of the eagle is the way of sharpness of sight. Sharpness of sight.

“Open my eyes, Lord, and let me see.”

Open my eyes, Lord, and let me see.

Clean my eyes with eyes.

There are things I am not seeing.

Let me see Your burden for this hour. Let me see Your concern for my own life. Let me see the things You want me to see right now.

Open my eyes that I may see.

Let me see.

Let me see You.

Because when Elijah saw—when Isaiah saw God, then he saw himself. Then he saw the world.

He saw God.

The year that King Uzziah died, he saw the Lord. And after seeing the Lord, he now saw himself:

“Woe is me! for I am undone.”

After seeing himself, he saw the world:

“Whom shall I send, and who will go for us?”

Many of us can't see anything clearly because we haven't seen God yet.

So, let our vision start with the vision of the Lord.

Show me who You are.

No wonder Moses cried and said:

“I beseech thee, shew me thy glory.”

No wonder Paul the apostle said:

“That I may know him, and the power of his resurrection, and the fellowship of his sufferings.”

When people see God, they see themselves—good or bad.

When you see God, you see the things in your life that need to be adjusted. You see the errors that need to be cleansed.

And when you see God, you see the things you carry that you are not aware of.

When Moses saw God, he saw the rod.

He became aware that he had a rod. He had something in his hand, and he did not know the implication of the rod.

What was in his hand was the deliverance of a nation, and he used it to tend flock—potential buried in spiritual blindness.

But he saw God. Then he saw himself.

Then he saw the gift in his hand.

Then he realized that this thing can part the Red Sea. This thing can bring water out of the rock. This thing can deliver a whole nation.

Hallelujah.

And while we trust God for this impartation this morning, somebody will be trusting the Lord for strange strength.

Somebody will be trusting the Lord for sharp sight.

And thirdly, **swift speed**.

Swift Speed

One thing we know about the eagle is swiftness of speed.

Deuteronomy chapter 28 and verse 49:

“The LORD shall bring a nation against thee from far, from the end of the earth, as swift as the eagle flieth.”

Swift speed.

Job 9:26:

“They are passed away as the swift ships: as the eagle that hasteth to the prey.”

Swift speed.

Habakkuk chapter 1 and verse 8, the Bible talked about the eagle. The last part said:

“And they shall fly as the eagle that hasteth to eat.”

And then, talking about Jonathan and Saul, David said in 2 Samuel chapter 1, verse 23:

“Saul and Jonathan were lovely and pleasant in their lives, and in their death they were not divided: they were swifter than eagles, they were stronger than lions.”

Eagle is recognized as a bird of speed.

Speed.

Destiny cannot be fulfilled without urgency.

Urgency.

You cannot rule and reign in your domain without a sense of urgency.

Urgency is a determinant of destiny.

Urgency is key to impact.

Urgency is key to dominion.

Many of us are too relaxed to make a mark.

Too relaxed.

No wonder the Bible says:

“Woe to them that are at ease in Zion.”

Woe to them that are at ease in Zion.

Woe to them that are slack in Zion.

“I am taking my time. I am taking my time.”

When God is moving, I'm moving. I'm moving. That taking of time has stolen so many people's destiny. Sometimes this “I am taking my time” is not a matter of waiting for instruction, but it's a matter of laziness of spirit, slackness of life.

Are you hearing what I'm saying here today?

Don't push things into tomorrow. Don't push the things that need to be done today into tomorrow. There are so many destinies, so many visions that have been buried in the graveyard of tomorrow.

Today was that tomorrow you talked about yesterday. Tomorrow will soon become today. So, the most important day of your life is **today**.

It is called the present.

Present means gift.

Your present, your moment, is a gift that you use to fulfil life's assignment.

He said:

“Redeeming the time, because the days are evil.”

Redeeming the time means buy back the time.

Do your best so you don't run into people—you are still running into people.

Hallelujah.

Amen.

Exchange Time for Meaningful Action

Let the passage of time be exchanged with meaningful action.

The passage of time, let it be exchangeable with meaningful, impactful action—memorable action.

Be able to account for the impactful things you did with yesterday.

Be able to account for the impactful things you are doing with today.

The wastage of today—

The wastage of time is the mother of regrets.

Anytime you see a person regretting too much, so much time was wasted.

What happened when Esau tried?

His father said, “Go and bring me venison.”

Jacob went and came back quickly. Esau went to the bush.

That is a story for another day.

Esau was going to look for meat that was already in the house.

He wasted his time and wasted his life.

When he came, the blessing was already gone. The Bible said he sought it carefully with tears, and he regretted, but it was never done. It was never released because **time wasters are life wasters.**

They are destiny wasters. You waste time, you waste life. You waste time, you waste destiny.

Time Is the Measure of Life

When you want to measure weight in our part of the world, you measure in grams and kilograms. When you want to measure volume, you measure in metres. When you want to measure height, you measure in feet or in metres.

When you want to measure life, you measure with time.

You measure with time.

When they say a person is 50 years old, it means that is the measure of his lifetime. When a person dies and they put 1946 to 2026, that dash is a compression of his life. Everything is compressed in that dash.

That is 80 years.

Those 80 years measured his life. The impact created within those 80 years is the outcome of that time spent.

So, any day time is wasting, that is life that is wasting.

Do Not Waste Your Time

Somebody says, "I sent you a message and you did not reply."

"I didn't have the time for the reply."

It is not an emergency. It is not a priority.

Don't put my life under pressure. I have so many things to do with life.

I cannot become a telephone operator because of GSM.

Some of us, if we are to answer all text messages, all WhatsApp messages, all emails, there is nothing else to do with life.

You will have nothing else to do with your life.

I have over 2,000, 3,000 unreplied messages right now.

And some get angry as if they own your time, with an entitlement mentality.

Not only are you not permitted to waste your time, **don't permit time wasters in your life.**

Don't permit time wasters in your life.

The wastage of your time is the wastage of your life.

If you will not waste your time, don't allow anyone to help you waste it.

I Am Faster Than Hurry

One day, John Wesley was talking with someone and he said, “Ah, you have taken ten minutes of my time for life.”

And the man said, “John, don't be in a hurry.”

He said, “Hurry? I don't have the time to be in a hurry. I am faster than hurry.”

That implied, “I don't even have time to be in a hurry.”

That's the man that woke up by 4:00 a.m. every morning.

Study for one hour, go on with another one hour, preaching in circuit, and then the schedule is maintained like that from 4:00 a.m. to 10:00 at night for 60 years.

Volumes he wrote. Forty thousand messages and sermons he preached impacted and shook the world.

At the time of his death, almost three or four hundred years ago, over 73,000 people were under his discipleship.

At the time he died, hundreds of years ago, 70-something thousand people were under his discipleship.

This is a modern day with more population.

How many lives is your life touching?

Are you hearing what I'm saying here today?

Somebody needs to wake up today.

You are dragging your feet too much.

You are beating your chest, doing clapping.

People are clapping for you in smallness.

Whatever you have conquered, there is more to conquer.

And there is no end of impact until we see Him face to face.

The Bible said it's when we see Him that we shall be as He is.

Somebody say amen.

Somebody shout the loudest amen.

Somebody, shout as a believer, amen.

Run With Speed

In the name of Jesus, anything that has arrested your speed, anything that is a cause of slackness, a cause of sluggishness, a cause of delay in your life, everything that is making your life to run slow and your destiny to run slow, I declare it broken right now in the name of Jesus.

Whatever is holding you down, the chain is broken.

Somebody, get ready to run with the speed of a twister and a tornado right now, in the name of Jesus.

Give the Lord a praise and take your seat.

The eagle is **swift speed**.

Scaling of Heights

Number four, it is **scaling of heights**.

Scaling of heights.

The Bible said the eagle's nest is in the crag of the rock. We read that in Job 39:27–29.

“She dwelleth and abideth on the rock, upon the crag of the rock, and the strong place.”

Next verse:

“From thence she seeketh the prey, and her eyes behold afar off.”

In Jeremiah chapter 49:16, God was speaking a curse to some people, but He used the eagle.

He said:

**“Thy terribleness hath deceived thee, and the pride of thine heart,
O thou that dwellest in the clefts of the rock, that holdest the
height of the hill: though thou shouldest make thy nest as high as
the eagle, I will bring thee down from thence, saith the LORD.”**

So, the eagle has a nest that is very, very high.

You know, Obadiah 1:4—I think we read it earlier on. He said:

**“Though thou exalt thyself as the eagle, and though thou set thy
nest among the stars, thence will I bring thee down, saith the
LORD.”**

He was talking to the rebellious, but we are learning from the first part of it.

Thou set thy nest among the stars.

And then in Proverbs chapter 23:5, he said:

**“Wilt thou set thine eyes upon that which is not? for riches
certainly make themselves wings; they fly away as an eagle toward
heaven.”**

If you are going to dominate, you must be addicted to height—**spiritual height.**

He told John the beloved:

“Come up hither.”

I'm Going Higher

To take addiction to height means allergy to the earthly, reaction against the mundane. Allergy to the earthly, reaction against the mundane, the ordinary, the earthly places, the low places, the ordinary, normal, average kind of living and existence is not your realm.

How do you know that you have escaped the earthly realm?

1. You Begin to See as God Sees

You see from the perspective of God. You see far. You see high. You see broad.

You begin to see from the perspective of God. You see as dawn is seen because from there you see far, you see wide, you see broad.

2. You Are Beyond the Reach of Harm

How do you know that you are higher?

Secondly, you are beyond the reach of harm.

He said, "He shall dwell on high; his place of defence shall be the munitions of rocks: bread shall be given him; his waters shall be sure."

When you dwell on high and not low places, you can dare the unbearable.

Where normal people are afraid to go, you go. You dare the undareable. You confront the unfrontable. You challenge the unchallengeable because you dwell on high.

Your place of defence is the munitions of rocks. Your waters are sure.

How do you know that you are dwelling on high? You have escaped the earthly realm.

3. You Operate in Unquestionable Authority

The eagle, you know, the safest way to fight and win apart from ground fight is fighting from the air.

Air power. Air power. Sky power.

Terrorists can engage soldiers one-on-one on the foot, but when they move high, even drones from the sky or fighter jets from above, killing the land, there is a realm where the anti-aircraft rifle cannot reach.

Are you hearing what I'm saying here today?

When you are dwelling in the earthly realms, you are beset with all manner of fears. You are beset with all manner of resistances. When we laugh, did you hear that they place a roadblock before an aircraft? It's in a realm where roadblock does not exist. Is God speaking to someone here tonight?

I'd like you to move higher. Ask God, "Escape me, escape this realm. I want to take charge of my domain, and I want to function from the top, not from the ground."

I want to function from the top, not from the ground. I want to speak to forces of darkness from above them, not from their realm. And when we begin to pray this morning, you're going to ask God, and He's going to do it.

4. You Begin to See Everything as Small

And how many of you know that? How do you know? Let me do one more.

How do you know that you have escaped the earthly realm?

What number is that?

How do you know that you have escaped the earthly realm?

You begin to see everything as very small in size, minute, big things now look small.

When you fly in the air and you see this Glory Dome, when you are very high up, it looks like the cover of a pencil or something.

When you are up there, cars look like matchboxes. Bicycles look like matchsticks.

Things are looking big to you because of where you are.

Things are looking big to you because of where you are.

Very, very soon, during the construction of this Glory Dome here, they will bring bills.

This is like eleven years ago. Construction started in January. At that time, one hundred million, one hundred and twenty million.

This wall at the back of the altar here, from one end to the other, is about 274 metres. A football field is 90 metres. So you can do your mathematics.

We were casting concrete that if they dropped you inside it, it could swallow you up, with wire net, a little segment of it like this.

We got a company that is a concrete manufacturing company. So they measure it for you and sell it in metres. That was a company we called; they sell it in metres.

A little, I don't know whether it was five or six metres of it that they fed with concrete, and their meter read 33 million.

It hasn't left that end. That end where that man is, is now in a white dress. Just a little bit. 33 million.

And it's pay as you go.

It's not today. 33 million today is big money. But I'm talking of when the exchange rate was 190.

So I said, "Let's—we need to buy our own concrete machine then and start manufacturing the concrete."

Still, the money was massive, but they would bring very big bills.

I said, “Go ahead, go ahead. That’s all right. Go ahead.”

Nobody can ask, “Where is the money coming from?” Go ahead.

We were spending monthly what is more than one year’s income of the church monthly.

Then how was it? Where was it coming from?

That is the monthly construction bill. The offering, everything of one year, count it—it is not up to it.

That is extra, extra offering income.

We were seeing from up, so it looks small.

We were seeing from up. They gave me yesterday’s bill from Fiji Island and Vanuatu and all that—their crusade budget bill.

I looked at it. Done.

You are going to go there, distribute welfare, you take no offering. Things are looking big because of where we are seeing from.

If you see from the earth, it is big.

If you see from the roof, it is still very big.

But if you see from on high, if you are seeing from on high, the calling of God on your life is possible.

If you are seeing from on high, what God said you should do with your life is possible. What God said you should do in the Kingdom is possible.

And I speak to someone here right now in the name of Jesus: everything that limited you so far, I declare the limitation is over!

Look at somebody by your side. Say, “It’s possible. It’s possible. It’s possible. It’s possible. It’s possible. It’s possible. It’s possible. It’s possible.”

Look at your neighbour. Say, “Begin to see from on high.”

Begin to see from on high. It is possible.

Take your seat and pray to the Lord.

At times, even the normal schedule, when you calculate it, is unthinkable.

How do you get this done and that done and that done and that done and this done?

5. Soaring Ability

Scaling of height.

Number five, eagle quality that makes it to dominate.

Number one was strength. Number two was sharp sight. Number three was swift speed. Number four was the scaling of heights. Number five is soaring ability.

Ability to soar.

The eagle soars. It mounts up with wings.

In Job 39:27, it said, “Doth the eagle mount up at thy command? and make her nest on high?”

Isaiah 40:31 said, “They shall mount up with wings as eagles.”

What does it mean to soar?

What does it mean to mount up with wings?

I’m going to be very fast because we need to pray and break before the evening time.

All birds fly like this. Before they go very far, their shoulder is paining them. They have to look for where to perch. They have to look for where to rest. They have to look for where to settle.

They rest a bit. Then they start again.

That is every bird with the exception of the eagle.

The eagle soars. It mounts up with wings.

Look at it. It waits for the wind, and then when the right wind comes, it stretches out its wings, and this can take it miles, and this can take it kilometres, and this can take it distances.

Brothers and sisters, the eagle rides the wind to rule the sky.

Ride the wind to rule the sky.

Ride the wind and rule. Ride the wind and rule. Ride the wind.

Ride the wind. Ride the wind.

Many of us, we have wearied our lives out. We have tired ourselves out because of the deployment of normal, natural energy. We tired our lives out.

I don't need to tell any Bible student here what the wind is. There came the sound of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the house.

The Holy Ghost, the Holy Spirit, is the One to ride.

Hallelujah.

Am I communicating at all?

It is the Holy Spirit that makes difficult work easy.

It is the Holy Spirit that makes it look like you didn't walk.

Can you imagine someone when I flew—I went to Nicaragua, to their country. We didn't have the time to go to the hotel to change or dress or do anything because of the distance from the airport. By the time we would go to the hotel before coming to the church, the service had already started.

So we went from the aircraft, after, is it 15 or 16 hours' flight, we went straight to the meeting.

They said that they thought I was going to minister for maybe 20, 30 minutes and then go and rest, whereas the preaching of the Word was not less than one hour.

Full download, then ministrations, healings, testimonies, miracles before the next day.

And then you finish and straight from the meeting into the aircraft and fly down home and come straight to the altar.

One of our people told me, he said, "What challenges them the most is how you come back home, come straight, come to the altar and preach a message that looks like you have been preparing for one week."

Fresh Word. Impactful Word.

That you're going around the world did not distract your ministry at home.

This, and we came in for five hours' service on Sunday.

That is, you went here, you went there, you impact here, impact there, return back home.

There is no diminution in the impact, no reduction in energy, no reduction in voice, no reduction in the intensity of the anointing.

It is humanly impossible. It is humanly impossible. It is humanly impossible.

It is being carried by the wind.

But can I say something before I go ahead?

Do you want to soar?

You must drop your weight.

The wind will not carry stone. The wind will not carry metal.

Drop your weight. Drop your weight.

You want to soar on the wind. You want to mount up with wings as the eagle. You want to fly. You want to be carryable.

Drop your weight.

Therefore, let us lay aside every sin that besets us and every weight, and run with patience.

The rest, you must drop.

The question you are going to ask God is, “Oh Lord, what is it that is preventing me from being carried? What is the weight in my life, in my ministry?”

Some of us, we talk too much, and in the course of too much talk, we lie inside.

Are you hearing what I’m saying here today?

Some of us, we are not financially straight. Our financial life is crooked.

Some of us, we have a lot of crookedness in other areas.

There is so much weight in our lives. We carry so much weight, and so we are not able to be—we are not flexible. We are not carryable.

When the wind carries you, you reserve your energy.

I told you my schedule this month. This same month, we went to Czech Republic, finished from Czech Republic, went to the United States of America, open-air crusade in Maryland, returned back home.

In the week we returned, before we went to Youth Convention, I preached every day to the youth, Monday to Friday. Every single day, hours every day, Monday to Friday.

I think there is a level you reach in ministry where you are such a big man that it is only the small boys that should preach to youth.

“Let the youth pastor preach to the youth.”

“Let’s invite a young pastor to preach to the youth, like Mike or anybody. Preach to the youth. We are big men. We have overgrown youth.”

Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday.

Friday was Night Vision. We left around 4:00 a.m., ministering to youth.

A Night Vision before the UK. We came into, I think that was Home Church Congress or something, and then American Conference, and then crusade, crusade in Maryland.

You saw the clip and then returned back from America, preached to the youth.

The week after that, Children’s Conference. Children from age two or three.

Yes, that’s Maryland Crusade. It’s all right.

Children from age two or three. Their conference there are about 20,000 children. You can show us the clip if you have.

I preached to them at least around one and a half hours, talking to toddlers, talking to children, interactive.

“What did I just say? Repeat the three things I just said.”

That’s children.

Hallelujah.

Fed them for three days.

Calculate the bill of 20,000 times three days, a meal. Children's meal.

How many of you know that there are children's church teachers? There are about 2,000 of their teachers who are with them.

And yet, we had to come and preach to children.

This is this August.

And then that finishes, we enter this conference, including Sunday services.

How is that possible?

One-on-one ministry.

It's not possible humanly speaking.

I speak to anyone: whatever is tiring you out, whatever is the reason for your weariness, I declare it is over!

Anything that is a reason for weariness, a reason for exhaustion, whatever is tiring you, wearing you out, I declare today it expires forever!

If you are saying amen, shout the loudest amen.

You will not be tired before time. You will not be weary before time. Lack of result will not tire you out.

Lack of results will not tire you out. Lack of results will not weary you out.

If you are saying amen, say a louder amen.

Take your seat in the presence of the Lord.

You want to be carried. You must drop your weights.

“Lord, show me my weights.”

Those things that are making it difficult for You to carry me, to carry my weight.

Show me.

You want to be carried by the wind.

That will lead us to number six.

Character of the eagle.

Was it number six?

6. Sharp Sensitivity

And number six is sharp sensitivity.

Sharp.

We must be sharp spiritually and sharp in sensitivity, being able to pick up divine signals.

It is said that the eagle has thermo-receptors under his wings, his body.

It stays on the rock waiting for the right current of the wind.

Normally, the rising up of warm wind current, that has force. It waits for that current, and the body—the thermo-sensor—senses that the right current is here.

Then he stretches out his wing and lands on that current.

It is precision.

He takes it straight to where it is going.

“As many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.”

It is not possible to have authority without sensitivity.

Otherwise, the devil messes up your destiny.

It is not possible to rule without sensitivity.

The Bible says the sons of Issachar, they had understanding of the times, to know what Israel ought to do; and their brethren were at their commandment.

Your dominion is rooted in your discernment.

Your dominion is rooted in your discernment.

The other day, I told my wife, I told her what we are doing now. We are, by God's grace, God has helped us to be doing this thing at the right time.

Yes. Yes, sir. Yes, sir.

We couldn't have been doing this when the church was being built, when the foundation of ministry was being built, when the root of ministry was being built, when the stature of ministry was being built.

We couldn't have.

We couldn't have been doing this when church planting was to start and start aggressively. We couldn't have been doing this.

We couldn't have been doing this during the construction of the Glory Dome or before construction.

Though we already were doing crusades and doing a couple of things, the various things had their timings and their phases.

When the time for this came, we moved.

When it was time for the Glory Dome construction, we started looking for land restlessly.

And I knew it was time for us to move from Area One. Six services, everywhere overflowed.

Counted 50,000 people on a Sunday, one of our last Sundays.

And then we invited Papa one time after it was—and then every Night Vision, I had to use my faith: one faith to prevent rain, another faith for people to be impacted, because people are sitting on the road everywhere.

And the Night Vision is the last Friday of every month.

So during rainy season, if the cloud is gathering, your heart is agitated:

“Lord, may it not rain.”

So I wanted to be free from such. I wanted the faith to be one: impact the people.

And I knew it was time to move from there.

Even when we went to the National Stadium in 2007 for All Night 2007—that’s 19 years ago—even there, the rain fell through the middle.

In August, we did three night vigils: the last Friday of August, last Friday of September. The rain fell.

Went to the old parade ground, last Friday of October. Rain still fell.

Then I was agitated.

Then Papa came and said, “You have overgrown this place. Don’t be sentimental about any location. Don’t have any unusual attachment to any particular location.”

I said, “Yes, sir.”

And God had been speaking:

“Lord, what do we do? We need the land.”

And then He spoke. He said, “Remember what I showed you on the Airport Road.”

I remember.

But we have gone to the Airport Road looking for land. They said there’s—I mean, we have gone, we have tried our best.

He said, “Remember what I showed you on the Airport Road.”

And He showed me this land on the Airport Road with a landmark. It’s like, if you see this, the land...

So I called our property agent here, anointed him with oil.

I said, “Go to the Airport Road between this place and this place. Our land is on the right on your way to the—locate it and come.”

He returned back in seven days.

He said, “I have found the place. There’s plenty land there, and they can sell for us as much as we can buy.”

I said, “Okay, let’s go.”

So we came, went inside, went here.

I said, “This is the place. How much is it?”

They told us the price, and the journey started, and we moved at that time.

Papa broke the ground, and then construction started. Dedication happened, and the journey continued.

If we didn’t discern when to start this construction and we are thinking of starting now...

If this roof was how many million in foreign currency then—which, what it was then, I won't mention the price now—and the exchange rate has multiplied almost nine times.

190 then is 1,400 and something now, right? That's almost eight to nine times.

So multiply the amount of all building cost by eight.

Wow!

Today, Jehovah helped us. We escaped it.

Sensitivity to Timing

Sensitivity.

Sensitivity to know when to start the next service. When to move out on the crusade. When to start this kind of outreach.

Sensitivity to know when to do this and when to do that.

He makes all things beautiful in His time.

If it is not time, it will be ugly.

Whether you went ahead of time or you went after Him, it cannot be beautiful outside of time.

Outside timing, everything becomes ugly.

Regular education is beautiful. Adult education can be difficult.

Sharpness—that is what makes you to soar as well.

You know when the Holy Ghost is moving and you move. When He is moving and you dive, then everything, you begin to look to people like you're a magician.

You're only following divine signals.

You are following divine signals that are making things to fall in place.

I decree today, in the name of Jesus, in the name of Jesus, in the name of Jesus, in the name of Jesus, in the name of Jesus:

Grace to hear clearly, receive now!

At the early stage of the church, please sit down.

Members from Nyanya-Maraba area, they said the distance to our church is far for them.

“Can we come and plant a branch for them in Nyanya?”

I didn’t pray about it. All I knew was that our members wanted a branch.

So we went and planted a branch and sent a pastor there.

One week, two weeks, three weeks, four weeks, five weeks.

The Lord showed me that I was on my own.

That branching, I went on my own.

He did not ask me to go for any branching.

So I asked the pastor. I said, “The Lord said we should close the branch.”

His face changed because he’s already a boss.

And you want to move him back to come and sit down and lead opening prayer and take testimony.

He’s already a boss. His eye changed.

I said, “It’s not time. God didn’t send us.”

He says, “So what shall we do?”

I said, “Close the church.”

“What about the chairs and the equipment?”

And I said, “Look for any good church there. Give them all the chairs and give them all the equipment.”

“What of those who will not agree to return back?”

They should find any church nearby.

That was how the church was closed.

And we returned back because we went when we were not sent.

Not that there were no people there, but we were not sent, and it was not time.

You know there are miracles—they even have timing.

Manifestations have their time.

Do you remember the man at the Beautiful Gate?

That was the temple Jesus passed to say, “Do you see this beautiful temple? Break it down in three days, I’ll build it.”

He entered the temple plenty times, met the man there, left him.

He met the man at the Beautiful Gate. He passed.

He healed other lepers, healed other cripples, healed other blind people.

He went, he saw the man, passed.

He told the disciples, “Your own time is always here. My time has not come.”

Every time is time.

He left the man, and somebody said, “Master, if you are to ask Him, why did You heal everybody? Why are You leaving this man?”

He said, “The answer is one: it is not time.”

it is not me. The time for his healing is not now. The person that will heal him is not me.

When the time came and the person showed up, who was his name?

Peter and John showed up.

“Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee. In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk.”

And he rose up on the spot.

The time came. The man came. It was easy.

Don’t kill yourself.

It’s not everybody God will use you to deliver. Don’t behave like a messiah. It’s not everybody God will use you to deliver. People will look at you and make you feel like you are the messiah. You will kill yourself for nothing.

There are some people whose deliverance, miracle, and testimony are in another person’s hand. There are those—whoever God sends your way under your spiritual coverage and oversight, you have responsibility over them.

You have responsibility over them, and you have spiritual endowment for their needs. That was why God sent them your way.

But when you are going about everywhere like Superman, you will waste your life.

We must be very sensitive.

Don't Waste Your Spiritual Assignment

One day, a man was coming to the altar in Area One. In those days, I used to shake hands with people. Newcomers would come out, and I would shake hands with them and welcome them to church.

So, a man was coming on the altar like this.

And the normal me, when I see a person walking with a bad leg like that, I would say, "Receive! Be healed!" And then maybe he comes on that power and stands up healed. "Move your leg."

But as he was coming, the Holy Spirit told me, "Nothing is wrong with him."

So he walked like that, expecting me to lay hands on him. I shook hands with everybody and avoided him.

He passed.

When I said they should go, he walked normally.

After he saw that his drama did not work, I don't know who sent him. Maybe they sent him to go and show that all those miracles are fake, that nothing is happening.

When he saw that it didn't work, mission aborted.

Are you hearing what I'm saying here today?

Don't kill yourself.

I was struggling with one man one day on a wheelchair.

"Be healed. Rise and walk."

He was resisting me.

So I looked at him and said, "What do you need? Actually, what do you really need?"

He said, “I need some money.”

In other words, don’t waste your time. “I don’t want to be healed. It is money I’m looking for right now.”

I’m comfortable because we just try hard. We just do everything that enters our hand, every invitation they give you.

Not Every Open Door Is God’s Door

One day, I was invited somewhere. Reverend Sam Sham, I was invited somewhere.

The moment I wanted to preach, heaven was completely closed. Completely.

I struggled.

Everything was closed and dry.

And many of us pastors, we have dried the oil on our lives by stepping on all kinds of altars—all kinds of altars because of lack of sensitivity.

When I saw everything was so dry, I said, “Lord, what is happening here?”

He told me, “Who sent you here?”

Wow.

“Who sent me here?”

This is a respectable person that I used to hear of. Who sent you here?

I said, “Lord, I’m sorry if I came here by myself. Please forgive me.”

Just that kind of quiet prayer. Silent.

“I’m really sorry.”

Then I worshipped, and as I worshipped, the heavens opened, and I preached with power.

And when I finished, I finished in a hurry and ran like a dog with its tail between its legs.

My wife was with me. I got to the hotel.

We knelt down.

“Thank the Lord.”

They said there is a morning session.

I said, “I’m not sure.”

And then they now said, “So we have the invitation for next year.”

I said, “No, not yet.”

“So when shall we send?”

I said, “I will let you know later if there is a need.”

That was how I ran for my life because I thought any door that is open is a door.

I thought that I’m a pastor and a preacher, so I could go even to places that God has already closed.

You know, the glory is departed. Many times we don’t see it, but it is there in the realm of the spirit.

I heard from Benhin. He said he wanted to pray for a man. This man was crying, with tears, a big cross on his neck like a minister’s conference.

He wanted to lay hands on him, and God said, “Don’t touch him.”

He said, “He has never heard of a thing like that.”

Why?

“I have rejected him.”

Don't waste your impartation.

Don't waste your laying on of hands.

“I am through with him.”

Those are the kind of people that God has given diverse warnings and all manner, and they just are on their way.

“I'm through with him.”

Sensitivity is a strength of the eagle.

One of the things we're going to be praying is:

“Lord, don't let me enter any trap that looks like a door.”

Did you hear what I just said?

“Father, don't allow me to enter any trap that looks like a door. Don't let me enter any trap that looks like a door. Don't let me take a journey that is not meant to be. Don't let me embark on a journey that was not meant to be.”

You have learned, but you have lost so much.

Father, don’t let me enter any trap that appears like a door.

Which of the kings was about to die?

Jehoshaphat, when he accompanied Ahab to battle.

And the Syrians looked at him and said, “Behold the king of Israel!”

And they shot, and they wanted to kill him. They surrounded him.

And he cried out, "I am not the king of Israel."

And then God moved them from him.

Ahab deceived him.

He said, "You wear your kingly garment. Me, I will just appear normal."

You will not die anybody's death.

Help me with sensitivity.

The sensitivity of the eagle that will help me to take charge.

7. Strategic Operation

Finally, character of the eagle: strategic operation.

The eagle is strategic.

It does what we call precision strikes.

Strategic operation. Calculative manoeuvres. Very calculative.

From there, he watches his prey and then moves.

Nobody is successful in life and destiny until they are strategic.

God is a strategist.

Master Strategist.

When He was creating the earth, the earth was without form and void, and darkness was upon the face of the deep.

The first thing He did was not to bring the earth out.

No. Everything was dark.

First thing to do: turn on the light.

“Let there be light.”

Light is on.

“Let’s look very well.”

Okay. This is earth and water together. That’s not correct.

Earth, move here. Water, move here.

Sky and earth together. Not correct.

Sky, move up. This remains.

Water, bring forth. Earth, bring forth. Sky, bring forth.

Vegetation.

All right. Everything is set for man to arrive.

“Let us make man.”

Man wasn’t made first to start looking for food to eat.

Man wasn’t.

You see, nothing can be successful until somebody is strategic.

You magnify your gain when you maximize your mind.

The Bible says we have the mind of Christ.

So the mind is not totally useless.

Am I communicating at all?

Don't scatter your life's energy.

Deploy it in directions of maximum impact.

Deploy Your Energy Strategically

That's why I cannot fly to Fiji Island to preach and return back. Then they say they invite me for Vanuatu, which is one and a half hours away, and then I fly there and then come back.

Then they say they invite you for Solomon Island, which is another one and a half hours away.

No, no, no. There is no such energy and time for such dissipation.

Fiji Island, Vanuatu, if possible Solomon Island—all of you together. I arrive, within one week I have passed through all of you.

I am set for the next place.

God created the whole world in six days.

There is nothing you cannot do under 24 hours.

Pagadian Crusade that went global. Everybody heard Pagadian.

It was 24 hours.

Pakistan Crusade was 24 hours or less.

Impact—massive.

In Pakistan, I heard that their TikTok shut down for one week for the impact of that crusade.

Everybody was on it.

Pagadian, it hit the whole nation of the Philippines. Governors and mayors started going to church on their own.

The person who hosted us for the crusade, they appointed him federally to become a mentor to 250,000 policemen after the crusade, to teach them.

He said, “And then it’s your instructions I am teaching them.”

So we need to become more calculative and more strategic.

So life’s energy is not wasted. Life’s time is not wasted.

Precision strikes.

I’ll go back to Nicaragua again.

And when we go, based on their courtesy, because by the last time I came, he said that we can come back for another crusade, a full-fledged crusade.

We’ll do some neighbouring places together.

Do you understand what I’m saying?

We are going to Colombia. Colombia is a neighbour. He is mentioning Colombia now.

Colombia is close there, and not also Dominican Republic.

Hallelujah.

Let the energy of your life produce major results.

Major.

Let it be strategic.

Let your steps be guided.

Whenever God guides you, let it produce lasting impact.

So we get more strategic and get more successful under God, and things get more dynamic.

Somebody say amen.

Strategic Impact Without Wasted Energy

And we do all of that, return back home.

Everybody in this church knows that no matter what happens, you must see the pastor on Sunday.

Is that true or false?

Go anywhere in the world, you must see the pastor on Sunday.

One day, I went to Europe and came back on Sunday morning around 5:00 a.m.

Preached 6:00 a.m. service, which was the first service in Rawan.

I did five services, went for lunch at home, refreshed, and headed to the airport in the evening to fly to South America the same day.

But it was strategic enough to ensure that nothing is suffering because of something else.

The crusade is not happening at the expense of the church, and the church is not happening at the expense of what I am meant to be doing.

Somebody asked me yesterday, “So how does all these things get done?”

Soaring on the wind, welfare is happening. Thousands are being fed. All manner of skill acquisition and empowerment are happening at the same time.

What are you doing?

Spread your wings.

Our Destiny Christian Academy is what you might call a five-star secondary school. Five-star, top of the range, Cambridge accredited, affiliated to universities in Canada and America.

Last year, there was such failure in JAMB, the Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board university entrance examination. I think only about 23% passed. Is there any teacher here who can correct me?

Only about 23% passed or something. There was no student in our school that was among that 23%. Not one failed. Not one.

The same story this year. The same story all the years.

But you sit down, the crusade is happening at peak, God is helping the church, and then academic institutions are running at the top of the range.

Mention three schools within this city. It is among the top.

Why? How?

Stretching on the wings of the wind and strategic operation.

Am I communicating?

The Eight Characteristics of the Eagle

In rounding off today, if we want to occupy our domain as the eagle, what are the characteristics responsible?

Can you identify them on the screen?

Let's go.

1. Strange strength.
2. Sharp appetite.
3. Swift speed.
4. Scaling of heights.
5. Soaring ability.
6. Sharp sensitivity.
7. Strategic operation.
8. Stainless character.

8. Stainless Character

Stainless character is the eagle.

Stainless.

And it is in two major ways.

Number one, the eagle will not taste corruption.

Food that is rotten belongs to the vulture. It belongs to the vulture.

If it is for the eagle, it must be fresh.

Maybe it was the eagle they were telling us about in Isaiah chapter 33:

“He shall dwell on high: his place of defence shall be the munitions of rocks.”

And:

“Bread shall be given him; his waters shall be sure.”

Now look at verse 15. He gives you the conditions that make that happen:

“He that walketh righteously, and speaketh uprightly; he that despiseth the gain of oppressions, that shaketh his hands from holding of bribes, that stoppeth his ears from hearing of blood, and shutteth his eyes from seeing evil.”

“He shall dwell on high: his place of defence shall be the munitions of rocks: bread shall be given him; his waters shall be sure.”

That is the eagle to me.

Do you want to dwell on high, to fly as an eagle?

You cannot compromise character.

Touch no corrupt thing.

Money that is not given you is not yours.

Avoid fraudulent deals.

That's the first dimension of the eagle's character.

Character in Marriage and Family

Number two, the eagle is connected to a mate for life.

We were meant to talk about unity for dominion. Maybe Dr. M will still speak about it later.

The eagle is together with his husband or wife for good.

Anything that is planning to make you give your husband or your wife distance is a challenge. Anything.

I have seen men, and I don't want anybody to feel bad right now. In case you have a marital problem or a marital crisis that is not of your own doing, let God bear you witness and judge righteously in that case.

But I have seen people who have people that are closer to them than their wife.

There is somebody in the office who is cooking tea for him.

He's cooking for him and putting things inside the tea.

“Madam, you cannot branch there?”

He's laughing until he reaches home. His face changes. He's a lion.

What kind of useless life is that?

Children can't approach him. Husband and wife can't approach him.

You face everybody that is valuable in your life away from you and surround yourself with wolves.

Don't do yourself such injustice.

At times, I pity my wife in terms of how she's following me everywhere, just following everywhere.

To the point of thinking, “Okay, maybe you should relax on this journey.”

But my inner mind says no.

This place is too far. Going to the Philippines, going across Cebu, going across Sri Lanka. By the time you come to Sri Lanka, you have another six-hour flight.

This journey is too far.

In the air between Ethiopia and Sri Lanka is another six or seven hours.

You are a girl. Maybe you should relax on this one.

Then from the inside, I hear, “No.”

Myself bear me witness that her presence is needed, not for any reason but for the benefit of presence.

And two heads will always be better.

Two are better than one:

“For they have a good reward for their labour.”

Prayer together, thinking together, strategy together, planning together, taming together.

But even if your case is not like that, because Oral Roberts was different from Kenneth Hagin, and different from Oral Roberts, I don't know how much Oral Roberts' wife went into the field. I don't know. Maybe I'll find out later.

T. L. Osborn's wife went everywhere with him, right?

But Oral Roberts' was a bit different, and probably Kenneth Hagin's.

Despite that, no devil could question the oneness of the home, the unity of the man and his wife.

No devil can question that.

Are you an eagle?

Ensure that your character and your family life are in place.

Your family life is in place against any odds.

If ancestral powers are fighting, you fight them.

The family life is in order, and ensure that corruption is not your portion.

Today, grace to do the right thing is coming for somebody.

If you are that person, say a louder amen.

Stand up on your feet with a louder shout of amen.

Prayer for the Eagle Lifestyle

Would you lift up your hands everywhere you are?

Can you place these things on the screen for me and say after me:

“Father, I come before You to ask for the impartation of the eagle lifestyle in order to occupy my domain of influence for You.

The impartation of the eagle lifestyle with strange strength, unbeatable strength, unusual strength.

Sharp sight. Open my eyes, Lord. Touch my eyes to see like You see.

Father, give me the impartation of swift speed to move with the speed and frequency of Your plan and purpose.

I reject every limitation, every hindrance, and every setback, now in the name of Jesus.

Help me, Lord, to go higher, to go beyond the ground level, to go to see and to dwell in Your realm, and to see from Your realm and to operate from Your realm.

In the name of Jesus.
