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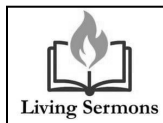

Introduction

Get your Bibles and go with me to **Joshua 3**.

That's old school right there. See how the old folks stood up? That new school does not know anything about that. As they used to say, *stand for the reading of the Word*.

The Scripture says:

“Early in the morning Joshua and all the Israelites set out from Shittim and went to the Jordan, where they camped before crossing over. After three days the officers went throughout the camp, giving orders to the people: ‘When you see the ark of the covenant of the LORD your God, and the Levitical priests carrying it, you are to move out from your positions and follow it. Then you will know which way to go, since you have never been this way before.’”

— **Joshua 3:1–4**

On your way to your seat, high-five somebody and tell them: **“Let’s focus on the glory.”**

You are about to enter new territory. You are about to step into the promise God made you. Whatever God promised you—you cannot die until you get it.

You are going to see it.

You are going to touch it.

And you are going to experience it.

God Hears the Cry of His People

Here we are in the book of Joshua. But to understand Joshua, you must first understand the journey of Israel. The children of Israel had been praying for years to be delivered out of bondage. The Bible says God heard their prayer and handpicked a man named Moses.

Moses' background was not squeaky clean. If you study the Scriptures, Moses had killed a man and hid the body. After that, he became a fugitive and ran into another land.

And then God called him. Please pay attention. He spent his first forty years thinking he was somebody. He spent his next forty years realising he was nobody. And he spent his last forty years discovering that God could use anybody.

And I want to rebuke some of your birth certificates, because some of you keep using your age as an excuse for why God cannot get glory out of your life.

You are right on time. When God called Moses, Moses said: **“Who am I...?”**
“I have a slow tongue.”

But God answered him: *“Who hath made man’s mouth?”* — **Exodus 4:11**

And I came to tell somebody: You are more than qualified. If He called you, He is about to equip you. Tap yourself and say: **“I have everything I need.”**

Say it again: **“I have everything I need.”**

Worship in the Wilderness

God told Pharaoh:

“Let my people go, that they may serve me...”

— **Exodus 8:1**

But notice: He did not say worship in Canaan. He said worship in the wilderness. Anybody can praise God when they get to Canaan. But a real worshipper praises God on the way to Canaan. And many of you are on your way somewhere special.

The only thing missing is your worship. You do not wait until you arrive to give Him glory.

- Every time you see improvement...
- Every time you see advancement...
- Every time you see movement...

You owe Him a hallelujah. Look back over your life and think about where He brought you from. When I look back over my life and think things over, I can truly say:

He has been good.

Pressure at the Red Sea

Finally Pharaoh releases them. But when they get to the Red Sea, Pharaoh changes his mind. Water in front of you. Enemy behind you.

That is pressure. Moses begins to panic.

But God says: **“Why criest thou unto me? ... What is that in thine hand?”**

— **Exodus 14:15**

In other words: You already have what you need to get out of what you are in. Use what you have. The Bible says God sent an east wind, and they crossed over on dry ground.

Praise Packed in Advance

When they crossed over, there was a woman named Miriam. I call her the *set it off*.

The Bible says she reached into her bag and pulled out a tambourine. And I have a question.

You just got free.

You had to pack up everything.

What made you pack a tambourine?

Because while she was packing, she must have said: **“I know He’s going to bring me out, so I’m going to have my praise ready.”**

That means she packed praise in advance. Some of you need to pack your praise before the breakthrough comes. Praise Him before it happens. Praise Him because it is already done.

The Wilderness Tests

God said:

“Let my people go, so they may worship me in the wilderness.” And Israel entered four wilderness seasons.

The Wilderness of Shur

They lacked water. Instead of worshipping, they complained. God gave them water from a rock. But just because God provided does not mean they passed the test.

Provision is not always proof of maturity.

The Wilderness of Sin

This time they lacked food. And God was testing their worship. Would they still praise Him if something was withheld?

Because real worship cannot be conditional. Some of you have been blessed in spite of your murmuring.

In spite of your complaining. In spite of your lack of praise. And God has still been faithful.

The Wilderness of Sinai

This wilderness was different. There was a mountain. God descended on the mountain with smoke. The people were afraid. But Moses climbed higher. And I hear the Spirit saying: **Let them keep watching while you keep climbing.**

Tell your neighbour: **“Let’s go higher.”**

It was at Sinai that God gave the Ten Commandments. It was there that He revealed His will.

Your Waiting Season Is Over

Finally they reached Paran.

And God said: **Go possess the land.** You made it out of Egypt.

You crossed the Red Sea. You survived miracle after miracle. Now go get it. And I came to tell somebody: Your waiting season is over. It is about to be your turn. God is about to place an open door in front of you that no man can shut. But circles matter. You need at least three people around you who are ready to go after everything God has for them.

Not people who are comfortable.

Not people who are satisfied.

But people hungry for promise.

People who can look at you and say:

“Let’s get it.”

Let’s get the house.

Let’s start the business.

Let’s fill the calendar.

Let’s possess the promise.

If you believe God has something waiting for you, lift your hands and worship Him—not for what you have, but for what is coming.

That’s the sound.

That’s the sound of expectation.

Protect the Promise

When God gives you a promise, you must protect it. Moses sent twelve spies. And they came back with opinions. Be careful who you solicit opinions from. Twelve saw the same land. Ten focused on giants. Two focused on God.

The ten said: **“We were in our own sight as grasshoppers.”**

— **Numbers 13:33**

But Joshua and Caleb said: **“We are well able.”**

Everybody will not agree with your faith. But if you can find at least two people crazy enough to believe God with you, that is enough.

Jeremiah said:

“Behold, I am the LORD, the God of all flesh: is there any thing too hard for me?”

— **Jeremiah 32:27**

Shake somebody’s hand and tell them:

“It’s already done.”

Your house is already built.

Your business is already started.

Your children are already saved.

Your ministry is already taking off.

It is already done.

Your Mouth Matters

The power of life and death is in your tongue. Some of you are waiting for somebody to prophesy over you. But you need to prophesy to yourself.

Tell yourself: This is about to be one of the best years of my life.

- My family is blessed.
- My children are saved.
- My house is covered.
- My future is secure.

Your mouth determines your movement. Your confession shapes your possession.

Exposed to Glory

Moses had to stand Joshua up before the people.

Why?

Because Joshua had been exposed to glory. Moses took Joshua up the mountain. He let him see what others could not see. And for some of you, God will place older voices in your life to expose you to glory. To the younger generation:

- Find you an OG.
- Find somebody with history with God.
- Find somebody who does not need music to praise.

Some people do not need a band.

They do not need lights.

They do not need a stage.

All they have is memory.

And every time they remember how good God has been—

Glory shows up.

You do not need a title.

You do not need a position.

You need glory.

You need God like a fish needs water.

And if you have been exposed to glory, understand this:

You are not normal.

You are not average.

You are marked by God.

And glory is coming.

With glory comes favour.

With glory comes healing.

With glory comes deliverance.

With glory comes freedom.

Say it:

“Glory is coming.”

You Are It

Touch somebody and tell them:

“Hey, hey, hey—you are it. Go get it. It’s your turn.”

It is your turn to apply.

It is your turn to take the mic. It is your turn to move from the back of the line to the front of the line. It is the wrong time to be afraid. You are about to do things you have never done before. You are about to go places you have never been before.

And I do not care anything about your age.

I rebuke your age.

You are still in the land of the living.

Stretch Me, Lord

Lift your hands and say: **“Yes, God. Yes, Lord.”**

If you are ready to be stretched...

If you are ready to go places you have never been before...

If you believe God is about to give you what you have never had before...

Then lift your hands and tell Him:

“I’m ready.”

I’m ready to go in.

I’m ready to get everything You have for me.

I’m ready to move.

I’m ready to shift.

I’m ready to be used by You.

And hear me:

For some of you, your assignment is bigger than the church.

You are not going to be bound by four walls.

God is about to take you worldwide.

He is about to make you international.

Moses Steps Back, Joshua Steps Up

Moses backs up.

Joshua steps up.

And now we begin to see leadership in a new light.

Moses led in three positions.

First, he was **among** the people.

He lived with them, touched them, walked with them.

Second, he was **ahead** of them.

He stood in front and said:

“Keep your eyes on me. Follow me.”

Third, he was **above** them.

He climbed the mountain while they looked up.

He was among them.

Ahead of them.

Above them.

But that was too much for one man.

And some of you who lead—whether in ministry, business, or family—you know exactly what that feels like.

It gets heavy.

Numbers 11:14 says:

“I am not able to bear all this people alone, because it is too heavy for me.”

That was Moses.

Even Moses got overwhelmed.

Even Moses got tired.

Even Moses got frustrated.

And Joshua watched all of it.

He watched Moses struggle.

He watched Moses break.

He watched Moses wrestle.

And Joshua understood:

“If I’m next, God is going to have to show me how to do this.”

There is about to be a shift.

God is about to put the right people around you.

Not people who drain you.

Not people who pull on you endlessly.

But like-minded people.

People who want God more than anything else.

Be Strong and Courageous

When Joshua's turn came, God said one thing four times: **“Be strong and of a good courage...”**

— **Joshua 1**

God was saying: I am not calling weak people. I am not calling passive people. I need warriors. You cannot wake up every day saying: “I don't feel like it.”

No.

You wake up and tell hell:

“What?”

You walk into work ready. You walk into life ready.

- A warrior does not lean back.
- A warrior leans forward.
- A warrior stays ready.
- A warrior fights.
- A warrior prays.
- A warrior worships.

And I need you to make sure you are sitting around warriors.

Say it:

“We're ready.”

Fewer Opinions, Greater Clarity

When Joshua sent spies into the land, he did not send twelve. He sent two.

Why?

Because ten opinions are too many. Some of you keep asking too many people what they think about what God told you. You remind me of Joseph. Sharing your dream with people who do not dream. People who only have nightmares.

Be careful who you share revelation with. When the two spies came back, they came back ready.

They came back saying:

“Let’s get it.”

And I prophesy:

This will be your year to get it.

The door is about to open.

Your name is about to be called.

God is about to do something supernatural.

He brought me here at the end of the first quarter.

That means He still has three quarters left in the year.

From April to December—He has time.

And God does not need much time to change everything.

We Got This

Find two or three people and say: **“We got this.”**

We are going to get what our parents never got. We are going to see what our grandparents never saw. We are the generational curse-breakers. We are breaking poverty. Breaking sickness. Breaking cycles. They may have died from it—But you are going to live.

Follow the Glory, Not People

Joshua says: Do not look for me. Look for **it**. Follow **it**.

Some of you keep following people. And people will let you down. But if you follow the glory—You will never lose your way.

Joshua 3 says:

“When you see the ark of the covenant of the LORD your God... move out from your position and follow it.”

Do not stand still.

- Move.
- Move from your position of doubt.
- Move from your position of fear.
- Move from your position of unbelief.
- Move away from toxic environments.
- Move away from limiting voices.
- Move away from spiritual stagnation.

Follow the glory.

What Is in the Ark?

The ark represents His presence. His glory.

It was made of wood overlaid with gold. On top sat the mercy seat. Inside were three things. And wherever the glory goes, these things follow.

1. Manna — Provision

Manna means provision. When the glory comes, provision comes. Rent gets paid. Mortgage gets covered. Doors begin to open. Jehovah Jireh shows up. Everything you need—He supplies. Your provision is coming.

2. The Tablets — Promise

The tablets represented God's promises. And God is not a man that He should lie. If He promised it—He will do it. Keep your eyes on the promise. Believe that you will live to see it.

3. Aaron's Rod — Power

The rod represented power.

Power to overcome.

Power to endure.

Power to survive.

Power to conquer.

Say it:

“Power is coming.”

Your Circle Is Changing

Hear me.

Your circle is about to change. God has already started separating you from certain people. You call them. They do not answer. You get around them. Your spirit feels uncomfortable. That is discernment.

The Holy Ghost is showing you: **This is not your people.** Everybody smiling at you is not for you. Some people clap for you publicly and curse you privately.

Discernment is a gift.

Pay attention.

Glory Carriers

Who carries the glory?

- Not always the people with titles.
- Not always the people with collars.
- Not always the people with positions.

Sometimes it is the person next to you.

Quiet.

Unknown.

Untitled.

But strong.

Fortified.

They have been through storms.

Through trials.

Through betrayal.

Through pain.

And they kept getting back up.

That is what makes them strong.

And if you know God has been your strength—

Give Him praise.

Fortified, Focused, Faith-Filled

Say it:

“I’m fortified.”

That means I’m stronger than what I have been through.

Say it:

“I’m focused.”

That means I will not be distracted by opinions.

I will not be moved by criticism.

I will not be shaken by rejection.

I know where I am going.

And say it:

“I’m faith-filled.”

I still believe.

I still trust.

I still know He is able.

The enemy thought you would have broken by now.

But you are still here.

Still standing.

Still believing.

Still carrying glory.

And that means:

God is not finished with you yet.

If you feel led to touch somebody's hand—even somebody you do not know—shift and grab them.

If you know somebody who is a prayer warrior...

An intercessor...

Grab their hand and say:

“Help me get my faith back.”

Hold that hand by faith.

And if you believe God can do anything, squeeze that hand and declare:

“God's got us.”

Get your faith back up.

Come on.

Get your faith back up.

You have to believe again.

You have to trust again.

You have to stand again.

Delay does not mean denial.

I said delay does not mean denial.

The Scripture says:

“I have been young, and now am old; yet have I not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his seed begging bread.”

— **Psalms 37:25**

And again:

“But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.”

— **Philippians 4:19**

And again:

“Greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.”

— **1 John 4:4**

Get back up in the spirit.

If I agree, and you agree, and we agree—Something big is about to happen.

You Have to Carry the Glory

Listen to me. You have to carry the glory. The only way your family is going to make it out—You have to carry the glory. The only way your friends will ever see it—You have to carry the glory. You are the one exposing them to things they have never seen before.

You are the curse-breaker. I came to get you today. I came to put you back in position.

To remind you who you are. You are fortified. You are stronger than you realise.

You are focused.

And you have faith.

Step Towards the Water

They had to step towards the Jordan. The water did not move until they stepped. Nobody crossed until somebody moved. What kind of pressure is that?

And some of you are feeling that pressure right now. Because you are the carrier.

- You are the youngest.
- You are the grandparent.
- You are the father.
- You are the mother.
- You are the one everybody keeps looking at.

And this is why the pressure is on you. Because you carry something. When they stepped towards the water—The water parted. And they carried the glory to the middle of the Jordan and stood firm while everybody else crossed. Hear me: They may get there before you...

But they could not get there without you. You thought you were left behind. But glory carriers are entering a catch-up season.

The Weight of Glory

Shake somebody's hand and say: **"Glory coming."**

Your strength is about to go to another level. You are about to become a game-changer. The glory of God is about to fall heavy. And some of you are about to feel God in ways you have never felt Him before. It is called the **weight of God**.

He is about to put the supernatural on your natural. You are not just a teacher—You are about to become an anointed teacher. You are not just a business owner—He is about to put favour on your business. He is putting glory on your life.

He is putting weight on your assignment.

Another Level

There is another level of glory.

- Another level of strength.
- Another level of focus.
- Another level of faith.

You cannot be afraid to go deeper. You cannot be afraid to obey God.

- If He gives you the mic—Go for broke.
- If He opens the door—Walk through it.
- If He calls your name—Answer.

There is another level waiting for you. And you are anointed for this.

Say it: **"I'm anointed for this."**

You Are the Curse-Breaker

You cannot leave the way you came. You have to get your strength back. You have to get your focus back. You have to finish what you started.

- You will not break.
- You will not lose your mind.
- You will not quit.
- You are going to see it.
- You are going to become it.
- You are a glory carrier.

And because you carry glory—You have to get your house. You have to get your children. You have to get your friends. You have to go back and pull somebody else through. Because this anointing is bigger than you.

Embrace Your Uniqueness

Lift your hands. Your assignment is huge. And it requires weight. That is why you had to go through what you went through. You were supposed to be dead. You were supposed to quit. But because you survived it—You are assigned to go after survivors. Embrace your uniqueness. Stop trying to be like everybody else.

- Your personality is not like everybody else.
- Your story is not like everybody else.
- Your fight is not like everybody else.
- And your oil is not like everybody else.

The enemy wanted to put your light out—Because when you walk into rooms, you change atmospheres. You change temperatures. You shift environments. And the devil knows it.

But he is a liar.

The First to Do It

Before you leave, hear this.

Many of you are about to be the first.

The first to do it.

The first to become it.

The first to break it.

The first to build it.

The first to carry it.

And because of you—Your family will make it out.

Your children will make it out. People connected to you will make it out. Not because they understood you. Not because they believed you. But because you stood.

You carried.

You had faith.

You believed.

You were misunderstood—But you still made it.

And because you made it—Others will too.

That is the burden of glory.

That is the responsibility of a carrier.

And glory is coming.

It is coming to your house.

It is coming to your family.

It is coming to your business.

It is coming to your future.

And when it comes—Carry it well.

“I can even be trusted with finances, because money flows through me. When they got to Canaan, they said it was a land flowing with milk and honey. Everybody open your mouth and declare: **Things are about to flow for me!**

Those of you who are going to sow, stand to your feet and lift your hands and begin to worship God with your glory seed.

Things are about to flow for me.

I’m going to turn the mic over, but I think we can do this. You can let me know if we can or we can’t.

I need those of you that are going to give this seed—I need you to touch this pulpit and just say, ‘Glory.’

Lay your hands on this pulpit as you sow your seed.

Even if you give electronically, I need you to touch this stage. **Glory.**

I pray that your finances shift.

I pray that God brings you out of debt and that you will be one hundred percent debt-free.

I pray that you lack nothing. I pray that there will be enough money for tuition.

After you touch the stage, you can go back to your seat. After you say, ‘Glory,’ declare: *This is my glory seed.*

And I pray that He increases you in ways that will blow your mind.

If you're in the building or online, whenever you watch this, I dare you to give a glory seed."

Built on a Firm Foundation

My house was built on You...

And I'm going to make it through...

"Hallelujah. Thank You, Father.

As you give—even online—as you give, we're all going to leave together.

Hallelujah.

Can we stop the music for just a second?

Can we worship?

Can you let your worship be the music in this moment?

Come on, lift your voice.

Lift your voice.

The glory is in the house.

Thank You, Father.

Thank You for what You did in this house today, God.

Thank You for renewing us, God.

Thank You because we came looking for a miracle, and You gave us more than that.

We came looking for breakthrough, and You gave us more than that.

I came and got more than what I was expecting.

I wasn't even going to come this morning, Father, but something in my spirit said I needed to get to the house.

I thank You for thinking that much of me.

I thank You for reminding me of who I am and what I carry.

I thank You for refocusing me, God.

I was looking at the wrong thing.

I was looking at the wrong people.

And now I know—I've got to follow it.

I've got to follow the glory.

Wherever the glory is, that's where I will follow.

Thank You for reminding me that You didn't create a mistake.

Thank You.

Thank You that You're not done with me yet.

Thank You that I shall live, and not die."

(KJV, Psalm 118:17)

It Has to Happen Today

"Thank You that there is more work for me to do.

Thank You that my age does not get in the way of Your promise.

Thank You, Father, that my current situation is not my final destination.

Father, thank You that You're changing things even right now.

Even as I come and give,

even as I sit in my seat,

even as I watch online—God, I thank You that things around me are shifting. I was getting depressed because I thought people were leaving me. But now I know You were shifting the right people my way.

God, thank You.

Thank You for every ‘no’ You gave me. Now I realise that the ‘no’ was for my next opportunity. That’s why my hands are lifted in worship.

Thank You for the refreshing. Thank You for Your glory that’s bringing everything that’s needed.

Families are healed.

Children are restored.

Mothers and fathers are covered.

Thank You, Father, that the curse breaks today.

That’s my word.

It’s going to happen today.

I believe it’s going to happen today.

The devil can’t take that from me.

I’ve already spoken it.

I’ve already declared it.

I’ve already decreed it.

You already stamped it in Your Word.

It’s going to happen today.

I don’t care what it is—but it has to happen today.

I don’t care how You do it.

It just has to happen today.

I'm standing on Your Word because You're not going to lie to me.

Your Word has to do what You sent it to do.

It cannot return unto You void."

(KJV, Isaiah 55:11)

"So my seed is for a **today blessing**."

Enter the Ark of Safety

"If you don't have to leave, don't leave. Why would you get out of the ark of safety?

Stay in it.

Focus on the glory. The glory is still here. We're getting ready to leave. But I believe somebody is in this room, and maybe you didn't come to do anything but sit.

Maybe somebody invited you. Maybe you've been wrestling. Maybe you convinced yourself that you would get right with God on your own terms. Maybe you convinced yourself that you were already saved. But something happened in this moment, in this service, and it's nudging you.

It's telling you: **Get into the ark of safety.**

Maybe you've heard about Jesus, but you've never fully met Him. I want to invite you to this altar right now. Make a conscious, sober decision that you are going to come and meet Jesus for yourself.

Not how your mother told you.

Not how your grandmother told you.

Not what you learned in Sunday school.

But for yourself.

Come right now.

Don't be afraid.

Don't be ashamed.

This is your time."

Heaven is Rejoicing

"We're not going to rush.

I see you coming.

Where are the believers that are going to celebrate them coming?

Use your glory and push the sinner back to Christ.

Come on, church.

Somebody's life is on the line.

Come on.

I see you coming.

Let's celebrate, because heaven is rejoicing. Every soul is met by a minister.

Jesus, thank You. I don't know about you, but I get excited when hell loses another one.

Hell, you lose again.

Another soul.

Another victory.

Anybody excited that hell lost again?"

Change Your Confession

“I want you to change your confession.

That struggle you feel—you’ve got to open your own mouth and declare:

I feel good.

This is your community.

We've got your back.

That's what community is.

That's what faith is.

That's what we do.

That's the Potter's House.

That's how we handle business.

You are not going to fight this thing by yourself.

If you don't feel good right now, we're going to make sure you're good."

Final Benediction

"Don't bring a problem in here, because we're going to pray it out. Because we know who we are, and we know Whose we are. Make a point of contact.

That hand you're holding is a miracle. That hand you're holding is blessed beyond measure. That hand you're holding may be the very thing that unlocks the next season in your life.

And as you hold that hand, remember: **This is how God is holding you.**

Father, I thank You right now for meeting us here like You do every week. I thank You for our leadership, our bishop, and for Pastor Hannah. I thank You for the reminder that the glory is what we follow. And now, as we leave this place, we leave in Your care.

Not looking after man,
not after government,
not after leadership—but following the glory.

And wherever it goes, so do we.

Keep us until we meet again.

In Jesus' name.

Amen and amen."
