## *Introduction*

---

Father, we give You the praise. With You we can be open. With You we can expose ourselves. With You we have nothing to hide. We come before You tonight and we ask that You will x-ray us and change someone's life and story, in Jesus' precious Name.

Lift your hands and give Him the praise. No friend have I found like You, Lord—one that I can trust, that is what You will remain. Great You, Lord. Bless You all. You are welcome. God bless you, in Jesus' precious Name.

I welcome everyone tonight. Thank You, Father, for giving us the privilege of Your presence and of being led in Your presence.

**Scripture Reference: 1 Timothy 3:9 (KJV)**

“Holding the mystery of the faith in a pure conscience.”

Tonight, we shall be looking at the subject: *Unravelling the Mystery of Faith*.

It will be a very sharp word. I trust it.

## *Objectives*

We have two basic objectives—maybe three.

First, we want to understand the mystery of faith.

Second, we will understand the profit of faith.

Thirdly, we will understand the way of faith—what leads to faith.

The subject of faith is one of the most mysterious subjects in Christendom. When you talk about prayer, people understand prayer. When you talk about holiness, people understand holiness. But faith... many are completely unaware of what it is.

To many, it is a difficult, mysterious, puzzling subject. So people ask: *How do I have faith? What is faith? How can I operate faith?*

And when people do not understand faith, they resign themselves to fate—“whatever will be, will be.”

But I want to say today that faith is both easy to understand and easy to operate.

## ***What Is Faith***

Faith is the combination of:

- Word revelation
- Heart conviction
- Right declaration
- Right action
- Producing the right outcome

In simple terms:

Faith is Word revelation plus heart conviction plus right declaration plus right action equals the desired outcome.

### **Scripture Reference: Romans 10:8, 17 (KJV)**

“But what saith it? The word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart... the word of faith, which we preach... So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.”

The process is simple:

You receive revelation from the Word of God.

That revelation enters your heart as conviction.

That conviction produces confession from your mouth.

That confession leads to corresponding action.

And that action produces the desired outcome.

For example:

“My God shall supply all my needs according to His riches in glory.”

“I cannot be a borrower.”

“I cannot be cut short before my time.”

Then your actions align—you begin to act in expectation of God’s supply.

Many people miss the process. Some hear the Word, but it never settles in their hearts. Some claim conviction, but speak the opposite. Some speak faith, but act in fear.

Your journey of faith begins with revelation, continues with conviction, proceeds to declaration, then action, and finally results.

It is simple.

Take the woman with the issue of blood.

**Scripture Reference: Mark 5:25–28 (KJV)**

“A certain woman, which had an issue of blood twelve years... When she had heard of Jesus, came in the press behind, and touched His garment. For she said, If I may touch but His clothes, I shall be whole.”

She heard.

She believed in her heart.

She spoke with her mouth.

She acted in faith.

And she received her healing.

It is a straight-line equation of faith.

Faith is carrying out required Word-based responsibility in order to experience desired Word-based possibility.

The Word of God shows you what to do and what God will do when you do it.

**Scripture Reference: Deuteronomy 28:1 (KJV)**

“If thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the LORD thy God... that the LORD thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the earth.”

**Scripture Reference: Exodus 23:25 (KJV)**

“And ye shall serve the LORD your God, and he shall bless thy bread, and thy water.”

Faith is simply doing what God says so that you experience what God promises.

# Classical Examples

## The Wedding in Cana of Galilee

### Scripture Reference: John 2:5 (KJV)

“His mother saith unto the servants, Whatsoever he saith unto you, do it.”

Jesus instructed them to fill the water pots with water.

They obeyed without questioning.

And the water turned into wine.

This is faith—acting without knowing how the outcome will appear.

The servants did not debate the instruction. They simply obeyed.

This is where many struggle—questioning instructions instead of obeying them.

Unbelief questions obedience. Faith obeys without argument.

When obedience is complete, prayer becomes small.

There are things you do not need to pray about when you have obeyed correctly.

Some miracles do not require long prayers—they require simple obedience.

People may mock what God instructs you to do. They may not understand it. But obedience is not validated by human approval.

You cannot determine destiny by age or appearance.

# Obedience

## **Scripture Reference: Luke 5:4–6 (KJV)**

“Launch out into the deep, and let down your nets for a draught...”

Peter obeyed despite experience telling him otherwise.

The result was net-breaking, boat-sinking abundance.

Obedience produces results beyond imagination.

Faith is the secret of victory.

## **Scripture Reference: 1 John 5:4 (KJV)**

“This is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith.”

Faith equals victory. You cannot have faith and lack victory. Faith is what overcomes the world system, challenges, battles, and opposition. There are battles from family backgrounds, environments, and unseen struggles—but faith prevails over all.

Faith is:

- Word revelation
- Heart conviction
- Right declaration
- Right action
- Resulting in outcome

Faith is also carrying out required Word-based responsibility to experience God’s promised possibility.

Faith is laying hold on the reality, reliability, and trustworthiness of God.

When you truly know God is real, reliable, and able, your life becomes a testimony of His power.

“I know that my Redeemer liveth...”

Even if everything fails, God remains faithful.

This is faith.

The grace to believe easily is released upon your life. Go and do what God has instructed you to do, and leave the outcome to Him.

In Jesus' Name. Amen.

The world is full of spiritual realities, but Jesus said, “In Me you shall have peace.” It is not written on everyone's forehead. You step in with audacity and step out unscratched, because you are not of their kind—you are another kind of person.

Not everybody is reachable in the realm of darkness. Not everybody is accessible. Some are untouchable by virtue of the life of God in them. Some may come to attack you, but they return powerless. They come to afflict, but they lose their capacity. Some battles are reversed instantly in the name of Jesus. I announce to someone—your victory is here.

## ***Faith Is Spiritual Power***

Secondly, faith is the secret of spiritual power—the power needed for spiritual exploits and results.

### **Scripture Reference: Acts 6:8 (KJV)**

“And Stephen, full of faith and power, did great wonders and miracles among the people.”

The fullness of faith is the fullness of power. Stephen was full of faith and power. Faith and power are inseparable. When we speak of miracles, signs, and wonders, it is not only about healing the sick or the blind seeing. It is about a life that becomes a wonder itself.

Your promotion, your progress, your life pattern—everything about you begins to defy normal cycles.

**Scripture Reference: 2 Thessalonians 1:11 (KJV)**

“...fulfil all the good pleasure of His goodness, and the work of faith with power.”

Faith works with power. The work of faith is executed through power.

**Scripture Reference: 1 Peter 1:5 (KJV)**

“Who are kept by the power of God through faith...”

Faith is a secret of power. A faithless man is powerless. A faith-filled man is powerful.

## ***Faith Is The Secret Of Possibilities***

Thirdly, faith is the secret of possibilities. What is impossible to men becomes possible with God.

**Scripture Reference: Matthew 19:26 (KJV)**

“With men this is impossible; but with God all things are possible.”

What makes all things possible with God is faith.

**Scripture Reference: Mark 9:23 (KJV)**

“If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth.”

Faith gives access to every possibility in God.

**Scripture Reference: Mark 11:23 (KJV)**

“...whosoever shall say unto this mountain... and shall not doubt in his heart... he shall have whatsoever he saith.” I decree over someone—whatever has been impossible is now made possible.

Receive fresh grace and impartation of the Spirit of faith.

## *The Way Of Faith*

### **Know The Lord**

#### **Scripture Reference: Hebrews 11:6 (KJV)**

“But without faith it is impossible to please Him: for he that cometh to God must believe that He is...”

The first way of faith is knowing the Lord.

There is a difference between those who love God and those who know God.

Knowing God is not head knowledge—it is experiential knowledge.

### **Experiential Knowledge**

Knowing God is like knowing a storm:

- One hears about it
- Another reads about it
- Another watches it
- But one who has been inside it knows it deeply

That is experiential knowledge.

It is not theory—it is encounter.

Faith becomes easy when knowledge becomes deep. When you know someone truly, belief becomes simple.

When you know God, trust becomes natural. It is easier to believe someone you truly know. Many people struggle with faith because they do not truly know God.

Paul said:

“That I may know Him...” (*Philippians 3:10, KJV*)

Knowing God changes your speech, confidence, and spiritual posture.

## **Know The Word**

Secondly, know the Word.

**Scripture Reference: Romans 10:17 (KJV)**

“So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.”

The Word of God fuels faith.

The Word is like a cheque—cashable anytime.

When you know what God has said, you know what God will do.

When you know the Word:

- You act differently
- You speak differently
- You live differently

For example, Scripture says:

**Scripture Reference: Deuteronomy 28:12 (KJV)**

“The LORD shall open unto thee His good treasure...”

So you align your life with that Word.

Even in hard times, the Word remains your standard.

## ***Marriage And Faith Principles***

Marriage itself becomes stable when the Word governs it.

Where the Word is absent, conflict multiplies.

But where the Word is followed, stability is established.

## **Living By The Word**

The Word says:

“Thou shalt not borrow...”

That means faith produces a lifestyle governed by divine instruction, not circumstance.

Even when conditions are tight, obedience remains consistent.

## **Final Charge**

When you pursue the knowledge of God and the Word of God:

- Faith grows
- Fear dies
- Possibilities open
- Life aligns with divine order

Charge yourself with the Word. Build your faith. Strengthen your inner man.

## **Closing Prayer Declarations**

Father, thank You for Your Word. Help me to know You more. Open my eyes to behold wonders from Your Word. Release a fresh baptism of the Spirit of faith upon my life.
