Tonight, we are looking at the subject:

Message Topic: The Flourishing of Faith

Our objective tonight is to understand what it takes—what to do to cause faith to both grow and flourish.

It is important to note that faith is a living force with the capacity to grow and flourish.

“Your faith groweth exceedingly.”

Faith is alive. It has the capacity to develop, increase, and flourish.

It is also important to note that we live in a world that is escalating in evil and wickedness. Evil is growing and flourishing at an alarming rate. Therefore, faith must grow and flourish at a surpassing rate so that we can neutralise the effect of evil.

We live in a world today where things happen that can shake your heart. Faith must grow to neutralise the growth of evil.

The question is: What are the factors that contribute to the growth and flourishing of faith?

There are many of them, but tonight we shall examine three.

The Revelation of the Word

The Word of God is the seed of faith.

“Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God.”

— Luke 8:11 (KJV)

“The sower soweth the word.”

— Mark 4:14 (KJV)

It is impossible for faith to germinate without the Word. The Word of God is the seed for faith. Faith cannot exist without the Word. The Word of God births faith in the heart of a person. Every genuine dimension of faith is traceable to revelation from Scripture.

The Word is both food and fuel for faith.

“But what saith it? The word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach.”

— Romans 10:8 (KJV)

“So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.”

— Romans 10:17 (KJV)

“For from you sounded out the word of the Lord... your faith to God-ward is spread abroad.”

— 1 Thessalonians 1:8 (KJV)

The sounding of the Word is the explosion of faith. Faith is non-existent without the Word. Please hear this carefully:

Faith Does Not Stand on Sentiments

Faith does not stand on sentiments. Faith stands on insight. You do not know how audacious you can become until you see from Scripture what you have never seen before.

You do not know how rugged you can become until revelation breaks forth from the Word. You do not know what you can dare until light enters your spirit. There are dimensions where fear dies when revelation rises.

The birth of faith is the death of fear.

Faith comes alive when light comes alive.

Let me say this before I move to the next point:

Faith is not blind belief in possibilities. There are people who believe blindly and call it faith. Someone may say:

“If you put something inside that glass of water, I can drink it and nothing will happen to me.”

Why?

“I just know nothing can happen to me.”

That is blind belief. Bible faith is not blind belief in possibility. Bible faith is strong belief in the authenticity of God and His Word.

The three Hebrew boys were not speaking carelessly when they said:

“Our God whom we serve is able to deliver us.”

— Daniel 3:17 (KJV)

They were speaking based on what they knew. Lift your right hand and say:

“I believe! I believe! I believe!”

The first thing that causes faith to flourish is the revelation of the Word.

The second is the knowledge of God.

The Knowledge of God

Faith thrives on the knowledge of God.

“But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.”

— Hebrews 11:6 (KJV)

The more of God you know, the more of His faithfulness and reliability you discover.

When you get close to people, you discover their character. In the same way, the closer you walk with God, the more you discover His faithfulness.

When you take hold of God’s faithfulness, that is faith.

When you stand your ground on the faithfulness of God, that is faith.

When you say:

“God is too faithful to allow me die before my time,”

—you are standing on His character.

The knowledge of God produces confidence in God.

Somebody say, “Amen!”

Doubt Is the Confirmation of Inadequate Knowledge of Who God Is

Doubt confirms inadequate knowledge of God.

If I, as a human being, tell someone I will give them something and they respond with suspicion, it hurts because I do not dwell in the realm of empty promises.

One of the greatest pains you can give God is to doubt Him.

People doubt Him because they do not know Him.

When a stranger promises you something, you may hesitate. But when a trusted father speaks, his children believe him because experience has proven his integrity.

That is how the knowledge of God works.

When He says, “I will do it,” you go to sleep.

“For I know whom I have believed, and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day.”

— 2 Timothy 1:12 (KJV)

To know God is to be persuaded.

To know Him is to be persuaded beyond dissuasion.

If you are still doubting God concerning certain things, it is because you do not yet know Him deeply enough in that area.

The prayer to know God more does not only increase your anointing—it grows your faith.

“That I may know him, and the power of his resurrection...”

— Philippians 3:10 (KJV)

When you pray:

“Lord, help me know You more,”

you are also praying:

“Lord, kill my doubts. Kill my fears. Kill my unbelief.”

I prophesy to someone here today: a new dimension of the knowledge of God is coming upon your life!

If you believe that, shout “Amen!”

Persuaded by the Knowledge of God

“I know whom I have believed, and because I know Him, I am persuaded.”

I am persuaded that no human being with breath in his nostrils can terminate my assignment before time. I am persuaded that as I serve God, the number of my days shall be fulfilled.

I am persuaded that no devil is devilish enough and no demon is demonic enough to suppress one day out of my assignment. I am persuaded that my source is God.

There are dimensions of the knowledge of God that make a person unshakably persuaded. I prophesy again: a deeper dimension of the knowledge of God is coming upon your life right now. May God reveal Himself to you in dimensions you have never known before.

In Jesus' Name.

The Testimony of the Acts of God

The third factor that causes faith to flourish is the testimony of the acts of God. Testimonies fuel faith. Faith comes by hearing—and hearing the right things.

What we hear affects our hearts. That is why testimonies are powerful. As simple as it sounds, when a husband tells his wife, “I love you,” it affects her heart positively.

In the same way, hearing what God has done boosts faith.

A.A. Allen once said:

“We know what God will do because we know what He has done before.”

Testimonies explode faith.

Observation Facilitates Imagination

When you see what God has done somewhere else, it shortens the journey of imagination. It helps you realise that what seemed impossible is actually possible.

David confronted Goliath with testimonies.

“Thy servant slew both the lion and the bear: and this uncircumcised Philistine shall be as one of them.”

— 1 Samuel 17:36 (KJV)

David remembered what God had done before.

Past victories became the foundation for present confidence.

What God Has Done Before Is the Foundation for What He Will Do Again

What God has done before is the foundation for what He will do again. What God has done for one person is a prophecy of what He can do for another. Mary also received faith through testimony.

When the angel told her about Elizabeth's miraculous conception, her faith rose.

“For with God nothing shall be impossible.”

— Luke 1:37 (KJV)

And Mary responded:

“Be it unto me according to thy word.”

— Luke 1:38 (KJV)

One major purpose of testimonies is to feed the faith of God's people. Testimonies are not fillers in church services. They are faith boosters. Latecomers should pity themselves when they miss testimonies because testimonies carry the power to strengthen faith and stir expectation.
