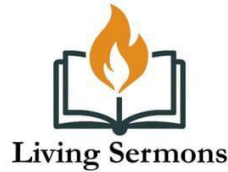

Preservation Through Obedience to Divine Leading

What brought you to this occasion? What brought you to this barrier? What brought you to this funeral?

It is written that when somebody dies, people gather there. I do not want to sound unnecessarily hard, but I was meant to travel for a programme. Everything was already set. Somebody had even volunteered to provide a plane for the journey. Everything was ready.

At the nick of time—less than one hour to go to the airport—I felt the leading of the Spirit: *Do not move.*

Some people who were to go with me had already gone ahead, but I said, “It is okay. I am not moving. This journey is cancelled.”

I told my wife, “I am not moving.”

She said, “Thank you, sir.”

The outcome of that event was not good. It would not have been palatable.

You will not die anybody’s death.

Do not ever love anybody enough to disobey the leading of the Holy Spirit to you. Do not ever fear anybody enough or respect anybody enough to disobey the leading of the Holy Spirit to you, because it will only be at your detriment.

Does anything occur to you as I am speaking now?

You remember the young prophet that came from Bethel to prophesy in Samaria. God spoke to him and said:

“When you go to Samaria, prophesy against that altar where Jeroboam worships.”

The young prophet obeyed. He prophesied, and the altar split into two. King Jeroboam wanted to strike him, but his hand became suspended in the air until the prophet prayed and his hand was restored.

Then an old prophet heard about the exploit of the young prophet.

Every young prophet should be careful of old prophets. An old prophet is not old by age; he is old by expired relevance—alive, yet no longer spiritually current.

This old prophet heard that a young prophet had come from another city and performed mighty manifestations. Jealousy entered his heart immediately.

“How can I be here, and God sent somebody from another town to perform such miracles?”

So he sent for the young prophet and said:

“Come to my house. I have prepared dinner for you.”

But the young prophet replied:

“God told me that when I come here and prophesy, I should not stop anywhere. I should return the same way I came.”

This account is found in 1 Kings 13.

The old prophet then said something shocking:

“An angel of the Lord told me to ask you to come back.”

My greatest question is this: God spoke directly to you, and another person claims an angel spoke to him. How do you discard what God told you directly because of what a man claims an angel told him?

Suppose he did not hear correctly? Suppose it was deception?

But perhaps out of respect for the older man, the young prophet followed him and began to eat.

As soon as the first bite entered his mouth, the same old prophet opened his mouth and declared:

“Thus saith the Lord: Because you disobeyed the commandment of the Lord, a lion shall kill you on your way.”

So it is possible to miss God and still prophesy.

That was how the young prophet died—for nothing. Wrong alignment. Listening to the wrong voice. Discarding what God personally told him.

That is why I say again: never respect anybody enough, fear anybody enough, or love anybody enough to disobey the leading of the Holy Ghost to you.

It will be at your detriment.

As the young prophet journeyed, a lion met him and killed him. Yet the lion did not eat the body, neither did it touch the donkey standing nearby.

Then the old prophet came and carried the body to bury him.

No wicked man will bury you.

The old prophet said:

“Let us bury him because he is truly a man of God, and everything he said shall surely come to pass.”

You will not die anybody's death.

Negative and wrong association will not kill you before your time.

If you are saying amen, say it louder!

Avoid the Wrong Company

In this season of serious insecurity in our land, we must not rush through these truths. Avoiding the wrong company is wisdom for preservation.

Be careful with:

Anyone Whose Life You Are Not Sure Of

Give such people space.

Anyone Whose Ways You Are Not Sure Of

Reduce unnecessary interaction.

Anyone Whose Principles Oppose Yours

If your principles of life are different, be cautious.

Anyone Who Constantly Brings You Face-to-Face with Danger

Either by their words or actions, danger constantly follows them.

The last time you travelled with them, you almost died, yet you keep repeating the same association.

This is wisdom for preservation.

Cast Out Fear Completely

Wisdom key number six: completely shun fear.

Job 3:25–26

“For the thing which I greatly feared is come upon me, and that which I was afraid of is come unto me. I was not in safety, neither had I rest, neither was I quiet; yet trouble came.”

Fear has been defined as:

False Evidence Appearing Real.

But I want to define fear as:

False expectation attracted into reality.

Fear is a state of negative anticipation where the mind is overwhelmed with the expectation that something terrible may happen at any moment.

Take note of the following:

You Attract What You Expect

And you precipitate what you anticipate.

Fear is a magnet.

Fear Is Faith in Reverse

Just as faith moves forward, fear drives life backwards.

Fear is faith in the devil. It is confidence in the success of satanic plans rather than confidence in the faithfulness of God.

But the devil is a liar.

Today, I take authority over every trace of fear, and I announce to somebody: what the devil said he will do to you shall never come to pass.

Whether the fear came from previous experiences, the experiences of loved ones, or terrifying dreams of the night—what the enemy has spoken shall never happen in your life.

Shout the loudest Amen!

Fear Is a Sinker of Destiny

Fear sinks people. In Matthew 14:30–31, Peter walked on water, but when he saw the boisterous wind, he became afraid and began to sink.

Fear is a companion of doubt and unbelief.

Jesus asked him:

“O thou of little faith, wherefore didst thou doubt?”

You will not sink.

There is an easy way to know what the devil intends to do in a person’s life: observe the area where he tries to introduce fear.

Whatever the devil wants you to fear is often what he plans to attack.

Fear gives satan licence to operate just as faith gives God room to move.

Deal brutally with fear:

- Deal with it by the Word.
- Deal with it through declarations.
- Deal with it through prayer.

Every spirit of fear is cursed to its roots in Jesus' Name.

Avoid Wrong and Negative Words

Wisdom key number seven: avoid wrong and negative words.

Proverbs 18:21:

“Death and life are in the power of the tongue.”

The Living Bible says:

“Those who love to talk shall suffer the consequences.”

People have died because of wrong words. Wrong words are killer words.

Numbers 14:28:

“As truly as I live, saith the Lord, as ye have spoken in mine ears, so will I do to you.”

Take note of these truths:

Words Carry the Power of Life and Death

Words carry blessings and curses.

How you speak can preserve your life or shorten it.

I heard of people who were healed in hospital, discharged successfully, and then said carelessly:

“I am tired of this life.”

They slept and never woke up.

What You Say Determines What You See

God said, “Let there be light,” and there was light.

God said, and God saw.

Speaking precedes seeing.

Speaking Is Sowing

And sowing is reaping.

Words are seeds.

Many people have been wounded deeply by hurtful words spoken into their hearts like seeds. Those words eventually produced bitterness and pain.

An experiment once revealed that cows treated harshly produced bitter, scanty milk, while cows treated with gentleness and affection produced abundant sweet milk.

Speaking is sowing.

And sowing is reaping. I shall be here for a very long time. The devil that can take me out does not exist. No man who has breath in his nostrils can terminate my destiny.

Jesus said:

“No man taketh my life from me. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again.”

Prophetic Declarations for Preservation

You shall fulfil your days.

Exodus 23:25–26:

“And ye shall serve the Lord your God, and he shall bless thy bread, and thy water; and I will take sickness away from the midst of thee. There shall nothing cast their young, nor be barren, in thy land: the number of thy days I will fulfil.”

Lift your voice and declare:

- I shall fulfil my days.
- I shall serve the Lord.
- The Lord blesses my bread and my water.
- Sickness is taken away from my life.
- I cannot be barren.
- I cannot cast my young.
- The number of my days shall be fulfilled.

Father, as I serve You, bless my bread and my water.

Take away every trace of sickness from my life.

I demand the fulfilment of the number of my days in the Name of Jesus Christ.

Amen.
