Living for the Kingdom

John 10:10

“The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy...”

That is the agenda in this category. You have very terrible occultic grandmasters. They have seen satan, satan has seen them; they know each other. These are people who are on a mission to see how many people they can channel to hell.

This is the group of ritual killers, satanic and demonic people full of demons, trading in human spare parts. Some categories of bandits, terrorists, and kidnappers belong here. These are confirmed witches and wizards.

I heard the story of a woman who was stronger than all the witches in her community because she drew her power from the graves of her children. Do you understand? These are people who are sold out to the devil. They serve the devil with impunity. They serve the devil boldly.

Yet there are those who serve Jesus timidly.

Those Who Live for Themselves

The second category are those who live for themselves. These are people focused entirely on themselves and on the things of the earth—what to eat, what to drink, what to wear, what to drive, and whatever will make them happy on the earth. Everything about their lives is summarised on the earth.

There is no eternal deposit. There is no eternity in mind. There is nothing like:

“When I leave this world, this is the reward I am expecting from God because of what I did with my life on earth.”

Nothing like that exists in their agenda. They live like animals that wake up in the morning looking for food and then die suddenly with no consciousness of eternity. Unfortunately, many people in church live like that.

They are not in church to work for God, worship God, or serve God. They are there for one prayer request or another. When you say, “Lift up your hands and worship God,” they are lifting prayer requests. Some are lifting photographs of people they want prayed for. Their mindset is:

“What can we get?”

I was speaking to some people the other day and said, when we came to the Lord in the 1970s and early 1980s, we did not know there were benefits attached to serving God. The only thing we knew was that God created us, and we must serve Him.

We knew we had no right to own our lives independently of Him. We served God so we could make heaven and not hell.

The idea that serving God would bring money was not part of the equation. That it would produce earthly blessings was not our motivation. Later, we discovered:

“Ye shall serve the LORD your God, and he shall bless thy bread, and thy water...” — Exodus 23:25 (KJV)

We did not know those things then, and it did not matter.

It is the benefits attached to the Gospel that have brought many people to church today. Somebody sees a pastor driving a good car and assumes that ministry is all about material gain.

Somebody cannot get a job and decides to become a pastor.

A Hireling Mentality

I told you the story before of a so-called pastor who approached one of our pastors in a location and said he wanted to sell his church building.

Why?

Because he bought a car on credit and could not pay for it. So he wanted to sell the church building to pay for the car. Our pastor asked him:

“What about the members?”

He replied:

“Can’t you people carry them?”

That is a hireling. That is an armed robber. That is a rogue. Human beings are not commodities to be transferred around carelessly. These are people who live for themselves. Eternity is not in the equation. Kingdom investment does not matter.

Investment in Eternity

Almost thirty years ago, I began to calculate what would happen when I stepped into heaven. I imagined the souls that had gone ahead because I led them to Christ. I imagined them welcoming me and saying:

“Welcome, sir. We are here because of you.”

I remember one of the earliest experiences I had as a medical student. A seventy-four-year-old man sent for me to come and pray for him. Before praying, I preached Christ to him and led him to Jesus. Afterwards, he held my hand and said:

“Thank you, my son, for giving me peace I have never had.”

That night, he slept and passed on peacefully. I did not cry. I rejoiced.

Why?

Because he was standing at the junction of eternity. He could have gone left, but God sent me, and he went right. In my heart, I said:

“Lord, that is one of the first fruits who has gone ahead to wait for me.”

Many people have nothing to look forward to in eternity. That is why many rich men do not want to die. Their investments are on earth. Most billionaires do not want to die. Politicians do not want to die. Everything about their lives is tied to the earth. Some have hidden wealth that even their families know nothing about. Yet they cannot carry any of it into eternity.

Swiss banks and foreign accounts have swallowed the hidden treasures of many people who trusted in uncertain riches.

Those Who Live for the Kingdom

Finally, there are those who live for the Kingdom.

Matthew 6:33

“But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.”

These are people whose lives revolve around God and His Kingdom. Their target is kingdom enlargement, kingdom expansion, and kingdom advancement. These are people who decided not to leave their generation the way they met it.

If they make money, the Kingdom is at the back of their minds. If they have influence, the Kingdom is at the back of their minds.

A Covenant in Medical School

When I was going to the university to study medicine, I entered into an agreement with God. I said:

“Lord, entering medical school is no big deal. I will not be the first doctor, and I will not be the last. The real value is that medical school gives me a platform to preach Christ.”

Then I prayed:

“Help me never to fail any examination, and I will preach and fulfil ministry aggressively.”

It was a sealed deal.

So I entered medical school with a Kingdom mentality. From my second year, I would pray for hours before classes—sometimes three hours before an 8 a.m. lecture, then another hour during break periods.

One afternoon behind the physiology laboratory, I was pacing and praying when a young man saw me. I shared a few Scriptures with him. When you are on fire, the only way for the fire not to implode is to distribute it. I dropped a little fire on him, and he exploded spiritually.

Later he said:

“What you are telling me is too much for only me. I am the president of the Medical Students Fellowship. Come and share this in the fellowship.”

I agreed.

By the time I finished speaking, fire was everywhere. I did not touch anybody, yet people were falling under the power of God. What you are seeing today started there. My wife, then Sister Becky, was in that congregation. Everyone kept asking:

“Which guest minister is this?”

Because I did not speak like a student.

Kingdom-Minded Living

Everywhere I went, I preached—in front of hostels, inside buses, inside taxis. Sometimes after preaching in a taxi, I would pay the transport fare for everyone inside. One driver once said:

“You preached to us and still paid our fare?”

That was Kingdom mentality. There was a popular reading area students gathered in through the night, but my own reading pattern was different. Deep worship music would be playing while I studied. After reading for some hours, I would pray intensely in tongues before returning to my books again.

One senior student once asked me:

“Did you come to Bible school or medical school?”

I answered:

“Both.”

He advised me to take things easy because medical school was difficult. Eventually, he repeated classes and later withdrew, while I progressed.

I had an agreement with God before I entered.

Your Platform Is a Pulpit

Do not just make money. Let the Kingdom be central to your pursuits. Do not occupy offices merely to enjoy titles. If you are a director, how many people have you directed into the Kingdom?

Your office is a mission field. Even during my short period of medical practice, I made up my mind that my consulting table was also a pulpit. After medical consultations, I would ask patients:

“How is your relationship with God? Heaven is real, and hell is real. I have told you the physical truth; let me tell you the eternal truth.”

Then I would lead them to Christ.

A Soul Rescued

One young lady came to the gynaecology clinic. She had gone through terrible complications from multiple abortions. One fallopian tube was gone, and her reproductive system was badly damaged.

I looked at her and said:

“You wasted your life in a hurry, but there is still hope for you in God.”

Right there in the clinic, I led her to Christ. Years later, I saw her again in fellowship. Then another time after a service, a woman approached me and said:

“Do you recognise me?”

I did not.

She reminded me that I had preached to her in the teaching hospital years before.

Then she said:

“I am now married, and I have a son.”

I stopped everything and announced to the congregation:

“If this woman can give birth to a child, anybody can give birth to a child!”

Because I knew her medical history in detail. As I drove home that day, I said:

“Lord, I have not wasted my life.”

Many people have wasted opportunities. God brought souls across their path, but they ignored them. Living for God means every opportunity carries Kingdom consideration.

To Live Is Christ

Philippians 1:21

“For to me to live is Christ, and to die is gain.”

To live for self is to live at a loss. To live for God is to live at a gain—both in this world and in the world to come.

One woman testified recently that after years of waiting for children, she remembered how aggressively she served God through evangelism before her first miracle child arrived. So she returned again to Kingdom service and evangelism.

And again, the yoke broke.

The Influence of the Holy Spirit

If you want to be prepared as a soul-winner:

1. There must be passion for God
2. There must be love for people
3. You must live for the Kingdom
4. There must be the influence of the Holy Spirit

Walking with the Spirit and praying in the Spirit are critical for soul-winning.

Acts 1:8

“But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me...”

The Holy Spirit helps us in several ways.

1. The Holy Spirit Empowers Us to Witness

The power to speak to people about Christ is imparted by the Holy Ghost.

He empowers our witness.

2. The Holy Spirit Gives Boldness

2 Timothy 1:6–7

“For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.”

One of the greatest challenges many people have is fear.

They say:

“I am not bold enough to talk to people.”

But when you carry the genuine Spirit of God, audacity comes with Him.

As a young man, there were areas of timidity in my life. Even speaking publicly could be difficult at times.

But when the Spirit of God came upon me, boldness arrived.

The Holy Spirit gives us courage.

3. The Holy Spirit Fills Our Hearts with Love

Romans 5:5

“...because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us.”

The Holy Spirit saturates our hearts with the love of God.

Love for God.

Love for people.

Suddenly, passion for God becomes effortless. You become burdened for souls naturally.

The Spirit of God floods the heart with divine love.

Closing Exhortation

I think I will stop here for tonight.

Lift up your right hand and give Him praise.

Begin to pray in the Spirit. Talk in tongues. Open your mouth and begin to pray in the Holy Ghost.
