Introduction

I perceive that tonight, the Lord is giving many people another chance. I perceive that tonight, the Lord has extended His longsuffering toward many of us. So many who have lost their spiritual compass, the Lord is going to touch you again. There is a fresh sense of His nearness. The Lord says:

"Am I a God at hand, saith the LORD, and not a God afar off?"

— **Jeremiah 23:23 (KJV)**

The Lord is making Himself near once again. You are going to sense His presence more than ever before. Tonight is about a deep consciousness, a fresh awareness, and an unveiling.

Somebody shout, "**Unveiling!**"

Shout, "**Take the veil away!**"

Tonight is a night of renewal.

I saw a brief vision from the Lord. I saw people shouting, while angels were exceedingly active all around. Heaven was full of activity.

Give the Lord a mighty shout of praise!

"O clap your hands, all ye people; shout unto God with the voice of triumph."

— **Psalms 47:1 (KJV)**

Growing Into the Ministry of Angels

There is an important aspect of the prophetic that I believe God wants His people to enter into more frequently, and that is **the ministry of angels**.

As I minister tonight, I perceive intense angelic activity.

As you build your spirit and cultivate spiritual consciousness, one of the realities God will introduce you to is the awareness that you can host His presence with a reality greater than anything your natural senses can perceive.

His presence becomes more real than what you can touch.

More real than what you can feel.

More real than the atmosphere of the room you are sitting in.

That is where God is bringing you.

If you believe it, say, **"Yes!"**

Overwhelmed by Spiritual Consciousness

One thing that troubled me for a long time in ministry was a constant sense of uncertainty. I always found myself unsure.

Then the Lord explained why.

He said,

"You have not yet been overwhelmed by consciousness. I will bring you to a place where your fears become nothing compared to the realities you carry."

My very first prophetic encounter came through an angel.

At the elementary level of spiritual experience, you begin by sensing God. You perceive His Spirit and learn to recognize His dealings.

But as you mature, especially if you are called to carry the burden of the Word of the Lord, there will be seasons where your interaction with angels becomes part of that prophetic landscape.

It may not happen every day, but I assure you that there is no prophet who grows into maturity without entering that realm.

The writer of Hebrews declares:

"But ye are come unto mount Sion... and to an innumerable company of angels."

— **Hebrews 12:22 (KJV)**

When you come into the council of God, you are not only conscious of the Holy Spirit within you. You also become aware of heavenly functionaries whom God employs in carrying out His purposes.

The Ambience of God's Glory

Tonight, one of the greatest mercies God will extend to us is to open the ambience of His glory. That glory introduces you to experiences that are beyond human reasoning.

If you have not entered that realm, you have not yet stepped into the order of the prophetic where God entrusts a man with the **message of the Lord**. I am not merely inviting you to learn how to operate spiritual gifts. Every believer has access to the gifts of the Spirit.

There is a higher realm.

When God begins introducing you to spiritual realities, He first teaches you to access His voice. But beyond hearing God's voice lies another dimension—the place where the **message of the Lord** comes from.

Not everyone who hears God carries the message of the Lord. The Hebrew word *Dabar* refers to the authoritative word or message that proceeds from God. That dimension belongs to prophetic functionaries.

Beyond Spiritual Gifts

Prophets are not defined merely by spiritual gifts. That is only the elementary stage. Every believer filled with the Holy Ghost should prophesy. However, there comes a point where prophecy begins to give birth to prophecy.

The voice of the Lord begins to produce a greater dimension of the voice of the Lord. You enter a place of waiting before Him until you receive what Scripture calls **the message of the Lord**.

I believe many people here tonight are about to be drawn into that experience.

The Council of the Lord

Because of time, my assignment tonight will be easier if you listened carefully to yesterday's teaching.

Please sit down for a moment.

Yesterday, as we concluded, I began bringing us into an experience that every prophet must become familiar with—not merely through theology, but through personal encounter.

If you are not there yet, you must pursue it.

That is where the message of a prophet originates.

That is where prophetic authority comes from.

Yesterday, we spoke about **the council of the Lord**, and the teaching was beautifully explained.

The council of the Lord is not merely an idea.

It is a dimension.

It is an experience.

God brings us into it gradually until it becomes a living reality we carry within us.

The Battle Against Natural Senses

One of the greatest battles in this journey is that we have become too accustomed to the natural order.

By "the natural order," I mean the five physical senses through which we have lived for many years.

Those senses become barriers that God must overcome.

Even after God begins drawing you into spiritual realities, your natural reasoning still competes with divine perception.

That was exactly what happened to Samuel.

Although Samuel stood within God's counsel, when he entered Jesse's house and saw Eliab, he immediately declared,

"Surely the LORD'S anointed is before him."

But the Lord corrected him.

"Look not on his countenance...for the LORD seeth not as man seeth."

— 1 Samuel 16:6–7 (KJV)

Assumption entered.

Human reasoning began to compete with revelation.

Yet when you are truly immersed in the council of God, the very voice of the Lord will interrupt your assumptions and silence your reasoning.

That is why God must bring us there.

Every Prophetic Journey Is Personal

There is no rigid formula for prophetic engagement.

It is an experience.

As was beautifully said yesterday, every prophetic person has his own journey.

There may be principles that describe the process, but God customizes the experience for every individual.

What God ultimately seeks to accomplish is to silence every competing voice until His own voice becomes supreme.

When God Shuts Down Other Voices

Consider Jacob on his journey toward becoming Israel.

He came to Bethel.

Interestingly, he stumbled into that atmosphere and fell asleep.

One of the ways God draws us deeper is through sleep.

Sleep shuts down competing voices.

When God begins awakening your inward man, your outward faculties are quieted.

Scripture says:

"And he dreamed, and behold a ladder set up on the earth, and the top of it reached to heaven: and behold the angels of God ascending and descending on it."

— **Genesis 28:12 (KJV)**

That vision revealed something profound.

Jacob discovered that something had always been upon him, but he had been unaware of it.

May God perform that same miracle in your life.

May He reveal the realities resting upon you that your dependence on the flesh has prevented you from seeing.

Sometimes even ministry activity itself can become a distraction.

May the Lord prevail over you.

Trapping Divine Experiences

When Jacob awoke, he said,

"Surely the LORD is in this place; and I knew it not."

— **Genesis 28:16 (KJV)**

The Lord can be present while we remain unaware of Him.

May the miracle that arrests the attention of God's servants happen in your life.

Tonight is not merely about shaking under the anointing.

It is not merely about falling.

It is about capturing an experience that God is bringing to you.

The Activation That Changed My Life

I have experienced different levels of spiritual activation throughout my life. I remember finishing a meeting in Akure. Something had shifted within me.

I returned home and sat at my dining table—not because I wanted to eat, but because something was happening inside me.

I had no prayer request.

I simply prayed.

When I finished praying, I went into my room.

I still could not stop praying.

I knelt beside my bed and cried,

"God, have mercy on me. Have mercy on me."

Suddenly, I was caught up in a vision.

The angel who entered my room was far larger than the room itself.

His head extended well beyond the ceiling.

He said,

"Get up."

I stood.

He said,

"I am taking you somewhere. This is where the first phase of your assignment will begin."

Immediately, we began to journey.

We arrived at a place, and as we walked through the streets, he began showing me different things.

Within less than fifteen minutes, I received information concerning nearly twenty years of my life and ministry.

The First Layer of God's Speaking

There is a secondary level of spiritual engagement where information begins to flow.

Sometimes God trains us—or places us under those who can train us—so that we become prepared for greater dimensions.

The things you are hearing now are only preparatory.

They position you to hear greater things.

God does not speak carelessly.

Often, when God begins speaking to someone, the first layer comes as instruction or teaching.

If time permitted, I would show you this pattern in the life of Elijah.

The same was true with Samuel.

Samuel heard the voice of God repeatedly.

He had sensitivity to hear, but he lacked understanding.

It was Eli who instructed him:

"Speak; LORD; for thy servant heareth."

— **1 Samuel 3:9–10 (KJV)**

That response positioned Samuel to move beyond merely hearing into receiving the message of the Lord.

Many believers remain at the level of whispers:

"Don't go."

"Stop."

"Don't buy it."

Those promptings are valuable.

But the prophet must grow beyond that.

There is a higher dimension where the Lord entrusts His message to those who have learned to remain before Him.

Before God entrusts you with greater dimensions of His speaking, you must first learn to respond to the dimensions He has already given you.

I believe Samuel demonstrated a measure of faithfulness before God began to entrust him with deeper encounters.

Samuel could have remained at that first level for years.

Some believers are exactly like that.

The last time God spoke to you, you described it by saying, *"Something told me."*

How can God continue to entrust you with His voice when you refuse to acknowledge that it was Him?

You even stand in church to testify:

"As I was about to cross the road, something just told me..."

Meanwhile, in heaven they say,

"Leave him there. He is not yet ready."

When Samuel entered into the flow of God's voice, what followed was overwhelming.

The Scripture says:

"Therefore Eli said unto Samuel, Go, lie down: and it shall be, if he call thee, that thou shalt say, Speak, LORD; for thy servant heareth. So Samuel went and lay down in his place. And the LORD came, and stood, and called as at other times, Samuel, Samuel. Then Samuel answered, Speak; for thy servant heareth."

— 1 Samuel 3:9–10 (KJV)

Notice what happened next.

The Lord did not introduce Himself again.

He immediately began to speak.

Samuel had already recognized His voice.

He had responded correctly.

Once you settle the issue that it is indeed the Lord speaking, you enter into the flow.

Are you here?

If you are still doubting His voice, you cannot move into that flow.

Many remain spiritual infants because they continually doubt God's voice and, in doing so, quench the Spirit.

Some of you clearly heard God, yet you questioned it:

"Could it really be God speaking to me?"

That uncertainty keeps you where you are.

Sometimes your response is not merely verbal.

Sometimes your response is obedience.

The moment your conduct aligns with God's instruction, He brings you into greater dimensions of His speaking.

Obedience Opens Greater Encounters

Look at Abraham.

The Bible says:

"Now the LORD had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country..."

— **Genesis 12:1 (KJV)**

We do not know how long God had been speaking before Abraham finally obeyed.

But the moment he stepped out in obedience, he entered into the flow of heaven's dealings.

That is how the voice of the Lord progresses.

The First Message Samuel Received

This passage in First Samuel makes me tremble.

Eli had raised Samuel.

He had mentored him from childhood.

Then the Lord appeared and said:

"Behold, I will do a thing in Israel, at which both the ears of every one that heareth it shall tingle."

— **1 Samuel 3:11 (KJV)**

The very first prophetic message Samuel ever received was a message of judgment against the house that had raised him.

The family that preserved him...

The priesthood that nurtured him...

That was the first assignment God entrusted to him.

God is not emotional.

He does not change His purposes because of human sentiments.

He is not saying,

"Let's not tell Samuel this because Eli may feel bad."

No.

Heaven had already reached a decision.

Samuel was God's replacement for Eli's priesthood.

Whatever kindness Eli had shown Samuel could not overturn God's eternal purpose.

There is something greater than personal relationships.

It is called **the purpose of God**.

The Scripture says:

"Thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created."

— **Revelation 4:11 (KJV)**

Everything exists for His pleasure—not ours.

If God's purpose requires a transition, He will not compromise His will.

When Mercy Has Reached Its Limit

The next verses broke me.

God said:

"In that day I will perform against Eli all things which I have spoken concerning his house: when I begin, I will also make an end."

— 1 Samuel 3:12 (KJV)

Do you know what that means?

God was saying,

"This is not the first conversation I have had with Eli."

"I have warned him."

"I have spoken repeatedly."

"The limit of mercy has been reached."

I do not know whether I am prophesying tonight, but when God begins a transition, He is not governed by emotions.

Sometimes the person leaving has exhausted the space that mercy provided.

God had warned Eli many times.

He watched him over the years.

He said,

"Eli, you have served Me faithfully, but I am not pleased with what is happening among your sons."

Perhaps Eli replied,

"Lord, they are spoiled children. Give me more time."

But the Lord answered,

"This priesthood concerns My purpose for generations.

It is bigger than you.

At some point, I must move beyond you if you refuse to respond."

The Responsibility of Spiritual Fatherhood

God does not merely call men into ministry.

He calls them into fatherhood.

Every father must raise another generation.

If you succeed in every other area but fail in that assignment, you have failed.

Can I preach as a prophet tonight?

The Lord declared:

"For I have told him that I will judge his house for ever for the iniquity which he knoweth..."

— 1 Samuel 3:13 (KJV)

When God warns you of coming judgment, do not delay repentance.

Do not comfort yourself because your ministry still appears successful.

The issue was not ignorance.

The Scripture says:

"The iniquity which he knoweth."

He knew.

And when God begins discussing your matter with someone else, it often means He is preparing to move beyond you.

The Bible says:

"...because his sons made themselves vile, and he restrained them not."

— **1 Samuel 3:13 (KJV)**

Notice carefully.

It does not say Eli became vile.

It says he failed to restrain those under his care.

Ministry Must Produce Sons

I speak particularly to those carrying the spirit of Elijah.

Many ministers think,

"As long as my ministry succeeds, I have fulfilled my assignment."

No.

If your ministry prospers but you fail to raise sons who continue God's purpose, you have not completed your assignment.

The spirit of Elijah must fulfill Malachi's prophecy:

"And he shall turn the heart of the fathers to the children, and the heart of the children to their fathers..."

— **Malachi 4:6 (KJV)**

The first responsibility of spiritual fatherhood is to create a pathway through which God can continue His work after you.

From the moment Eli failed in that responsibility, heaven began searching for another house through which the priesthood could continue.

Let me tell you something.

Your gift may survive...

But your ministry may not.

The Lord declared:

"Therefore I have sworn unto the house of Eli, that the iniquity of Eli's house shall not be purged with sacrifice nor offering for ever."

— 1 Samuel 3:14 (KJV)

A Cry for Mercy

At this point, the congregation broke into heartfelt prayer.

The cry was simple:

"Show me mercy, Lord."

Do not let my priesthood be given to another.

Show me mercy.

Excuses are never enough.

Your mercy I plead.

Your mercy I plead.

Excuses are never enough.

Your mercy I plead.

This is the hour to cry before God.

Search me.

Know me.

Purge me.

Purge me, Lord.

Purge me.

Three more minutes.

Lift your voice and respond to what the Spirit is saying.

Be Afraid When God Stops Speaking

I remember...

God told you about that issue.

You ignored Him. He spoke again. You still ignored Him.

Then one day...

He stopped talking about it. That should frighten you. Be afraid when God no longer addresses the matter.

Cry out:

"Lord, show us mercy."

Do not allow our priesthood to be given to another.

Samuel's First Prophetic Assignment

The Scripture says:

"And Samuel lay until the morning, and opened the doors of the house of the LORD. And Samuel feared to shew Eli the vision."

— **1 Samuel 3:15 (KJV)**

Notice Samuel's heart. His first prophetic assignment was not delivered with excitement.

He was afraid. Only an immature prophet delights in announcing another person's judgment. Even David, though anointed to replace Saul, refused to stretch out his hand against him. There is a posture of heart that God approves.

Even when God judges someone, He does not expect His servants to rejoice over it.

Samuel feared. He carried the burden all night until morning.

Then Eli called him and said,

"Samuel, my son."

Samuel answered,

"Here am I."

Eli already knew the matter concerned him.

When a man has ignored God's warnings for too long, every message begins to sound personal.

He asked Samuel:

"What is the thing that the LORD hath said unto thee? I pray thee hide it not from me..."

— **1 Samuel 3:17 (KJV)**

Eli knew.

God had not bypassed him.

He had spoken to him repeatedly before speaking to Samuel.

That is why he insisted,

"Hide nothing from me."

He understood that a young prophet might be tempted to soften the message out of respect.

But Samuel did not alter the word.

The Scripture says:

"And Samuel told him every whit, and hid nothing from him."

— 1 Samuel 3:18 (KJV)

He faithfully declared everything the Lord had spoken.

And Eli replied:

"It is the LORD: let him do what seemeth him good."

— 1 Samuel 3:18 (KJV)

Eli responded,

"It is the LORD: let him do what seemeth him good."

— 1 Samuel 3:18 (KJV)

Imagine hearing that your generation would be cut off, and all you could say was,

"It is the Lord. Let Him do what seems good."

At that point, Eli had reached a place where he no longer knew how to remedy the situation.

Perhaps he thought,

"I wish I had dealt with these boys earlier."

"I wish I had corrected them while they were still young."

"I should have taught them the fear of the Lord when they were still under my influence."

But now they had grown beyond his control.

He could no longer restrain them.

He had reached a point where he no longer knew what to do.

That is the place I never want to arrive at.

I do not want to come to a place where I can no longer turn.

Where repentance is no longer a genuine response.

Where all I can say is,

"God is justified."

Even if He judges me, I do not want to get there.

I want a remedy while there is still time.

I do not know who I am speaking to tonight, but I want a remedy on time.

I do not want excuses. I do not want explanations. I want mercy while mercy can still be obtained. Lord, do not lead me to a place where I cannot turn again.

Help me.

Show me mercy.

Do Not Journey Beyond Mercy

Eli reached a point where, in his own mind, there was no longer a solution.

He simply accepted the judgment.

"It is the Lord."

"Is it not the Lord who said it? Let Him do what seems good."

One thing I have discovered about prophetic people is that we are often satisfied with outward excitement.

If Eli had immediately been removed from the priesthood, perhaps that would have shocked him.

But God did not remove him immediately.

He continued serving.

His office remained.

Yet heaven had already found a replacement.

That is frightening.

Some of us think,

"As long as I am still the pastor..."

"As long as I can still prophesy..."

"As long as ministry is still happening..."

Everything must be fine.

No.

Lord, do not allow me to journey so far that You have already chosen another while I am still occupying the office.

Show me mercy.

Cry out to God tonight.

Do not let me travel beyond the boundaries of Your mercy.

Samuel Became What Eli Was Replaced By

Let me leave Eli for a moment.

There is something even sadder.

Turn with me to **1 Samuel 8**.

The Bible says:

"And it came to pass, when Samuel was old, that he made his sons judges over Israel... And his sons walked not in his ways, but turned aside after lucre, and took bribes, and perverted judgment."

— 1 Samuel 8:1–3 (KJV)

How can you become the victim of the very reformation you introduced?

The very thing you warned the previous generation against...

You eventually arrived there yourself.

Say it with me:

"Not again!"

How can we call ourselves reformers and then repeat the very errors we condemned?

How can we say Pentecostalism lost its way, only for us to lose our way in our own generation?

Not again!

There must arise a generation that gives God hope.

Evangelists...

Prophets...

Pastors...

Teachers...

If we have identified where our fathers missed it, then we must not repeat the same mistakes.

We cannot keep celebrating ourselves while ignoring the same issues.

We must confront them.

We cannot go the way of Eli.

Somebody shout,

"Not again!"

Do Not End Where You Began Preaching Against

How is it possible that the very first prophetic message that defined Samuel's ministry eventually became the same weakness in his own house?

We have said,

"They loved money."

Should we now love money?

We have said,

"They did not walk in unity."

Should we now become divided?

We have said,

"They became intoxicated with fame."

Should we now become celebrity prophets?

Should we arrive at the very place from which God is departing?

That is the question before this generation.

Lift your hands before the Lord.

Pray:

"I am Samuel.

I will not fail God.

Help me.

Help me, Lord."

No matter how carefully we hide things, God knows our journey.

He knows where we are heading.

If you hear His voice early enough...

Turn.

Oh Lord, show us mercy. Expose my heart. If there is any deviation in me, make me turn.

May My Gift Never Enhance My Departure

This has become one of my deepest prayers: **May my gift never enhance my departure from God.** I understand the meaning of mercy because I have missed the mark before. I know what mercy means. I do not stand here claiming greater credentials than anyone else.

I simply keep asking the Lord,

"Help me all the way."

The Lord told Elijah,

"Yet I have left me seven thousand in Israel..."

— **1 Kings 19:18 (KJV)**

In other words,

"If you choose to outsmart Me, I already have others."

When you have successfully convinced everyone around you that you are right, go before God and admit that you are wrong.

That was not even what I planned to preach tonight.

Lord, help me.

The Foundation of True Prophetic Sight

I believe the Lord is breaking new ground in this assembly.

Fresh foundations are being laid.

Old ground is being ploughed again.

Now let me begin to conclude.

Yesterday, the man of God told us that the primary requirement for deeper prophetic operation is **sight**.

We must learn to see accurately.

But here is where many prophetic people misunderstand the matter.

They think accuracy is measured by how many things they see.

That is not true.

Even fallen men can access certain dimensions of supernatural perception.

Some of the things they see are accurate.

As I shared yesterday, I grew up seeing certain things spiritually.

At the latent level of the human soul, there are capacities that exist even apart from the Holy Spirit.

It is not always demons that produce supernatural perception.

The soul itself possesses remarkable abilities.

The prophet reminded us yesterday that this capacity traces back to Adam.

God's Original Intention

Prophetic ministry—and every other ministry—is actually secondary in God's original plan.

Ministry became necessary because of the Fall.

Before sin entered the world, Adam enjoyed uninterrupted fellowship with God.

There were no scheduled prayer meetings.

There were no prayer hours.

Life itself was fellowship.

That is the experience God wants to restore.

He wants to bring you into a place where you remain in fellowship while taking your bath...

While driving on the road...

While standing at a junction...

Where prophecy is no longer dependent on a church atmosphere or musical instruments. God wants us to become so united with Him that we can receive the Word of the Lord anywhere. Like Paul standing in the middle of a storm and declaring,

"For there stood by me this night the angel of God, whose I am, and whom I serve."

— Acts 27:23 (KJV)

When everyone else is panicking...

When emotions are everywhere...

You remain connected.

Every Other Sight Must Flow From Seeing God

The Lord once told me, "The place where many prophetic people miss it is that they are always looking for enhancement to see things."

That becomes their validation.

"I saw it."

"I saw it happen."

"My prophecy came to pass."

Then the Lord said something that changed my life.

Every genuine sight must first proceed from **your sight of God**.

If you are going to see anything else correctly, it must begin with seeing Him.

That is God's agenda.

Jesus declared:

"Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God."

— **Matthew 5:8 (KJV)**

Some people think Jesus was speaking only about heaven.

No.

Seeing God is meant to be an everyday reality. The clarity of every prophetic perception depends upon the purity of your heart. Once you see Him rightly, every other revelation flows from that encounter. That is the true pattern of prophetic ministry.

The Pursuit of Holiness Produces Accurate Sight

The writer of Hebrews also says:

"Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord."

— **Hebrews 12:14 (KJV)**

Therefore, anyone who desires to steward the prophetic accurately must pursue purity.

Every significant revelation flows out of the revelation of God Himself.

If you can see Him clearly, every other sight finds its proper place.

The Danger of Pursuing Things Instead of God

Do you know why people become obsessed with seeing things?

Because knowledge inflates the flesh. It feeds the ego. That obsession has produced many of the personality cults we see across Africa today. The moment someone demonstrates an unusual ability to reveal hidden information, people immediately elevate that person.

Soon they begin surrendering their discernment. Some even tolerate manipulation and abuse simply because they believe the person "sees."

Why?

Because many people do not really want God.

They only want information.

They say,

"Show me things."

Not,

"Show me God."

The tragic reality is that the demands of the audience often create false prophets.

If people continually reward sensationalism, someone will eventually arise to satisfy that demand.

A New Prophetic Order

But the generation God is raising is different. Their cry is not, "Show me things."

Their cry is, "**Show me You.**"

When you truly find Him, every other revelation becomes available in its proper order. That is the new prophetic order. That is God's call upon this generation. That is God's call upon your life.

Intimacy Before Commission

Before I close, let me leave you with this thought. Before God approves a prophet, He brings that person through successive layers of intimacy.

He develops trust.

He brings the heart to a place where His presence becomes everything. He knows you are no longer driven by recognition. He knows gain is no longer your motivation.

The Scripture says that we receive power to become witnesses. A witness is one who is willing to die for the testimony he bears. Only after God has established that kind of intimacy does He entrust a man with greater responsibility.

Even the first man called a prophet was naturally timid.

He still interpreted life through human reasoning before God trained him to walk by the Spirit. God's highest goal is not to produce gifted prophets. His highest goal is to produce men and women who know Him intimately, see Him clearly, and faithfully represent Him wherever He sends them.

The Spirit Is Greater Than Human Wisdom

"Oh, in these days another pastor is looking for your wife." (*Congregation laughs.*) "Oh, you're joking."

You must have sense.

Better still, you must have the Spirit, because human wisdom will disappoint you many times. Human wisdom would have disappointed Abraham.

Abraham called his wife and said,

"You know, I'm not trying to be a pathological liar, but by virtue of where we came from, you are also my sister. So, when we get there, we have to be discreet."

I don't know what dimension of God's life Sarah was living in at that age that she was still so beautiful.

Mama, don't you covet that kind of grace? Imagine having a wife who is over seventy years old and somebody still says, "*Ah! How are you doing?*"

That is grace!

So Abraham said,

"We have to be wise. When they ask about your husband, just tell them he is your brother."

The king heard about Sarah and said,

"How can such a beautiful woman be in my territory without my knowing? Bring her to me."

But the moment the king took her, the Angel of the Lord appeared to him and said,

"I have only come to announce to you that you are already a dead man."

In other words, your funeral has already been published.

The only thing left now is resurrection.

The king pleaded,

"Lord, I am innocent! I did not know."

God answered,

"Go to Abraham. He will pray for you."

And it was God Himself who introduced Abraham as **a prophet**.

A Prophet Before Giving Great Prophecies

There must have been things God saw in Abraham before He called him a prophet.

Abraham had not yet given spectacular prophecies.

He had simply lived a life worthy of being called a prophet.

That is important.

One of my sons once followed me to a meeting.

He said,

"Papa, I think you're going to disappoint these people. They are expecting you to do what you did in that other meeting where you called out almost everyone in the hall by prophecy. That is actually why this pastor invited you."

I replied,

"Oh my God... I am not going that way. The Master has not instructed me to minister like that."

So I began studying Abraham, the first man God called a prophet.

I discovered that God first brought him into a relationship of trust.

I'm not saying Abraham was completely faultless.

But there were clear indicators throughout his journey that revealed the purity of his heart.

The Test of Lot

Abraham brought a young man from his village named Lot.

The day came when they had to separate.

There was no fighting.

Abraham simply knew it was time.

He even gave Lot the privilege of choosing whichever portion of the land he wanted.

Lot asked,

"Uncle, are you serious? You mean I should choose first?"

Abraham answered,

"Go ahead."

Lot chose what appeared to be the best land.

Have you ever heard the story of someone who left a church and took almost everyone with him?

He says,

"God called me."

Then after years of your labor, you watch nearly everyone follow him.

That was exactly Abraham's situation.

Yet Abraham chose to see differently.

After Lot departed, God said,

"Lift up now thine eyes, and look from the place where thou art..."

(Genesis 13:14, KJV)

God is humorous.

Lot had taken what appeared to be everything.

Yet God told Abraham,

"From where you are standing... look."

(Congregation laughs.)

I might have replied,

"Lord, there is nothing left to look at! Lot has already surveyed the land and taken everything."

But a man who walks with God does not see the way ordinary men see.

That is the prophet Abraham I am introducing to you.

Purity of Heart Is Proven by Love

Eventually, a coalition of kings invaded the land.

They captured Lot and carried away everything he possessed.

If this happened in many Pentecostal circles today, people would quickly come to tell Abraham,

"Now we know you are truly a covenant man! God has fought your battle for you."

People like bringing reports that seem to justify our bitterness.

They came to Abraham saying,

"We thought Lot was prospering, but your God has judged him. He has been carried away captive."

They expected Abraham to celebrate.

Instead, Abraham rose up.

He had never fought a war before.

Yet he declared,

"I am going to rescue him."

How do you fight a war to save the man who divided your church?

These are the templates of purity of heart.

Many people would have cursed him instead.

They would have said,

"Since you broke my church, die there."

And if the one you cursed continues to prosper, your heart becomes even more offended.

Remember Cain.

He murdered his brother.

God judged him.

Yet Cain built cities and had descendants.

God is not a man.

You cannot reduce Him to human calculations.

Your responsibility is not to calculate God.

Your responsibility is to meet the requirement of a pure heart so that you may see Him more clearly.

Abraham took **three hundred and eighteen trained servants** born in his own household and entered a world war simply to rescue Lot.

When will the Church come to a place of such innocence?

When will our hands be free from another man's blood?

Abraham brought Lot back.

That is a prophet.

Friendship Before Revelation

God eventually said of Abraham,

"Shall I hide from Abraham that thing which I do?"

(Genesis 18:17, KJV)

There is a level of intimacy where God Himself begins to bring you confidential reports.

Before God judged Sodom, He came first to Abraham.

Why?

Because friendship had been established.

God was saying,

"I know you. I know My priorities have become your priorities. My desires have become your desires."

Jesus later elevated His disciples into that same relationship.

"Henceforth I call you not servants; for the servant knoweth not what his lord doeth: but I have called you friends; for all things that I have heard of my Father I have made known unto you."

(John 15:15, KJV)

Are you ready for that level?

A place where your intimacy with God is so deep that when He is about to do something in Nigeria, He comes to your room first.

Those are deeper prophetic experiences.

Not merely seeing visions.

Not merely calling names.

But receiving knowledge because you have entered into friendship with God.

He says,

"All things that I have heard of My Father I have made known unto you."

That level belongs to friends, not merely servants.

Some of those revelations may never be preached publicly.

They are privileges of friendship.

A New Cycle Is Opening

Please rise to your feet.

My time is up.

Evangelist...

I saw you before the Lord.

I saw a deep dissatisfaction in your spirit.

I saw you asking,

"What next? How do I do more for God?"

It looked as though everything you had previously learned had become insufficient.

You kept asking,

"Lord, is there more?"

I saw a burning desire within you to do more for God.

The Lord asked me to tell you why you have entered that season.

He said,

"A cycle has been completed, and another cycle is opening."

Then I saw you in the Spirit.

You were being equipped.

I saw you carrying a bow.

Behind you, the Lord placed a quiver.

The quiver kept being filled with arrows.

Arrow after arrow.

The Lord said,

"This time you will shoot with greater accuracy."

Then He said,

"I have tested your heart and I have seen your ways."

"I, the Lord, will bring you forward again to bring victory unto Me, even to divide the spoil of the mighty."

"I will set you before Me like a warrior."

"I will hold your hand."

"I will send your arrows into many places."

"Every arrow you release shall bring Me victory, because your desire has been to bring glory to My Name."
