Introduction

In this first part of our series, we've been looking at salvation being a gift—a gift from God.

Ephesians 2:8–9 says:

“For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast.”

This is not your doing. It is the gift of God. We understand that salvation is not by what we did. There is nothing that we did that could make us earn salvation from God. It's just a gift. And this gift, we understand, is given freely of God through faith.

So salvation belongs to God. The psalmist cries in the book of Psalms:

“I will lift up mine eyes unto the hills, from whence cometh my help.

My help cometh from the LORD, which made heaven and earth.”

— Psalm 121:1–2

The problem of humanity was so deep and dark that salvation could arise nowhere except from God. So that is what we've been discussing. We realize that this salvation that comes from God is a gift.

And for the past three or so sessions, we've been trying to unpack this gift.

We realize that many people have gifts. You may be given a gift. Even I can give you a gift right now. But until you unpack that gift and look at what you have been given, you may not be able to appreciate it.

And we realize that this is the problem that many Christians and many Christian circles are going through. They know that salvation is a gift, but they don't know what that gift really entails.

Praise the Lord. Is somebody with me?

What Salvation Entails

So far, we've talked about the four things that this salvation you are given entails.

The four things that we have discussed are:

- Forgiveness.
- Healing.
- Glory.
- Acceptance.

Note: This salvation entails healing. And we established that this healing that is being talked about in this gift of salvation is physical healing.

“By whose stripes ye were healed.”

— 1 Peter 2:24

And we also established that salvation brings us back to the glory that we lost. So we are no longer ashamed. We are taken back to glory. And also, we discussed intensely that salvation brings us acceptance. We are no longer rejected by God.

You can follow our sermons; these sermons are recorded. You can follow them.

The Fifth Thing Salvation Brings

So today, I'm talking about the fifth subject that salvation gives unto us. And I'm not saying that whatever I'm going to say is exclusive. It's just by the limit of my study and my exposure with God.

I'm still walking with God in, let me say, my primitive years of molding by the grace of God. So don't be satisfied with whatever we are sharing here. Go and dig deep. Follow, and I know the Lord will help us.

We are not a monopoly of knowledge. God has raised others who are deeper, better, and they know why. And as we follow, we are able to make these things available to you.

So the fifth thing that this gift of salvation brings to us is **blessing instead of curse**. And we are going to understand that when you are saved, you are blessed.

MAN WAS CREATED BLESSED

Genesis 1:27-28.

“So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.

And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth.”

What I want to try to bring you here is that when man was created, the original template of man from God—God created man and blessed man. So when man was created, man was not created in a curse.

Man was not created in curses. The idea of man was that God created a blessed man, so that when man is blessed, he is able to achieve God's purpose. Because you can't fully achieve or come to God's realization, God's purpose, or fulfillment of life and destiny if you are not blessed.

So I want you to understand this: In creation, in the beginning, man was created in blessings.

The Beginning of Curse

So we hear that curses started coming after the fall of man in Genesis chapter 3.

That's why you find cursing coming into humanity, and it was a result of sin. That's why the ground was cursed. You find things like curses now beginning to be introduced into the life of man. But initially, man, in his innocence in the Garden of Eden, was walking as a blessed man. And one of the manifestations of these curses that we see in the life of man is that now he had to toil and sweat to eat.

You see, when man was created, he was created in abundance. He didn't labor to eat. All his labor was just to keep and guard the garden, yet food was available.

But after sin, now this man is laboring under a curse. Now he has to sweat.

And one of the manifestations showing that we are laboring under curses—we'll see later—is that you are waking up and coming to sleep in the evening only to eat. All your labors are fulfilled. You are trying to sustain yourself.

Because in God's primary agenda, the blessedness of God was that we would do His will, yet He sustains us in His blessings.

The Devil's Strategy

So curses began to operate as a result of sin. And you realize that the devil now began to use the curses in our lives to keep bringing us into bondage.

So man was caused to labor under a curse in order to eat. You see, in God's blessings, you realize that God wants us to eat for free when we serve Him.

Nobody works.

If you are a reasonable man, when you have a worker, when they labor for you, you meet their needs.

You see, blessings will change people for good. When somebody is blessed, somebody working and laboring under blessing—it will change them for good.

Yet curses are always negative. And from then, we see curses going from generation to generation.

Misfortunes coming on people's lives.

People laboring and being under bondage of the enemy because of the curses that began to operate after the fall of man.

Understanding The Origin Of Curses

I'm telling you this because I'm telling the origin of curses. We won't have time to dig deep into curses, but I'm telling you the origin of curses.

When we now come to see what Christ did on the cross, because what brought curses was sin, and when that sin is dealt with on the cross, it will bring—it will undo it.

So man originally was blessed of God.

And you find now, when you start the Bible, you still start seeing this curse operating from generation to generation. They start operating in places.

When we were talking about territorial war in one of our sessions, we realized that there are some places that are cursed.

They are cursed.

Why?

Because these things—all of these things—came because of the portal that man opened through Adam by sin.

WHEN THE FRUITFULNESS IS BLOCKED

You are doing so much. You find somebody—you study, you work, yet you are never becoming fruitful.

Things like you're working so hard, yet you are laboring under the yoke of poverty. I'm not saying this for the lazy. I'm saying this for the hard workers. You are hardworking, yet you are not seeing the fruit of what you're doing.

You are always being defeated. You are laboring under sicknesses. Some are hereditary genetic diseases. Some of them are just a result of this. And when we understand the cross, we'll be able to overcome some of these things.

Is somebody getting what I'm saying? Am I with people here?

THE OPERATION OF CURSES

When you look around, you see the operation of curses. They are just visible. You see things like mental diseases and illnesses, psychiatry.

You know, I've, by the grace of God, studied a little medicine, and I've realized this side called psychiatry doesn't have a cause. We just manage symptoms. We don't know even a cause. We are trying to formulate hypotheses and theories to accommodate some things that are bound by some influences.

Things like barrenness, chronic illnesses, miscarriage. There are some breakdowns in marriages that even are a sign of curses. Nobody gets married—I know most of us are young. We don't understand.

You're in your prime. We thank God. So we understood that we can deal with those things before they reach there.

Getting drawn to accidents within three months—there's something hanging over you that, if you don't know the provision of the cross to undo that thing, then you'll end up a victim.

Because they don't choose. And my people perish because of lack of knowledge.

Hosea 4:6 says:

“My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge.”

These curses—some of the things that bring curses to operate in our lives, apart from what we have understood, began to operate legally after the sin of man.

But there are things even in our lives that we do in our generation that, when we submit ourselves to them, make these curses strong and they begin to be active.

Things like idolatry.

Idolatry And Cultural Practices

Idolatry—worship of traditional gods and culture.

I hear this saying that we always keep saying, that, you see, Africans—we used to worship our gods before the whites came with their God.

I'm like, “Oh my goodness, our gods.”

That's what we Africans used to worship.

Let's go back traditionally.

You are calling the devil your gods.

Africa had Christians before a white man. Jesus was not even white. Jesus was a Jew.

He was a Jew, but He came with white men as you—Africa.

Africa had Jesus even before Europe. Jesus came to Egypt when He was young.

So Africa had Jesus.

These things—let's go back. Those idolatries.

That's why, if you still worship culture, there are some demonic things they trigger.

Your great-grandfather—they sat down and they agreed that if a secondborn marries after the firstborn, then the secondborn will die.

And then you want to follow culture.

“I follow culture.”

You are triggering something. Are you getting what I'm saying?

You have to worship Jesus alone. Because some forms of idolatry trigger some of these curses.

False religion and secret societies.

That's why sometimes we are so careful about these false prophets.

WRONG ATTITUDES CAN TRIGGER CURSES

Some of the other things that trigger curses are wrong attitudes towards your biological parents.

“Mrs., I don't agree with my dad.”

I don't agree with my dad. Keep quiet and thank God that you are alive. Let me say this, and I know through—it's unfortunate, maybe your dad was not able to go with the generation to my...

Attitude.

Dishonor.

You see, these are parents. Honor your father and mother.

“Honour thy father and mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.”

— Exodus 20:12

I'm not saying you can't disagree.

Honor.

The attitude that you give can trigger some of these things. And also, be careful with your words. Some of these things—your own words, your own words—can trigger some of these things.

“Me, I'll not be great. I can't. I'm just okay.”

“I'm just...”

“I'm just small. I'm just nothing. I'm just nothing in this meeting.”

Those are some of the words that can trigger some of these curses, even words from authority—people that are higher in authority.

You need to be careful.

BE CAREFUL WHAT YOU SUBMIT YOURSELF TO

You need to be careful about honoring people. Visiting witch doctors.

You know, visiting a witch doctor can trigger something.

And you don't know the cross, and what the cross has made available for you.

You will be serving these things. You will be doing things, and then they take off your...

...your grandparent...

And then we pass.

We are in Christ, but you don't understand the cross on those things.

And in your new life, you can be bewitched.

The entire church in Galatia was filled with the Holy Ghost.

Paul asked them:

“O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not obey the truth...?”

— Galatians 3:1

Who bewitched you?

You need to get some of this knowledge.

Can we kindly understand these things?

CURSES DO NOT CHOOSE

And these curses—they don't choose.

Look at Esther.

There was a decree that every Jew was going to be killed during those days in the palace.

She was not even aware of what was coming—that if you don't arise, even you and your entire family will be wiped out.

You may be enjoying life in Christ.

If you don't rise, even you will be swept up.

And somebody else—if you don't come into the knowledge and take action, then you also...

You're not...

The fact that you are in the palace doesn't make you immune to some of these decrees.

Because God is a just God, and Satan is a qualified lawyer from a university that is well known.

If in Kenya we could call it the University of Nairobi, doing law.

He's a qualified lawyer.

He's not a quack.

A quack—you will present your case.

Are you understanding up to that point?

So there are things you need to study.

KNOW WHAT IS OPERATING IN YOUR FAMILY

Maybe in your family, your great-grandmother had miscarriage.

Your grandmother did, and then you...

You speak in the Holy Ghost.

I tell you the truth, I lie not: it's hanging.

But it is possible to overcome them in Christ.

And that's the reason why this class is available today.

The headache that you're having in your family is unusual.

Unusual headache.

Headache. Headache.

Headache.

Like the head is aching too much.

There are some things that are generational.

You need to know these things so that you use what salvation has brought to you to undo some of these things.

Maybe in your family, nobody has ever gotten married.

They struggle every time. They struggle. They struggle.

Nobody has ever wed from your family. There's no history of wedding in your home.

And then, "I am in Christ Jesus."

Before you know it, you will be a victim.

But now that you know it, you won't be a victim.

Nobody has...

I tell you, sometimes...

You see, this thing that people say—things happen, they do happen.

Why?

Because there's something hanging on the cloud.

Yes.

So you need to know what you need to find. You need to know what to box.

Sometimes you need to sit down and say:

“What is it in my life? Why am I born? I'm studying so hard, yet the highest I can get is 42.”

Studying so hard.

I remember in primary, I studied so hard to go to Alliance. But I thank God my daughter will go there in Jesus' name.

I studied so hard.

But we thank God. Where God placed me is also good.

That was meant for a joke.

Glory to God.

That was a joke, not a curse.

UNDERSTAND THE SOURCE

But what I'm telling you is that there are things that, if you know the source, you can deal with.

Because Satan wants you to fight spiritual things naturally because he wants to take them naturally.

Somebody is saying to me, "I'm good."

Can we get Galatians 3:10?

Maybe somebody said, "This person is no longer quoting Scriptures. He has become a motivational speaker."

"For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse: for it is written, Cursed is every one that continueth not in all things which are written in the book of the law to do them."

— Galatians 3:10

So this is how it is.

The law came.

And the law was like, if you cannot observe the entire law, you are cursed.

Are you getting it now?

Because the law was like, you have to observe every bit.

But they do know the law regulates how we shave.

The law even regulates how we dress.

You choose one.

You can't plant maize and beans in the same shamba.

You are cursed.

So cursed is anyone who does not abide in all things.

Therefore, under the law, we are all cursed.

I assure you, even the preacher here.

But I know better.

Why?

Because I'm not under the law.

Those who rely on the works of the law are under a curse.

Why?

Because you know the law placed a standard that, if you want to be blessed, you have to observe the whole law.

NO ONE COULD KEEP THE WHOLE LAW

Now, right now, I'm always wondering how we are so angry with the politicians because they are not abiding by the law.

And I'm asking: Are you a citizen?

Which citizen in Kenya abides with the law?

Even observing traffic rules.

Where do you cross the barabara? Is it at the zebra crossing or the flyover?

Do you?

So if all of us are under the same category...

If all of us...

We are unfair.

We say that the leadership in Kenya is unfair.

And you are going to begin to...

That mama, you are offering five bob.

Are you not being unfair to them?

So under the law, all over, stop pointing fingers at the top.

Point fingers at yourself.

And then...

Come on, somebody, right now.

You can...

Don't abduct me, please.

So you can't observe the law and come out of a curse, because the only way to come out of a curse by the law is to observe everything that is written there.

The Standard of The Law

James 2:10.

James is just—James is always after Genesis.

“For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all.”

— James 2:10

What the Bible is saying is that if you say, “Ah, I’m going to observe the one,” and then you fail in one, you’ve violated the entire law.

So because none of us could keep the law, all were under a curse by default.

Are you getting it?

So without Christ...

Because if you’re not under Christ, you are regulated.

You are either under grace or under the law.

So if you are not under grace, if you're not under Christ, then we are all lawbreakers, and we are all under a curse.

And those curses have legitimacy to operate in us.

Is somebody understanding?

BEFORE POINTING FINGERS, LOOK AT YOURSELF

So sometimes I think about us Kenyans and how we seem righteous when we point at politicians.

Let me just share this, and I know...

Before pointing at those people, let's point at ourselves.

How many have paid KRA?

How many have lied to KRA?

You're working it.

You are near returning.

How many?

So if you begin repenting, start:

“Lord, I am a sinner. Have mercy.”

I'm deviating. I don't know why.

Have mercy on me.

Kenyans right now, they say...

Yes, Amos.

You are full of glory.

But can I ask you something?

On your side, are you...

If politicians are corrupt, who gives our policemen bribes?

You.

You that violate NTSA rules by...

Where do you belong?

Yes, there are some problems in some parts of the...

The preacher is also a victim.

Praise God.

Let's come to the topic.

I'm deviating.

May I be guided?

ONLY CHRIST CAN FREE US FROM THE CURSE

So because none of us could keep the law...

Yes, Amos is trying to say that driver is driving the car from outside in some of the cars that we use.

So none of us could keep the law.

So we were all under a curse by default.

So how did it happen?

Only through Christ are we able to be free from the curse and to overcome them.

Galatians 3:13.

I want us to see something here.

“Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree.”

— Galatians 3:13

You see, I told you that God doesn't understand—you have to pay.

If you owe God something, you have to pay it.

So what God did is that Christ became a substitute for you, so that through Him you may be free from the curse.

“Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree.”

I hope you know how Christ died.

It was not like the movies put it.

Christ was...

No, He didn't.

He was cursed.

He was like a cursed figure.

Jesus was naked on the cross.

He hung naked on that cross so that He may become a curse, so that through Him we'll be able to overcome the power of the curse over us.

And sometimes I pity some.

They are cursed. Curses are manifesting in their lives, and then they go...

You can't overcome a curse in your family by working hard to go to university.

I tell you the truth.

I always say that if you are cursed and you are poor in your family lineage, you can't overcome it by going to university.

Where do you block through education?

You have to be free indeed so that you can work.

You can't...

The devil wants to blind you to see it as:

“People didn't love education in your village.”

No.

There is something at work that is making it manifest.

So Christ was hung so that through Him we are able to overcome the power of the curse.

But the death of Christ is not as those movie tellers...

You see, even one of the thieves told Him:

“Are you really the Christ? Why can't you come down? Why are you so powerless on this cross?”

You look cursed.

But He did that so that He may free us.

So the Bible says Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us. For it is written:

“Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree:”

Galatians 3:13 (KJV)

So the curse that was due you was placed on Jesus so that you may be free from it.

Verse 14 says:

“That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.”

Galatians 3:14 (KJV)

Ah! So when Christ was made a curse for you, it was so that the blessing—the blessing, the blessing—may come upon you.

When the Bible talks about Gentiles here, we are Gentiles because Jews and Gentiles are people that are not Jews.

True? True.

So every curse that was due us, that could have come on us, was laid on Jesus instead, so that the blessing of Abraham and his seed might be available to us.

God's blessing can only come—the blessing that was intended before creation can only come to us in Christ Jesus.

That's why the enterprise of salvation began with Abraham. Isaiah 51 talks about:

“Look unto Abraham your father, and unto Sarah that bare you: for I called him alone, and blessed him, and increased him.”

Isaiah 51:2 (KJV)

So the enterprise of salvation began with Abraham.

There's a sermon I taught here—I think it's in one of our videos—entitled “**We Are Blessed with Blessed Abraham.**” Do you remember that sermon?

Go and find it. It was in January. It's a 40-minute-something sermon. “**We Are Blessed with Blessed Abraham.**”

It will give you a lot of insight.

The Blessing Of Abraham Is Available Through Christ

Let's read Galatians 3:16.

The blessing of Abraham that might come to us—that blessing.

So when God was trying to bring the enterprise of salvation, it began with Abraham. That's why our salvation is by faith, the same as Abraham believed in God, and it was credited to him as righteousness.

Now the promises were made to Abraham and to his offspring.

So that offspring—the promise God gave, “I will bless you and your offspring”—that offspring was in Christ.

How?

So that when we become in Christ, we are included in the blessing that God blessed Abraham with.

Someone may ask, “How was Abraham blessed?”

Genesis 24:1:

“And Abraham was old, and well stricken in age: and the LORD had blessed Abraham in all things.”

Genesis 24:1 (KJV)

The blessings of God in our life should be in all things.

The blessing of Abraham covers every aspect of our lives, and this blessing is made available to us through faith in what took place on Jesus on the cross.

That blessing entails being old and advancing in years.

So this is the liberty that we receive when we come to Jesus: that we enter into the blessing that God blessed Abraham with.

And he was blessed in all things.

In marriage, he was blessed.

He lied many times, but he was blessed nonetheless.

He was blessed.

He had cattle. He had his life in peace. God was on his side.

That is the blessing that we enter when we come to Jesus.

The Goal of Satan

Satan doesn't want us to get into this liberty. So he wants to blind you, because you see, Satan was defeated once and for all.

I always say that Satan may be powerful, but not to me. Not because I am powerful, but because I am in Christ.

Does the Bible say:

“Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might.”

Ephesians 6:10 (KJV)

When you want to combat Satan, you have to enter into the strength of God, because Satan knows that he was defeated and he knows that his time is up.

So when he knows that his time is up, he will not fight you by force. He will fight you by trying to make you not know what you're supposed to know—to not know your liberty.

You are bound. You are sick, and you're comfortable.

Curses are hanging over you, and you're comfortable.

He doesn't want you to know that you are freed in Christ so that you may contend for your blessings.

That's why many times Satan wants us to lose the vision of the cross.

Like in Galatians 3:1:

“O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, crucified among you?”

Galatians 3:1 (KJV)

So the bewitching of the Galatians was not in charms.

It was that Satan just came and took off their eyes from Christ the crucified.

So they began to live life apart from Christ. They began to lose focus on Christ.

And I always tend to believe that every preacher needs to come to a place where they can portray Christ publicly, because that's the only salvation of mankind.

How are we going to be able to come out of the bondage of things that our fathers subjected us to?

It is when Christ is portrayed.

And that's why we are unpacking this gift: that when we unpack it so well, religion will fall off of you, and you will see what is yours and you'll take it.

Because Satan wants you to waste your energy in buying what has already been paid for.

You didn't get that clearly.

He wants you to waste your energy in buying what has been paid for.

And you know very well that there is no price that God will accept except the one that only He can pay.

So Satan knows you can't attain the price to buy the blessing, and he doesn't want you to know that it was paid.

He wants you to be comfortable in your lack.

And he wants you to labor, labor, labor, labor, labor for something that has been paid for you by Jesus.

Yes, paid for your blessing so that you may receive it by faith.

So even when we are praying, we are praying on the strength of what Christ did.

STOP PRAYING FROM A MINDSET OF DEFEAT

And I read the books of Derek Prince a lot. And one thing that I learned from him one time is that he said, **“Stop praying for the negative.”**

Believers are fond of praying for the negative.

Because you see, some people maybe have an exam and then you pray, “God, help me so that I may not fail.”

Very pathetic prayer.

I’ve just remembered Martin. It’s well. *[Laughter]*

“God, help me so that I may not fail,” instead of praying, “Lord, thank You because You’ve made me...”

Just pray, “God, help me to pass.”

But you see, you’re just on the negative: “Help me so that I may not fail.” *[Laughter]*

Many believers, just because Satan has blinded your mind, believe that you deserve the negative.

Praise the Lord.

How many of you are going to pray, “God, save me. God, help me so that I may not be poor and I may not fail in life”?

Many people that know you know that you pray all prayers with thanksgiving.

So it will be like:

“Lord, thank You for what Jesus did. I pray that may I be successful in doing what You have called me to do.”

There are some who are so much obsessed with backsliding:

“Lord, that I may not backslide one day.”

My prayer to God is:

“Lord, help me to walk till the end.”

Because if this is possible, help me. How can I backslide?

Jesus is praying for me in heaven.

The Holy Ghost is praying in me, in my heart, and they are praying for me.

I can't think of backsliding.

You will think of it until you backslide because the mentality—Satan has blinded your eyes.

You are just negative always.

You are praying for people just on the negative.

“Lord, that I may not die today.”

Lord, help me.

Who told you you're going to die?

God has killed death. We are life.

God, I will live.

Praise God.

See life as things.

Satan wants you to always focus on what Jesus paid for.

Oh, you just want to lose your focus.

And that's why believers are like the church in Galatia. They were taken off from the grace, and they started working, going back to the law to earn what Christ already paid for.

Through the cross, in Christ Jesus, we get the blessings of Abraham, and they are free and by faith.

Galatians 3:29.

Look at this. Give me KJV.

King James:

“And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.”

Galatians 3:29 (KJV)

So if you are in Christ, then that blessing that was for Abraham and his seed—you are that Abraham's seed in Christ, and you are an heir to the blessing.

Let me tell you, there are problems in your life that may not have a source. You're looking so empty, and I read so well—I'm working hard to get out of the block, the way people say it.

You need to sit down and pray to God: **“Open my eyes that I may see.”**

The good thing is Christ became a curse so that you may be blessed. It's already 11. I don't want to extend today, so that you may not say that...

Yeah. Let me stop there.
