Arise, Shine: The Rising Glory

In the precious name of Jesus Christ. This evening, I speak on **the rising glory—from generation to generation.**

Isaiah 60:1–3 declares:

“Arise, shine; for thy light is come, and the glory of the LORD is risen upon thee.

For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people: but the LORD shall arise upon thee, and his glory shall be seen upon thee.

And the Gentiles shall come to thy light, and kings to the brightness of thy rising.”

The rising glory is the rising of divine illumination, divine influence, and divine manifestation from one level to another.

Tonight, the focus is twofold:

First, to understand the rise of glory.

Second, to understand the graces behind the rise of glory.

God is a God of action and motion. He is not stagnant. He is not static. He is ever moving, ever working, ever advancing His purpose.

In Exodus 14:13–16, Moses said to the people:

“Fear ye not, stand still, and see the salvation of the LORD...”

But the Lord overruled him:

“Wherefore criest thou unto me? speak unto the children of Israel, that they go forward...”

God is a God of motion, not stagnation. When motion is required, standing still becomes disobedience.

Your instruction may be theologically accurate but revelationally inaccurate if it contradicts divine timing.

When God says move, even spiritual stability must give way to divine movement.

God Is A God Of New Things

Isaiah 43:19 declares:

“Behold, I will do a new thing...”

God never runs out of newness. In God, news never ends. He is perpetually unfolding dimensions that have never been seen before.

God Is The God Of Increasing Dimensions Of Manifestation

God does not repeat levels—He increases them.

More and More

Proverbs 4:18:

“But the path of the just is as the shining light, that shineth more and more unto the perfect day.”

Strength to Strength

Psalm 84:7:

“They go from strength to strength...”

Faith to Faith

Romans 1:17 speaks of righteousness revealed:

“From faith to faith...”

Glory to Glory

2 Corinthians 3:18:

“But we all... are changed into the same image from glory to glory...”

Glory is not static. Glory is progressive. Glory is dimensional.

Even Ezekiel 47 reveals depth increasing step by step—ankles, knees, loins, and then waters to swim in.

This is divine progression: from measure to measure, from depth to depth, until it becomes overwhelming and uncontainable.

The Wave Of Generational Glory

The move of God is like waves upon waves. What begins in one generation travels to another. It increases in strength, builds momentum, and culminates in divine explosion.

From Moses to Elijah, from Elijah to Elisha, from generation to generation—it is increasing glory. We are not meant to see repetition; we are meant to see escalation. From Adam to Christ, we see increasing dimensions of redemption. In Genesis 3:21, God clothed Adam with an animal sacrifice. From there, Exodus 12:3 reveals a lamb for a house. Leviticus 9:7 shows a lamb for a nation.

Then John 1:29 declares:

“Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.”

From one person, to a household, to a nation, to the entire world. And not with an animal anymore—but with Christ Himself. This is rising glory in redemption.

From Abraham To Isaac To Jacob

Abraham was a man who dealt with nations. Isaac became greater than a nation. Jacob became a nation himself. This is progression: from man to influence, to nationhood. God always advances generations in glory.

From Moses To Joshua

Moses brought Israel out of Egypt. Joshua brought them into their inheritance. Moses demonstrated deliverance. Joshua demonstrated possession. The next generation must not only deliver—it must possess.

From David To Solomon

David prepared the materials for the temple. Solomon built the temple. David fought battles. Solomon entered rest and manifestation.

Some generations prepare the way; others build upon it.

From Elijah To Elisha

Elijah operated in fire and prophetic authority. Elisha walked in double measure. Where Elijah saw chariots of fire, Elisha saw a mountain full of horses and chariots.

The next generation carries multiplied grace.

From John The Baptist To Jesus Christ

John the Baptist preached in the wilderness. He wore camel's hair, ate locusts and wild honey. His ministry was confined to the wilderness. But Jesus came with a greater glory—preaching in cities, synagogues, and temples.

John's disciples even left him to follow Jesus. This is rising glory: from preparation to manifestation.

From The Master To The Apostles

Jesus declared:

“He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do...” (John 14:12)

And again:

“Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.” (Mark 16:15)

What began in Israel expanded to the entire world. Every generation is called to go further than the one before it.

The best of God is not behind us—it is ahead of us. We are not called to repeat history, but to exceed it. A rising glory is coming upon this generation.

From strength to strength.

From faith to faith.

From glory to glory.

And in the name of Jesus Christ, we will not be left behind.

Amen.

It is the God I know.

The God who does not diminish in power across generations, but increases in manifestation.

The people who went ahead of us moved in dimensions, but those who come after are designed to go further in impact, further in expression, further in manifestation.

There is a holy stirring in the spirit—an awakening to rise into what God has reserved for this generation.

From The Original Apostles To Paul The Apostle

Peter, James, and John walked with the Lord physically. They saw glory, they witnessed power, they handled the manifestation of Christ on earth. But Paul carried a dimension that was distinct and expansive.

“But by the grace of God I am what I am... and I laboured more abundantly than they all...” (1 Corinthians 15:9–10)

Paul’s testimony reveals a rising dimension of grace—labour beyond limitation, revelation beyond proximity. Grace does not only preserve; grace increases assignment capacity.

The Rising Glory Through Church History

From Reformation to Holiness Movement

Martin Luther carried the revelation:

“The just shall live by faith.”

A new light broke forth. Then came the Holiness Movement—John Wesley, Charles Wesley, John Fletcher. Men who laboured intensely in doctrine, discipline, and devotion. John Wesley preached tens of thousands of sermons, travelling relentlessly. John Fletcher prayed until even his environment reflected the intensity of intercession.

The Pentecostal Explosion

Then came the early Pentecostal move—William Seymour, John G. Lake, and others. A realm of power that shook natural limitations. Healings defied medical expectation.

Testimonies broke natural order. One recorded dimension: restoration of broken bodies, creative miracles, and supernatural interventions that could not be explained by natural means.

John G. Lake operated in realms where distance became irrelevant to prayer.

From South Africa, he ministered healing to a man in Wales—demonstrating the collapse of geographical limitation under the Spirit.

This was rising glory.

Then came the healing revival—Oral Roberts, William Branham, A. A. Allen, and others.

Mass healing meetings.

Creative miracles.

Restoration of deformities and incurable conditions.

Testimonies of children born with multiple deformities receiving instant transformation under the power of God.

Crowds responding in mass deliverance.

Wheelchairs emptied.

Crutches abandoned.

Bodies restored in real time.

This was not theory—it was manifestation.

From Individual Laying On Of Hands To Mass Manifestation

Earlier generations often ministered one by one. But later outpourings shifted to atmosphere-based healing—where the power of God moved across entire assemblies.

No longer only individual touch, but corporate visitation. A new dimension of glory entered the Church.

The Charismatic And Modern Expansion

Then came a further wave—global charismatic renewal. The presence of God became accessible across nations. Distance no longer limited impact.

Massive global gatherings, televised manifestations, and widespread encounters began to emerge. The Church entered another phase of expansion and visibility.

And still—this is not the end. We are at the brink of another wave.

There is a glory assigned to every generation.

No generation is permitted to be empty of divine expression.

Therefore:

We must accept responsibility for the move of God in our time.

Like Gideon, we must respond to divine commissioning with availability.

“Go in this thy might...” (Judges 6:14)

Heaven is still asking: *Where are the vessels of this generation?*

Three Postures For Rising Glory

1. Acceptance of Responsibility

This generation must not outsource its spiritual assignment. We are the ones appointed for this hour. Availability is the gateway to manifestation.

2. Refusal to Anchor in the Past

We cannot build tents around previous moves of God.

Every past move is a reference—not a residence.

God is still moving forward.

3. Forward-Looking Faith

What has happened before is only a platform.

Paul declared:

“Forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before...” (Philippians 3:13)

Expectation must remain higher than experience.

4. Focused Spiritual Hunger

We must set our gaze on what is ahead. Hunger is the womb of future glory.

5. Standing on the Prayer Watch

Prayer is the access point for dimensions yet unseen.

Habakkuk declared:

“I will stand upon my watch...” (Habakkuk 2:1)

Prayer births revelation and releases glory.

The Burden Of Prayer And The Move Of God

Great revivals were preceded by sustained intercession. Evan Roberts prayed for years before the Welsh revival erupted. No glory is accidental.

No move of God is without a praying generation. Prayer sustains what prophecy announces.

There is a rising awareness in the spirit.

Something greater is ahead.

Not decline. Not repetition. Not stagnation.

But escalation.

We are standing at the threshold of another outpouring that will define nations, cities, and generations.

There must be a refusal to live below assigned glory.

A refusal to miss what God has prepared for this generation.

A demand for divine help, divine grace, divine enablement.

A fresh release of strength, mercy, and power.

For every assignment, there is a corresponding grace.

And that grace is released now.

Closing Declaration

This generation will not miss its portion.

The glory of this time will not be absent.

The move of God will not bypass us.

We will participate, we will carry it, and we will manifest it.

In Jesus' name.
