Introduction

Pathway to high destiny. God has a destiny on high for us. What is our pathway to our high destiny in God?

Deuteronomy 28:1–2 says:

“And it shall come to pass, if thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the Lord thy God, to observe and to do all his commandments, which I command thee this day, that the Lord thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the earth:

And all these blessings shall come on thee, and overtake thee, if thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the Lord thy God.”

The word is *set*.

The Lord will set you on high.

In **Matthew 5:14**:

“Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid.”

Our objective is to understand the pathway to our high place in God. It is confirmed in Scripture that the high place is the place for God’s people. The destiny of God’s people is a high destiny—spiritually, socially, materially.

God has no place for His own except the top.

The High Places Of The Earth

In **Deuteronomy 32:13**:

“He made him ride on the high places of the earth...”

God is making His people ride on the high places of the earth.

In **Isaiah 58:14**:

“Then shalt thou delight thyself in the Lord; and I will cause thee to ride upon the high places of the earth...”

Not low places. Not struggling places. Not places of frustration.

The high places of the earth.

Declare It: The High Place Is My Place

Lift your voice and say: the high place. Say it louder: The high place is my place.

The high place is the portion of God's people.

The Pursuit Of God: The First Key To High Destiny

Men and women who pursue God find themselves in the high places of life.

Matthew 6:33:

“But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.”

The high place is a product of the pursuit of God. A heart for God is the guarantee of height in life. Also, the pursuit of God equals the possession of good. It is not possible for a man to pursue God and not possess good.

In Psalm 63:8:

“My soul followeth hard after thee...”

Hard chase for God equals high flight in life. David pursued God intensely, and God established him.

In 2 Chronicles 26:5:

“...and as long as he sought the Lord, God made him to prosper.”

God is the maker of those who pursue Him. You cannot pursue God and remain unchanged. Many pursue gold, many pursue the transient things of life—and remain empty. But the pursuit of God is the key.

Look at your neighbour and say: *Pursue God. Other things will pursue you.*

The Fear Of God: A Lifter Of People

The second key is the fear of God. The fear of God lifts people. It is living a God-honouring life and a God-pleasing life—publicly and privately.

That was what lifted Job.

Job 1:1:

“...that man was perfect and upright, and one that feared God...”

It placed him above his contemporaries. Joseph declared in **Genesis 42:18:**

“...for I fear God...”

That fear positioned him as ruler in Egypt.

Daniel also:

Daniel 1:8 — he purposed in his heart not to defile himself. **Daniel 6:4–5** — he was found faithful; no fault was found in him. God lifted him to prominence.

Even Jesus:

Matthew 3:17:

“This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.”

The question remains: is God pleased with your life?

Do you honour Him in your office, in your family, in your private life?

The Power Of God's Voice And Direction

The voice of God is a lifter of destiny. **Deuteronomy 28:1–2** again shows that hearkening to God's voice brings lifting. God spoke to Abraham in **Genesis 12:1–3**, and he moved from obscurity into generational greatness.

Isaac obeyed God in famine (**Genesis 26:1–3**) and became exceedingly great. He sowed in the land and received a hundredfold increase. Obedience to God makes a man envied. David said in **Psalm 85:8**:

“I will hear what God the Lord will speak...”

Jesus declared in **John 5:30**:

“I can of mine own self do nothing...”

The voice of God remains the secret of elevation.

Whose Voice Do You Hear?

Whose voice is most important in your life?

The voice of friends? Society? Popular opinion?

Or the voice of God?

God speaks through His Word—Scripture becomes His voice. When you hear God, you become a voice in your generation. Ask: Lord, open my ears. Let me hear You clearly.

The Mercy Of God: The Final Key

The mercy of God is behind the lifting of men.

Romans 9:15–16:

“I will have mercy on whom I will have mercy...”

It is not of him that willeth, nor of him that runneth, but of God that sheweth mercy. God can lift one by mercy above those with greater qualifications. So we lay aside pride and qualifications and submit under mercy.

It is mercy that raised Solomon, even from the line of David and Bathsheba. God’s mercy overrides human limitation.

Pack aside your qualifications. Pack aside your achievements. And dive under mercy. When mercy speaks, destiny is lifted.

And he sent by the hand of Nathan the prophet—the same prophet that came and judged David—and called his name *Jedidiah*, loved of God because of the Lord.

How can you love be king that came out of such a relationship, and then later on you say you will be king?

I can tell you that Solomon, without any trace of equivocation or prevarication or oscillation, had a hard time growing. As all the children of the legitimate wives saw him, they said, “*Look at you, bad boy... shallow picking child of a prostitute.*”

A climate of rejection. A climate of ostracisation. A climate of prejudice. And he grew up in that hostility. And when God saw that no matter how bad his mother was, the boy has paid the price enough, God said, “*It is okay. You will be the king.*”

Ahead of all those who think they are qualified. Ahead of all those who think they are legitimate children—*you be the king.*

Don't Over-Claim Right Before God

Don't over-claim right in front of God. Just surrender. Submit. Subscribe to mercy. That was the story of David himself. David himself was picked by mercy because everybody abandoned him.

In **1 Samuel 16:1–3**, when God sent Samuel to Jesse's house to anoint a king, Jesse presented everyone except David. To serve your father well—was that a crime? He was the only one looking after the sheep. Father didn't love him. Mother didn't like him. Brothers didn't like him. When they gathered everyone, nobody remembered him. Nobody spoke for him. Until the oil refused to flow.

Oil here—no way. Oil there—no way. What is happening? *Are these all your children?*
“No, there is one in the bush.”

And as soon as he arrived, God said, *“Arise, anoint him; this is the man.”*

When Mercy Overrides Rejection

I think I see something here. When Samuel came, he told them to sanctify themselves—clean your life. But still, it was none of them. When David arrived, he was not asked to clean himself again. He was simply anointed—because he was already prepared.

So there is a mystery here. Why are you claiming you are holier than all of us?

In **Psalm 27:10**:

“When my father and my mother forsake me, then the Lord will take me up.”

God is taking somebody up today. I don't know who has ganged up against you, but in their very presence, God will lift you.

Anointed In Front Of Enemies

In **Psalm 23:5**:

“Thou anointest my head with oil...”

You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. He anointed me in front of my enemies. Not in a private room. Not in secrecy. That is the mystery of mercy.

No wonder Scripture calls it:

“The sure mercies of David.”

I will extend to you the sure mercies of David. Somebody who is ready for mercy—shout *Mercy!*

The Lifting Power Of Mercy

That is the mystery of God’s mercy—it lifts people. It was mercy upon Paul the apostle:

“I laboured more abundantly than they all: yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me.”

— **1 Corinthians 15:10**

A man who was meant to be a murderer became a star apostle by mercy. That same mercy is coming your way. Somebody say a loud amen!

Prayer And Activation Of Mercy

Lift your hands and say after me:

Father, thank You for Your mercy that lifts me up. I come before You today—place in my heart fresh passion to pursue You. In the name of Jesus.

A fresh baptism of the fear of God. Connect me, Lord, with Your voice of direction. And today, Lord, I apply for Your mercy. Pray for the next moments—open your mouth and pray.

Salvation Call - The Gateway To Mercy

The Bible says:

“He that covereth his sins shall not prosper: but whoso confesseth and forsaketh them shall have mercy.”

— **Proverbs 28:13**

If you want mercy for forgiveness of sins, you must confess and forsake your sins.

Say after me:

Lord Jesus, I am a sinner. I am in need of Your help.
Come into my life. Make me a new person.
Today I have decided to follow You. No turning back.
Forward ever, backward never. Amen.

Those who prayed that prayer, lift your hands.

Ushers, guide them forward.

Come with your Bible, come with your belongings.

Run to the altar.

Give the Lord a clap as they come.

Final Prayer Over Salvation

Place your hand on your chest:

Lord Jesus, I surrender my life to You.
Forgive me my sins.
Today it is my decision to follow You.
No turning back. Forward ever, backward never.
Thank You Lord, in Jesus' name.

Amen.

I pray for you today:
The hold of the enemy is broken.
Grace to live for God is released upon you.
In Jesus' precious name. Amen.
