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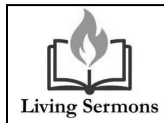

CHAPTER -ONE-

The Battle Is Not Yours

This is what I read this morning in **2 Chronicles chapter 20**. Three armies had joined forces against the children of God, and the king was greatly discouraged. But he did what most people don't do when they're in trouble.

Most people, when they're in trouble, move away from God.

King Jehoshaphat had enough sense to call a meeting. The Bible says they fasted and prayed. As they were praying, the Spirit of God came upon one of the men, and he gave this message.

2 Chronicles 20:15–17 (KJV)

"...Thus saith the LORD unto you, Be not afraid nor dismayed by reason of this great multitude; for the battle is not yours, but God's...

Ye shall not need to fight in this battle: set yourselves, stand ye still, and see the salvation of the LORD with you... fear not, nor be dismayed; to morrow go out against them: for the LORD will be with you."

Everybody say:

"The Lord is with me."

Then King Jehoshaphat bowed low with his face to the ground, and all the people of Judah and Jerusalem did the same, worshipping the Lord.

The Levites from the families of Kohath and Korah stood up to praise the Lord, the God of Israel, with a very loud shout.

Early the next morning, the army of Judah went out into the wilderness of Tekoa.

On the way, Jehoshaphat stopped and said,

2 Chronicles 20:20 (KJV)

"...Believe in the LORD your God, so shall ye be established; believe his prophets, so shall ye prosper."

After consulting the people, the king appointed singers to walk ahead of the army, singing to the Lord and praising Him for His holy splendor.

This is what they sang:

"Give thanks unto the LORD; for his mercy endureth for ever."

At the very moment they began to sing and give praise, the Lord caused the armies of Ammon, Moab, and Mount Seir to begin fighting one another.

The armies of Moab and Ammon first destroyed the army of Mount Seir, and after that they turned on each other.

When Judah arrived at the lookout point in the wilderness, all they saw were dead bodies lying on the ground as far as they could see.

Not a single enemy had escaped.

King Jehoshaphat and his men went out to gather the plunder.

They found vast amounts of equipment, clothing, and valuables—more than they could carry.

There was so much plunder that it took them **three full days** to gather it all.

On the fourth day they assembled in the **Valley of Berachah**—the Valley of Blessing—because there they praised and thanked the Lord.

That place is still called the Valley of Blessing to this day.

Then all the men returned to Jerusalem with Jehoshaphat leading them, overjoyed because the Lord had given them victory over all their enemies.

Breakthrough Night

That's what tonight is. Tonight we announced that this is **Breakthrough Night**. It's a night where God, in one hour, just like He did here, gives you victory over every enemy attacking your life and your family. When we leave this auditorium, we're not leaving to go into battle.

The Lord is fighting for us right now.

The rest of this year you're going to spend your time collecting the wealth of the wicked and fulfilling God's purpose and plan for your life.

In Jesus' Name.

If you believe it, can you shout,

"Amen!"

The men returned to Jerusalem overjoyed because the Lord had given them victory over their enemies. They marched into Jerusalem with harps, lyres, and trumpets and proceeded to the Temple of the Lord. When all the surrounding kingdoms heard that the Lord Himself had fought against Israel's enemies, the fear of God came upon them.

So Jehoshaphat's kingdom was at peace, for the Lord had given him rest on every side from all his enemies.

Now go with me to **1 Kings chapter 17**.

Let's begin in verse 8.

1 Kings 17:8–16 (KJV)

The Lord spoke to Elijah and told him to go to Zarephath, where He had commanded a widow to sustain him.

When Elijah arrived, he found the widow gathering sticks.

He asked her for a little water and then requested a piece of bread.

She answered,

"As the LORD thy God liveth, I have not a cake, but an handful of meal in a barrel, and a little oil in a cruse..."

She explained that she was gathering sticks to prepare one final meal for herself and her son before they died.

But Elijah said to her,

"Fear not."

Notice that in both passages we've read tonight, the first thing God says is:

"Don't be afraid."

Elijah continued,

"Go and do as you've said, but first make me a little cake, and afterward make for thee and for thy son."

For thus saith the LORD God of Israel, The barrel of meal shall not waste, neither shall the cruse of oil fail, until the day that the LORD sendeth rain upon the earth."

She obeyed.

And she, Elijah, and her household continued to eat for many days.

I preach from the sixth edition of the New Living Translation. In the original edition—the one I used right after Bible college—verse 16 was translated like this:

"No matter how much she used, there was always plenty left over, just as the Lord had promised through the prophet Elijah."

I like that wording.

I don't hear much preaching on breakthrough anymore. If you do hear it—and I don't know about England because I've only been here for one day—but in America it's almost become a mocked concept. People mock preachers who tell you that breakthrough is coming. They mock people who say that if you believe God, things can change overnight.

They act as though those preachers are lying. But the Bible is filled with account after account of people who were in impossible situations and watched God supernaturally turn their captivity around.

A Modern-Day Miracle

There was a lady in Los Angeles whose husband texted me a picture of her while she was in intensive care. She had a tumor somewhere in her stomach or intestines that had become so large food couldn't even pass through.

Her husband wrote, "Would you please pray for my wife? They've given her less than three days to live."

I replied, "I'll be in Los Angeles on Saturday night after I finish preaching. I'll come and pray for her."

I think he assumed that because I lived in Pennsylvania, I was just going to send praying-hand emojis in a text. But if my wife were in that situation, I'd want more than emoji praying hands. I'd want somebody to come and pray.

So I treated that lady like she was my own mother. After preaching that night in Los Angeles, I drove about an hour and ten minutes to St. Jude Cancer Center. The security guard let me in and walked me to her room.

It was around midnight.

I knelt beside her bed and laid my hands on a woman who had been a missionary to Africa earlier in her life. It was the first time I'd ever met that family. I think the husband had found me on Instagram.

She looked terrible.

There are some people you pray for with your eyes closed—not because you're trying to be especially reverent, but because if you keep your eyes open, it messes up your faith. Brother R. W. Shambach once told the story of praying for a woman with severe breast cancer. He said, "Lady, close your blouse. It's messing up my faith."

And then he prayed with his eyes shut. That's how this woman looked. She looked so close to death that I honestly wondered whether she would survive the prayer. She was unconscious. She was probably on fentanyl or morphine because of the pain.

Her skin was yellow. Her eyes were yellow.

I knelt beside her and prayed the best I knew how. Nothing happened on the monitors. You always hope they'll suddenly start beeping and somebody starts playing an organ while the person jumps out of bed dancing—but that didn't happen.

So I left. Her husband thanked me for praying.

There Is No Mountain Faith Cannot Move

The following Tuesday, while I was back home, I received a text from her husband. Now, I'm a faith preacher, so I'm not supposed to think like this, but I didn't even open the message for about three hours.

I was convinced it was going to say, "Thanks for coming. My wife's in Heaven now. We appreciate you praying."

I just didn't feel like getting punched in the stomach. Finally, I worked up the nerve to read it. He had written in all capital letters:

"ALL THE CANCER IS GONE OUT OF MY WIFE'S BODY, AND SHE'S COMING HOME TODAY!"

There is **no mountain that is immovable by faith**. That's why I brought up **1 Kings chapter 17**.

There was no financial strategy that could have taught that widow how to make one meal last for three and a half years. She couldn't have budgeted better. Today, so much preaching about finances is centered around managing money, making wise decisions, and avoiding bad financial choices.

Those things are good.

But that's not how Israel came out of Egypt.

Israel came out because God judged the gods of Egypt and stripped Egypt of its wealth.

God performed a miracle for that widow.

What wasn't enough for one more meal suddenly became enough for **three and a half years**, until the rain returned.

Don't Quit Before the Harvest

The Bible says:

Galatians 6:9 (KJV)

"And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not."

If the devil knows payday is on the first, he'll do everything in his power to get you to quit on the twenty-eighth.

Many people build their theology while they're living in the valley.

Again, I'm not talking about Britain because I've been here less than twenty-four hours.

But in America and Canada, I've heard many people say,

"I used to believe in explosive breakthrough."

"I grew up in that kind of church."

"But as time went on, I realized it doesn't really work."

I'm telling you, as the son of a preacher, having talked with many discouraged preacher's children, **there is a real God who knows your name.**

2 Timothy 2:19 (KJV)

"...The Lord knoweth them that are his..."

God knows exactly where you are in this room tonight. He knows every prayer you've prayed. And whatever the delay is concerning your miracle, **it is not God.**

God Is Helping His People Tonight

There is a devil who goes about discouraging, harassing, and trying to hold people back.

But the devil is in trouble tonight, because no matter what he plans, it cannot stand against the mighty hand of God that is upon your life.

I want to declare to you right from the beginning tonight:

You're not going back home the way you came.

Tonight, there is a release of the anointing to do what you cannot do.

To go where you cannot go.

Because you're not doing it in your own strength.

You're doing it in the strength of God.

And God is helping His people tonight.

If you believe that, keep doing what you're already doing. Clap your hands and give the Lord a mighty shout tonight in London!

Come on, give Jesus a wonderful shout!

I want to tell you something:

One day, everything breaks. I'm glad Joseph didn't develop his theology while he was a slave or while he was sitting in prison.

The Bible says there came a day when the word of the Lord came to pass, and overnight Joseph went from being a prisoner to becoming the prime minister of the most powerful nation in the world.

God is a God of promotion.

The Bible says promotion comes from the Lord. God does not discriminate in whom He promotes. The Bible says that in every nation He accepts those who fear Him and do what is right. You could have been anywhere in the world tonight.

You're in what is probably one of the greatest cities on earth—for restaurants, shopping, sports, and so many other things. You could be doing anything. But you chose to be in the presence of God. And I want to tell you:

God has a miracle with your name on it tonight.

God can lift you from where you are right now to where He has ordained you to be, and it won't take Him more than one hour. God is going to promote somebody tonight. Your life will never be the same again.

In Jesus' Name.

If you believe it, say **Amen!**

CHAPTER -TWO-

From Battle to Blessing

I preached this morning about **2 Chronicles 20**. How many of you were in the Saturday morning meeting? I preached about how the windows of Heaven opened over God's people.

Instead of having to fight, all they had to do was collect the blessing God had already won for them. The year 2015 was when things broke through for me. I was preaching in Philadelphia.

Philadelphia is a rough city in America. It has one of the highest violent crime rates in the country. There are a lot of shootings in America, but many of them are connected to gangs or drugs.

Philadelphia is different.

Anybody can get shot.

The shooters there don't discriminate.

I had never really spent much time there before.

One night, around 1:30 in the morning, my wife and I had just returned from preaching in Hawaii, so we were completely off schedule because of the time difference.

I decided to walk and get something to eat. As I walked through the streets, I saw several men around my age—in their early to mid-thirties. They had no shirts on. Many had no teeth. They were scratching themselves, clearly high on drugs.

It deeply troubled me.

Because Philadelphia had once been one of the great centers of the Great Awakening. George Whitefield had preached there and shaken the entire city. Now it seemed as though the devil had simply camped himself there. I went back and told my wife what I'd seen while we were eating. Even after that, I couldn't shake it from my spirit.

Pay Attention to What Burdens Your Heart

Pay attention in life to the things that trouble your spirit.

Pay attention to what burdens your heart. Oral Roberts was moved by sickness because sickness had affected his own family. John G. Lake, the great healing evangelist, watched half of his siblings die before they reached eighteen years old.

His first wife also died from sickness.

Because of that, he hated sickness.

David hated Goliath.

The thing you hate may very well be the clue to the problem God has anointed you to solve.

Can you say, **Amen?**

The following night I was preaching in Philadelphia. Without planning to say it, it suddenly came out of my spirit.

I said,

"Philadelphia is a mess."

Now, when you're preaching in someone else's city, that's not exactly the smartest thing to say.

The whole congregation just stared at me as if to say,

"Then go back where you came from."

But I wasn't insulting the city.

I was expressing how grieved I was by what I had seen. Then I said, "Somebody needs to do something about this."

The moment those words came out of my mouth, I felt the Lord convict me. God never shows you a problem so somebody else can solve it. He shows it to you because He wants **you** to do something about it. Can you say, **Amen?**

Then it came out of my spirit. I said, "I'm going to go preach in downtown Philadelphia." Nobody said "Amen."

People were still upset that I had criticized their city. Then I said, "I'm going to get two speakers and a microphone, and I'm going to preach downtown until somebody arrests me."

After the service, I took my wife back to the hotel and told her to go upstairs while I stayed outside for a few minutes.

I walked around the hotel talking with God.

A Prayer That Changed Everything

I prayed,

"Father, You called me to be an evangelist when I was eight years old."

"If I had one hundred people come to the altar every night, six nights a week, fifty weeks a year—and if fifty of them were first-time decisions for Christ—that would be fifteen thousand people a year."

"That would make a nice Instagram picture." "But in a nation of over 300 million people, it wouldn't make much difference." "But You have the power to change that." I know people say God doesn't care about numbers. But I always find it interesting that He named an entire book of the Bible **Numbers**. So I appealed to Him that way. I continued, "You have the power to let me see as many people saved in one night as it currently takes me an entire year to reach by preaching in churches."

"I can't promote myself."

"My uncle isn't the head of a denomination." "My father isn't the leader of a church organization who can give me a position." "But I have You." "And You said promotion comes from You." "So I'm asking You to give me an opportunity like You gave T. L. Osborn, Jimmy Swaggart, and Billy Graham."

"Give me a chance to reach my generation." "And if You do, I won't make You sorry."

"I won't start preaching strange doctrines." "I won't begin saying foolish things from the platform."

"I'll preach Christ."

"I'll preach the Bible."

"I want to see my generation impacted for Jesus."

You Were Sent to Carry the Fire

I feel that same burden here tonight. Deep down, I believe that's why many of you are here. You didn't come to the United Kingdom to become like the United Kingdom.

You came here to carry the fire of God.

You came to see your generation shaken by the power of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

I finished praying and said,

"It's over to You now, Lord.

In Jesus' Name.

Amen."

The next day, I went back to preach the noon service.

Back then I preached every day at noon and again at 7:00 p.m.

The pastor was seventy-nine years old.

He came running down the center aisle.

Whenever you see a seventy-nine-year-old man running, you know something important has happened.

He said,

"Do you remember what you said last night about preaching downtown until somebody arrested you?"

I thought,

"Unfortunately... yes."

He said,

"A woman from the Philadelphia City Council was watching the service on livestream."

At first I thought,

"Oh great.

They're going to arrest me before I even get started."

But he said,

"No."

"She went to the City Council this morning and told them, 'There's a young preacher in our city who is grieved over the drug problem. He says he's going to preach downtown until we arrest him. Instead of arresting him, maybe we should give him a permit.'"

Then he told me, "The City Council wants you to contact them because they'd like to help you organize an evangelistic crusade in one of the most liberal and godless cities in America."

When that happened, it changed something inside me. Before that day, if someone had asked me whether God hears prayer, I would have answered, "Absolutely."

If they had asked whether God answers prayer, I would have said, "Yes."

But I never expected Him to answer **that fast**. I prayed that prayer around 12:30 in the morning. Within hours, the wheels had already started turning.

In fact, if that woman was already watching the livestream, then what I was praying for was already being set in motion before I even asked.

The Bible says:

Isaiah 65:24 (KJV)

"And it shall come to pass, that before they call, I will answer; and while they are yet speaking, I will hear."

I want to tell every person who's been told that your breakthrough is twenty years away—The wheels are already turning. The angels of the Lord are already working on your behalf. The devil is going to retreat from your life.

The plans of God are going to prevail for you and your family.

In Jesus' Name!

CHAPTER -THREE-

Extraordinary Help

So I went to meet with the City Council. The woman who wanted to meet me belonged to the Nation of Islam. When I realized that, I thought, "This is going to be a very short meeting."

I assumed that as soon as she found out we weren't simply giving away socks, diapers, or bottled water—but that we intended to preach the Gospel and pray for the sick—she would lose interest.

But you'd be amazed whom God uses to help His people. People spend too much time focusing on those who refuse to help them. "My mother never helped me."

"My father is wealthy, but he won't even buy me a car."

Never focus on who refuses to help you. God specializes in using unexpected people through extraordinary means. I see God mobilizing extraordinary help in your direction tonight.

In Jesus' Name.

She invited me into her office. For nearly forty minutes I simply sat there and listened. She talked about the problems in Philadelphia. Then she said,

"You popped up on my YouTube, and I watched you preaching."

Think about that. It wasn't a Christian looking for a sermon. The anointing drew her. She continued,

"We help people with their finances."

"We help them create budgets."

"We provide diapers for single mothers."

"We help people pay their rent."

"But it's not enough."

Immediately the Holy Spirit prompted me, and I replied,

"That's right.

Because what they really need is **a new heart.**"

She looked at me and said,

"Exactly."

I told her,

"That's my assignment.

Only God can change a person's heart."

She answered,

"That's exactly what we need."

I said, "Let's pray."

I simply folded my hands.

As I began praying, she reached over and placed both of her hands between mine.

I thought,

"Well, if you're going to do that, then you're getting a real prayer."

I prayed,

"Father, in the Name of Jesus, may her enemies become Your enemies."

She immediately said,

"Amen."

Everybody likes that prayer.

Even atheists would probably say "Amen" to that one.

Then I prayed,

"Keep her alive and healthy."

That part was a little selfish.

If I had favor with the City Council, I certainly didn't want her dying.

Then I prayed, "Every political enemy trying to remove her from office, deal with them in Jesus' Name."

She said, **"Amen."**

When I finished praying, she stood up, hugged me in the City Council office, and said, "I'm going to help you organize this crusade."

Think about that.

Muslims don't normally help Christians organize Gospel crusades. But the anointing changes everything. I said, **The anointing will mess everything up for the devil.**

When God pours out His oil, everything begins working together for your good.

In Jesus' Name.

She even offered to use the city's voter mailing list to distribute invitations throughout Philadelphia. I didn't argue. I simply watched God work. You would be amazed whom God will use to help you if you'll stop saying things like,

"No one ever helps me."

"I have nobody."

Instead, learn to lift your hands and declare:

Psalm 121:1–2 (KJV)

"I will lift up mine eyes unto the hills, from whence cometh my help.

My help cometh from the LORD, which made heaven and earth."

I tell you again tonight:

Help is on the way.

In Jesus' Name.

Everything was finally set up. Then we started driving to the meeting. As I was driving, I began thinking, *"Who's actually going to show up?"*

I'm not famous. Everything had come together, but I thought nobody was going to come. We left around 4:00 p.m. for a 7:00 p.m. service. While we were driving, people on my staff started sending me pictures. Others began posting on social media.

There were **2,200 people already lined up** waiting to get into the meeting. Then another thought came into my mind. Looking back now, I realize I was full of doubt even though I thought I was full of faith.

I thought,

"Well, they'll enjoy the music."

Anybody can enjoy good praise music.

Whatever religion you belong to, people would enjoy the music we've had here today and tonight.

That drummer is supernatural.

I think he has four arms.

So I thought,

"They're going to enjoy the music."

"But the moment I stand up, open the Bible, and begin preaching, everybody's going to leave."

I was completely wrong.

When I stood up, the Lord gave me exactly what to say.

Before the meeting, we had distributed money for utility bills, diapers, and grocery vouchers.

I asked the crowd,

"How many of you have enjoyed tonight?"

Everybody applauded.

Then I said,

"I'm a pastor.

I'm happy to help people pay their bills.

I'm happy to provide diapers for your children.

I'm happy to help meet practical needs.

But I'd be a poor pastor if all I did was help you on the outside and did nothing for what's happening inside of you."

Then I said,

"Until something changes inside you, nothing will permanently change outside you."

The moment those words came out of my mouth, the Holy Spirit gripped that crowd.

People leaned forward.

The atmosphere changed.

I'm not sharing this testimony just to tell you what happened.

I'm trying to show you something.

There are **two ways** to live.

One is your own way.

Even if you're trying to do the right thing, your own strength makes life difficult.

That's how Ishmael was born.

Abraham tried to fulfill God's promise through human effort.

But there's another way.

You receive God's vision...

Then you wait on the Holy Ghost to bring it to pass.

When you live that way, Jesus' words become reality:

Matthew 11:30 (KJV)

"For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light."

That's why there are two different camps within Christianity.

One group hears faith preachers say,

"His yoke is easy."

"His burden is light."

"God is a God of victory."

And they respond,

"That's nice, but you don't understand my life."

They love God.

They believe the Bible.

But they have never learned what the old-time Pentecostals called **yielding to the Holy Ghost**.

I'm telling you tonight:

God not only has a great plan for your life...

He has a supernatural way to bring you into it.

It won't be your strength accomplishing it.

It will be **the grace of God working mightily through you**.

Receive that grace tonight.

Receive it while I'm preaching.

Receive it when this service ends.

You're not going to accomplish God's plan by might.

You're not going to accomplish it by human power.

Tonight, there is a mighty outpouring of the Holy Spirit to carry you from where you are now into where God has ordained you to be.

If you receive it, let your **Amen** be the loudest!

As I was preaching, an elderly man from Haiti—probably around eighty years old—started walking onto the platform.

I thought,

"This is exactly why we have security."

"I'm finally getting a breakthrough, and this old man wanders onto the stage."

I was in a difficult position. If I ignored him, the crowd would stay distracted. If I rebuked him, everyone would probably turn against me.

While I was trying to decide what to do, he tapped me on the shoulder.

He said,

"I can hear."

I thought,

"Well... so can I."

Then he explained,

"I wear hearing aids.

The sound suddenly became so loud that I took my hearing aid out to turn it down.

When I removed it...

my hearing became even stronger.

Jesus just opened my ears."

His elderly wife stood beside him weeping with joy. The moment he testified in front of that crowd, everything changed. That's what miracles do.

Miracles convince people that this isn't just another excited Christian shouting into a microphone.

Miracles reveal that there is a real Jesus...

Who died on the Cross two thousand years ago...

Who loves people...

And who still demonstrates His power today.

That night I gave the altar call. **Seven hundred and seventy-four people** came forward. Every single one of them was making a first-time decision to follow Christ.

God gave me exactly what I had asked Him for. Then it became even greater. The next night, even more people came.

CHAPTER -FOUR-

Fresh Oil for a Nation

The meetings were held in one of the roughest neighborhoods in America. By Tuesday evening people had started bringing couches out from their apartments. Others carried chairs from their living rooms.

It was chaotic...

But it was glorious.

Every night over **2,000 people** gathered.

The Lord began speaking to me.

He said, "Stop treating America as though everyone already knows the Gospel." "Treat America the way T. L. Osborn treated India." "Treat America the way the early missionaries treated Africa." "A new generation has risen that neither knows the Lord nor remembers His mighty works."

That's why God has us here tonight.

Fresh oil is being released to take the Gospel throughout the United Kingdom with signs and wonders following. I have an announcement tonight.

The devil will not write the final chapter of London.

The devil will not write the final chapter of England.

Nor Wales.

Nor Scotland.

Nor Ireland.

Nor Northern Ireland.

God's people, empowered by the Holy Ghost, will write the final chapter.

And it will be a glorious chapter.

In Jesus' Name.

If you believe that, take thirty seconds and clap your hands. Give God a mighty shout.

Let the devil know he has opposition!

God's Work Never Moves Backward

By Tuesday people had brought furniture from their homes and filled the field.

Every night the crowds kept increasing.

Wednesday night I laid hands on everyone.

Say this Scripture with me:

"He which hath begun a good work in me will perform it."

Philippians 1:6 (KJV)

"Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ."

That's what I preached this morning.

When God gives you a breakthrough, it isn't meant to shrink.

If you'll remain in the flow of the Holy Spirit, it keeps growing.

The Kingdom of God is built upon increase.

Mark 4:28 (KJV)

"...first the blade, then the ear, after that the full corn in the ear."

Wherever you are today, Scripture gives you every reason to expect growth.

God never leaves people where He found them.

His power never stagnates.

From today, you are not going to become smaller.

Today is the smallest you'll ever be.

From tonight forward you will go:

- From glory to glory.
- From victory to victory.
- From strength to strength.

If you believe it, shout,

Amen!

On Tuesday I was driving to the meeting. I prayed, "Lord, this has been incredible. But the meetings end Thursday. What happens after that?

Do I just go back to what I was doing before?

I couldn't have organized this.

You did it.

If You feel I've done well...

Would You give me another opportunity?"

Everybody shout,

"That night!"

I'm not having you say that for no reason.

I'm telling you:

It does not take God long to answer prayer.

He created the world in six days.

He never needs years to help an ordinary person.

Can you say,

Amen?

That evening I parked in a different place than usual.

I always parked somewhere different so nobody would know where my vehicle was.

Standing in that parking place was the seventy-nine-year-old pastor—who had now just turned eighty.

He was originally from Italy.

I got out of my car and said,

"Brother Fina, you don't have to stand out here in this heat.

You've been preaching since you were sixteen years old.

You've served God for more than sixty years.

I'm not going to tell you anything tonight that you don't already know.

Go home and rest."

He looked at me in that deep preacher's voice and said,

"I didn't come to hear you preach.

I came because I have a word from the Lord for you."

He told me he had been driving to pick up his wife from an appointment.

The Holy Spirit instructed him exactly where to go...

And exactly where to stand.

That's the Holy Ghost.

Everything I had prayed in the car...

God answered through that prophetic word.

He said,

"You've done well by pursuing people nobody else wanted.

Because you've gone after the people nobody wanted...

God is now going to begin sending you the people everybody wants."

At that point in my life I had never even met a billionaire.

Today I have relationships with many of them.

God kept His Word.

Because I pursued the broken and forgotten...

God sent people that, naturally speaking, others spend their lives trying to reach.

I declare over you tonight:

The people everyone else is chasing...

Will begin chasing you...

As you faithfully follow God's plan for your life.

If you believe it, give me a living,

Hallelujah!

That night around **five hundred more people** gave their lives to Christ.

By the end of those five nights, **2,576 people** had made first-time decisions for Jesus.

That represented years of ordinary church meetings compressed into just a few days.

After preaching, I walked behind the platform to get some water because I was completely exhausted.

It was nearly **40°C**.

A man wearing a black T-shirt and black trousers suddenly ran toward me.

He threw his arms around me and pointed toward the altar.

"This is wonderful!

This is wonderful!"

I thanked him.

Then I wondered,

"Where is security?"

He introduced himself.

"I'm the mayor of Vineland, New Jersey.

If you'll come to my city and do this, I'll give you any venue you want.

I'll secure every permit you need.

Just promise me you'll come."

When he said,

"Promise,"

he hugged me even tighter.

So I quickly answered,

"I'll come."

One Breakthrough Leads to Another

We went to Vineland.

On the first night alone, **98 people** came to Christ, with more than **4,100 people** in attendance. And the work just kept growing.

I didn't realize something then that I understand now. When God delivers you from the lion and the bear...

He's preparing you for Goliath. Every breakthrough is building confidence for an even greater assignment.

How to Position Yourself for Breakthrough

So what do you do when Heaven's windows are open?

How do you position yourself for breakthrough?

1. Ask for Rain in the Time of Rain

Zechariah 10:1 (KJV)

"Ask ye of the LORD rain in the time of the latter rain..."

Just because it's raining doesn't automatically mean everyone receives the rain. Natural rain falls on everyone. But spiritual rain is received by those who ask. When you sense the favor of God moving...

When you recognize that it's a season of divine momentum...

That's the time to ask boldly. I haven't discussed this with Pastor Poju. But I can guarantee you that's exactly what's happening here.

He has sensed God's momentum. Instead of becoming comfortable with one church in Lagos...

He stepped out in faith.

Look what God has done.

Look around this arena.

God is honoring bold faith.

God is honoring steps of obedience.

Tonight, I want you to ask Him for the very best.

Don't ask God for something you already know how to accomplish.

You don't need faith for what you can do.

Faith is for the impossible.

Tonight is a night when God is releasing the impossible to His sons and daughters.

Ask for rain in the time of rain...

And He will send bright clouds and showers of blessing.

Can you say,

Amen?

So, I'm going to fast-forward a little.

From that time in 2015 until now, that flow has never stopped.

Pastor Poju shared this morning how we met, and I'm telling you—it was supernatural.

I'm not a spooky type of person. I like looking for logical reasons why things happen. But the way Pastor Poju and I met was beyond explanation.

I had landed in Uganda at about 9:10 in the morning. I was scheduled to preach at 10:30, so I barely had enough time to go upstairs, change clothes, and head straight to church.

As I was walking through the hotel lobby, a man I had never met before called out,

"Jonathan Shuttlesworth!"

I turned and said, "Yes?"

He said, "Would you mind if we took a picture together?"

I don't even think he told me he was a pastor.

He's a very humble man.

That's why God is exalting him.

The Bible says that if you humble yourself, God will exalt you.

And let me tell you, as someone who has been around ministry for over forty years, you have one of the most humble, genuine, forthright, and pure leaders in this movement. It ought to be recognized.

I said, "Sure, we can take a picture."

Honestly, I had no idea who he was.

I was exhausted. I was basically sleepwalking through the airport.

Then everything Pastor Poju shared this morning happened.

He posted the picture.

Later, a friend called me and said,

"Oh, I saw you were with Pastor Poju."

I asked, "Who's Pastor Poju?"

He said,

"One of the great pastors in Nigeria."

I replied,

"Man, I wish I had known that when I met him."

Divine Connections

About eight days later, I was scheduled to preach at a pastors' conference in Port Harcourt, Nigeria.

I walked into the meeting, and the preacher speaking before me was the very same man I had met in the hotel lobby.

Even if I had been an atheist, I would have started thinking,

"Wait a minute..."

He preached.

Then I preached.

We greeted one another again.

Then the invitation came for me to minister at WOFBEC in January.

And now, here I am, preaching in England for the very first time.

All because of the flow of the Holy Spirit.

Thank God for education.

I'm not preaching against education.

We don't need more ignorant people—we need fewer.

It's good to know how to read.

It's good to understand grammar.

It's good to know how to study.

But let me tell you something...

The Holy Spirit can do more for you in one week than man can do for you in forty-five years.

You can have every connection the world offers, but without God, you'll struggle.

But when God is for you...

Who can be against you?

I want to tell every person here tonight:

God is for you.

And you're going forward whether the devil likes it or not.

Joy to Houston

Last December, I planned to take most of the month off and simply preach at my church.

While I was enjoying some time at home and wasn't thinking about ministry at all, the Lord spoke to me.

He said,

"I want you to find a place in America with very high childhood poverty. I want you to give those children Christmas from Me."

He said,

"Bring a gift for every child who comes. Give them a quality gift. Tell them, 'Merry Christmas from Jesus,' and then tell them about Me."

We had done outreaches like that before.

Normally, we would have somewhere between 800 and 1,200 people register.

This time...

Within forty-eight hours...

Twenty-five thousand people registered.

Then it became fifty-two thousand.

That's both wonderful...

...and terrifying.

Wonderful because so many people were coming.

Terrifying because my Christmas gift budget jumped from about \$20,000 to \$1.2 million.

And you actually have to get the money.

Because if you tell families in the inner city that every child will receive a Christmas gift—and then you run out of gifts—that'll be the last time anybody ever sees you.

They'll probably find you in a ditch without your shoes.

The Peace That Comes Through Faith

But there's a supernatural peace that accompanies the gift of faith whenever you're flowing with the Holy Spirit.

The man who closed the morning service quoted a wonderful Scripture.

Romans 14:17.

The Kingdom of God is righteousness, peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.

Faith carries peace with it.

Looking naturally, I should have been worried about raising \$1.2 million.

But I wasn't.

I didn't even start calling people.

I simply had peace.

Then a man who has connections in the White House called me.

He said,

"I saw on social media that you're doing an outreach in Houston called *Joy to Houston*."

I said,

"That's right."

He asked,

"How many people have registered?"

I told him.

Then he asked,

"Do you have enough toys?"

I answered,

"Not yet."

He asked,

"When's the event?"

I said,

"Eleven days from now."

Sometimes, when you become too peaceful, other people become concerned for you.

God will actually trouble someone else about the problem you should be worrying about.

He said,

"Let me see what I can do."

Extraordinary Help

An hour later, he called back.

"I found three companies willing to donate toys. They'll sell them to you at a seventy-percent discount."

I thought,

"Wonderful!"

Now the cost had dropped from \$1.2 million to around \$400,000.

That's certainly better than \$1.2 million...

...but it's still a lot of money.

I thought I might have to pull my daughter out of school and send her to work in the coal mines.

Then another hour later, he called again.

This all happened within three hours.

He said,

"Those three companies found out what you're doing with the toys."

"And they decided to give them to you."

Completely free.

When you watch the video later, you'll see we weren't giving away cheap toys.

There were gaming systems...

Go-karts...

Bicycles...

Better toys than I had growing up.

And every one of them was given in the name of Jesus.

The companies said,

"Just pay the truck drivers."

One shipment came from Washington State.

Another from California.

Another from Texas.

The transportation alone would have cost about \$6,000 per truck.

Then the truck drivers learned where the toys were going.

They called and said,

"We'll donate the transportation too."

So we received \$1.2 million worth of toys...

With free delivery.

God Assembles the Army

Then the eighteen-wheelers arrived.

Now somebody had to unload them.

I recorded one short Instagram video.

I don't even have a church in Houston.

I simply said,

"Hi, this is Jonathan Shuttlesworth. We're doing Joy to Houston."

I explained the outreach and said,

"If you'd like to help unload the trucks and prepare gifts for these families, here's where to meet."

Five hundred fifty-four Christians showed up.

God brought the toys.

God provided the transportation.

God assembled the volunteers.

God built the army.

God Builds From Glory to Glory

I'm telling you all of this because it didn't begin in Houston.

It started with believing God in Philadelphia.

Then it moved to Vineland.

Then it moved to Newark.

Each breakthrough became bigger than the last.

For years I prayed,

"Lord, let us see ten thousand people attend an evangelistic crusade in America."

Not a Christian conference.

Lost people.

Real sinners.

The largest crowd we'd ever had before that was about 9,600.

But during that outreach—which you'll see in the video—we finally crossed ten thousand people in attendance.

There was a massive harvest of souls.

Then I invited anyone who wanted prayer to come forward.

I laid hands on person after person.

Many people called their families from nearby apartment complexes, telling them,

"You need to come here right now."

Even more people arrived.

Don't Lower Your Faith

I'm sharing all of this for one reason.

Too many believers in Canada...

The United Kingdom...

And across Europe...

Have lowered their expectations.

They say,

"It doesn't work like that here."

"It's different here."

"No, that kind of breakthrough only happens somewhere else."

But that's simply not true.

God has not changed.

His power has not diminished.

His Spirit still moves.

And breakthrough still belongs to those who believe.

God Is No Respector of Persons

God is no respector of persons.

The Bible says in **Acts 10:34–35**:

"God is no respector of persons: But in every nation he that feareth him, and worketh righteousness, is accepted with him."

You're not supposed to be able to hold crusades like this in America anymore.

They're barely legal.

They're passing many of the same hate-speech laws there that they're passing here.

But let me tell you something.

If you'll ask God to use you in these last days...

If you'll tie your vision to the advancement of His Kingdom...

There will come a tsunami from Heaven.

A tsunami of helpers.

A tsunami of provision.

A tsunami of anointing.

A tsunami of signs and wonders.

A tsunami of supernatural strength.

And I declare that tsunami is sweeping over you tonight in the mighty name of Jesus Christ!

If you receive it, lift your hands and give God your greatest shout one more time!

Let Him know you're a candidate.

Attack the Vision God Has Given You

Before we watch this video of what Jesus did in Houston, Texas, I want to say something to every pastor and every evangelist here in the UK.

When you leave this conference...

Forget where you are.

Forget what the critics have been saying.

Forget everyone who tells you,

"You can't do that here."

"It doesn't work like that here."

"It may work somewhere else, but not here."

Listen carefully.

Maybe it doesn't work for them.

Maybe other people can't do it.

But the rules are going to change for you.

Because when God breathes on your life, even unbelievers will recognize that you belong to Him.

They will stand in awe of what God is doing through you.

Do you believe God can take you from where you are today...

...to where He has called you to be?

This is your time, London.

This is your time, United Kingdom.

This is our time.

In Jesus' Name.

What God Did in Houston

(Video Presentation)

Led by the Holy Spirit, we went into one of the areas of Houston experiencing some of the highest levels of childhood poverty with one simple goal:

To bring joy and hope to families.

When God speaks...

You move quickly.

Revival Today immediately went into action.

Within only seventeen days, the entire outreach came together.

Originally, we planned to reach only a few thousand people.

But the advertising spread rapidly.

More than 20,000 people registered.

Paula White Ministries...

The National Faith Advisory Board...

CityServe...

And several other organizations...

Donated two fully loaded eighteen-wheelers containing more than 22,000 Christmas toys.

I came to tell the devil something in Houston.

Enough is enough.

It's time for the people of Houston to be free.

In the name of Jesus...

The tide is turning in your life today.

No more poverty.

No more struggling for food.

No more struggling for housing.

I'm introducing you to Someone.

His name is El Shaddai—The God who is more than enough.

As the Gospel was preached, tears filled the crowd.

Strongholds were broken.

When the invitation to receive Christ was given...

Hundreds responded.

That night, 10,320 people attended.

Seven hundred and ten people surrendered their lives to Jesus Christ.

This is not the devil's hour in America.

This is America's hour to come to Christ.

Our generation shall be saved!

Say it with me.

"Our generation shall be saved!"

One more time!

"Our generation shall be saved!"

Stop Letting Other People Define Your Future

With the few minutes I have remaining...

I want to ignite something inside of you. Stop letting other people determine what's possible. Stop allowing people to tell you what you can or cannot become. Some people are still living under words spoken over them decades ago.

A teacher told them in second grade,

"You have a learning disability."

They're fifty-one years old...

...and they're still repeating it.

Who said that teacher diagnosed you correctly?

She's not your Creator.

She's not even a physician.

My daughter made High Honors last quarter for the first time.

When she was in first grade, the school called my wife and me in for a meeting.

The teacher said, "Your daughter is struggling with reading."

I answered,

"I noticed.

That's why I brought her to school."

Then she continued explaining the problem. Finally I said, "It's your job to teach her to read.

I'm not homeschooling her.

I'm paying tuition for you to teach her."

Then I asked,

"Have you ever heard of Helen Keller?"

She said,

"Yes."

I said,

"Did you know Helen Keller was blind, deaf, and unable to speak?

Yet Anne Sullivan taught her to read."

Then I looked at the teacher and said,

"I gave you a healthy child who can see, hear, and speak.

I'm not asking you to perform a miracle."

That parent-teacher meeting ended very quickly.

My wife later told me that every future parent-teacher conference began with one question:

"Is your husband coming?"

She'd answer,

"No."

And the teachers would breathe a sigh of relief.

Stop Making Unbiblical Confessions

Who told you what you cannot do?

Why do you make biblical confessions inside church...

...and unbiblical confessions as soon as you leave?

Stop saying things like,

"I'm just a single mother."

"I'm getting older."

"I'm on disability."

Someone once came to me believing God for financial increase.

They said,

"I'm on a fixed income."

I said,

"Then unfix it."

Who fixed it?

Who decided that your income had reached its limit?

Your job is not your source.

Your employer only pays you because the law requires it.

Your paycheck is not your limitation.

God is your Source.

That was Oral Roberts' first principle of Seed-Faith giving:

God is your Source.

I'm around preachers all the time.

Even many faith preachers.

Sometimes, if you listened to the way they talk, you'd think there wasn't a God.

"We're short on partners."

"Offerings are down."

"The economy is bad."

"People aren't giving."

On and on they go...

Talking about things the Bible never says.

I pray today that you become so saturated with God's Word...

...that something rises inside you and declares:

"I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me."

CHAPTER -FIVE-

I'd Rather Go Broke Believing God

When we were preparing *Joy to Houston*, here's what I thought. If the money doesn't come... I'd rather go broke attempting something great for God...

...than play it safe for sixty years...

Retire at eighty-five... Sit on a porch somewhere... Watch the sunset...

And wonder...

"What would have happened if I had really believed God?"

I didn't have enough money to hold that first Philadelphia crusade. In fact...

The cost of that crusade equaled everything our ministry received the previous year. Naturally speaking...

It should have bankrupted us. But that's why my first point is so important.

Ask for Rain

How do you engage a season of breakthrough?

Number one: Ask.

Ask God for something that would be impossible without Him.

What Kingdom desire has God placed in your heart?

Are you simply watching society collapse while saying,

"Isn't it terrible what's happening?"

I decided in America that I wasn't going to spend my life complaining.

I'm not going to say,

"It's awful that people are dying from drugs."

"The politicians are ruining the country."

"The government never fixes anything."

No.

If God placed me on this earth...

Then He placed me here for such a time as this.

And if God truly is who He says He is—The One who declares,

"I am the LORD, and there is none like Me."

The One who asks,

"Is any thing too hard for the LORD?"

Then why would I limit Him?

If God never intended for you to attempt great things...

He filled the Bible with some very misleading promises.

But God is not a man that He should lie.

Neither is He the son of man that He should repent.

Whatever He has spoken...

He is able to perform.

Whatever He has promised...

He will bring to pass.

Today...

The gift of faith is coming alive inside you.

It is being released in this breakthrough service.

I'm looking at a room full of people who have already done well.

But you're about to do even better.

Because the wind of Heaven—The gift of faith—Is filling your sails.

And you're crossing over to the other side.

In Jesus' mighty Name.

Let me ask you a question. What are you asking God for?

What Kingdom purpose does it serve?

I flew here on my own aircraft. I've been operating private aircraft since 2020.

Do you know something?

I never prayed for a jet.

I never confessed,

"I receive a jet."

A jet simply became necessary for the assignment God gave me.

When the need appeared...

God supplied it.

I was preaching somewhere for the first time.

I didn't know anyone there.

At the end of the service, a man walked up to me and said,

"I enjoyed your preaching tonight."

"I'm purchasing a Falcon 50 aircraft."

"It will take about two years to prepare it."

"When it's ready...

I'm giving it to you."

Honestly...

It sounded crazy.

Every church has a few unusual people.

My grandfather pastored for sixty years.

He used to call them "granola Christians."

Fruits...

Flakes...

And nuts.

Sometimes people become emotional and promise things they have no ability to do.

So I simply smiled.

I didn't even take his name or phone number.

About eighteen months later, Patrick—the man who oversees our ministry finances—came to me and asked,

"Do you remember that man who said he was giving you an airplane?"

I said,

"Vaguely."

He replied,

"It's going to be ready in six months."

"He wants to know where you're going to park it."

I didn't even know airplanes needed parking spaces.

I thought maybe I'd leave it behind a Tesco somewhere and just pay the parking tickets.

So we arranged a hangar.

The day arrived.

The aircraft taxied around the corner like someone returning a rental car.

The man stepped out and introduced two pilots.

He said,

"These are your pilots."

"They'll fly you wherever God sends you."

"Just pay for the fuel."

Fuel isn't cheap.

It costs about \$31,000 (USD) to fill the tanks.

But do you know what happened?

The very day the airplane arrived...

Two checks came in the mail.

One was for \$100,000 from Texas.

In the memo line it simply said,

"For fuel."

The second was for \$150,000 from New Mexico.

Also marked,

"For fuel."

Before the need ever arose...

The provision was already waiting.

That's how God works.

So let me ask you again...

Are you simply asking God to make your business bigger?

To make your ministry larger?

Or are you asking Him for something that advances His Kingdom?

Because that's exactly what Pastor Poju preached on last night.

And that's the key to everything.

Tie Your Dream to God's Dream

Instead of asking God to bless the thing you want to do, look in the Bible and discover what God wants done on the earth.

I'll tell you what He wants.

He delights in churches being built. He delights in evangelistic crusades. He delights in people being saved. He delights in people being delivered. He delights in people being healed.

If you'll tie your dream to God's dream, you'll never have to keep praying only personal prayer requests. You'll live with the windows of heaven open over your life from this day forward, in Jesus' name.

If you believe it, can you say, "Amen?"

Amen!

Provision Follows Obedience

I planned on starting no new churches this year because we had already planted four churches in two years. For me, that was enough. In fact, it was four more than I originally wanted.

Then I felt the Lord speak to me about starting a church in Toronto, so I announced it.

Not long afterward, a church in Texas came up for sale. They contacted us and said, "If you want this building, we'll sell it to you for half price. We've been watching you on YouTube, and we want this building to remain a church."

I felt the Lord tell me to take it.

The following week, as we were preparing for those two churches, Jesse Duplantis came to preach at our church. He has ministered there before, but he had never done this.

He said, "The Lord told me to bring something for you."

Then he handed me a check for **\$500,000**.

The very next day, we received another call. We have a church in Arizona that was meeting in a rented facility. A realtor informed us that a church in Phoenix wanted to sell us their property for half price. The only requirement was a **\$500,000** down payment.

Before the need ever arose, the provision was already waiting.

God Supplies Before the Need Appears

I prophesy in the name of Jesus:

You will never live from behind again.

From this day forward, you will live ahead.

Deuteronomy 28 says that God will fill your storehouses with grain. That means provision exists before the need ever arrives.

You're not serving a God who gives you one sip, waits until you've finished it, and then gives you another.

No.

He anoints your head with oil, and your cup runs over.

I said, **your cup runs over.**

From today, you and your family will live with an overflowing cup in Jesus' name.

If you receive that, give God your loudest handclap and your loudest shout!

Number Two: Stop Using Defeatist Language

I heard a preacher recently, and I'm actually glad I did because it stirred something in me. It ended up producing the best summer our ministry has ever had—and summer isn't even over yet.

This preacher appeared on my Instagram feed.

He should have known better. His father was friends with my grandfather.

On June 1st he posted:

"Partners and friends, every summer is the hardest and driest season for our ministry. If you could sow a seed, it would really help."

Nobody wants to sow into depression.

If I had been preparing to give, that message would have stopped me.

That kind of speech doesn't inspire faith.

Then he repeated:

"Summer is always the worst time of year for our ministry."

Let me tell you something.

If the last thirty-four summers had truly been the worst seasons of my ministry, I would not drag that confession into 2026.

I'd pray differently.

I'd say:

"God, the last thirty-five summers have been difficult, but today I believe You for a turnaround in Jesus' name."

I guarantee there are many Christians who have unknowingly become accustomed to cycles.

Things never change.

Nothing improves.

Everything stays the same.

Eventually, those experiences begin shaping their confession.

People start speaking according to what has happened instead of according to what God has said.

But tonight something is being ignited inside you.

You're going to begin speaking the Word of God.

Instead of saying what you see, you'll declare what the Bible says.

And what the Bible says will become what you see.

Stop talking about how difficult life is.

Start declaring:

"I'm going to make it."

The battle is not mine.

The battle belongs to the Lord.

I'm going over in Jesus' name.

Expect a Miracle

Don't use defeatist language.

Don't expect bad things.

Expect a miracle.

Everybody shout:

"Expect a miracle!"

What does it actually mean to expect a miracle?

My daughter has been traveling with me these last two weeks. As I loaded our suitcases into the car, she had two bags. One was heavy. I lifted it into the trunk. Then I picked up the second suitcase and almost threw it over my head because it was so light.

I asked,

"Camila, what's in this suitcase?"

She smiled and said,

"Nothing."

I asked,

"Then why are you bringing it?"

She replied,

"For whatever you decide to buy me."

I pray that **Camila's spirit of expectation** comes upon you.

May you begin showing up before God with an empty suitcase. May you start expecting that good things are coming your way.

The Bible says:

"Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life..." (*Psalms 23:6, KJV*).

I came to tell you tonight:

The last defeat you experienced will be the last defeat you ever see. God isn't going to give you just one victory. He's about to bulldoze every plan of the devil concerning your life. You're going over in Jesus' name.

You're not getting sicker—you are being healed right now. The healing power of God is strengthening your body. God is opening doors that no man can shut. Get ready for everything to turn around for your good, in Jesus' mighty name.

Number Three: Don't Limit God by Your Resources

Don't miss your promotion by planning only according to what you're able to do. God told David not to number the people. Jesus preached while Judas carried the money bag. Why?

I heard Bishop David Oyedepo say something about fifteen years ago that I've never forgotten. He said:

"Jesus had Judas carry the money bag because you can't preach and hold the bag."

You cannot constantly look at what you have and still walk by faith. No crusade makes financial sense. Reaching the lost rarely makes budget sense.

If you make every decision based on what's currently in your account, you'll miss what God wants to do.

Your true resources are not what's sitting in your bank account. The Bible says your treasure is kept in heaven, where neither moth nor rust corrupts. God releases what you need when you need it.

Can you say, "Amen?"

You may think you don't have enough.

But if you'll step out with what you have, God will turn what you have into more than enough.

I declare that will become your testimony in Jesus' name.

Amen!

Number Four: Use "God Is With Me" Language

Romans 8:31 says:

"If God be for us, who can be against us?"

Stop talking about what the devil is doing.

Start talking about what God is doing.

Fill your mouth with testimonies of God's help.

There are believers who spend more time talking about demons than they do talking about angels.

If they focused on God's heavenly help as much as they focused on demonic activity, the world would already be won to Christ.

The Bible doesn't say demons are assigned to follow you.

It says God gives His angels charge over you.

Think about it.

How would someone like me—a white man from Pennsylvania—and Pastor Poju, a Nigerian pastor, ever meet?

I'd never been to England.

He was from Nigeria.

Yet God orchestrated every connection.

His angels were arranging what no human being could arrange.

God's angels are opening doors.

They're moving things into place.

So stop talking about what's against you.

Start celebrating that God is for you.

And if God is for you, your tomorrow is going to be all right.

Number Five: Travel With an Empty Suitcase

Expect a miracle.

Travel with an empty suitcase.

Let me tell you something.

God did exactly what my daughter expected.

When she packed that empty suitcase, I later used it as an illustration while preaching in Eastern Europe.

The country where we ministered had an average annual income of about **\$13,000 USD**.

After I shared that story, people began walking forward.

One person handed me **€1,000**.

Another gave **€2,000**.

They said,

"This is to fill your daughter's suitcase."

I eventually lost track of how much people gave.

After that meeting, we traveled through Milan before coming here.

I took my daughter to Louis Vuitton.

I bought her so much that people in the store couldn't stop staring. I'm telling you something tonight. We do not serve a lesser god. We serve **El Shaddai**—the God of more than enough.

God's people should be the most blessed people on the earth. So hear me one final time tonight: Get ready for the best six months you've ever experienced.

From July through December, I declare this shall be your season of miracles in Jesus' name.

Praise in Advance

Expect a miracle.

Stay on your feet.

Give God praise.

That's exactly what we're going to do tonight.

We're going to praise Him in advance.

You don't wait until the battle is over before you shout.

You shout before the victory appears.

The Israelites didn't wait until Jericho's walls fell.

They shouted first.

Then the walls collapsed.

The Bible says that at the very moment they began to sing and praise the Lord, He set ambushes against their enemies.

Praise warfare works.

That's why we talked about it this afternoon.

Whether it's Canada...

Dead churches in America...

Or spiritually dry churches across Europe...

They all have one thing in common.

When praise disappears, spiritual life disappears.

Many churches begin with slow, lifeless songs.

Sometimes it sounds like they're holding a funeral for Jesus.

The devil hates praise.

But tonight, in the United Kingdom, we're bringing back the kind of praise that brought down the walls of Jericho.

The people of God are going to shout.

We're going to sing.

We're going to remind the devil that he lost two thousand years ago.

He cannot stop what God is doing.

God is on our side.

Prayer Sets Angels in Motion—Praise Brings God Near

Say this with me:

"Angels attend to my prayers, but God Himself steps into my praise."

That's right.

When you pray, things begin to move.

Daniel 10 shows us that an angel was dispatched the moment Daniel prayed.

But when you praise...

Psalm 22:3 tells us that God inhabits the praises of His people.

Have you ever considered that many of the attacks you've faced were simply attempts to silence your praise?

The enemy wants you talking about how hard life is.

How difficult the season has become.

How nothing ever changes.

How faith doesn't seem to work anymore.

Make up your mind tonight.

Devil, you've already thrown your best punch.

And it still isn't enough to stop me from praising God.

Tonight, hell is going to hear a sound coming from London that it hasn't heard in a long time.

Thousands of God's people lifting holy hands.

Without wrath. Without doubting. Declaring His praise.

And when that praise breaks loose...

Every obstacle...

Every barricade...

Every force standing against your blessing...

Will be bulldozed by the power of Almighty God.

If you receive it, shout, "Amen!"

Let Everything That Has Breath Praise the Lord

Every hand lifted to the Lord.

(The worship team prepares to lead.)

I don't want the slowest song. Give me the fastest song you know. Give me something born out of Nigeria. Something full of praise. Something that frustrates the kingdom of darkness.

Remember this:

This is not noise.

This produces victory. At the very moment God's people praised, He caused their enemies to turn against one another. Did you know you can win battles without fighting?

You win by refusing to let someone else praise God on your behalf.

The Bible says:

"Let every thing that hath breath praise the Lord." (*Psalms 150:6, KJV*).

Before we finish, let's read Psalm 150 together.

Praise ye the LORD. Praise God in his sanctuary: praise him in the firmament of his power. Praise him for his mighty acts: praise him according to his excellent greatness. Praise him with the sound of the trumpet: praise him with the psaltery and harp. Praise him with the timbrel and dance. Praise him with stringed instruments and organs. Praise him upon the loud cymbals: praise him upon the high sounding cymbals. Let every thing that

hath breath praise the LORD. Praise ye the LORD. (*Psalm 150:1–6, KJV*).

Notice that dancing is in the Bible.

The same Bible that says, "*Thou shalt not commit adultery*" also says:

"Praise him with the dance."

Praise belongs to every believer.

Now...

Are you ready?

Let's praise the Lord!
