Haggai chapter 2.

Today is March 1st, and many of you may know that for the next thirty days, those of us who are in agreement are giving up processed sugar.

Now, if you are not in agreement, this is not necessarily a fast. If you do not know the history behind it, I do not want to take too much time unpacking it—you can scan the QR code. But essentially, we all know processed sugar is not good for us.

You can trace many sicknesses and diseases—from diabetes to high blood pressure and so much more—back to processed sugar. It is what it is. I am not judging you or trying to convict you; it just is.

So, I did a little research. I asked, *“If I gave up processed sugar for all of 2026, what would happen?”*

Of course, all the health benefits came up, and that was wonderful. But something else appeared that I did not expect.

It said:

You will have better mental clarity.

And at a time when God has me speaking about clarity, that stood out.

So I said, *“Okay, God.”*

I started this conversation in LA last week, and God said, *“I am still saying it.”*

And He has given it to me in a way that is different, but very much for us.

The Promise of Glory

“For thus saith the LORD of hosts; Yet once, it is a little while, and I will shake the heavens, and the earth, and the sea, and the dry land;

And I will shake all nations, and the desire of all nations shall come: and I will fill this house with glory, saith the LORD of hosts.

The silver is mine, and the gold is mine, saith the LORD of hosts.

The glory of this latter house shall be greater than of the former, saith the LORD of hosts: and in this place will I give peace, saith the LORD of hosts.”

— Haggai 2:6–9 (KJV)

That is powerful. He says: **“I will shake all nations.”**

And then: **“They shall come to the desire of all nations.”**

What God is saying is this: Even if they do not know what they desire—it is Me.

Even if they do not know what they hunger and thirst for—it is Me.

Lord, we love You so much. May the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in Your sight. God, I thank You for wisdom, revelation, insight, knowledge, prophecy, and all of heaven's resources to communicate this word in a way that will be prophetic and divinely prolific. Let there be a stirring in the hearts and minds of Your sons and daughters. Let the gift of God be stirred up.

Let there be an activation that brings alignment and produces glory in their lives, through their lives, and throughout all the earth.

In Jesus' name.

Amen.

Honour Where Honour Is Due

I want to take this moment to honour our bishop—my father, my friend, our champion, our king, builder, coverer, protector, guider, wisdom-giver, strength. A man who will fight off lions and bears for those he loves. We love you and honour you, sir. And of course, our forever First Lady—our mother, our intercessor, our prayer warrior, our strength, our model, our example.

We love you both so very much. And with each passing day, we appreciate you even more.

Hallelujah.

Get In Position

I want to talk from this prophetic declaration. And my belief is that when you hear these three words, they will resonate in your spirit in a way that bypasses your intellect and reaches deep into your spirit.

These words are not merely a title. They are a divine command. An instruction.

And if you align with this command, something is going to be unleashed in and through your life like never before.

The words are: Get in position.

Understanding God's Timing

There are two words translated as “time” in Scripture, particularly in the Greek.

One is **Chronos**.

The other is **Kairos**.

Chronos is where we get our English word *chronological*.

It deals with ordinary time—the ticking of the clock.

But Kairos is different.

Kairos is an appointed time.

A set time.

A divine moment.

Galatians 4:4 says:

“But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son...”

— Galatians 4:4 (KJV)

That is Kairos.

It means God has timing that we often do not understand. Jesus was the Lamb slain before the foundation of the world, yet there was a moment in time when that reality manifested.

Kairos is a predestined, pre-appointed moment where things become what God always intended. God holds times and seasons in His hands. And He has expectations for what He created to look like at certain times.

That is why Hebrews says:

“For when for the time ye ought to be teachers...”

— Hebrews 5:12 (KJV)

God has expectations tied to timing. He created us with Kairos assigned to us. And not just us—all creation.

There are things that shock us but never shock God. God declares the end from the beginning. And the fact that we are shocked only proves: His thoughts are not our thoughts. His ways are not our ways. God is never saying, “*Oh my God.*”

He is God.

The Latter Glory

The latter glory will be greater than the former glory. In context, Haggai is speaking of the rebuilt temple. But prophetically, he is speaking beyond the temple.

Jesus said:

“Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up.”

— John 2:19 (KJV)

The temple pointed to Christ. And Christ’s body points to us. We are now the temple of the Holy Ghost. So when God says the latter glory will be greater, He is talking about who we are becoming.

That means the idea of “*the good old days*” is inaccurate. To long for yesterday violates this prophetic reality. Because God says: **The glory of the latter shall be greater.**

And Scripture says:

“...from glory to glory...”

— 2 Corinthians 3:18 (KJV)

The best is still ahead. Turn to your neighbour and say: “**The latter will be greater.**”

Glory Requires Shaking

Now here is the challenging news. The text speaks of glory—but in the backdrop of shaking. Before the glory comes: God shakes.

He said: “**I will shake heaven and earth.**”

Do not overlook that. Because glory requires shaking. Successive levels of glory require shaking. Shaking is the administrator of glory.

Why?

Because glory requires alignment. Glory requires divine alignment. We behold the Lord and are transformed into His image. Transformation means movement.

And as we change: Glory follows.

Glory follows a pattern.

When Moses went up the mountain, God did not say:

“Build whatever you feel.”

No.

He gave him a pattern.

A blueprint.

And when Moses implemented that divine pattern, glory filled the tabernacle. Glory does not respond to misalignment. God is specific.

Sometimes, to move you out of what you think and into what He knows requires a shaking. And we do not like it.

But we need it. Because often, we are content to stay where we are—while the glory is somewhere else. So because God loves you, He will shake you into alignment.

He will shake you into position. And sometimes, that shaking is the greatest thing that can ever happen to you. Because we love comfort.

But God loves purpose. And purpose requires positioning.

Adam, Where Art Thou?

“Adam, where art thou?”

God was not asking for Adam’s location.

Adam was still in the garden.

This was not about geography.

It was about positioning.

Adam moved.

His perspective changed.

His paradigm shifted.

His sensitivity was altered.

He was no longer aligned.

And God said:

“Where are you?”

Not because God could not find Adam. But because Adam could no longer find God. When Adam was in position, glory covered him. When he moved out of alignment, he had to cover himself. God has always required pattern before glory. That is why Jesus said:

“Not my will, but thine, be done.”

— Luke 22:42 (KJV)

Because God’s will contains the pattern. And the pattern produces glory.

The Definition of Alignment

Alignment is when everyone—and consequently everything—is lining up as God purposed before the world began. When you are aligned, what you produce becomes aligned. And what flows from your life reflects heaven's original intention. That is why getting in position matters. Because we are in a Kairos moment.

- This is not the time to be casual.
- This is not the time to be out of order.
- This is the time to get in position.

See, God does not want us to simply be in alignment for the sake of alignment. He wants us to be in alignment so that we can be fruitful, multiply, and produce from that place of alignment.

Are you hearing me?

What you do when you are out of position is different from what you do when you are in position. Alignment is when everyone—and consequently everything—is lining up as God purposed before the world began. And because of that, you have to pursue it.

That is why I am pursuing clarity by any means necessary in this season.

It is not about a book.

It is about the backdrop of the world right now.

And what the backdrop is saying to me is:

We are getting close.

And I do not want to be distracted, confused, or misaligned.

I do not want my feelings and emotions manipulated by this source or that source.

I need clarity.

There are so many things aimed at us right now, trying to make us think one way or another. The arguments grow more compelling and more seductive by the day. There is a strategy to keep you confused. To pull you this way today and another way tomorrow.

Mad one day. Happy the next.

Aligned one moment. Misaligned the next.

No.

I need clarity.

I need the voice of God to steer me through this season.

I am not playing games.

If I have to give up sugar, so be it.

I will do whatever is available to me to be clearer than I have ever been.

I do not want anything manipulating me.

Not even sugar.

You have got to be hungry, thirsty, and desperate for clarity in these times.

The Bible says:

“...the people that do know their God shall be strong, and do exploits.”

— Daniel 11:32 (KJV)

I need to know my God.

- I will fast.
- I will pray.
- I will read my Word.

I will seek His face. I am going to be clear in this season.

The Flow of Alignment

You have got to pursue alignment. There is nothing like knowing you are in alignment with God. And you do not have to guess it.

There is a sensing when you are. And there is a sensing when you are not. When you are in alignment, there is a flow. Things that once felt like toil begin to flow like oil.

What was difficult suddenly becomes easy.

Doors begin to open.

Things start moving towards you.

It feels like all of creation is cooperating with you.

And that is Bible.

Romans says:

“For the earnest expectation of the creature waiteth for the manifestation of the sons of God.”

— Romans 8:19 (KJV)

Notice—it did not say Christians.

Because you can carry the title and still not walk in sonship.

Creation is waiting for the revealing of sons.

Creation is leaning in expectation for the real you.

The aligned you.

And when you step into alignment, God begins to funnel things to you through creation.

But do not get it twisted.

Creation is not God.

Creation is the delivery system.

God is the source.

Creation is only the mailman.

And you do not praise the mailman for the cheque.

You praise the One who sent it.

When you are in alignment, creation starts cooperating.

But creation will not cooperate with a false version of you.

Creation recognises truth.

Restoration Through Positioning

Sometimes things have been hard for years.

Five years.

Ten years.

Twenty years.

But when you step into alignment, God begins to restore the years the locust has eaten.

Things you thought were gone begin to return.

And you are blessed as though you had been in position the whole time.

That is why Hebrews says:

“Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompence of reward.”

— Hebrews 10:35 (KJV)

There is great reward in expectation.

But you need patience.

Patience after you have done the will of God.

That means patience through the shaking.

Patience through the discomfort.

Patience through the process.

Because once God gets you into position, everything He promised concerning your life begins to show up.

The Sons Must Be Revealed

All creation eagerly waits for the revealing of the sons of God.

That means sons must be revealed.

And do not get caught up in gender.

This is spiritual language.

This is kingdom language.

Sonship speaks of position.

Authority.

Inheritance.

And the revealing of sons speaks to a process.

Creation is waiting for you to become you.

From glory to glory.

Through your willingness to align with God.

And who are the sons?

Romans tells us:

“For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.”

— Romans 8:14 (KJV)

That is critical in this season.

We are going to need an intentional relationship with the Holy Spirit like never before.

Because the Holy Spirit leads us both **in alignment** and **to alignment**.

God Speaks Through Shaking

You ask:

“How do I get into alignment?”

That is a legitimate question.

And here is the answer:

It is not your job.

It is the Holy Ghost’s job.

Your responsibility is to yield.

Hebrews 12, referencing Haggai, says that everything that can be shaken will be shaken, so that what cannot be shaken may remain.

And before it says that, it gives a warning:

“See that ye refuse not him that speaketh...”

— Hebrews 12:25 (KJV)

That is powerful.

Because in the context of shaking, God says:

Do not refuse Him who speaks.

Meaning:

The shaking is God speaking.

God speaks through shaking.

And many times we blame the devil for what God is using.

Even if the devil is involved, God still uses it.

Look at Job.

God used the shaking to bring Job into greater glory.

Sometimes the greatest gift God can ever give you is to shake you.

Because He is trying to get your attention.

He is saying:

“The time has come for you to get in position.”

And because He loves you too much to let you miss your moment, He will shake you.

It will not feel good.

It will make you uncomfortable.

It may make you dizzy.

But He is up to something.

He is the Potter.

You are the clay.

And He is shaping you into something you could never become without the shaking.

Shake Everything That Is Not Me

When God shakes you, the only thing that falls off is what was never really you.

Your spirit cannot be shaken.

So God shakes everything that is not you.

Everything you thought you needed.

Everything you were holding onto.

Everything you built that He did not build.

And when it falls away, you realise:

You never needed it in the first place.

Shake everything that is not me.

Shake everything against me.

Shake everything I built that You did not build.

Because Hebrews says:

“...we receiving a kingdom which cannot be moved...”

— Hebrews 12:28 (KJV)

Some of you are about to move from church into kingdom.

From title into truth.

From performance into purpose.

God is shaking everything that cannot withstand fire.

Everything that cannot survive flood.

Everything that cannot survive testing.

Because there is a call on your life.

An assignment that only the son-version of you can fulfil.

It will not happen by might.

It will not happen by power.

It will happen by His Spirit.

The Holy Spirit and Truth

The Holy Spirit is the difference-maker.

Jesus said:

“Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth...”

— John 16:13 (KJV)

He is not just a guide to truth.

He is the Spirit of truth.

He is my inner alignment.

And if I want to be aligned, I must be intentional about my relationship with Him.

The Bible also says:

Do not grieve the Holy Spirit.

How do we grieve Him?

Through untruth.

Sometimes we would rather grieve the Holy Spirit than grieve the things we need to let go of.

But Jesus said:

“Blessed are they that mourn: for they shall be comforted.”

— Matthew 5:4 (KJV)

To follow God, you will have to grieve some things.

Some desires.

Some attachments.

Some relationships.

Some habits.

Because if you will not grieve temporarily, you may grieve permanently.

Get in position.

Three Areas of Positioning

It is time for you to take your place in three specific areas:

1. Spiritual Authority

This comes first. Because whenever God gives you natural authority, it is a gift. But what makes you effective is your ability to function in spiritual authority.

2. Economic Empowerment

God wants to position His people in places of provision and influence. Not merely for themselves—but for kingdom assignment.

3. Societal Impact

There are places in society God is calling His sons into.

Places of leadership.

Places of legislation.

Places of transformation.

Places where kingdom values can shape culture.

This is what alignment looks like in practical terms. And this is where God is calling His people in this hour. When you are not just legislating naturally, but legislating spiritually—in prayer and in becoming—God gives wisdom, strategy, favour, and insight.

He will allow you to outwit the enemy.

He will allow you to see wickedness before it fully forms.

And He will give you the wisdom to cut it off before it even begins.

But you need spiritual authority.

And that is for all of us.

God gave the Church not merely the authority to be loud, but the authority to be effective. Sometimes, the quieter you are, the more effective you can be.

You do not always have to announce your strategy. What army announces its strategy?

Just move.

Just move.

Spiritual authority is critical.

Economic Empowerment Is Kingdom Work

Economic empowerment is spiritual. Many times we separate money from ministry, but resources have always been part of how God worked with His servants—from Abraham onward. Resources matter because resources move kingdom assignments.

Right now, we are devising strategies to get resources into Iran. Many of you may not know this, but years ago I planted a church—an all-Farsi-speaking church—made up of former Muslims from Iran who have now given their lives to Jesus.

That church is still strong.

And now they have access into regions that have been destabilised.

If we had no money, all we could offer would be thoughts and prayers.

But God intends to increase His people.

And that increase must be intentional.

That is part of what the School of Kings was about.

Not just quoting:

“But thou shalt remember the LORD thy God: for it is he that giveth thee power to get wealth...”

— Deuteronomy 8:18 (KJV)

But manifesting it.

God gives the ability to create wealth.

Not for selfish ambition.

But for kingdom assignment.

Societal Impact

Spiritual authority.

Economic empowerment.

Societal impact.

These are the three channels through which God desires to use His people.

And this is for everybody.

Some may not feel called to build businesses.

That may not be your assignment.

But spiritual authority belongs to all.

We need your prayers.

We need your intercession.

We need the strength of your faith.

We need your wisdom.

We need your mentorship.

Everybody has a part to play.

I am so grateful for what the deacons are doing—our mature deacons pouring into the younger ones, and the younger ones pouring back into the older ones through technology.

That is kingdom.

Everybody has a role.

But all of us must get into position.

The Holy Spirit Leads Us into Alignment

The Holy Spirit leads us in alignment and to alignment. Without Him, alignment would be impossible.

He is real.

And He is here.

When you say yes to Jesus, it is because the Holy Spirit first drew you.

That drawing is His voice.

Scripture says:

“...no man can say that Jesus is the Lord, but by the Holy Ghost.”

— 1 Corinthians 12:3 (KJV)

If you can perceive right now that Jesus is Lord—that is the Holy Spirit at work.

But there are levels to this.

There is surrender.

There is filling.

There is baptism in the Spirit.

And that is where we must get.

Galatians says:

“Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh.”

— Galatians 5:16 (KJV)

The Holy Spirit leads us in alignment.

Because our flesh is powerful.

Our will is powerful.

But His Spirit is greater.

Romans tells us:

“For if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.”

— Romans 8:13 (KJV)

You cannot overcome the flesh without the Spirit.

The Altar Call

I want to extend a multi-tiered invitation.

If Jesus is speaking to you right now—if you feel the tug of the Holy Spirit—and you know He is calling you, this is your moment.

Maybe you have hesitated because you have looked at your own strength and thought:

“I cannot do this.”

And honestly, I respect that.

Because you are not trying to play with God.

But hear me:

His Spirit will give you what you do not have.

You are weighing the outcome through the lens of your own ability.

But He is saying:

“I am not calling you to Me in your own strength.”

Take the little strength you have.

Come.

And watch Me work.

If that is you, say yes to Jesus.

Yielding Instead of Resisting

The second part of this invitation is for those who know they have been grieving the Holy Spirit.

You have been feeling conviction.

But you have been forcing it down.

And today you are saying:

“I will not grieve Him anymore. I will yield.”

That is rededication.

That is surrender.

And then there is a third invitation.

For those who now recognise that the shaking in your life is not to destroy you—but to better you.

You have resisted it.

You called it the devil.

But now you understand:

It was God positioning you.

And today you are saying:

Not my will, but Your will be done.

I surrender to the shaking. And as you surrender, God will give you strength. Not just to survive the shaking. But to become better because of it.

It Was Good That I Was Afflicted

There will come a day when you will say:

“It is good for me that I have been afflicted...”

— Psalm 119:71 (KJV)

It is hard to say in the moment.

But when God brings you through it, and you see what it produced, you will understand.

Paul said:

“For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory.”

— 2 Corinthians 4:17 (KJV)

A light affliction never feels light while you are in it. But when glory shows up, you realise it was worth it. I am not minimising your pain. I am not dismissing your hurt.

I know life hurts. Sometimes life itself hurts. But Paul also said:

“For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us.”

— Romans 8:18 (KJV)

When the glory comes, you will know it was worth it.

And God says:

“I will not leave you in the fire alone.”

He will be the Fourth Man in the fire.

Right there with you.

Trust the Shaker

Trust the Shaker.

That is the word of the Lord.

You shall come forth as gold.

And your clothes will not even smell like smoke.

Your life will not look like what it has been through.

God says:

I have got you.

Before He formed you in your mother's womb, He knew you.

- He ordained you.
- He set you apart.
- He called you.
- He chose you.
- He claimed you.

And if He is for you, who can be against you?

Nothing will separate you from His love.

- Not tribulation.
- Not distress.
- Not peril.
- Not things present.
- Not things to come.

Nothing.

Closing Prayer

Father, I commit Your sons and daughters into Your hands. Those here and those watching. Your Word will not return void. It will accomplish what You sent it to do. Seal those who are saying yes to You for the first time.

Seal their faith. Seal their trust. Let it never be uprooted. Strengthen those entering into a new or renewed relationship with the Holy Spirit. Holy Spirit, You are our guide.

- Our comforter.
- Our advocate.
- Our alignment.
- Our strength.
- Our victory.

And for those surrendering to the shaking, meet them with grace.

Strengthen them.

Give them peace.

Give them shalom.

Let them know You are holding them.

That You will not let them fall.

That their steps are ordered.

And though the path may not be easy, it is sure.

From glory to glory.

In Jesus' name.

Amen.
