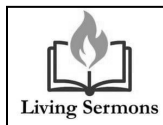

Introduction

I want to share on **the prophetic streams**—the operations of God through the prophet and through the prophetic believer. Let us begin by reading from the Scriptures.

"Beforetime in Israel, when a man went to enquire of God, thus he spake, Come, and let us go to the seer: for he that is now called a Prophet was beforetime called a Seer."

— 1 Samuel 9:9 (KJV)

Now turn to **1 Chronicles 29:29**.

"Now the acts of David the king, first and last, behold, they are written in the book of Samuel the seer, and in the book of Nathan the prophet, and in the book of Gad the seer."

— 1 Chronicles 29:29 (KJV)

Remember the first Scripture we read. It says that before time in Israel, when a man wanted to inquire of the Lord, he would say, *"Let us go to the seer,"* because the one who was formerly called a seer is now called a prophet.

When the Bible recounts the lives of those who ministered around David, it deliberately identifies them differently. Samuel is called **the seer**, Nathan is called **the prophet**, and Gad is also called **the seer**.

These distinctions are not accidental.

Samuel the Seer and Nathan the Prophet

When you examine these words in the Hebrew, you discover that different terms are used. The word translated "**seer**" in reference to Samuel is the Hebrew word **ra'ah**. It means *to see, to look into, to behold, or to gaze upon*.

So when the Bible says that, in former times, the prophet was called a seer, it is describing someone who had been given the ability by God to look into His counsel. Such a person was granted access to behold the visions of God.

That is the meaning of **ra'ah**.

When it speaks about Nathan, however, the word translated "**prophet**" is the Hebrew word **nabi**. A *nabi* is:

- one who is a spokesman for another,
- one who speaks by divine inspiration,
- one who serves as God's spokesman,
- an inspired man.

Then the word used for Gad carries the idea of beholding or seeing into a matter.

My focus, however, is on these first two expressions—**the seer** and **the prophet**.

The Seeing Eye and the Hearing Ear

The Bible says:

"The hearing ear, and the seeing eye, the LORD hath made even both of them."

— Proverbs 20:12 (KJV)

When we study the operations of the prophetic—how the prophetic stream functions through the prophet and through the believer—we discover something remarkable.

Just as we possess five physical senses, the human spirit also possesses spiritual faculties.

Physically, we have:

- the sense of sight,
- hearing,
- taste,
- smell,
- and touch.

Among these physical senses, sight and hearing are the two most dominant. In the same way, when it comes to the prophetic, God unlocks the faculties of the human spirit so that a believer can participate in His counsel and receive revelation. The two dominant spiritual faculties are **seeing** and **hearing**.

That is why Scripture says:

"The seeing eye, and the hearing ear, the LORD hath made even both of them."

— Proverbs 20:12 (KJV)

Samuel is described as a **seer**—a man who could look into, perceive, and behold the counsel of God. He could actually see the Word of the Lord. Nathan, however, is

described as a **prophet**—a spokesman, one who hears and speaks by divine inspiration. Therefore, when we examine the prophetic operation in the believer, we discover that these are the two principal faculties God unlocks to produce supernatural revelation:

- the faculty of **seeing**, and
- the faculty of **hearing**.

The Seer Dimension: Seeing the Word of the Lord

The description of the seer reveals that one of the primary ways revelation comes is through spiritual sight. The seer:

- sees,
- looks into,
- perceives,
- beholds the Word of the Lord,
- and receives the visions of God.

This is one of the major streams of the prophetic. A prophetic believer must understand the power of spiritual sight because this is one of the primary ways God grants entrance into His Word. Habakkuk declared:

"I will stand upon my watch, and set me upon the tower, and will watch to see what he will say unto me..."

— Habakkuk 2:1 (KJV)

Notice the language. He said: *"I will watch to see what He will say."*

That means the Word of the Lord can be **seen**. God reveals His counsel by granting people spiritual sight.

Hearing the Word of the Lord

God also reveals His counsel by giving men the ability to hear His voice.

Jeremiah asks:

"For who hath stood in the counsel of the LORD, and hath perceived and heard his word? who hath marked his word, and heard it?"

— Jeremiah 23:18 (KJV)

The word translated "**perceived**" here is the same Hebrew word **ra'ah** used for the seer.

When a man stands in the counsel of the Lord, he is given the capacity to both **see** and **hear** the Word of the Lord.

The word translated "**counsel**" carries the idea of God's secret council or intimate assembly.

A person must first be brought into the counsel of God before he can receive the counsel of God.

This Scripture shows us that when God brings a prophet into His counsel, the prophet receives His counsel by seeing and hearing His Word.

The Two Major Streams of the Prophetic

From **1 Chronicles 29**, we discover two major prophetic streams. The first is the **ra'ah** dimension. This is the **visionary operation**. When God unlocks this stream in your spirit, He grants you access to spiritual sight. There are times when you may not hear anything, yet you will clearly see.

That is the operation of the seer. God gives the ability to behold His Word and to see His visions. At times, while standing in God's counsel, the seer may also hear. Nevertheless, the dominant operation is sight. This is why the seer operates primarily through visions.

These experiences may come through:

- dreams,
- trances,
- inner visions,
- or other visionary encounters.

In every case, God is opening the faculty of spiritual sight.

The Nabi Stream: Inspiration From Within

The second stream is the **nabi** dimension. The Hebrew verb associated with prophecy is **naba**, which means **to bubble forth, to flow out, or to pour forth from within**.

When the **ra'ah** stream is activated, your capacity to see is heightened. You begin to behold the Word of the Lord. When the **nabi** stream is activated, your capacity to hear is heightened.

The Word of God begins to bubble up from within your spirit.

If you function in the prophetic, you will discover that these streams operate differently at different times.

Sometimes you function in the **ra'ah** dimension—you see.

At other times you may not see anything, but you hear clearly.

The Bible intentionally tells us that Samuel was primarily a **seer**.

That means the dominant stream in his life was spiritual sight.

He beheld the Word of the Lord.

He perceived divine realities.

He saw what God was showing him.

He was a visionary prophet.

Nathan, however, is simply called a **prophet**.

The Bible does not call him a seer.

This tells us that the major stream through which Nathan ministered was hearing.

Most of the revelation he received came through divine inspiration.

Discovering Your Prophetic Stream

As you continue to walk with the Lord, you will begin to recognize where your strength lies.

Some believers discover that the dominant operation of the Spirit in their lives is spiritual sight.

They simply enter into prayer, and suddenly their eyes are opened.

Sometimes they lie down to sleep, and their spirit becomes alive with visions.

Others rarely experience visual encounters, yet they hear the Lord with remarkable clarity.

Both are prophetic.

They simply represent different streams.

The **nabi** stream is inspirational.

The **seer** dimension is visionary.

When the Spirit of God begins to stir within you, words begin to rise from your spirit until you speak them.

This is what happened repeatedly in the Book of Acts.

When believers were filled with the Holy Spirit, they spoke with other tongues and prophesied.

In **Acts 19**, when Paul arrived at Ephesus, he found certain disciples and asked them:

"Have ye received the Holy Ghost since ye believed?"

— Acts 19:2 (KJV)

They replied that they had not even heard whether there was a Holy Ghost.

When Paul laid hands upon them, the Holy Spirit came upon them.

"...they spake with tongues, and prophesied."

— Acts 19:6 (KJV)

That is the **nabi** operation. As the Spirit of God moves, divine inspiration begins to flow. People suddenly begin to prophesy. They begin to speak what God is saying.

Sometimes someone says, "I see the Lord doing this."

The person may not actually be seeing a vision. Rather, the Holy Spirit has unlocked the fountain of **nabi** inspiration, and words begin to rise from within.

That is the operation of the **nabi**.

Some prophetic people do not see many visions, but their hearing is exceptionally strong. Some prophets are "big ears" prophets. Others are "big eyes" prophets.

There are people with a very strong prophetic gift who rarely experience trances or dramatic visions, yet their hearing is remarkably accurate.

It is the same Holy Spirit working—either unlocking the **ra'ah** operation or the **nabi** operation within the believer.

The prophetic can therefore be:

- visionary,
- or inspirational.

Some believers are naturally more visionary.

Others primarily receive by inspiration.

Both are streams of God flowing through His people.

God Is Unlocking These Streams

God causes His people to hear.

God causes His people to see.

These are the prophetic streams He desires to unlock within every believer.

As you spend time in worship, in prayer, and especially praying in the Holy Ghost, something begins to happen.

It is as though the fountain within your spirit begins to break open.

The river starts to rise. Before long, words begin to form in your spirit. Thoughts begin to arise—spontaneous thoughts inspired by the Holy Spirit. You may not see a vision, yet the hearing faculty of your spirit becomes active.

The prophetic operates through seeing and hearing. These are the two principal streams God unlocks. That is what God is doing with us in this conference. Some of you will leave this place and discover that your ability to see has become heightened. You will enter your prayer closet, and suddenly dimensions of revelation will open before you.

Sometimes you will simply lie down to sleep, and your entire night will be filled with visions. You will find yourself in different places. At one moment you are on earth.

At another moment you are in heaven. At another, you are between realms.

God is bringing you into the **ra'ah** experience.

Understanding the Times

When you awaken from such encounters, you become like the children of Issachar. The Bible says:

"...which were men that had understanding of the times, to know what Israel ought to do..."
— 1 Chronicles 12:32 (KJV)

They were a prophetic tribe. They could access the secrets of God. They understood the times because they could interpret them. One of the functions of a prophet is to interpret times and seasons. People may be rejoicing and celebrating, yet the prophet begins to weep.

Why?

Because he is not responding merely to what people are seeing. He is responding to what God is revealing. The prophet is able to interpret the seasons.

He can tell the people why events are happening because he has seen from the perspective of God's counsel.

Interpreting the Signs of the Times

A prophet is able to explain the signs of the times because he has been given access to both **seeing** and **hearing**. He understands why events are unfolding the way they are because God grants him insight into His counsel.

The Bible says:

"For when they shall say, Peace and safety; then sudden destruction cometh upon them..."
— 1 Thessalonians 5:3 (KJV)

While people are celebrating and declaring that prosperity has arrived, the prophet may be hearing an entirely different sound.

God unlocks these prophetic fountains so that His servants can discern His mind concerning the times.

The Gift of Prophecy and the Ministry of Edification

When we come to **1 Corinthians 12** and **1 Corinthians 14**, the Apostle Paul gives remarkable insight into the operation of the gifts of the Spirit, especially the prophetic.

He begins by saying:

"Follow after charity, and desire spiritual gifts, but rather that ye may prophesy."

— 1 Corinthians 14:1 (KJV)

He continues:

"For he that speaketh in an unknown tongue speaketh not unto men, but unto God... howbeit in the spirit he speaketh mysteries."

— 1 Corinthians 14:2 (KJV)

Then he explains the purpose of prophecy:

"But he that prophesieth speaketh unto men to edification, and exhortation, and comfort."

— 1 Corinthians 14:3 (KJV)

Later he says something very powerful:

"He that speaketh in an unknown tongue edifieth himself; but he that prophesieth edifieth the church."

— 1 Corinthians 14:4 (KJV)

The key to edifying the Church through prophecy is first learning how to edify yourself through praying in the Holy Ghost.

The Lord opened this Scripture to me one day.

He showed me that when you spend time praying in the Holy Ghost and become spiritually edified, you are able to plug into the fountain of the prophetic so that you can minister edification to the Church.

Throughout **1 Corinthians 14**, Paul continually moves between speaking about tongues and prophecy.

By the time he reaches the end of the chapter, he concludes:

"Wherefore, brethren, covet to prophesy, and forbid not to speak with tongues."

— 1 Corinthians 14:39 (KJV)

Earlier he had also declared:

"I will pray with the spirit, and I will pray with the understanding also... I will sing with the spirit, and I will sing with the understanding also."

— 1 Corinthians 14:15 (KJV)

Notice the order.

For Paul, praying in the spirit comes first.

This teaches us that one of the great keys to edifying others prophetically is first allowing yourself to be built up through prayer.

What Happens When You Pray in the Holy Ghost

The word **edify** means **to build up, to strengthen, to charge, or to reinforce**.

When you spend time praying in the Holy Ghost, you are not merely becoming conscious of God's power. Four significant things happen within your spirit.

1. You Are Enlivened

Life enters your spirit.

You are quickened.

2. You Are Enlightened

Suddenly your spirit and your mind become flooded with light.

3. You Are Empowered

The Holy Spirit charges your spiritual battery.

You become energized with divine power.

4. You Are Emboldened

Boldness begins to rise within you.

In **Acts 4**, after the apostles had been threatened and commanded not to preach in the name of Jesus, they prayed:

"...grant unto thy servants, that with all boldness they may speak thy word."

— Acts 4:29 (KJV)

They already possessed power. They had experienced **dunamis**. Yet they recognized that power alone was not enough.

There are moments when power resides within your spirit, yet boldness is absent. You feel the reality of God's power, but you hesitate to step out. One of the ministries of praying in the Holy Ghost is that it produces holy boldness.

Suddenly courage rises within you. That is exactly what happened to the apostles.

Praying in the Spirit Unlocks the Gifts

Paul shows us that praying in the Holy Ghost becomes a gateway into the operation of:

- the revelatory gifts,
- the utterance gifts,
- and the power gifts.

The revelatory gifts, in particular, have much to do with the faculty of the mind. Many believers assume that being prophetic is only a matter of the spirit.

Very few consider the role of the renewed mind. The moment the mind is mentioned, some people begin to think that spirituality is being diminished.

But that is not true.

If the Holy Spirit speaks into your spirit, it is your mind that understands what He is saying.

The mind is the faculty of understanding.

The Language of God Is Light

God speaks in light. He floods your spirit with divine illumination. What eventually reaches your conscious awareness are thoughts, words, impressions, visions, and pictures. Your mind then interprets what God has communicated using the language in which it has been trained.

If English is the dominant language of your mind, you will ordinarily perceive God's communication through English.

If another believer has been trained primarily in Yoruba, the Holy Spirit will ordinarily communicate through the vocabulary and thought patterns that person understands.

The Holy Spirit uses your thoughts. He uses your vocabulary. He uses your mental framework.

Why?

Because when divine light enters your spirit, your mind must interpret that revelation. That is why one highly educated believer may prophesy in polished English, while another person with little formal education may say in simple language:

"God say make I tell you say Him bless you."

That is genuinely how the person heard the Lord. I am not saying God cannot enable someone to speak a language they have never learned. We see supernatural language in Scripture. But ordinarily, God communicates through the language with which your mind has been trained.

God is light.

When His light enters your spirit, your mind interprets that light into words you understand.

Revelation, Interpretation, and Application

Prophetic communication operates on three levels.

Revelation

Anyone can receive revelation.

Interpretation

This is where many people fail.

If the interpretation is wrong, then the final stage will also be wrong.

Application

A genuine revelation can still produce wrong results if it is interpreted incorrectly.

Your ability to discern God's frequency therefore depends greatly upon the renewal of your mind.

That is why Paul wrote:

"And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God."

— Romans 12:2 (KJV)

A prophetic believer understands the importance of guarding the mind.

The Scripture says:

"Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life."

— Proverbs 4:23 (KJV)

For this reason, you remain rooted in the Scriptures. The Word of God is doing far more than giving information. It is releasing divine life that transforms the soul.

The Word of God Renews the Mind

The psalmist declares:

"The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple."

— Psalm 19:7 (KJV)

There is a genuine work of conversion that God's Word performs upon the human soul.

As you continually expose yourself to Scripture, your thinking is transformed.

Many believers struggle in prophetic ministry not because revelation is absent, but because the mind has not yet been renewed enough to interpret what God is revealing.

A prophetic person therefore understands that the mind is a gateway for receiving the Word of the Lord.

It is not merely a matter of the spirit.

The mind is vitally important.

The Eyes of Your Understanding

Paul prayed this remarkable prayer:

"That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ... may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him: The eyes of your understanding being enlightened..."

— Ephesians 1:17–18 (KJV)

Notice his emphasis.

He prays that the **eyes of your understanding** would be enlightened.

Light is what makes things visible.

Without light, nothing can be seen.

If every light in this room were switched off, and something valuable fell to the floor, you would be unable to find it.

Light reveals.

Therefore, the prophetic believer must carefully guard the condition of the mind.

The expression "**understanding**" here points to the inner faculty of thought—the mind itself.

The Greek word refers to the intellect or understanding.

Many people think only about the spirit.

Yet the prophetic also involves the mind.

When your spirit is energized by divine light, that illumination flows into your mind.

Your mind then interprets what God is communicating.

Paul therefore prays that God would give us the spirit of wisdom and revelation.

When that spirit comes, the eyes of the mind are flooded with light.

The result is that you begin to know.

The word translated **know** carries the idea of perceiving or seeing with understanding.

Paul is praying that God would flood your inner eyes with light so that you can truly see.

The Strength of the Prophet Is Spiritual Sight

One of the greatest strengths of a prophet is the ability to see. When the Holy Spirit floods the eyes of your understanding with light, He is bringing you into spiritual perception. As you study the Scriptures, something greater than acquiring information begins to happen.

You start seeing.

There comes a moment when a passage you have read many times suddenly opens before your eyes. That revelation changes you. Transformation comes because the eyes of your understanding have been illuminated. Now you possess the ability to see.

God told Abraham:

"Lift up now thine eyes... for all the land which thou seest, to thee will I give it, and to thy seed for ever."

— Genesis 13:14–15 (KJV)

Paul understood this principle. He knew that if believers were to function in revelation, the eyes of their understanding had to be enlightened. Light is what makes things manifest.

We are not called to navigate life merely by our physical eyes.

We are to journey through life by the light of our inner eyes.

A Wise Man's Eyes Are in His Head

The Preacher says:

"The wise man's eyes are in his head..."

— Ecclesiastes 2:14 (KJV)

A wise man does not live merely by what his natural eyes observe.

He journeys through life with his inner eyes.

He depends upon God for inward light.

When confusion surrounds everyone else, the wise man focuses upon the illumination within.

He is governed, directed, and guided by the light that God places inside his spirit.

Throughout Scripture there is a consistent connection between wisdom and spiritual sight.

In **Genesis 3**, the serpent told Eve:

"...your eyes shall be opened..."

— Genesis 3:5 (KJV)

He promised that she would gain knowledge of good and evil. The woman looked upon the fruit and saw that it was desirable to make one wise. Again we see the connection between sight and wisdom. True wisdom flows from the illumination of the inner man. It is not determined merely by what we observe outwardly. A wise man's eyes are in his head.

Therefore, he lives continually before God, ensuring that there is no darkness within him. He maintains an inward light by which he navigates life.

Walking by the Light Within

Job testified:

"...when by his light I walked through darkness..."

— Job 29:3 (KJV)

He continued:

"...when the secret of God was upon my tabernacle."

— Job 29:4 (KJV)

He also declared:

"When his candle shined upon my head, and when by his light I walked through darkness."

— Job 29:3 (KJV)

What is the candle of the Lord?

The Bible answers:

"The spirit of man is the candle of the LORD, searching all the inward parts of the belly."

— Proverbs 20:27 (KJV)

When God desires to bring you into revelation, He lights your candle. He illuminates your spirit. He causes the fire of God to burn within your inner man. Then the light shining from your spirit begins to illuminate your mind. As Job declared:

"When His candle shined upon my head..."

My spirit, which is the candle of the Lord, received illumination from Him, and that divine light flooded my mind.

Walking Through Darkness by His Light

Job declared:

"...when by his light I walked through darkness."

— Job 29:3 (KJV)

Obviously, he was not referring to physical darkness. He continued:

"...when the secret of God was upon my tabernacle."

— Job 29:4 (KJV)

How do men receive the secrets of God within their inner tabernacle?

It is through the light that comes from the Holy Spirit into the human spirit. That light illuminates the mind. The eyes of your heart are enlightened, and suddenly you begin to see because something has happened within.

Even in simple physics, we understand that vision depends upon light. Light must strike the retina before an image can be formed. Only then can a person see.

The prophetic works the same way.

It is by light that we navigate.

Job said:

"When Your candle shined upon my head... by Your light I walked through darkness."

He had light from God by which he navigated through seasons of darkness.

He also said:

"The secret of God was upon my tabernacle."

Keep Your Spirit Burning

A prophetic person understands that he must do everything possible to keep his spirit burning.

That is why prayer is the nearest companion of the prophet.

Your spirit is the candle of the Lord.

Paul writes:

"Pray without ceasing."

— 1 Thessalonians 5:17 (KJV)

Then he continues:

"Quench not the Spirit. Despise not prophesyings."

— 1 Thessalonians 5:19–20 (KJV)

Notice how Paul connects continual prayer with the prophetic. As you pray without ceasing, your spirit remains alive and burning. The fire of the Holy Spirit continually lights your human spirit. When your spirit is illuminated, there is light within you, and that light enables you to see. The prophetic ministry is fundamentally a ministry of light.

You cannot function prophetically without light. It is light that enables spiritual sight. When your spirit remains ablaze, you possess the illumination necessary to navigate every season of life. Therefore, the prophetic believer must do everything possible to keep the inner lamp burning.

If that lamp goes out, you will stumble like every other person. If that light is extinguished, you become vulnerable to the same deceptions that mislead natural men because you no longer possess the inward light by which to see.

Prayer keeps the prophet's lamp burning.

John Was a Burning and Shining Lamp

Jesus said concerning John the Baptist:

"He was a burning and a shining light..."

— John 5:35 (KJV)

Many modern translations render the word **light** as **lamp**. John was a burning and shining lamp. His spirit continually burned before God. That is why he was sent into the wilderness. He was there tending the lamp of his spirit, ensuring that the fire never went out.

This was the same principle God taught the priests under the Old Covenant. He commanded:

"The fire shall ever be burning upon the altar; it shall never go out."

— Leviticus 6:13 (KJV)

When the lamp of your temple is burning, you possess light for life's journey. When you meet people, you know how to respond. You no longer know men merely after the flesh. You discern them by the Spirit because your inner lamp is alive.

The Fire of God Upon Your Spirit

The Book of Revelation tells us:

"...seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God."

— Revelation 4:5 (KJV)

Not only does the Spirit of God burn, your human spirit also burns because His Spirit dwells within you.

The Scripture says:

"But he that is joined unto the Lord is one spirit."

— 1 Corinthians 6:17 (KJV)

The more you fellowship with Him, the more the burnings of His Spirit ignite your own spirit.

Your lamp begins to burn.

David understood this principle.

He declared:

"For thou wilt light my candle: the LORD my God will enlighten my darkness."

— Psalm 18:28 (KJV)

Then he continued:

"For by thee I have run through a troop; and by my God have I leaped over a wall."

— Psalm 18:29 (KJV)

It does not matter what armies of darkness stand against me.

As long as my spirit is burning, I have light.

By my God, I can run through a troop.

By my God, I can leap over a wall.

No resistance of darkness is sufficient to restrain a man whose lamp is burning.

Tend the Lamp of Your Spirit

The responsibility of prophetic people is to ensure that their lamp never goes out. Do everything possible to keep your lamp burning. Do not allow distractions to extinguish your fire. It is through the burning of your inner lamp that you receive light to navigate every season. It does not matter where you find yourself.

If there is light, there is a way forward.

Job said:

"By His light I walked through darkness."

The prophetic begins with the inner man.

It starts in your spirit.

Then the light that enters your spirit floods your mind.

Finally, your mind begins to see.

The Mind Is the Canvas of Revelation

The pictures... The visions... The prophetic images...

All of them are projected upon the canvas of your mind. It is with the eyes of your mind that you see visions. The same mind you use to solve mathematical problems...

The same mind you use to study medicine...

The same mind you use to retain knowledge...

It is that same mind God uses to reveal His visions.

Because of this, you must do everything possible to keep your mind healthy and pure.

Guarding Your Environment

Many times, when I find myself alone in a hotel room, I do not spend my time watching television. If there is Wi-Fi available, I will play worship music or listen to sound biblical teaching.

Why?

Because I am deliberately controlling my environment. I am guarding my mind. I know that my mind is one of my greatest prophetic assets. If I allow every kind of thought to cloud my heart, I will lose the light needed to journey accurately.

At one point, my family and I decided to unsubscribe from DSTV. It may seem old-fashioned to some people, but every destiny has its own consecration. Instead, we told our children:

"There is Wi-Fi in this house, but if you are going to watch anything, there are three priorities."

We call them **the Three E's**.

1. **Edification**
2. **Education**
3. **Entertainment**

Entertainment comes last. You must culture your environment.

If you walk into my living room, you will not find people spending the entire day watching entertainment from morning until night. Our environment is intentionally guarded. It is intentionally sanctified.

If my children are going to watch anything, it must first edify them. Next, it should educate them.

Entertainment comes afterward.

Why?

Because the Bible says:

"Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life."

— Proverbs 4:23 (KJV)

Some people spend hours watching one season after another, filling their minds with every imaginable distraction.

Then they wonder why they cannot hear God.

Later, when it is time to make major life decisions—such as marriage—they find themselves completely confused.

There is no light.

Their candlestick has gone out.

They wonder why they no longer experience visions from God.

When they close their eyes to meditate, instead of seeing what God is revealing, they see the images they have continually filled their minds with.

A Life of Consecration

People often tell me about football results, and I discover I know nothing about them.

They ask,

"How can you be on earth and not know who won the Premier League?"

I simply smile.

I live in a different ecosystem.

And I am not saying that watching football makes someone a sinner.

This is simply my own consecration.

There was a time when I was a passionate football fan.

God delivered me from that.

Why?

Because you must guard your heart.

You must guard your environment.

If you want to tend the fire of God within you...

If you want to grow in prophetic vision...

Then you must protect the atmosphere around your life.

When divine light comes, your mind must possess enough strength and transformation to capture the thoughts of God.

Your renewed mind must be able to recognize those spontaneous impressions that the Holy Spirit places within.

God Begins With a Thought

When God communicates prophetically, it often begins with a thought.

God thinks concerning a matter.

Then He brings you into His frequency.

Suddenly, you begin thinking with Him.

You begin understanding what He desires to reveal.

In physics there is a principle called **resonance**.

Resonance is the vibration of one body causing another body to vibrate at the same natural frequency.

The same principle illustrates prophetic communion.

As I keep the fire of God burning within me, when the Holy Spirit begins to move, my spirit vibrates with His.

I begin to think His thoughts.

I begin to hear His voice.

I begin to understand His Word.

That is why I do everything possible to guard my heart.

I carefully watch over my mind.

The prophetic has much more to do with the mind than many believers realize.

When people think about the prophetic, they think only about the spirit.

But let us look at the Scriptures.

Daniel and the Revelation of Secrets

In **Daniel 2**, Daniel and his companions sought the Lord concerning Nebuchadnezzar's dream.

The Bible says:

"Then was the secret revealed unto Daniel in a night vision..."

— Daniel 2:19 (KJV)

Daniel praised God, declaring:

"He revealeth the deep and secret things: he knoweth what is in the darkness, and the light dwelleth with him."

— Daniel 2:22 (KJV)

Light dwells with God because God Himself is light.

Later Daniel stood before Nebuchadnezzar and declared:

"But there is a God in heaven that revealeth secrets..."

— Daniel 2:28 (KJV)

Then Daniel explained what happened to the king:

"As for thee, O king... thy thoughts came into thy mind upon thy bed, what should come to pass hereafter..."

— Daniel 2:29 (KJV)

Notice that.

Thoughts came into his mind concerning future events.

The One who reveals secrets placed those thoughts there.

The prophetic has much to do with the mind.

The Holy Spirit aligned the king's mind to receive a prophetic transmission.

Thoughts came into his mind about things yet to happen.

Daniel then humbly explained:

"...that thou mightest know the thoughts of thy heart."

— Daniel 2:30 (KJV)

The Salvation of the Soul

Do not become a praying believer while neglecting your soul.

Pay careful attention to the Word of God.

The Word does far more than provide information.

It transforms.

It deals with every form of corruption within the soul.

The salvation of the soul takes place through continual exposure to God's Word.

Peter speaks of:

"...receiving the end of your faith, even the salvation of your souls."

— 1 Peter 1:9 (KJV)

James also says:

"Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls."

— James 1:21 (KJV)

God is continually working within the soul until it becomes capable of thinking with Him.

Adam Entered the Thoughts of God

In Genesis, God brought the animals to Adam.

The Scripture says:

"...whatsoever Adam called every living creature, that was the name thereof."

— Genesis 2:19 (KJV)

Notice what happened.

Adam did not randomly invent names while God merely approved them afterward.

No.

Whatever Adam called them was already correct.

Why?

Because Adam entered into the thoughts of God.

He perceived each creature's identity exactly as God intended. His prophetic mind was functioning. His consciousness was aligned with God's. His mind was alive. His understanding was enlightened. He could think the thoughts of God.

That is how the prophetic operates. Very often, God broadcasts into your mind.

The Holy Spirit aligns your thinking with His own frequency.

The Different Ways Revelation Comes

Just as multimedia contains different forms of communication, so does prophetic revelation. Sometimes revelation comes as **still images**. You simply see a picture.

There is no accompanying voice. At other times, revelation comes as **audio**. You hear a voice, but you see nothing. Sometimes revelation is **audio-visual**.

You both hear and see simultaneously. This is one of the beautiful ways the Holy Spirit communicates with His people.

If man created all of these forms of multimedia, it was by the ability of God. Man was made in the image of God. So, when your mind is aligned with your spirit and the Holy Ghost lights you up, everything He speaks into your spirit, your mind will be able to interpret. The eyes of your mind—the eyes of your heart—will be enlightened. You'll be able to know the thoughts of God.

In **Amos 4:13 (KJV)**, the Bible says:

"For, lo, he that formeth the mountains, and createth the wind, and declareth unto man what is his thought..."

If you read some other translations, you'll notice that it emphasizes that God reveals His thoughts to man. God has thoughts, and He reveals His thoughts into your thoughts.

The prophetic is about knowing the thoughts of God concerning you. It is about coming into the mind of God. That is why we say prophecy is the revelation of the mind and the will of God.

Coming Into the Thoughts of God

In **Isaiah 55:6–9 (KJV)**, the Lord says:

"Seek ye the LORD while he may be found, call ye upon him while he is near: Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts: and let him return unto the LORD, and he will have mercy upon him... For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith the LORD. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts."

God desires to bring you into His thoughts.

The anointing of the Holy Spirit brings us to that point where our spirits receive the light of God, and our minds receive His thoughts.

That is why **1 John 2:20 (KJV)** says:

"But ye have an unction from the Holy One, and ye know all things."

Part of what the prophetic anointing does within the believer is to bring him into divine knowledge. It is the anointing that enables you to know. It is the anointing that enables you to see.

The Holy Spirit Can Turn Your Mind

In Daniel chapter 2, one translation says:

"While you were on your bed, your mind turned to the future."

The Holy Ghost can turn your mind. That is how the revelatory gifts operate. Within a split second—even within a nanosecond—your mind is carried into God. It is almost as though God thinks briefly with your mind.

Someone once asked me,

"How do you receive words of knowledge? How do you know these things?"

I explained that a word of knowledge is like trying to remember something you never learned. Everything you have ever known is stored within the memory bank of your mind. If I ask you where your house is, immediately a picture of your house appears in your mind.

If I ask whether you have ever seen a pink elephant, it becomes difficult because you have never seen one. If I ask whether you have ever seen a dog, instantly the picture of a dog appears.

That is how the Holy Ghost works.

When He gives you a word of knowledge, He enables you to tap into the memory bank of God.

Suddenly, you are no longer thinking from the information stored in your human memory but from the knowledge stored in the mind of God.

For a brief moment, you think with the mind of God. It is like remembering something you never knew. You can only remember what you already know. If I ask you about your wife or about your trip to the United States, you can give details because those memories already exist within you.

But in the operation of the word of knowledge, the Holy Ghost inserts your mind into the memory bank of the Spirit.

Suddenly, you know something you were never taught.

That is why faith is required.

Even for me, there are times I receive things that are so weighty that I must go away and pray over them because the download is not consistent with my normal thinking patterns.

The Mind Must Be Renewed

That is why we must continually yield ourselves to the Word of God and to prayer. That is how conversion takes place within the soul.

That is how your soul begins to align with your spirit so that every flow from the Holy Spirit can enter your mind and be properly received.

The prophetic is not only about the spirit.

The mind is also involved.

The revelatory gifts have much to do with the mind.

If your mind is dirty, if your mind is corrupted, you will not be able to transmit accurately for God.

The Utterance Gifts

When it comes to the utterance gifts, it is almost as though the Holy Spirit bypasses the normal processes of the mind.

As the **naba** operation begins, words start bubbling up within your spirit.

Before your mind has the opportunity to analyze or rationalize them, they have already been spoken.

That is why prophecy is classified among the **utterance gifts**, not the revelatory gifts.

The revelatory gifts are:

- The word of wisdom
- The word of knowledge
- Discerning of spirits

But prophecy is an utterance gift.

As the words bubble up from within your spirit, you simply yield by faith and begin to utter things that have been hidden from before the foundation of the world.

How Words of Knowledge Can Come

In the revelatory gifts, the Holy Spirit lays hold of your mind and paints pictures there.

The first time I ever received a word of knowledge concerning someone's name, I was still in school.

I was preaching in a fellowship.

As I looked at one sister, the picture of another lady I had known while growing up suddenly appeared in my mind.

Before I had time to analyze what I was seeing, I looked at her and said,

"Esther."

Everyone was surprised because I had just arrived there. There was no natural way I could have known that her name was Esther.

Then I began to release the word of the Lord.

Some people may say,

"Ah! You are such a powerful man."

But honestly, even I felt as though the Holy Ghost bypassed my own thinking. He simply brought the picture of that Esther into my mind. The same thing can happen when I look at someone whose name is Tony.

I may not know him naturally, but suddenly the picture of another Tony I know appears in my mind. Without thinking, I simply call him Tony. Many believers do not understand how these things work. They are not nearly as mysterious as people imagine.

You only need to remain under the tutorship of the Holy Ghost.

The Holy Spirit Becomes Your Personal Teacher

Much of His communication comes through signs. One day I looked at a lady, and suddenly the image of my wife's beautiful flower appeared in my mind. Before I could even process it, I said,

"Rose."

There are times you actually hear words within your spirit. But as you continue walking with the Holy Ghost, it becomes an adventure. He becomes your personal Teacher.

He schools you in the School of the Spirit. You are the only student in your classroom. You have no classmates. That is why you do not need to struggle to become like someone else. The Holy Spirit trains you according to your own wiring, your own configuration, and your own ordination.

He teaches each of us according to our individual makeup. That is why every believer hears God differently. We can teach principles and share signs, but the inward operations of the Spirit will always be unique to each individual.

That is why Scripture says:

"...the people that do know their God shall be strong, and do exploits." —

Daniel 11:32 (KJV)

Notice that it says **their God**, not merely the God of your father or the God of your pastor.

He must become your God.

The Re-Education of a Prophetic Person

It takes years for God to raise prophetic people because there is a continual re-education taking place. The way you have learned to think, God begins to retrain. He takes you through pathways. He opens your spirit. You begin to see. You begin to know.

Sometimes while I am praying, I simply hear something within my spirit.

David said in **Psalms 16:7 (KJV)**:

"I will bless the LORD, who hath given me counsel: my reins also instruct me in the night seasons."

When the Lord speaks to your spirit, it is your heart—your mind—that begins to instruct you.

The communication enters your spirit, but your soul begins to understand what God is saying as light rises within your mind.

Many people think that when we speak about the prophetic, we are speaking only about the spirit.

But your mind is very important.

Moses: A Different Dimension

In **Numbers 12:6–8 (KJV)**, God called Moses, Aaron, and Miriam together and said:

"If there be a prophet among you, I the LORD will make myself known unto him in a vision, and will speak unto him in a dream."

Then He said:

"My servant Moses is not so... With him will I speak mouth to mouth... and the similitude of the LORD shall he behold."

Moses belonged to a different class. For ordinary prophets, God spoke through visions and dreams. But with Moses, there was direct communion. The word **similitude** speaks of the form or manifestation of the Lord.

Whatever way God chose to appear, Moses had been so trained in the Spirit that he could discern Him. His discernment had become mature.

God Is Not Limited in How He Speaks

God may choose to speak through a television advertisement. Years ago, my life seemed to be falling apart. As I sat in my living room, I watched a Milo advertisement.

A young boy kicked a football into the net, and the advert simply said,

"Pursue your dream."

At that moment, it became the voice of God to my spirit.

That season of my life was filled with dreams and visions from God.

The Lord was saying,

"Pursue it."

It became the word of the Lord to me.

God can speak through a billboard.

He can speak through an unbeliever.

One day I was about to enter a bus when I heard a little girl—perhaps eight or ten years old—telling her friends,

"Don't enter this bus. It is going to break down."

I entered anyway.

Immediately, I lost my peace.

The Holy Ghost said,

"I just spoke to you through that little girl."

We continued the journey until eventually the bus broke down.

I missed the meeting where I was supposed to preach.

That experience taught me something.

The similitude of the Lord shall Moses behold.

God is not confined to visions and dreams.

Do not say,

"Unless I feel fire in my belly..."

or,

"Unless my body begins to shake..."

God can speak through your child.

Learning to Discern Every Voice of God

One of the men who worked with Apostle Joseph Ayo Babalola was said to possess an unusual grace.

It was said that he could interpret the cries of babies.

Now, that is not listed among the gifts in **1 Corinthians 12**, but there are depths in God.

He could enter a place, hear a baby crying, and discern what was being communicated.

There were also occasions when they travelled through villages.

As birds chirped nearby, he suddenly stopped and said,

"The birds are telling us there is a python ahead waiting to attack someone."

As they proceeded carefully, they discovered a large python hiding exactly where he had indicated.

Who told you your wall cannot speak to you?

Who told you God cannot speak through a television advertisement?

Who told you He cannot speak through a billboard?

God said concerning Moses,

"...the similitude of the LORD shall he behold." — **Numbers 12:8 (KJV)**

Moses had been trained to discern God in whatever form He chose to appear.

He was not waiting only for visions or dreams.

Like David in **2 Samuel 5**, when David asked,

"Shall I pursue the Philistines?"

The Lord instructed him:

*"...when thou hearest the sound of a going in the tops of the mulberry trees,
then... bestir thyself..."* (2 Samuel 5:24, KJV)

David understood that when he heard the sound in the tops of the mulberry trees, the hosts of heaven had gone before him into battle.

He had learned to discern the voice of God in the ways God chose to speak.

Fan Into Flame the Gift of God

That is why David never lost a battle. At every point, he would inquire of the Lord. David never fought by experience; he fought by inspiration. Every time, he waited for the stirrings of the Spirit. He never said, "This is the strategy that worked the last time." No.

That is why the Bible says:

"Pray without ceasing." — *1 Thessalonians 5:17 (KJV)*

Pray without ceasing. Quench not the fire of the Spirit.

Have you ever watched a blacksmith at work? As he pumps the bellows, the temperature rises, the pressure increases, and the fire becomes red hot. That is exactly what happens to your inner man when you pray.

You are fanning the flame.

Perhaps your fire has gone out. But when you begin to pray, the fanning begins again. You begin to **fan into flame the gift of God** that is within you. Suddenly your spirit becomes red hot. Suddenly light begins to shine from within, giving you the ability to navigate life's journey.

Pray without ceasing.

Quench not the fire of the Spirit.

Despise not prophesyings.

When you pray long enough, light comes. When your lamp begins to burn, illumination follows. That light enables you to receive the word of the Lord because it is only what you have seen that you can prophesy.

"Surely the Lord GOD will do nothing, but he revealeth his secret unto his servants the prophets." — *Amos 3:7 (KJV)*

The Lord God has spoken—who can but prophesy?

Paul therefore admonished Timothy:

"Wherefore I put thee in remembrance that thou stir up the gift of God, which is in thee..." — 2 Timothy 1:6 (KJV)

Then he continued:

"For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind." — 2 Timothy 1:7 (KJV)

There is power in your spirit.

There is love in your spirit.

There is the mind of Christ in your spirit.

One day, as I was meditating on that Scripture, the Holy Spirit said to me, *"I have given you the spirit of power, of love, and of a prophetic mind."*

What a revelation!

I have the mind of Christ.

If I stir up the gift of God long enough, I will have visions. I will receive revelations. I will have sight to navigate.

Someone may ask, "How do I know whether the visions I receive are from God? How do I know my mind is not simply imagining things?"

Many years ago, I experienced very intense visions. Then there came a season when those visions reduced, and I asked the Lord what was happening. I prayed, "Lord, how do I know when You are speaking to me?"

He directed me to John chapter one.

"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God." — John 1:1 (KJV)

Then He brought me to verse four:

"In him was life; and the life was the light of men." — John 1:4 (KJV)

The Lord said to me, *"You will know Me by the sense of life."*

We know God by life because God is life.

Jesus said:

"And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent." — John 17:3 (KJV)

If you continually stir up the divine life within you, you will know what to do because **life produces light.**

"In Him was life, and the life was the light of men."

If I stir up the Zoe of God within me, I will have light to navigate. I will know what to do in every area of life because life gives birth to light.

Can you find your lamp again?

Can you find your spirit again?

David declared:

"For thou wilt light my candle: the LORD my God will enlighten my darkness." — Psalm 18:28 (KJV)

By my God I can run through a troop.

By my God I can leap over a wall.

The spirit of man is the candle of the Lord, searching all the inward parts of the belly.

Can you cry out:

"Lord, light me up! Light me like the menorah! Let my spirit burn! Burn! Burn! Burn!"

John was a burning and a shining lamp.

As long as he kept burning, his voice reached the entire nation.

The key to the prophetic is to ensure that your lamp is always burning.

A Prophetic Impartation

The spirit of seeing and knowing is here.

The seeing eye and the hearing ear are from the Lord.

The Bible says:

"Counsel in the heart of man is like deep water; but a man of understanding will draw it out." — Proverbs 20:5 (KJV)

The counsel of the Lord is like deep waters within you. It takes illumination to draw it out.

Can you declare:

"I draw tonight!"

I see the Holy Ghost lighting people up right now.

Jesus said:

"Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid." — Matthew 5:14 (KJV)

No man lights a candle and hides it under a bushel. He places it on a candlestick so it gives light to everyone in the house.

The Holy Ghost is lighting your spirit.

You will not remain under a bushel.

That is the secret of visibility.

Ensure that you are lit.

I see the Holy Ghost walking through this place.

The hearing ear and the seeing eye are from the Lord.

The Lord is giving sight.

The Lord is giving hearing.

The Lord is lighting men up.

The fire of God is coming upon your spirit.

Your heart will burn.

Did not our hearts burn within us while He spoke with us?

Burning hearts.

Burning hearts.

Jeremiah declared:

"But his word was in mine heart as a burning fire shut up in my bones..." — *Jeremiah 20:9 (KJV)*

There is a fresh kindling tonight.

Holy Ghost, begin to light Your people.

Begin to light them.

Some of you whose eyes have been covered—Receive eyes!

Receive seeing eyes!

He comes.

From my left to my right, I see garments of fire coming upon people.

Eyes are opening.

Ears are opening.

Tonight is a night of prophetic induction for many of you.

Come into your season.

Receive the fire.

God is inducting seers tonight.

Seers of divine revelation.

Father, let Your hand rest upon them.

Hand of God, move.

Let the Spirit enter them.

Just as in the days of Moses, when God called the seventy elders and took of the Spirit that rested upon Moses and placed it upon them.

Lord, where are the seventy?

Where are the company of Eldad and Medad?

The Bible says the Spirit of the Lord came upon them, and they prophesied.

Locate them tonight.

Let this be a night of encounter.

A night of visitation.

Angels of fire, locate them everywhere—Inside. Outside. Online.

Let the Spirit enter you.

Receive the baptism.

Our fathers were baptized under Moses.

Tonight is a night of prophetic baptism.

Lift your hands if you are hungry.

The Lord is locating His seventy.

Take the fire.

Take the fire.

For this is that which was spoken by the prophet Joel:

"And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh..." — Joel 2:28 (KJV)

Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy.

Your young men shall see visions.

Your old men shall dream dreams.

He will pour out His Spirit, and they shall prophesy.

The prophetic is not only for the church.

Receive fire for your office.

Receive fire for the marketplace.

Receive fire for your family.

Wherever you go, let your spirit burn.

I see a cloud dropping fire upon the front rows.

Holy Ghost—

Mantle them.

Some of you are receiving life-changing encounters.

Even those joining online, God is encountering you.

The anointing for visions is resting upon you.

Some of you will fall into a trance.

There is a bowl of fire.

Take the fire.

Take the fire.

Let prevailing worshippers arise.

May the Lord touch your tongue with coals of fire.

The hand of the Lord is upon you.

Fire of God!

Fire of God!

Let the prophetic fire come upon you.

Receive it now.

Jesus.

My God.

There are people who will carry this fire to campuses.

Some will carry it into banks.

Some will carry it into every sphere of society.

Some of you will feel as though you have been connected to a high-voltage power line.

The Lord is activating the tangible healing anointing.

"Neglect not the gift that is in thee..." — 1 Timothy 4:14 (KJV)

Gift of healings—

Be released.

Be released.

You came from far and near.

You will not return empty.

You are going back with something.

You are going back with the fire of the Holy Ghost.

You are returning with a fresh anointing.

May healers arise.

May men who carry healing fire arise.

May women who carry healing fire arise.

Let them arise everywhere.

“Oh!” *[The preacher cried out in the Spirit.]*

“I see the burning ones. I see burning men walking through us... walking through us. Some of you, they will pass by you, and you will come into fire. They will pass you. They will pass you.”

“Pastor of Kaduna, there is a burning one by your side. Hey! Hey! Hey!”

“Touch! Touch! Touch!”

“My God! My God! My God!”

Young people, lift up your hands. If you are hungry, lift up your hands.

It is like a garment. It is like a mantle resting upon people.

Paul said:

“For I long to see you, that I may impart unto you some spiritual gift, to the end ye may be established.”

— **Romans 1:11 (KJV)**

Take it.

Take it.

Take it.

It is for your establishment.

All over this place—even outside and at the back—there is a distribution taking place.

There is a distribution going on.

The gift of discerning of spirits is being released.

There are at least twenty-five people who are coming into the tangible operation of the discerning of spirits.

You will see angels.

You will see heaven as God wills.

Sometimes God will give you access to the deep things of the Spirit so that you can become a prophetic evangelist. When you preach, your words will burn with conviction, and men will be pierced in their hearts.

“Father!”

The preacher cried out.

“Let that gift of discerning of spirits be released now!

Now!”

“Yes!

Holy Ghost!

Holy Ghost!

Holy Ghost!”

Some of you, the discerning of spirits will not operate only through sight.

There was a time when I began to experience the discerning of spirits through smell.

I once smelled the spirit of death in my neighbor's house. I was still a young believer then, and I did not know what to do. I did not know how to pray about it.

Less than an hour later, my neighbor's son—who was also my friend—was on the football field preparing to take a free kick. Suddenly, he collapsed and died.

I wept like a child.

I had smelled the spirit of death before it happened.

From that day, there have been times while ministering to people that I have known those afflicted by demonic spirits simply by spiritual fragrance. I can smell the presence of demons.

Sometimes I walk close to a person, and immediately I perceive it.

When that discernment opens, the odor is worse than sulfur and ammonia combined.

It is a terrible stench.

There are also times when I pray and perceive the fragrance of heaven.

Sometimes I can smell people in the Spirit.

I am not a puppy, but I can discern spiritual fragrance.

Occult practitioners understand these realities.

I see the Lord touching people's nostrils.

You will discern men not only by sight.

You will smell them.

You will smell angels.

You will smell demons.

You will smell the presence of the Lord.

One day, while I was praying in my closet, a fragrance like vanilla filled the room.

I knew immediately that the Lord was near.

That is the closest description I can give.

“Father, thank You for a night of distributions.

Distributions.

This conference is a conference to unleash prophets.

To unleash seers.

Seers over families.

Seers over territories.

Over cities.

Over nations.

Watchmen, arise!”

The preacher cried aloud.

“You will live, and you will become a watchman.”

You will begin to see the visions of the Lord.

You will carry His burden.

The sons of Issachar had understanding of the times.

They knew what Israel ought to do.

They could discern and interpret the handwriting of God in their generation.

The reason God gives prophetic sight and intelligence is so that you can carry His burden.

If Issachar was able to understand the times and interpret the seasons, it was because they had become burden bearers.

The Scripture says:

“And of the children of Issachar, which were men that had understanding of the times, to know what Israel ought to do...”

— **1 Chronicles 12:32 (KJV)**

Yet the prophetic picture concerning Issachar is that he is:

“...a strong ass couching down between two burdens.”

— **Genesis 49:14 (KJV)**

The relationship suddenly ends.

On several occasions, your families have even begun preparations for traditional marriage introductions, but every time there has been disappointment.

I have seen at least four disappointments.

This is the family of God.

If that is your experience, come.

The Scripture says:

“For surely there is an end; and thine expectation shall not be cut off.”

— **Proverbs 23:18 (KJV)**

The Holy Ghost has not stopped moving.

But we need to switch for a moment.

If you are that person, come.

How many times has this happened?

You have had this dream repeatedly?

These are the symptoms I am describing.

I am not speaking generally.

Is this your experience?

Suitors have come.

Families have been involved.

Yet every one of them left.

How many times?

“Three times.”

And you?

“Countless.”

“No,” the preacher replied. “Not countless. How many times?”

“Four times.”

They have come.

They have gone.

And this recurring dream has remained.

Lift up your hands.

“Tonight, we destroy the veil of witchcraft.

Play gently for me.

Lord, we speak over these ones.

Every covenant that has given spirits of darkness legal access into their lives—

Let that covenant be broken!

Break!

Break tonight!

Let them go!

Let them go!

Go!

Be free tonight by the blood of Jesus!

We break every covenant.

We shut every door.

Every covenant that has given these spirits access—

We break it.

Be loosed in the name of Jesus!”

“My sister...

Today the enemy is exposed.

His legal grounds are destroyed in the name of the Lord Jesus.

Go!

Let me touch all of you.”

“Every bondage—Break!

In the name of Jesus!”

We declare her free in the name of Jesus.

I curse that demon. I curse that affliction.

I declare that she is free from this moment.

Let those legs begin to return to their normal size.

Let the yoke of witchcraft be broken in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ.

It is done.

Your mother is set free.

Your mother also?

Father, we release the same mercy, the same benevolence of the Lord.

Let them all be delivered.
