Introduction

Isaiah 9:6–7 (KJV)

"For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.

Of the increase of his government and peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this."

There are two major things we will do today.

One is national, which by implication also becomes global. The other is individual. I pray that the Lord will help us, so I want you to follow very carefully. There is a nation that has been plagued with darkness, yet there is a divine promise that light will arise upon her. We have already heard that light is coming.

How many of you heard that?

Even though there has been a delay, there is a reason for that delay. Today, I will present a prophetic parable, and may the Lord grant you understanding. For the purpose of this parable, Nigeria will be referred to as **the nation of Pelton**. Whenever that name is mentioned, you already know what it represents.

The Child Who Would Change Government

The One responsible for bringing that light was clearly introduced in Scripture:

"Unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given..." (Isaiah 9:6, KJV)

As you continue reading the passage, you discover that He came to initiate an overthrow. He came to establish a new government. One of the ways He accomplished this was by becoming a child born into the world. This is the One whom the prophet called **Immanuel**—"God with us."

He was born, and He dwelt among us. As John wrote:

"And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us..." (John 1:14, KJV)

That was not an easy process. The reason we cannot treat God's plan for the salvation of Nigeria lightly is because Heaven made enormous provisions for it. God Himself paid an immeasurable price. The writer of Hebrews asks:

"How shall we escape, if we neglect so great salvation...?" (Hebrews 2:3, KJV)

Think about what it required. God laid aside His divine privileges to become a man.

The First Adam and the Last Adam

The first man was created in the image and likeness of God.

"So God created man in his own image..." (Genesis 1:27, KJV)

When you read **1 Corinthians 15:45**, Scripture introduces both the first Adam and the last Adam.

The first Adam was **man in the likeness of God**.

The last Adam was **God in the likeness of man**.

That is why, after Paul ministered powerfully among certain people, they exclaimed:

"The gods have come down to us in the likeness of men."

That was the highest language they possessed. They did not know the true God, so they described what they witnessed using the vocabulary available to them. God's expectation is that whenever one of His sons enters a place, it should be as though God Himself has entered that place in human form.

Why Does Darkness Still Remain?

If we possess such tremendous spiritual resources, why does darkness still prevail?

That is the burden we want to address tonight. Why has darkness lasted this long?

Many sincere believers have questions before God. Why have we prayed for so many years, yet it appears God has not answered?

Why do we have prayer gatherings everywhere?

Why do we have pockets of revival?

Why do we have committed men and women of prayer, yet it seems our problems continue?

Some of you have wrestled with these questions. Why is Nigeria still not free?

If we have genuine intercessors, why has she not been delivered from the grip of darkness?

If you are honest, these questions have crossed your mind. Why have we not produced a priesthood powerful enough to dismantle the works of darkness?

Why are we still mourning children who are killed daily?

Why has God not intervened?

Has God stopped hearing our prayers?

These are the burdens carried by every genuine intercessor.

Understanding the Three Priesthoods

To make matters even more sobering, the priesthood behind the darkness is actually the weakest of the three priesthoods revealed in Scripture.

There is:

- The priesthood of Satan.
- The priesthood of Aaron.
- The priesthood of Christ.

It is the priesthood of Satan that energizes every manifestation of darkness. Yet the astonishing truth is that Satan's priesthood is inferior even to the priesthood of Aaron.

Think about what that means.

A faithful Jew under the Mosaic covenant did not possess the indwelling Holy Spirit as believers do today. He did not speak in tongues.

Yet, by remaining faithful to the covenant God gave Israel, enchantments could not prevail against him. That should provoke serious reflection.

Today, believers possess the Holy Spirit, yet many still find themselves oppressed by darkness. Something is wrong.

Mordecai and the Testimony of the Enemy

Consider the account of Mordecai. He was simply a faithful Jew living under the priesthood of Aaron. He did not speak in tongues. He had not experienced the New Birth as we know it today. Yet when Haman consulted those around him, they answered:

"...If Mordecai be of the seed of the Jews... thou shalt not prevail against him, but shalt surely fall before him." (Esther 6:13, KJV)

Notice what they did not say. They did not ask whether he belonged to a particular denomination. They did not ask whether he spoke in tongues. They simply asked:

"Is he a Jew?"

Their conclusion was immediate: "If he truly belongs to the Jews, you will certainly fall."

Even witches understood the covenant covering over Israel. If the kingdom of darkness could testify concerning the covenant strength of an Old Testament believer, why should darkness continue reigning where people carry the Holy Spirit?

Something is fundamentally wrong.

There Is No Enchantment Against Israel

The Bible declares:

"Surely there is no enchantment against Jacob, neither is there any divination against Israel..." (Numbers 23:23, KJV)

Those who remained faithful under Aaron's priesthood enjoyed supernatural protection. Enchantment could not overcome them. Divination could not prevail against them.

If that was true under the Old Covenant, how much more should it be true for believers who carry Christ Himself within them?

Perhaps we need to understand more deeply the One who lives inside us.

The Three Revelations of Christ

When you study Scripture carefully, you discover three major revelations of Jesus Christ.

- The pre-incarnate Christ.
- The incarnate Christ.
- The glorified Christ.

Paul writes:

"...Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God." (Philippians 2:6, KJV)

Before His incarnation, He possessed all the fullness of deity. Yet He willingly laid aside those privileges in order to accomplish redemption. As Jesus prayed toward the close of His earthly ministry, He asked the Father:

"And now, O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was." (John 17:5, KJV)

That was the glory of the pre-incarnate Christ. He laid it aside because He came to save humanity. He came to save Nigeria. He came to save Africa. He came to save the nations of the earth.

The Humility of the Son of God

Because of that mission, Satan could stand before Him in the wilderness and say:

"If thou be the Son of God..." (Luke 4:3, KJV)

Ordinarily, such a conversation would have been impossible. But because humanity needed redemption, the Son willingly accepted human limitations.

- He could be mocked.
- He could be slapped.
- He could be spat upon.

People challenged Him:

"If thou be a prophet, tell us who smote thee."

The eternal Creator accepted the limitations of time and space.

- He walked from city to city.
- He endured rejection.
- He endured suffering.

All because there was a people living in darkness who needed salvation.

The Glorified Christ

Yet Scripture does not end with the suffering Christ. Hebrews reveals His exaltation.

Paul declares:

"Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name." (Philippians 2:9, KJV)

This is the Christ who now lives within every believer. John experienced this revelation on the island of Patmos. When he heard the voice behind him and turned to see who spoke, he encountered not merely the Jesus he had walked with on earth, but the glorified Christ.

The same disciple who had once leaned upon Jesus' breast now fell at His feet as though dead. Believers must renew their understanding of who Jesus is today. He is no longer merely the incarnate Christ who walked the roads of Galilee.

He is the glorified Lord, exalted above every principality, every power, and every name that can be named.

He is no longer the Jesus they slapped.

He is no longer the One they mocked.

Is this glorified Jesus unable to make cancer disappear?

Tonight, I declare boldly that there is no infirmity, no disease, no sickness, no affliction, and no ancestral curse that will stand before the glorified Christ.

Everything must bow before Him tonight. All we need to do is expose Him to the situation. John encountered the glorified Christ and fell as one dead. Jesus had to touch him before he could stand again. For Christ to enter the womb of a woman, there had to be a divine "step-down."

Just as electricity is stepped down before it enters a home, Heaven stepped down His glory so He could fit into human flesh.

That step-down happened because of you. I am saying all of this to provoke your faith tonight. I want you to understand why the destiny of our nation cannot remain in the hands of her oppressors. Everything Christ passed through was for the emancipation of nations. Why then are we still living in darkness?

The Power of the Exalted Christ

When Jesus walked the earth in His incarnate state, He travelled on foot. After His resurrection and glorification, the disciples locked themselves inside a room out of fear.

Yet Jesus simply walked through the wall and stood in their midst. When travelling becomes difficult, who says Jesus cannot take a man from here to Germany and bring him back without a visa or an airplane ticket?

He can send His servants anywhere He desires. The prophets experienced such realities. I know of a man of God in Brazil whom God supernaturally transported to Colombia.

He did not travel by airplane. He arrived physically in a family's home while they were having breakfast. He sat with them. He ate with them.

Then God returned him to Brazil. When he arrived back, pieces of the bread were still in his mouth.

This was not a dream. It was not a vision. It was not a trance.

His physical body went and returned.

Today, he pastors one of the largest churches in Colombia because God first showed him the land He intended to give him.

If Evil Spirits Can Produce Results...

Even demons understand the mystery of indwelling. Remember the young woman in Acts who followed Paul, declaring:

"These men are the servants of the most high God, which shew unto us the way of salvation." (Acts 16:17, KJV)

Paul eventually discerned that an evil spirit was speaking through her and cast it out. Immediately, her owners became angry because that spirit had been their source of financial gain.

If an evil spirit could produce such results...

How much more the Holy Ghost living inside a believer?

The One who dwells in you created galaxies. The One who lives in you created worlds beyond human imagination. Poverty has no business defining your life.

You will not die poor. After tonight, there shall be a dramatic turnaround in families, businesses, ministries, communities, and nations.

Christ Lives in You

This Jesus who owns Heaven and earth...

The One who owns the galaxies...

The One whose streets are paved with gold...

Lives inside you. This is not religious language. It is reality.

If you expose Him to cancer, cancer must wither. If you expose Him to infirmity, infirmity must lose its grip. Do you hear what I am saying?

The Last Adam

Help me say, "**The Last Adam.**"

There is a reason Scripture calls Him the Last Adam. Imagine buying an iPhone today. Before long another version is released. If Jesus were called the second Adam, perhaps we would still be waiting for a third, a fourth, or a fifth.

But He is not the second Adam. He is the **Last Adam**. He is God's final and perfect revelation. There will never be another version after Him. When you have Christ, you possess the fullness of God. You carry God's final expression.

The best version.

Who, then, is cancer?

Who is poverty?

Who is disease?

Who is infirmity?

Nothing better than Christ will ever come.

Sometimes people say,

"The best of God is yet to come."

I respectfully disagree.

The best of God has already come.

His name is Jesus Christ.

And He lives inside you.

Jesus Lives

Jesus lives. He lives in you. He lives in me. No more sorrow. No more cancer. No more sickness. No more diabetes. No more stroke. I do not care what diagnosis you received. I do not care what the hospital called it.

I do not care what spirit is behind it.

Jesus lives.

Because He lives, everything must bow.

Because He lives...

You can face tomorrow. If the enemy planned for you to die before your time, what a disappointment awaits him.

You shall live long.

You shall fulfill your days.

You shall accomplish your assignment.

The Last Adam cannot be improved upon.

The experiences of Old Testament prophets pointed toward Him.

He is the fulfillment.

Let Christ Alone Be Seen

John the Baptist said, "He must increase, but I must decrease." (John 3:30, KJV)

But under the New Covenant, our experience goes even deeper. It is no longer merely decreasing.

It is disappearing so that Christ alone is seen. Even one percent of self can become dangerous. The New Testament equation is this: Disappear...

That Christ may fully appear. That is why Paul declared:

"I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me..." (Galatians 2:20, KJV)

I have been removed from the equation. He is now the One living through me. The Last Adam is God revealed in the likeness of man. People may see a human being...

But the One at work is God Himself. Today He will destroy the projects of hell.

Christ Holds the Keys

The devil cannot kill anyone apart from what God permits. If Satan truly possessed ultimate authority over death, everyone who died in a nightmare would never wake up.

Jesus declared:

"I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death." (Revelation 1:18, KJV)

Notice whose hands hold the keys. The One who loves you. The One who died for you. Hebrews confirms this truth:

"...that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil." (Hebrews 2:14, KJV)

The devil **had** that authority. The word "had" is in the past tense. He no longer possesses it. Christ does. The enemy now operates primarily through fear. Fear opens doors to torment. But Christ has already won the victory.

The Lion Who Became the Lamb

The journey of Christ was both downward and upward. He descended. Then He ascended. As Scripture declares:

"Wherefore he saith, When he ascended up on high, he led captivity captive, and gave gifts unto men." (Ephesians 4:8, KJV)

When He descended into the realm of death, hell celebrated. They thought they had destroyed Him. They rejoiced because they believed the One who troubled them was gone. But they did not understand the wisdom of God. As Scripture says:

"...for had they known it, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory." (1 Corinthians 2:8, KJV)

The Cross looked like defeat. It was actually Heaven's greatest victory. Jesus had walked the earth healing the oppressed and destroying the works of the devil. Hell thought killing Him would end the threat. Instead, His death produced an innumerable company of sons and daughters. He was no longer alone. Now there are believers everywhere carrying His life.

Saviours shall arise.

The Lord Mighty in Battle

When Christ approached the gates of victory, Heaven announced:

"Lift up your heads, O ye gates... and be ye lift up, ye everlasting doors..."
(Psalm 24:7, KJV)

The response came:

"Who is this King of glory?"

The answer thundered back:

"The LORD strong and mighty, the LORD mighty in battle." (Psalm 24:8, KJV)

One of His delights is to fight for His people. Why would you have the Lord of Hosts and refuse to engage spiritual warfare?

Fight the good fight of faith. Stand your ground. Invite the Lord of battles into every situation. He delights to triumph.

Worthy to Open the Sealed Book

When Christ reached the throne of God, He took the sealed scroll. No one else in Heaven, on earth, or beneath the earth was worthy. Yet He alone opened its seals.

If Jesus could approach the highest throne in existence and open what no one else could open...

Then every throne opposing your destiny must bow before Him.

Every ancestral throne.

Every satanic altar.

Every demonic manipulation.

Every sealed destiny.

Every sealed ministry.

Every delayed ordination.

Tonight, in the name of Jesus Christ, let every sealed thing be opened.

Amen.

Everything I have shared so far has been by way of introduction, showing you what Jesus Christ accomplished to procure our salvation.

The writer of Hebrews asks:

"How shall we escape, if we neglect so great salvation...?" (*Hebrews 2:3, KJV*)

Think about it.

If someone neglects such a great salvation, what should be the consequence?

Sometimes we spend our energy debating questions that reveal how little we appreciate the price Christ paid.

We argue endlessly over matters while failing to grasp the weight of redemption.

Meanwhile, Heaven is looking for people through whom His purposes can be established upon the earth.

The Foundation of National Deliverance

I have introduced you to the economy of salvation. This is the foundation of everything we shall do tonight. Jesus made it possible for individuals to live in freedom. By extension, He also made it possible for territories and nations to be delivered.

Christ died for every tribe. He died for every nation. He paid the price so that those who sat in darkness could walk in light. What we have established is simple:

The emancipation of Nigeria is possible. Now that we agree on this truth, let us move to the second part of the message.

The Prophetic Parable of the Handshake

Earlier, Dr. raised a very serious matter. He spoke about a **handshake** between the nation of Pelton and Turkey. Remember, we are speaking in prophetic parables. The handshake represents an alliance.

To understand the danger of the alliance, we must first understand the history of the one extending the hand. There was once a nation that was entirely Christian. Today, that same nation has become deeply immersed in another religious system. The purpose of the handshake is to reproduce that same condition. That is why we must pay attention. Yet there is already a prophetic word concerning Pelton. God has spoken. However, the enemy is not passive.

Jehoshaphat's Alliance

Let us examine the Scriptures. **2 Chronicles 18:1 (NLT)** tells us:

*"Jehoshaphat enjoyed great riches and high esteem, and he made an **alliance** with Ahab of Israel by having his son marry Ahab's daughter."*

Notice the word: **Alliance**.

At this point in Israel's history, the kingdom had already been divided. Judah was ruled by Jehoshaphat, a righteous king who still acknowledged the government of God.

Israel, however, had come under the influence of Baal worship through Ahab and Jezebel. Jezebel brought foreign worship into the nation.

She did not merely marry into Israel.

She imported an entire religious system. Gradually, what had once been secondary became dominant. That is the strategy of darkness. It enters quietly. Before long, it occupies positions of influence.

The Purpose of the Handshake

The alliance was designed to bring Judah into the same spiritual condition as Israel. Its purpose was not merely political. Its goal was spiritual corruption. What eventually became the condition of Judah?

The worship of Baal. That was the outcome. The consequences become even clearer in **2 Kings 11:1–2**.

Athaliah, after the death of her son, attempted to destroy the entire royal family. The nation drifted further into idolatry.

Later, **2 Chronicles 24:7** confirms that the house of God itself suffered because of Baal worship.

That was the fruit of one alliance.

A Prophetic Responsibility

If this prophetic parable speaks concerning our nation, then we cannot end this gathering without releasing prophetic direction. Remnant Christian Network is not merely a teaching ministry. It is an apostolic and prophetic ministry. God has blessed us with sound doctrine. He has blessed us with faithful teachers. That is necessary. But we also need prophetic direction for nations.

There are prophecies that concern individuals. There are also prophecies that concern territories. Both are important.

The Counsel of God

One day, while Prophet Arome was ministering, the Lord opened my eyes. A statement was made that has remained with me:

You must be in the council of God to receive the counsel of God.

By God's mercy, I was privileged to behold something concerning the future. The Lord showed me that there was already an announcement concerning the next president.

Again, remember that I am speaking in prophetic parables. He also showed me that something could still be done. Even where judgment has been announced, God is still able to demonstrate mercy. That means there remains an opportunity for the Church to respond correctly.

Introducing Abimelech

Let us consider **Judges 9**.

Abimelech provides a prophetic picture. Scripture tells us that he went to his mother's relatives and appealed to them. He said:

"...Remember also that I am your bone and your flesh." (Judges 9:2, KJV)

Notice what his campaign was built upon. Not competence.

Not qualification.

Not proven leadership.

His appeal was based upon tribal identity.

"I am one of you."

That was enough.

Tribalism Cannot Build God's Kingdom

In Christ, there is neither Jew nor Greek. There is neither bond nor free. We are one in Christ Jesus. How then did we arrive at a place where believers openly support leaders primarily because they belong to the same tribe?

Where did we learn that?

The question should never be: "Is he my tribesman?"

The question should always be: "Is he qualified?"

"Does he possess the character and capacity required?"

Abimelech succeeded because people chose tribal loyalty above righteous judgment. That remains a danger in every generation.

A Warning to the Church

I am not merely speaking to the nation. I am speaking to the Church. If the Church gets this wrong, the nation will get it wrong. Why should tribalism find a home inside the Body of Christ?

How can our priesthood remain powerful if our decisions are governed by tribal sentiment rather than the mind of God?

This is one reason our spiritual authority has weakened. Instead of producing a priesthood capable of transforming nations, we have often allowed earthly loyalties to replace Kingdom priorities. Yet this prophetic handshake shall be dismantled.

The Spirit Behind Abimelech

Abimelech's campaign was driven by identity rather than righteousness. His relatives promoted him because he belonged to them. Not because he was the best man.

Scripture says the people chose him because he was their relative. Not because he possessed wisdom. Not because he demonstrated integrity. Not because he had the fear of God. Simply because he was "their own."

This is a warning for every generation.

Money from the Temple of Baal

The next verse reveals something even more troubling.

"And they gave him threescore and ten pieces of silver out of the house of Baal-berith, wherewith Abimelech hired vain and light persons, which followed him." (Judges 9:4, KJV)

The resources used to advance his agenda came from the temple of Baal. With those resources he gathered reckless men around himself. That should concern us.

Because the same spirit still seeks influence today. It attempts to finance unrighteousness. It attempts to purchase influence. It attempts to silence prophetic voices.

A Call to Preserve the Integrity of the Priesthood

My concern is this: When resources that originate from corrupt altars find their way into the Church, the priesthood loses its spiritual authority.

The moment the priesthood becomes compromised, its voice loses weight. Then, when evil increases, its rebuke carries little authority.

The Church must guard the integrity of its altar. The Church must guard the integrity of its priesthood. If compromise has entered, repentance must come quickly. That is one reason our voices have not carried the weight they ought to carry.

We cannot confront Baal while carrying Baal's gifts. Am I beginning to answer our questions?

Why does it seem our prayers no longer carry the same weight?

Why do our voices appear to have lost their potency?

One reason is that many have accepted the treasures of Baal. When those gifts are received, a covenant is made. You sign your brother's death. Then, when innocent blood is shed, you no longer possess the moral authority to cry out, because you participated in the transaction.

You entered into a handshake.

The Price of Blood

I know of a minister who received five hundred million naira. He celebrated it as a breakthrough. He used it to build a church building. But when you receive resources that originate from corrupt altars, Scripture calls them **the price of blood**.

When Judas returned the thirty pieces of silver, the religious leaders refused to place the money back into the treasury because it was the price of blood. Instead, they purchased a field, and it became known as **the Field of Blood**.

You may be wearing an expensive suit...

Yet be clothed with blood. The money used to purchase it may already have been dedicated upon an altar before it reached your hands. May you never worship in a sanctuary built with the price of blood. May you never build God's work with resources that carry the stain of innocent blood. Wherever you are, do not receive the price of blood.

A Covenant Once Received

Judas never intended for Jesus to be crucified. When he realized events had gone too far, he attempted to reverse the transaction. But by then it was too late. Once the agreement had been sealed, those who paid him simply answered, "See thou to that."

An agreement had already been made. That is how darkness operates.

The Consequence of Corrupt Altars

Whenever resources are taken from the altar of Baal, they eventually produce bloodshed. Think about it. If someone is willing to sacrifice innocent lives upon an altar, what makes you believe human life will suddenly become valuable afterward?

The altar that finances corruption eventually demands blood in return. Anyone who knowingly participates in such a transaction becomes entangled in its consequences. That is why the Church must remain uncompromised.

A New Priesthood Must Rise

Once compromise enters the priesthood, its authority is weakened. Its voice becomes ineffective. Its influence is diminished. God is therefore looking for another company of people. He is looking for men and women whose voices remain pure. Through such people, He intends to bring deliverance to Nigeria. The Lord spoke to me that He would raise **one hundred and twenty intercessors**.

He will baptize them with fire. He told me He would plant a divine alarm within their spirits. At appointed times, that alarm will awaken them to pray. They will not need human reminders. The Spirit Himself will summon them into intercession.

Two Great Dangers

We have already identified two major dangers. The first is **tribalism**. The second is **corrupt financial influence**. Money sourced from corrupt altars seeks to purchase spiritual voices. It seeks to buy the hands of leaders.

Do not receive it.

Do not justify it.

Do not baptize compromise with religious language.

Someone may say, "Use this money for evangelism."

Another may say, "Use it for a crusade."

Be discerning. Even sincere servants of God can be trapped because they genuinely desire to reach souls. That is why discernment is indispensable.

We Will Not Receive It

The Lord has determined to bring deliverance. Therefore, I say again: Do not receive it.

Tell your pastors.

Tell your leaders.

Tell everyone who serves in God's house. Do not receive it. We will preach the Gospel with resources obtained in righteousness. We will not build God's Kingdom with the treasures of Baal. No matter how attractive it appears...

No matter how persuasive the offer...

I will not receive it.

I will not take it.

The Pattern of Abimelech

Returning to **Judges 9**, we discover what happened after Abimelech secured power. He went to his father's house at Ophrah and, upon one stone, seventy of Gideon's sons were killed.

Only the youngest, Jotham, escaped because God preserved a remnant. God always preserves a remnant. Whenever He intends to save His people, He hides a remnant for Himself.

Notice the pattern. The money was distributed. Then bloodshed followed. Immediately after Abimelech's rise came violence.

Eliminating Every Opposition

This pattern also reveals something about political systems. Abimelech removed every possible rival. Every potential challenger disappeared. He eliminated opposition until no meaningful resistance remained. The people gathered and crowned him king.

Again, remember that this is a prophetic parable.

God Is Raising New Voices

The Lord showed me that if we continue depending upon compromised voices, we shall fail. Therefore, He is recruiting another generation.

A remnant. A people who will stand in purity. Will you become one of those voices?

Will you be among those hidden for God's purposes?

Will you be part of the remnant that declares, "This handshake shall proceed no further." There is a nation to be preserved. There is a people to be rescued.

Mercy Beyond the Window

The Lord also made something very clear to me. Even if certain prophetic events unfold, His determination to save Nigeria remains unchanged.

There may be missed opportunities. There may be delayed manifestations. Yet His mercy still speaks. As in the account of Abimelech, those who established him eventually became the very instruments of his downfall.

The Lord grant you understanding.

Prophetic Intercessors Must Arise

The direction is clear. Prophetic intercessors must arise. Perhaps the Holy Spirit has already placed within your heart the witness that you are one of those He is calling. If that witness is there, respond to Him. Respond without hesitation.

A Prophetic Declaration

O nation, hear the word of the Lord. Your day of salvation is drawing near. This handshake shall not prevail. The Lord Himself shall take hold of this nation.

The Lord says,

The God who preserved His servants in the fire is still able to preserve His people today.

His power shall once again be revealed.

National Deliverance and Personal Emancipation

Tonight, two things shall happen. There shall be national deliverance. There shall also be individual deliverance.

Personal freedom.

Personal healing.

Personal restoration.

Through the mouths of intercessors, God will perform His work in Nigeria.

The Lord will empower one hundred and twenty intercessors. This gathering will mark the birth of a fresh movement of prayer. One of the lasting fruits of this conference shall be the raising of intercessors who will continually stand in the gap for Nigeria.

The Trumpet of Solemn Assembly

The Lord showed me that this work will be accomplished through intercession. Joel chapter 2 speaks of two trumpets. The first announces the coming Day of the Lord.

The second gathers God's people for solemn assembly. Scripture calls everyone.

Children.

Priests.

Ministers.

Even newly married couples are summoned because the urgency of God's purpose outweighs personal comfort. The Lord commands:

"Let the priests, the ministers of the LORD, weep between the porch and the altar..." (*Joel 2:17, KJV*)

And their prayer is:

"Spare thy people, O LORD..."

Tonight, our cry is:

"Spare Nigeria, O Lord."
