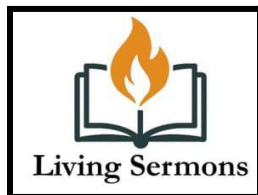

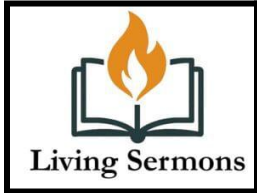

Opening Remarks and Worship

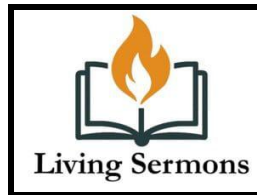

Prayer for Encounter

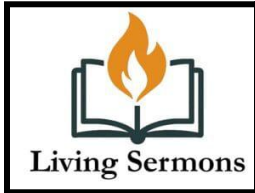
May we lift our hands to heaven and ask the Lord for an encounter tonight. The Bible says, "For everyone that asketh receiveth."

God's Method: His Word

Hallelujah! God's method has always been, and will always be, His Word. His method to lift is by His Word. His method to bless is by His Word. His method to change a man's level is by His Word. His method to restore is by His Word.

I would always liken the Word of God to a **servicing tray**. When you order a meal, it usually comes on a tray. The tray is not what you eat, but you rejoice because it comes with your meal.

Similarly, when God's Word comes to you, it brings **healing, restoration, lifting, and illumination**.

The Cause of Transition

The second thing I want us to note is that **revelations create transitions**. When God wants to move you, Revelation is like a vehicle. It stops you from remaining in the same position. The moment the light of God comes to you, the revealed Word sustains the ability to transition you to a **new realm, a new dimension, a new horizon**.

The Bible says in **Ezekiel 2:1-2**:

“And he said unto me, Son of man, stand upon thy feet, and I will speak unto thee. And the spirit entered into me when he spake unto me, and set me upon my feet.”

Someone, by the light of God’s Word coming upon you, will rise from that level. Say a believing **Amen!**

After this meeting, you will look at your former self and not find it again. You will so transition that you will be a marvel, a **sign and a wonder** to yourself, in the name of Jesus Christ.

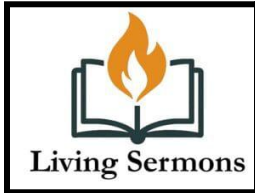
I want to share a few points along the theme, and I pray that the Lord grants us understanding. Amen, amen, and amen.

When God calls a people, He calls them first **to Himself**. It doesn’t matter where He finds them—like the Prodigal Son, or the nation of Israel in Egypt. The most important thing is that the moment God calls you, it means you’re ready to move from where you are to the place of **prophecy and destiny**.

The protocol is important: God does not call you to an assignment first. He calls you **to Himself**, and out of that encounter, a mandate is born.

“Say unto Aus that the ministry which thou hast received in the Lord, let him be faithful in it.” (Colossians 4:17, paraphrased)

If you ever assume any task or responsibility in the Kingdom without an encounter with the One who sent you, you will fail. There is something only His presence can impart that becomes the reason you succeed.



God's Desire: Manifestation of Glory

God's desire for every believer is that we eventually become a manifestation of His glory. The Hebrew word *kabod*, and the Greek *doxa*, mean the weightiness of a thing. When you talk about God's glory, you are talking about everything that makes God God: His wisdom, favour, power, and excellence.

God's goal is that our lives become a **living epistle** that reveals Him to others. If your life fails to do that, it doesn't matter whether you succeed career-wise or vocationally—you will have failed to represent God effectively.

Your results matter to God. The Bible says in **John 15:8–16** that bearing fruit justifies the investment of heavenly resources over your destiny. Likewise, in **Matthew 5:13–16**, Jesus teaches that believers are **salt and light**, called to preserve, add value, and shine in a way that cannot be ignored.

Ephesians 2:10 reminds us:

“For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.”

Empowerment and Access

Every believer has access to the **empowerment of the Spirit** to become effective witnesses. But access does not equal possession. Access means the possibility for possession exists, but there is a **conversion process** to move from potential to actualisation.

Just like a cheque must be converted to cash to be usable, so must spiritual access be activated through the Spirit. This is why empowerment is vital. Without it, a believer lives ineffectively, regardless of calling, profession, or vocation.

Signs and Wonders

Isaiah 8:18 says:

“Behold, I and the children whom the Lord hath given me are for signs and for wonders in Israel.”

Everything around you—your business, your school, your church—is intended to be a **sign and a wonder**, a demonstration of God’s presence and power.

Zechariah 8:23 reinforces this:

“Ten men shall take hold out of all languages of the nations, even shall take hold of the skirt of him that is a Jew, saying, We will go with you: for we have heard that God is with you.”

Gentiles shall come to your light, and their kings to the brightness of your rising. The world is too dark for lightbearers like you to be ignored.

Experiencing God: The Foundation of Signs and Wonders

The Christian experience was never meant to be believed arbitrarily. You stand by faith, yes, but you are called to **taste and see that the Lord is good**. There is an experience. Are we together?

The Bible says in **Acts 8:5–6**:

“Then Philip went down to the city of Samaria, and preached Christ unto them. And the people gave heed with one accord, giving heed unto those things which Philip spake, hearing and seeing the miracles which he did.”

Notice, Philip did not rely solely on words. He demonstrated the reality of God through **miracles**, so people could see what he was saying. God lifts. God restores. It is essential for people to **see what you declare**, for the God you know is the God you reveal to your world.

Key #1: Encounter with the God of the Bible

For every believer serious about their destiny, about becoming a **sign and a wonder**, the first key is this: **you must have an encounter with the God of the Bible**.

The God you meet is the God you reveal. You cannot reveal a lifting God if you have never encountered Him as a lifting God. The God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob is the same, yet the revelation of Him differs according to the encounter.

If your revelation of God is weak, it is because your encounter has been weak. Moses asked, *“Who shall I say hath sent me?”* before standing before Pharaoh. Destiny will ask you the same question: **“Who sent you?”** Whether you aim to lead in business, ministry, or family, life will challenge you—your audacity and confidence depend on knowing the God you serve.

Paul said in **2 Timothy 1:12**:

“I know whom I have believed, and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day.”

Your conviction, confidence, and audacity are the products of the **depth of your encounter**. Many believers rush to principles, skipping the crucial step of **knowing God**. Time invested in knowing Him is never wasted.

Knowing God Produces Exploits

Daniel 11:32 declares:

“The people that do know their God shall be strong, and do exploits.”

Knowing God equips you to **overcome failure, opposition, and fear**. Confidence comes not from pride, but from certainty in the God you have met. Psalm 3 reminds us:

“Thou, O Lord, art a shield for me; my glory, and the lifter up of mine head.”

An encounter with God builds audacity. Life can bully you, reference your background, or test your courage—but when you meet a mighty God, you **cannot remain weak**.

Consider David: a teenager confronting Goliath. Alone, without social media or support, he relied entirely on his **training and encounter with God in the wilderness**. Lions, bears, and hardship prepared him to act in God’s strength. Likewise, God trains each of us with the **tools of encounter**—prayer, scripture, wisdom—so we can confront the giants in our lives.

Do not discard your God-given tools. Use what God has trained you with; that is what produces victory.

God Helps Men

God can help men—ordinary men—to become **extraordinary**. Help from God serves two purposes:

1. To make things **possible**
2. To make things **easy**

Great men in the Kingdom are made through **strengthened encounters with God**. These encounters are not limited to supernatural visions or angelic appearances. Scripture itself is an encounter: light, understanding, and courage flow from the Word.

Spend time knowing God through His Word. Let what you know about Him form your **confidence, audacity, and power to become**.

Believing activates the power to become. When you believe God lifts you, the power to be lifted is released. When you believe God is your salvation, the power to become happens.

Encounter Leads to Authority

An encounter with God is essential before you pursue ministry, business, or kingdom assignments. Without it, life's assignments will **overwhelm and defeat you**. God calls ordinary people—like the disciples—to extraordinary purposes.

Even in the marketplace, knowing God equips you to **stand against spiritual opposition**, retain wealth, and manifest kingdom influence. The name of Jesus is heavy, requiring strength and resources to lift it high for the nations. Those who know God are strengthened—emotionally, intellectually, and spiritually—to do exploits and bring glory to His name.

The Result of Encounter

When God helps you:

- The **impossible becomes possible**
- The **weak become mighty**
- **Ordinary people achieve extraordinary results**

Your life will become a **sign and a wonder**, demonstrating the God you have encountered. Helpers, opportunities, and breakthroughs will align with your destiny. Audacity, confidence, and boldness flow naturally from encountering Him.

The assignment you receive will **always exceed your natural ability**, so you depend fully on the God you have met. Only the person who has seen God can complete what God commands.

Practical Steps for Encounter

- Spend **time in His Word**. Read, meditate, and allow the Spirit to illuminate Scripture.
- Pray for **divine wisdom and revelation**. Seek understanding beyond knowledge.
- Reflect on God's past faithfulness. Let your history with Him build audacity.
- Prepare to use **the tools God trains you with**: prayer, fasting, Scripture, wisdom. Do not replace them.

Let us declare:

"I receive, I manifest Your power and Your wisdom till the nations see Jesus lifted up, exalted, and glorified."

An encounter with God gives you confidence and audacity. Your life, actions, and results will **speak louder than words**, becoming a living testimony of His power. Ordinary beginnings yield extraordinary endings when God's hand is upon you.

Key #2: Faith—The Law Behind Signs and Wonders

To thrive in God's purposes, the second key is **faith**. Becoming a sign and a wonder operates according to the **law of faith**. Faith is not merely belief; it is a **law**, a spiritual principle that governs the believer's experience.

The Bible repeatedly declares:

"The just shall live by faith." (Romans 1:17; Galatians 3:11; Hebrews 10:38)

To live by faith means to prosper, to move forward, and to succeed in God's plan. Faith is your **persuasion, conviction, and corresponding obedience**. It is more than agreeing with God—it is acting on what He commands.

Deuteronomy 28:1–2 says:

"If thou shalt diligently hearken to the voice of the Lord thy God, to do and to observe all His commandments, I will set thee high above all nations of the earth."

Faith is what positions you to claim your portion of God's blessings. There is good in every land, for **the increase of the earth belongs to all**, but faith is required to command and receive your portion.

Faith in Action

Jesus emphasised the power of faith. In **Mark 11:22–24**, He taught:

"Have faith in God. For verily I say unto you, that whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith."

Faith requires **trusting God without guarantees**. There is no assurance in life, business, or ministry—sometimes you must act on God’s Word, even when circumstances seem impossible. Like Peter stepping out of the boat, faith demands that you obey His call, knowing **Jesus holds your hand**.

Many believers lose momentum because they fear failure. The Lord calls you to **move forward boldly**, even if the world criticises, circumstances intimidate, or fear whispers lies. Your obedience activates God’s promises.

Faith is essential not only in ministry but also in business and personal pursuits. The principle is the same: **trust God, obey His Word, and move forward in confidence**. Fear is a cancer that hinders progress; bold action, supported by faith, brings destiny to fruition.

Even when resources seem scarce, begin by faith. Register that company, start that business, take the first step in obedience—and watch God make provision. Vision, like rainfall, will find a container: those who act by faith receive.

Key #3: The Anointing of the Holy Spirit

The third key is the **anointing**—the empowerment of the Holy Spirit. **Acts 10:38** says:

“How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power, who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with Him.”

Isaiah 61 further confirms:

“The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me; because the Lord hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek...”

The anointing is **more than oil or ritual**—it is the divine empowerment that elevates a believer from merely agreeing with God to becoming a **demonstrator of His**

power, a witness to His reality. Every level of success in the Kingdom is **sponsored by the anointing**. It is the grace that produces results:

- **To prosper** (advancement and effectiveness, not just finances)
- **To receive mercy**
- **To mobilise men**
- **To operate with God-like power**

The anointing provides **speed and restoration**—acceleration in time-sensitive assignments and recovery of lost opportunities. Yesterday’s anointing cannot produce today’s results; repeated empowerment is necessary to sustain extraordinary impact.

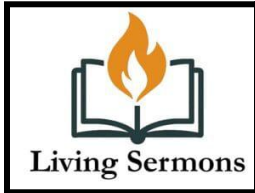
The Anointing and Results

- **Wisdom beyond your age:** Leads teams and organisations effectively.
- **Grace for influence:** Positions you so your voice carries authority.
- **Acceleration in life:** Achieves more per unit of time
- **Restoration of lost opportunities:** God can bring back what was delayed or missed.

The anointing legitimises your operation in the Kingdom. Knowledge and intelligence alone are insufficient; the **Spirit’s grace** is what transforms potential into reality. Fountain of Life, take note:

1. **Encounter God**—without Him, signs and wonders cannot manifest.
2. **Operate by faith**—trust and obey His Word, even without guarantees.
3. **Walk in the anointing**—let the Holy Spirit empower you to prosper, influence, and transform your sphere.

These three keys—**encounter, faith, and anointing**—are the foundation for anyone who desires to become a sign and a wonder, advancing God’s purposes on earth.



The Cry with Intelligence

There are different kinds of cries in the believer's life. Some are mere lamentations, unproductive and empty. But there is a **cry with intelligence**—a cry that recognises God's past help and calls Him to act in areas where breakthrough is needed.

“Lord, You have helped me, but this area of finances is not opening. This area of favour, You have called me to intercession, but I struggle to pray effectively.”

Faithful prayer is not passive; it requires **awakened intelligence and persistence**. Even if you find yourself distracted while reading the Bible, the Spirit can still meet you. Tonight, **something you didn't carry into this place will leave with you**.

Understanding God's Anointing and Authority

When Saul left his father's house, he went without an anointing, yet God's purpose prevailed through Samuel's recognition. Samuel said:

“Is it not because the Lord has anointed you?”

God makes His children **Captains over His inheritance**. This means you are entrusted with His resources, programmes, and vision. The anointing places you in authority over what He has designated, and equips you to steward it effectively.

Prayer with intention, powered by faith and the Spirit, activates this authority. Pray for:

- **Grace for favour**
- **Grace for speed**
- **Grace for restoration**

Whether you have not yet seen God's glory in a particular area or desire progression from glory to glory, His anointing empowers you to manifest the life He has promised.

The Prophetic Dimension

The prophetic is not merely predictive—it is **creative**. Prophets do not simply foresee; they **bring to pass** events in alignment with God's will.

Jesus' ministry required prophetic intervention: Simeon, Anna, and John the Baptist were essential to His destiny. Likewise, the prophetic can:

- Recalibrate spiritual and natural climates
- Position destiny helpers to intersect with your life
- Open doors that were previously closed

Through the prophetic, God aligns people, resources, and circumstances with His purpose for your life.

Decreeing Spiritual Shift

We declare today, in the authority of Jesus Christ:

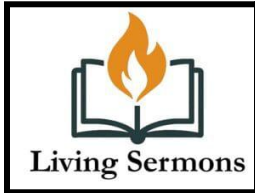
- **Every closed door in your life opens**

Counsellors are ready to guide you in this step of faith. Stand boldly, surrender fully, and receive the grace to live a victorious Christian life.

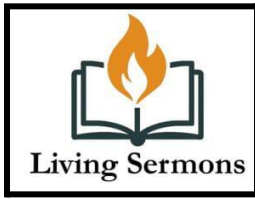
Closing Declaration

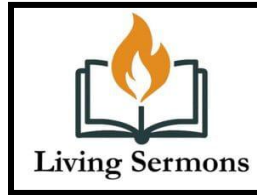

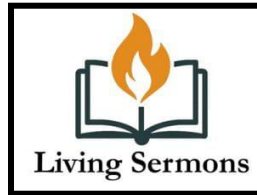

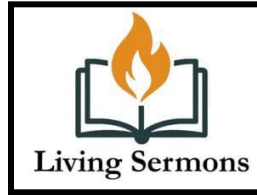
