Introduction

Every single aspect of service is critical, and the testimony segment is not an exception. Anything that makes a person despise testimonies is an injustice to their faith.

You know there are all manner of people who come to church. My father in the Lord told me that at the beginning of their ministry many years ago, there was somebody in their church who was meant to be a pastor and would rebuke people who testified at the end of service.

“You are testifying too much!”

Is that not a devil? That is practical, physical witchcraft. “You are talking about this breakthrough too much. Are you the only one God is doing something for?”

Of course, such a person cannot go far. You may have such members who are very bitter:

“Every day testimony. Every day testimony. Sister testimony. Brother testimony.”

It is meant to be mockery. No. If God has not done it for you yet, do not be angry. Just calm down.

As a matter of fact, I have mentioned this before. We are going to have books of testimony documentations. As I am saying it now, it should be a reminder.

There will be documentation of a hundred testimonies on fruit of the womb—twins, triplets, marital breakthroughs—and whenever you are trusting God for fruit of the womb, you locate the book.

Side by side with Scriptures, as you charge your faith with the Word, you charge it with testimonies.

You can say:

“Devil, you are a bastard. If you could not stop this woman who had no fallopian tube, endometriosis, uterine fibroid, and a husband with low sperm count, and now they have three children, then who are you?”

Testimonies of financial explosions will be documented.

You are struggling with business failure, then you pick up one of those testimonies.

Testimonies of supernatural preservation—people escaping kidnappers and escaping killers—you use them to charge your heart with the fact that not everybody is wastable.

You are about to embark on a dangerous journey; you carry such testimonies as companions.

As I am talking now, one of those books should be out within the next one month.

Are you following what I am saying here today?

The Benefits of Testimonies

Now let me give you three critical benefits of testimonies. Somebody heard your testimony and heard how your neck was healed—how the cervical condition disappeared. The person listened to the recording of how many times your neck was making sounds every day—over two hundred times.

The person said to me:

“I now believe in God and believe in church.”

He even said:

“I want to make you my personal pastor.”

Very funny.

From one testimony, a person’s faith came alive.

Hallelujah.

Testimonies Bring Instruction

What is the impact of testimonies?

Number one: testimonies bring instruction. They bring instruction. It is said that a picture is worth a thousand words. You look at a picture and can see many things that were never verbally explained.

In the same manner, one testimony can be worth a thousand messages. What you are trying to preach and explain, the testimony already explained it. You are trying to tell us how big God is, how almighty He is, how nothing can stop Him. Then one testimony explains everything.

The Bible says in Psalm 119:24:

“Thy testimonies also are my delight and my counsellors.” (Psalm 119:24
KJV)

That is, they are my instructors. They guide me. They counsel me. They bring light and instruction.

Every miracle has a message.

Every sign has a voice.

In Exodus 4:8, God spoke to Moses:

“And it shall come to pass, if they will not believe thee, neither hearken to the voice of the first sign, that they will believe the voice of the latter sign.”

(Exodus 4:8 KJV)

Notice the phrase: *the voice of the sign*.

Every miracle has a voice.

So while you are studying the Bible and hearing the voice of God, you are also watching miracles and hearing God speak through them.

He is saying something to you.

I watched A. A. Allen minister one day. I watched all manner of people healed. The other day, that young man who was practically paralysed was healed instantly and began to run on this altar.

Somebody told me:

“That operation was typical classical A. A. Allen.”

One day I watched testimonies of deaf people hearing in a particular video clip. Then I went for a meeting, and the first thing I said was:

“Everybody who is deaf here, come out!”

My faith was so charged that not one person returned home deaf that day.

That was over twenty years ago.

Are you hearing what I am saying?

Testimonies bring instruction. They show you things you could not have learned ordinarily.

When people stand here and tell you that a car lost for five years was not only recovered, but another brand-new car was bought to replace it, the message is this:

Nothing is too lost to be found in God.

The lion that took your meat can still vomit it.

So when you hear a testimony, ask:

“Lord, what are You telling me through this testimony?”

That nothing is too lost to be found.

That no matter where it has gone, God knows where it is and can redirect it back into your hands.

Somebody say, “Amen!”

Testimonies Destroy Doubt and Unbelief

Number two: testimonies destroy doubt and unbelief.

That young man who was brought in paralysed since the previous year—when he first came out to testify, they had stopped holding him, but he was still shuffling.

Then suddenly, he began to run.

His father could not believe it. He went on his knees asking:

“How is this possible?”

The same young man!

So testimonies destroy doubt. They destroy unbelief. They destroy uncertainty.

And they irrigate and fertilise faith and confidence in God.

They water your faith.

“Oh yes, if God did that, then it can be done!”

Do you remember when Saul told David:

“You cannot face Goliath. He has been a man of war from his youth.”

But when David rehearsed his testimonies, everything changed.

David said:

“The Lord that delivered me out of the paw of the lion, and out of the paw of the bear, he will deliver me out of the hand of this Philistine.” (1 Samuel 17:37 KJV)

Immediately Saul heard that testimony, his doubt died.

He said:

“Go, and the Lord be with you.”

The man who doubted now believed.

Look also at Mary.

Initially she asked:

“How shall this be?”

But after hearing the angel speak, she said:

“Behold the handmaid of the Lord; be it unto me according to thy word.”
(Luke 1:38 KJV)

Today, every doubt in your heart shall die by the speaking of the Word you are hearing.

Every fear, uncertainty, anxiety, and unbelief dies now in Jesus' Name.

Testimonies Carry Prophetic Power

Finally, testimonies carry prophetic power. Revelation 19:10 says:

“For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.” (Revelation 19:10 KJV)

How many of us came into the Cross Over Night service with great expectations because we know declarations made in previous years came to pass?

That is prophetic power.

It builds anticipation and expectation unto manifestation. So testimonies build expectation leading to manifestation. When you hear a testimony, it weighs on your spirit like a prophecy coming your way. It builds anticipation leading unto explosive manifestation.

Somebody's testimony is another person's prophecy. The person is testifying, but actually prophesying. They are saying:

“This is what God did for me, and this is what God can do for you.”

Have you ever seen anything God did on this altar that you desire in your own life?

If yes, that is your prophecy. I declare today: it is released in your direction in Jesus' Name!

God is no respecter of persons. He is only a respecter of principles. If He has done it for one, He can do it for another.

Build Your Faith Intentionally

My counsel to you is this:

Build your faith through the Word of God, the knowledge of God, and the testimonies of His acts. Before you sleep tonight, ask God to give you even one verse. Any area where you have a challenge is an opportunity to build your faith. For example, if they sat on your promotion in the office, begin to locate Scriptures on promotion.

“For promotion cometh neither from the east, nor from the west, nor from the south. But God is the judge...” (Psalm 75:6–7 KJV)

You shall be the head and not the tail. Use every battle as fuel for faith. Everything the devil wants to use against you, use it to take off. If you are always tired, locate Scriptures on strength.

“The joy of the LORD is your strength.” (Nehemiah 8:10 KJV)

If nightmares disturb your sleep, locate Scriptures on peaceful sleep.

“For so he giveth his beloved sleep.” (Psalm 127:2 KJV)

Every confrontation is an opportunity to build your faith. Every enemy challenge is a ladder to rise. Did not David rise because of Goliath?

The Responsibility of Spiritual Growth

Anybody can do many things for you, but nobody can eat for you. People can pray for you, but nobody can build your faith for you. It is a personal responsibility.

Locate messages and teachings in the areas where you need help. Play them repeatedly. Even while sleeping, let the Word enter your subconscious realm. The spirit of man does not sleep. Let light replay in your inner being.

After thirty-three years, Paul still prayed:

“That I may know him...” (Philippians 3:10 KJV)

Pray continually:

“Lord, show me the dimensions of You I do not yet know.”

That revelation will shift your level.

The Power of Remembered Testimonies

One day, I sat down and wrote the number of times I escaped near-death situations. I counted them one by one—including face-to-face encounters with armed men.

When I looked at the list, I simply said:

“Thank You, Lord.”

All those preservations were not accidental. The devil that could not succeed before cannot succeed forever. Somebody say, “Amen!”

Testimonies charge your spirit.

They give you capacity.

One young man told me he heard my testimony of medical school and how I preached the gospel while studying.

He was still in primary school when he decided he would become a doctor and behave like this pastor. From primary school to secondary school, he kept excelling academically. Eventually, he scored over 340 in JAMB and gained admission to study Medicine. Not only that, he became a fiery preacher with a fellowship of almost five hundred people.

All from hearing one testimony. That is the power of testimonies. They impart determination. They release force. They shift people's destinies.

Something is changing in your life tonight in Jesus' Name.

Prayer and Declaration

Lift your hands and give the Lord praise.

Father, we worship You.

Father, we honour You.

Father, we magnify You.

Have you been blessed by what you heard tonight?

The best response is gratitude.

Lift your hands and thank Him for what you heard.

Blessed be Your Name forever, Lord.

Prayer for Revelation

We are going to pray very quickly.

Prayer number one:

“Father, open my eyes to see wonders from Your Word. Show me depths in Your Word that I do not yet know. Show me light and insight that will build and feed my faith in this season.”

Prayer to Know God More

“Father, help me to know You.

That I may know You and the power of Your resurrection and the fellowship of Your sufferings.

Show me Yourself.

Build me up with the knowledge of You that will explode my faith, destroy my fears, and terminate my unbelief.”

Prayer for Fresh Manifestations

“Father, You have done it before on this altar.

You have done it before in my life.

Do it again.

Show Yourself strong in my life.

Show the world that You are real.”

The Bible says:

“The LORD thy God in the midst of thee is mighty; he will save, he will rejoice over thee with joy...” (Zephaniah 3:17 KJV)

Father, show Yourself mighty in Dunamis worldwide.

Show the world that You are in the midst of Your people.

Demonstrate Your power in the lives of every member of this commission.

In Jesus' precious Name. Amen.
