Introduction

The thread running through this conference has been remarkably consistent. Every speaker who has stood on this platform has addressed one central theme—the **changing of the guard**.

Each speaker has highlighted the dangers confronting this generation: the rise of counterfeit voices, false ministries, and the challenges facing the Church. Yet they have also pointed us toward God's solution and the direction in which He is leading His people.

Hallelujah!

The consistent message has been that God is raising a new generation of leaders. This is a season of transition. There is a changing of the guard, and every speaker has described the characteristics of those who will make up this new guard—how they must live, how they must conduct themselves, and what God requires of them in this season.

During my first session with you on Wednesday, I shared the word the Lord gave me while I was in London. When Apostle first spoke to me, the Lord reminded me of the changing of the guard that takes place at Buckingham Palace.

There, you see soldiers standing faithfully at their posts. They remain dedicated to their assignment until the appointed time comes for transition. Then another group arrives, there is a handover, and a new guard takes over the responsibility.

If you have been listening carefully to what the Spirit of the Lord is saying in this season, you will recognize that God is speaking about such a handover.

Hallelujah!

In the previous session, I laid a foundation by sharing some of the characteristics necessary to become part of the new guard that God is establishing in this hour.

As the old guard is being replaced, different reasons account for that transition. Some faithful servants are stepping aside simply because of age. The baton is being passed to another generation.

However, others are being replaced because they failed in their kingdom guard duties. They did not fulfill the responsibilities entrusted to them.

As a result, a new guard must arise to replace the old, and there must be a proper handover.

Somebody say,

"Handover!"

Understanding the Season of Handover

From the spiritual realm, we must discern the times and seasons in which we are living.

This is a season of **handover**.

Previously, I compared this season to a relay race. In a relay race, victory depends upon one runner successfully passing the baton to the next.

Likewise, the Lord showed me that the baton is now being handed to Africa.

Many continents have already experienced their appointed seasons. They have carried the baton for their generation.

Now God is releasing that baton to African apostles and African prophets.

We must understand the times, prepare ourselves, and be ready to receive what Heaven is entrusting to us.

The Lord declared:

"Do not drop the baton."

Tell three people,

"Do not drop the baton."

Remain alert.

Remain vigilant.

Recognize that the baton is changing hands.

Africa—the continent that was despised, colonized, and looked down upon—is entering her season of rising.

God has spoken.

Our days of being known as the begging bowl are over.

Our days of being despised are ending.

Our days of being labeled the "Third World" are coming to an end.

Our days of being described as the "Dark Continent" must end.

The new guard will usher Africa into a new identity—a continent of light.

A continent that has received Yeshua HaMashiach.

A continent that has embraced her apostolic and prophetic mandate.

Hallelujah!

Understanding National Redemptive Purpose

In our previous session, we also spoke about understanding the redemptive purpose of nations.

I sought to help you understand that Nigeria's purpose is much bigger than Nigeria itself.

Nigeria carries a continental responsibility.

The nations of Africa are waiting for the rising of Nigeria.

Your assignment is not merely national.

It is continental.

We also discussed the importance of understanding your environment.

As one of the previous speakers emphasized, you can never function effectively in a place whose atmosphere, mandate, and spiritual environment you do not understand.

That is why we must pray and ask God to reveal these things to us, so that we function in alignment with the redemptive purpose of the territory where He has placed us.

Amen.

Lessons from the School of Prophets

I remember attending the School of Prophets under my spiritual father.

Although he is based in Ghana, he originally comes from Nigeria.

During those days, classes began at 8:00 every morning and ended at 5:00 in the evening.

If you arrived even five minutes late, you remained standing for the entire class.

I remember warning my taxi driver:

"If you make me late, both of us will stand together!"

That was how serious the discipline was.

He was teaching us self-control, order, and alignment.

Even his own wife attended the same class, and she received no special treatment. If she came late, she also stood.

One lesson from that experience has remained with me.

For almost two months, nobody taught us about prophets.

Instead, we studied one subject:

The Kingdom.

Every day we learned about the Kingdom.

What is the Kingdom?

What does it represent?

Who is the King?

The word **kingdom** points us to the King and His dominion.

How can you represent God when you do not understand His Kingdom?

How can you function in an environment you do not understand?

Before we ever studied the prophetic office, we first had to understand the King's domain.

We studied God's earthly jurisdiction. We learned about the three heavens. We explored how His Kingdom functions. We examined **Psalm 148** to understand the different dimensions of God's Kingdom.

Many students became frustrated. Some even wanted to leave the School of Prophets.

They kept asking, "When are we finally going to learn about prophets?"

But our instructor would respond, "How will you function as a prophet when you do not understand the environment in which you are called to function?"

Many today are making that very mistake.

Understanding the Kingdom Before Ministry

You must understand more than your calling.

You must understand the Kingdom itself.

You must know its pillars.

Scripture tells us:

"Justice and judgment are the habitation of thy throne: mercy and truth shall go before thy face." — Psalm 89:14 (KJV)

How can anyone function correctly while operating outside the principles of righteousness and justice upon which God's throne is established?

We had to study the thrones of heaven.

We learned about scepters and authority.

Sometimes we have ministered in nations experiencing political conflict and disputed elections.

When we entered those places prophetically, we understood that we were confronting spiritual rulerships.

We knew we were dealing with the scepter—the spiritual authority behind earthly governance.

But how can someone understand such assignments without first understanding the Kingdom?

The Necessity of Process

Once again, we return to the subject of **process**.

Some people simply want to arrive at the gate and imagine that after making a few declarations the devil begins to tremble.

No.

That is not how spiritual authority works.

You must understand the principalities stationed at the gates. You must understand the battles fought at the gates. You must know how to deal with territorial strongholds.

You must understand how spiritual scepters are removed. You must be prepared to confront the enemies positioned at the gates. That is why we went through a season of processing. We were trained.

We learned the Kingdom.

Only after two months did we begin studying the office of the prophet. Because before you understand your office, you must understand your environment.

You must understand the atmosphere into which God has placed you.

Hallelujah!

The Constitution of the Kingdom

What is the constitution of God's Kingdom?

Sadly, many believers do not even know it. The constitution is the Word of God. The Bible is the constitution that every Kingdom citizen is called to enforce.

Hallelujah!

God's Search for Gatekeepers

Previously we spoke about the redemptive purpose of Africa and Nigeria. We discussed the ministry of gatekeeping. We considered Mordecai and Absalom. In this season, God is looking for **Mordecai gatekeepers**.

Not people who appoint themselves to strategic positions like Absalom did, but men and women whom God Himself has assigned for national purposes rather than personal ambition.

Hallelujah!

The Church Must Leave the Building

In this session, I want to continue speaking on **Changing of the Guard (Part 2)**.

One of the things the Lord spoke clearly to me about is this: The Church must move beyond the building and begin impacting the world outside its walls. We have remained inside the building for too long.

Every Sunday we gather together, and that is good because the Scriptures instruct us:

**"Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together..." —
Hebrews 10:25 (KJV)**

The church gathering is our filling station. It is where we come to be refreshed, strengthened, and filled. But once we leave, that is where our influence should become visible. Our impact must be felt in the marketplace.

It is not enough to gather, sing "Hallelujah," and then leave without transforming our communities. The Church must leave the building.

The Salt Must Leave the Shaker

Salt is never effective while it remains inside the salt shaker. How can it preserve anything if it never comes out?

It must first be shaken. Then it must be poured out. As I prayed, the Lord gave me a picture. I saw the Church as a salt shaker. Someone was trying to shake it, but the salt would not come out.

It was blocked.

The Lord said this is a picture of the Church today. The salt has been blocked by many things. But I hear the Spirit of the Lord declaring:

"I am about to unblock the salt shaker."

The unblocking is connected to the changing of the guard. God is raising a new generation that will remove every blockage. Tell somebody:

"I am about to be part of that unblocking."

Church, God is shaking us. He is shaking us in Benue. He is shaking us across Nigeria.

He is shaking us out of comfort.

He is shaking us out of complacency.

He is shaking us out of fatigue.

Tell somebody:

"Be shaken!"

God is shaking us out of spiritual slumber.

We will not fear.

For,

"For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind." — 2 Timothy 1:7 (KJV)

Tell somebody,

"I am about to step out."

I will not be intimidated.

I refuse intimidation.

I am stepping out prophetically.

We are stepping beyond Benue.

We are stepping beyond Nigeria.

We are going to the nations.

For,

"Arise, shine; for thy light is come, and the glory of the LORD is risen upon thee." — Isaiah 60:1 (KJV)

God is shaking me so that I can shake nations.

Wherever I go, I will carry His grace.

Demons will tremble.

The anointing of God will be revealed.

I will carry the shaking of God wherever He sends me.

Once again, I see that salt shaker.

It has been shaken.

Now it is being unblocked.

The salt is finally coming out.

Tell somebody:

"The salt is coming out!"

The Salt Must Go to the Nations

Tell somebody:

"The salt is coming out!"

The salt is coming out.

It is going to the nations.

It is going to Jerusalem.

It is going to Judea.

Tell somebody,

"Judea, here I come!"

The salt is going to Samaria.

Tell somebody,

"Samaria, here I come!"

The salt is going to the uttermost parts of the earth.

Church, it is time to move.

Take someone's hand and say,

"Let's go!"

You have been seated for too long.

Arise, Church!

Let us go!

We are no longer sitting at the gate like lepers.

We are rising to possess the gates.

God is shaking His Church.

What is happening across the nations is a divine shaking designed to bring us out of complacency and out of our comfort zones.

We are being shaken so that we will come out.

It is time to arise.

Be shaken!

Shaken to Bring Transformation

God is shaking you so that you can bring His shaking into the earth.

Shake out corruption.

Shake out theft.

Shake out every counterfeit.

Tell somebody,

"I am here to shake out the counterfeit."

I am here to shake out fraud.

I am here to shake out poverty.

May the grace to bring righteous change rest upon you.

It is in your spiritual DNA.

You are salt.

When salt appears, things change.

When salt appears, there is a shift.

When salt appears, there is flavor.

Tell somebody,

"I am a flavor."

I am a flavor of righteousness.

I am a flavor of the Kingdom of God.

God is shaking me so that I can introduce a new taste.

There will be the taste of righteousness.

There will be the taste of God's Kingdom.

Tell somebody,

"I am the salt."

There is a shaking because the light has awakened to the power that God has placed within us.

Light Must No Longer Hide

In this season, light will no longer bow before darkness.

Tell somebody,

"I am the light."

I carry the light of God.

I will no longer remain hidden.

I will no longer remain invisible.

How can false prophets continue speaking while those carrying God's true light remain silent?

Tell somebody,

"I am about to show up."

I am about to release a sound.

A sound of deliverance.

A sound filled with the savor of the Kingdom.

A sound of light. In the name of Jesus, when I stand, darkness must retreat.

Darkness must flee. Darkness cannot survive where God's light is revealed.

I push back every work of darkness.

I stand.

I become visible.

I refuse to remain silent.

Unmute Yourself

I hear the Spirit of the Lord saying,

"You are being placed on unmute."

Think back to the days of virtual meetings during the pandemic.

Many people would speak passionately while still muted.

Everyone could see their lips moving, but nobody could hear them.

Someone always had to say,

"Unmute yourself."

The Lord says this is a season of unmuting.

Unmute yourself.

It is not God who muted you.

You have muted yourself.

Tell three people,

"Unmute yourself."

There is a sound that Heaven expects from you.

There is a prophetic voice that must be released.

Africa,

Unmute yourself.

Africa Must Tell Her Own Story

How is it possible that Africa's story is continually told by others?

Others define our identity.

Others create the narrative.

They portray Africa as poor, weak, and hopeless.

Too often, images of malnourished children become the only story the world hears about our continent.

But in this season, Africa will be unmuted.

We will declare God's perspective over our continent.

Tell somebody,

"Unmute yourself."

Begin to prophesy over Africa.

Begin to tell the true story.

Our testimony will not be written by others.

We are not the poorest.

We are richly blessed.

The silver belongs here.

The gold belongs here.

Our land is rich with precious resources.

The Lord has deposited abundance within this continent.

The Fire That Removes Every Blockage

Remember the picture of the salt shaker. For too long, the Church has remained on the table without influence because the salt has been blocked.

But God says this is the season of unblocking. As I prayed, I sensed the Lord showing me how He removes blockages.

He applies heat. He applies fire. I see the fire of God's presence resting upon His people. That fire will remove every obstruction. The works of darkness will not withstand it. Every strange fire will be consumed by the genuine fire of God.

Fire confronts fire. Altar confronts altar. The altar of God will prevail over every counterfeit altar. The fire of God will consume every strange fire manifesting in this generation.

Hallelujah!

Genuine Salt Versus Counterfeit Salt

God continues to say, "**Be salt.**"

There is an important lesson about salt. For every genuine thing, there will always be a counterfeit. One example is **monosodium glutamate (MSG)**.

It looks white like salt. It resembles salt. It even produces a similar taste. Yet it is not salt. Many health professionals caution against excessive consumption of MSG because of its potential health concerns.

Likewise, in the spiritual realm, there are counterfeits that resemble the genuine. They look authentic. They sound convincing. But they are not the real thing.

God is saying that His true salt must arise. When genuine believers arise, they expose the counterfeit. We have allowed imitation to occupy the place reserved for authenticity. Counterfeit spirituality has damaged many lives. It has introduced spiritual sickness into the Body of Christ.

But God says,

"No more."

Tell somebody,

"I am showing up."

People often accept the counterfeit only because the genuine has not yet appeared. When the real arrives, the fake is immediately exposed.

Elijah Did Not Debate the Counterfeit

Consider Elijah on Mount Carmel. There were **450 prophets of Baal** and **400 prophets associated with Asherah**.

The numbers overwhelmingly favored the false prophets. Yet Elijah did not spend his time arguing with them. He simply showed up. He called upon the God who answers by fire. His prayer was remarkably simple. There is a place for long seasons of prayer.

But there are also moments when years of intimacy with God produce simple prayers spoken with great authority. Elijah's prayer was, in essence:

"Lord, You know me, and I know You. You are the God of Israel. Now reveal Yourself."

Then he said,

"Show them who You are."

That was enough.

The Ways Of God

Imagine the crowd gathered that day. If they had been placing wagers, many would have chosen the 850 false prophets. The majority appeared stronger. But God does not operate by democracy. He rules by His sovereign authority. The crowd saw one man standing against hundreds. Yet Elijah was never alone.

He stood with the Alpha and the Omega. He stood with the Lord of Hosts. He stood with the God of Israel. Perhaps today you feel surrounded. Perhaps opposition seems greater than your strength.

Hear this: **You are not alone.**

Tell somebody, "**I am not alone.**"

Though many may stand against me, the Mighty God stands with me. If God is for me, who can successfully stand against me?

Demonstrating the Reality of God

The confrontation on Mount Carmel was not merely between one prophet and hundreds of false prophets. It was a demonstration of the living God. After fire fell from heaven, Elijah did not even need to give an altar call. The supernatural itself became the invitation.

The people witnessed undeniable evidence. As a lawyer, I understand the importance of evidence. Courts require tangible proof. But there is a higher evidence than human reasoning can explain.

The people saw fire consume not only the sacrifice but even the water surrounding the altar. It defied natural explanation. God will use His people again to demonstrate His supernatural power. He will perform works that leave people astonished. They will respond to His glory because His power cannot be denied. My prayer is that the demonstrations of God's presence become so evident that people spontaneously surrender their lives to Christ.

A Word to Women in This Generation

Many years ago, I was invited to preach at a bishops' conference. To this day, I still wonder how I received the invitation. Everyone else looked the part. They wore distinguished robes and ceremonial attire.

I had none of those things. On top of that, I was a woman. Earlier today, when Pastor spoke about being underestimated, I smiled because many women understand exactly what that feels like. Yet I thank God for leaders who understand that the Spirit has no gender. We do not preach because of clothing. We do not preach because of appearance. Whether your hair is natural or purchased, it is not your hairstyle that carries the anointing. It is the Spirit of God within you. To every woman who has been overlooked...

To every woman who has been told to remain silent...

Hear the Word of the Lord. God is raising an army. That army includes women.

Declare with boldness, **"I am part of the army."**

I will preach the Gospel. I will be ready in season and out of season.

Strength With Order

Let me encourage every woman. There is nothing wrong with femininity. Remain feminine. Do not believe that effectiveness requires becoming like a man. That is not God's design. We are not called to rebellion. We are called to biblical order.

Consider Deborah. She was a prophetess. She was a judge. She led a nation. Yet she also understood God's order within the home.

Strength and submission are not enemies.

Authority and humility can exist together.

God is not raising a generation of disorder.

He is raising women who are powerful, prophetic, and aligned with His divine order.

We are vessels that God can use mightily.

Reject disorder.

Reject chaos.

Choose God's order.

Be orderly.

Even if God uses you powerfully outside your home, honor His order within your home.

Do not seek to usurp authority.

Walk in wisdom.

Walk in humility.

Walk in the order established by God.

Women Are Part of the Changing of the Guard

I want to encourage every woman because you are part of this changing of the guard. I count it a privilege to stand among so many great servants of God. Often, I have found myself as the only woman on the platform. Yet God continues to remind me that when He calls, He also equips.

The changing of the guard will not exclude faithful women. It will include every servant—male and female—who is fully surrendered to the purposes of God.

Stop Undermining the Grace of God

I remember being invited to address the **Pentecostal Fellowship of Nigeria (PFN)** shortly before President Buhari came into office.

That year was significant because, for the first time, they invited non-Nigerians to minister. Traditionally, they regarded those meetings as addressing local issues.

By God's favor, and through the influence of respected fathers in the faith, I was included.

I remember asking the Lord,

"God, who am I to stand before these great generals of the faith? What can a young woman like me possibly say to such seasoned men of God?"

Then the Lord spoke to me.

He reminded me of the young servant girl who directed **Naaman**, the Syrian commander, toward the prophet through whom God would heal him of leprosy (2 Kings 5).

She was only a young girl. Yet God used her to change the course of a great man's life.

The Lord said, "**Stop undermining yourself.**"

Stop looking down on yourself.

And I say the same to you today: **Stop undermining yourself.**

Someone recently said something that stayed with me: *"It is possible to be both humble and confident."*

That balance is important. Humility should never become an excuse for minimizing the grace of God upon your life. Sometimes what we call humility is actually refusing to manifest what God has placed within us.

That is not humility.

It is disobedience.

At the same time, never allow the grace of God to make you proud. Never begin to think, *"I am the answer. I am the greatest. I am indispensable."*

Remain humble while confidently walking in the assignment God has given you.

Remember, you are part of the **changing of the guard**. This is not about taking over. It is about receiving a **handover**. God is the One who places the baton into your hands.

We do not seize it. We receive it.

A Lesson from Reinhard Bonnke

Let me tell you another story that has remained with me for more than thirty years. I was in Lusaka, Zambia, during a gathering with **Evangelist Reinhard Bonnke**. He shared a testimony that has helped set many people free from religious legalism and the Pharisaical spirit that resists the move of God.

The Lord declared:

"And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh..." — Joel 2:28 (KJV)

What does *all flesh* mean?

It means God pours out His Spirit without partiality. If God gives gifts and grace, are we meant to remain silent?

Scripture also says that both sons and daughters shall prophesy. How can someone prophesy while remaining permanently silent?

So once again, I say: **Unmute yourself.**

However, do it with order. The Apostle Paul was not opposing women being used by God; he was correcting disorder in the gathering. Everything in God's Kingdom must be done decently and in order.

The Lifesaving Stick

Evangelist Bonnke told us that after arriving in Malawi, a journalist asked him, "*Man of God, what is your opinion about women preachers?*"

With his characteristic wisdom, Bonnke replied, "*Young man, do you know how to swim?*"

The journalist answered, "No."

Bonnke continued,

"Suppose you fell into deep water and began drowning. You cried for help, and a woman came with a stick extended toward you. Would you refuse to take it because she was a woman?"

The journalist quickly replied, *"Of course not. I would take it because she would be saving my life."*

Bonnke then answered, *"If you would accept a stick from a woman to save your physical life, why would you refuse the Gospel from a woman when it has the power to save your soul?"*

The Gospel is life-giving. Whoever God sends to extend that lifesaving message should be received.

As Scripture declares:

"Arise, shine; for thy light is come, and the glory of the LORD is risen upon thee." — Isaiah 60:1 (KJV)

You are part of the changing of the guard. Take the lifesaving message of Christ and carry it wherever God sends you.

Power Must Walk with Order

Now, ladies, let me add something with a smile. If you stood up just now, and you are married, let your husbands know that I also said something else.

Do not go home and tell them, *"Mommy Pearl told me to take over the house!"*

I never said that.

I said, "**Be orderly.**"

Whether God has called you as a prophet or an apostle, continue to honor your family.

Serve with love. Walk in humility. Never use ministry as an excuse to neglect your responsibilities. Kingdom power should always be accompanied by Kingdom character.

The Prophetic Carries Solutions

There are two important aspects of the prophetic ministry that I want to emphasize.

The first is **solutions**.

The second is **systems**.

Whenever God raises up a prophet, He intends that prophet to carry solutions.

Solutions for nations.

Solutions for communities.

Solutions for families.

Solutions for neighborhoods.

At the same time, God raises prophets to confront ungodly systems.

Unless we understand these two dimensions—bringing solutions and confronting corrupt systems—we will misunderstand the purpose of the prophetic.

Stay in Your God-Given Lane

Every prophet carries a unique emphasis according to God's assignment. Although different prophets may proclaim the same truth, each does so through the particular lens God has given them.

Consider John the Baptist.

His message was simple:

"Repent."

That was his assignment. For me, much of what I preach centers on the marketplace. God has called me as both a prophet and an apostle to influence systems within society.

Therefore, whenever I minister, you will often hear me address justice, leadership, governance, and transformation in the marketplace.

That is my assignment.

I am not called primarily to pastor a local church. God has sent me into what Scripture would describe as "Babylon"—the systems of society—to bring Kingdom influence.

Tell somebody, **"Stay in your lane."**

Do not try to imitate someone else's calling. Do not preach merely to impress people. Remain faithful to the assignment God has entrusted to you.

The Messenger Is Never Greater Than the Message

One of the tragedies of our generation is that many have reduced the prophetic to predicting telephone numbers, football scores, and other spectacles.

That is not the purpose of the prophetic. Whenever you evaluate prophetic ministry, ask one question: **Who receives the glory?**

Where is the attention directed?

Is it pointing people toward Christ?

Or is it pointing people toward the vessel?

Even the word **apostle** simply means "**one who is sent.**"

An apostle is a messenger. No matter how many titles someone accumulates...

No matter how many degrees follow their name...

They remain a messenger. A messenger never sends himself. He is sent. And the messenger must never become greater than the message. That truth alone is enough to humble every minister.

Beware of Counterfeit Wonders

The prophetic should never exist to draw attention to human personalities. I once watched a video that became popular online. A well-known false minister claimed he was walking in the air. The video carefully showed only dangling legs.

His face was never visible. Yet many people were amazed. As I watched, I asked myself, *"What is the purpose of this?"*

How does this glorify God?

How does this heal anyone?

How does this provide wisdom?

How does this solve a single problem?

The only message being communicated was,

"Look how powerful I am."

But what benefit does that bring to someone struggling financially?

What hope does it offer the broken?

What healing does it provide?

Nothing.

Tell somebody,

"Stop it."

Stop being deceived. May the eyes of your understanding be opened. In the name of Jesus, you will not be deceived in this season.

Wake up!

Do not allow charlatans to capture your attention while directing your eyes away from Christ. The purpose of true ministry is to point people toward the One who heals, delivers, restores, and saves.

Declare boldly, **"I will not be deceived."**

The Holy Spirit has given us discernment. He enables us to distinguish truth from deception.

God is bringing forth a generation that carries solutions. Tell somebody, **"God is placing solutions within me."**

He will use me to transform my community. He will use me to change the atmosphere around me. He will use me to rewrite the narrative of my nation. Earlier we saw presentations addressing practical needs within society.

That is exactly what the Church should be doing. We should identify the needs of our communities. We should gather believers with professional skills. We should combine prayer with practical action. Scripture tells us:

"Even so faith, if it hath not works, is dead, being alone." — James 2:17 (KJV)

We pray.

We declare God's Word. But we must also provide practical solutions. Medical professionals should address health issues. Educators should strengthen education.

Business leaders should transform economies. Not every illness is caused by demons.

Some illnesses result from unhealthy lifestyles.

The Church must minister holistically.

It is time for the Body of Christ to become known once again as a people who solve problems.

Silence Protects the Counterfeit

Sadly, many counterfeit ministers offer no solutions. Instead, they become part of the problem. One of the greatest burdens I carry in Southern Africa is counseling young women who have been abused by men claiming to represent Christ.

Many came into church seeking safety. They joined worship teams. They desired to serve God. Instead, they encountered manipulation and exploitation. Some were gradually groomed and abused by those who should have protected them.

This grieves the heart of God. Many people dislike me because I refuse to remain silent about such things. Others are afraid to confront these influential figures. But hear me:

No matter how large a ministry appears...

No matter how famous a leader becomes...

No one is greater than God. If the Spirit of God lives within you, you must speak the truth. Declare it boldly:

#IShallNotBeSilent

Remember the words spoken to Esther:

"For if thou altogether holdest thy peace at this time... then shall there enlargement and deliverance arise..." — Esther 4:14 (KJV)

If we remain silent when truth must be spoken, God will raise someone else. But I believe this generation will not remain silent. We will release a sound of righteousness.

A sound of truth. A sound of deliverance. Like a trumpet in the hand of God, we will proclaim His Word with boldness and faith.

Carrying Solutions and Defending the Voiceless

God will hold us accountable if we refuse to speak out in defense of the young, the vulnerable, and the defenseless.

The Scripture commands us to **speak for those who cannot speak for themselves**. We cannot remain silent while injustice prevails.

Right now, we are in court, standing against the government in South Africa. They sought to close our baby rescue centers, and I gathered our "Deborahs" and said, *"This is your moment. You were raised for such a time as this. Stand at the gates of righteousness."*

It's time for spiritual warfare.

Just as we prepared ourselves for battles when we were young, we must now prepare ourselves to stand for truth. Remove every distraction. Get ready. The battle before us is not physical—it is spiritual, legal, and moral.

I told them:

"Go to court. Represent the defenseless. Stand at the gates of justice. Babies must not die on our watch."

We did not study law merely to accumulate wealth or prestige.

When I first entered law school, I imagined myself driving sports cars and living an extravagant life. But decades later, I thank God for the vehicle He gave me because it carries me to places where expensive luxury cars cannot go.

Never despise what God has placed in your hands. The resources He has given you are perfectly suited for your assignment. They may not match your original plans, but they perfectly fit God's purpose.

Justice Must Be Rooted in Righteousness

As we prepared our legal team, I realized something profound:

You cannot understand justice apart from the One who is Justice Himself.

God had to retrain my thinking.

The first Scripture He impressed upon my heart was:

"Righteousness and judgment are the habitation of his throne..."

(Psalm 97:2, KJV).

The first lesson was this: **There is no true justice without righteousness.**

They are inseparable. That changes everything. Human governments may legalize abortion and call it justice. Human governments may legalize prostitution and call it equality. But if righteousness is absent, it cannot be true justice.

God measures differently. He measures with righteousness. Sometimes what people call equality actually produces injustice. Consider the biblical principle:

"If any would not work, neither should he eat."

Now apply that principle equally to a six-year-old orphan. Would that be justice?

No.

Equality alone is not justice. That is why Scripture also commands us to care for widows and orphans. God intentionally gives special protection to those who are vulnerable.

From a purely human perspective, that may appear unequal. But from Heaven's perspective, it is perfectly just. God's justice always flows through righteousness.

The Church Must Bring Solutions

One of the greatest lessons God taught me is that my legal education was never about titles, robes, wigs, or status. It was about bringing Kingdom solutions. Sometimes I watched judges wearing heavy colonial wigs under the African sun, and I thought:

How many traditions have we inherited simply because someone else handed them to us?

I pray that every spirit of unhealthy colonial thinking that has blinded us will be broken. Colonization changes culture.

It changes food.

It changes behavior.

It changes identity.

But there is only one Kingdom that should colonize us:

The Kingdom of God.

That is exactly what salt does. Salt is a colonizing agent. Wherever it enters, everything changes. It does not ask permission. It simply transforms its environment. Salt does not wait for meat to come looking for it.

Salt goes into the meat. Likewise, the Church must move into society. We cannot remain hidden.

We carry solutions.

Tell somebody:

"Solutions."

The emerging generation must become carriers of Kingdom solutions.

False Prophets Cannot Produce Solutions

Many counterfeit prophets are not merely failing to solve problems. They have become part of the problem. Some exploit God's people. Some plunder public resources.

Some enrich themselves while nations suffer. If you stole what belongs to the people, then that is your problem before God. The prophetic was never designed for exploitation. It was designed to bring God's answers into broken situations.

A Biblical Model of Prophetic Solutions

Let us look briefly at **2 Kings 3**.

Three kings formed an alliance to confront Moab after Moab refused to continue paying tribute. Before Elisha gave them God's strategy, he first confronted Jehoram.

He challenged his wrong relationships. Only because of Jehoshaphat's presence did he agree to minister. There is an important lesson here.

Be careful about your alliances. Not every collaboration is ordained by God.

Yet this is also a season where God is raising strategic Kingdom collaborations.

The kingdom of darkness often collaborates better than the Church.

Its members may dislike one another, but they unite around a common agenda.

They place the mission above personal preferences.

The Church must learn this lesson.

Collaboration Over Competition

Collaboration began with God Himself. From the beginning we see perfect unity between:

- God the Father
- God the Son
- God the Holy Spirit

No competition.

Only cooperation.

Together they brought creation into existence.

The Church must rediscover this pattern.

We are not called to compete.

We are called to complete one another.

Tell somebody:

"I didn't come to compete. I came to complete."

If you have been comparing yourself with others...

If you've been counting followers...

If you've been measuring ministries...

I break that spirit of competition. This is the season of collaboration.

I celebrate your gifts. I am not threatened by your calling.

Jealousy has no place in the Kingdom.

Jealousy is charismatic witchcraft.

Every Gift Has Its Place

Throughout this conference, I have watched God's servants honor one another instead of competing. Sadly, I have also been in gatherings where ministers tried to out-preach each other.

It became more about performance than ministry. More about proving who had the greater revelation. That is not the Kingdom.

God forbid. In this season, we will complete one another.

One carries wisdom.

Another carries knowledge.

Another carries prophecy.

Another operates in signs and wonders.

Each gift serves the others.

The apostle is not competing with the teacher.

The teacher grounds believers in sound doctrine.

The pastor shepherds and nurtures the flock.

The evangelist gathers the harvest.

The prophet provides direction.

The apostle establishes governmental order and alignment.

Together they function as one Body.

The evangelist brings people into the Kingdom.

The teacher equips them.

The pastor heals and shepherds them.

The prophet gives divine direction.

The apostle establishes Kingdom government.

Working together, they build what Christ intended.

As **Ephesians 2:20** reminds us, the Church is built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Jesus Christ Himself as the chief cornerstone.

This is the model of the Kingdom:

Not competition.

Collaboration.

Not comparison.

Completion.

Not personal ambition.

Kingdom purpose.

Stay in Your Lane

Tell somebody again:

"I will not compete."

Stop measuring your value by numbers.

There are sons today who believe they are greater than those who fathered them simply because they have accumulated millions of followers.

But numbers are not the measure of Kingdom greatness.

Some followers are not even disciples. Having a large audience is not the same as having Kingdom fruit.

Consider Jesus.

How many disciples did He begin with?

Twelve.

Yet no one has ever transformed history more than He did.

So stop boasting about numbers.

Say it again:

"I did not come to compete. I came to complete."

I came to bring what God deposited within me.

I came to fulfill my assignment.

I came to run my race.

Stay in your lane. Don't spend your race watching someone else's. Keep your eyes on the finish line. Don't worry about who has the bigger platform, the larger ministry, or the greater recognition.

Run.

Run with grace.

Run with focus.

Run with endurance.

Looking unto Jesus, the Author and Finisher of our faith.

He determines how we run, when we run, and the pace at which we run.

Guard Your Alliances

Solutions require discernment. The first lesson from **2 Kings 3** is this:

Be careful who you align yourself with. Ask yourself:

Who am I walking with?

Why am I connected to this person?

Examine your alliances.

The Scripture says:

"He that walketh with wise men shall be wise: but a companion of fools shall be destroyed." (*Proverbs 13:20, KJV*).

I pray you will never be destroyed because of wrong relationships.

God warned Solomon not to marry certain women because they would turn his heart away from Him.

Wrong alliances slowly shift your affections.

People who once pursued God passionately can begin pursuing mammon instead.

Eventually they lose the ability to recognize compromise.

Is There a Prophet of the Lord?

In **2 Kings 3**, Jehoshaphat asked an important question:

"Is there not here a prophet of the LORD?"

May that question rise again in our generation.

When nations face crisis...

When governments are confused...

When societies lose direction...

May leaders once again ask:

"Is there a prophet of the Lord?"

I remember when the South African government planned a national celebration that included dedicating the nation to ancestral spirits.

My spirit was deeply disturbed.

In honor of spiritual order, I first approached respected apostolic fathers.

One after another, many responded:

"It is a sensitive issue."

At that moment I realized that fear—and in some cases mammon—had silenced many voices.

But God also raised courageous leaders who encouraged me:

"Woman of God, do what the Lord has told you to do. If anyone questions you, send them to us."

So we acted.

We gathered believers.

We prayed.

We established altars of intercession before those events began.

When global gatherings with ungodly agendas were scheduled, we mobilized prayer across the nation.

We declared:

"Not on our watch."

Where are the intercessors?

Where are the gatekeepers?

This is the hour to arise.

We must not be found sleeping.

God has not given us the spirit of fear.

We will not remain silent.

We will raise altars of prayer for our nations.

Stand Without Fear

Over the years I have received many threats because I have spoken publicly on difficult issues. People have sent messages promising violence.

Yet God has preserved me. If God has assigned you to stand at the gates, there is grace for your assignment.

There is room for you.

There is a place for you.

Take your position.

Do not retreat.

God surrounds His servants with ministering angels.

The Prophet Must First Be a Servant

Returning to **2 Kings 3**, notice how Elisha was introduced:

"Elisha... which poured water on the hands of Elijah."

That statement reveals two vital qualities:

- Humility.
- Discipleship.

Many want the office.

Few embrace the process.

Some leave Bible school expecting immediate prominence.

They desire titles without training.

Authority without submission.

Influence without character.

No one is asking you to become someone's slave.

But God does require process.

Character is formed through faithful service.

Have you served?

Have you honored those who invested in you?

Some people are trained, equipped, activated, and mentored, only to leave and immediately behave as though no one ever poured into them.

They become "big men" overnight.

They forget the hands that helped shape them.

In many African cultures we have a saying:

After drinking from a well, do not pollute it.

One day you may pass that way again.

Remain honorable.

You may eventually leave a ministry or move into another assignment.

But leave with blessing.

Leave with gratitude.

Leave with honor.

How tragic that some people honor charlatans more than the genuine spiritual fathers and mothers who trained them.

Beware the Spirit of Gehazi

Jehoshaphat recognized Elisha because **the word of the Lord was with him.**

May that also be said of us.

Not that we speak because of financial reward.

Not because mammon influences our message.

But because God's Word truly dwells within us.

Whenever I read the story of Gehazi, it sobers me.

At one time he carried genuine grace.

He even perceived things that assisted his own mentor.

He recognized the Shunammite woman's need before Elisha did.

Yet later he believed his own insight made him greater.

He thought,

"My mentor missed an opportunity. I'll go and collect the silver and gold myself."

Pride led him where revelation never should have taken him.

May that never be our portion.

Never assume that one fresh revelation makes you greater than the one who trained you.

Guard your heart.

The Prophetic Power of Minstrels

Before Elisha released God's solution to the national crisis, he made an unusual request.

He said:

"Bring me a minstrel."

Only after the minstrel ministered did the prophetic strategy come.

The atmosphere changed.

Then revelation flowed.

Then came the instruction:

"Make this valley full of ditches."

The solution emerged after worship prepared the atmosphere.

This house understands something important.

Minstrels are not simply musicians.

They are prophetic atmosphere carriers.

Many years ago, the Lord spoke to me about Africa's minstrels.

He revealed that a season would come when prophetic songs released from Africa would impact nations.

There would be moments when ordinary words would no longer be enough.

God would release solutions through prophetic worship.

That is why we must pray for the minstrels.

Pray that God will give them fresh songs.

Songs that shift atmospheres.

Songs that birth revelation.

Songs that release Kingdom strategies.

Songs that carry solutions for cities, nations, and generations.

When the atmosphere changes, Heaven speaks.

And when Heaven speaks, solutions follow.

Prayer for Prophetic Minstrels: Atmosphere Carriers of Kingdom Solutions

"Prophet Jesse, come and declare over these minstrels that they will not merely be entertainers or performers. They will be those who change the atmosphere. Through them, solutions will arise because God is raising up prophetic minstrels.

You will change the atmosphere. You will create an atmosphere that brings solutions for the nation and for communities.

Come on, stretch out your hands.

Stretch out your hands.

He said, *'Call for me the minstrel. Call for me the minstrel. Call for me the minstrel.'*

We call forth minstrels who will activate a new atmosphere that releases solutions, in the name of Jesus. In the name of Jesus."

"Can you lift up your hands?

Father, we thank You for this morning.

We release the sounds of Zion this morning. Just continue to play.

We release the sounds of Zion.

We release the mantle of the minstrel.

We release the spirit of the psalmist.

This morning, we declare that prophetic minstrels are arising.

We declare that prophetic minstrels are rising.

We declare that men and women with the ability to receive the sounds of heaven are rising from this conference.

Men and women who will hear the sounds of heaven.

Men and women who will bring the sounds of heaven into the earth.

We declare, by the Spirit of life, that they are being raised this morning.

We declare that the sounds of God are entering your spirit this morning.

You will leave this conference with a fresh anointing.

You will leave this conference with a new ability.

You will leave this conference with ears to hear—ears to hear what the Spirit is saying—and with the ability to release the sounds of heaven into the earth.

In the name of the Lord Jesus, we declare that the hand of the Lord is upon you.

As the hand of the Lord comes upon you and you begin to release a sound, the prophets will hear accurately, and the voice of God will travel throughout the earth.

We declare that grace is poured upon you this morning, in the name of Jesus."

Hallelujah!

Come on, clap your hands for Jesus!

As you return to your seats, I want to conclude this morning's message.

Your Sound Must Be Authentic

Listen to me, minstrels.

Never be intimidated by sounds that come from outside.

Never try to copy or imitate sounds from elsewhere.

God has given you an authentic and unique sound.

Don't try to sound more American than the Americans.

Yes, unfortunately my accent is like this because I grew up in America. But what I'm saying is this: don't imitate.

There is a sound unique to Africa that carries healing, that carries deliverance, and God is exporting that sound to the nations.

You may miss your assignment to the nations because you are trying to imitate people who already have their own sound.

Amen.

The New Guard Must Understand Systems

We've talked about solutions, and I've tried to give you a case study of solutions. If you study the Scriptures, you'll find many examples where prophets were used to bring solutions.

You see it again in 2 Kings 2:19–22. The city of Jericho had a polluted water source. Once again, they called for the prophet to ask, "How do we remove this corruption?"

In this season, the new guard must be people who carry solutions—not merely people prophesying telephone numbers while helping no one—but people bringing community solutions, national solutions, and solutions to governments and parliaments.

That is the prophetic new guard. If you want to be part of this new guard, you must move in that direction. Not people checking Facebook just to gather information so they can pretend to prophesy over others.

I beg.

Stop it.

Hallelujah.

I have a large Facebook page, and people sometimes try to prophesy over me. I know exactly when you've been checking my Facebook because I know what I've posted there.

That's why the other day I said it wasn't that I was trying to "scan" Prophet Jesse. The office of the prophet carries discernment. Depending on your level of maturity, you can sit beside someone and know certain things.

I already knew he was a genuine prophet.

The things he told me had never appeared on Facebook.

But some people simply go online, gather information, and then pretend to prophesy.

Jaka-jaka prophecies.

Hallelujah.

Don't try that with me.

No.

Somebody tried it once.

Counterfeit Prophecy

A young man from Ghana called me after I had attended a friend's daughter's wedding.

After the wedding, I travelled to Botswana. Before leaving, I gave the couple a large envelope of cash because I preferred giving money instead of buying gifts they might never use. I told them to keep it safe so it wouldn't get mixed with the presents.

About two weeks later, the groom called me.

"Hello... is that Prophet?"

"Yes."

He said, "I saw your legs tied to a tree, and there was a black cat..."

I said, "Hey! Don't bring that rubbish to me!"

Laughter.

He continued, "You must go back to your village..."

I stopped him immediately.

"My grandfather was the first evangelist in our village. Don't bring that nonsense here."

Then I called his father.

I said, "Please, we respect you. Tell this young man not to try these things with me."

Laughter.

You know what happened?

He had seen the large envelope of money and thought, "Let me prophesy so I can get more."

I said, "Young man, stop it."

Laughter.

His father was deeply embarrassed.

He apologized profusely.

I told him, "Please correct him before he damages your ministry with these Hong Kong prophecies."

That's not how the prophetic works.

Understanding Systems

The new guard must understand systems and know how to influence them. If you are functioning prophetically in Babylon like Daniel, you must understand the Babylonian system so you know exactly what must be dismantled.

Jeremiah 1:10 gives us the prophetic modus operandi. The Scripture deals with nations, kingdoms, and systems.

Before we can build and plant, we must first root out, pull down, destroy, and throw down.

Only then can we build and plant.

You cannot build on rotten foundations.

Psalms 11:3 asks,

"If the foundations are destroyed, what can the righteous do?"

That's why you see courageous servants of God exposing false foundations.

What are they doing?

They are rooting out.

They are pulling down.

They are destroying.

They are throwing down.

Why?

Because we cannot build upon corrupt and counterfeit foundations.

Someone must be courageous enough to confront them.

Someone must refuse to fear charlatans.

That is the prophetic assignment.

We must understand Babylon so we know what needs to be uprooted, what needs to be destroyed, and what must be pulled down.

Only after uprooting can we build and plant.

Hallelujah.

Don't Let Babylon Swallow You

Many believers enter Babylon only to become aligned with Babylon. Years ago, I belonged to a ministry called Globe Ministry. As the Botswana chapter leader, we frequently travelled to Zambia for meetings at Mulungushi Hall.

One of the national leaders would pray with tremendous power.

Fire would fall.

But before long, the system swallowed him.

Suddenly we were hearing that he was at the State House because he had chased away his wife—the mother of his seven children.

Then came court cases.

Then came all kinds of scandals.

The system swallowed him.

Tell somebody, "The system."

If you don't understand how systems operate, they will swallow you.

Like Daniel, you must know how to sit in Babylon without eating Babylon's delicacies.

Learning Babylon Without Becoming Babylon

That was one of the greatest lessons God taught me while I worked for the United Nations. Yes, Apostle—I worked for the United Nations.

The United Nations is a corrupt system. Thirty years ago, when I entered the UN, Apostle Bill Akani prophesied over me. He said, "God is calling you to be a light in the midst of darkness."

At the time I didn't understand.

I thought,

"The United Nations? Such a wonderful place!"

I had no idea of the agendas working behind the scenes—efforts to legalize abortion, normalize immorality, and promote ungodly policies.

Many international organizations attach moral compromises to the aid they offer Africa.

God had already warned me.

Three weeks into my orientation in Geneva, I almost resigned.

I had just begun serving as a Senior Social Dialogue Specialist.

An elderly official approached me almost immediately.

With his large stomach and self-importance, he told me that if I wanted rapid promotion to become a director, I needed to be "very nice" to him.

I almost resigned.

But what shocked me most was this:

The International Labour Organization had written global policies against sexual harassment.

Yet during my first week there, I was being sexually harassed.

I cried out to God.

He said,

"Don't leave.

I need you to understand how Babylon operates.

One day you will expose these systems."

Today, when I speak in parliaments across Africa, I understand those agendas because I learned them from inside.

We now develop programs that protect children and counter destructive ideologies because I sat in Babylon—but I refused to eat Babylon's delicacies.

Don't run away from Babylon.

Sit at the table.

Be excellent.

Be skilled.

But don't partake of the delicacies.

Don't run from the system.

Know why God positioned you there.

I learned how to work with government ministers.

Many of them made inappropriate advances.

I learned how to decline their proposals with dignity.

God told me,

"They don't see your humanity. They only see something they want to consume.

Show them your humanity.

Don't become angry.

Don't become aggressive.

Carry yourself with dignity."

When you sit at the table, there will always be people who think you are on the menu.

But know how to conduct yourself with wisdom and honor.

That was one of the greatest lessons God taught me.

One of the senior officials became my protector. As I conducted myself with dignity and integrity, he gradually came to know me. When other men approached me with inappropriate intentions, he would step in like an elder brother.

May God lead you to the table without compromise. May you be in the system without bowing to Baal. May you refuse to partake of its delicacies. May God raise protectors around you. You will enter Babylon, yet Babylon will not change you—you will change Babylon.

God is calling many of you into places of influence.

People say, "Politics is a dirty place."

It is dirty because you are not there.

You are supposed to be the salt.

Tell somebody, "**There's space.**"

There is space in parliament.

There is space in the judiciary.

There is space in the executive.

I call forth every member of parliament who is here today. I came to tell you: **there is space for the righteous in the name of Jesus.**

The darkness remains because the light has not shown up.

You are the salt.

You are the light.

You must arise.

When you appear, darkness must retreat.

Tell three people, **"There's space! There's space! There's space!"**

There is space for you in parliament.

There is space for you in the judiciary.

How can we continue to have corrupt judges and corrupt magistrates?

In South Africa today we are witnessing commissions investigating corruption among police officers, judges, and public officials.

If you are in the legal profession, hear the word of the Lord:

There is space for you.

There is space for you in the judiciary.

There is space for you as a magistrate.

There is space for you as a judge.

Arise and shine.

Righteousness and justice are the foundation of God's throne.

Come with righteousness.

Do not compromise.

Do not eat of Babylon's delicacies.

There is space for you.

The church began responding together:

"There's space! There's space! There's space!"

God is making room.

Confronting Systems

There are evil systems everywhere.

God works through systems.

Esther confronted the Persian system.

There was space for Esther.

There was space for Mordecai.

There is space for gatekeepers.

Even David confronted a system.

Goliath was more than a giant; he represented an oppressive system that had held an entire nation hostage through fear.

David challenged that system.

It does not matter what you look like.

You may appear to be nothing more than a shepherd boy.

People may underestimate you.

It is not about your title.

It is not about your money.

It is not about the car you drive.

Tell somebody:

"There's space for me."

I may not have much today—there is space for me. I may look insignificant—there is space for me.

I may be like a shepherd boy—there is space for me. I may be an orphan girl like Esther—there is space for me.

Tell three more people: **"There is space for you."**

We are going to change systems.
