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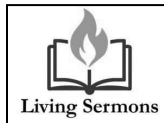

Chapter 1

When God Turns Your Captivity

If you have your Bible, turn with me to **Psalm 126**. I'll be reading from the **New Living Translation**.

"When the LORD turned again the captivity of Zion, we were like them that dream.

Then was our mouth filled with laughter, and our tongue with singing: then said they among the heathen, The LORD hath done great things for them.

The LORD hath done great things for us; whereof we are glad.

Turn again our captivity, O LORD, as the streams in the south.

They that sow in tears shall reap in joy.

He that goeth forth and weepeth, bearing precious seed, shall doubtless come again with rejoicing, bringing his sheaves with him."

— Psalm 126:1–6 (KJV)

Notice what happened.

God did so much for His people that even those who didn't believe in Him looked at them and said:

"They must have a God. Nobody could have that much blessing on their own."

That is the kind of testimony God wants His people to have.

Now turn with me to **2 Chronicles 20**.

Rather than read the entire chapter, most of you are familiar with the account.

Three armies joined together against God's people. They may have been able to defeat one army, but they couldn't fight three at the same time. It would be like playing football with eleven players against thirty-three.

So they prayed.

As they prayed, the gifts of the Spirit began to operate, and God spoke through one man.

"...Hearken ye, all Judah, and ye inhabitants of Jerusalem, and thou king Jehoshaphat, Thus saith the LORD unto you, Be not afraid nor dismayed by reason of this great multitude; for the battle is not yours, but God's."

— **2 Chronicles 20:15 (KJV)**

Everybody shout: **"Do not be afraid!"**

Fear Is Never God's Message

Sometimes I hear people say,

"I've been spending time with God, and He's shown me things about the future that are so frightening I don't feel comfortable telling the congregation."

But I have never read anywhere in the Bible where an angel appeared and said,

"I know you're afraid, but if you knew everything we knew, you'd be even more afraid."

Every single time an angel appeared, the message was: **"Fear not."**

God continued:

"...Tomorrow go ye down against them... Ye shall not need to fight in this battle: set yourselves, stand ye still, and see the salvation of the LORD... fear not, nor be dismayed; tomorrow go out against them: for the LORD will be with you."

— **2 Chronicles 20:16–17 (KJV)**

Everybody say: **"God is with me."**

Believe God and Believe His Prophets

King Jehoshaphat bowed before the Lord, and all the people worshipped Him. Then the Levites stood and praised the Lord with a very loud voice. Early the next morning, as the army marched into the wilderness, Jehoshaphat stopped everyone and declared:

"Believe in the LORD your God, so shall ye be established; believe his prophets, so shall ye prosper."

— **2 Chronicles 20:20 (KJV)**

After consulting with the people, the king appointed singers to walk ahead of the army.

They sang:

"Praise the LORD; for his mercy endureth for ever."

— **2 Chronicles 20:21 (KJV)**

Praise Transfers the Battle

The Bible says:

"And when they began to sing and to praise, the LORD set ambushments against the children of Ammon, Moab, and mount Seir..."

— 2 Chronicles 20:22 (KJV)

Every time I read that verse, I think about a revival meeting I was preaching in Pittsburgh about ten years ago.

Apparently, the neighbors complained that the meeting was too loud. A police officer came to respond to the noise complaint. It happened just as I was about to give the altar call. It wasn't a large church, so when I saw the officer walk through the back doors, I knew his presence could disrupt the whole service.

Then the Holy Spirit gave me an idea.

I said,

"Quickly, everybody stand to your feet. Close your eyes. Lift your hands. On the count of three, I want you to shout unto God with the voice of triumph!"

The entire congregation shouted with everything they had. The police officer just stood there looking around in amazement. The one thing I wish I had was the recording of what he radioed back to headquarters.

He probably wondered what kind of Christian jihadist meeting he had just walked into!

The First Thing Satan Attacks

The first thing Satan tries to remove from the church is praise. Go into any dead church—in America, the United Kingdom, Ireland, Scotland, or Canada—and you'll discover what has disappeared.

Praise.

As you can probably tell, I'm white. In many white churches, once a year we'd invite an African children's choir. They would dance, sing, clap, and shout. Then the pastor would stand up afterward and say, *"Isn't it wonderful how they praise God?"*

As though **Psalm 150** was written only for Black people. It wasn't.

Psalm 150 was written for **everyone**. Nobody has a pass when it comes to praising God.

"Let every thing that hath breath praise the LORD. Praise ye the LORD."

— **Psalm 150:6 (KJV)**

Hallelujah!

Praise is coming back to the United Kingdom. Loud music is coming back to the churches of the UK. Shouting and dancing are coming back to the churches of the UK.

If you believe it, can you shout a living **Amen!**

Notice what happened in 2 Chronicles.

God said, *"The battle is not yours; it's Mine."*

But what transferred the battle into God's hands?

Praise.

God didn't tell them to stay home while He fought for them.

He told them to take their position. And their position was to praise Him with a very loud shout. I once heard Pastor E. A. Adeboye say something that has stayed with me for years:

"Scripturally, you can pray quietly, but it is scripturally impossible to praise quietly. Worship has its place, but praise rattles the gates of hell."

No other religion has praise like Christianity. I say this respectfully, especially since I'm in the UK and have no desire to visit a British prison.

Not all religions are the same. In every other religion, the songs are mournful. The music is in minor keys.

There is chanting.

There is moaning.

But Christians sing praise.

During COVID in the United States, the government issued specific instructions to churches. I wrote every one of them down because they revealed exactly what the devil dislikes.

They said:

"Don't take communion."

So I wrote in my notes:

Take more communion.

Then they said:

"When you preach the Bible, just talk. Don't shout."

I wrote: **Shout more.**

Then they said:

"Don't sing loudly. Chant."

We don't chant.

This isn't karate class.

Christians sing praise!

I also noticed something interesting.

There were no such restrictions placed on other religions.

Only Christianity.

Because the devil knows that if he cannot stop churches from being built, he will try to control what happens inside them.

If all the biblical ingredients that produce victory are removed, then it doesn't matter if you build one hundred thousand churches.

They'll be powerless.

They won't impact the nation.

Chapter 2

A Fire the Devil Cannot Put Out

But when praise returns to the church, a fire begins to burn. The devil may hate that fire. But he cannot extinguish it. I prophesy in the Name of Jesus:

There is a fire coming into your life in this conference that the devil will never be able to put out. If you believe that today, put your hands together and give Jesus your greatest shout of victory!

Victory belongs to the children of God!

I almost forgot I was in the UK.

Let's continue.

The Bible says they began to sing and praise. Praise transfers your problem out of your hands and into God's hands. That's why the Bible says:

"In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you."

— **1 Thessalonians 5:18 (KJV)**

When you lift your hands to God and begin to praise Him from deep within your spirit, the devil doesn't know what to do with people like that. I feel strongly impressed to say

this. It isn't even in my notes. Actually, I haven't gotten to my notes yet, and I may never get to them. One time I prepared an excellent message, but the Lord led me in a different direction.

I said,

"Lord, I prepared a message."

The Lord simply spoke to me and said,

"I saw it."

So I'll always follow wherever the Lord leads.

God Is Going to Honor Your Coming

I feel as strongly as I have ever felt that God is going to honor every one of you for coming to these meetings. God does not bring you into His house to punish you.

He brings you into His presence so His Word can be released into your spirit. The Word of God builds faith. Faith builds strength.

The things that were designed to destroy you this year will not destroy you. Not only are you going to survive them, but you're going to leave this morning's meeting stronger than you were before the attack.

I see thousands of people leaving this meeting making the devil sorry he didn't kill them when he had the opportunity.

I tell you in the Name of Jesus:

Get ready for the best six months you have ever had!

In Jesus' mighty Name.

Praise Produces Complete Victory

The man who had been discouraged suddenly began speaking by the Spirit. "Build your life on God's Word, and you'll be established."

"Believe His prophets, and you'll prosper."

Then the Bible declares:

"And when they began to sing and to praise, the LORD set ambushments..."
— **2 Chronicles 20:22 (KJV)**

The armies of Ammon and Moab turned against Mount Seir and completely destroyed them. Then they turned on each other. By the time Judah arrived at the lookout point in the wilderness, all they could see were dead bodies lying across the ground.

Not a single enemy had escaped. King Jehoshaphat and his men went out to gather the spoil. There was so much equipment, clothing, and treasure that it took them **three full days** to collect everything.

On the fourth day, they assembled in the **Valley of Berachah**—the Valley of Blessing—because there they praised and thanked the Lord.

Then they returned to Jerusalem with great joy because the Lord had given them victory over their enemies.

They entered Jerusalem with harps, lyres, and trumpets as they went to the house of the Lord.

Then something remarkable happened.

"And the fear of God was on all the kingdoms of those countries, when they had heard that the LORD fought against the enemies of Israel."
— **2 Chronicles 20:29 (KJV)**

God Gives His People Rest on Every Side

The Bible says:

"So the realm of Jehoshaphat was quiet: for his God gave him rest round about."

— **2 Chronicles 20:30 (KJV)**

The Lord gave them rest on every side from all their enemies. That is what you're receiving today. I said, **that is what you're receiving today!**

Life is not supposed to be constant fighting.

I grew up in Pentecostal Christianity—what I would call the Pentecostal Holiness wing. They let my mother wear a little lipstick, but not too much makeup. That was the tradition I grew up in. That kind of Christianity was extremely focused on demonic attacks.

The devil was always attacking. If something went wrong with the church sound system, the devil was attacking. It had nothing to do with the fact that it was an old one-hundred-pound sound system with bad wiring that had probably been assembled by the children's church. But the devil got blamed for everything. People would say, *"How many know the devil's attacking?"*

You could have a tremendous church service, and someone would still conclude, *"Well, the devil will be waiting outside to attack us. Lord, help us."*

It was a Christianity that was centered more on the devil than on Christ. Even today, I hear things on social media.

Someone will say,

"We need deliverance every ninety days because we pick up spirits everywhere we go without realizing it."

Let me tell you something. When I go out into public, I don't pick up spirits.

I cast out spirits.

Jesus said:

"And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils..."

— **Mark 16:17 (KJV)**

Can you say, **Amen?**

Chapter 2

Light Drives Out Darkness

I was preaching in Alabama. If you've never been to Alabama... don't go. It was deep in the woods. The whole town probably had about a thousand people. We were holding revival meetings from Sunday through Wednesday.

On Tuesday night, three women walked into the service who clearly didn't look like church people. They sat in the back.

A friend of mine from Ghana, Pastor Kofi, was traveling with me. He went over—not to confront them—but simply to welcome them.

He asked, "Where are you ladies from?"

They replied,

"We're witches."

Well, that was unexpected. We don't advertise our meetings on *witchesmeet.com* or anything like that.

So he asked, "What made you decide to come?"

They answered,

"We didn't know there was a meeting. We've been trying to do what we normally do in the forest all week, but it isn't working. We traced the disturbance to this building, so we came to find out what was happening."

Two of them left. One stayed and gave her life to Christ. I've been preaching for twenty-five years, and for the last eleven years I've preached virtually every week, often twice a day. Never once have I had to stop a service because nothing was working and go into the woods to ask witches to stop practicing their spells.

But I found it fascinating that while I wasn't thinking about witches at all that week, they couldn't carry out what they wanted to do simply because the church was in session.

Light drives out darkness. Darkness never drives out light.

The Devil Is Under Our Feet

Is there a devil?

Absolutely.

I've cast demons out all over the world. Someone once told me before I traveled to Congo, *"You'll discover that demonic power is much stronger in Africa."*

I replied, "I've actually found the devil to be weak everywhere."

The devil is defeated. He is not over our heads. He is not eye-to-eye with us. **The devil is under our feet.** When something comes alive inside you from the Word of God, you stop trying to gain victory over the devil.

That's how many of us were taught growing up. One day we'll finally be free when we get to Heaven. But the Bible doesn't teach that. We don't have to wait until Heaven. Heaven came down to earth in the person of Jesus Christ.

He shed His blood on the Cross. And when He did, He didn't merely weaken the devil's power. **He utterly destroyed it.**

Every chain you walked into this meeting wearing is broken today by the authority of the Word of God.

"The grass withereth, the flower fadeth: but the word of our God shall stand for ever."

— **Isaiah 40:8 (KJV)**

God's Word is lifting you today. He is setting your feet upon a rock. You will walk in victory for the rest of this year. If you believe it, put your hands together and give Jesus a mighty handclap!

Victory belongs to the children of God. Can you say, **Amen?**

I'm not trying to get the victory.

I already have the victory.

My daughter is here with me, so I have a witness.

This isn't some preacher's story.

A little over a week ago we were preaching in Eastern Europe. Demons began coming out of people, and I never even had to cast them out directly. I simply walked up and down the aisles, just as Pastor Poju mentioned earlier that I often do.

Every few rows someone would scream—and the demon would come out. The devil knows who knows the Bible. I love the story of the seven sons of Sceva.

They said,

"We adjure you by Jesus whom Paul preacheth."

— **Acts 19:13 (KJV)**

The evil spirit answered,

"Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who are ye?"

— **Acts 19:15 (KJV)**

In other words,

"If you were Jesus or Paul, we wouldn't even be having this conversation. We would already have packed our bags and left. But we know you don't have what they have."

Today, you're joining the list of people the devil knows not to touch.

God has a list of untouchables. And today, your name is being written on that list.

In Jesus' Name.

If you receive it, clap your hands again. Lift your voice. Let the devil know that the United Kingdom is not up for grabs. **The United Kingdom belongs to the people of God!**

Say this with me:

"There is a season where the devil has to leave me alone."

When Jesus was tempted in the wilderness, He answered Satan with the Word of God three times.

Then the Bible says:

"Then the devil leaveth him..."

— **Matthew 4:11 (KJV)**

There was a season when Satan had to leave Him alone. After Jehoshaphat's victory, the Bible says God gave them rest on every side. David fought battle after battle. But Solomon never had to fight a single battle throughout his reign.

Pastor Poju mentioned when he introduced me at WOFBEG that my grandfather was a Pentecostal preacher. My father became a Pentecostal preacher.

Now I am one too.

I've had a very easy life because my grandfather was the first Christian in our family. He fought battles that I never had to fight. It only takes one person in a family to stand up and declare:

"As for me and my house, we will serve the LORD."

— **Joshua 24:15 (KJV)**

I feel something in this room. Some of you are here because your grandmother was the one who made that decision. Others because your grandfather made that choice years ago in Nigeria. But now it is time for a new generation to stand and say:

"The devil will never harass my children."

"I take my stand today."

As for me and my house, we will serve the Lord!

If you believe it, shout **Amen!**

The Wind Is No Longer Against You

I want to leave this thought with you during this first session. There comes a time when the wind is no longer blowing in your face. It begins blowing at your back.

Much of Christianity only talks about opposition.

"The devil's attacking."

"There are problems."

Yes, those things exist.

I understand.

Last year I spent time in court dealing with permits and zoning issues for our church.

Whatever you've been through, I understand.

But I don't live there.

My ministry is not built around court battles.

My life is built upon the Word of God.

Jesus said:

"Therefore whosoever heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them... the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew... and it fell not: for it was founded upon a rock."

— **Matthew 7:24–25 (KJV)**

The wind still blows. The rain still falls. But the house remains standing. So why spend your life focusing on the wind and the waves?

Be like the Apostle Paul. They beat him. They imprisoned him. Instead of asking for medical treatment, he would have said, "Does anyone have a pen and paper?"

I still need to write another letter to one of the churches."

John never stopped to complain in Revelation about being boiled in oil. They were consumed with the mission God had given them. When you're focused on what God has called you to do, you don't even notice the problems.

Ten years later you'll look back and think, "Wow... we really went through some things."

But while you were going through them, God gave you grace. You didn't even feel the arrows of the wicked.

I prophesy in the Name of Jesus:

Your season of enjoying God's victory begins now. From July through December, may these be the greatest six months you have ever experienced.

In Jesus' Name.

There are people in this room who will see God do more in the next six months than He has done in the last ten years combined.

Get ready for the best six months of your life.

This is not the devil's time.

This is the time of the Church of the Lord Jesus Christ.

If you believe it, say **Amen!**

Chapter 3

Ask for Rain in the Time of Rain

The title of today's message is: **Ask for Rain in the Time of Rain**. God says there is a time of peace. God says there is a time of blessing. I am watching that happen all over the world. On December 31st, the Lord placed a Scripture in my spirit:

"...This gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come."

— **Matthew 24:14 (KJV)**

The Lord spoke to me that day and said, "**This is the time.**"

Notice what the verse does **not** say. It doesn't say Bibles must be smuggled into every nation. It says the Gospel **must be preached**. The Gospel must be preached by people. You can see what nations attempt to accomplish through military power. Bombing from the air alone cannot take a country. There must be people on the ground.

Thank God for television. Thank God for YouTube. But Jesus still calls men and women to go. People like Morris Cerullo. People like T. L. Osborne. People like Reinhard Bonnke.

They went into nations. They preached the Gospel. They laid hands on the sick. **That time is now.**

God Has an Agenda for the Last Days

On December 31st, I prophesied that divine judgment would come upon every leader who was deliberately holding back the Gospel of Jesus Christ from their people. I grew up in Pentecostal churches. Whenever anyone preached about the last days, it was always about demons...

The Antichrist...

The mark of the beast...

Those things will happen. But the devil is not in charge of the last days. **God also has an agenda.** His agenda is found in Scripture:

"...I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh..."

— **Joel 2:28 (KJV)**

Notice He didn't say,

"I'll try."

He said,

"I will."

I was talking with the protocol team, and they told me how Pastor Poju's ministry has exploded over the last four years. Look around this morning.

A massive crowd on a Saturday morning in the United Kingdom. A ministry reaching countless people through conferences and online broadcasts. Where did it come from?

Because God has an interest in this generation.

God is not going to stand by while my generation and my daughter's generation are destroyed by addiction and hopelessness.

Governments don't have the answer. The United Nations doesn't have the answer. The hope of the United Kingdom is that people are baptized with the Holy Ghost and fire and carry the Gospel to their generation. I see people in this room being raised up by the fire of God to become everything He has called them to be. It only takes one person to take a stand. Then the dominoes begin to fall.

One Miracle Can Change an Entire Family

Let me tell you about a young lady from Fiji named Ashley. She was the only Christian in her family. One day she brought her grandmother to one of our meetings in California.

Her grandmother came forward to receive Jesus Christ. One of her eyes was not only blind—it was completely dead. There were no tears.

No movement.

Nothing.

As she prayed the sinner's prayer, repented of her sins, and asked Jesus to come into her heart, she suddenly felt a tear come out of that eye.

She thought that was unusual.

Then she opened the eye.

For the first time, she could see light and shadows. Over the next five days, the eye continued improving until it became completely clear. When she returned to Fiji, she already had surgery scheduled for that eye.

The doctor examined her and canceled the operation because her eye could now see. When the rest of the family heard what God had done, everything changed. They went from having **one Christian** in the family to **260 believers**. Four generations of Hindu idol worshippers came to Jesus Christ.

I'm telling you, when you look at your family—or even at your nation—it may seem like God has a huge job to turn things around. But remember what we read in **2 Chronicles 20**. You're only **one miracle away** from the entire plan of the devil being destroyed in your life...

...in your family...

...and in your nation.

I wanted to show you that testimony because people in places like America, the UK, and Canada often begin treating every religion as though they're all the same.

They say, "If you're from this part of the world, you like Jesus." "If you're from another country, you have another god."

No.

God is not **a god among gods**. **He is the Most High God**. Jesus is **the Christ, the Son of the living God**.

Jesus Himself said that if people would not believe His words, they should believe the works He performed.

One morning I was in a barber shop. A man from another religion heard that I was a pastor. He walked over and said, "You know, Jesus never claimed to be the Son of God."

It was about 8:15 in the morning. At that hour, you could insult me or even my mother, and I'd probably just nod my head. I wasn't looking for an argument. Besides, the man had scissors in his hand and I was unarmed. So I planned just to smile and keep quiet. But something came out of my spirit.

He continued,

"He only claimed to be another rabbi."

I answered,

"Then why did the other rabbis have Him put to death?"

He stopped.

I continued,

"When they became angry with Jesus, He said,

'Many good works have I shewed you from my Father; for which of those works do ye stone me?'

— **John 10:32 (KJV)**

And they answered,

'For a good work we stone thee not; but for blasphemy; and because that thou, being a man, makest thyself God.'

— **John 10:33 (KJV)**

Then I asked him,

"What did Jesus say next?"

At that point I knew it was the Holy Spirit because I honestly didn't know where the conversation was going.

The man admitted, "I don't know."

The Holy Spirit kept speaking through me.

I said,

"Jesus didn't deny it.

He doubled down."

He quoted the Scriptures and defended His claim to be the Son of God.

Then they picked up stones again because they understood exactly what He was saying.

So I told the man,

"You don't know what you're talking about."

Then I added something else.

Not only did Jesus identify Himself as the Son of God...

The demons identified Him as the Son of God.

Whenever you meet people trying to persuade Christians that Jesus never claimed deity, remember this:

The demons knew exactly who He was.

In fact, Jesus had to command them to be silent so they wouldn't interrupt His ministry.

Jesus is not merely a prophet. Jesus is not simply a teacher. Jesus is not just another religious leader. **Jesus is God manifested in the flesh.**

He died on the Cross. He rose again from the dead. He is coming back again.

And today, He lives in the hearts of those who believe.

Believe Because of the Works

Jesus said:

"...Though ye believe not me, believe the works..."

— **John 10:38 (KJV)**

He also declared that though the temple would be destroyed, He would raise it again.

And He did.

He's alive.

There isn't a body lying in some tomb while Christians simply choose to believe otherwise.

Christianity is entered by faith.

But it is **not** built upon blind faith.

The tomb is empty. Jesus rose from the dead. He ascended into Heaven. He will never die again.

The angels declared:

"...This same Jesus... shall so come in like manner as ye have seen him go into heaven."

— **Acts 1:11 (KJV)**

I want every person in this room to leave today with absolute confidence that Christ is alive inside you. The victorious Christ lives in you.

Christ Has Already Overcome the World

Turn to **John 16:33** in the **Amplified Classic**.

Jesus said:

"I have told you these things, so that in Me you may have perfect peace and confidence. In the world you have tribulation and trials and distress and frustration; but be of good cheer [take courage; be confident, certain, undaunted]! For I have overcome the world. I have deprived it of power to harm you and have conquered it for you."

When I was growing up, many churches stopped preaching halfway through that verse.

They emphasized only this part: *"In the world you will have tribulation."*

Then the sermon became about how difficult life is. People would say,

- "Sometimes God says yes."
- "Sometimes He says no."
- "Sometimes He says wait."

But they ignored the rest of what Jesus said.

Be of good cheer.

- Take courage.
- Be confident.
- Be certain.
- Be undaunted.

Because **Jesus has overcome the world**. He has deprived it of its power to harm you. He has conquered it **for you**.

Chapter 3

The Devil Is a Big Talker but a Bad Fighter

Look at David and Goliath. The devil talks constantly.

- He tells you that you're not going to make it.
- He tells you that you don't have enough money.
- He tells you you're going to die.
- He tells you you'll get cancer.
- He tells you you're going down.

But if you confront him with the Word of God, you'll discover something.

He's a big talker...

...but a terrible fighter.

I see people in this room rising like David. You're going to knock the devil down and walk into your victory.

In Jesus' Name.

If you believe it, say **Amen!**

Say this with me:

"As for me and my house, we will serve the Lord."

I prophesy in the Name of Jesus:

When you stand in Heaven one day, you will not be standing there alone.

Not one member of your family will be missing.

Every son trapped by drugs...

Every wayward daughter...

They are coming home.

Even now, God is working in the spirit.

Every chain over your family is being broken.

You will see the blessing of God manifested in full measure.

If you receive that today, praise Him in advance.

Give Him a mighty handclap.

Lift up a great shout!

When God Turns Everything Around

Let me finish with this thought. I want you to understand what happens when everything changes. What happens when it no longer feels like the wind is constantly blowing against you?

What happens when God turns your captivity, just as He did for Zion?

"When the LORD turned again the captivity of Zion, we were like them that dream.

Then was our mouth filled with laughter, and our tongue with singing..."

— Psalm 126:1–2 (KJV)

Even the unbelievers looked and said, "The Lord has blessed those people." That is the season we are entering.

When I saw one of the prophetic words the Lord had given begin to come to pass, I immediately began making arrangements to preach in Venezuela.

Initially I was told it would be many months before anyone could publicly hold meetings there because of the instability in the country.

Then I was contacted by leaders who were organizing an evangelistic outreach across hundreds of cities, reaching millions of people.

The Lord spoke to me and said,

"Don't come empty-handed.

Bring food and supplies."

That instruction came **before** a devastating earthquake occurred. The permits were already secured before the disaster happened. Do you know what that teaches us?

Before the devil even makes a plan to destroy, God already has a plan to give His people the victory.

For the third time today, I tell you: I see you walking in continuous and complete victory all the days of your life.

In Jesus' Name.

If you believe it, shout **Amen!**

There comes a season when the devil has to leave you alone. Apparently, God's people gave him such a defeat in **2 Chronicles 20** that he decided to stay away for a while.

You can give the devil such a sound beating through faith and obedience that he backs off.

Lester Sumrall once told a story about casting a demon out of someone during a large conference.

As the demon was leaving, it shouted, "I hate Oral Roberts!"

Oral Roberts wasn't even at the meeting. When the devil starts mentioning your name before he leaves, you've done serious damage to the kingdom of darkness.

There are people in this room today whom the devil will regret not destroying when he thought he had the opportunity.

We've all been through battles.

We could spend all day talking about hardships. But think about this. The devil hit you with his best shot. And it still wasn't enough to keep you out of a Saturday morning meeting in London. So let me congratulate you ahead of time.

Victory after victory will mark the rest of your life. The devil is defeated.

The people of God have the victory.

Ask for Rain in the Time of Rain

The Bible says:

"Ask ye of the LORD rain in the time of the latter rain; so the LORD shall make bright clouds, and give them showers of rain..."

— **Zechariah 10:1 (KJV)**

Ask for rain in the time of rain.

There comes a season when the windows of Heaven open and God pours out blessings so great that you cannot contain them.

The word the Lord gave me on December 31 is already beginning to unfold.

Think about Venezuela.

An entire generation has scarcely heard the Gospel publicly proclaimed.

Now the Gospel is about to be preached openly.

That nation is opening to the message of Christ.

And it's happening elsewhere too.

God is moving among the nations.

Churches are being planted.

People are gathering to worship Christ.

The Gospel continues advancing because God's plan cannot be stopped.

I also want to say this.

The revival that began in Nigeria through men like **Joseph Babalola**, continued through **Archbishop Benson Idahosa**, and has been carried forward by many great men and women of God, is now reaching the nations of the world.

Those seeds have become mighty branches stretching across the earth.

The devil is in trouble.

It is time to see the powers of darkness driven back and the Gospel preached among the nations.

If you believe it, shout a living **Amen!**

The Time of the Latter Rain

We are living in the time of the latter rain.

So what happens when the rain begins to fall?

Unprecedented Multitudes Turn to Christ

The Bible says:

"Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added unto them about three thousand souls."

— Acts 2:41 (KJV)

In one day, the Church grew from approximately one hundred and twenty believers to more than three thousand.

That is what happens when God pours out His Spirit.

That is going to be the story of ministries that are connected with Pastor Poju. You are not going to grow at a normal rate. You are not a stock-market investment that grows by eleven or seventeen percent a year.

God is a God who can take you from one hundred to three thousand in one day. That is what is going to happen in this last-day revival.

Unprecedented Miracles

Let's look at **Acts 5:15–16 (KJV)**:

"Insomuch that they brought forth the sick into the streets, and laid them on beds and couches, that at the least the shadow of Peter passing by might overshadow some of them.

There came also a multitude out of the cities round about unto Jerusalem, bringing sick folks, and them which were vexed with unclean spirits: and they were healed every one."

The reign of God produces undeniable miracles.

As a Christian, as a pastor, and as an evangelist, embrace the supernatural.

If you go to Speaker's Corner here in London, don't spend your time arguing. Tell people about Jesus. Then ask, "Who has cancer? Who needs healing?"

The calling card of the Church is not merely ideas or opinions.

Paul said:

"And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power:

That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God."

Whether you feel like it or not, as a believer you carry the resurrection life of God.

During COVID, I became so irritated hearing people say, "Watch it. Your hands spread disease."

Brother, these hands do not spread disease. These hands are anointed to heal the sick and cast out devils.

The supernatural is going to follow your life in an unprecedented way from today.

When God Begins a Miracle

I was preaching on an Indian reservation in the United States when a woman came up to me and asked, "Do you remember me?"

I said, "I don't."

She replied, "I was the woman in the wheelchair that you prayed for in New Mexico."

She had not walked for six and a half years.

I didn't recognize her because she had since lost about thirty kilograms. Once she could walk again, her body began functioning normally, her blood sugar stabilized, and although she had also been legally blind, her vision became 20/20.

Now I want you to understand something.

Anyone over the age of thirty has seen how one attack of the devil can ripple through an entire family. A husband dies, the wife falls into depression, the children stop going to church, and eventually become trapped in addiction.

One attack, if left unchecked, keeps multiplying.

But miracles work the same way.

Philippians 1:6 says:

"Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ."

When God performs a miracle, it is like a stone being thrown into a pond. The ripples continue spreading.

When Ashley's grandmother received her miracle, we rejoiced because a blind eye had been healed.

But God was not finished.

The next time I returned, thirty-one family members who spoke almost no English came to the meeting. They kept asking Ashley, "When is it time to receive Jesus?"

They had come to be saved.

We celebrated that.

Then they returned to Fiji, and over two hundred additional family members gave their lives to Christ.

I'm telling you today, whatever little thing God has already done for you—whatever cloud is only the size of a man's hand, whatever five loaves and two fish you currently possess—don't despise it.

Begin thanking God for what He has already placed in your hands.

God will multiply it beyond anything you imagined.

Every hand of the devil against your marriage...

Every hand of the devil against your finances...

Every hand of the devil against your future...

It is being broken today in the mighty Name of Jesus Christ.

(Video testimony played.)

Some of you have fought battles that your children will never have to fight because tonight you are going to lift up a praise that drives the devil out of your family line forever.

Can you say, "Amen"?

There is a season when the devil has to leave you alone.

There is also a season when you live beneath open heavens and watch God pour out blessings so abundant that you will not have room enough to receive them.

Start focusing on the blessing Scriptures. Start focusing on the reward Scriptures. Hebrews 11:6 teaches that faith stands upon two pillars.

- First, you must believe that God is.
- Second, you must believe that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

God has a reward with your name on it. God is rewarding you right now. I believe this very Saturday is a day of open heavens over God's people.

God has not given up on the United Kingdom.

God is not finished with London.

God is not finished with this nation.

And God is certainly not finished with you.

The miracles you've already celebrated are about to become generational miracles that affect entire families until even unbelievers declare:

"Look what the Lord has done."

Can you say, "Amen"?

Say it with me:

"There is nothing the devil has done to me that God cannot reverse in one day."

Many people believe God's promises, but they keep pushing them into the future.

"One day..."

"Someday..."

But faith always says, **"Now."**

"Now faith is..."

"This is the day the Lord has made."

God never told Jehoshaphat:

"I'm going to deliver you eventually. There are three armies against you, so give Me some time."

No.

The very moment they began praising and thanking God, the Lord set ambushments against their enemies.

In a single hour, every battle was over.

And God still was not finished.

Whenever God delivered His people in Scripture, He made the enemy pay for what had been stolen.

The valley that should have become their place of death became the Valley of Blessing.

Receive that expectation today.

July through December will not resemble January through June.

This year will not resemble the last.

The children of God do not stagnate.

We go from glory to glory...

Victory to victory...

Strength to strength.

I came to London to announce to the people of God that your season of continual attack has come to an end.

Welcome to your glorious season of blessing in the Name of Jesus Christ.

If you receive it, clap your hands unto the Lord and give Him a mighty shout!

(Congregation praises the Lord.)

Thanksgiving Multiplies What God Has Given You

Say it aloud:

"The Lord is good, and His mercy endureth forever."

Now be seated.

Remember the five loaves and two fish.

The disciples looked at the crowd and asked, "What are we supposed to do with this?"

But Jesus already knew exactly what He was going to do.

The first thing He did was bless the food and thank God for it.

Until you thank God for what you already have, you will never fully experience multiplication.

Stop becoming conscious of everything that remains undone.

Instead, become thankful for what God has already placed in your hands.

Complaining causes what God has given you to diminish.

Thanksgiving causes what God has given you to multiply.

I declare that whatever God has placed in your hands will begin multiplying from today in Jesus' Name.

Praise Is Spiritual Warfare

Paul and Silas were beaten, chained, and thrown into prison.

They prayed.

Yet nothing happened.

But when they prayed **and** sang praises unto God, everything changed.

I'm not trying to build a bridge between myself as an American and you as a Nigerian-British audience.

I'm simply stating facts.

The songs that came out of the Nigerian revival are now being sung all over the world.

They are sung throughout Asia.

They are sung throughout America.

They are even being sung in Presbyterian churches by people who hardly know where they originated.

Why?

Because every genuine revival produces praise.

In the 1980s, Nigeria sang the songs that came out of revival in America.

Today America, Canada, Europe, and nations across the world are singing songs that came out of the Nigerian revival because the fire of God rests upon them.

That praise you carry is powerful.

The very moment Jehoshaphat's people began singing and praising God, the Lord set ambushments against their enemies.

Praise is not merely music.

Praise is supernatural warfare against every power of darkness.

Can you say, "Amen"?

Suddenly

Paul and Silas prayed.

Still no breakthrough.

Then they praised.

"And suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken: and immediately all the doors were opened, and every one's bands were loosed."

Notice what happened.

Their praise did not merely free them.

It freed every prisoner.

Even the jailer came to Christ.

Many Baptist scholars believe that Philippian jailer later became the pastor of the church at Philippi.

What the devil intended for evil, God turned into something glorious.

God does not merely deliver you from evil.

He transforms the very thing Satan intended to destroy you into something that advances His Kingdom.

So once again, I congratulate you in advance on the greatest six months you have ever experienced in Jesus' Name.

(Congregation rejoices.)

When Praise Catches Up with Prayer

Kenneth E. Hagin shared an account that was published many years ago in the *Pentecostal Evangel*.

An American missionary contracted smallpox before there was a vaccine and was quarantined in isolation.

She prayed continuously.

Yet the disease only seemed to worsen.

While praying in tongues and in English, she saw a vision of Jesus entering the room carrying a balance scale.

One side was labeled **Prayer**.

The other side was labeled **Praise**.

The side marked **Prayer** was heavy.

The side marked **Praise** was empty.

Jesus said to her:

"When your praise catches up with your prayer, there will be an earthquake."

She stopped pleading:

"Please heal me, Lord."

Instead she began declaring:

"Thank You, Lord, that I am healed."

"Thank You for the blood of Jesus."

"Thank You for the resurrection life of God."

Four hours later, the nurse entered the room and exclaimed:

"What happened?"

She replied, "What do you mean?"

The nurse answered:

"All your smallpox is gone."

She had become so absorbed in praising God that she never even noticed the healing had already taken place.

Return Praise to God

That is what we are doing today.

That is what we will continue doing this afternoon.

That is what we will do tonight.

We are returning praise to God.

As we praise Him, God is driving the devil out of every area of your life.

Out of your health.

Out of your finances.

Out of your mind.

Depression is leaving.

Poverty is leaving.

Cancer is leaving.

This is not the devil's season.

This is the season of the people of God.

Rejoice and be glad, because the Lord has given you the victory.

This is your time to shout.

This is your time to dance upon the defeated enemy.

This is your time to remind Satan that two thousand years ago he lost forever.

You are not going down.

You are going up.

The God who began a good work in you will bring it to completion. The devil may not like it, but there is nothing he can do about it. You are going from glory to glory...

From victory to victory...

From strength to strength.

It's Time to Celebrate

Today, I want us to do exactly what the Lord instructed us to do:

Return praise to God. Many of us have already prayed enough. Nigeria and South Korea practically wrote the modern book on all-night prayer.

If there is an all-night prayer meeting in America, chances are it is being hosted by a South Korean church, RCCG, Living Faith, or another African congregation.

Prayer is probably not your problem. What many believers lack is the willingness to stop praying for a moment and begin celebrating as though the answer has already arrived.

Say:

"My prayer has been heard."

"My answer has been sent."

"My five loaves and two fish are becoming more than enough."

So on the count of three, let us release a shout that reminds the devil he has already lost.

Hell is going to wonder:

"What is happening in England?"

"What is happening in London?"

"We thought we had silenced their praise."

But it is too late. Thousands of believers are lifting up the praises of God. And that praise is driving the devil out in the mighty Name of Jesus.

Are you ready?

On the count of three...

Not a religious shout...

Not a polite shout...

Praise God in a way that makes the devil nervous.
